



LONG LIVE THE KING?

Sent off the 15-8 favorite after sustained support this week, the supplemented **Kingsbarns (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) followed 2011 hero Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) by annexing yesterday's G1 Racing Post Trophy off a single maiden win. Susan Magnier's bay usurped all of Ballydoyle's potential contenders for this prize after some heady gallops following his seven-length score over a mile at Navan Oct. 10, and the risk proved well founded as he duly provided his stable with a seventh renewal of the Doncaster contest. Tracking the early pace under a confident Joseph O'Brien, the bay was sent to the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and maintained the gallop all the way to the line to beat **Van Der Neer (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}) by 1 3/4 lengths. "He relaxed and traveled very well--I might have got to the front too soon, but my rhythm was taking me there and I had to keep going," his rider said. "He was very green and he went through the last furlong and a half with his ears pricked. I think this is going to be a very good horse. He'll have no problem with good ground--he works on it at home and on the all-weather. Soft or quick ground is no problem."

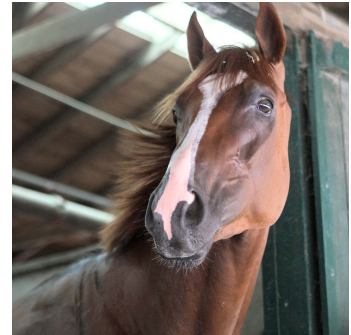

DULLAHAN WORKS AT SANTA ANITA

Donegal Racing's **Dullahan** (Even the Score), pre-entered in both the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and GI Breeders' Cup Turf, covered five furlongs over the Santa Anita main track in 1:00 Saturday. The handsome chestnut worked four furlongs in :47 4/5 on the Santa Anita lawn Oct. 20. "We'll talk to [exercise rider Tammy Fox] and [owner] Jerry [Crawford]," trainer Dale Romans replied when asked which way he was leaning for Dullahan's Breeders' Cup race. "It'll be Jerry's decision. There's no rush, but by entry time on Monday, we'll have it settled by then."

Dullahan, a smart winner of the GI TVG Pacific Classic S. at Del Mar, was a disappointing fifth in the GI Jamaica H. over the Belmont lawn last time Oct. 6. "They wouldn't change this to Poly for me, so there's nothing I can do about it," Romans concluded. "We'll see what happens." Romans also sent out **Shackleford** (Forestry) (GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile) out for a five-furlong spin in 1:00; **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) (GI Breeders' Cup Turf/Mile) covered the same distance in 1:01.80 on grass; and **Moonwalk** (Malibu Moon) (GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf) in 1:01.60 on the lawn. **Cont. p4**

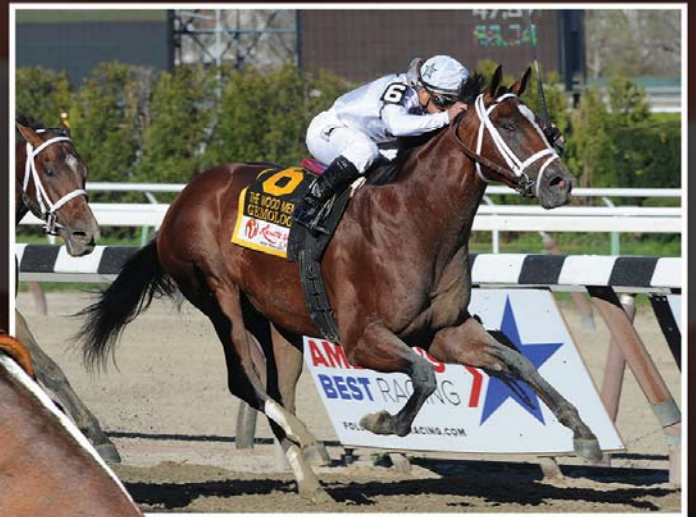

Alongside Camelot, Aidan O'Brien's previous winners of this prize also included the similarly unexposed Sadler's Wells pair of Aristotle (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire), and the alarm bells were ringing loudly earlier this week that Kingsbarns could be the next dark horse to enter the limelight on Town Moor. Despite having the likes of the G2 Beresford S. winner Battle of Marengo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in line for this race, the Ballydoyle conditioner opted for this colt alone and the punters took note. Settled in third early as Trading Leather and Steeler dominated the early proceedings, he was still traveling relatively easily in the testing conditions passing the three-furlong marker as Kevin Manning went to work on Jim Bolger's raider. Steeler and Kieren Fallon were left in front soon after as Trading Leather weakened, but Joseph O'Brien appeared to have plenty of horse underneath him and Kingsbarns quickly asserted from that rival, who eventually lost second to the rallying Van der Neer.

