SAME OLD DUDE IN SAN ANTONIO

Just three foes lined up to take on accomplished multiple Grade I winner **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) in yesterday's GII San Antonio S. in Arcadia, and it looked more like a one-horse race at the finish. Backed all the way down to 1-9 off a bounce-back win in the GIII Native Diver S. at Betfair Hollywood Park Dec. 1, the 6-year-old gelding did not make an easy lead, but it didn't matter. **Game On Dude** was pestered by an eager **Basmati** (Borrego) going into the first turn, and rider Mike Smith did his best to keep his mount

calm as the pair traded jabs down the backstretch through a half in :46.78. The chalk left his antagonist in the dust late on the home turn, and braced for a challenge from **Clubhouse Ride** (Candy Ride {Arg}), who was traveling with ominous ease approaching the stretch. The possibility of an upset was short-lived, however, as **Game On Dude** quickly spurred clear in the run to the wire without any real encouragement from Smith. **Cont. p3**

Point of Entry Gets in Final Work for GP Turf...

Point of Entry (Dynaformer) got in his final breeze at Payson Park Sunday as he eyes a showdown with the likes of **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) and **Unbridled Command** (Master Command) in Saturday's GI Kitten's Joy Gulfstream Park Turf H., covering four furlongs on the main track in :47.40. "He shaded 48 [seconds for four furlongs]-- he went very well," trainer Shug McGaughey said of the three-time Grade I winner. The 5-year-old will be making his first start of 2013 in the nine-furlong event, and first since Frank Stronach purchased a 50% racing and 100% breeding stake in the Phipps Stable homebred. "I'm looking forward to it," McGaughey said. "This is no win-at-all-risk type of situation. It's only February. Our main objective is the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Turf] next fall. How I get him there, we'll see, but so far, so good." **Point of Entry** was last seen finishing second by a nose with some traffic trouble to **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) in the Nov. 3 BC Turf at Santa Anita.

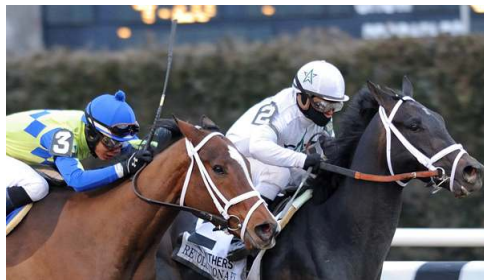

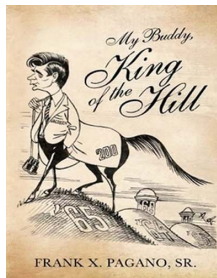

Same Old Dude in San Antonio cont. from p1

Game On Dude followed up a successful 2011 that included a pair of Grade I wins and a runner-up effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic with a very similar 5 1/4-length romp in this event a year ago. A fruitless trip to Dubai for the G1 Dubai World Cup came next, but the dark bay proved no worse for wear when he annexed the GII Californian S. at Hollywood by 7 1/4 lengths in June. He bested then-stablemate Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) in the following month's GI Hollywood Gold Cup H., but was nipped by sophomore invader Dullahan (Even the Score) in Del Mar's GI Pacific Classic S. Aug. 26. He upped his record over this track to five-for-five with a facile tally from Nonios (Pleasantly Perfect) in the GI Awesome Again S. Sept. 29, and stood firmly atop the handicap division going into the Breeders' Cup Classic Nov. 3. The 13-10 choice was

a surprising no-show seventh that day, but dismissed that effort as nothing more than a fluke with a 1 1/4-length defeat of Nonios in the Native Diver. "You know, I got pressured, even more so than if it was a full field, believe it or not," Smith said of his trip. "In these short fields people make you do things because it's more of a match race. He has a high, high cruising speed and you just let him get into his rhythm whether that's up front or off the lead. I let him do his thing today and he ran brilliantly. He stood up over on the turn, took one breath and turned around like it was nothing. They were running quick, but that's just him." Trainer Bob Baffert, who also took the GII Robert B. Lewis S. with Flashback (Tapit) and GII Strub S. with Guilt Trip (Pulpit) Saturday, said that Game On Dude would be pointed to the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 2. When asked how the San Antonio might have set Game On Dude up for that spot, Smith said, "Really well. This is an extremely talented horse, he might even be better this year. I never rode him last year, but I ran against him a few times. The feeling he gave me today was even more so than when I first rode him."

Co-owner Joe Torre, who races as Diamond Pride LLC and is best-known as the former manager of the New York Yankees, was on hand Sunday.

