HOT NIGHT AT GOLD COAST

A buoyant night session of the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, led by a A\$500,000 daughter of Fastnet Rock (Aus), brought the gross to A\$67,677,500 over the course of four days. Last

year's gross at this stage was A\$62,570,000. The average rose to A\$136,172 from A\$127,175, while the median remained ahead of 2012 at A\$105,000, compared to A\$100,000. The trimmed session was held after a

day of racing at the Gold Coast Turf Club just across the road, and buyers were cautioned that bids would not be accepted from the bar.

"Tonight's session was very strong and from a catalogue of just 90 lots, for the average to rise again from yesterday is terrific," said Magic Millions Managing Director Vin Cox. "It has been an extremely strong sale. The most rewarding part was the support that we got from new vendors and buyers."

The leading buyer through Sessions 1-4 was Gai Waterhouse and James Harron Bloodstock, which signed the ticket on 27 lots for a total expenditure of A\$6,050,000 for an average of A\$224,074. Denise Martin's Star Thoroughbreds, whose purchases will eventually be trained by Waterhouse, was the second-leading buyer. Star Thoroughbreds was the name on the docket for 21 yearlings for a total of A\$2,355,000. Cox paid tribute to Waterhouse after Saturday's session concluded. **Cont. p3**

Csaba (Kitten's Joy) has come a long, long way since finishing a well-beaten sixth at 65-1 to Union Rags (Dixie Union) in last year's GII Fasig-Tipton Fountain of Youth S. less than a year ago, and figures around the 2-1 favorite in today's Gill Hal's Hope S., the main local prep for the GI Donn H. in a month's time. He carries a three-race winning streak into today's event and enters this off a thoroughly dominating victory over GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile third **Delegation** (Speightstown) in the Dec. 16 Harlan's Holiday S. over 8 1/2 furlongs. Interestingly enough, Csaba will race around one turn for just the third time in what will be his 17th career start and for the first time since winning his maiden sprinting at Calder at second asking. **Hal's Hope S. cont. p5**

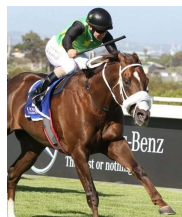

"Gai starts in October," Cox noted. "No one works harder in this business than Gai Waterhouse, bar none. She sees soft patches in the market and gets in."
 Yearlings expected to head overseas include the eight purchased for a total of A\$2,100,000 by the Hong Kong Jockey Club. The strength of the Australian currency did not deter bidding from foreign interests.
 "The percentage of overseas buyers is up from last year," Cox said. "Our dollar has been strong for several years now and it is seen as the norm, rather than the exception. We've had tremendous support from Hong Kong. We've been the beneficiary of 15-20 years of drawing on the best bloodlines in the world from America, Europe and Japan, and I think that's reflected in the results."

Fast Times at Gold Coast...

Lot 597, a Fastnet Rock (Aus) filly consigned by Tyreel Stud, had an attractive page and set an early standard during the night session that would be unmatched. Produced by a stakes-placed sibling to Starspangledbanner (Aus) (Choisir {Aus}), a champion sprinter in Australia and Europe, the bay was at the center of a bidding clash between Sydney-based trainer Chris Waller and his Melbourne counterpart Peter Moody. Waller eventually prevailed at A\$500,000 and said that he would put together a partnership to race the filly.
 "She should be easy to sell," Waller said. "She seems special, a lovely horse with an excellent pedigree. She's by Fastnet Rock out of a speed mare and Starspangledbanner sticks out. These pedigrees are hard to get and you have to pay more to get into them."
 Immediately after signing the ticket, Waller received a bottle of Johnnie Walker Blue, courtesy of Magic Millions. Asked if that would be opened on the night, Waller quipped, "Whoever buys into her can have it."
 Tyreel Stud offered the filly on behalf of breeder Makybe. Her dam produced a Choisir filly Aug. 28.

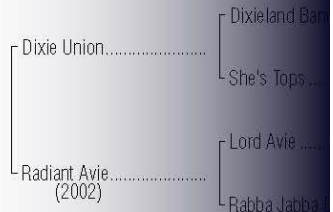

Ingordo also secured one of the last yearlings to sell Saturday, buying lot 659 for A\$370,000.

The Medaglia d'Oro colt is out of Kylikwong (Aus) (Red Ransom), who was runner-up in both the G1 VRC Oaks and G1 Australasian Oaks. She is a full-sister to the ill-fated Australian Horse of the Year Typhoon Tracy (Aus).

Over the course of four sessions, Ingordo signed the ticket on 12 yearlings for a total of A\$2,230,000.

Americain Anthem...

