



'LADY' IN THE CITY

Well supported for Thursday's Thanksgiving Day feature at Churchill Downs, the GII Falls City H., Afleeting Lady (Afleet Alex), sporting a two-race win streak heading into the nine-furlong affair, stole the show with a professional 2 1/4-length victory. Allowed to settle behind modest opening splits of :23.68 and :47.62 set by Joyful Victory (Tapit), the 6-5 choice didn't let that rival get too far out of her sights. After collaring the tiring grey approaching the quarter pole, the half-sister to Classic winner

Shackleford (Forestry) was comfortably in front turning for home and had enough left to fend off the late-moving Brushed by a Star (Eddington). Joyful Victory held on for third. "I had a perfect trip and [Afleeting Lady] had me in a good spot the whole way," explained winning rider Joel Rosario. "I let her do whatever she wanted to do. I was a little worried, because I thought she was getting a little tired in the stretch, but she was able to hold it together and keep going. Like I said, I let her do what she wanted to do and she put me in the winner's circle." Cont. p3

REALLY MR BAFFERT

The GIII Hollywood Prevue S. at Betfair Hollywood Park offered an exercise in certitude as Bob Baffert-trained runners swept the first four positions, including the first across the wire, Really Mr Greely (Horse Greeley). On the engine soon after the start, Really Mr Greely reeled off opening splits of :22.74 and :46.31 as stablemate and 4-5 choice, Super Nintey Nine (Pulpit), was content to settle in a stalking position. Still in charge turning for home, the longest shot in the field was all out in the late stages and had enough to fend off the late-closing favorite at the wire. Shakin It Up (Midnight Lute), last in the early going, rallied late to be third. "I wanted to be on the lead," said winning rider Julien Leparoux. "He relaxed well and left me alone, which was beautiful and, when I asked him to go, he answered nice. At the three-eighths pole, I felt they were coming at me, so I asked him to start going, and he never really stopped." Cont. p5

FULL MOON IN CLARK

Juddmonte Farm's Lunar Victory (Speightstown) might have sheltered from open stakes competition for much of 2012, but he had nonetheless been busily racking up wins along the New York-bred circuit. The 5-year-old steps out of his comfort zone to take on the big kids in this afternoon's GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs. Victorious in his first four starts of the season, including the nine-furlong Evan Shipman S. against state-breds at Saratoga July 23 and in a \$75,000 optional claiming test against open company Aug. 23, he was only a nose back in second behind fellow New York-bred Saginaw (Peruvian) in Belmont's one-mile Promenade All S. Sept. 23. The bay bounced back to take the Empire Classic at the Elmont oval Oct. 20, and his rider that day, Junior Alvarado, who is unbeaten on the 5-year-old this season, is back on board. Offering up a two-pronged attack is trainer Mark Casse, who has Pool Play (Silver Deputy) and Stealcage (Lawyer Ron). The former, who took last June's GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill, won the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup Oct. 6, but failed to land a blow when a well-beaten eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 3. The latter, who won going a mile over the Louisville dirt May 31, added a victory on the Poly in the nine-furlong Ontario Derby Sept. 16, and comes into this off a third in the Nov. 2 GIII Ack Ack H. here. winner Shackleford won an \$80,000 optional claimer at Churchill Downs in her second start back in May before coming home a distant second behind divisional leader Royal Delta (Empire Maker) in the June 16 GII Fleur de Lis H. Off the board in her next start in Monmouth's GII Molly Pitcher S. July 29, the bay came back to annex the Sept. 3 Lady's Secret S. before adding Belmont's GIII Turnback the Alarm H. Oct. 27. "She looked

comfortable the whole race and I thought she would run big, and she did," said trainer Dale Romans of the 5-year-old's win Thursday. "I think she's still improving." As for her future on the racetrack, Romans added, "We're going to sit down and decide whether we want to go on with her now or retire her. We'll make a decision in the next few days."

Caixa Electronica, winner of last season's GIII Westchester S., proved the decision to send him to West Virginia in April for the nine-panel GII Charles Town Classic was truly an inspired one when coming home an easy winner in the \$1-million event.

