THROCKMORTON ON TOP FINAL FOALS DAY

Worcestershire's Throckmorton Court Stud had plenty to celebrate on Saturday evening after selling two of the top four lots on the final day of the December Foal Sale at Tattersalls. The session's highest price of 105,000gns was given by Paddy Twomey for a Dutch Art (GB) (Medicean {GB}) colt (lot 1227) from the speedy family of Amour Propre (GB) (Paris House {GB}) and Cape Of Good Hope (GB) (Inchinor {GB}). The colt was consigned by Throckmorton for Sheila Oakes, who bought his grandam Calamanco (GB) for £2,800 in 2000. The Clantime (GB) mare has produced five winners, including Listed Scurry S. winner Corrybrough (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}), whose full-sister Fairy Shoes (GB) was responsible for the next colt through the ring, her firstborn by American Post (GB) (Bering {GB}), which fetched 30,000gns.

Immediately preceding the final day-topper, the draft began with a son of Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who was sold to Timmy Hyde for 90,000gns on behalf of Lady Jennifer Green. The colt's dam Sinister Ruckus (Trippi) was a dual winner in Canada and is a sister to Jealous Again, who took Royal Ascot by storm in 2009 when winning the G2 Queen Mary S. for Wesley Ward before being sold to Godolphin.

"We had such a lot of interest in them so we felt quite confident," said Peter Balding, owner of Throckmorton Court Stud. "They were three lovely individuals by fashionable sires, and I'm just delighted for the team at home." **Cont. p3**

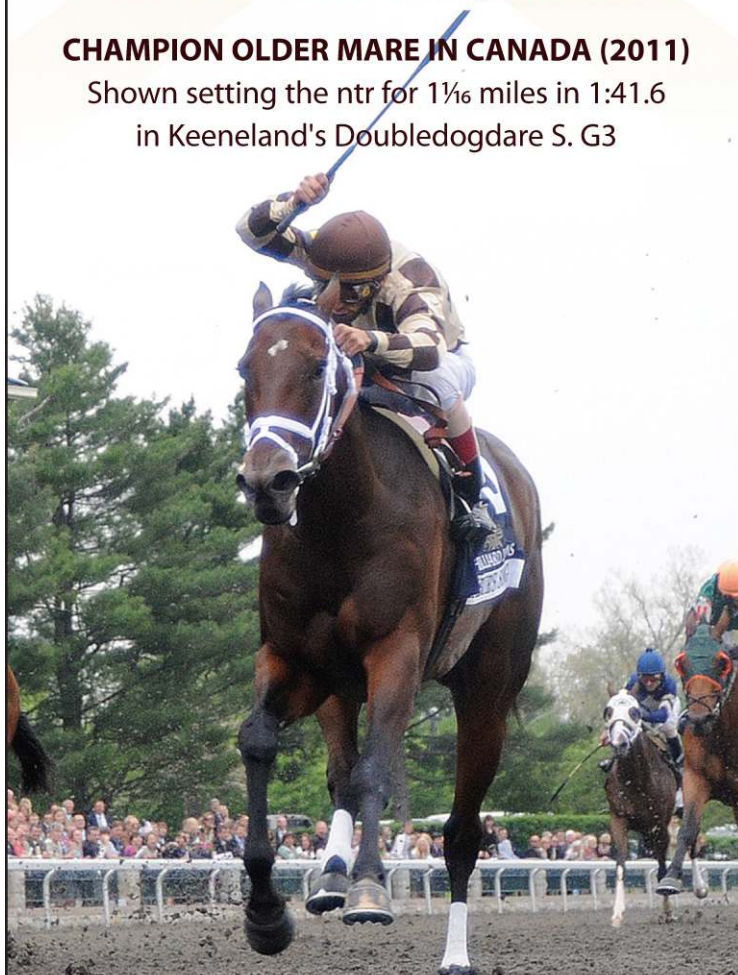

Big Result for Small Breeder

Peter and Michelle Morgan of Carmel Stud were among the major buyers on Thursday and they struck again on Saturday for a colt by the same sire, Exceed And Excel (Aus) (Danehill) (lot 1142), at 100,000gns. The colt is out of Robert Cornelius's homebred Pivotal (GB) mare One Giant Leap (GB), whose 3-year-old Morocco Moon (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) was sold to race in America this summer and won her first start for Neil Drysdale at Santa Anita in October.

