**GETTING 'LUCKY' IN THE JACKPOT**

Like previous recent GIII Delta Jackpot S. winners Big Drama (Montbrook) and Gourmet Dinner (Trippi), the South Florida-based multiple stakes winner **Itsmyluckyday** (Lawyer Ron) will be bringing his talents from South Beach for Saturday's \$1-million centerpiece.

"Horses that have been stabled at Calder have done well there in the past," trainer Eddie Plesa Jr. acknowledged.

"Every year I say the same thing. The Calder 2-year-olds far exceed what you think they could do based on pedigree and everything else. I don't know--I don't think it's the surface. I just think that Calder 2-year-olds do well wherever they go."

The runaway winner of the washed-off Fasig Tipton Turf Dash S. in the slop Aug. 25 and the two-turn Foolish Pleasure S. Sept. 15 ([video](#)) has plenty of bullets in the holster for the big one, including a best-of-22 five-furlong move in 1:00 2/5 at the Miami oval Oct. 28. He breezed an easy mile in 1:43 3/5 Nov. 6.

"Needless to say, the purse is a million dollars," Plesa admitted of the Jackpot's appeal. "He's trained well and has done well, and it just looked like the right spot for us."

The versatile Itsmyluckyday, no worse than third in five career trips to the post, earned his diploma by two lengths at Monmouth Park in June. He certainly held his own in his lone try on grass, placing a close third in the Jersey Shore's Tyro S. Aug. 5. Subsequent GII Summer S. hero I'm Boundtoscore (Even The Score) was second that day, beaten only a half-length. What does Plesa think Itsmyluckyday's best game will be going forward?

"I think two turns--that's what I thought before his last race," Plesa replied. "I was dying to get him into a two-turn race and I just didn't have an opportunity to do so. I was chomping at the bit to get him in a distance race and he proved me right. It will be interesting when we can stretch him out on the turf, whenever that may be." **Cont. p3**

**Amazombie Fine Following BC Bust...**

Thomas Sanford and William Spawr's **Amazombie** (Northern Afleet), a disappointing eighth as the 7-2 favorite while defending his GI Breeders' Cup Sprint title, has emerged from the race in fine shape. "I don't think he handled that track," said co-owner/trainer Spawr. "He just wouldn't get into the bit. He's fine, though, so we're just going to hang out and look for options." The 2011 champion sprinter, hero of Del Mar's GI Bing Crosby S. July 29, entered the Championships following a fourth-place finish as the 4-5 chalk in the GI Santa Anita Sprint Championship S. Oct. 6.

It was almost exactly five years ago that John Shirreffs unveiled the great Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) to a 'TDN Rising Star'-earning debut, and that champion's half-sister **EBLOUISSANTE** (Bernardini) will look to begin the daunting task of following in big sis's hoofsteps today at Betfair Hollywood Park. The dark bay, who will carry the colors of her breeder Eric Kronfeld, has been brought along slowly by her patient conditioner, emulating the 13-time Grade I winner's early preparations. "If you care anything about your horse, you stop and give them time," explained Shirreffs. "Then you start over again, you don't just pick up where you left off. It's a matter of letting the filly grow and develop. Zenyatta was unique in that she grew into the horse she became. She started out one way and grew and developed."

Itsmyluckyday, a \$47,000 KEESEP yearling purchase by former trainer turned bloodstock agent Nick Hines, brought \$110,000 from Trilogy Stable and Laurie Plesa earlier this year at the OBS March sale. Consigned by Eisaman Equine as agent, the dark bay covered an eighth in :10 3/5 (video) during the breeze show. The second foal out of the stakes-placed Doneraile Court mare Viva La Slew was bred in Kentucky by Liberation Farm and Brandywine Farm.

"I liked that he was by Lawyer Ron," Plesa offered. "I had run against him with Gottcha Gold (defeated Lawyer Ron in the 2007 GIII Salvator Mile H. at Monmouth Park), and I know what kind of horse he was. I liked the way (Itsmyluckyday) moved, I liked where he came from and he fit my budget. Eisaman Equine does an outstanding job, and I feel 100% comfortable with what they sell."

