Game on Dude Readies for Classic

Looking to improve upon a second-place finish in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs, **Game on Dude** (Awesome Again) worked six furlongs in 1:12.20 at Santa Anita Sunday morning.

Accompanied by Rafael Bejarano, the dark bay's time was the second fastest of 21 moves at the distance. "He went *really* nice," said trainer Bob Baffert. "I really liked it. Everything went smooth."

Victorious in last season's GI Santa Anita H. and GI Goodwood

S., the gelding finished 12th in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup before reeling off wins in the June 2 GII Californian S. and GI Hollywood Gold Cup July 7. Runner up in the Aug. 26 GI Pacific Classic, Game on Dude bounced back to take the Sept. 29 GI Awesome Again S. at Santa Anita last time. "He's been like this all year long," said Baffert. "He's been really good ever since he came back from Dubai." **cont. p3**

Awesome Feather Works For Ladies Classic

Stronach Stables' **Awesome Feather** (Awesome of Course) drilled six panels in 1:12.24 over the Belmont Park main track yesterday in preparation for the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 2.

According to trainer Chad Brown, this will be the undefeated 4-year-old's second-to-last piece of work prior to the Breeders' Cup. "I was very pleased with her work," said Brown. "She went in 1:12 and I got her [galloping] out in 1:24 and change for the seven eighths, all by herself, nice and easy. I'm very, very happy with the way she was moving. She galloped out super, and came back to the barn good." **cont. p3**

STREET SENSE TO JAPAN

GI Kentucky Derby and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire})--Bedazzle, by Dixieland Band) will relocate to Darley's farm in Japan for the 2013 breeding season, Sheikh Mohammed's operation announced Sunday. The 8-year-old entered stud at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Kentucky in 2008, and has been represented by graded stakes winners Castaway and Motor City from his first crop. He ranks in the top five among second-crop sires on earnings, wins and stakes wins this year.

"Japan is a racing superpower," said Darley Chief Operating Officer Olly Tait. "The transfer of Street Sense there is an indication of the ambition that Darley has for our operation in many different parts of the world. We have a considerable number of mares in Japan and it is great testament to Street Sense that he will breed the majority of them in 2013." Sheikh Mohammed and his family were granted Japanese racing licenses in 2009, and he, along with his wife Princess Haya and his son Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed, now operate racing stables in the country. Homebred Fleet Street (Jpn) (Street Sense) won two stakes in Japan earlier this year for Sheikh Mohammed, and ranks as his sire's top earner with career winnings of \$424,659. **cont. p3**

In addition to Street Sense heading to Japan, Darley also revealed yesterday that **Desert Party** (Street Cry {Ire}--Sage Cat, by Tabasco Cat) would join fellow Darley stallion Girolamo (A.P. Indy) at Sequel Stallions in New York in 2013. The \$2.1-million Fasig-Tipton Florida graduate, a U.S. graded stakes winner at two and multiple group winner in Dubai, entered stud in Kentucky last year. "New York is a great place to breed and race horses," Tait said. "We've shown our support for New York breeders by standing Girolamo there this year, and we received it back. Desert Party standing alongside him at Sequel Stallions in 2013 is another way of moving forward in that market."

In addition to GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopeful Game On Dude, Bob Baffert also sent out **"TDN Rising Star" Executiveprivilege** (First Samurai), who is slated to contest the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. With Rafael Bejarano aboard, the undefeated filly--working in company with Super Ninety Nine (Pulpit)--completed six panels in 1:12 flat, the fastest of 21 works yesterday morning in Arcadia. Her stablemate executed the task in 1:12.80. "Her work didn't go as smooth as I wanted it to, because she was too far back," explained Baffert. "[Bejarano] grabbed a hold of her and then she lost interest, but she worked good." Winner of Del Mar's GIII Sorrento S. Aug. 8, the bay added scores in the Sept. 1 GI Del Mar Debutante S. followed by Santa Anita's GI Chandelier S. Sept. 29.