"It's a bit of luck that I kept One Giant Leap as she broke a bone in her foot as a yearling, which meant she couldn't go to the sales," recalled Cornelius, who owns two mares and has shares in two more with Peter and Ed Player of Whatton Manor Stud, where One Giant Leap is a permanent boarder.

"I guess I was pretty hopeful coming here, but you never really know," Cornelius continued. "He was very popular--the Players have done a great job consigning him--and the sire has had a good week so the omens were positive."

One Giant Leap, from a consistent winner-producing family that includes Group 3 winner Rag Top (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) and Colmore Row (GB) (Mummy's Pet {GB}), is in foal to Royal Applause (GB), and Cornelius and the Players also have her 2-year-old by Teofilo (Ire), named Lookbeforeyouleap. (GB). She is currently enjoying a winter break, but will go back into training with Eoghan O'Neill in France next year.

Exceed and Excel has been one of the most sought-after sires this week at Tattersalls. On the final day, three of his colts featured among the top 10, including a 95,000gns weanling from the Rings View Stud draft out of the Life Rely (lot 1150). The Maria's Mon mare may have been unraced, but that hasn't stopped her producing three winners from her three foals of racing age, and her current foal was bought by a partnership between French-based Canirola Bloodstock and Franny Woods of Rathbarry Stud.

"We'll take him back to Rathbarry and let him grow up. He'll tell us which sale he's right for next year, but he has a great outlook," said Woods.

In total, 23 foals by Exceed and Excel were sold over the four days for an average of 57,500gns.

Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal) continued to be one of the standout first-season sires on the final day of the Tattersalls Foal Sale, with his grey son of the Unbridled's Song mare Mundus Novus (lot 1104) selling for 85,000gns. A half-brother to this season's juvenile winner Steer By The Stars (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}), the Horse Park Stud consignee was one of four weanlings pinhooked by Mick Flanagan at the sale.

"I loved this colt. The sire is getting outstanding stock and stamping them," said the graduate of the

Darley Flying Start course who has been acting under his Townley Hall Bloodstock banner since March. It's been a hectic few months for Flanagan, but after next week's December Sale at Arqana, he will be preparing for sunnier climes.

"I'm off to Magic Millions and Karaka in January," he said. "It's been a tough year trying to get going, but I've really enjoyed it and I'm looking forward to next year."

Flanagan plans to reoffer the Lope de Vega colt next year

through another relatively new operation, Baroda & Colbinstown, which enjoyed some notable successes through the yearling season.

"They're doing really well, they're young, honest guys and really professional. I can only see them getting better and better," he said of his fellow Irishmen David Cox of Baroda Stud and Colbinstown Stud's David Myerscough.

Flanagan later bought another Lope de Vega foal, this time a filly bred in Ireland by Eileen Farrelly out of her listed-placed Flying Spur (Aus) mare Twiggy's Sister (Ire) for 24,000gns.

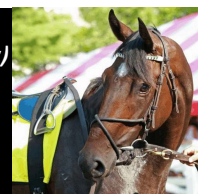
Freshman Competition Fierce

Giving Lope de Vega a good run for his money in the freshman popularity contest was Tweenhills' new boy Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}). Though nine of his 26 catalogued foals were withdrawn from the sale, the 14 which changed hands did so for a highly respectable average of 76,714gns. Five are likely to be racing eventually for either Pearl Bloodstock or Qatar Racing, having been knocked down to David Redvers Bloodstock, including a daughter of the former Aga Khan mare Shemriyna (Ire) (King Of Kings {Ire}). She was offered by Richard Kent's Mickley Stud as lot 1239 and fetched 80,000gns, the second-most expensive of her sire's fillies to sell this week.

Coolmore's Rip Van Winkle earned his stripes on the racecourse with three Group 1 wins and another three runner-up finishes at the highest level, and he too has been rewarded with good support for his first crop in the sales ring. Thirteen were sold--two reaching 140,000gns--at an average of 68,385gns from a first-year fee of €20,000.

