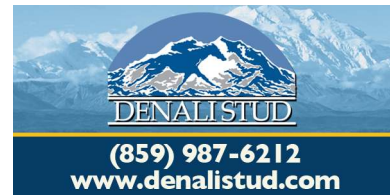

her defeat last winter, when she went down by a neck as the 7-10 chalk, but returns on just two weeks' rest off a taxing runner-up effort in the Correction H. at Aqueduct Feb. 2. "I haven't done much with her since her last start, but I am comfortable that she is coming into the race tight enough and

**RACHEL REMAINS IN SERIOUS CONDITION**

Officials at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital said Friday afternoon that Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro), admitted to the hospital Wednesday after foaling a filly by Bernardini, remained in 'serious' condition following surgery to repair a section of her small colon. The attending veterinarians on her case, Dr. Bonnie Barr and Dr. Brett Woodie, are pleased with her progress, with Dr. Barr calling her a "strong mare". Her vital signs remain normal and she was brighter, more alert and demonstrating an improved attitude on Friday afternoon. "She looks better today," said owner Barbara Banke. "Rachel is a determined fighter. It makes me feel better that she was happy to have a mint. I want to thank all her fans for their incredible devotion to Rachel. Your thoughts mean so much right now."

**CAVIAR GOING FOR LIGHTNING THREE-PEAT**

**Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) is expected to start at something around a nickel on the dollar when she makes her first start in nearly eight months in today's G1 Lightning S. up the 1000-meter straight course at Melbourne's Flemington Racecourse. The 6-year-old mare should have no problem defeating this field in her attempt to win the race--now named in her honor--as she is rated about 10 lengths higher than her closest rival, and the focus is on what could come next. Even a return trip to Royal Ascot was suggested Friday morning on Melbourne radio by co-owner Gary Wilkie, and trainer Peter Moody wouldn't rule it out either--though under special circumstances. "The only reason I thought she might make the trip would be if the owners thought about her going to a stallion like Frankel and being served to Southern Hemisphere time," Moody told Melbourne radio station RSN. If anything is to give the supermare a tussle, it could be her barnmate **Moment of Change (Aus)** (Barely a Moment {Aus}). The 4-year-old overcame the 15 hole to land the G1 Rupert Clarke S. when last seen Sept. 30, but has a lot of running to do to catch Black Caviar.

Manando (Bluegrass Cat) is the 9-5 favorite on the morning line on the strengths of a blowout victory over next-out maiden winner Curly Top (Curlin) and a pacesetting third to Goldencents (Into Mischief) in the GIII Sham S. Jan. 5. Carving (Any Given Saturday), owned in part by Bode Miller, has been something of an over-achiever, having won a pair of stakes at two. He enters his 3-year-old debut off a sixth in the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 15.

**HOLLENDORFER HAS SANTA MARIA TRIO**

Gary and Mary West's **Book Review** (Giant's Causeway) successfully navigated an ambitious sophomore campaign last season. A third-start maiden winner in May, she continued to climb the conditions ladder throughout the summer, and became a Grade I-winner over this strip in the La Brea S. Dec. 26. The 4-year-old filly will look to add to that tally today

when she goes postward as the 8-5 favorite in the GII Santa Maria S. at Santa Anita Park. The chestnut put in a respectable effort to finish second in her seasonal debut in the GII La Canada S. over this track and trip Jan. 20. Chasing a tepid pace from the back of the pack that day, she was

given the slip by the front-running More Chocolate (Malibu Moon) at the top of the lane, and could not do enough to catch that rival in the final stages. While Book Review has done much of her running over seven furlongs, she showed the ability to handle this distance when winning the Imperial Gesture S. at Belmont by 4 1/2 lengths in October. Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer will saddle half this six horse field, including **Snow Fall** (War Front), who has made two starts for her conditioner since being transferred from Graham Motion at the end of last year.

Second in the Kalookan Queen S. over this wet-fast strip Dec. 29, she was much the best when taking the Paseana H. gate to wire over this track and trip Jan. 13. There is little committed speed here, and the 5-year-old has shown the versatility to go to the front or sit off the pace. Breaking to her inside will be **Lady of Fifty** (After Market), who seeks her second graded victory after taking the GII Bayakoa S. over the Betfair Hollywood Park cushion track Dec. 8. She finished fourth, beaten 4 1/4 lengths, in the La Canada, and shoulders highweight of 123 pounds here. Hollendorfer appears to have selected an ambitious spot for **Going for a Spin** (Ministers Wild Cat) here, but the 5-year-old does have the potential to hit the board. Plucked out of a \$40,000 Betfair Hollywood Park claimer by her current connections last May, she has since won three stakes--one each over dirt, turf, and synthetic--including a starter stake on the turf here Jan. 20.

