

## NEWS 'FLASH': BAFFERT ONE-TWO IN LEWIS

Gary and Mary West's **Flashback** (Tapit), a full-brother to the talented Zazu, followed his sharp debut win going seven furlongs at Betfair Hollywood Park Dec. 8 with a smooth front-running success in Saturday's two-turn GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita. It was 6 1/4 lengths back to fellow Bob Baffert runner **Den's Legacy** (Medaglia d'Oro) in second. "We were hoping he would do something like that, but when a horse came to him, he pinned his ears a little bit," Baffert commented. "He's still pretty green." As for what's next, the Hall of Famer continued, "Right now, I don't know. I'll speak with Gary [West], we'll just figure out a plan for him and just keep him healthy.

Right now, I can't think that far ahead. We knew he was a special horse, and to win the Robert B. Lewis is really a sentimental win for me, because he was one of the greatest owners in the sport. ## SKY HIGH

**Falling Sky** (Lion Heart), the \$425,000 topper from the OBS January Mixed Sale a few weeks back ([TDN Coverage](#)), was cross-entered for Saturday's GII Hutcheson S. going seven furlongs at Gulfstream Park, but trainer John Terranova was eager to try two turns with the colt. The plan came together when **Falling Sky** led from gate to wire to defeat **Dynamic Sky** (Sky Mesa) by a neck in the GIII Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa yesterday. "This is why we bought him," Terranova commented. "We thought he would be a natural route horse. Nick Sallusto suggested the purchase, and we put together a few of our big clients and went and got him for this reason. We cross-entered him in the Hutcheson because we weren't sure if now was the time to stretch him to two turns or to continue the natural progression, but obviously it looks like we made the right call." **Cont. p4**

## 'DILLON' GETS IT DONE IN HUTCHESON

Just minutes after **Flashback** (Tapit) took the GII Robert B. Lewis S. at Santa Anita, Joseph Bucci's **Honorable Dillon** (Tapit) scored a graded stakes double for his sire in Gulfstream's GII Hutcheson S. Backed down to 5-2 from an 8-1 morning line, the grey parlayed a stalking trip into a half-length score over late-running favorite **Forty Tales** (Tale of the Cat), who just nosed out **Undrafted** (Purim) for second. **Cont. p5**

## ON THE WARPATH

WinStar Farm's **Revolutionary** (War Pass), a runaway maiden winner in his two-turn bow over the Big A inner surface Dec. 28, overcame some Belt Parkway-like traffic in the stretch to secure an improbable neck victory as the 3-5 chalk over 16-1 **Escapefromreality** (Read the Footnotes) in the GIII Withers S. "Obviously, things didn't go well out of the gate, but he hung in there and Javier [Castellano] did a nice job of being patient," WinStar's Elliott Walden commented. "Finally, when he got some room, he came running. When you're looking at a race like the Derby, potentially down the road, to get that kind of experience, it's invaluable." Walden continued, "It was nice to see him come running like that. He couldn't blow out a match in the winner's circle. We'll talk with Todd [Pletcher] and we'll see. I'd be inclined to take him to Florida and regroup until that last round of preps. Probably just one more race [before the Derby]. This race was worth three in terms of education." **Cont. p4**

favoring in the Lewis, the gray took control from his inside post to show the way through an opening quarter in :24.17. With Julien Leparoux aboard, Flashback raced under a loose rein while pressed on the outside by He's Had Enough

through a half in :48.69, but still had plenty left when it mattered most, roaring off the turn and exploding down the stretch in a dominating performance. "I think he's still a little green--it was an easy race, we won easy, and this is a nice horse," Leparoux said. "If he keeps improving, I think he has a bright future. He was great changing leads, even on the backside he switched to his right lead right away. I had no problem with that. I think he will improve off this race, and I can't wait to ride him next time out. Many thanks to Bob Baffert and the owner. It's a pleasure to ride these kind of horses."