"When he won his maiden, he had just arrived and after that we were thinking of leaving him alone, but he did one bit of lovely work and sat the final exam for the Racing Post," Aidan O'Brien commented.

"He came though it with flying colors and all the data on him at home was so good, we were wondering would another like Camelot come along so soon after, and we were worried it might not be true.



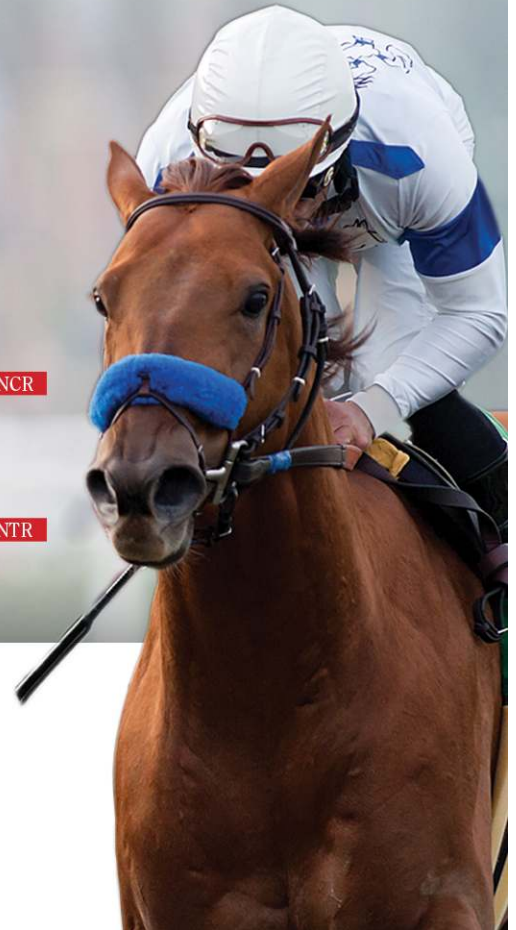

Willcox Inn (Harlan's Holiday), third at 23-1 in the 2010 GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, put in his final preparations for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, a five-furlong breeze in 1:00.80 over the Polytrack. He worked in company with 2-year-old filly Every Way (City Zip), most recently a solid third in the GIII Mazarine S. The All In Stable and Lael Stable colorbearer was second-best behind Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile S. Oct. 6. "Our horse traditionally, especially going a mile when there's going to be pace in front of us, will be sitting back," co-owner/trainer Michael Stidham said. "I'm not sure how far back, depending on how fast they're going up front. He's always got a really good kick, like he showed in the Shadwell. We're just hoping the kick that he has is good enough."

Oscar Party (Dixie Union), pre-entered in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, covered five furlongs in 1:00.60. The James Covello colorbearer, heroine of the Kentucky Downs Juvenile Fillies S., was fourth, beaten only a neck in a blanket finish in Keeneland's GIII Jessamine S. Oct. 11. "She was out in the middle of the track and she was just flying out there," trainer Wayne Catalano said.



NY SHIPPING ADVISORY

Regarding the charter flight of Breeders' Cup horses scheduled to leave Islip, New York, Tuesday, Breeders' Cup issued the following statement:

In the event that weather conditions at the time of departure for the westbound Sutton aircraft leaving out of Islip, N.Y., include winds in excess of 50mph and/or heavy cross-winds, Sutton Forwarding will make alternate arrangements for the horses to be vanned to the airport at Newburgh, N.Y. for their flight to California on Tuesday, Oct. 30. If the flight is delayed on departure so as to affect the 72-hour ship in rule, Breeders' Cup security personnel will accompany the horses on the flight so that security protocols are maintained. Breeders' Cup investigators will also accompany the horses from Ontario Airport to Santa Anita Park to maintain security procedures.



