**BAFFERT STAYS SUPER AT OAKLAWN**

Trainer Bob Baffert's domination of Oaklawn Park's sophomore stakes program continued Monday when **Super Ninety Nine** (Pulpit) splashed home an 11 1/4-length winner of the GIII Southwest S. Sent off the even-money choice, the chestnut colt quickly assumed control into the first turn and cut through a driving rain as he took the field through fractions of :23.33, :47.49 and 1:12.29. He snuck away on the turn and bounded clear in the stretch, effortlessly extending his advantage to the wire. "With the way he broke and the speed we had, everything went well," said winning rider Rafael Bejarano. "There at the end, my horse still had something left."

Baffert swept both divisions of last year's Southwest, as well as the GII Rebel S. and GI Arkansas Derby. Over the last five years, the California-based trainer has a record of 15-11-2-1 in Oaklawn's graded stakes races, according to DRF Formulator. Baffert was able to enjoy the rain-soaked victory from the comforts of his Mexico vacation. "Rafael called me before the race and I just told him to let him get away from there and do his thing," Baffert said via phone. "Turning for home, I could see he had plenty of horse. It's exciting. This is the time of year when these 3-year-olds start getting exciting."

**CAN'T MIZ AT SANTA ANITA**

GI Breeder's Cup Turf Sprint heroine **Mizdirection** (Mizzen Mast) kept her record over the Santa Anita turf perfect with a win in yesterday's GII Buena Vista H. The gray entered Monday's contest with four wins in four attempts down the hill in Arcadia, the site of her Breeders' Cup victory and most recent tally in the GII Monrovia S. Jan. 6. The course specialist was stretching out to a mile for the first time since winning Del Mar's Sandy Blue Hen S. in August of 2011. Undeterred after being bumped at the start, the well-deserving 3-5 favorite showed versatility, heading straight to the front unlike her pressing Monrovia or deep-closing Breeders' Cup tactics.

Mizdirection set a sensible pace along the rail, going the half in :47.00 as **Byrama (GB)** (Byron {GB}) pressed from two wide. Meanwhile, jockey Gary Stevens had his hands full holding **In the Stars (Brz)** (Romarin {Brz}) to track in third.

Still in command at the top of the lane, Mizdirection shifted into gear, shaking free from In the Stars, who had tipped out and was in pursuit, in midstretch and finished under good handling.

**Super Ninety Nine Takes Southwest (cont. from p1)**

Super Ninety Nine began his racing career with a 1 1/4-length victory over seven furlongs at Santa Anita last October. He was forced to miss the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint after getting cast in his stall the night before the race, but returned with a runner-up effort in the Nov. 22 Gill Hollywood Prevue S. Fourth in a Dec. 28 six-furlong allowance at Santa Anita, the colt stretched out to a mile to record an impressive 3 1/4-length allowance victory in Arcadia last time out.

As for what is next for the handsome chestnut, Baffert said, "We'll get him back home and see how he does. We know he likes the track now. I don't like to plan ahead and with these young horses, you just never know. We'll definitely have something for the [Mar. 16 Gil] Rebel."

Bejarano, meanwhile, will be spending another night in Hot Springs. "I missed my flight, but as thrilled as I am with the race, I don't mind waiting until tomorrow," he said.

**Ninety Nine Gives Chus Super Start**

Super Ninety Nine is the first racehorse owned by the Tanma Corporation of Susan and Charles Chu. Trainer Bob Baffert picked the colt out of last year's OBS June sale on behalf of the couple. After working a bullet furlong in :10 flat, the juvenile was the sale's third-highest price at \$260,000. Originally from Taiwan, the Chus reside in Massachusetts. Charles Chu works in the GPS and security systems business. Susan Chu has long been involved with showhorses.

Out of Exogenetic (Unbridled's Song), an unraced 3/4-sister to MGISW Exogenous (Unbridled), Super Ninety Nine is a half-brother to multiple stakes winner Elusive Horizon (Elusive Quality). Exogenetic has a yearling filly by Quality Road and was bred to Smart Strike last spring.

"If anything good came out of it, she rated really well," jockey Mike Smith said of the bump at the break. "I don't know if it was because of that or she was just going to rate well. She's a much more mature horse this year. She's stronger, she's bigger, and she'll definitely get a mile. I thought if a horse was going to come to her she would have dug back in, so now at least we have options. There's not too many six or six and [a half furlong races], but we can kind of pick our spots. I don't know how much further we want to go than this, but she can certainly get a mile."

