AY QARAABA!

Qaraaba (GB) (Shamardal), one of three Simon Callaghan trainees in the nine-horse field, closed determinedly down the center of the course to win Sunday's GIII Robert J. Frankel S. at Santa Anita by an expanding 1 1/4

lengths. Off a step slowly, the bay mare was taken in hand and was headstrong while forced into a trailing position as stablemate **Imperialistic Diva (Ire)** (Haafhd {GB}) set the pace through fractions of :24.41, :49.69 and 1:13.85. The pacesetter began to tire at the top of the lane and was soon swarmed by a host of rivals, including favored **Tiz Flirtatious** (Tizbud), but it was Qaraaba who found her best gear in deep stretch and surged clear of the pack for her first graded stakes victory.

"We thought the world of this filly from Day One," Callaghan said of the winner. "She's special. She'll get better as she goes further. You need to take her back and get her to relax, no matter what the pace is. Julien [Leparoux] did a good job."

"Simon told me to ride her with a lot of confidence and I did," Leparoux added. "She's a very handy filly and she relaxed perfectly. As you could see, she won pretty easily and she had a lot left." **Cont. p3**

COR COR SEEKS THIRD STRAIGHT IN OLD HAT

Steve Ballou and Harriet Waldron's **Cor Cor** (Smoke Glacken) will look to remain unbeaten in three starts when she faces four rivals in Tuesday's GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream Park. The filly is second choice at 3-1 on the morning line behind **Kauai Katie** (Malibu Moon) and trainer Joan Scott is confident in her speedy charge.

"Any time you run in a graded stakes, you're going to go up against heavy hitters," Scott said. "They don't give stakes wins and placings away--you have to earn them--but she has done nothing wrong so far and is doing super, which is what I'm concerned about."

Cor Cor opened her racing career with a 2 3/4-length debut victory at Keeneland Oct. 11. She returned with a stakes-record setting wire-to-wire tally in the Sandpiper S. at Tampa Bay Downs Dec. 1, holding on to score by a half-length after blitzing through fractions of :21 4/5, :44 2/5 and :56 3/5 before completing the six furlongs in 1:10.02. "[The Sandpiper win] showed me that she had some guts," Scott admitted. "I saw the fractions, I didn't know what was going to happen. I was really proud of her. It shows you a lot."

Since the Sandpiper, Cor Cor has turned in a pair of bullet works at Tampa, going a best-of-21 five furlongs in 1:00.60 Dec. 14 and a best-of-40 four furlongs in :47.40 Dec. 23. "She's quick about everything," Scott said. "You have to train her with relaxed training. But if she's ready to go, you just have to push the button."

Ballou, a construction executive, and his 13-year-old daughter Danielle, with the help of bloodstock agent Murette Farrell, purchased Cor Cor for \$40,000 out of the OBS June sale. **Old Hat full field p3**

Qaraaba Surges to Frankel Victory (cont. from p1)

Qaraaba, who began her racing career for her breeder, Shadwell Estate, was purchased by trainer Seamus Durack for 11,000gns out of the 2010 Tattersalls July sale. She won three starts for new owner Peter Deal and Durack before being purchased privately and transferred stateside to the barn of trainer Simon Callaghan and owners Alice Bamford and Michael Tabor. In her first U.S. outing, the bay mare overcame a slow start to record a last-to-first 1 1/2-length victory in a Nov. 15 allowance at Betfair Hollywood Park.

Callaghan said Qaraaba would likely target the Apr. 20 GI Santa Barbara H., with Arlington Park's GI Beverly D. a long-term goal.

Tiz Flirtatious, coming off a runner-up effort in the Nov. 25 GI Matriarch H., couldn't hold off Qaraaba's late surge, but trainer Marty Jones was content with the favorite's second-place finish. "I thought she ran well," Jones said. "She wasn't able to save much ground. I never had her on soft ground, so I don't know if she really prefers that or not, but she tried. The other filly just ran a little better. We'll see how she takes the race and we'll figure out where we go from here."