### WHO WILL BE THE 'MAC' DADDY?

As if today's GII Mac Diarmida S. weren't a difficult-enough handicapping assignment, the prospect of ease in the ground and a tricky pace scenario almost ensure a handsome mutuel on the winner. **Lucky Chappy (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) tries older horses for the first time in his career, and acquitted himself quite well in graded company at three. A nose second in the GIII El Camino Real Derby in February, he handled a yielding Colonial

turf course nicely when a one-length runner-up behind Silver Max (Badge of Silver) in the GII Virginia Derby in July. He came from well back to be third to Unbridled Command (Master Command) in both the GIII Saranac S. Sept. 2 and in the GI Hollywood Derby in his most recent start Nov. 25. Anything

close to his morning line of 5-1 would represent good value. **Amira's Prince (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) has been a revelation in a pair of starts since coming to this country, including a big-figure allowance victory going 12 panels over the yielding here Jan. 19. He is another who should appreciate the flow of this race. The pace figures well above par, with committed front-runners in the form of **Ioya Bigtime** (Dynaformer), **Fifty Proof** (Whiskey Wisdom) and **Belo Acteon (Brz)** (Acteon Man {Brz}). That could help set things up for the top two, as well as **Nikki's Sandcastle** (Castledale {Ire}), whose wide rally in the GII Fort Lauderdale S. Jan. 12 was only good enough for fourth. Today's added distance shouldn't hurt his cause.

**‘DERBY’ DREAMS**

Trainer Bob Baffert used the GIII El Camino Real Derby to launch his first GI Kentucky Derby starter, Cavonnier, into the classic picture in 1996. That result proved bittersweet, with the dark brown gelding coming up a nostril short to Grindstone on the first Saturday in May, but Baffert quickly found redemption, sweeping the next two Derbies with Silver Charm and Real Quiet. The Hall of Famer looks to get back into the El Camino Real winner's circle--and onto the Road to the Kentucky Derby--today with **Manando** (Bluegrass Cat) and **Carving** (Any Given Saturday). Campaigned by Natalie Baffert and Bode Miller, Carving is a two-time stakes winner, but hasn't been seen since finishing a well-beaten sixth in the GI CashCall Futurity at Betfair Hollywood Park. Dec. 15. Manando has been on the improve since a debut third Aug. 18. Although it took the Kaleem Shah colorbearer four starts to graduate, he has run up against some respectable foes, including subsequent San Pedro S. winner Distinctiv Passion (With Distinction) and next out winner Belvin (Empire Maker), who is entered for Sunday's GI San Vicente S. The bay colt graduated while stretching out to 1 1/16 miles at Betfair Hollywood Park Dec. 13, and most recently finished third behind Goldencents (Into Mischief) and Den's Legacy (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GIII Sham S. over this strip Jan. 5. Joseph Vitek's **Majestic Hussar** (Majestic Warrior), the impressive front-running winner of a seven-furlong allowance at Gulfstream Park Jan. 19, will stretch out for the first time in next Saturday's GII Fountain of Youth S. at the Hallandale oval. A debut graduate in the Saratoga slop Aug. 11, the homebred showed some early zip before dropping out to finish seventh behind Shanghai Bobby (Harlan's Holiday) in the GII Hopeful S. Sept. 3. He resurfaced with a runner-up effort to recent GIII Sam F. Davis S. winner Falling Sky (Lion Heart) in a Dec. 15 allowance over 6 1/2 furlongs and is coming off a 2 1/4-length defeat of the well-regarded Palice Malice (Curlin). And now, it's time to see what he's capable of, explains trainer Eddie Kenneally. "We know we have a quality sprinter after his two races here with the horses he ran against," the conditioner explained. "We want to try the distance. If it doesn't work we still know we have a good sprinter. We know he likes the track. Gabriel Saez will ride him." Majestic Hussar is well-bred to stay a two-turn distance. Not only is he kin to the good turf routers GSW Joes Blazing Aaron (Graeme Hall) and GSP Tiz Sardonic Joe (Tiznow)--the latter of which goes for Kenneally in today's GIII Tampa Bay S.--he is bred on a similar reverse cross to GISW Any Given Saturday.

