

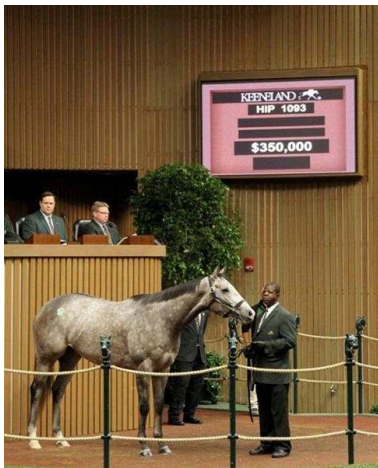

## 'LADY' LEADS SOLID GAINS AT KEENELAND

Hill 'n' Dale Sales continued its hot streak during Friday's fourth session of the Keeneland November Sale in Lexington. Two days after selling a pair of mares for \$4-million plus and four days after selling a trio of seven-figure mares at Fasig-Tipton, John Sikura's operation was back at it yesterday. Hill 'n' Dale sold three of the top four horses yesterday, including the session-topping **American Lady** (Stormy Atlantic), who made \$350,000. Gabriel Duignan, on behalf of Castleton Lyons, signed the winning slip out back for the 4-year-old racing or

broodmare prospect. American Lady is a stakes-winning half-sister to The Pamplemousse (Kafwain), a multiple graded winner in California.

The transaction highlighted a solid day of trade at Keeneland. Once again, the session was up against a comparable 2011 session bolstered by the Ned Evans dispersal. But for the first time at November this year, session numbers saw year-over-year increases. The session average of \$82,891 was up 5.12%, while the median jumped 40%, from \$50,000 in 2011 to \$70,000. The not-sold rate was 23.74%.

"It was a good horse sale," said Keeneland Vice President of Sales Walt Robertson. "We had some nice weanlings, and mares with good pedigrees sold very well. We had some mares get up above \$300,000 that had good pedigrees."

## CARTIER NOMINEES ANNOUNCED

**Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) is in line to dominate the Cartier Awards for the third year in succession as the honors are unveiled on Tuesday. With a juvenile crown in 2010 and the Horse of the Year title last year, Khalid Abdullah's remarkable winner of 14 straight races is a formality for the latter award once again and the older horse category. Up against him for the Horse of the Year title are **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}), **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}). The latter is likely to top the 3-Year-Old Colt division as a result of his 2000 Guineas and English and Irish Derby successes. Harry Herbert, Cartier's racing consultant, said yesterday, "We have enjoyed a vintage year of racing with thrilling performances from horses of different generations over all distances. We were especially privileged to witness the wonderful Frankel, who was the Cartier Horse of the Year in 2011, and is certain to take that accolade again for an unprecedented second successive year." **Full list p13**

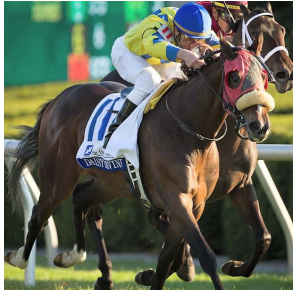

**The Baffert/Hill 'n' Dale Connection...**

Like **Eden's Moon** (Giant's Causeway), who sold at FTKNOV for \$1,525,000, Hill 'n' Dale consigned yesterday's session-topping **American Lady** ([hip 1093](#)) on behalf of prominent owner Kaleem Shah. And like many of Hill 'n' Dale's biggest home runs this week, the filly was previously trained by Bob Baffert.

All three of Hill 'n' Dale's seven-figure horses at Fasig--the \$3.5 million **Cry and Catch Me** (Street Cry {Ire}), the \$2.3 million **Contested** (Ghostzapper), and **Eden's Moon**--were trained to Grade I glory by the Hall of Famer.

As Shah's primary trainer, Baffert purchased **American Lady** for \$230,000 at the 2009 Keeneland September Sale, and sent her out to a win in this year's restricted **Reminiscing S.** at Betfair Hollywood Park in June. Fourth to **Switch** (Quiet American) in the **GII A Glean H.** in July, she just missed by a nose when third in the **Bangles and Beads S.** at Fairplex Sept. 21.