Baffert continued to turn out Breeders' Cup contenders Sunday, including GI Xpressbet BC Sprint hopefuls **Coil** (Point Given) and **Capital Account** (Closing Argument), first and second-place finishers of the Oct. 6 GI Santa Anita Sprint Championship, respectively. Coil negotiated four furlongs in :46.60, while his barnmate covered the distance in :48.80. Coil, victorious in last season's GI Haskell Invitational S., recorded the fastest of 45 moves at the distance yesterday. Also possible to join Baffert's Sprint team, **Fast Bullet** (Speightstown)--unraced since taking a Hollywood allowance in November 2011--covered five furlongs in :58.60. According to Baffert, the 4-year-old will be ridden by Joe Talamo in the Sprint.

Awesome Feather seeks her second Breeders' Cup victory. She took the 2010 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies en route to divisional honors. Despite being plagued by injury, Awesome Feather has remained perfect in 10 starts, including two Grade I wins. She most recently took the Nasty Storm S. at Belmont Sept. 20 following an eight-month layoff. "Fingers crossed, if we can keep her happy and healthy, we're in good shape," Brown added. "I'm going to come back and, hopefully, work her next Sunday [Oct. 28th], and, if she checks out good on Monday morning, we'll put her on the plane and bring her to Santa Anita."

In registering convincing successes in the G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen over 10 furlongs at Frankfurt May 6 and G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen over a furlong farther at Cologne June 10, Novellist could not have taken better credentials into the July 1 G1 Deutsches Derby. Surprisingly workmanlike in the Hamburg Classic, he managed to beat all racing closest to him before losing out overall to the isolated rail runner Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}), and there was the familiar sense of anticlimax that naturally occurs when an unbeaten star surrenders that tag.

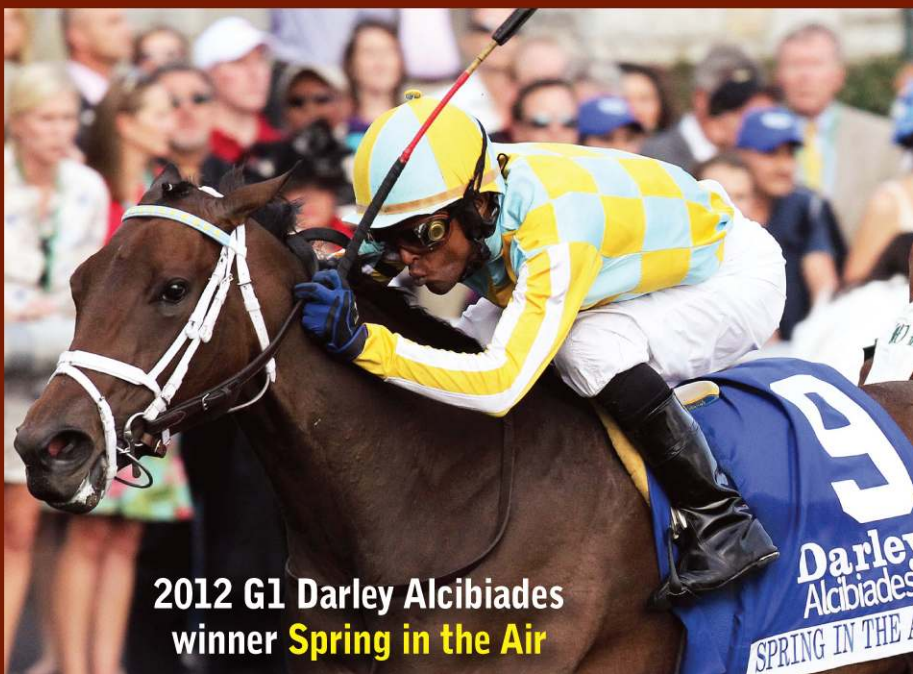
Restrained in third early by Eduardo Pedroza racing keenly off the moderate pace, he was shuffled back to second-to-last by the home turn. Asked to close passing the three pole, the Andreas Wohler trainee gained command in the center of the track a furlong later and employed his stamina reserves to draw away from chief danger **Retrieve (Aus)** (Rahy) on the run to the line.