Fourth in the May 28 GI Metropolitan H., the chestnut appreciated the drop back to the sprinting ranks when taking the June 9 GII True North H. Off the board in a trio of starts at the Spa, including a fourth in the Sept. 1 GI Forego S. over seven furlongs, he was runner up in the Sept. 29 GI Vosburgh Invitational before coming home seventh in the seven-panel GIII Bold Ruler H. Oct. 27. Proving once again that six furlongs is his best distance, Caixa Electronica pressed early pacesetter This Ones for Phil through an opening half mile in :44.84, was on even terms with that rival a furlong out and drew off late to post the easy victory. "The way he's been running at six furlongs, he's been making that one big run," said winning owner Mike Repole. "With Poseidon's Warrior not running yesterday, there was no possible speed that could have been out there [with This Ones for Phil] except Mine Over Matter. The other horses were coming out of distance races." Repole added, "I told [Jockey] Javier [Castellano], 'The horse is so versatile, he can do so much; keep him in the game. Do not let This Ones for Phil get away. If he walks the dog and goes :23 and :46 and we come in second, I will be furious.' Javier said, 'I'll do what you want.' When he broke, he was right there; we went :22 and :44 [seconds] and at the top of the stretch, once he got close, it was just a matter of time."

This daughter of Danehill sire Tiger Hill, consigned by Haras du Logis, has raced in Germany, with a win and a fourth place at Listed level. A real blueblood, MOUNTAIN ROSE is from a female line of the highest quality. Her dam, Montfleur, has already produced the very good **Mawingo**, a four year colt who distinguished himself when recording a win in the Bavarian Classic (Gr.3) at Munich and in the Doomben Cup (Gr.1) in Australia, on 19 May this year. Mackie, the dam of Montfleur, proved equally good on the track, finishing placed at **Group 1** level in the United States, as she was in the breeding shed, producing four black type horses, including Mr. Mellon, winner of the Arlington Classic Stakes (Gr.2) in the USA.

Daughter of Galileo, Spin is from the lovely family of Featherhill, a family which is both very much alive and international and includes the Wertheimer & Frère owned Plumania, Balladeuse, as well as Légèreté and Falco, all four of which have made their mark at Gr.1 and Gr.2 level. Spin is herself a sister to Kiltiernan Stakes (Gr.3) winner Hearthstead Maison, as well as Stakes winners turned broodmares, Rave Reviews, Fermion and Sail.

Born on 16 February and consigned by Haras d'Etreham, this is a daughter of the young stallion Raven's Pass and TRES RAPIDE, a young mare out of which she is just the 2nd foal and who was several times **Group** placed in France and Germany, including a 2nd place in the Prix Royallieu (Gr.2). She came very close to winning her own Group race in the Prix Allez France (Gr.3) run at Chantilly, finishing just a short neck behind the Aga Khan owned Shemima. Her half-brother Très Rock Danon has his part won three Gr.3 races in Germany.

Now aged 4, the daughter of Danehill Dancer will be consigned by Haras des Capucines in foal to leading European sire Galileo. From one of thoroughbred racing's finest families, that of Miesque, Kingmambo and Rumpelstilskin, she was successful at 2 and notably ran 2nd in the CL Weld Park Stakes (Gr.3) at the Curragh. Last year, at 3, she confirmed her status among the best of her generation, finishing among others 3rd in the Poule d'Essai des Poulaches (Gr.1) at Longchamp, not beaten far by the top class Golden Lilac and Glorious Sight. From then, she ran exclusively in Ireland where she finished 2nd to Gr.1 winner Cityscape in the Solonaway Stakes (Gr.3) and was awarded a rating of 108.

Two weeks later, she made a successful transition to Group level at Royal Ascot, where she won the Queen Mary Stakes (Gr.2). She added 2 further good performances to her 2yo race record, with 3rd places in the Cherry Hinton Stakes (Gr.2) and in the Phoenix Stakes (Gr.1) where she finished just a length down on quadruple Gr.1 winner Henrythenavigator. She was retired on a rating of 105.

