'CAVIAR' THUNDERS HOME IN LIGHTNING

The more things change, the more they stay the same. Despite an injury-enforced absence of nearly eight months, **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) took her record to a perfect 23 for 23, stamping her

authority on the G1 Lightning S. for the third consecutive season in front of 27,047 fans Saturday at Melbourne's Flemington Racecourse. It was the sixth win at the highest level at the track for the supermare and 13th overall, equaling the feat of fellow Australasian darling Sunline (NZ) and Tie the Knot (Aus) and leaves her just one behind the all-time record of Kingston Town (Aus).

"It's good to have her back," a noticeably emotional Peter Moody commented afterwards. "I said to my girls that it was the first time I've been nervous in a long time. I suppose it was the break."

At the end of the day, there was very little to sweat.

Away without incident from stall two, Black Caviar dictated terms beneath a motionless Luke Nolen and hooked up with the track proper traveling with supreme confidence. Nolen shook the reins at her and, as is her custom, she put a couple lengths on her rivals and came home a much-the-best winner at minimum odds.

Moment of Change (Aus) (Barely a Moment {Aus}) and **Golden Archer (Aus)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) ran on to fill out the minors for a stable 1-2-3. The final time of :55.42 clipped 0.08 seconds off the previous course record established by Special (Aus) in this event some 25 years ago.

"We were hiding nothing by bringing her back, the job was done and we thought it was over [after Ascot], but to come back and do that and run a record, I'm lost for words," Moody continued. "I'm just so proud of her. She is just a good-news story and I am very grateful for the owners who are prepared to share her with everyone. I think that is very understated in this whole story. Imagine having something this good and sharing it with every bugger in Australia. They are true blue Aussies, aren't they," Moody quipped.

There are two relations to Black Caviar in the upcoming Inglis Easter Yearling Sale. Lot [131](#), a Redoute's Choice (Aus) half-brother to the mare, will be offered by Three Bridges Thoroughbreds on behalf of Rick Jamieson's Gilgai Farm. Also set to go under the hammer is lot [319](#), a colt by Redoute's Choice out of Black Caviar's second dam Scandinavia (Aus).

ROYAL DELTA BACK FOR MORE IN SABIN

Besilu Stables' **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) will look to use today's GIII Sabin S. at Gulfstream as a launching pad to another Eclipse Award-worthy season. The 2011 champion 3-year-old filly could do no better than a well-beaten second to Awesome Maria (Maria's Mon) in this event a year ago, but she garnered champion older female honors by the time her campaign was through, capping things off with a decisive score in the G1 Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita in November. "She's stronger than last year," red-hot trainer Bill Mott said. "I think the campaign at four was easier than the campaign at three. She beat older mares in the [2011] Breeders' Cup [Ladies' Classic]. I think she was a little tired, a little light [last year]. She's a bigger, stronger filly this year. I think she's grown into her frame a bit more."

An improved Royal Delta could spell trouble for the G1 Dubai World Cup field--the **"TDN Rising Star"** will look to atone for a ninth-place finish in last year's renewal of that prestigious event Mar. 30 if all goes well here. "I think she was a victim of a rough trip over there," Mott said of last year's World Cup. "She went into the race well. It was just that she was a victim of bad racing luck." The heavy favorite's main source of competition should be **Grace Hall** (Empire Maker), winner of the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks last March and fourth last time in the Ladies' Classic. **Field p9**

Funnys Approval got an inauspicious start to her career--she finished last of seven in a \$15,000 maiden seller at Turfway in March--but the Bobby Rankin homebred has now won four straight. The chestnut broke through emphatically in career start number five when trying the dirt for the first time at Mountaineer Oct. 5, and streaked to similarly impressive tallies back at that venue Oct. 28 and Dec. 7. Those last two scores came in the slop, and similar conditions here proved to the longshot's liking. Crowded a bit out of the gate, Funnys Approval rushed up in between horses to seize the lead and post splits of :23.02 and :46.46. She was confronted by favored My Wandy's Girl at the top of the lane, and while the former looked poised to score when she took the lead briefly on the rail, Funnys Approval dug back in gamely to re-break and blow up the tote. "I always knew she was good enough to make good races," trainer Jose Lopez said of Funnys Approval. "She won three races in a row and we were waiting for races. I came last week and I ran one here and I looked at the stakes and said 'Let's take a shot, you've got to be in it to win it.'... When I saw the forecast I was happy about it. I was doing the rain dance. I've only won one other stakes. My second is in a Grade II. That's absolutely unbelievable." The winner is one of five foals from her sire (by Distorted Humor)'s first crop. Rankin and Lopez campaigned Outrageouslyfunny, whose career highlight was a third-place run in the 2007 Forego S. at Turfway. He is standing the 2013 breeding season at Poplar Creek Horse Center in Ohio.

