## KATIE TURNS BACK FOR OLD HAT

Stonestreet Stables's ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★

**Kauai Katie** (Malibu Moon) will look to keep her undefeated record at sprint distances intact in

Gulfstream's GIII Old Hat S. for newly turned 3-year-old fillies this afternoon. An effortless winner of both the Aug. 12 GII Adirondack S. and Sept. 30 GII Matron S. after a smashing Saratoga debut in July, the \$490,000 Fasig-Tipton Florida grad could do no better than fourth after chasing Beholder (Henny Hughes) in the 8 1/2 furlong GI Breeders'

Cup Juvenile Fillies Nov. 2. "It wasn't a bad race," noted trainer Todd Pletcher, who last won this event in 2008 with Game Face (Menifee). "It was probably a little farther than she wants to go. She'll probably be best at sprint distances for now, and this is a good spot to get started." The bay enters with back-to-back bullet works at Palm Meadows Dec. 19 and Dec. 26.

Glorilu Stables's **Power Lady** (Discreet Cat) may have also been undefeated going short if not for some traffic trouble in her last. The bay romped by 11 3/4 lengths when unveiled at Penn National Sept. 30 and cruised by 7 3/4 lengths in a Parx allowance Oct. 6, but she finished third, beaten 1 1/4 lengths, last time in Laurel's Nov. 3 Smart Halo S. "She was in behind a wall of horses the whole race and turning for home, she had an opening on the inside," recalled trained John Servis of the Smart Halo. "She went for it and the horse in front came down on top of her." Servis acknowledged that Kauai Katie will take some beating, saying, "I'm glad she's in the one hole and inside of me, but she's also a very talented filly. This will be a good test for my filly to see where she's at." Power Lady will be racing with Lasix for the first time.

Steve Ballou and Harriet Waldron's **Cor Cor** (Smoke Glacken) comes off a victory in Tampa Bay's Sandpiper S. and has been working up a storm at that oval. She figures to join the chalk up front early.

## SOPHOMORES SQUARE OFF AT GULFSTREAM

A pair of intriguing stakes events for sophomores at Gulfstream today kick off the Florida leg of the 2013 Derby trail. John Oxley's **Star Contender** (Henny Hughes) makes his dirt debut in the one-mile Gulfstream Park Derby. A winner of the Cup and Saucer S. over yielding Woodbine sod Oct. 20, the bay was last seen finishing second in the main-track Coronation Futurity Nov. 10. "We had a lot of nice 2-year-olds this year and he was the greenest of the bunch," said trainer Mark Casse, who will be putting blinkers on Star Contender for the first time. "He's Canadian-bred and there are so many good races for them at Woodbine, so we just left him up there. He's trained very well on dirt, but it's a question you want to answer." The bay sports a pair of upbeat works at Palm Meadows in preparation for this.

The six-furlong Spectacular Bid S. may be the tougher of the two races, with **Merit Man** (With Distinction) getting the morning-line nod at 6-5 coming off a nose defeat in Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint Nov. 2. "He ran a great race," trainer Bob Hess, Jr. said of that contest. "I think he got to loafing a little bit out there on the lead. We think we've learned a few things about him since then." **Little Distorted** (Distorted Humor) is a close second choice on the line at 8-5, but he could easily go off lower. The chestnut was purchased privately by Silverton Hill Farm from Kuehne Racing and transferred to Darrin Miller from Michael Mareina after a 101 Beyer Speed Figure-earning debut score at Belmont Oct. 28. The runner-up that day Revolutionary (War Pass) earned a 102 for his 8 1/2-length graduation tally at the Big A Friday. **Fields p3**

