CLASS INFUSION AT FTKFEB

Even in its first incarnation, the catalog for the 2013 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Winter Mixed Sale, to be held today at the sale's company's Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, looked to be particularly strong compared to previous years. But after the announcement that prominent owner/breeder Eugene Melnyk would be selling the majority of his breeding stock at the auction, the normally workmanlike event took on a downright bourgeois feel. The Taylor Made-consigned Melnyk horses, as well as 10 or so additional offerings from other consignors, swelled the catalog from 295 to 337. That nonetheless represents a 20% reduction in the size of last year's 425-strong book, which was led by the \$200,000 Fancy Prancer (Bertrando), whom Paramount Sales sold to Bluegrass Hall.

The Melnyk horses include Canadian Horse of the Year and GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf runner-up **Sealy Hill** (Point Given) ([hip 299](#)); the New York Grade I winner **Pool Land** (Silver Deputy) ([hip 327](#)); and Sovereign Award finalist and Grade II winner **Roxy Gap** (Indian Charlie) ([hip 314](#)).

Fasig-Tipton President and CEO Boyd Browning, Jr. talked yesterday about the late addition of the Melnyk mares. "We got a phone call from Taylor Made saying that Mr. Melnyk was considering selling these mares, and asked if it was something we could accommodate in, literally, a 2 1/2- or three-week window," he said. "I asked if they could send over a list of the mares, just so we could see what we were dealing with. They said, 'We don't have to send you a list--here are some of the names.' And after about five minutes, I said, 'Yeah, we can accommodate this!'"

The aforementioned Roxy Gap isn't the only Sovereign finalist in the supplemental catalogue. Apart from the Melnyk horses, Three Chimneys and clients will send the 6-year-old **Atlantic Hurricane** (Halo's Image)--already a Sovereign champion--through the ring, as well. Cataloged as [hip 306](#) as a broodmare prospect, the chestnut is nominated in the champion female sprinter category after a 2012 season that saw her win a second renewal of the Gill Ontario Fashion S. and place in three other Grade III races. Atlantic Hurricane was tabbed champion female sprinter in 2011 after a six-for-eight campaign that included wins in the Gill Seaway S. and Gill Bessarabian S.

MYSTERY GRABS BERTIE EN ROUTE TO KY

Farnsworth Stable's **Golden Mystery** (Awesome Again) had to make one last stop in Florida Sunday before heading north to Kentucky for Monday's Fasig-Tipton Winter Mixed Sale, dropping by the Gulfstream Park winner's circle to get her photo taken after running away with the Gill Hurricane Bertie S.

The victory was the first graded triumph of the 7-year-old's career, but it almost didn't happen.

"We weren't sure we were going to run," admitted trainer Marty Wolfson. "I sent her home [to Farnsworth Farm] for four or five days. She was going to the sale. When I found out [Gill Sugar Swirl S. winner] Dust and Diamonds (Vindication) got hurt, I told the owners I wanted to bring her back for this race. That was the filly to beat."

Golden Mystery sells Monday as a racing or broodmare prospect and Wolfson thinks the mare still has plenty of races left in the tank.

"I think she's a Breeders' Cup type," Wolfson said. "She's gotten so good. The older she gets, the better she's gotten. She's just happy."

“We’re just hoping for no traffic on I-75!” laughed Browning about the late-arriving Golden Mystery.

Hers was at least the second notable update to come out of Gulfstream Park in the last few days. On Thursday, the 4-year-old filly Pianist (More Than

Ready), already a stakes winner in New York, looked very good winning an optional claimer in Hallandale and will likely be returning to stakes company soon. Which makes her dam **Red Piano** (Red Ransom), selling in foal to Exchange Rate, an interesting prospect as [hip 5](#). Hunter Valley Farm consigns.

“Those are the kind of updates that really help, and sometimes with a sale, you’d rather be lucky than good,” said Browning. “It helps everybody, and creates excitement for buyers and sellers alike.”