Gabriel Duignan said there's a chance Castleton Lyons would continue to race the filly at five. "We haven't fully decided," he said. "We'd want to examine the x-rays a bit more." **Cont. p4**

Asked about her appeal, Duignan commented, "I thought she was an unbelievable physical, and it's a very nice family. She's a bit special. [The Pamplemousse] was probably a very talented horse and she ran a 5 [Ragozin figure] herself, so it's a very good family."

Duignan said the purchase was ultimately about bolstering the broodmare band of Shane Ryan's Castleon operation, which currently has a roster of roughly 50 mares. Castleon Lyons' champion Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) stood his first season this year.

Like Duignan, Sikura commended American Lady's physical. "Bob Baffert picked her out as a yearling," said Sikura. "He buys such good horses, and her quality really came through. She's a great type from a really active family. She worked for a lot of people and was very popular."

Sikura said Kaleem Shah was selling Eden's Moon, his first Grade I winner, and American Lady so he could continue to focus on his racing operation. "His passion is owning racehorses and running in races--he doesn't really want to breed--and so he's selling these mares," said Sikura.

He added, "People see that, that he's selling the good mares and not just the ones that don't make it, and it allows them to bid with confidence."

With 18 horses sold for an average of \$749,167, Hill 'n' Dale is by a large margin the leading consignor at Keeneland by that measure. Its KEENOV consignment is led by the \$4.5-million Pure Clan (Pure Prize) and the \$4.2-million Changing Skies (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), both of whom sold during Wednesday's second session.

"It's been a great week," Sikura summed up.

**Four Gifts Goes to Beckers for \$340,000...**

California-based breeders Barry and Judith Becker came away with the session's second-highest-priced mare yesterday, the good MGSW **Four Gifts** (Even the Score--Agiftfromservice, by Service Stripe), who sold for \$340,000.

Indian Creek consigned the 6-year-old, in foal to Hard Spun, as [hip 820](#).

"We liked the fact she was a multiple graded stakes winner, and she was a really good physical specimen," Becker said by phone. "Of all that we saw for the day, she was our favorite physically. We got outbid on a few earlier in the week, but we were really glad to get her."



**Four Gifts**

Trained in all but one of her 12 career starts by Steve Asmussen, Four Gifts won the 2008 renewal of the GIII Delta Princess S. over C. S. Silk (Medaglia d'Oro)--a \$1.45 million FTKNOV mare earlier in the week. A year later, she added the GIII Eight Belles S. at Churchill and the \$250,000 Charles Town Oaks. She concluded her career with five wins and \$640,068 in earnings.

Sent through Fasig's 2009 November Sale, Four Gifts brought a bid of \$310,000 from Alistair Roden Bloodstock. Four Gifts's first foal, a filly by Sky Mesa, sold for \$120,000 at KESEEP two months ago.

Four Gifts was produced by a winning full-sister to the GI Spinaway S. heroine Cashier's Dream. Becker said 2013 breeding plans were undecided.

"We'll breed her to someone who's commercially appealing, as we try to do with all our mares," he said.

The Beckers breed primarily for the market, and have 10 mares in total. All are boarded at Summerhill Farm on Old Frankfort Pike in Lexington. The Beckers sell through Andy Havens's Havens Bloodstock Agency, and Barry said Havens helped select Four Gifts.

“I think the market has made a substantial recovery in the last couple of years, and we’ve made some investments in mares expecting it to continue to improve,” added Becker. “We’ve had a good sale year in 2012, and I think it’s getting stronger.”

The Beckers have indeed had a good year selling. They sold the top-priced short-yearling at the Keeneland January Sale, a \$490,000 Unbridled’s Song 3/4-brother to Sassy Image (Broken Vow)

who was hammered down to Fox Hill Farm. They had purchased their dam, Ideal Image (Hennessy), with that Unbridled’s Song in utero for \$170,000 at the 2010 Keeneland November Sale.