As Meatloaf once said, "Two out of three ain't bad." Gold Ship, hero of the first jewel of Japan's Triple Crown, April's G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas), before running fifth in the second, May's G1 Tokyo Yashun (Japanese Derby), lived up to his prohibitive favoritism to take down the series finale yesterday at Kyoto. Coming off a return victory in the G2 Kobe Shimbun Hai Sept. 23 and sent postward the 2-5 pick with rival and Yashun hero Deep Brillante (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) a late defection, Gold Ship was a bit slow to get going from the inside draw. Despite being pushed along, he soon found himself at the back of the pack. Last but not one while a dozen lengths behind as they passed in front of the stands for the first time, Gold Ship began to make eye-catching headway on the outside as they raced down the backstretch and progressed all the way to third with 600 meters remaining. He struck the front shortly after they made the right-hand turn into the lane, and while fellow closer Sky Dignity gave game chase, Gold Ship was never seriously threatened in the run to the wire.

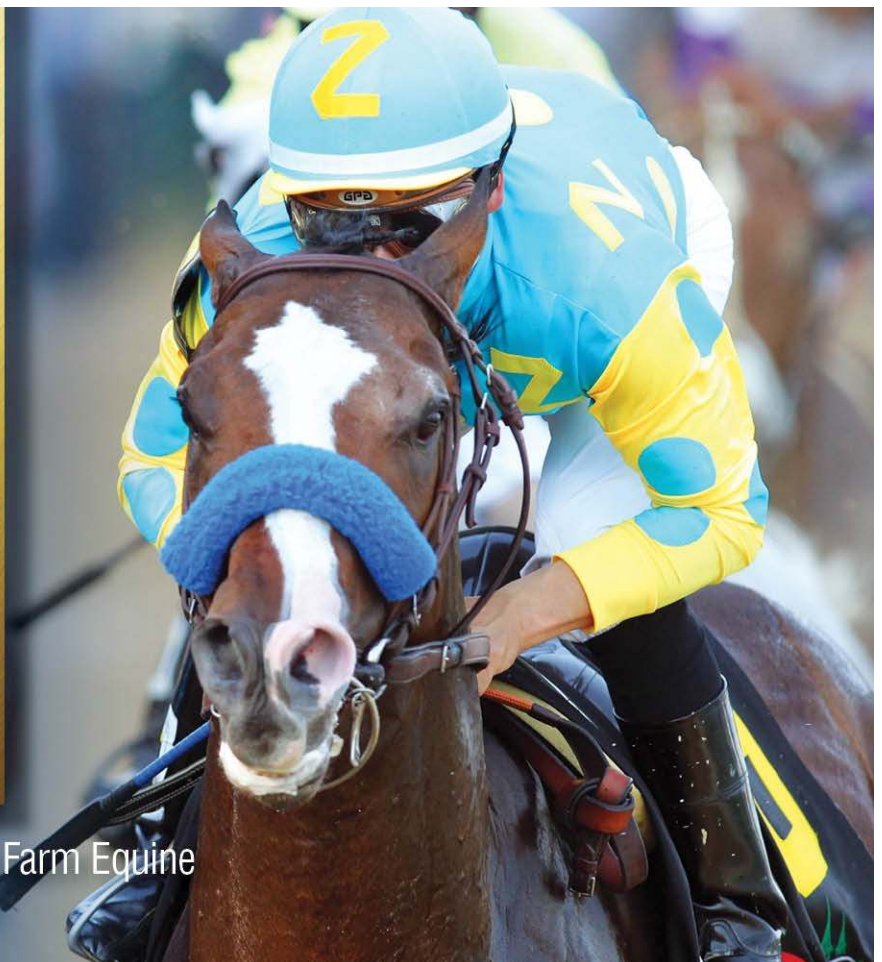

DETTORI TO GO FREELANCE Frankie Dettori's longstanding partnership with Godolphin has been brought to an end, it was announced yesterday. A statement issued on the website of the racing operation of Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum read, "Frankie Dettori will not be retained by Godolphin next year, but he will continue to ride for the stable." Dettori, whose 18-year spell in the royal blue began with a ride on the operation's first Classic winner Balanchine (Storm Bird) in 1994, has registered 110 pattern-race successes for the firm in total. Reflecting on the decision to close out the formal arrangement, Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "We have had a tremendous association with Frankie over many years. He has achieved so much on behalf of Godolphin and has made the difference between winning and losing on so many occasions in the world's biggest races. However, Frankie is looking for a fresh challenge, and we felt that the retainer was not really working, so this is the best way forward. We have had many great days together, and we look forward to working with Frankie in the future and, hopefully, enjoying more success together. He remains a great friend--the difference next year will be that he will not be our retained jockey and will operate as a freelance instead." Dettori added, "I have had 18 wonderful years. Godolphin has been a major part of everything I have achieved in racing, and I have loved every minute of it. I feel the time has come for a change. My position in the stable has changed a little bit, and I need a new challenge. Sheikh Mohammed has been an unbelievable boss to me. He had the confidence to take me on board when I was young, and we smashed every record together. I will be forever grateful to him for everything he has done for me and for my family. The whole team have been fantastic--none of it would have been possible without them."