World traveller Americain (Dynaformer--America {Ire}, by Arazi) is just about to embark on his breeding career in his Kentucky birthplace, but the dark bay stallion will later shuttle to the scene of his greatest triumph. Adam Sangster's Swettenham Stud, based in Nagambie, Victoria, will stand the 2010 G1 Melbourne Cup hero during the Southern Hemisphere breeding season.

"We'd been interested in the horse for quite some time," Sangster confirmed. "He's a bit of an attraction down here. We've stood Melbourne Cup winners before--Jeune and At Talaq--and he does have a quality about him."

Originally campaigned in France by his breeders, Alain and Gerard Wertheimer, Americain secured the 2009 G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier and was later sold to a group of Australians including Gerald Ryan and Kevin and Colleen Bamford. He captured the G2 Prix Kergorlay the following year before winning the G3 Geelong Cup in his first start down under. Two weeks later, Americain posted a stylish win in the "race that stops a nation" at Flemington ([video](#)). He won 11 of 34 overall starts and amassed over \$5.78 million.

No 'Doute' About It...

The progeny of Redoute's Choice (Aus) have been in demand at this venue, and lot 602 set the standard for his sire Saturday night when bloodstock agent David Ingordo made the winning A\$460,000 bid. Consigned by Newhaven Park, the bay is the first foal from Hades (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}), who is herself a daughter of the swift Hasna (Aus) (Snippets {Aus}). After finishing a troubled third in the 2003 G1 Golden Slipper, the bay annexed the G1 Sires' Produce S. and G1 Champagne S. She earned over A\$1.2 million and was named Australia's champion juvenile.

"He's a fine horse and we're very happy to get him," Ingordo said. "He comes from a breeder who does an excellent job, and they had one of the best groups here."

Stallions who throw fast-maturing offspring have been especially popular in recent years in Australasia, but Sangster believes Americain can forge a new path.

"There is [an emphasis on precocity], but he is out of an Arazi mare, so some of them might come up early,"

he said. "It is a good Wertheimer family."

Americain's dam America, a half-sister to Group 2 and multiple Group 1-placed Majorien (GB) (Machiavellian), collected the G2 Prix de Malleret and G3 Prix Vanteaux as a 3-year-old.

"Standing a stayer is a bit like a government bond--you

trust that it will eventually pay dividends," Sangster speculated. "There is a focus on 2-year-old racing here, but there is a lot of prize money for middle-distance horses as well. While it may be a challenge, he is a very good-looking horse with an excellent turn of foot."

Americain will stand at Swettenham for A\$12,500.

Hal's Hope S. cont.

While several of these will be using the Hal's Hope as a possible steppingstone for the Donn, the same is likely not true for Sullivan Lane Stable & Dennis Narlinger's **Associate** (Wando). No worse than third in any of his last eight starts, the chestnut attended a fast pace and took a Belmont allowance going the one-turn mile Sept. 22, but couldn't outquick Buffum (Bernardini) in the GIII Bold Ruler H. over seven furlongs and settled for third.