The Beckers, who live in Long Beach, founded Pegasus Building Services, a janitorial service company, in the late 1960s. They purchased their first broodmare in the early ‘70s and have bred several stakes winners, including the 2006 GI Prioress S. heroine Wildcat Bettie B (Meadowlake). --Lucas Marquardt

**Stonestreet Still Pounding the Pavement Friday...**

Highly visible over the first three days of the November sale, Stonestreet Stables was back in action Friday with a pair of purchases. Topping the operation’s acquisitions at \$335,000 was **Christine Dae** (Giant’s Causeway), offered by Hill ‘n’ Dale Sales as [Hip 1165](#).

“That’s a fair price,” commented Stonestreet advisor John Moynihan, who signed for the 5-year-old. “I know there was a lot of hype about her, but we’re happy to have her for that. Giant’s Causeway looks like he’s on his way to becoming a nice broodmare sire.”

Out of GSP Descapate (Dehere), the flashy chestnut was sold in foal to Lonhro (Aus) (Octagonal {Aus}).


“We don’t know much about [Lonhro], but he was a great racehorse and he’s been a great sire in Australia,” admitted Moynohan.

A three-time winner at Gulfstream Park, including a runaway 8 3/4-length victory in January, 2010, the filly also placed in Monmouth’s Red Cross S.


“She was a good mare on the racetrack and she had brilliance,” said Moynihan. “Oddly enough, I called [her trainer] Patrick Biancone the first time she ran. When she won, she looked like a real good horse. They wanted a lot of money for her at the time after she broke her maiden, so we backed off.”

Outlining her future as a member of the Stonestreet broodmare band, Moynihan offered, “I’m not sure who we’re going to breed her to, but it might be [Stonestreet stallion] Maclean’s Music [by Distorted Humor] or one of our [other] horses.”

Also during Friday’s session, Stonestreet paid \$210,000 for a weanling colt by first season sire Eskendereya (Giant’s Causeway). Consigned by Eaton Sales, the Mar. 4 foal a half-brother to MGSW Eaton’s Gift (Johannesburg) (see p8 for more). --C Bossinakis

### Adena Returns to the Well...

Throughout the week at Keeneland November, Frank Stronach's Adena Springs hadn't accounted for any of the session toppers, but instead had been busy collecting a solid team of mares at a variety of price points. Chief among Adena's purchases Friday was [Hip 917](#), GSW **Mighty Caroline** (Stormy Atlantic), in foal to Lonhro (Aus). Out of the unraced Mighty Renee (Maria's Mon), the 3-year-old is from the family of Grade I winner Over All (Mr. Prospector). The fourth-highest price of the session, she was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, who enjoyed a banner week by selling a pair of mares, Pure Clan (Pure Prize) and Changing Skies (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) for \$4.5-million and \$4.2-million, respectively.

"We liked her very much on pedigree and Frank is very in tune to Lonhro as a international stallion," explained Adena General Manager Eric Hamelback, who signed on the purchases. "The pedigree also fits Ghostzapper. As good as a year Ghostzapper has had, [Frank Stronach] is shopping for mares that can go back specifically to Ghostzapper. That has been a particular focus for him at this sale, to buy mares for Awesome Again too, but particularly for Ghostzapper."

A leading sire in Australia, Lonhro stood in his first season at Darley's Kentucky operation in 2012.

"[Stronach] applauds Darley for bringing him over and trying what they are doing," said Hamelback. "Frank has always been an advocate for out-crossing and to try and bring new blood into the States. We bred several mares to [Lonhro], so that had a similarly positive effect."

During Friday's session, Adena also secured [Hip 871](#), Jordy Y (Congrats--Debt Free, by Fly So Free) for \$220,000 and [Hip 900](#), Lucky Strikes Gold (Smart Strike) for \$170,000. They also purchased [Hip 934](#), Much Fanfare (Maria's Mon--Pocho's Dream Girl, by Fortunate Prospect), a half-sister to GII Peter Pan S. winner Mark Valeski (Proud Citizen). Later in the session, Adena grabbed **Dancing Raven** (Tomahawk--Captivating, by Arch) for \$195,000 from the Four Star Sales consignment ; and **Dansette (GB)** (Dansili {GB}--Kalinka, by Soviet Star) for \$105,000 from Brookdale Sales. The 5-year-old Dancing Raven, who was sent through the ring as [Hip 1184](#), was a stakes winner in Canada and an earner of almost \$400,000. She is a half-sister to standout juvenile Uncaptured (Lion Heart), who recorded three stakes victories this year at Woodbine before shipping south of the border to take the GIII Iroquois S. at Churchill Oct. 28. Dansette, [Hip 1185](#), followed Dancing Raven through the ring.

