## LOGOTYPE PULLS UPSET IN ASAHI FUTURITY

Longshot **Logotype (Jpn)** (Lohengrin {Jpn}) gamely held off favored **Codino (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) to win the G1 Asahi Hai Futurity by just a neck Sunday at Nakayama. Fourth behind the unbeaten Codino in the G3 Sapporo Nisai S. Sept. 1, Logotype was coming off a victory in Tokyo's Begonia Sho Nov. 25. Well-placed just off the first flight with Codino a few slots back, Logotype struck the front at the head of the lane as Codino shadowed his move on the outside. The favorite slowly whittled away at Logotype's advantage approaching the wire, but the winner dug in determinedly to pull off the upset. His final time of 1:33.40 equaled the stakes record set by **Meiner Recolte (Jpn)** (Chief Bearhart) in 2004. Logotype capped a one-three finish and scored a first black-type victory for second-crop sire Lohengrin (Singspiel {Ire}), who has just four foals in his 2010 crop. **Gottfried (Jpn)** (Lohengrin {Jpn}) was third in the 1600-meter race.

## EbLOUISSANTE AVOIDS SERIOUS INJURY

**Eblouissante (Bernardini)**, scratched from what would have been her second career start Saturday after suffering a minor injury in the receiving barn at Betfair Hollywood Park, was doing well Sunday morning. Eblouissante bruised her hip when she banged into a stall door just prior to Saturday's fourth race. "She's good this morning," reported trainer John Shirreffs, who also trained the 3-year-old filly's champion half-sister **Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire})**. "It was a contusion or abrasion. It took some hair off and it's bruised. We're treating it topically now. We iced it about four or five times [Saturday]. She's walking good on it, so we're going to take her out and train her and see how she handles it." Eblouissante, racing for her breeder Eric Kronfeld, was tabbed a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** after a 4 1/4-length debut victory at Hollywood Nov. 16.

Heathcote got a late start to his career, but opened his 4-year-old campaign the right way with three straight victories against fellow Ontario-breds this summer. The dark bay gelding suffered his first loss when fourth against open company in an Aug. 15 allowance and was coming off runner-up efforts in off-the-turf 10-furlong allowance contests Sept. 22 and Nov. 3. Emma-Jayne Wilson put Heathcote on the lead soon after the break and the gelding was in hand through a half in :50.94 and six furlongs in 1:16.16.

Heathcote and Quaesitor opened a lengthy margin on the rest of the field going under the wire for the first time and the eventual winner distanced himself further into the backstretch after a mile in 1:42.19. Wilson asked her mount for more turning for home and Heathcote surged clear down the lane for an easy victory.

Wilson said she was never worried about Heathcote's ability to get the Valedictory's 1 3/4-mile distance.

"He is a big horse with a big, long stride," she said. "We knew the mile and three-quarters wasn't going to hurt him at all, and when I got him just cruising along with his ears up the whole way, I thought it would take a race horse to beat him."

The veteran rider thought the winner would have gone even further. "He just started getting going at the three-eighths pole," Wilson smiled. "No matter how good they are, and how much they handle that distance, they do seem to get a little tired. But he would have went around again."

Heathcote is owned by Bob and Mark Krembil's Chiefswood Stable, which campaigned his sire, Queen's Plate winner Niigon.

"[There's] nothing definite," said Romans, "but we might run him twice in Dubai."

## HOLLYWOOD STAKES WINNERS SHIP OUT

**Violence** (Medaglia d'Oro), who maintained his unbeaten record with a 1 1/4-length victory in the GI CashCall Futurity at Betfair Hollywood Park Saturday, came out of the race in good shape, according to trainer Todd Pletcher. "He cooled out real nice and is on a plane heading for Palm Meadows," Pletcher confirmed Sunday morning. Joining Violence on the flight to Florida were the D. Wayne Lukas-trained duo of **Optimizer** (English Channel), third in the GII Hollywood Turf Cup and **Oxbow** (Awesome Again), fourth in the Futurity. Trainer Paddy Gallagher reported Saturday that Turf Cup winner **Grandeur (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}) "seems fine this morning." Gallagher added, "He'll be leaving for a quarantine facility in a day or two. He's going back to Europe, so he'll need 30 days in quarantine." Trained in Europe by Jeremy Noseda, Grandeur won the Nov. 2 GII Twilight Derby and was second in the Nov. 25 GI Hollywood Derby. The Turf Cup was his first start for Gallagher.

