The \$20,000 in supplemental fees required to get Magdalena Racing's **Pure Fun** (Pure Prize) into the G1 Hollywood Starlet seemed like it might not pay off as the chestnut lagged far back in the early running of Saturday's event, but as she came rolling into the lane, it was clear why her

connections saw fit to make the gamble. The 6-1 shot continued to sustain her jaw-dropping run to blow right on by pacesetter **Blonde Fog** (Divine Park) at the sixteenth pole for an extremely impressive one-length success. Longshot **Scarlet Strike** (Smart Strike) completed the trifecta, while heavily favored **Executiveprivilege** (First Samurai) was a no-excuse fourth. "She jumped away well, but I was a little bit concerned because she was not traveling her best around the first turn," explained winning pilot Garret Gomez. "About halfway down the backside, she started figuring it out and when I wheeled her out she was really accelerating. She took off and was very impressive." **Cont. p3**

LEVEL PLAYING FIELD IN HONG KONG CUP

Friday's announcement that Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) would miss today's G1 Longines Hong Kong Cup due to a left fore tendon problem has increased the chances that **California Memory** (Highest Honor {Fr}) can successfully repeat in the richest event on the program, but it has certainly brought others into the discussion. Sent to the sidelines off a seventh in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup May 20, California Memory resumed with a solid fifth to Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}) in the Sha Tin Trophy H. over an insufficient 1600 meters Oct. 28 and defeated last year's Cup runner-up **Irian** (Ger) (Tertullian) in a flying

ROSEGREEN FILLIES LEAD AT ARQANA

Two ex-Ballydoyle trainees set fire to the Arqana Breeding Stock Sale Saturday, with the Classic-placed **Wild Wind** (Ger) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) breaking the million-euro barrier as darkness descended at the Elie de Brignac sales complex. From Haras des Capucines, the 4-year-old out of the unraced Sadler's Wells mare Woman Secret (Ire) was one of the wild-card entries that have proved so successful here of late, and hip **160** was one of the most significant boosts to the latest renewal of this auction. A descendant of Miesque, Wild Wind was third in last year's G1 Poule d'Essai d'Essai des Pouliches before scoring at listed level and was offered carrying a coveted foal by Galileo (Ire). Despite the persistence of Thierry Deleuge, who was representing Qatari interests, she was eventually secured at €1.175 million by Michael Youngs of Three Chimneys Farm acting as agent for Goncalo Borges Torrealba. "The aim is to build up a strong broodmare band with the best European pedigrees and breed them to American stallions," Youngs told the *Racing Post*. "She will probably stay in Europe to foal and be covered before heading to America." Despite a reduced first-day book, an improved clearance rate yielded record turnover as advances stretched across the board. The aggregate jumped 22% to €13,202,000, while the average and median markers rose 20% and 11%, respectively. **Cont. p9**

Pure Fun began her career somewhat inauspiciously with a fifth-place run in a \$50,000 main-track maiden claimer at Churchill in June. Donning cap and gown three starts later going a mile at Kentucky Downs, she was seventh, beaten just 1 1/4 lengths with trouble, in Keeneland's grassy GIII Jessamine S. Oct. 11. Second over the same course in an Oct. 20 allowance, Pure Fun showed her first flashes of brilliance back on the Churchill Dirt Nov. 24, romping home by 9 1/4 lengths and earning an 89 Beyer Speed Figure in an eight-furlong optional claimer.

Racing without Lasix--as she has throughout her career--Pure Fun broke fine from her rail draw, but quickly dropped back to travel double digit lengths off of splits of :23.63, :47.33 and 1:12.47 set by pressured ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Blonde Fog**. She came into the view of the track camera like a blur leaving the home bend, spun five or six wide into the lane and reeled in **Blonde Fog** to post what once seemed like an improbable score.