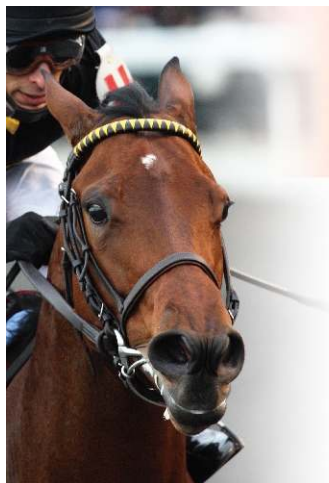

Along with a large gathering of fans, HRTV was on hand to document the "Meet and Greet," as Romans first addressed questions regarding how his horses trained earlier and then brought each horse out individually to pose for pictures.

Before Romans brought out his first horse, Little Mike, winner of this year's GI Arlington Million, one of the attendees told Romans, "Somebody (in media) said that Shackleford worked too fast and that he might be over the top."

To which Romans quipped, "Tell him to get a trainer's license. He trains fast and he runs fast."

Next out was recent GI Pacific Classic winner Dullahan, of whom Romans said, "This is the only horse in the history of racing who has three wins and all three have been in Grade I races."

When asked if Dullahan would be entered in the Breeders' Cup Classic or the Turf, Romans said, "I'll talk to Tammy (Fox, who is Roman's chief exercise rider, assistant and life partner) tonight and we'll make a decision. If was up to me, I'd run him in the Classic, but we'll discuss it."

The morning's main event came when Romans paged Shackleford, a winner of last year's Preakness and this year's GI Metropolitan Mile H. and GII Churchill Downs S.

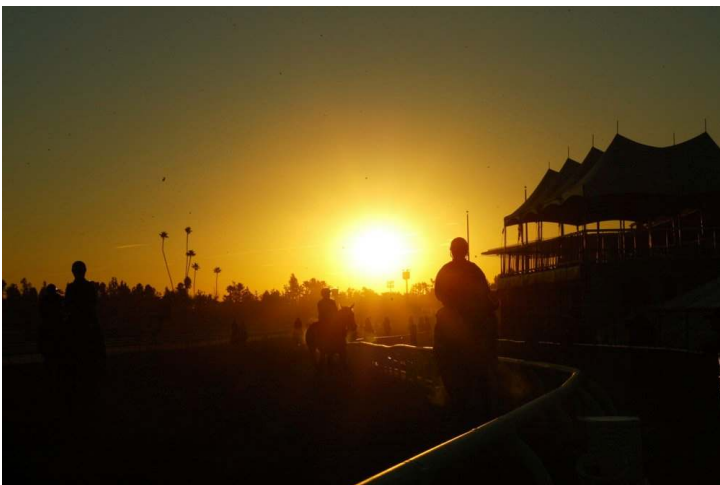
When the 4-year-old son of Forestry emerged from his shedrow, there was no doubt that he is the Romans' stable star. The striking chestnut posed calmly with his ears pricked and turned his head from time to time to take in the shutter-clicking throng.

"Shackleford, he knows he's the king," said Romans. "He's an absolutely special horse. When he won the Preakness, they always have a big party at the barn afterwards and there must've been a thousand people come by to pet him."

After approximately five minutes, Romans asked if anyone had a mint. Several people said they did, and at that point, Romans allowed about 25 people, mainly small children, to come forward and have their picture taken with the barn's leading man.

"I always thought he was a super cool horse and we wanted to give him a good name," said co-owner and breeder Mike Lauffer, who had been on-hand earlier for Shackleford's final Breeders' Cup breeze. "We visit North Carolina a lot, and the Shackleford Banks are part of the barrier islands off the coast. They are populated by wild horses that are believed to be descendents of a Spanish shipwreck in the 1700s."

Yes, it was quite a show Saturday morning at Barn 76 and, as the song promises, "The Best is Yet to Come."

I would definitely consider the [GI] Cigar Mile [at Aqueduct Nov. 24]. That would be our next goal."

With Frankie Dettori stewing in traffic, Jim Crowley stepped in as a late replacement and enjoyed an armchair ride as Godolphin's grey laid down a hefty marker for Classic aspirations next year. Stepping up from a debut 11th in a seven-furlong Ascot maiden Sept. 8, he was runner-up in a one-mile test at Salisbury Oct. 3 before shedding maiden status in taking fashion over the same trip at Nottingham last time Oct. 17. Tawhid was patiently ridden just behind the pace from the outset of this black-type bow. Challenging the pacesetter Alhebayeb hard on the steel passing the two pole, he seized control soon after, and quickened clear in impressive style inside the final eighth to easily account for that rival by daylight. "It felt very good, he's a lovely horse and it was a nice spare ride to pick up because Frankie [Dettori] couldn't make it," commented Crowley. "He traveled lovely, went through the gears very nicely and did it with the minimum of fuss. You never know quite what's going to happen when the ground is as testing as that, but he clearly loved it. It was great, it was a nice performance and he's done everything right."