## IBN BEY DEAD

Former Paul Cole trainee **Ibn Bey (GB)** (Mill Reef--Rosia Bay {GB}, by High Top {Ire}), who garnered a trio of top-tier events in the silks of Prince Fahd Salman, died recently in Japan, according to *Racing Post*. Successful in the 1989 G1 Europa Preis at Cologne, the chestnut's final campaign the following year yielded wins in the G1 Grosser Preis der Berliner Bank at Dusseldorf, and the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh. He also placed four times at the highest level, including a one-length second to Unbridled (Fappiano) in the 1990 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Belmont. He retired to Big Red Farm on Japan's Hokkaido island after an eighth in the 1990 G1 Japan Cup, and was relieved of covering duties in 2007. Ibn Bey was 28.

# From Start to Finish...



with Darley Flying Start's Sophie Ignarski

The Hong Kong International Races last weekend attracted a record crowd of over 70,000 and several trainees in our group were fortunate to count themselves amongst the number, stopping off to enjoy Hong Kong's flagship raceday following the completion of our time in Australia.

During the lead up to the event, I had been fortunate to complete a three-week work placement at the Hong Kong Jockey Club (HKJC). Working alongside the handicappers, race programmers, stipendary stewards, vets and many others, I was able to discover much more about this world-renowned organisation and its unique business model, one that many have proclaimed as the 'gold-standard' for the provision and regulation of horse racing.

As I swiftly learnt, racing (or more precisely, betting) in Hong Kong is something of a religion. Going racing for the first time at Hong Kong's Sha Tin and Happy Valley racecourses, the flamboyant, social crowds of Flemington and Randwick were replaced by row upon row of studious betting enthusiasts, scribbling furiously in their form guides. The significance of betting in Hong Kong was put into perspective when I learnt that the total amount bet in Hong Kong during the 2011/12 racing season (around US\$11 billion) virtually equalled the amount wagered on horses in the whole of the U.S. so far this year. On a typical race day, the HKJC processes around six million bets, a figure that takes on greater significance in the context of Hong Kong's population of seven million people.

The success of Hong Kong racing is largely derived from this robust gambling culture, a culture that continues to thrive thanks to the HKJC's provision of an incredibly desirable wagering product. **Cont. p7**

At a time when racing worldwide faces rigorous scrutiny from the media and general public, integrity and transparency remain paramount in Hong Kong, where the impetus is on generating a product that people *want* to bet on. Key to this is the provision of freely available information for the public.

The HKJC's website receives 600,000 visitors a day and offers a wealth of material relating to the horses in training, from training logs to stewards' reports, and perhaps surprisingly, information relating to veterinary treatment--ranging from records of surgeries to bloodwork abnormalities. With access to this information, any guess work is eliminated which ultimately ensures maximum betting confidence, one of the chief objectives of the HKJC.

In addition, the organisation is keen to embrace technological change and has made substantial investments in this field. In its pursuit of new, young fans, it has recently installed several ground-breaking electronic wagering tables in its racecourse nightclub 'Adrenaline,' offering touch screen data on the runners in each race and allowing racegoers to bet using preloaded 'smartcard' technology. As a further move to encourage participation, iPads are offered on loan to patrons, with the aim of targeting high-end, young racegoers by mixing a social atmosphere and a fun, non-threatening immersion in to racing.

With mega-casinos in nearby Macau to contend with, the HKJC knows that it must remain competitive (particularly amongst young professionals) and it seems that they may have struck marketing gold with these enticing new tools. As a whole, racing has dawdled in embracing such technologies, but the HKJC has shown that the rewards of this unblinkered, forward-thinking approach can be handsome.

The international race meeting last weekend offered us a chance to see for ourselves how the HKJC has produced an event that is the envy of racing jurisdictions worldwide. In weather so good that it warranted a rare opening of the famous retractable roof covering the parade ring, the day was seamless from beginning to end.