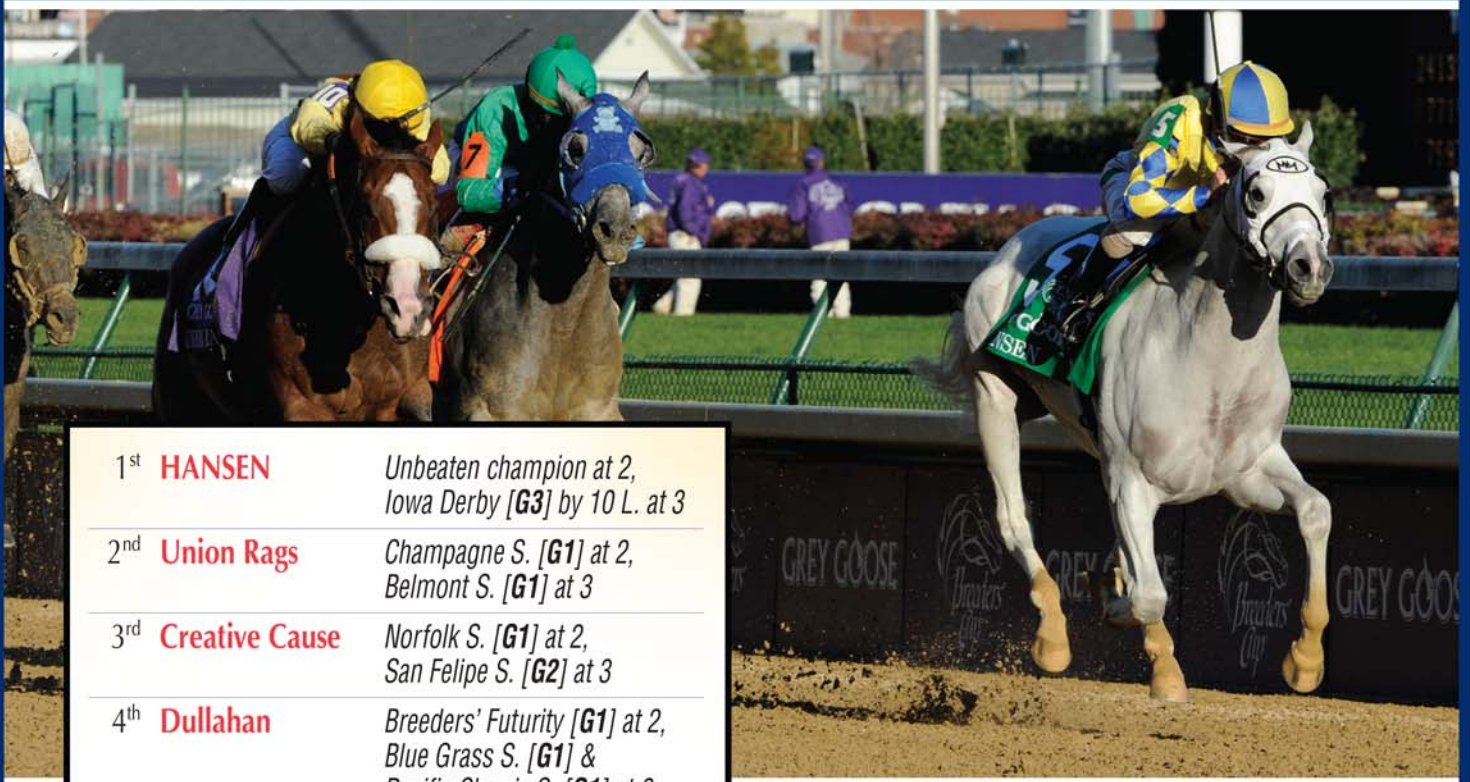

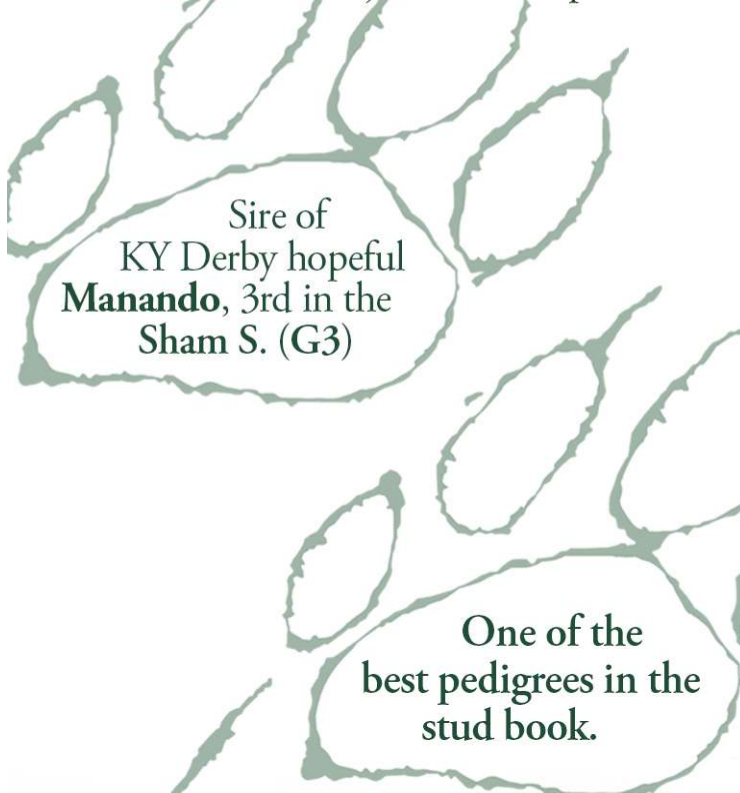

Real Surreal was offered at the Magic Millions Premier Sale, but was led out unsold with a A\$75,000 reserve. The bay filly hails from the first crop of Real Saga (Tale of the Cat), winner of the G2 Todman S. and third in the G1 Blue Diamond S. He stands at Glenlogan Park Stud.