The 4-year-old is a half-sister to English champion Soviet Song (GB) (Marju {Ire}), and is from the family of Adena's Grade I winner and sire Milwaukee Brew (Wild Again).

Winless in four starts last year in her native England, she is in foal to leading first-season sire Henrythenavigator (Kingmambo). Late in the session, Adena went to \$245,000 for Exchange Funds, offered as [Hip 1213](#). By Speightstown out of stakes winner and GSP Jetinto Houston (Houston), the 5-year-old mare was sold in foal to Hard Spun.

Among Adena's top purchases this week are Book 1 purchases Capital Plan (Rock Hard Ten--Miss Dahlia, by Strawberry Road {Aus}), who brought \$825,000; Calais (A.P. Indy--Flanders, by Seeking the Gold), a \$700,000 buy and Xs Belle (Dynaformer--Queenie Belle, by Bertrando), who realized \$510,000.

"From my early inspections, she was on of my top two selections," confirmed Hamelback. "Of course, Frank makes the decisions, and he had selected her off pedigree alone, but unfortunately he can't be here, so there were physical attributes along with his pedigree assessment in which he thought she would fit."

As for the future of the two-time graded stakes winner, Hamelback offered, "We are still trying to evaluate possibly putting her in training. Originally, the plan was just to retire her, but right now, we are evaluating her at the farm. When she was sold, nothing was hidden, so we just want to do what's best for her."

In foal to Distorted Humor, Calais was the second-highest-priced Adena purchase through Book 2. **Cont. p7**



"She was a pedigree-type that Frank really liked," explained Hamelback. "She is one of those unraced mares with an outstanding pedigree that you wouldn't be able to buy if, in fact, they were runners. Frank saw an opportunity to buy into this family. He has supported Distorted Humor in the past, so he felt paying that money was warranted."

Asked whether the prices paid for those top Book 1 mares were fair, Hamelback replied, "I think Calais was very fairly priced. She was spot on. With Capital Plan, I anticipated that she would go for a little bit more. Market value is very hard to judge when you are in the midst of buying. But, I thought she was going to go a little bit higher and I wasn't sure Frank was going to value her as high as I had expected her to be. So at \$825,000, I was pretty pleased with the comparables that had been sold earlier and at Fasig-Tipton for those horses that could run and had some pedigree were at least \$1-million or even \$2-million plus. So, I was very happy with what we got and the longevity of that family and the depth."

As is usually the case, Adena donned both the buyer's and seller's cap at Keeneland this week. Represented by six head on its first day of selling Thursday, Adena will offer an additional 10 today and an additional 39 Wednesday.

"Frank's program has always been to replenish," said Hamelback. "He will often buy mares particularly to breed to one of our stallions and then move on. He likes to influence the breed. If he thinks the nick or the cross works then its not uncommon for him to sell one of those mares."

Included among those following that Adena philosophy, are Thoroughly Holy (Holy Bull), sold for \$35,000 in foal to Cape Blanco (Ire); and City Bird (Carson City), out of Eishin Houlton (Wild Again), a full-sister to Wild Rush who brought \$40,000.

"Frank is always very fair if not to say low with reserves," said Hamelback. "If they don't get purchased in the ring, that's fine, but he doesn't put exorbitant reserves just to try and drive it up. When Frank brings one into the ring, he anticipates the opportunity to sell her. Especially with the yearlings, if he puts a \$100,000 value on it, then he feels that it what it is worth, if not more." --C Bossinakis

### Regis Farm Picking Up Steam...

After making its initial auction acquisition at Keeneland just this past September, Nat Rea's Regis Farm upped the ante by securing an additional seven at Keeneland this week. Chief among yesterday's purchases was [Hip 885](#), **Le Reine Lionne** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}), secured for \$230,000. Consigned by Hidden Brook, the multiple graded-stakes placed is a half-sister to the stakes-winning Battle of Love (A.P. Warrior).