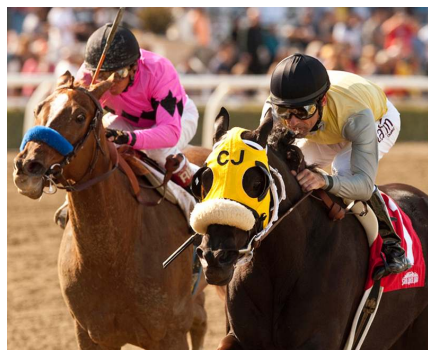

It must be nice being Gary Stevens. The Hall of Fame pilot has only been out of retirement for some six weeks, and he's already won two graded stakes. He nursed Slim Shadey (GB) (Val Royal {Fr}) along on the front end to take the turf GII San Marcos S. a week earlier, and employed similar tactics here on the main track. Great Hot had last found the winner's circle in the 2011 GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland, but the veteran's touch and the addition of blinkers did the trick this time.

The highlight of the homebred's 2012

campaign was a track-and-trip second-place effort behind Eclipse finalist Include Me Out (Include) in the GII La Canada S. last January, but she could do better than ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint here Nov. 3. Third behind next-out winners Teddy's Promise (Salt Lake) and Snow Fall (War Front) in the Dec. 29 Kalookan Queen S., she was stretched back out to finish fourth here behind Snow Fall in the Jan. 13 Pasaena H.

Allowed her head by Stevens to establish command after breaking from the rail, Great Hot settled nicely into rhythm as she faced little resistance through splits of :23.94, :48.19 and 1:12.11. Favored GI La Brea S. winner Book Review tipped out to confront the pacesetter entering the straight, but Stevens exuded confidence, and never bothered going to the whip as his mount bounded to victory.

"It was so sweet," Stevens said of his trip. "I moved her out about three wide and she just shut it down and was listening to my commands all the way around. I was just being a passenger until the head of the stretch." Of his hot hand in recent weeks, the 49-year-old said, "It feels good. I've had that feeling before. I guess that's why I came back, I had that feeling, and I wanted it again."

Winning conditioner A.C. Avila, who said he will point Great Hot to the nine-furlong GI Santa Margarita S. here Mar. 16, was quick to praise Stevens.

"Gary got the breaks," he said. "Nobody wins 5,000 races for no reason. I put the blinkers on to give her more focus. He spoke to me yesterday, I said, 'I'm going to do one thing. I'm going to give you a leg up and you are the boss.' How am I going to tell Gary Stevens how to ride?"

A maiden winner in seven European starts for trainer David Wachman, Amira's Prince was fourth to the talented Sharestan (Ire) (Shamardal) in listed company at The Curragh June 30 before finishing third in a blanket finish in a conditions event Fairyhouse July 15. Runner-up in a similar test at Down Royal July 27 and in a Aug. 21 handicap at Gowran Park, the bay was acquired by these connections and given some time off. Lasix went on for his U.S debut over this course and distance Dec. 22, and he made it two straight in a 12-furlong allowance Jan. 19. That was good enough for the bettors to make him favored here. A little slow to begin, Amira's Prince was ridden forward to take up a midfield perch, as Teaks North showed the way from

loya Bigtime. He improved his position slightly into a stalking third with a lap to race and continued in the three path on the backstretch run. Amira's Prince eased past a weakening loya Bigtime into second leaving the three-eighths pole, was on even terms with Teaks North turning for home and pulled confidently clear. "The plan was not originally to run him in this race, but he was doing so well," trainer Bill Mott admitted. "I said, 'You know, it would be a shame to keep the horse in the barn as well as he's doing.' He might be doing as well as anyone else in the barn, just the way he's been training." Mott indicated Amira's Prince could return for the GII Pan American S. Mar. 23.