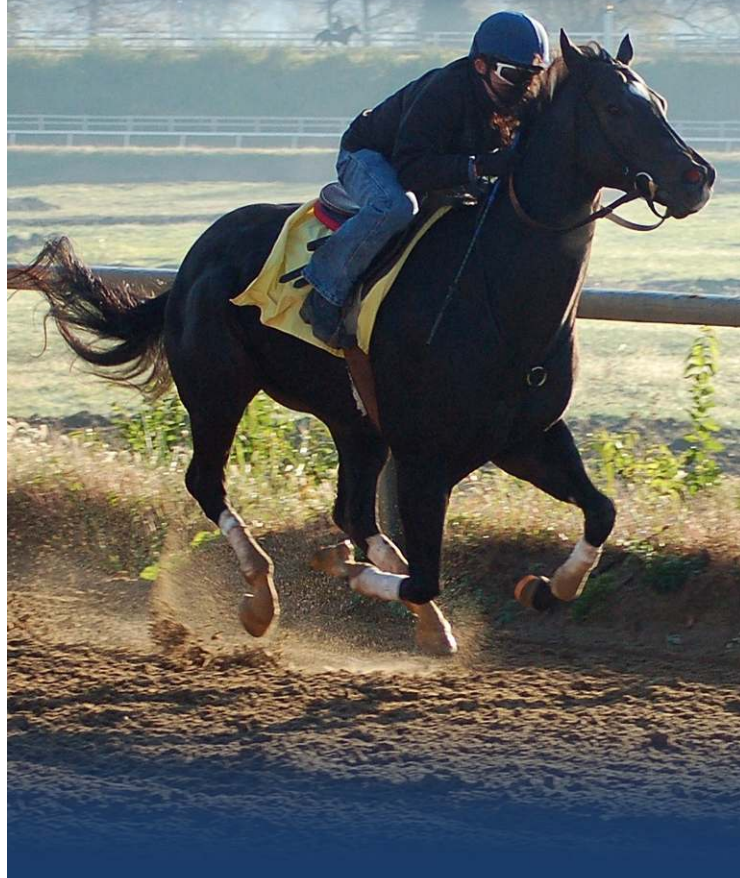

NYSRWB ORDERING NECROPSIES

The New York State Racing and Wagering Board has ordered necropsies of all future fatal racing breakdowns on the inner dirt track at Aqueduct after three horses died from injuries suffered at the Queens track in a span of three racing days this week.

In addition, it said that bodies of two horses that died from injuries on the inner track will be examined.

A year ago, when 21 horses suffered fatal injuries in races at Aqueduct, Governor Andrew Cuomo appointed the New York Task Force on Racehorse Health and Safety to investigate the matter. The task force's lengthy report, released to the public Sept. 28, made a number of recommendations, including necropsies. The board quickly adopted many of those recommendations, but said in an Oct. 11 press release that increased and enhanced necropsy procedures would require collaboration with the New York Racing Association.

Following the death of Pleasantfriday, who was euthanized Thurs., Jan. 10, the board decided to immediately require necropsies following all racing-related deaths. Bomber Boy and Wildcat's Smile were euthanized after suffering catastrophic injuries in separate incidents Sunday, Jan. 6.

The three deaths brought to four the number of horses who have died as the result of racing injuries since Aqueduct's inner-track season opened on Dec. 12. According the board's database, El Macho was euthanized on Dec. 14, the day after he suffered leg injuries in the first race of the program.

Four horses, Paci Di Notte, Missile Motor, Withalittlebit and Gultopper, died during Aqueduct's main-track season that ran from Nov. 3-Dec. 9.

"The Racing and Wagering Board continues to closely monitor and investigate the circumstances of every breakdown at Aqueduct," board spokesman Lee Park said in a statement. "Comprehensive investigative reports for the four equine fatalities from the inner track meet are being completed by Board staff.

"Necropsies for two horses that have died at Aqueduct--Pleasantfriday and Gultopper--were ordered by the Board because circumstances of those incidents raised red flags with investigators and required more information. Going forward, the Board is ordering necropsies for all horses that are fatally injured while racing on the inner track at Aqueduct. The Racing and Wagering Board and the forthcoming Gaming Commission will continue to work with NYRA to establish a consistent procedure for the logistics of necropsies as recommended by the Task Force on Racehorse Health & Safety."

STEVENS BACK IN THE WINNER'S CIRCLE

Jockey Gary Stevens, who announced at the start of the year that he would return to the saddle after a seven-year hiatus, recorded the first victory of his comeback yesterday in the first race at Santa Anita aboard Glen Hill Farm's well-bred 3-year-old filly **Branding** (Street Sense) (see *California Report*) for trainer Tom Proctor. Stevens settled Branding off the pace during the early stages of the seven furlong affair before the pair made their move approaching the top of the stretch. They gained the lead in midstretch and won by 2 1/2 lengths. It was the third ride for Stevens since he made his return Jan. 6. "You can consider me a full-time rider," said Stevens, who also works as an analyst on HRTV. "They were getting with it the first quarter of a mile and I thought they might come back to me. My filly was traveling real well around the turn. She didn't really accelerate coming into the stretch, but they stopped pretty good." The three-time GI Kentucky Derby winning rider is named on four horses today at Santa Anita, including Tale of a Champion (Tale of the Cat) for trainer Kristin Mulhall in the GII San Gabriel S.