"She was a lovely, balanced mare," said Regis Farm's Racing Manager and advisor Richard Hogan. "She was a good racemare, had good racetrack form and has some family behind her."

During yesterday's session, Hogan went to \$145,000 to secure [Hip 977](#), a weanling filly by first season sire Majesticperfection (Harlan's Holiday). Offered by Airdrie Stud, the New York bred is a half-sister to MGSW Park Avenue Ball (Citidancer) and SW Beacon Hill Road (Forestry).

"Number one, we try and buy athletes and if they go on to be good fillies on the track, then we can look at breeding them," offered Hogan.

In addition to Friday's sole weanling acquisition, the operation, located in King City, Ontario, purchased five youngsters through the first three days of the sale, including its top priced buy at Keeneland November so far, a colt by Harlan's Holiday out of Glory and Grace (Coronado's Quest) who brought \$290,000 on Day 2.

"I think if you buy some fillies with some pedigree and they go on to be graded stakes performers, like some of the fillies we saw earlier this week, and you try to buy them, it goes through the roof," explained Hogan. "But if you buy them earlier, as weanlings or yearlings, and they make good racehorses, you get some good value."

After making its initial investment, a filly by Curlin at the September sale earlier this fall, Regis bought three more yearlings at the Fasig-Tipton October sale. Principal among the operation's earlier purchases is a Bandini filly, out of Bella Dorato (Goldminers Gold), a yearling half-sister to recent GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Trinniberg (Teuflesberg). The yearling was purchased for \$250,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky.

"We try and mix it up," said Hogan, explaining the farm's current buying schedule. "If we see a nice mare, we'll buy them. We've bought some nice fillies, both weanlings and yearlings, as well go. And if they become performers, we'll look into breeding them. You just have to try and mix it up, try and buy what you like and get lucky at the track."

Asked about the game plan for the fledgling operation, Hogan added, "We're just trying to buy what I think works. We will take our time and gather some up, just put it together slowly. We'll just buy the horses we like, and then we'll figure that all out as we go."

Following five days of selling in Lexington, Hogan offered some insight into some of the trends observed over the past week.

"I just think the pendulum has swung back to where people want the factories again," opined Hogan. "For a few years, it was cheaper to buy them than to raise them, but I think it's gone back again to where people are looking for the mares."

In 2002, Rea, a tool and die maker by trade, helped form Martinrea International Inc., an auto parts and industrial manufacturer based in Ontario. He served as the company's vice president and director before stepping down from those roles last June.

**McDonald Enjoys Eskendereya Pinhook...**

When the Carson City mare Kit's Girl went through the ring a year ago at Keeneland November, Reiley McDonald of Eaton Sales was watching with interest. Not only was she in foal to the exciting first-season sire Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway), but Kit's Girl was already the dam of Grade II winner Eaton's Gift (Johannesburg), which Eaton Sales had consigned at Keeneland September in 2006 and sold for \$150,000 to Zayat Stables. When the bidding stalled prematurely on the 14-year-old mare, McDonald entered the fray.

"I walked in the ring when she was selling, and the bidding stalled at \$37,000," McDonald explained. "I had sold Eaton's Gift, and knew he was a really nice horse. So I bid just one time, and got her for \$42,000."

Fast forward one year, and McDonald was back at Keeneland November during the sale's fourth session yesterday with Kit's Girl's Eskendereya weanling, Hip 879. The \$42,000 McDonald shelled out for the colt in utero last year began to look like a bargain when he was hammered down to Stonestreet Stables agent John Moynihan for \$210,000. **Cont. p8**

"We're very happy," McDonald said. "Anytime you get a healthy foal that looks like he does then brings good money, you have to be happy."

"He was very, very popular, and he handled it all well," McDonald continued. "Foals get put through a lot here. They get shown 60 or 70 times, then scoped seven or eight times. That's a lot for a baby, but he handled it all really well. John Moynihan bought him, and he has a great eye for a racehorse."

Moynihan noted that the Kit's Girl colt was his pick of the day.

"He was a really top weanling," Moynihan said. "I thought physically he was probably the best colt in the sale today. He's gorgeous, gorgeous, gorgeous."