Beau Pere was an established sire in New Zealand and Australia when Mayer bought him to stand at his California stock farm. Some years later, when Mayer was dispersing his stock, he sold the aged stallion to Combs, who moved him to Kentucky; the relocation proved to be too much for Beau Pere and he died before he could cover a mare in Kentucky. All of Beau Pere's influential stock was produced in California.

Alibhai was imported by Mayer to be a racehorse, but after he worked a mile in 1:36 and came back with bowed tendons in both forelegs (stories don't agree on why--that he got away from the rider is one theory), the unraced colt became a stallion in the Mayer barn. At the time of Mayer's dispersal, Combs put together a syndicate to purchase Alibhai as a proven stallion from Mayer for an eye-popping \$500K; his transfer to Kentucky ended better than Beau Pere's and Alibhai went on to greater sire glory.

And although Royal Charger stood at Combs' farm from the beginning of his U.S. career, he was purchased in Ireland by Neil McCarthy, who had been Mayer's adviser on breeding matters. McCarthy also imported the outstanding Australian racehorse Shannon II to race in California and upon his retirement, sent him to Combs's farm for stud. Mr. Combs did not import any of these horses--his contribution was standing and supporting them. Kindly give the credit to those to whom it is due.

The 2012 Grade I winners Spring in the Air (Spring at Last) and Willy Beamin (Suave) further underscore the inexpensive gems that can be unearthed, as that pair cost \$50,000 and \$16,000, respectively. According to Fasig-Tipton, the October sale has produced more than 100 stakes winners who cost less than \$40,000 in the last five years.

“The reality is the sale is having more success because consignors are bringing us a better horse,” said Fasig-Tipton President and CEO Boyd Browning, Jr. “As long as people bring a quality product, you’ll have success with sales graduates.”

That success helped drive growth last term, when gross surged 81.4% to \$17,046,800. The average price saw a similar rise, increasing 76.3% to \$24,010, while the median rocketed 140% to \$12,000. The buyback rate was a very good 19.8%.

“We had a very good sale in 2011, and all indications are the sale will be good in 2012,” added Browning. “We’ve had significant pre-sale activity. I think a lot of folks still need yearlings and racing prospects, and that should bode well, as I think we have a better group of horses here than we’ve ever had.”