"I felt okay with her on the lead," trainer Mike Puype said of Mizdirection's unusual position at the front through the early going. "Mike said he kind of got her to settle," the conditioner noted of the start. "[She] grabbed a pretty good-sized quarter off that foot, too, so we're going to have to go to work on that after the race. It's a testament to how tough she is. She was training beautiful going into this race. I thought she was actually as good if not better than [before] the Breeders' Cup, the way she was training for this."

"We have a lot of options as to what we're going to consider at this point," Puype commented. "She shows up. Let me tell you something, the filly chasing her is a good horse. I thought In the Stars was the horse to beat today. She came after her [Mizdirection] like she was going to make it a race, and Mike looked like he had a lot of horse. I'm very pleased."

Brigand (Flatter) in the City of Laurel S. Dec. 8 and second white routing in the Native Dancer S. Jan. 21. Javerre broke well from the six slot in this one and prompted the pace set by Il Villano from three wide. Javerre continued to press Il Vilano through the turn as Brigand moved out three wide from his tracking position. When jockey J.D. Acosta went to the whip entering the lane, Javerre responded, taking the lead in midstretch and pulling clear as Brigand chased in pursuit. "When I saw Kendrick [Carmouche] go to the lead with Il Villano, it worried me a little bit," said winning jockey Acosta. "Because that horse could run and I knew I'd have a really big challenge down the lane, but I knew I had the horse to make it work and so he did." Although Brigand hit the wire second, he was disqualified for interfering, early in the race. The colt came out, bumping Associate (Wando), and was disqualified and placed fifth.

**FALLING SKY EYES FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

**Falling Sky** (Lion Heart), winner of the Feb. 2 Sam F. Davis S., had been expected to return to the Tampa Bay oval for the Mar. 9 GIII Tampa Bay Derby, but was entered yesterday for Saturday's GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream. The sophomore colt won a Gulfstream allowance Dec. 15 before selling to Newtown Anner Stud, James Covello and Joseph Bulger for \$425,000 out of the OBS January sale. His Sam F. Davis victory was his first start for the new connections. "He's just doing great," reported trainer John Terranova. "He's won over the track here [at Gulfstream]. I think coming back in three weeks, if anything, could help him.

"He seems to thrive on work," Terranova continued. "We thought it would be a good spot to put him in since he came out of the Tampa race absolutely fantastic." Falling Sky worked a half-mile at Palm Meadows Sunday in :49.94. "He cruised the half, galloped out well and was hitting the ground great," Terranova said of the work. "He's eating great; he looks tremendous."

Reddam Racing's **He's Had Enough** (Tapit), third in the GII Robert B Lewis S. Feb. 2, was entered in both the GII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds and the Fountain of Youth. Trainer Doug O'Neill said the gray colt will likely keep the Gulfstream engagement. "We drew post nine in the Fountain of Youth and 12 of 15 in the Risen Star," said O'Neill. "Mr [Paul] Reddam is in a meeting at the moment and we'll discuss it, but I'd say we're leaning toward the Fountain of Youth."

**Pure Fun** (Pure Prize) was clocked going four panels in :51.60 at Gulfstream Park yesterday in her first works since taking the GI Hollywood Starlet S. Dec. 8. "We only went 3/8ths with her and they gave her a half-mile time," said trainer Ken McPeek. "We clocked her in :37.00 for the 3/8ths. We were just letting her test drive and getting her going. She's doing fine."

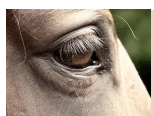

Did Saturday's GII Mac Diarmida S. mark the start of something big? The breeders who made Galileo's son Cape Blanco (Ire) the busiest stallion in the U.S. in 2012 will be fervently hoping so, as the victory by Amira's Prince provided Galileo's stallion sons with their first American graded stakes victory.

Only a week ago, the *TDN* reported on the number of American-based or American-raced mares in the first book visiting the mighty Frankel (Galileo {Ire}). These feature the likes of Oatsee (Unbridled), In Lingerie (Empire Maker), Mi Sueno (Pulpit), Icon Project (Empire Maker), Balance (Thunder Gulch), Eden's Moon (Malibu Moon), Eden's Causeway (Giant's Causeway) and Rose of Summer (El Prado {Ire}), so there should be plenty to look forward to on American tracks from 2016.