Moynihan said the colt took after his sire, who Stonestreet part-owns and stands at Taylor Made Farm near Nicholasville, Kentucky.

"He looks a lot like his father and he's extremely well-bred, being out of a Grade II-producing mare," he said.

According to Moynihan and Travis White, stallion nominations manager at Taylor Made, the Kit's Girl colt is one of many good-looking Eskendereya foals.

"I've seen most of his foals, and they're great-looking horses," White noted. "Most of them will probably sell as yearlings next year, and many of the breed-to-race operations, like Stonestreet, Zayat Stables and Juddmonte have Eskendereyas. We're very pleased with him. Most of the foals are taking after him, being big chestnuts with white faces, and they have good bone and a lot of muscle, so I think overall he's stamping his foals pretty well." **Cont. p10**

Bred in Kentucky by Sanford Robinson, Eskendereya was a \$250,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase by Ahmed Zayat. After breaking his maiden by 7 1/4 lengths in Belmont's Pilgrim S. as a 2-year-old, he went on to finish an unlucky ninth behind Vale of York (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Santa Anita.

Eskendereya would not lose in three more career starts as a sophomore. After opening his 3-year-old campaign with an allowance victory at Gulfstream Park, Eskendereya swept the GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. by 8 1/2-lengths, and the GI Wood Memorial by 9 3/4 lengths, establishing himself as the favorite for the 2010 GI Kentucky Derby. Unfortunately Eskendereya would not get his chance at the roses. An injury the week before the race would result in his untimely retirement. A part interest in the colt was sold to Jess Jackson and Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Stable, and the 3-year-old was sent to Taylor Made Farm, where he covered his first book of mares in 2011 for a fee of \$30,000.

"He was the one horse we really wanted from that crop, so we were really pleased to get him," White explained. "He bred 137 mares in his first year, and 110 last year. He's been very popular in the breeding shed."

If Eskendereya's foals inherit their father's talent as much as his looks, they should also be popular on the racetrack.

"Some of the best foals we have on our farm are Eskendereyas," Moynihan noted. "Probably the best looking foal we have is an Eskendereya, and that's out of everything, including Distorted Humors, Tapits, and all the other really good sires. We're really excited about him."

Eskendereya has also been a sought-after covering sire at the Keeneland November sale. Three of his in-foal mares have sold for more than \$200,000, including Hip 607, the stakes winner and graded stakes-placed Sister Dawn (Indian Charlie--Joi's Flame, by Strawberry Road {Aus}), who sold carrying her first foal for \$260,000.

Moynihan said that the Kit's Girl colt would likely be retained by Stonestreet to race.

"We'll wait and see," he said. "We'll decide a little later on, but that is probably the plan." --by Kelsey Riley

**Haymarket On the Rise...**

Chip and Bets Montgomery's Haymarket Farm has been breeding for about a dozen years now, and while they might be flying slightly under the radar on the sales scene, that might soon change. Haymarket has bred some very good horses in recent years, including the ill-fated but immensely talented Odysseus (Malibu Moon) and this year's GII Firecracker S. winner Guys Reward (Grand Reward), and rang up a nice score yesterday with [hip 846](#), a Harlan's Holiday--Havenlass (Elusive Quality) colt who sold to Chinook Farm for \$170,000. The colt was produced by an unraced half-sister to the Grade II winners Royal Haven (Hail Emperor) and Belterra (Unbridled) and was consigned by James Keogh (Grovendale).

The transaction follows on the heels of a couple of home runs at Keeneland September, where Haymarket sold a Colonel John half-brother to Grade I Sean Avery (Cherokee Run) for \$325,000. Haymarket purchased that one's dam, Latin Lynx, for just \$32,000 at the 2007 Keeneland November Sale. In the same sale, the Montgomerys, in partnership with Carrie and Craig Brogden's Machmer Hall, sold another Harlan's Holiday colt for \$380,000, that after buying the colt's mare for \$30,000 at the 2009 November sale.

"Chip is a lucky parnter," Carrie Brogden confirmed. "But he's earned that luck, if you know what I mean."