Revolutionary overcame a nightmare break to finish a promising third as the chalk in his Saratoga unveiling Sept. 3. Freshened, he disappointed as the 1-5 favorite when a clear-cut second to Little Distorted (Distorted Humor) at Belmont Oct. 28, then was third behind next-out winner Orb (Malibu Moon) when stretched to a mile at the Big A Nov. 24. Heavily favored off the strength of his aforementioned impressive maiden victory, good for a 102 Beyer, he was off a beat slow here as the neighboring Long River (A.P. Indy) stumbled horribly out of the stalls. Revolutionary never looked quite comfortable while buried along the inside through an opening quarter in :24.22, and was last of eight through a half in :48.18. The WinStar colorbearer began to advance on the turn for home, but was still dressed up with nowhere to go when the field of eight straightened for home. With Castellano remaining cool in the irons, Revolutionary was finally guided out in the stretch and finished up full of run along the inside to nail Escapefromreality on the wire.

Previously owned by Armachan Stable and Off The Hook LLC and trained by Antonio Sano, Falling Sky rolled in his Calder debut Nov. 1, then reported home a decent fourth in Tampa's Inaugural S. Dec. 1. The bay got back on track with a sharp optional claiming tally at Gulfstream Dec. 15, then switched hands for a sale-topping \$425,000 at the OBSJAN sale. Making his first start beyond 6 1/2 furlongs here, Falling Sky was hustled to the front from his outside post to lead through an opening quarter in :23.49 with Divine Ambition (Divine Park) glued to his flank. Challenged from every angle at the top of the stretch as Speak Logistics (High Cotton) was checked sharply along the fence, Falling Sky fought off all comers and had just enough left in the tank to get the money. A rider's claim of foul from Angel Serpa aboard Speak Logistics wasn't allowed.

Third on debut at the Spa July 28, Honorable Dillon donned cap and gown by 1 3/4 lengths from GII Remsen S. show horse Delhomme (Dixie Union) back at that venue Aug. 25. He was beaten 3/4 of a length by Singanothersong

(Songandaprayer) going a sixteenth shorter Jan. 4, but was off at significantly lower than that foe's 19-1 odds here. Honorable Dillon was kept in the clear in fourth early as Singanothersong posted splits of :22.07 and :44.64. He inched closer to confront Undrafted--who had taken over from the pacesetter late on the turn--and engaged that rival in upper stretch. Undrafted put up a game fight, but the green Honorable Dillon finally leveled off in the final sixteenth to pull clear, as the eventual runner-up came flying down the center of the track with a head-turning late rally. "He relaxed beautifully and stalked on the outside and really dug in," offered winning trainer Eddie Kenneally. "He was a little green and was on the wrong lead in the stretch, but he gutted it out. He's determined. He's a nice horse." Of what might be next, the conditioner said, "We'll talk with the owner and come up with a plan...we may try [to stretch him out]. We'd like to try at some point. He's bred to go farther than seven eighths of a mile. Can he do it? We'll find out when we try. The [seven-panel Mar. 2 GIII] Swale is a definite possibility." We gave him some time, and had him at Laurel, Delaware and Monmouth and he wasn't doing what I wanted. I said, 'He's an Aqueduct horse, let's get him home to Aqueduct.' I sent him to Rudy [Rodriguez], and he's getting better all the time. I'm just thrilled with him."

Suggestive Boy broke his maiden at second asking in Group 1 company in 2011 and added three more wins at the highest level, including the G1 Gran Premio Jockey Club to close out that portion of his career. He gave an excellent account of himself in his U.S. debut, running second to Jeranimo (Congaree) in the GI Shoemaker Mile S. last June 30 ahead of a victory in the restricted Wickerr H. at Del Mar the following month. A big-figure fifth behind Dullahan (Even the Score) in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 26, the bay was a midpack fifth in the GI Awesome Again S. in the only try of his career on dirt Sept. 29 and was a latest seventh to Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Nov. 3. Drawn one from the outside here, the lukewarm favorite was unable to get in during the opening furlongs and was forced to race three wide around the first turn, but secured cover behind GIII Sir Beaufort S. hero Silenzio for the run up the backstretch. Joe Talamo began to get after his mount, and he steered Suggestive Boy off heels and three wide traveling well at the quarter pole. Wilkinson tried to match strides inside the winner passing the eighth pole, but Suggestive Boy accelerated away nicely to score by a comfortable margin. "The post position today, I was a little worried about," admitted trainer Ron McAnally. "But he managed to get him over before the turn. That was all I was concerned about. Once he got him over, I was comfortable. He's a good horse."