Adena Springs outlasted trainer Mark Casse for last year’s topper, the stoutly bred **Celestial Cruiser** (Medaglia d’Oro), a half-brother to Grade I winner Honor in War (Lord at War {Arg}), who went for \$380,000. Mill Ridge consigned the as-yet unraced colt.

Casse came back for the second-highest-priced horse of the 2011 sale, the Smart Strike colt **Desert Strike**, from Bluewater Sales for \$270,000. On Oct. 14, Desert Strike donned cap and gown in a two-turn maiden special weight at Keeneland for Casse and owner John Oxley ([video](#)).

Other graduates from a year ago who have won recently include the \$230,000 **Delhomme** (Dixie Union). The Winstar Farm LLC and Twin Creeks Racing-owned, Todd Pletcher-trained youngster led every step in a Belmont maiden special event ([video](#)) Oct. 13. Delhomme, number five on last year’s topper’s list, was consigned by Lane’s End and purchased by Al Pike, who subsequently sold him to Pletcher and company for \$440,000 at Fasig’s Florida Sale.

Just yesterday, the juvenile colt **Rei** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) added to the sale’s win column at Woodbine. Acquired from the Three Chimneys draft by Bradley Thoroughbreds for \$70,000 a year ago before reselling for \$490,000 at OBS March, the first-timer registered a professional win for Casse and owners Pike Place Racing and Robert Masterson going seven furlongs ([video](#)).

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING ...AT THE SALES

Fasig-Tipton's Boyd Browning, Jr. on the yearling market in 2012:

"I think both buyers and sellers feel it's been difficult, which probably means it's a more fair marketplace. It's not easy to buy a good horse, and it's damn sure not easy to sell a horse who isn't perceived as good. Buyers continue to be selective, but the diminution of the number of horses produced has certainly brought supply and demand more in synch."

WinStar's Elliott Walden on finding prospects at FTKOCT:

"This sale's a little different. Some of their hair coats are starting to turn, and horses don't look quite as shiny as they do in September. But they're also bigger and stronger. So there's a nice blend in trying to put that puzzle together and finding a nice horse."

Pinhookers have been making a lot of money off these horses for a long time, and now I think you're starting to see more end-users here, too. For a sale they almost gave up on a few years ago, it's really gained momentum. A big part of that is in the results. When you see a Spring in the Air or a Willy Beamin, who won the GI King's Bishop, you know there are good horses in the sale, and I think pinhookers have known that for a while."

CHANTAL SUTHERLAND RETIRES

Jockey Chantal Sutherland announced her retirement from riding yesterday. "The moment has come where I have decided to announce my retirement from being a professional jockey; I almost can't believe it myself," began a statement on Sutherland's website. "I'm not sad, but rather looking at another opportunity to begin a new chapter in my life. Looking ahead, I'm excited about new challenges and new opportunities that life has in store for me." Sutherland, 36, earned Sovereign Awards in her native Canada in 2001 and 2002 for Outstanding Apprentice Jockey. She rode 931 winners from 7,350 career mounts with earnings of nearly \$47.3 million. Her most recent major riding accomplishments came aboard MGISW Game on Dude, who she piloted regularly until losing the mount on the leading GI Breeders' Cup Classic contender last month. "Horse racing has been my life for the past 14 years," Sutherland's statement continued. "I've reached many of the goals that I set for myself. I've lived out many of the dreams I had as a little girl, back when I was riding my pony, mucking stalls, feeding cows, aspiring to finally become a professional jockey and racing in stakes races on a worldwide stage. I'm so very blessed and grateful of the life that I have lived and career that I've had." Sutherland married Dan Kruse in May. She was suspended for five days last month after failing a breathalyzer test at Woodbine. Her final mount came in Woodbine's Bunty Lawless S. Sunday--she finished seventh aboard Crushin Hard, who her father Hugh co-owns.