### Live Lively, Lady Banks Set for Davona Dale...

**Live Lively** (Medaglia d'Oro) and **Lady Banks** (Successful Appeal) know each other well and are set to renew acquaintances in next Saturday's GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream. Live Lively defeated Lady Banks to win her maiden at second asking at Aqueduct Nov. 23 and followed up with a smashing 11 1/4-length allowance tally going seven furlongs at Gulfstream Jan. 1. "She showed she liked the track in the allowance and ran well enough to earn a chance in this race," said her trainer Mark Hennig. "There really aren't really a lot of options for a 3-year-old and I don't want to think about shipping for an easier spot. She doesn't have to win...just show us where we are." Lady Banks graduated in her second start Dec. 14 in New York and added the Ruthless S. Jan. 12. "I think she'll get the distance because she doesn't run until you ask her to," stated trainer James Lawrence. "I've thought from the beginning that she was very classy."

**DOMINGUEZ DISCUSSES REHABILITATION**

*Edited Press Release*

Three-time Eclipse award-winning jockey Ramon Dominguez, who suffered a skull fracture in a spill at Aqueduct Jan. 18, made his first on-camera appearance since the accident yesterday, discussing his rehabilitation with television analyst and former jockey Richard Migliore.

Dominguez, 36, spent four nights in intensive care at Jamaica Hospital in Queens following the incident before being moved to New York-Presbyterian Hospital/Weill Cornell Medical Center. He was transferred to that institution's Medical Step-Down Unit Jan. 26, and then spent about a week at the Burke Rehabilitation Center.

This was Dominguez's second skull fracture. He suffered his first in 1998.

"This [fracture] was probably a little more severe," Dominguez said Thursday. "Having said that, I wasn't overly concerned because the doctors, from the get-go, felt like I was going to recover well and they were very happy with my condition even from the beginning. They said I was exceeding their expectations, and I really didn't last too long [at the rehabilitation center]."

Dominguez noted that his high fitness level had aided in his recovery.

"I feel like the prognosis the first week I was [at the Burke Rehabilitation Center] was excellent," he said. "The physical therapy couldn't do a whole lot for me, so therefore I need to talk to my doctor again, because I feel like I should be at a higher level [of therapy]. Maybe a lot of that has to do with being an athlete, your level of fitness is pretty high."

Dominguez said that while there is no timetable yet for his return to race riding, he is eager to get back in the saddle.

"When I was at my previous rehab center [the issue of when I might be able to return to riding was] one of the questions I asked a couple of times to the doctors," he said. "I feel like maybe it was too early for them to tell me I could come back in an 'x' amount of time. From then on I just decided to focus on my exercises and my physical therapy and try to get better. I don't think you'd call it selfish or just foolish, but I'm definitely dying to know when I can come back to riding horses."

Throughout it all, Dominguez has maintained his sense of humor.

"I feel physically capable of running a marathon, as I mentioned to one of the therapists," he said. "And mentally, if I'm not sharp, I don't think it's due to the injury; I've probably been this way always. So I feel pretty good and, God-willing, I can come back to riding racehorses in a short amount of time."

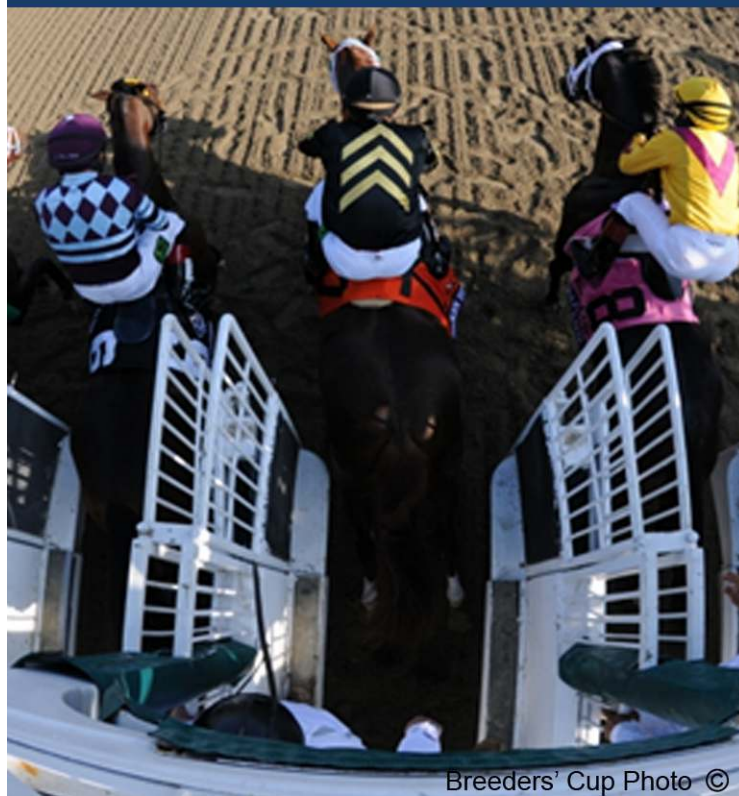