The Montgomerys are in the car business, owning in partnership six Kia and two Chevrolet dealerships. Chip Montgomery said he was first drawn to the horse business by the challenges it presents, as well as its beauty and excitement. **Cont. p12**

"We first got involved as silent partners with the Walden brothers [Ben and Elliott] and also with the Brogdens," explained Chip Montgomery. "Five years ago we bought a farm near Simpsonville, Kentucky, which was already named Haymarket. I had fond memories of Haymarket when I came down to my father's Chevrolet dealership in downtown Louisville, next to the Haymarket section where vendors set up their fruit and vegetable stands, so I kept the name."

Haymarket bred Odysseus in partnership with Lakemont Stable, and after selling the colt for \$110,000 at the 2008 FTSAUG sale, got the brief thrill of having a horse on the Derby trail when he captured the GIII Tampa Bay Derby two years later. Sadly, Odysseus was knocked off the Derby trail by injury, then contracted laminitis later in the year and was euthanized. The Montgomerys have retained two of his sisters.

Chip gave credit to his farm manager Grant Stiff for helping the operation through the tough times. "We have been privileged to have Grant as our manager from day one, and his attitude and diligence have made a difference in our lives," said Montgomery.

Currently, Haymarket has about two dozen mares. "Grant foals out all the mares and runs the farm," said Chip.

Haymarket recently received a big update courtesy of the Breeders' Cup Sprint upsetter Hightail (Mineshaft). The Montgomerys purchased the colt's dam, the 7-year-old Stormy Renee (Storm Cat), for \$55,000 at the Keeneland January Sale earlier this year, and got a Henrythenavigator filly out of her this spring.

When talking about yesterday's \$170,000 Harlan's Holiday colt, Chip explains that he took a chance buying his dam Havenlass, essentially as a breeding prospect, for \$30,000 at the 2008 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. "She comes from a very good racing and selling family, and I was intrigued by the family and the fact that she was in Book 6 as a yearling," he said of the filly, who was crooked in front. "When Carrie Brogden and I looked at her in the back ring as a yearling, we surmised she was somehow compromised in the womb. I bought her under that premise, and she has been a blessing."

The Harlan's Holiday was her second foal. Her first, a filly by Old Fashioned, sold for \$67,000 at few months ago at September. Montgomery said that, for the time being, Haymarket will sell the majority of its prospects as weanlings.

The Montgomerys recognize that it's relatively early days yet for its operation, but said they're enjoying the ride so far. "Like many people we have learned the most by the big mistakes we have made," Chip admitted. "It hasn't been easy, but the last two years have been rewarding." --Lucas Marquardt

With the majority of the best juveniles are tucked away for the year, today's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud offers those hard-knocking types who have been kept on the go for this stamina test a chance to shine. It will be 10 furlongs on heavy ground, but one juvenile who should not balk at such an examination is Daniel-Yves Treves' talented G3 Prix de Conde winner **Morandi (Fr)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}). Having danced through the mud to win that nine-furlong contest by 12 lengths at Longchamp last time Oct. 21, the Jean-Claude Rouget-trained colt boasts the most obvious claims here. One who could offer a stern challenge is Charles Mimouni and Haras de Bernesq's **Wingate (GB)** (Zamindar), who also showed he handles deep conditions when registering a six-length score in the Listed Prix des Sablonnets over a mile when last seen at Nantes Oct. 23. He has been supplemented along with the unbeaten British raider **Willie the Whipper (GB)** (Whipper). That juvenile also relishes a testing surface, and Qatar Racing's latest acquisition comes here on the back of a first black-type win in Pontefract's Listed Silver Tankard S. over a mile Oct. 22. "I think he's going to be even better next year," trainer Ann Duffield told the *Independent*. "I know it may seem like tilting at windmills, going straight from a listed race to a Group 1. It's only his third ever run, but we know he handles the ground and he wants a trip. The jockey couldn't pull him up in either of his races."

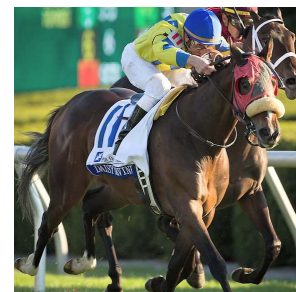