Plesa quipped, "We got lucky." -Steve Sherack

## CAPOTE MARE TOPS KEENOV

Average was down, median was up on the second-to-last session of the Keeneland November Sale yesterday in Lexington. A total of 216 horses sold Thursday for \$1,695,500, an average of \$7,850. That represented a 13.8% dip from last year's corresponding session. The median of \$5,500, however, was up 22.2%. There were 53 RNAs, a rate of 19.7%.

Topping the session was the 8-year-old mare **Local Color** (Capote--Setting, by Exclusive Native), who sold to Rancho San Jose for \$45,000. Indian Creek consigned the winning mare, in foal on a Mar. 19 cover to Square Eddie (Smart Strike), as [hip 3338](#). Local Color is a half to two stakes horses, including the GI Oak Leaf S. heroine Vivid Angel (Septieme Ciel).

[Hip 3310](#), a colt from the second crop of Grade II winner Parading (Pulpit), brought the session's top price for a weanling. New Horizon Farm paid \$26,000 for the son of the 10-year-old black-type winner Isle See You Later (Caller I.D.). Susan M. Forrester consigned the colt.

## TOP JOCKS SIGN ON FOR HK COMPETITION

A distinguished group of riders from all corners of the globe will descend on Hong Kong's Happy Valley Racecourse for the Longines International Jockeys' Challenge Dec. 5, where they will compete for increased prize money of HK\$800,000 (\$103,200).

"The 2012 Longines International Jockeys' Championship has a great line-up of global talent, one that befits a world-renowned contest which now offers HK\$500,000 more in overall prize money than it did 12 months ago," said William A Nader, HKJC's Executive Director of Racing. Also expected to compete are Tom Queally, who famously partnered Frankel (GB) in each of his 14 career wins; Australia's Craig Williams, who won last year's G1 Hong Kong Vase aboard Dunaden (Fr); Singaporean champion Joao Moreira; and record-setting Kiwi James McDonald. The 12-strong field will be completed by the leading jockey and the leading local jockey in Hong Kong as of Nov. 22.

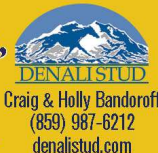

### PATINACK ANNOUNCES RESTRUCTURING

Australian mining magnate Nathan Tinkler has announced the closing of his Patinack Farm racing stable at Melbourne's Flemington Race Course as part of a broader restructuring of the business. Tinkler, who currently owns a reported 1,300 Thoroughbreds, plans on steadily drawing down those numbers to a more sustainable 1,000 horses. "The racing operation is losing money and, unfortunately, part of the rationalisation will include the closure of our Flemington stables in Melbourne and a reduction of horses in work," Tinkle Group CEO Troy Palmer told *Australian Associated Press*. "There are simply too many horses in work, and the reduction in numbers will greatly assist in coordinating better placement of horses and a much greater focus on quality. This will enable us to concentrate on full-time racing stables in Brisbane and Sydney and support our breeding operations in the Hunter Valley and the Gold Coast." Palmer continued, "We have some of Australia's most valuable and successful horse racing and breeding stock, and it makes sense to resize the business to a manageable level of around 800 to 1,000 and concentrate on what we do best, breeding." Patinack currently stands 10 stallions at their stud, including Casino Prince (Aus), the sire of Patinack's All Too Hard (Aus), the A\$1.025-million topper at the 2011 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale who recently won the G1 Caulfield Guineas and was runner-up in the G1 Cox Plate. All Too Hard is to be syndicated for his stallion career at the end of the 2012-2013 racing season. On behalf of Patinack, Magic Millions played host to an unreserved sale of 203 of the farm's broodmares, which raised just short of A\$2.8 million. As part of the new business model, Patinack will disperse another 50 mares at Inglis next month and will sell an additional 50 mares privately. The Patinack broodmare band currently numbers approximately 400.