"I've seen [Game On Dude run] a number of times, but this is the first time I was able to see him since the Breeders' Cup," said Torre. "Obviously, we were disappointed that day, but he just keeps on going. He just seems to be such a great competitor. Again, I'm not an authority on horses. I sit next to Baffert whenever I can, and when he told me at the top of the stretch that he's got plenty left, I sort of relaxed a little bit."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

'Courage' and Castellano Get Acquainted for Donn...

Saturday's GI Donn H. at Gulfstream yesterday morning. The duo covered four panels over the main track in :48.31, good for the fifth-fastest of 45 works at the distance.

"Javier said he went good and felt great," trainer Kellyn Gorder said of the newly turned 4-year-old. "We just have to keep him happy for the rest of the week." When asked about the pace scenario Gorder is looking for for his late-running charge, the conditioner offered, "He doesn't need a speed duel or anything like that up front, but it would help him for there to be a legitimate pace to close into." A five-length winner of the GII Super Derby last September, Bourbon Courage will be making his first afternoon appearance since running third to Shackleford (Forestry) in the GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 23. He was a head behind fellow Donn contestant **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy). Leandro Goncalves had ridden Bourbon Courage in his last three starts.

Abaco Breezes for Suwanee River...

Trainer Shug McGaughey made it back to Gulfstream from Payson Park after overseeing Point of Entry (Dynaformer)'s work Sunday morning to observe fellow Phipps homebred **Abaco** (Giant's Causeway) prep for a tilt in Saturday's GIII Suwanee River S. The 5-year-old drilled four furlongs over the turf in :47.24--the fastest of five spins at the distance--alongside stablemate Scampering (Afleet Alex), who covered the same ground in :47.82. "She went nice," McGaughey said of Abaco, who will be seeking her fifth-straight win in her stakes debut Saturday. "I've been lucky to be able to use her conditions. She's come around, and this is another step for her. It's her first time in a stakes, and I'm sure it will be a very competitive field." The chestnut went from last to first in a one-mile third-level allowance in Hallandale last time Dec. 9. The Suwanee River will be run at nine furlongs--a distance at which Abaco cleared her first allowance condition at Belmont in September.

WinStar Farm's **Revolutionary** (War Pass), who overcame a nightmare trip to get up in the shadow of the wire in Saturday's GIII Withers S. at Aqueduct, will head to trainer Todd Pletcher's Florida base at Palm Meadows Tuesday as his connections mull over a final prep before the GI Kentucky Derby. Possible spots include the Mar. 30

GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream or the GI Wood Memorial S. back at Aqueduct Apr. 6. WinStar and Pletcher took last year's Wood with Gemologist (Tiznow). When asked about Revolutionary's trip in the Withers yesterday, assistant trainer Mike McCarthy said, "I was watching the replay of the race a little while ago, and there was nothing good about it except for the last two or three jumps. That may have been one of the worst winning trips I've ever seen."

Withers Runner-up Staying in New York...

Trainer Dominick Schettino said Sunday that GIII Withers S. runner-up **Escapefromreality** (Read the Footnotes) will remain on the New York leg of the Derby trail and will be pointed to Aqueduct's GIII Gotham S. Mar. 2 and GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 6. "We're planning on running in the Gotham and the Wood, depending on how he comes out of the race once we start him back training," Schettino said of the MaryEllen and Anthony Bonomo homebred. "We'll decide from there, but we'll point for the Gotham and Wood." The gelding was making his first start beyond six panels and first start outside of the New York-bred ranks. "I thought he ran exceptionally well [in the Withers], first time going two turns, lightly raced, coming out of two sprints, he rated," said the conditioner. "I'm very happy with the way he ran."

Tampa Stakes Times Adjusted...

The displayed times for turf races at Tampa Bay Downs Saturday have been revised due to a technical error discovered after the completion of the card involving electronic tracking and timing system Trakus. Due to an incorrect lane assignment, sectional times were inaccurate and produced final times that came back approximately two seconds too fast. **Old Tune (Brz)** (Wild Event), winner of the GIII Endeavour S., was originally credited with a 1 1/16-mile course record, but her official time of 1:41.48 came short of the 1:39.65 mark set by Legs Galore (Ogygian) in the 1999 Tampa Bay Breeders' Cup S. **Tapicat** (Tapit) retains her stakes record for the GIII Florida Oaks, as her 1:41.89 adjusted clocking was still faster than the previous record of 1:43.30 set by last year's winner Dixie Strike (Dixie Union). The Florida Oaks was first run on turf in 2011.