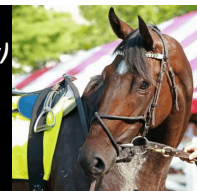

May. He annexed Colonial's grassy one-mile Da Hoss S. July 21, but could do no better than seventh going long on the lawn here in the Sept. 8 Japan Racing Association S. Action Andy appreciated the turnback and surface switch to take the track-and-trip Maryland Million Sprint

H. Oct. 6, and produced a similar, if not improved, effort to come out on top in a tight one. Forced to take back for fear of getting hung wide after trying for the lead early, the dark bay tracked from fourth behind splits of :22.15 and :45.46. Beaten to the punch by Ill Villano at the top of the stretch, Action Andy followed that foe's move and wore him down nearing the wire for the narrowest of victories. "I was a little worried at the sixteenth pole, but I know when he kicks he keeps coming," said winning trainer Carlos Garcia. "He trained better than he ever has coming into this race, and Horacio [Karamanos] rode him to perfection. That was an extremely nice horse he beat today. They both wanted to win; you could see that. But I guess he wanted it more. This is the biggest win of my career. It's hard to explain how I feel right now."

GIRL STAYING POWER

Longchamp's G1 Prix Royal-Oak has proven a happy hunting ground for the distaffers of late, with three of the last six renewals falling to that brigade, and His Highness The Aga Khan's **Dalkala** (Giant's Causeway) is one who could extend that sequence today. Handling heavy ground and the 1 9/16-mile trip when beating the solid yardstick Shirocco Star (GB) (Shirocco {Ger}) in the G2 Prix de Royallieu here last time Oct. 6, the homebred looked as if she would stay this extended distance on that evidence. Also from the Alain de Royer-Dupre stable is **Verema (Fr)** (Barathea {Ire}), and she is more than a pacemaker based on her success in the Sept. 9 G3 Prix de Lutece and fourth in the Oct. 6 G2 Prix Chaudenay both at this track. Any stamina issues regarding that pair will be exposed by Andrew Black and Owen Promotions Limited's **Brown Panther (GB)** (Shirocco {Ger}), who looked in need of further than the 14 furlongs of the G1 Irish St Leger when a strong-closing third in that Curragh contest last time Sept. 15. Previously second to the classy Mount Athos (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in Newbury's G3 Geoffrey Freer S. over an extended 13 furlongs Aug. 18, last year's G1 St Leger runner-up is overdue a day in the sun. "We had plenty of options at this stage of the season and I just hope we've picked the right race, the ground and trip should be fine for him," trainer Tom Dascombe told *PA Sport*. "The trip is one mile, 7 1/2 furlongs and given that he wasn't stopping over a mile and six furlongs in Ireland, I wouldn't have thought it would be a problem. They are unlikely to go a crazy gallop, as they very rarely do in France. It would be great to sign off the season with a Group 1 win, it really would be wonderful." If there is one to upset the main players, it could be Stephane Seignoux's 3-year-old **Les Beaufs (Fr)** (Apsis {GB}), who almost pulled off an upset under aggressive tactics before losing out by a neck to Canticum (GB) (Cacique {Ire}) in the Prix Chaudenay over 1 7/8 miles here last time.

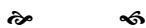

John Osborne of the Irish National Stud announced the news at Leopardstown yesterday. "Famous Name is retired today after a glorious career," he confirmed to *Irish Racing Online*. "He has had 38 starts and has 21 wins, 20 in stakes company, to his name. We are looking forward to producing horses just like him. In six seasons he has only run outside stakes company once, and that was when he won his maiden by seven lengths. He was only beaten in a photo in the French Derby as a 3-year-old, but if had won that day we'd have missed out on all the great days he had here. We are very excited to have him and you couldn't find a racehorse like him. They've always loved him at Rosewell and he has been a great horse to train, is uncomplicated and sound. He has had six seasons competing at the highest level and always gave his best."

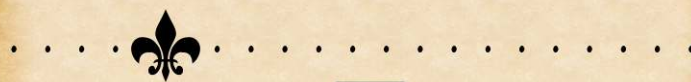