"She was a little bit further back than I thought she was going to be," admitted Matt Shirer, assistant to trainer Ken McPeek. "[Gomez] said he asked her to go around the three-eighths pole and she gave him a little. Then by about the quarter pole she really kicked it in. All of a sudden she gave a great burst of energy about six or seven wide around all those horses. In Kentucky [last time] it was the same kind of thing--around the quarter pole she came flying. She's probably going to stay here for about a week, then she will fly back to Lexington. She'll go to the farm for a little bit and most likely be pointed toward the [GI Kentucky] Oaks."

Bob Baffert, trainer of the runner-up and the beaten favorite, said of **Executiveprivilege**, "She didn't punch. The winner ran a good race and my other filly ran a good race. On the turn for home I saw she was struggling a little bit. She felt fine for [Mike Smith], but when she turned for home, she put her head up a bit and just had no zip."

Hall of Famer Jerry Hollendorfer took this event two years ago with Washington Bridge (Yankee Gentleman), and he enjoyed yet another graded victory as trainer and co-owner with the now five-time stakes winner Lady of Fifty. The grey began a three-race stakes winning streak over the Golden Gate Tapeta a year ago, culminating in a decisive score in the California Oaks in January, but an initial pair of trips down to Southern California were unsuccessful. Third of four two back in Santa Anita's 6 1/2-furlong L.A. Woman S. Oct. 7, the sophomore was coming off a win in the one-mile Palm Springs H. back in Arcadia Nov. 1.

Lady of Fifty appeared as if she'd take up a perfect stalking spot along the rail entering the first turn, but she began tossing her head about along the bend and lost three positions as Martin Garcia tried to settle her down. She regained her composure to stalk from midpack in the two path, and began to re-rally turning for home while four deep. Garcia kept after his mount at the head of the lane and, once she switched leads, she responded willingly to bound home impressively.

"She's gotten bigger and stronger and has been training real well," said Hollendorfer of Lady of Fifty. "We're very proud of her and very pleased with the way she's doing right now. Backing out of there early may have been the thing that made her win because the pace got a little rapid out front. She recovered nicely and didn't nick herself up. We feel very fortunate for that. I don't have a race picked out yet, but we'll find something."

Her new connections had to go all the way to \$900,000 to secure Dust and Diamonds at last month's Fasig-Tipton November Sale, and the dark bay immediately helped put a dent into that sum as the prohibitive chalk here. Under the care of Steve Asmussen, Dust and Diamonds reeled off a trio of wins for her owner/breeder Padua Stables, capped by a decisive score in Belmont's Gil Gallant Bloom H. Nov. 3. She was no match for likely Eclipse winner Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint Nov. 3, but proved a clear second best after pressing the pace.

Kept well out in the clear by John Velazquez to press an opening quarter in :22.92, Dust and Diamonds put a head in front while three wide at the :45.17 half. She was a length or so clear as her rider peeked back at the top of the lane, and quickly stiff-armed a bid from Golden Mystery to win with ease.

"I'm very pleased," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher, "I don't know what else she could have done, running six furlongs in 1:08 3/5 and winning under a hand ride."

It was revealed last month that the Brazil-based Borges Torrealba family had become a partner in Three Chimneys Farm. Michael Youngs of Three Chimneys, acting on behalf of Goncalo Borges Torrealba, purchased Saturday's topper at the Arqana Breeding Stock Sale for €1.175 million (see page one). 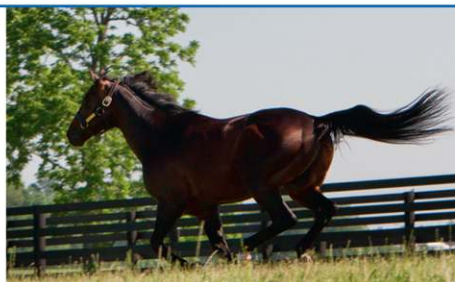

Settled in third early against the fence by Anthony Delpech, she was launched on the front end soon into the straight and had already inflicted the damage by the time Hammie's Hooker closed the deficit.