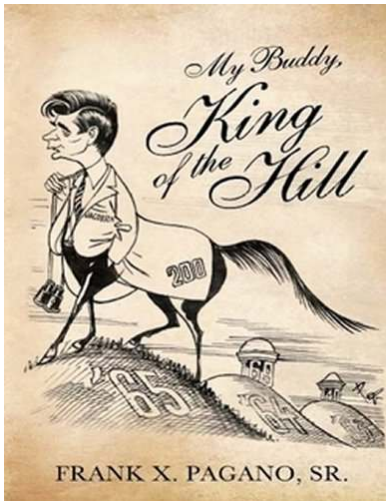

Book Review

MY BUDDY, KING OF THE HILL by Frank Pagano

Frank Pagano's recently published book My Buddy, King of the Hill chronicles the relationship between



Pagano and notorious trainer Howard 'Buddy' Jacobson. Jacobson, a successful New York claiming trainer in the 1960s and 70s, is now better remembered for his conviction in the 1978 murder of Jack Tupper. The "Upper-East Side Murder," as the press would call it, and Jacobson's subsequent escape from the Brooklyn House of Detention, have all but replaced any memory of his time on the track.

Pagano, a former assistant, hoped to restore some of his friend's legacy with this work, mentioning the murder in the introduction and final chapters of the book and leaving the rest of the story to describe the side of Jacobson that Pagano knew. As Pagano explains in the final page of the work, "It was not my intention to focus on the murder, the trial or the escape...His name cannot be cleared in a court of law and to me this was such a small part of who Howard Buddy Jacobson was...I want people to remember the person I knew. The man that was so much more than inmate number 80a3899."

The story of Jacobson's life is unsettling, both before the murder and after. Pagano details his numerous affairs and indiscretions with the biased judgement that only a friend can maintain in the midst of Jacobson's reckless behavior.

Although Jacobson is the main focus of the work, the setting of Aqueduct in the 60s and 70s plays a prominent role. Forgotten stories from New York racing history reemerge and become the most enjoyable aspect of the work. Pagano describes a young Bobby Frankel getting his start for the Jacobson barn and Nick Zito hurrying to leave the track after giving J. Edgar Hoover a bad pick. Jacobson was the first trainer in New York to employ a female jockey and Pagano recalls Jacobson's mostly promotional, but nonetheless barrier-breaking decision to hire Barbra Jo Rubin. Jacobson also spearheaded the 1969 NYRA backstretch worker's strike, which lasted just 10 days, but was one of the first movements for improved working conditions on the backside.

One of the more colorful stories Pagano shares is that of Lake Delaware, a horse Jacobson claimed out of spite after he was ignored by the horse's owner, New York Yankee's pitcher Whitey Ford. The conditioner would make waves with Lake Delaware when the horse won the Lovely Nights Handicap, a prestigious hurdles race in Saratoga. Such narratives bring a humanity to Jacobson.

Pagano's prose can be a bit choppy and repetitive at times, and it's clear he's not a writer by trade. However, he's still able to convincingly tell the story of Buddy Jacobson, preserving the memory of a successful trainer as Pagano intended and enriching the reader with a bit of history of New York horse racing.

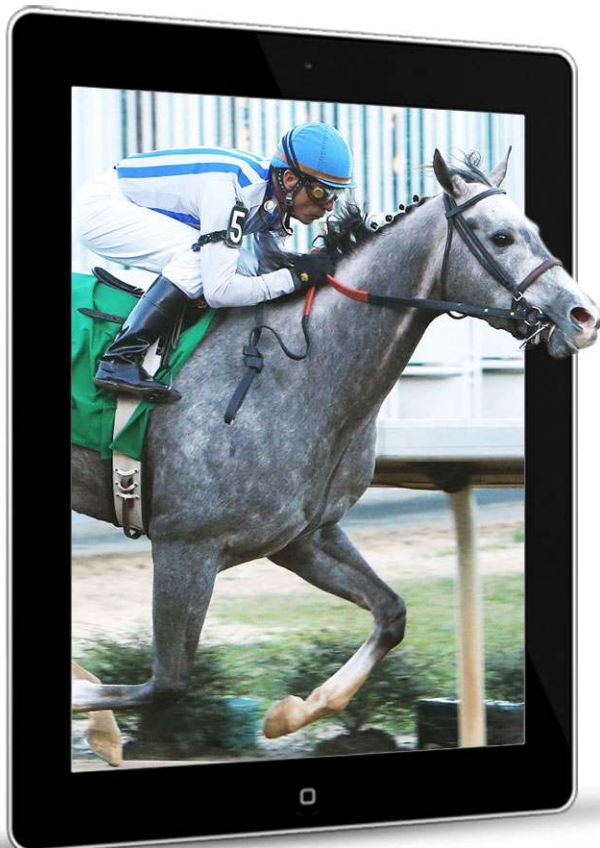

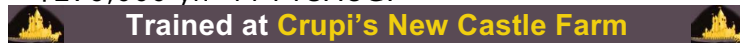
