PLATE NO WALK IN THE PARK

Jockey Glen Boss, a two-time winner of the G1 Cox Plate, likes his chances astride **Ocean Park (NZ)** (Thorn Park {Aus}) in Australia's weight-for-age championship Saturday afternoon at Moonee Valley, and, if Boss is right, age will have something to do with the outcome. Much of the pre-race attention has been focused on the trio of 3-year-olds lined up, including juvenile Triple Crown winner **Pierro (Aus)** (Lonhro {Aus}) and Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus})'s half-brother **All Too Hard (Aus)** (Casino Prince {Aus}), who lowered Pierro's colors for the first time in the G1 Caulfield Guineas Oct. 13. It is not the sophomore set Boss fears, but rather champion **More Joyous (NZ)** (More Than Ready) and **Green Moon (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). "More Joyous will step up again," Boss told *Australian Associated Press*. "She needed that run the other day [when fourth under 132 pounds in the G1 Toorak H]. She had two soft wins up in Sydney, they were like barrier trials, and then she got down here and had a hard run, so she probably needed that." Ocean Park will take his fair share of beating. A half-length winner of the G1 Makfi Challenge in New Zealand Sept. 22, he crossed the Tasman for a mild upset in the G1 Underwood S. Sept. 22 ([video](#)) and exits a 3/4-length success as the odds-on favorite in the G1 Caulfield S. Oct. 13. "He's the right horse for the race," Boss said. "He's a weight-for-age horse and he's doing everything he has to do with three pretty good wins this preparation. He can sprint off the mark, he can sustain runs, the distance is not a problem, he's got good fitness levels now, and to the eye he just looks fantastic." Pierro ([video](#)), More Joyous and stablemate **Proisir (Aus)** (Choisir {Aus}) ([video](#)) all worked well this week. Asked which of the three has the best chance this weekend, she said, "It's hard, but I've always been a great admirer of Pierro. I can't see why he can't win this race. I've set him for it all along."

O'Neill Runners Highlight Thursday Activity

Several of Doug O'Neill's Breeders' Cup hopefuls recorded works at Santa Anita yesterday morning, topped by GI Classic contender **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid), who drilled six panels in 1:15.40 alongside 2-year-old stablemate Cinco de Mario (Candy Ride {Arg}). Richard's Kid's work was the 11th-fastest of 17 at the distance, while his workmate went in 1:17 flat, the slowest time at the trip. "There was not a lot of deep thought going on," O'Neill said of the decision to work the MGISW 7-year-old in company. "I wanted to see a good three-quarters and let him finish up good, which he did. I got him in 1:14 with him finishing up faster than he started off. He galloped out great, so we're very pleased." Also among the O'Neill pupils to drill yesterday were GII Pennsylvania Derby winner **Handsome Mike** (Scat Daddy) (GI Dirt Mile/Classic) and GII Best Pal S. winner **Know More** (Lion Heart) (GI Juvenile). The former was clocked in 1:15.20 (9/17), while the latter went in 1:15.40 (11/17). **Cont. p3**