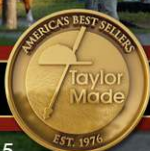

Earlier, another jewel of the draft was the 14-year-old **Tender Morn** (Dayjur). Hip [125](#) has proved a prolific producer, with the black-type performers Elusif (Fr) (Elusive Quality) and Single (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}) and also last year's G3 Prix d'Aumale winner and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac third Zantenda (GB) (Zamindar) in her armory. Carrying a full-sibling to the latter class runner, the half to the sire Diableneyev was bought by Horse France for €300,000. Late in the session, a third member of the consignment, the 3-year-old **Secrete** (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}), was purchased by Meridian International for €250,000. Hip [193](#), a half-sister to 2010 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Plumania (GB) (Anabaa) and 2008 G2 Prix de Royallieu scorer Balladeuse (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}), is also a relative of the aforementioned Spin.

Another of the wild cards to create excitement was the 12-year-old **Sweet Stream (Ity)** (Shantou), winner of the 2004 G1 Prix Vermeille and the dam of pattern-race performer Tidespring (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}). She was runner-up in the G3 Deutsches St Leger and third in the G3 Hubertus-Liebrecht-Gedachtnispreis, while Sweet Stream has another feather in her cap in the form of a 2-year-old colt by Galileo (Ire) in training with Pia Brandt. Offered by Ecurie des Monceaux in foal to Oasis Dream (GB), Sweet Stream was bought by BBA Ireland for €500,000. Minutes later, Shadai Farm stepped in to secure hip [147](#), the Elie Lellouche-consigned 4-year-old **Miss Lago (Ire)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) for €350,000. Solemia (Fr) (Poliglote {GB}) in the G2 Prix Corrida May 28 and third to **Giofra (Fr)** (Dansili {GB}) in the G1 Falmouth S. July 13, she took one of Europe's premier filly/mare mile stakes, the G1 Sun Chariot S. Sept. 29. Despite just a 15-day turnaround, the bay shipped to

Woodbine and worked home best of all for a 1 3/4-length defeat of **Pagera (Fr)** (Gentlewave {Ire}) in the G1 E. P. Taylor S. Oct. 14. Siyouma turned in arguably the week's best piece of trackwork when streaking home to cover the final furlong of a Thursday breeze in a sensational :10.68. **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) and **Glorious Days (Aus)** (Hussonet) face a personal rubber match in the Mile. The dual Horse of the Year defeated Glorious Days in the Sha Tin Trophy H. Oct. 28, but was beaten on the square by 1 1/2 lengths in the G2 Jockey Club Mile Nov. 18. Two-time G1 Champions Mile winner **Xtension (Ire)** (Xaar {GB}) was third in a blanket finish in last year's Mile and was having his first run of this preparation when a running-on fifth in the Jockey Club Mile. **Sadamu Patek (Jpn)** (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) outgamed compatriot **Grand Prix Boss (Jpn)** in the G1 Mile Championship S. at Kyoto Nov. 18 and will look to follow in the hoofprints of Hat Trick, and G1 Prix de la Foret winner **Gordon Lord Byron (Ire)** (Byron {GB}) can make some noise late if he can reproduce that form over 1600 meters today.

FAMILIAR FACES IN THE VASE

Even with Saturday's scratching of Khalid Abdullah's G1 Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up Sea Moon (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}), the G1 Longines Hong Kong Vase, the first of the four International events this afternoon, features several horses

already successful on some of the world's biggest stages. Chief among those is **Dunaden (Fr)** (Nicobar {GB}), the defending Vase champion, who entered this event last year off a stirring victory over Ronald Arculli's **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the G1 Melbourne Cup. Dunaden

