

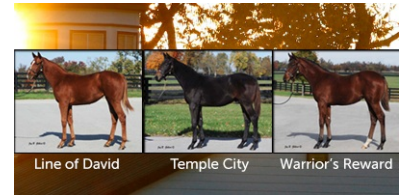

BAFFERT PLEASSED WITH DUDE

Game on Dude (Awesome Again), likely favorite for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, tuned up for the race with a seven-furlong drill in 1:25.00 Sunday at Santa Anita. The 5-year-old worked in company with Blueskiesrainbows (English Channel), who was credited with a six-furlong drill in 1:13.60. Jockey Rafael Bejarano was aboard for the work.

"He worked like he's been working right along," Baffert said of Game on Dude. "It was his last workout [before the Classic]. So far, so good."

Baffert's three contenders for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint each turned in four-furlong works Sunday at Santa Anita. **Coil** (Point Given) went in :48.20;

Capital Account (Closing Argument) in :48.60; and **Fast Bullet** (Speightstown) in :48.20. GI Juvenile contenders **Power Broker** (Pulpit) and **Title Contender** (Pulpit) worked in company and earned the five-furlong bullet of :59 flat. **Fed Biz** (Giant's Causeway), aiming for the GI Dirt Mile, went four furlongs in :48 flat and GI F/M Sprint hopeful **Contested** (Ghostzapper) went six furlongs in a bullet 1:11.40.

"Coil and Capital Account went really nice; Fast Bullet went real nice, and Power Broker went real nice with Title Contender," Baffert ticked off. "Contested worked really fast early, but I didn't think she was going that fast."

While Baffert was pleased with his Cup contingent, he admitted, "a lot can happen in a week."

GIVE ME A SIGN

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **"TDN Rising Star" Sign** (Pulpit) overcame some immaturity to run to her reputation in Churchill's GI Pocahontas S. yesterday, galloping home an emphatic four-length winner and stamping herself as one to watch for back under the Twin Spires next spring. The homebred belied 10-1 odds on debut when romping by the length of the stretch sprinting at Saratoga Aug. 26, but the secret was out this time and she was backed down to 4-5. Sign dropped back to last in the early going and seemed a bit unwilling to settle as she tossed her head about from the two path down the backstretch. She advanced steadily entering the turn while kept well off the rail, and continued to give rider Rosie Napravnik some trouble as she dragged her way further into contention between horses leaving the bend. Sign appeared as if she might be floundering in upper stretch, but the light came on past the eighth pole as she dashed to the rail and pulled clear from pacesetter **Gal About Town** (City Zip). Longshot **Cloudy Vow** (Broken Vow) completed the trifecta. "She's really impressive," Napravnik said. "She's handled everything really well. She was much the best today and I had a good trip. She did break a little bit slow, but that was fine. I let her settle and she came with a big run." **Cont. p5**

This renewal looked short of star names with convincing stamina credentials beforehand and it was left to Stephane and Valerie Seignoux's Les Beaufs to expose the chinks in the armor of his rivals under a perfectly judged front-running ride from Julien Guillochon. Still a maiden when tried in black-type company in the 12-furlong Listed Derby de l'Ouest at Nantes July 2, the bay managed third place there despite hold-up tactics not playing to his strengths. Ridden more aggressively next time when shedding his winless tag in a conditions event over 1 11/16 miles at Deauville Aug. 3, he was again ridden from behind when fourth in the Aug. 25 Listed Grand Prix de Clairefontaine dropped back to 12 furlongs. Allowed to bowl along at the head of affairs in the G2 Prix Chaudenay over 1 7/8 miles here last time Oct. 6, he was caught close home by Canticum (GB) (Cacique {Ire}) and many of his rivals expected him to fold again here.

Soon clear as the 13-10 favorite Dalkala (Giant's Causeway) led the main peloton, he traveled powerfully and turned on the pressure in early stretch, where it was soon clear that the remainder would struggle to bridge the gap. Keeping up a relentless gallop in the heavy ground, he never looked likely to surrender his advantage to the one-paced outsiders Silver Valny and Rollex Borget. "He's finished for the year, but will run in all the good staying races next season," Valerie Seignoux said. "He can go on good ground, but is probably better on this."