An overcast Sunday afternoon in Lexington yesterday didn’t dissuade any buyers, and action looked strong throughout the barns. “I think there’s been good overall traffic at virtually every level,” said Browning. “The feedback we’ve gotten from consignors is that they’ve been busy, and every time I look up, I see a new face or two that I hadn’t seen. It’s been well-attended, and we’ve had a lot of interest. There’s been some bounce to this sale for two or three weeks now.”

Last year’s FTKFEB sale saw 270 horses sell for \$4,601,800. That was good for an average of \$17,044, up 10.5% from 2011. The median was \$6,000, up 5.1%. There were 76 horses that did not meet their reserve, a rate of 22%.

Golden Mystery stalked the pace as defending Hurricane Bertie champ **R Holiday Mood** (Trippi) set the pace through an opening quarter in :22.39. She moved to challenge for the lead after a half in :45.50 and spurred clear under a hand ride in upper stretch before sailing home an easy 3 1/2-length winner.

"I felt like I would win this race because I know this mare," explained jockey Luis Saez. "This is her favorite weather, too, because she has a problem sweating. Martin Wolfson told me when she is coming down the stretch to let her run. He wanted her in second or third position and that would be perfect for her. She was very easy, amazing."

Golden Mystery was purchased privately by Robert and Myron Miller's Farnsworth Farm before winning the Mongo Queen S. in 2011. She earned her first graded placing when second behind Dust and Diamonds in the Gill Sugar Swirl S. last December. Second again in the Dec. 30 Ocala S., the chestnut scored the biggest win of her career last time out with a 5 1/4-length victory in the Jan. 19 Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint.

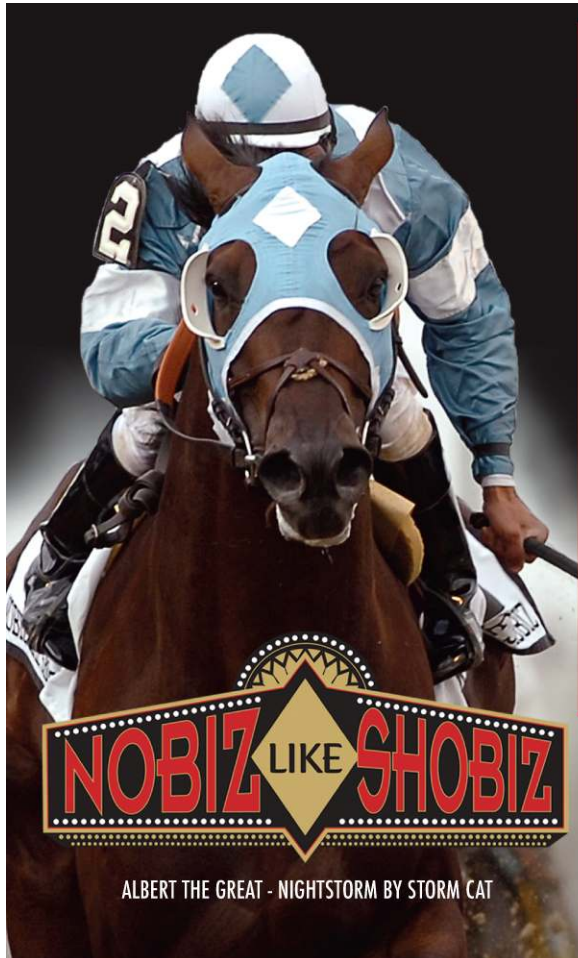

TREASURY BILL LOOKS TO STEP UP

Gary and Mary West, who already have GII Robert B. Lewis S. winner Flashback (Tapit) on the Kentucky Derby trail, will be looking to see if they have a second colt in the Derby discussion when **Treasury Bill** (Lemon Drop Kid) goes postward in Sunday's GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita. Trained by Ron Ellis, Treasury Bill is coming off a 1 1/4-length maiden win over 6 1/2 furlongs at Santa Anita Jan. 27 ([video](#)).