returned to Australia and was spectacular in besting Alcopop (Aus) (Jeune {GB}) by a half-length in the G1 Caulfield Cup, but a muddling pace developed in this year's Melbourne Cup and the French raider could finish no better than 14th. But Australian jockey Craig Williams is willing to draw a line through the Flemington effort and is looking forward to this repeat bid. "You think back a year, the worry was that he might be too dour coming back from 3200 meters to 2400 meters, but the way he feels, I think he wouldn't be out of his distance range in a 2000-meter race now," Williams stated. "He just seems sharper." He'll need to be as he faces a deeper field this yea. **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) can be a threat on his best. A dual Group 1 winner in 2012, the striking gray was runner-up in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 16, but didn't run a step in the Arc, finishing 12th. **Bayrir (Fr)** (Medicean {GB}) won the G1 Secretariat S. over the summer at Arlington and was runner-up to Saonois (Fr) in the G2 Prix Niel on Arc Trial day Sept. 16. He exits a longshot 10th in the Arc Oct. 7. **Chinchon (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) is no stranger to an international audience. Winner of the G1 United Nations S. in 2010 and runner-up in the Monmouth feature last summer, the globetrotter was only a longshot eighth in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. here last April, but shipped to Singapore and defeated G1 Hong Kong Cup hopeful Zaidan (Street Cry {Ire}) in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup May 20. He reunites with Olivier Doleuze today. **Field p15**

As dominant as Hong Kong has been in the Mile, they've been nearly bulletproof in the G1 Longines Hong Kong Sprint, with nine wins in the last 10 years. Only South African speedball J J the Jet Plane (SAf)

(Jet Master {SAf}) has been able to upset the apple cart in 2010, but Japan's Lord Kanaloa (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) has the credentials to play spoiler this afternoon. The 4-year-old has seven wins and four seconds from his 11 career outings, including a

second to Curren Chan (Jpn) (Kurofune) in the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen Mar. 25 before turning the tables on that female rival in the G1 Sprinters' S. Sept. 30. Lord Kanaloa was favored in his nine starts prior to the Sprinters S., where he was 3-1 to Curren Chan's 3-2. Curren Chan was fifth, beaten 2 1/4 lengths by Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) in last year's Sprint and makes the final start of her distinguished career this afternoon. Lucky Nine's chances took a hit Thursday morning when he drew the outside post in this field of 12, but trainer Caspar Fownes isn't conceding anything just yet. Fifth with a troubled passage in the Sprinters, the 5-year-old was reportedly nowhere near 100% for the G2 Jockey Club Sprint, but managed to find the line just ahead of an unlucky Time After Time (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). The latter missed the break that afternoon and was forced to rally from the tail. He looms a serious, if overbet, rival this afternoon. Sea Siren (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) tries to take the Sprint back to Australia for the first time since Falvelon (Aus) won back-to-back in 1999 and 2000. The 4-year-old won the G1 Manikato S. going 1200 meters around bend under the lights at Moonee Valley Oct. 26 before finishing second up the Flemington straight course in the G1 Patinack Farm Classic Nov. 10. Connections believe she is better around a turn and she is getting plenty of respect in pre-post wagering.

No further details were provided by Hong Kong Jockey Club stewards, but they indicated that the decision was made in concert with Sea Moon's trainer Sir Michael Stoute. Sea Moon had reportedly been dealing with travel sickness since arriving in Hong Kong Dec. 1, but had worked well Friday before blood tests Saturday revealed that something was amiss. **Carlton House** (Street Cry {Ire}) will represent the stable in the G1 Hong Kong Cup. Dual Hong Kong Horse of the Year **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) was cleared after a Sunday morning examination for participation in today's G1 Hong Kong Mile. The 6-year-old was found to be "moderately lame" in his right hind leg by HKJC vets Saturday.

Encosta de Lago Gelding Tops HKIS...