GULFPORT BREEZES FOR JEROME

Mike Rutherford, Michael Lauffer & Kinsman Stable's **Gulfport** (Unbridled's Song) turned in the fastest of four six-furlong works at Gulfstream Saturday with a 1:12.40 clocking. The \$775,000 FTSAUG yearling is expected to run in Aqueduct's GI Jerome S. Jan. 5. "He continues to improve," trainer Dale Romans said Saturday. "He's a very classy horse with a class pedigree. He has the looks and the natural talent, and he's just gotten better. Today's work is about as good as it gets." The son of MGISW Dream Supreme (Seeking the Gold) and half-brother to GISW Majestic Warrior (A.P. Indy) paired up victories last time with a 2 3/4-length optional claiming score going a mile at Churchill Downs Nov. 24.

Groupie Doll Arrives at Gulfstream...

Likely champion female sprinter **Groupie Doll** (Bowman's Band) arrived at Gulfstream Park by van Saturday as she eyes a 2013 debut in the GII Inside Information S. Mar. 17. The 4-year-old has been turned out at owner/breeder/trainer Buff Bradley's Indian Ridge Farm in Frankfort, KY alongside 2006 GI Donn H. winner Brass Hat (Prized) since finishing a close second in the GI Cigar Mile H. Nov. 24. "She's been out every day," said Bradley. "I don't think she's lost a lot [of conditioning]. Brass Hat keeps her going. She'll probably gallop the month of January and start breezing in February."

Mucho Macho Man Preps for Sunshine Millions...

Reeves Thoroughbred Racing's **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) breezed five panels in 1:00.09 at Gulfstream Park Saturday morning as he prepares for a defense of his Florida Sunshine Millions Classic title over the strip Jan. 19. Under exercise rider Nick Petro, Jr., the GI Breeders' Cup Classic runner-up was clocked in splits of 11 2/5, :22 2/5, :34 3/5 and :46 1/5 en route to the second-fastest of 26 spins at the distance. "He went really good," offered trainer Kathy Ritvo. "He likes to train. He's a horse that's happiest when he trains."

Little Distorted Returns in Spectacular Bid...

Little Distorted (Distorted Humor), purchased by Silverton Hill after an impressive debut victory at Belmont Oct. 28 ([video](#)), will make his second start in Tuesday's Spectacular Bid S. at Gulfstream Park. The chestnut colt, debuting for trainer Michael Mareina and owner Kuehne Racing, upset Revolutionary (War Pass). That colt returned with an 8 1/2-length graduation at Aqueduct Friday. Little Distorted has been with new trainer Darrin Miller since early last month. "He's a very impressive horse with a good demeanor," Miller said of his new charge. "He's very easy to work with. He's a willing, accommodating horse. He's a talented horse who can turn it on and turn it off. He's a very athletic horse."

California Trainers Back on Track...

Two Southern California trainers sidelined by illness and injury returned to Santa Anita Sunday. Humberto Ascanio, long-time assistant to Hall of Famer Bobby Frankel, presented the trophy to connections of the winner of the GIII Robert J. Frankel S. It was Ascanio's first trip to Santa Anita since suffering a stroke last December. Retired trainer Mel Stute, who had been hospitalized after a fall at his home last month, also returned to the track Sunday. "I have three horses in today and one is owned by his wife [Annabelle]," explained Stute's son, trainer Gary Stute.

New Zealand

JOCKEY ASHLEE MUNDY DIES

Jockey Ashlee Marie Mundy died yesterday from injuries sustained during a fall in the seventh race at Kurow racecourse Sunday, according to a release from New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing. She was 26. Mundy's mount, Elleaye, clipped heels and fell approaching the 600-meter mark. Mundy was taken by helicopter to a Dunedin hospital.

"All our thoughts are with Ashlee's family at this terrible time," said Greg Purcell, chief executive of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing. "This is a very sad day for them and for the wider racing community in New Zealand."

Mundy began riding in 2004. She rode 232 winners in New Zealand, including four stakes victories, and had been riding in Australia in the last few years. She rode 43 winners in Queensland.

"Her family live in Westport and she had returned to New Zealand for a holiday and riding," Purcell added.

Mundy's death is the first race-day fatality for a New Zealand jockey since 2004.

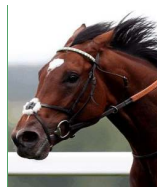