Ellis is looking for his charge, a \$230,000 Fasig-Tipton July yearling, to improve as the distances get longer than Sunday's seven-furlong event. "He's doing well, but seven-eighths of a mile against talented maiden winners, it's just not his ball game," Ellis commented. "We're just trying to get untracked for some of the bigger Derby preps. This will get another race under his belt, give him a little more experience and we'll move on to two turns."

Still, the trainer is happy with Treasury Bill's progress so far. "We're on an upward trajectory," Ellis said. "We just want to keep him doing that. We've still got a few months to go before the big ones. This won't be a big test for him because it's only around one turn, but his next race, when he runs in March, will be."



trainer Lon Wiggins, best known as the original connections of Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro), the \$45,000 KEESep yearling was a narrow runner-up sprinting over the Keeneland

Polytrack Oct. 5. She showed an obvious affinity for the site of the GI Kentucky Oaks with her next-out Churchill graduation, and soon became the highlight of the Morrison dispersal in Lexington. Getting Lasix here from new conditioner Bill Mott, who had already sent out a trio of 3-year-old fillies to earn the  **"TDN Rising Star"**  distinction this meet, the 1-2 chalk pressed the pace in the two path and asserted on the bend. She built up a clear edge by the time she hit the top of the lane, and required little encouragement to stretch her advantage to 4 3/4 lengths at the wire. Miss Patricia (Indian Charlie) just edged GI Spinaway S. runner-up Sweet Shirley Mae (Broken Vow) for second. "She looked like from her previous form she had some natural speed, which she did," said Mott of the winner. "What I was most pleased about was when [jockey] Joel [Rosario] took her back off the lead horse, she rated very kindly, wasn't rank, and was in a nice rhythm. The way the end of the race looked it seemed like she should go on. She had such a nice, easy comfortable stride going on the backside. She was a little itchy around the gate and wasn't running off. Joel had to ask her a little, but every time he did, she gave more and finished when he asked her."

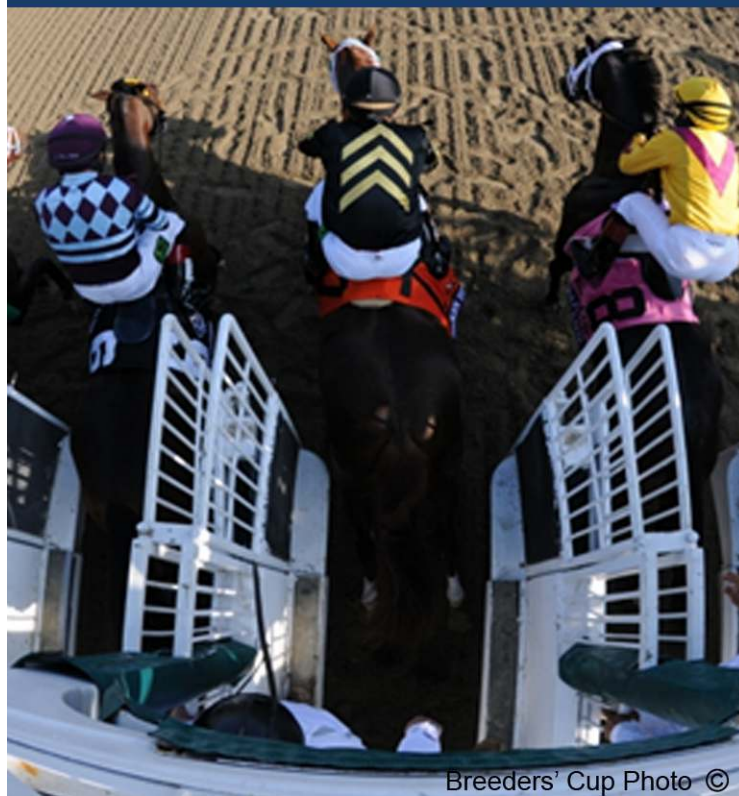