Really Mr Greely debuted at Santa Anita with a fourth after a problematic trip Oct. 20 before bounding home an easy 7 1/2 length winner going six panels against \$100,000 claiming company at the Arcadia oval Nov. 4. Making his graded stakes bow this time, the dark bay was sent off the longest price of the Bob Baffert-trained quartet. "When you have that many horses in the same race, all you can do is tell the jockeys to stay out of each other's way," said Baffert's assistant Jimmy Barnes. "And Julien [Leparoux] did the best of staying out of the way. I knew [Really Mr Greely] was fast, but you never know until they break. All four of them are good horses. In the [2002, GI] Del Mar Futurity we ran five. We won it with a horse called Icecoldbeeratreds. We were first, second, third, fourth and sixth."

Nestled in along the hedge while reserved off the early pace, Kya One eagerly inched her way up to the leading rank on the backstretch. Making smooth progress from the outside to take on the hedge-hugging Naples Bay and Janicellaine, Kya One forged clear in the final stages to collect her first graded win. "My plan was to put her wherever I could in the race, so I just let the other fillies go and she settled nicely behind," explained winning rider Paco Lopez. "At the three-eighths pole, I had a good position, and then when I pushed, my filly started running hard. She tried real hard from the mile to the mile and a sixteenth, and she finished strong. She's a nice filly."

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Owner B J Wright and trainer Michael Pender hold a strong hand in today's GII Citation H., as they send out the top morning-line choices **Ultimate Eagle** (Mizzen Mast) and **Jeranimo** (Congaree), winner of this race last year. Ultimate Eagle established himself as one of the leading turf sophomores in the country last year, annexing the GII Oak Tree Derby and the GI Hollywood Derby late in the year. Put on the shelf after a third-place finish in the Dec. 26 GII Sir Beaufort S. at Santa Anita, Ultimate Eagle recaptured his old brilliance in his 4-year-old debut, running away with the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita by 7 1/4 lengths Feb. 4. He faded to an uncharacteristic 10th--beaten 12 lengths--behind Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) in the Mar. 3 GI Santa Anita H. after contesting a hot early pace, and has not been seen since that effort. He represents the lone speed in the race, and if he can carve out softer early fractions than last time, he could be dangerous off a nine-month layoff. The consistent Jeranimo recorded his first victory at the highest level over this track in the GI Shoemaker Mile June 30 before finishing third in the GII Del Mar Mile H. Aug. 26. He most recently finished sixth--beaten 4 1/2 lengths--in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Nov. 3. Stuart S. Janney's homebred **Data Link** (War Front) recorded a career-best 100 Beyer Speed Figure when winning the GI Makers Mark Mile at Keeneland Apr. 13. After an off-the-board effort in the GI Turf Classic S. at Churchill May 5, he added the GII Monmouth S. June 10, and was most recently the victim of Horse of the Year candidate Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 6, where he finished fifth. One spot ahead of him that day was **Doubles Partner** (Rock Hard Ten), who takes a step back after knocking on the door in Grade I company all year. Victorious in the GIII Canadian Turf S. to kick off his 5-year-old campaign at Gulfstream Mar. 3, the WinStar Farm colorbearer finished third to Data Link in the Makers Mark Mile and fourth in the Turf Classic. The consistent Florida-bred has won two of three tries over this distance, and while he makes his first start in California, he is well-traveled and handles shipping well.

FILLIES TAKE FLIGHT IN GO FOR WAND

IEAH Stables and Resolute Group Stables' **Fantasy of Flight** (Tiznow) stamped herself as one to watch last year, breaking her maiden at first asking at Churchill Downs in May and following up with a second-place effort in the Gil Dogwood S. going a mile over that strip for trainer John Terranova. It took her almost a year, however, to find the winner's circle again, but she cleared her first allowance condition going seven furlongs over the Keeneland Polytrack Apr. 12. Assigned a big class jump in the GI Humana Distaff at Churchill May 5, the 4-year-old finished a well-beaten ninth, and was subsequently transferred to trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. On the shelf for five months, Fantasy of Flight reappeared in a seven-furlong optional claimer at Belmont Oct. 18, where she won gate-to-wire by an authoritative 9 3/4 lengths. She has been installed the 7-5 morning line favorite and 116 pound heavyweight, but she will have to contend with the James Iselin-trained **Willet** (Jump Start), who posted an equally impressive effort last out when winning the sloppy Iroquois S. at Belmont Oct. 20 by 9 1/4 lengths after a wide trip. She earned a field-topping 99 Beyer Speed Figure for that effort, and will race for the first time beyond seven furlongs here. Robert Masterson's **Nefertini** (Empire Maker) will also try this mile distance for the first time, but she owns three wins going 1 mile 70 yards, including the Monmouth Beach S. May 27.