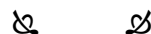

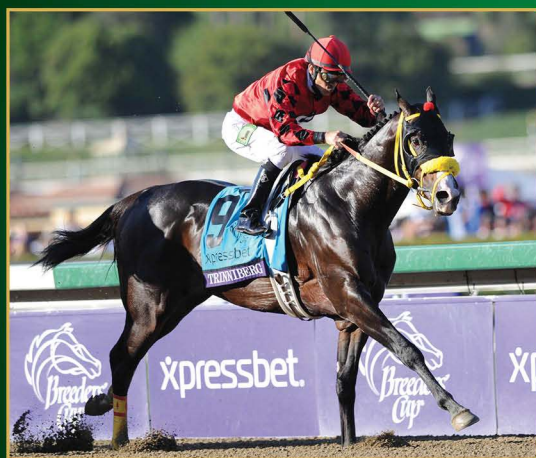

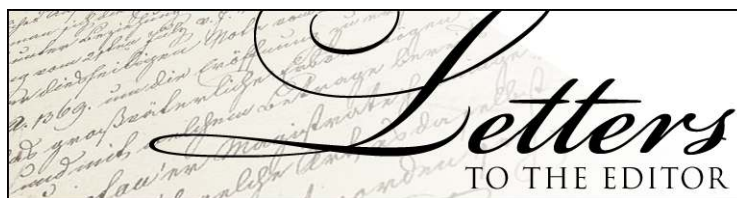
## RMTC BOARD MAKES RECOMMENDATIONS

*Edited Press Release*

The Racing Medication and Testing Consortium Board of Directors addressed a number of initiatives including therapeutic medications, laboratory proficiency, corticosteroid regulation and penalties for rule violations at its Nov. 13 meeting in Louisville, Kentucky. Among the Board's actions were approvals of thresholds and withdrawal guidelines for six medications that were presented with the recommendation of RMTC's Scientific Advisory Committee. These thresholds and withdrawal guidelines were approved for medications identified as having therapeutic purposes by the American Association of Equine Practitioners, and were based upon scientific research conducted by laboratories associated with the RMTC. "We have eagerly anticipated the conclusion of these administration studies and applaud the work of the University of California-Davis Kenneth L. Maddy Laboratory in providing research on the majority of medications we addressed today," said RMTC Chairman Dr. Robert Lewis. "This should help veterinarians and trainers avoid rule violations." The board approved recommendations on the following medications-- acepromazine, butorphanol, clenbuterol, dantrolene, detomidine and mepivacaine. "The recommendations will provide veterinarians, trainers and owners useful guidelines when developing therapeutic medication plans for horses in training," said Dr. Rick Arthur, chair of the RMTC SAC and equine medical director for the California Horse Racing Board. "With the completion of these administration studies, the RMTC can now move forward with its imperative initiative to focus on the detection of prohibited drugs."

I am writing today to encourage other industry participants--trainers, owners and track management--to do the same, and help them in their mission of trying to increase our fan base (*Contact Penelope Miller at [pmiller@ntra.com](mailto:pmiller@ntra.com) to do so*).

It's easy to sit back and criticize the initiatives of others without making any real attempt to participate in a constructive way. Right now, the industry needs everyone's help to start to reverse the declines of the past decades. I hope everyone will get on board the bus.

It was almost exactly five years ago that John Shirreffs unveiled the great Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) to a 'TDN Rising Star'-earning debut, and that champion's half-sister **EBLOUISSANTE ([Bernardini](#))** will look to begin the daunting task of following in big sis's hoofsteps here. The dark bay, who will carry the colors of her breeder Eric Kronfeld, has been brought along slowly by her patient conditioner, emulating the 13-time Grade I winner's early preparations. "If you care anything about your horse, you stop and give them time," explained Shirreffs. "Then you start over again, you don't just pick up where you left off. It's a matter of letting the filly grow and develop. Zenyatta was unique in that she grew into the horse she became. She started out one way and grew and developed." Of Eblouissante's similarities to Zenyatta, Shirreffs said, "She's almost like having Zenyatta in the barn because they're so much alike. As far as characteristics, both like to hold their head up high and are really into what's going on around them. Both are imposing fillies and both are big and rangy." While Zenyatta debuted at 6 1/2 panels, Shirreffs said that "up until her last work, [Eblouissante] didn't show a lot of speed in her workouts, so we thought we'd go long with her." According to *DRF Formulator*, Shirreffs has won with just 6% of his first timers over the past five years. Eblouissante and Zenyatta are also half-sisters to Balance (Thunder Gulch), a three-time Grade I winner who scored first out in 2005. Interestingly, Zenyatta's owners Jerry and Ann Moss also have a horse in the race--John Sadler trainee **Belonging ([Include](#))** gets the 3-1 morning-line nod as she stretches out off a fast-closing sixth sprinting at Del Mar Aug. 12. 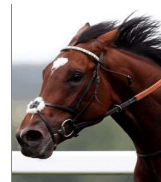