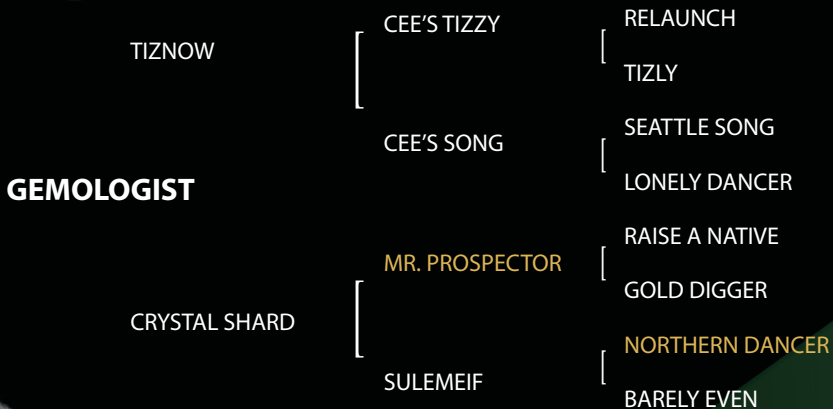

Although I don't consider myself unduly superstitious, I will admit to feeling uneasy as the clock strikes midnight on New Year's Eve. In my defense, I grew up in an area where it was considered essential, for some unfathomable reason, that the first person through the door after midnight should be a tall, dark-haired man carrying a lump of coal. I am therefore not immune to wondering whether each New Year is going to be better or worse than its predecessor.

Wearing my Juddmonte hat, I can't help thinking that it is virtually impossible for 2013 to be as good as the Frankel days of 2012. And anyone connected with Distorted Humor must also be wondering whether this influential stallion can make as big an impact as he did in 2012.

Remember, the WinStar stallion was directly responsible for two Grade I winners, in the shape of the 3-year-olds Aesop's Fables and Jimmy Creed. The latter is the latest winner of the prestigious Malibu S., a race whose roll of honor features such familiar names as Dixie Union, Mizzen Mast and Rock Hard Ten. Distorted Humor also sired the year's highest-priced American yearling, thanks to his \$1.65-million colt out of Mushka.

The now 20-year-old stallion also made his mark through his stallion sons and broodmare daughters. Of course, his son Flower Alley came tantalizingly close to taking the Triple Crown with I'll Have Another, while another son, Sharp Humor, came up with a pair of second-crop Grade II winners (to make his sale to South Korea look regrettable).

Daughters of Distorted Humor also had a couple of excellent 3-year-olds to their credit and these two--Book Review and Reneesgotzip (City Zip)--were recently separated by only a neck at the finish of the GI La Brea S. **Cont. p5**

There is every chance that Distorted Humor could better his 2012 achievements, as his total of North American Grade I winners has stood as high as three in 2005 and 2007. There is also reason to believe that he could prove himself a sire of sires, in much the same way that his sire Forty Niner and grandsire Mr. Prospector did. Forty Niner, you may recall, proved very effective in this sphere. In addition to Distorted Humor, his team of stallion sons featured such as End Sweep, Jules, Rich Man's Gold, Luhuk, Coronado's Quest, Ecton Park, Gold Case, Gold Fever, Roar, Sunday Break, Twining, West Acre and Tactical Advantage. Collectively they have left quite a legacy.

There are several young sons of Distorted Humor worth keeping an eye on, ranging from his GI Belmont S. and GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Drosselmeyer to his ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Maclean's Music, who showed such exceptional potential in scoring at Santa Anita in March 2011 in what proved to be his only appearance.

I am particularly interested in Distorted Humor as a broodmare sire. With Mr Prospector and Danzig as his grandsires, he is well qualified to succeed in this role, but it is important to remember that Distorted Humor's first four crops, foaled between 2000 and 2003, were sired at fees no higher than \$12,500.

The very fact that these four crops produced 43 stakes winners from only 246 named foals--a remarkable 17.5%--proves that there was very little wrong with the quality of the mares covered by Distorted Humor in those early years. It is possible to argue, though, that the fillies from these early crops are unlikely to possess the same strength of bloodlines as the fillies from Distorted Humor's later crops. His first daughters sired at a fee higher than \$20,000 weren't born until 2005, so have had little chance so far to prove themselves as broodmares, and his first daughters sired at six-figure fees were not born until 2007. In other words, there is every reason for hoping that the best is yet to come from Distorted Humor as a broodmare sire.