She was third in her most recent start in the GIII Turnback the Alarm S. at Belmont Oct. 27 off a three-month freshening, and could advance off that effort. She owns a prior win over Fantasy of Flight over the Aqueduct inner track in March.

STARS COLT LEADS THE WAY AT GOFFS

Last season, the Sea the Stars (Ire) factor was pivotal to a record-setting renewal of Goffs' November Foal Sale and, without that level of excitement, this year's auction was never going to be able to match its predecessor. So it proved, with an 11% drop in the overall average, thanks in part to the fact that the Tsui family's performer had just one foal catalogued this time. Despite that numerical disadvantage, he still managed to steal the limelight as his Jockey Hall Stud-consigned colt topped the list at €310,000. Described by auctioneer Henry Beeby as a "real jewel", hip [735](#) is out of the accomplished producer Mood Swings (Ire) (Shirley Heights {GB}) whose reputation is based on the exploits of her most successful offspring Hurricane Floyd (Ire) (Pennekamp), Grand Ducal (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and Best Side (Ire) (King's Best). The latter is also the dam of the 2010 G3 Dee S. winner Azmeel (GB) (Azamour {Ire}) and the listed scorer Baisse (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and her April-foaled relation quickly exceeded the €200,000-mark.

Despite the interest of the Tsuis' Racing Manager John Clarke, it was Blandford Bloodstock's Tom Goff who prevailed. "He was one of the nicest foals that we have seen by the sire and he really does resemble his stallion," said Goff. "The mare has already done very well at stud and the foal himself is just a cracking individual."

No Passing on This One...

Darley's Raven's Pass has been quick off the blocks with his first crop, which includes the G2 Royal Lodge S. winner Steeler (Ire) and the Kildangan Stud resident was on the mark at Goffs yesterday when accounting for four of the top dozen foals. Leading the way was a bay colt consigned by Swordlestown Little, hip [788](#), a February-foaled half-brother to last year's G2 Railway S. victor and Rathbarry Stud sire Lilbourne Lad (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) and the 2010 G3 Gallinule S. runner-up Bobbyscot (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}). John Ferguson outlasted Ibrahim Araci at €280,000. "He's a half-brother to a high-class 2-year-old and I think that he is one of the best foals that we will see either this week or next week," said Ferguson. "He's by a sire that Sheikh Mohammed has a particular liking

for and we were happy to get him." **Cont. p10**

Hip [868](#), a daughter of Danehill Dancer (Ire) from Cahermorris Stables, was another to be snapped up by BBA Ireland, this one bringing €200,000. She is a half-sister to the smart Johannesburg pair of Thomas Baines and Face the Problem (Ire). Grangecon Stud's supremo Rick Barnes, who missed out on the son of Chelsea Rose (Ire), paid €180,000 for a daughter of Dansili (GB) from the draft of Abbeville and Meadow Court Studs. Hip [718](#) is out of a half to Dansili's 2007 G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero Zambezi Sun (GB). Barnes also paid €125,000 for a daughter of Ballylinch Stud's first-crop sire Lope de Vega (Ire) from Knockainey Stud. Hip [793](#) is an April-foaled bay half-sibling to a pair of winners from just two runners and is out of a winning half-sister to the 2010 GI Gamely S. victress Tuscan Evening (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}). Out of the 2004 Listed Prix des Lilas victress Cattiva Generosa (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), herself a daughter of the G1 Oaks d'Italia and G1 Premio Roma placegetter Signorina Cattiva (El Gran Senor), he was knocked down to Blandford Bloodstock for €140,000. Another newblood making early waves is the Tweenhills-based Makfi (GB) and the second foal by the top-class miler to enter the ring sold to Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud for €105,000. Tinnakill House's hip [737](#) is out of the group-winning Mother of Pearl (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a three-parts sister to Turtle Island (Ire) who has already produced the listed scorer Danehill's Pearl (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and the useful 3-year-old Captain Cat (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). "He's a good looking colt by a very good racehorse," O'Leary commented. "The dam was very talented and she has already done well at stud. He'll be back for resale as a yearling next year."