Sortilege began her black-type campaign with a third placing in the May 17 Listed Prix Bedel over 12 furlongs at Lyon-Parilly before dropping to this trip to contest the G3 La Coupe at Longchamp. No match for No Risk At All (Fr) (My Risk {Fr}) and Meandre (Fr) (Slickly {Fr}) in that June 11 encounter, the bay was ambitiously tilted at the G1 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville Aug. 18 and was out of her depth when beating only one rival in that hot contest. Fresh from a confidence-building first black-type success in the Listed Grand Prix de la Region d'Alsace at Strasbourg Sept. 15, the Wertheimer cast-off stepped up markedly to upstage some more high-profile names and spring a surprise here. Restrained early towards the rear by Andrea Atzeni off the honest tempo set by the runaway British raider Opera Gal (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), she cut through the pack in early straight and had dead aim on Sajjhaa (GB) (King's Best) as that rival overhauled the long-time leader with a quarter mile to race. Gaining a slight edge approaching the furlong pole as Cherry Collect, Nova Hawk and Wedding Fair (GB) (Oratorio {Ire}) joined in the blanket finish, she gave a final surge to see off all-comers and win with something in hand.

"We wanted her to be back, you never know when they're last, but we wanted her back and to get a good finish," trainer Al Stall Jr. said of Sign, who will return for the GII Golden Rod S. Nov. 24. "I could see her fighting the dirt a bit on the backstretch. She overcame a few things and ran a great race." The 'TDN Rising Star' earned 10 points in the newly introduced "Road to the Kentucky Oaks" point system for her victory, which was Churchill Downs stakes win number 30 for co-owner/breeder Claiborne Farm. Sign's stakes-winning dam Cross, a half-sister to MGSW Lattice (Arch), has a yearling filly by Arch and a weanling colt by Claiborne/Diltschneider's GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Blame (Arch).

Iroquois S. cont.

Uncaptured was installed the early 30-1 winter book favorite by Wynn Las Vegas for the 2013 GI Kentucky Derby after reeling off four straight victories in Canada. He put a damper on those expectations last time when stretched out for Woodbine's GIII Grey S. Oct. 7, but the John Oxley colorbearer made amends here at the site of the "Run for the Roses." Following a debut nose victory in a key heat going five panels May 13, the dark bay romped home a 5 1/2-length winner of the June 30 Clarendon S., earning a 96 Beyer Speed Figure. He continued his winning ways in the July 28 Vandal S. and Sept. 9 Clarendon S. as the distances slowly increased, but settled for fifth at 2-5 in the Grey after some minor traffic trouble.

Away alertly, Uncaptured settled nicely into stride and took up a spot towards the back of the field in the two path behind an opening quarter in a snappy :22.88. The dark bay came through horses to take closer order leaving the backstretch, but had to remain in neutral as the field bunched up. He was beaten to the punch at the top of the stretch by the ominously traveling Positively, but Uncaptured was tipped out by pilot Miguel Mena and immediately responded. Lugging in briefly, he kicked clear inside the final furlong and required little encouragement in the run to the wire. Favored GII Futurity S. winner Overanalyze was shuffled back on the turn and couldn't re-rally to contend with the top two in the lane.

"I had a good trip and he's a very nice horse," Mena said. "I had just a ton of horse and he just galloped. He's very good." Trainer Mark Casse, who said Uncaptured is likely to return for the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S.

Nov. 24, added, "He had a rough trip last time, but I don't have a real good explanation [for why he ran fifth]. He had been very powerful before that and that's why I wanted to bring him here and run him on the dirt. If it didn't work well, then I was going to send him home for a break, but I think we got the answer today." Positively's trainer Pat Byrne offered, "I thought my horse ran well. He got beat by a better horse. Obviously the horse that won is a good horse. He's a Canadian champion. Something happened to him in the Grey. I didn't see that race, but he definitely showed up here today. We just got beat by a better horse."

ROGER NATAF DIES

Roger Nataf, a prominent French-based horseman, died yesterday at the age of 95. Nataf, who was involved in many aspects of the Thoroughbred industry, is best known as the founder of Horse France, a full-service agency he began in 1995 with his sons Robert and Paul. "He was a prominent figure in the horse business," said Robert Nataf. "You could say he introduced the modern way of acting as an agent, not only buying horses on behalf of customers, but offering a wide range of services, like shipping, insurance, advising, and management." Nataf was the principal of Horse France until the late 1990s, helping evolve the company into a leading buyer at Keeneland, Tattersalls, Goffs, and Arqana. One of Nataf's most prominent purchases was Triptych (Riverman), champion mare in France and winner of the 1988 G1 Coronation Cup. "He will be remembered as very active and exuberant, and professionally recognized by all in the racing industry in Europe and worldwide," said Robert Nataf. A funeral for Nataf will be held tomorrow in Paris, France.