While the long layoff is always a question mark, the bay had been working steadily at Pletcher's Palm Meadow base, turning in a bullet five-furlong move on the turf in 1:00 Jan. 21, and most recently went four furlongs in :50 3/5 Jan. 27. Receiving first time Lasix here and securing the services of Joel Rosario, Old Tune was fastest from the gate, and held the lead on the fence into the first turn. She relinquished the advantage to Awesome Belle (Awesome of Course) heading into the backstretch, and was content to sit just off that leader through opening splits of :23 and :46 2/5. Reclaiming the lead entering the far turn, Old Tune hit the quarter pole 1 1/2 lengths in front and well in hand. ## Triple Crown Draws 369 Nominees...

The early nomination period for the 2013 Triple Crown closed Jan. 26 with 369 3-year-olds nominated for the GI Kentucky Derby, GI Preakness, and GI Belmont S. That number is down 7.3% from 398 last year. Heading the list is Starlight Racing, Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's Eclipse champion 2-year-old male **Shanghai Bobby** (Harlan's Holiday), who suffered his first defeat in the GIII Holy Bull S. Jan. 26. The dual Grade I winner is trained by Todd Pletcher, who leads the trainers category with 29 nominated, including GI CashCall Futurity winner **Violence** (Medaglia d'Oro), multiple graded stakes winner **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union) and **Verrazano** (More Than Ready), who remained unbeaten in two starts with an impressive allowance victory at Gulfstream yesterday. Other highlights among the nominations include John Oxley's multiple graded stakes winning **Uncaptured** (Lion Heart); GIII Holy Bull S. victor **Itsmyluckyday** (Lawyer Ron); GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner up **He's Had Enough** (Tapit); and multiple graded stakes winner and Grade I placed **Goldencents** (Into Mischief).

Nine of the horses nominated are based overseas with Irish trainers Dermot Weld (four) and Aidan O'Brien (two). Seven fillies have been nominated, headed by Eclipse champion 2-year-old filly **Beholder** (Henny Hughes) and GI Frizette winner **Dreaming of Julia** (A.P. Indy).

The majority of the nominees (352) were bred in the U.S., with 71% foaled in Kentucky. Seventeen were bred outside the U.S., including 11 Canadian-breds.

The early nomination period required an entry fee of \$600. Horses may still be entered for \$6,000 during the late nomination period, which is now underway and runs through Mar. 23. Last year, 20 were added during the late nominations period.

### Duo Breeze for Donn; 'Mucho' to Pass...

WinStar Farm and Chuck and Maribeth Sandford's **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy), second behind Shackleford (Forestry) in the GI Clark H. Nov. 23, tuned up for next Saturday's GI Donn H. with a four-furlong bullet in :47.02 at Palm Meadows Saturday. "He was sharp," trainer Pat Byrne said of the 2012 GI Florida Derby hero. "I wanted to put a little speed in him and stretch his legs. He actually went three-eighths in :34 2/5 and galloped out in :47. We're all set and looking forward to next Saturday." Bruce Hollander and Cary Shapoff's **Csaba** (Kitten's Joy) worked four furlongs in :50.60 at Calder yesterday. "He's doing good and looked good this morning," trainer Phil Gleaves said. "It's a big test for us and most of the horses in the race. It's a quality Donn field." Csaba heads to the Donn riding a four-race winning streak, most recently annexing Gulfstream's GIII Hal's Hope S. Jan. 13.