The relevant link between Frankel and Teofilo, the sire of Amira's Prince, is that they rank alongside Golden Lilac, Roderic O'Connor, Maybe and Cima de Triomphe among the Group 1 winners that Galileo has sired from daughters of Danehill.

The other similarities between the two extend to their 2-year-old careers. After winning all five of his juvenile starts, including the Dewhurst S., Teofilo was recognized as Europe's champion 2-year-old, with a World Thoroughbred Racehorse Ranking of 123.

Four years later, Frankel was unbeaten in four outings, including the Dewhurst, before sharing top place on the rankings with a figure of 126. Of course, Frankel's official figure at two was widely considered miserly, with Timeform rating him 133p, compared to Teofilo's 126.

Teofilo's Dewhurst victory earned him the position of winter favorite for the 2,000 Guineas and Derby, and there was even talk of his becoming a Triple Crown winner, even though the English Triple Crown had been won only once since 1935, by Nijinsky in 1970.

Teofilo's colorful trainer Jim Bolger had first mentioned the Triple Crown after his colt's victory in the G1 National S.

"If he wants to be the next Triple Crown horse," Bolger ventured, "then I'm not going to stand in his way!"

Talk of the Triple Crown arose partly because Teofilo's National S. success came only eight days after colts from Galileo's first crop had filled the trifecta in the Group 1 St. Leger. As Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) showed last year, the St. Leger is arguably the most difficult for a modern Thoroughbred, because of its distance of more than a mile and three-quarters.

At 16.2 hands, Teofilo is a sizeable horse by European standards. When I reviewed his pedigree after the G1 Dewhurst, I commented that:

"There is always a worry that high-class juveniles which enjoy a physical advantage over most of their rivals at two will not be as dominant at three, when their less-mature rivals have had a chance to catch up. But that didn't happen with Nijinsky and there is every reason to think that Teofilo will also stay a step ahead of the opposition."

Bolger had also fanned the speculative flames after the Dewhurst by insisting that Teofilo would be even better as a 3-year-old running over middle distances. "You won't see the true horse until he goes over a mile and a half," he suggested.

The colt's pedigree supported the idea that he would be even more effective at three. Back in 2006, I mentioned that Teofilo's family has also generally done better at three than two. I unearthed a quote Bolger gave after Teofilo's dam Speirbhean had won the Derrinstown Stud 1,000 Guineas Trial:

"This filly is up there with Give Thanks, Flame of Tara and the others," he claimed. "She isn't three yet [she was born as late as May 25] and still has a bit of maturing to do. She deserves a chance at the 1,000 Guineas. The long-term plan is to bring her back here for the Irish Champion S. in September. I think she'll stay up to a mile and a half."

Of course, all this Triple Crown speculation was rendered pointless when Teofilo suffered a knee injury which initially forced him to miss the 2,000 Guineas and then led to his retirement.

There is, therefore, no evidence about how far he would have stayed, but subsequent years have confirmed that Triple Crown ambitions weren't too fanciful. Galileo's, sum, as a stallion includes victories in the G1 2,000 Guineas (thanks to Frankel), G1 Derby (New Approach {Ire}) and St. Leger (Sixties Icon {GB}), as well as the equivalent Classics in Ireland. **cont. p10**

Teofilo's first crop, which features Amira's Prince and three other group/graded winners, has also shown he can transmit stamina. Among his better winners are Light Heavy (third in the G1 Irish Derby) and Black Arrow (a creditable fifth in the G3 German Derby). His best daughter, Voleuse de Coeurs, won the Irish Cesarewitch over two miles by 10 lengths. Although

his progeny are winning over a variety of distances, plenty of them have won over a mile and a half or more, and I was intrigued to note that, in addition to Voleuse de Coeurs, he has at least three other winners beyond two miles.

Although some of the Teofilos stay well, that hasn't stopped some of them making their mark at two. His first crop contained a Dewhurst S. winner in Parish Hall (Ire), a Group 3 seven-furlong winner in Remember Alexander (GB) and the listed winners Black Arrow and Teolane (Ire). His second batch of 2-year-olds did even better, with the unbeaten Loch Garman (Ire) taking the G1 Criterium International, the very likeable Trading Leather (Ire) winning the G3 Autumn S. and the prolific winner Havana Gold (Ire) landing the G3 Somerville Tattersalls S. Roz (GB), another member of his second crop, was runner-up in the G1 Fillies' Mile, while another of his daughters, Upward Spiral (GB), was fast enough to finish fourth in both the G2 Queen Mary S. and G1 Cheveley Park S. With Group 1 winners in each of his first two crops, Teofilo is now priced at €35,000, having been available for €15,000 in his fourth season in 2011.