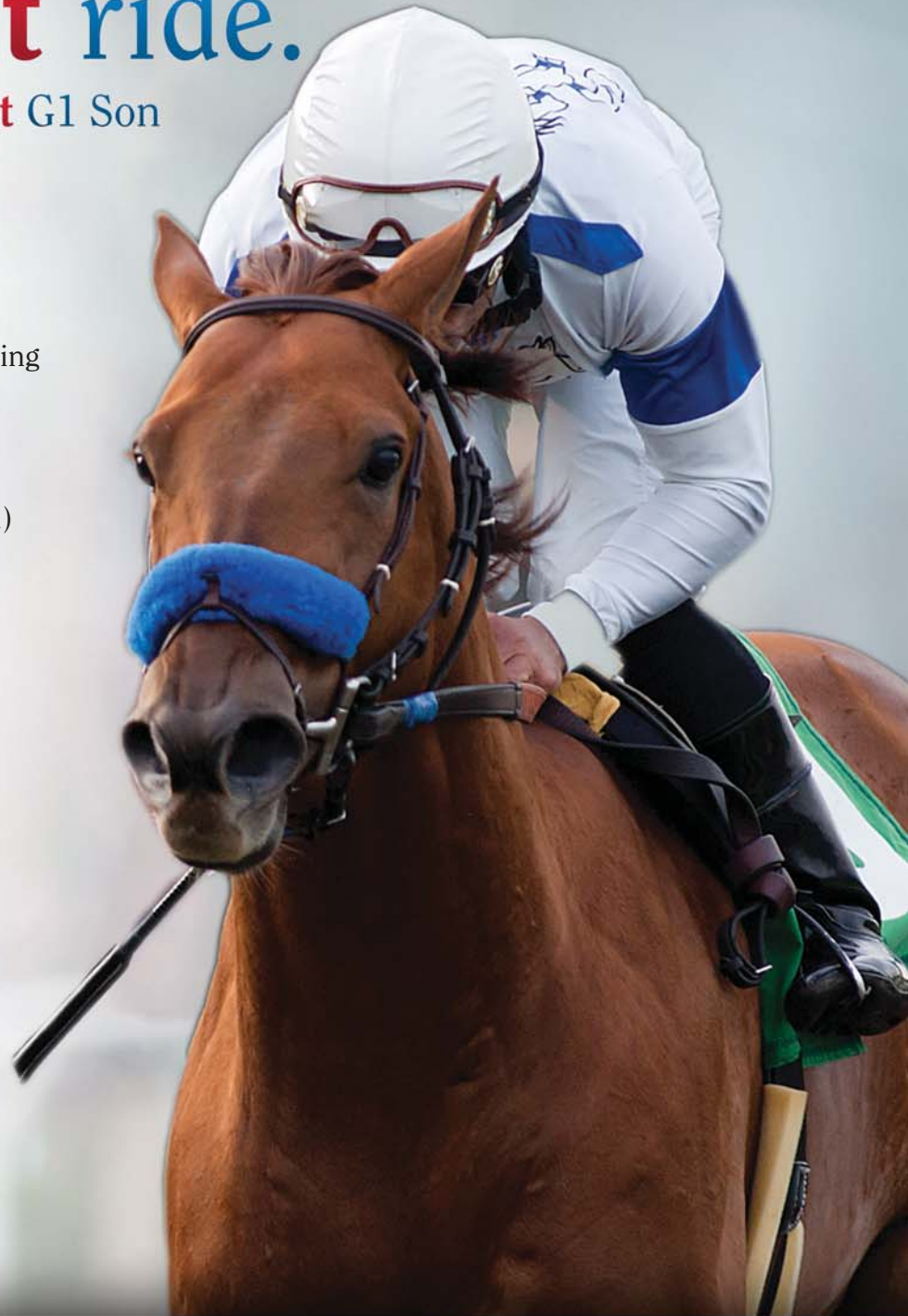

"Know More and Handsome Mike both worked great," O'Neill said. "[Thursday] was a day for maintenance works and an excuse to give them an easy day [Friday] and then we'll get right back into our normal good gallops right into the race." **He's Done Enough** (Tapit), who could join fellow J. Paul Reddam colorbearer Know More in the Juvenile or go in the GI Juvenile Turf, fired six-furlong bullet from the gate in 1:12.40. He was last seen finishing a troubled-trip 11th in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Santa Anita Oct. 6. Reddam's **Cogito** (Giant's Causeway), who will make his first start for O'Neill in the GI Turf off a fourth-place run in the Oct. 6 GI Jamaica H., was clocked in 1:14.60 (7/17). **Boxeur des Rues** (Smart Strike), who hopes to get off the also eligible list in either the GI Sprint or GI Turf Sprint, covered the same six panels as his stablemates in 1:13.80 (5/17).

Wayne Hughes's fleet-footed **Beholder** (Henny Hughes), last seen annexing an Oct. 4 allowance in Arcadia by 11 lengths with a 108 Beyer Speed Figure, practiced harnessing her speed at Santa Anita yesterday as she looks towards either the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies or Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint. The GI Del Mar Debutante runner-up worked five panels in 1:01.60, good for the seventh-fastest of 25 spins at the distance yesterday. "It was a nice work," trainer Richard Mandella said. "We're pre-entered in both races, but we're leaning towards the open Sprint." Rider Garret Gomez added of the work, "We had her sit off another horse and she went around there real nice."

Dundonnell in BC Prep at Wolves

Khalid Abdullah's G3 Acomb S. winner **Dundonnell** (First Defence) worked around the turns of Wolverhampton in preparation of a tilt at the Nov. 3 G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Santa Anita. "He's never raced around a bend and most of the opposition will have," commented trainer Roger Charlton. "I took him to Wolverhampton and he worked around the bottom bend mainly, but cantered

around the first bend after the winning post and then down the back, around the bottom. James Doyle rode him and Dundonnell moved well and I was very pleased with his work. Had he been disappointing, I think we'd have scratched the idea and waited until next year." The homebred bay, who was runner-up in the Sept. 15 G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster last time, has sidestepped top-level domestic events owing to continued soft conditions in Britain. "The [G1] Dewhurst and the [G1] Racing Post Trophy were a possibilities, but the Racing Post is historically always run on soft ground and I think you probably need a Galileo or a Montjeu to win that," added Charlton. "There weren't many options. The Dewhurst was run on slow ground, and I have great respect for Dawn Approach, so I thought maybe Santa Anita would suit. Fast ground, a mile, a couple of turns and he's an American-bred horse, so we'll give it a go. It's never an exact science as to whether it's a good thing to go all the way to California and back, but it's a big prize and an exciting challenge. We've had runners all round the world this year and this adds another dimension."

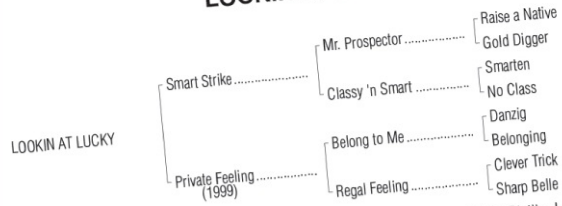

TOC Adopts Strong Raceday Medication Policy:

The Thoroughbred Owners of California (TOC) formally announced its position on raceday medication yesterday following recommendations by the TOC Medication Committee. The committee's recommendations come as a response to The Jockey Club's Reformed Racing Medication Rules. The position is as follows:

- Insist that Lasix continue to be allowed on the day of the race.
- Lasix to be administered by a third party, not a private veterinarian, provided the CHRB comes up with an acceptable protocol for administration.
- No race day medications other than Lasix.
- No adjunct medications permitted with the use of Lasix.
- Published, consistent guidelines for withdrawal periods.
- Stiffer penalties for performance enhancing drug violations,
- Consistency of testing at the labs.
- Drug violations would result in the accumulation of penalty points.