Reeves Thoroughbred Racing's **Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno), eased while defending his title over a sloppy track in the Sunshine Millions Classic Jan. 19, will not be entered in the Donn. "After considering the Donn as an option, we've decided to pass," trainer Kathy Ritvo said. "It does not fit as well into our long-term objectives for Mucho Macho Man as others do."

### Caviar Gallops in Front of Fans at Flemington...

Superstar sprinter **Black Caviar** (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) galloped in front of her adoring fans in between races at Flemington yesterday as she eyes a return to racing. The 6-year-old was last seen narrowly defending her perfect 22-for-22 record in Royal Ascot's G1 Diamond Jubilee S. last June, but exited that performance with torn muscles in her back. "She's enjoying it," trainer Peter Moody told *Racing and Sports* as the three-time World Champion Sprinter dragged pilot Luke Nolen around. "She's happy and that's as important as anything else with her." Moody continued, "This is the best that we've had to work with in a long time. Her muscles and joints are good and she's happy." Black Caviar is expected to make her first start back in Flemington's G1 Lightning S., which was renamed in her honor and kicks off the Global Sprint Challenge, in two weeks' time. "The last time we saw her, there were bits and pieces falling off all over the place," co-owner Gary Wilkie told *Racing and Sports*. "But this was fantastic. We will go on to the race in two weeks and then have another look at her. There's plenty of races, but we'll take notice of whatever the trainer says. 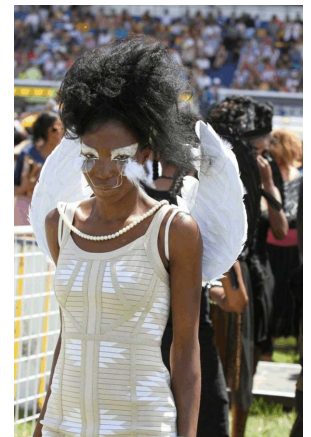

He could now go for the Durban July."

**CHRB Report Shows Increased Fatalities:**

An annual report issued Friday by the California Horse Racing Board showed that equine fatalities rose as a whole at the state's racetracks for the period of July 2011 through June 2012. A total of 278 fatalities were recorded during that time frame, an increase of 4.9%. Of those, 207 were related to racing or training--a 10.1% increase--and the remaining 71 were attributable to non-exercise rated causes. The state had a total of 265 fatalities during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, of which 186 were racing or training accidents. The news was especially grim at Santa Anita, where nearly twice the horses (59) died in fiscal year 2012 versus the previous period (30). Del Mar recorded 12 racing/training fatalities, a 50% bump from the previous year.

Dan Excel, joint-favored at 7-2, was stymied for a run behind Beauty Lead in the lane and dove down to the fence for a final rally. ## ON TO CLASSIC CUP FOR MIZANI, SUNNY YING

**Mizani (Ire)** (Bachelor Duke) and **Sunny Ying (GB)** (Haafhd {GB}) punched their respective tickets to the HK\$6-million (\$773,560) Hong Kong Classic Cup Feb. 17 with handicap victories Saturday afternoon at Sha Tin. Mizani, one of three Hong Derby hopefuls for trainer Richard Gibson, was winning for the second time in two starts in Hong Kong, having broken his

local maiden going 1400-meters Jan. 6. Sent off the 7-5 chalk, Mizani was off a beat slowly, but eagerly tugged Olivier Doleuze into fourth before settling down a bit. Still patiently ridden into the stretch, the gelding was switched off heels into the three path, but looked in some trouble, as top-