Although 2013 is still in its infancy, members of Teofilo's first crop, such as Royal Empire (Ire), have been performing well in Dubai and now Amira's Prince is flourishing in the U.S.

Amira's Prince is inbred 4x3 to the exceptional Danzig, as is the Group 1-placed Roz. The GII Mac Diarmida S. winner's dam Twice The Ease (GB) is by Green Desert, a broodmare sire who has also been excelling with Teofilo's sire Galileo. From his first 12 foals out of daughters of Green Desert, Galileo has sired Was (Ire), winner of the G1 Oaks over a mile and a half, Lay Time (GB), a Group 3 10-furlong winner, and Battle of Marengo (Ire), a 2-year-old Group 2 winner over a mile in 2012.

It is beginning to look as though Teofilo is also suited to Green Desert, as his good son Havana Gold has a dam by Green Desert's son Desert Style. Another of Galileo's sons, New Approach, owed Tha'ir (Ire), one of his trio of stakes winners at last year's Royal Ascot, to yet another Green Desert mare.

Jim Bolger, in his successful role of breeder, isn't frightened of close inbreeding. He bred Teofilo's first Group 1 winner Parish Hall, who is inbred 3x3 to Sadler's Wells, and he also bred Teofilo's listed winner Paene Magnus (Ire), who is inbred 3x2 to Danehill. Bolger's smart Holy Roman Emperor colt Leitir Mor is inbred 2x3 to Danehill and we can probably expect to see much more "Double Danehill" in years to come. Guelph, a recent Group 3 2-year-old winner in Australia, is another inbred 2x3.

Amira's Prince isn't short of stamina, for which he can thank Teofilo. The colt's stakes-winning half-sister Hen Night (Ire)--another inbred to Danzig via Danehill and Green Desert--was a miler and their dam Twice The Ease was a sister to Desert Ease (Ire), a listed winner over six furlongs at two. This is a distinguished Moyglare family with previous form with Danehill blood. Trusted Partner, a sister to Amira's Prince's second dam Easy To Copy, visited Danehill to produce Dress To Thrill (Ire), a Classic winner in Ireland who also enjoyed Grade I success in the U.S.

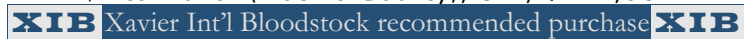

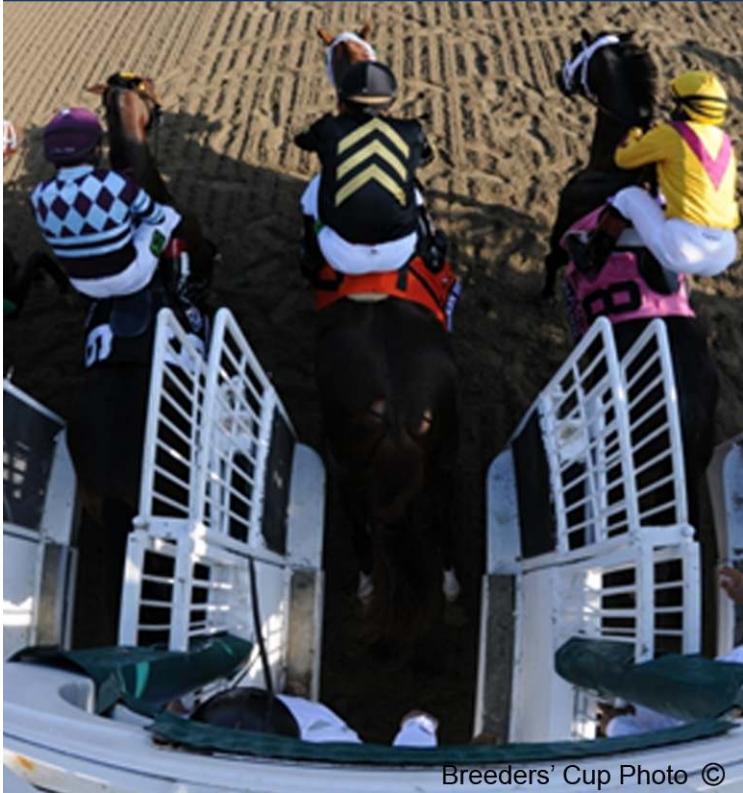