Encouraged by the fun they had with the dual winner, they bought his half-sister Fiveofive (Ire), the dam of Medici Code, Lilli Marlane and listed-placed Polly Alexander (Ire) (Foxhound).

Auctioneer Alastair Pim had a few hearts fluttering when knocking down a foal to Piers Brosnan Bloodstock on Saturday morning. Sad to report, the former James Bond star has not turned his back on acting to become a pinhooker, but the buyer in question was Brosnan-lookalike Gerard Burke of Glidawn Stud, who has been busy during the last week, signing for a total of nine foals.

The Bond theme continued with a new name on the buyers' list--Skyfall Bloodstock. The enterprise investment scheme syndicate, which includes agent Charlie Gordon-Watson, spent a total of 225,000gns on three weanlings, including a Rip Van Winkle colt for 100,000gns. Hustled from his inside draw by Smith, Game On Dude slightly brushed into Nonios while gaining a narrow lead as they entered the clubhouse turn. Game On Dude showed the way down the backstretch through fractions of :24.52 and :49.81 with Nonios in hot pursuit. The 5-year-old began to shake clear at the top of the lane as Nunios was under a ride, but the Green Smith Jr. colorbearer wasn't done yet. The pair were almost on even terms in midstretch, but the classy Game On Dude turned back his game foe to win going away late. "He had a little hiccup coming out of the gate," Smith revealed.

"He was squatting a little. I had a couple of ideas maybe we'll try. The idea was just to stay out of his way. (Jockey) Martin (Pedroza) secured the lead and if he wanted it going at a decent pace, I was going to let him have it. But he didn't really go on and I was determined to stick him in there." Smith continued, "I know this horse is brave, so I just put him where I thought I had to. The key for me was to win, and if I could win without gutting him, it would be really good."

Minus a 12th-place finish in the G1 Dubai World Cup and the aforementioned bust in the Classic, Game On Dude has done little wrong throughout his 5-year-old campaign. The dark bay put them back-to-back in Inglewood in the GII Californian S. June 2 and GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. July 7. He was second-best in the GI TVG Pacific Classic S. at Del Mar Aug. 26 before punching his ticket to the Championships with a dominating tally in Santa Anita's GI Awesome Again S. Sept. 29 under Rafael Bejarano.

"I thought Nonios would be the horse to beat in here," Baffert commented. "That's one of the reasons we put Mike (Smith) on him, because when you're a heavy favorite, you can go ahead and get aggressive on him. I saw Nonios making that move on the (final) turn and was coming back on, I said 'Whoa,' because this track is pretty demanding. But then he cut back in and he wasn't really tired when he got back."

STRONG FIELD FOR JAPAN CUP DIRT

This year's renewal of the G1 Japan Cup Dirt features past winners **Espoir City (Jpn)** (Gold Allure {Jpn}) and **Transcend (Jpn)** (Wild Rush), but the up-and-coming **Ijigen (Jpn)** (Empire Maker) may have the goods to topple his elders. A \$75,000 KEESEP yearling that matured into a \$400,000 KEEAPR juvenile, the grey colt has won five of eight career starts--all this year. Misamichi Hamashi's 3-year-olds is coming off a rallying victory in the G3 Musashino S. going a mile on the Tokyo dirt Nov. 11, and is 4-1 on the morning-line. Ryan Moore will pilot Ijigen, whose name means "another dimension" in Japanese. The morning-line favorite **Roman Legend (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}) is perfect in five starts this season, most recently taking the G3 Miyako S. at Kyoto Nov. 4.

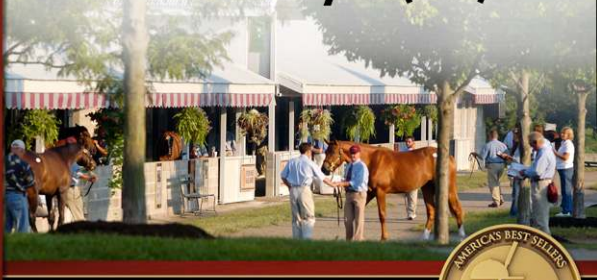