weighted Let Me Handle It (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) came to tackle at the furlong grounds. But Doleuze got after Mizani and he re-broke to post a neck success ([video](#)). "Olivier Doleuze has always really estimated this horse," said Gibson, whose 4-year-old riches also include Hong Kong Classic Mile hero Gold-Fun (Ire) (Le Vie Dei Colori {GB}) and expensive import Akeed Mofeed (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}). "I thought he rode him in a very smooth, professional, confident manner today. He has a lot of faith in this horse and we've got some options--with good horses like this you can consider absolutely everything. We learn more about the horse after every run, and today was an excellent performance." The less-heralded Sunny King will be pointed for the Classic Cup off a narrow victory over that race's 1800-meter trip Saturday. A 5-1 chance off an improved fourth going a mile Jan. 20, Sunny Ying traveled midpack on the turn and had plenty to do in upper stretch, but found his best stride late and was up in the shadow of the post ([video](#)). "That was a gem of a ride, one of the best I've seen all season on one of my horses" said trainer John Moore. "It was a dour staying effort and the further he goes the better. Now we go on to the Classic Cup next--he's only going to be rated 81 or 82 but that's what we bought him for."

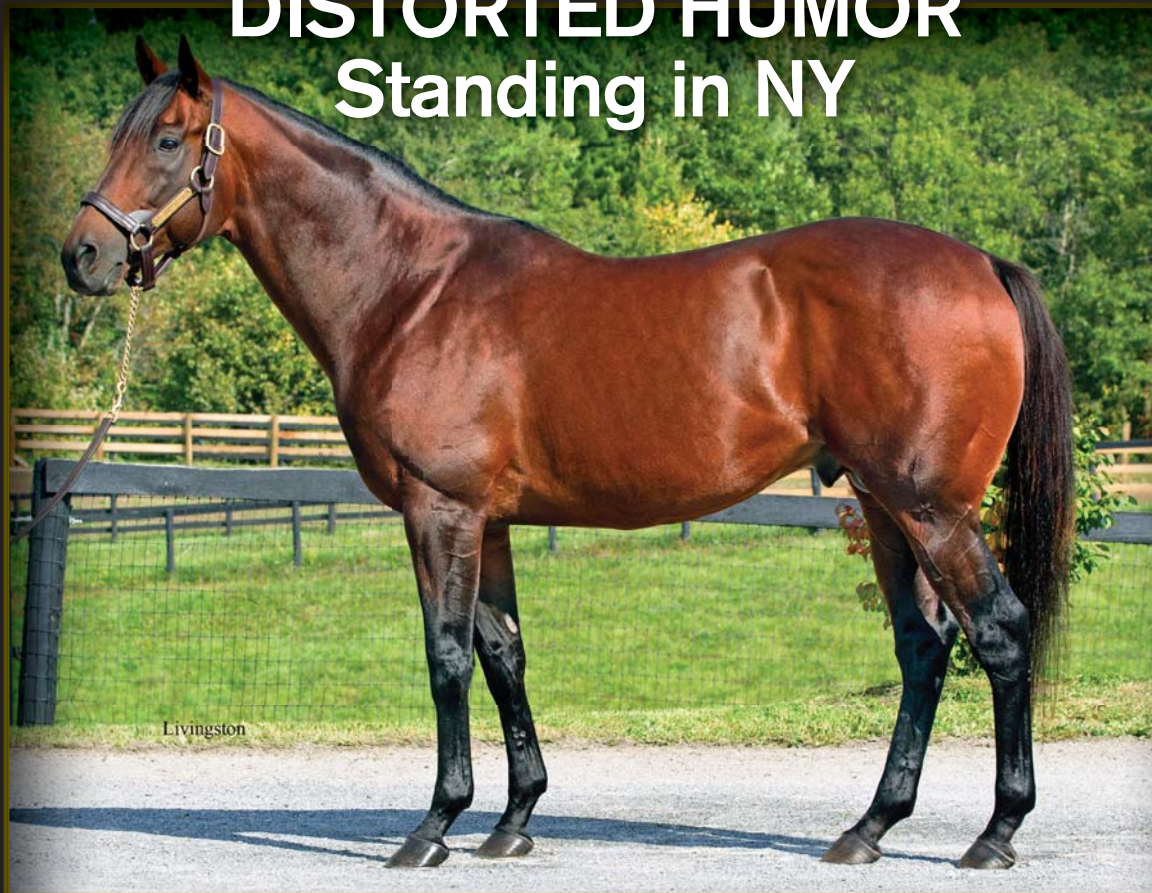