A very smooth-moving son of the outstanding sire Encosta de Lago (Aus) was knocked down for a final bid of HK\$5 million (\$645,161) to top the December portion of the Hong Kong International Sale held in a makeshift sales ring in the Sha Tin walking ring. Catalogued as lot 14, the brown gelding, a son of Australian Group 2 Sharp (Aus) (Danzero {Aus}), was picked up for A\$360,000 at the 2011 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. Jackie Wong, the board chairman of Hong Thai Travel Services, signed the winning ticket. Wong has a pair of horses in training in Hong Kong with trainer Dennis Yip, including Travel Brand (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}), winner of a Class 4 handicap at Sha Tin in October. Most of the horses offered at the HKIS have already been gelded, but that lot 11 was offered as an entire is not surprising given his pedigree. The son of High Chaparral (Ire) is a half-brother to two-time Hong Kong Horse of the Year Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}), and the NZ\$420,000 acquisition from the NZB Premier Yearling Sale was purchased by Andrew Wong, the director and CEO of Fung Seng Enterprises Limited, for HK\$3.8 million (\$490,323). One of the most exciting races ever run at Sha Tin was the 2000 G1 Hong Kong Mile when local hero Fairy King Prawn (Aus) (Danehill) just failed to reel in the irrepressible Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}). Lot 1 presented buyers with an opportunity to buy into her family, when the Encosta de Lago (Aus) gelding was sold to William Yem for HK\$3.3 million (\$425,806) after being purchased as a yearling for A\$320,000 at the Gold Coast sale earlier this year. The gelding's dam, Sun Song (Aus) (Desert Sun {GB}), is a granddaughter of Sunline's dam Songlines (NZ). Overall, the 17 horses, each sold without reserve, grossed HK\$43.7 million (\$5,638,710), for an average of HK\$2,570,588 (\$331,689) and a median of HK\$2,300,000 (\$296,774). "Today was a break-even sale, which is a good thing--we're not in this to make money on the sale," said Bill Nader, Executive Director of Racing for the HKJC. "As we've said many times in the past, the purpose of this sale is to be a service provision to our owners and members, to give them the opportunity to have options in bringing horses to Hong Kong and race. The owners set the market and the fact that it was a buyer's market is fine with us. We're here to produce horses that will benefit racing in Hong Kong and hopefully some of these horses will go on to become successful racehorses and be good value for our owners." He added, "We have another Hong Kong International Sale in March, and that might have contributed to the fact that the prices were a little more reasonable today. When we get into our second sale and weigh it all up together, we'll have a big picture view of how the two sales work within one season, but I think having two sales will be a positive step because it will give owners more opportunities to find the horse they want to purchase and also keep the prices a little more realistic." **Cont. p17**

Phony Events Take Toll on Horse Racing Industry

"The Florida Senate's new Gaming Committee soon begins its crucial work. Chairman Garrett Richter and all legislators should be aware that counties throughout the state will be rushing to hold slot machine referendums. John Shear, a familiar face in the paddock at Betfair Hollywood Park since 1962, will work his final day at the track Sunday. Shear, who will turn 92 in January, isn't completely retiring from the sport he loves. He will be working the paddock when Santa Anita, which is only three miles from the home he shares with wife Diane, begins its Winter/Spring meet Dec. 26. Severely injured in March of last year when he heroically stepped into the path of a loose horse in the walking ring at Santa Anita to protect a 6-year-old girl, Shear said he will miss Betfair Hollywood Park, but plans on visiting often during the 2013 Spring/Summer season. "Horses have always been my life and I'm going to miss the people," he said. "I love people and love to talk to them. I became friends with a lot of celebrities through the years. Cary Grant used to seek me out every morning to have a conversation and Howard Koch was a very good friend of mine. Plus all the jockeys and trainers. I remember how Bill Shoemaker used to play what was called 'Racetrack Rummy.' He would have rather sat and played a game than ridden a horse." Certain Thoroughbreds that have excelled at Betfair Hollywood Park also hold a special place in Shear's memory. There are quite a few, he said, but a couple came quickly to mind. "Of course, Zenyatta," said Shear. "She was a very special mare and brought a lot of excitement every time she ran. Native Diver won three consecutive Hollywood Gold Cups (1965-67) and was a brilliant horse, and his trainer [Buster Millerick] was a friend of mine." Eual Wyatt, Jr., Betfair Hollywood Park's vice president and general manager, said Shear will definitely be missed. "The paddock won't be the same without him," he said. "He's been an extremely loyal and valuable employee and his love of horse racing is obvious to anyone who knows him."

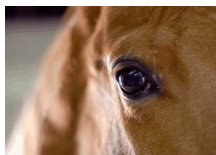