He has a pair of younger sisters by another Coolmore resident in Giant's Causeway.

Swift Warrior, purchased privately by these connections during his sophomore season from owner/trainer Steven Dwoskin, got his picture taken following Saratoga's grassy Win S. last August, then showed little when eighth behind Horse of the Year Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Oct. 6. The chestnut outran his 17-1 odds with a close fourth in the GIII River City H. at Churchill Downs Nov. 25, then kicked off the new year with a sharp wire-to-wire victory in Sam Houston's GIII John B. Connally Turf Cup S. Jan. 26. Supported as the second choice here, the 2012 GIII Tampa Bay S. third-place finisher chased the early leaders in fourth through fractions of :24.73 and :49.69. With Jose Espinoza aboard, he revved up with a three-wide move on the far turn to challenge for command, and emerged with a narrow lead in deep stretch as four of them hit the wire together. "This horse is my best friend--he is a real professional," Espinoza said. "If we need speed he has it; if we decide to wait on the speed like today, he will do that. I was able to wait with him until the final turn, and he made a response there that won us the race."

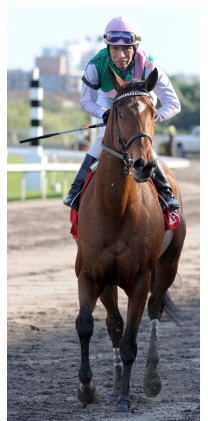

After making her first four starts in France--where she collected a victory in the Listed Prix de la Grange Aux Belles S. in her second try--Starformer crossed the Atlantic to join the stable of Hall of Fame conditioner Bill Mott in the summer of her 3-year-old campaign. She recorded her first American win over this track and trip in her fourth stateside start nearly a year ago to the day, and went on to collect the GIII Robert G. Dick Memorial S. at Delaware in July. She rounded out the year with a victory in the GIII Long Island H. at Aqueduct Nov. 10. Resurfacing for her seasonal debut here, the homebred was sent off the 3-2 favorite. Breaking sharply from the rail, Starformer was taken back by Edgar Prado in the early stages, and settled into a ground-saving third for the first trip past the stands. Moving out to travel outside the frontrunners down the backstretch, she moved into second for the run into the turn, and took over the lead while in hand approaching the quarter pole. Prado gave a shake of the reins at the top of the lane and Starformer responded, kicking clear to score comfortably. "We knew she was one of three horses in the race with speed and she fell into a good position third--she got a great trip," offered winning conditioner Bill Mott. "She came to us as a 3-year-old and was a little disappointing running in her first few races for us at a mile or a little more. She seemed to get in trouble. After that we stretched her out to 11 furlongs or more and she seems to like that a lot better. The [GIII] Orchid is here [Mar. 30], and I guess that will be next for her."

Cardoza and Pegram's **Shakin It Up** (Midnight Lute) appears to be Team Baffert's first-stringer, having finished a close third behind two other stablemates in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 22. The dark bay broke his maiden by 4 1/4 lengths over **Caballo Del Cielo** (Songandaprayer) in his previous outing here Oct. 27. Baffert's other two runners, **Belvin** (Empire Maker) and **War Academy** (Giant's Causeway), are coming off graduation scores, but have plenty of upside. The former was second to eventual San Pedro S. winner Distinctiv Passion (With Distinction) in a key heat in Inglewood Nov. 25, and donned cap and gown going a sixteenth shorter here Dec. 26. The Donald Disney homebred hails from a speedy family and is a half-brother to the graded stakes-winning and Grade I-placed Apriority (Grand Slam). The Coolmore contingent's War Academy, a \$450,000 KESEEP yearling, scored in his lone previous outing at Betfair Hollywood Park Nov. 9 with **Treasury Bill** (Lemon Drop Kid) two spots back. Treasury Bill broke through over this strip next out Jan. 27, and figures to be running late for trainer Ron Ellis and Gary and Mary West.

The bay put it all together next out, however, graduating at Aqueduct Nov. 24. The homebred added a 1 1/8-mile Gulfstream optional claimer Jan. 26.

"When I came down here after he broke his maiden, I thought it was a deal where I'd get to run him a couple times and then when we got him back to New York, we'd run him over the bigger track, and that'd be his gig," McGaughey said. "He was a surprise the other day, but he was training awfully well for it."