Reneesgotzip, whose dam, No Dress Code, belonged to Distorted Humor's first crop, was once sold for as little as \$3,500 as a yearling and her second dam Westfold Vale ended up in New Mexico. However, the La Brea winner Book Review possesses a more fashionable pedigree. Her dam Clever Babe, a member of Distorted Humor's fifth crop, never raced after making \$100,000 as a yearling. But she has made an excellent start as a broodmare, with Book Review being her first foal. Incidentally, Book Review is yet another fine advertisement for May foals, as she has a May 14 birthday. **Cont. p6**

The La Brea winner is one of three foals of racing age sired by Giant's Causeway from daughters of Distorted Humor. All three are winners, which bodes well for Clever Babe's 2011 Giant's Causeway filly.

The choice of Giant's Causeway as a mate for Clever Babe perhaps owed something to the fact that she is a grand-daughter of Forty Niner. The Ashford stallion

sired the Grade II turf winner Naissance Royale (Ire) from a Forty Niner mare.

Clever Babe is a half-sister to Irish Smoke, winner of the GI Spinaway S. in 2007. The next dam, the winning sprinter Added Time, is a sister to Added Gold, winner

of the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. over a mile and an eighth. Book Review's third dam, the Grade III seven-furlong winner Added Elegance, also produced another graded winner in Added Asset, so this is a solid enough family. The fifth dam, Vit Reina, was an outstanding performer in South America, where she won the Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini.

Clever Babe is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector, so her pedigree is similar to those of the Grade I winners Commentator (3x4), I'll Have Another's sire Flower Alley (3x3) and Fourty Niners Son (3x4). Other Distorted Humors inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector include the Grade II winners Sharp Humor and Regal Ransom.

There were many trainers who gave us an opportunity, but I might not have won the championship without Jamie Ness, who trusted me the entire year." 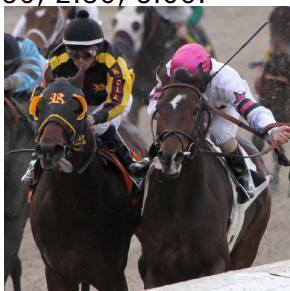

### Baffert Releases Tweebster Statement:

Yesterday, trainer Bob Baffert issued a statement pertaining to the death of **Tweebster** (Tapit), a 5-year-old gelding who was euthanized after sustaining a serious leg injury following a claiming race at Santa Anita Dec. 30. The multiple graded stakes-placed runner had failed to hit the board since February and was entered for a \$12,500 tag in Saturday's race in which he finished fifth. The conditioner's statement follows:

We all know racing is a sport of extreme highs and lows, and there is nothing lower than the death of a horse. When the public's perception is that you are somehow responsible, it makes the pain all the greater. Not only am I distressed over the death of this tough, gallant horse, I am deeply troubled by the comments on social media. They insinuate Tweebster's death was a result of my dropping him down for a \$12,500 claiming tag, suggesting the horse was unsound and I was merely trying to get rid of him.

I respect and fully appreciate the sensitivity regarding the well-being of animals, so I feel I owe it to everyone to explain the events that led to Tweebster's injury and subsequent death. As is required, Tweebster was thoroughly examined by the state veterinarian yesterday morning and found to be perfectly sound going into the race. The decision to run him in this particular race was not based on a lack of soundness, but rather a lack of races available for him at higher claiming prices. Tweebster was healthy and happy. I felt he was in need of a confidence booster and thought this would be an easy spot for him to get it. I understand a severe drop in class can indicate a horse is unsound, but I assure you that was not the case with Tweebster. Just before the race, heavy rain and hail poured down, making the track more muddy and heavier. The horse was moving great and his jockey says he felt comfortable throughout the race. It wasn't until after the finish that Martin [Garcia] felt him take a bad step. We brought him back to the barn in hopes of saving him, but knew quickly that wasn't going to be the case.

I have run horses at lower levels in the past and seen them regain their old form by getting their confidence back. Sometimes I have had the horses claimed from me in the process and they have gone on to win stakes and allowance races for other owners and trainers. I realize that is part of the claiming game.

The death of any horse on the racetrack is hard to accept. When that horse is one who you saw and took care of every day, the pain is physically gut-wrenching. While I realize some people are going to think what they want, I want to express my feelings and deepest regret over the loss of a horse for whom I had a great deal of affection.