RACHEL'S CONDITION "REMAINS SERIOUS"; FOAL ON NURSE MARE

Two days after undergoing emergency surgery to repair internal injuries and resulting infection from foaling, the condition of 2009 Horse of the Year Rachel Alexandra (Medaglia d'Oro) remained serious yesterday, according to a release from owner Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Farm.

The 7-year-old mare, who foaled a Bernardini filly Feb. 12, underwent surgery at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington Wednesday after displaying discomfort and signs of excess fluid in her abdominal cavity. Surgeons repaired an infected section of the mare's small colon--likely injured during foaling--and veterinarians continue to closely monitor her condition.

She is being administered nutrition and medication intravenously, and yesterday ate a "small amount" of feed on her own.

Wednesday night, and is reported to have bonded strongly

with Quarter Horse nurse mare Miss Beautiful Ojos, a nurse mare the farm has used before.

"Ojos' is both very sweet and a great milk producer, two of the most important nurse mare qualities," Stonestreet said in the release. "Rachel's filly has bonded with Ojos, and she now considers Ojos to be her mother. She will remain with her until she is weaned. Rachel's condition remains serious, and she will need her strength as she fights to recover."

Rachel Alexandra was herself raised by a nurse mare after she was rejected by her dam, Lotta Kim (Roar). Stonestreet noted that Ojos produced a filly of her own Wednesday, which received the vital colostrum (antibody-rich first milk) from his dam, and is now being hand fed on nutritional supplements.

"We visited Ojos's filly Friday afternoon," the release stated. "She is being hand-raised along with another foal whose mother is also a nurse mare. This little filly will be bottle, then bucket-fed along with her stall mate. They are both nicely bred Quarter Horse foals and she is expected to be a reining or cutting prospect."

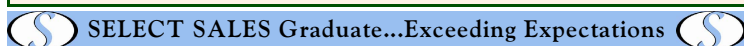

YPR is social racing initiative; its members do not pay costs and will not receive prizemoney earned by Vadashan. Ballots will also be held to select a group of members who will enjoy ownership privileges on days when he is racing. In addition to raceday affairs, the initiative also provides opportunities for various industry experiences, including attending bloodstock auctions and trackwork, as well as stud tours and fashion events.

"We decided to throw open the door to the backstage of racing to the younger generation in Sydney by offering them access to the world of racing," Leonard explained. Though the primary aim of the group is to educate future participants in the industry, it has already inspired members.

"We had many groups so keen to get involved that they have taken shares in horses with Gai Waterhouse, Graeme Begg, Paul Messara and a couple of the major syndicators," Leonard said. "Bruce, Gus and I have made ourselves constantly available for any information that the members requiring, helping to introduce members to relevant people in the part of the industry they are most interested in."

The fact that YPR was created with a focus on the social aspects of racing dovetailed with the Redoute's Choice Club mission.

"Many of our core values are similar and had the main goal of helping to drive the new generation of horse owners in New South Wales," Leonard noted. "The RCC would continue to have a strong education component running the industry specific events, while YPR will drive the social and networking events."

Leading rider Douglas Whyte had his choices to make and landed on **Gold-Fun** over **Autumn Gold**. The flashy chestnut was fifth in a Class 2 over 1400 meters Nov. 18, but has since rattled off three straight at a mile, including a narrow defeat of **Garlic Boy** in the Hong Kong Classic Mile Jan. 20.

"Gold-Fun has maintained an easy training programme since his run and he's in very good shape—I'm very happy with him," said Gibson. **Akeed Mofeed** has been the talking horse of the division for most of the past couple of months and will attract plenty of support here off a troubled third in a 1400-meter handicap Jan. 12. Despite that effort, Gibson is still of the belief that he is an unfinished product. "I don't think he's quite 100% fit—he's not raced much at all in the last 12 months," Gibson explained, adding that he thinks Akeed Mofeed will be better for the run. Autumn Gold is facing decidedly softer here, after finishing down the field behind California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}) in the G2 Jockey Club Cup in November and in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 9. He trialled well for this, but does lose Whyte to Gold-Fun. Ryan Moore had been expected to fly in for the ride, but suffered a wrist injury this week. Tom Queally has picked up the ride.
