VIOLENCE INJURED, OFF DERBY TRAIL

Black Rock Stable's **Violence** (Medaglia d'Oro), a game second while suffering his first loss in Saturday's GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S., sustained a fracture to his right front medial sesamoid. The sophomore is expected to be shipped to Steven Marshall's Black Rock Stables Farm in Versailles sometime this week for further evaluation and recuperation. "It's such a disappointment to see such a promising colt sustain an injury," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "He's been training beautifully and made such an impressive effort in his second place finish yesterday." A maiden winner at Saratoga last August, Violence took the GII Nashua S. in his second start before ending his juvenile campaign with a win in the GI CashCall Futurity in December.

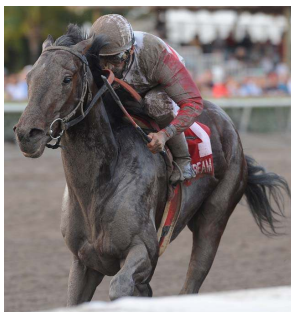
With three wins from four starts to date, the dark bay colt has earnings of \$623,000. His runner-up effort Saturday put him third on the list of Kentucky Derby point earners.

ORB EXITS FOUNTAIN WIN IN FINE SHAPE

Orb (Malibu Moon) exited his victory in Saturday's GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S. in good shape, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. He was making his stakes debut in the Fountain of Youth and McGaughey was impressed with the colt's effort. "It was great," the trainer said of the race. "We got a good pace, but for him to be able to catch up from where he was over this kind of track, twice, is saying a whole lot."

McGaughey added the colt, who broke his maiden in his fourth start and came into the Fountain of Youth off a nine-furlong optional-claiming victory at Gulfstream Jan. 26, had matured considerably in recent months.

"He's come so far over the winter," said McGaughey. "My people have done a great job with him. If he keeps improving, maybe he'll be something." He added, "I would never have thought, when I brought him down here, that he'd be where he is today. He just kind of grew up." As for what is next for Orb, McGaughey said a decision would be made after co-owner Stuart Janney III returns from New Zealand next week.

MILITARY ATTACK ON TOP IN HONG KONG

California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}) was dispatched the 4-5 chalk in the Citibank Hong Kong Gold Cup, but never picked up his feet, as **Military Attack** (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) broke through at the top domestic level under Zac Purton at Sha Tin Sunday.

With Purton--giving perennial leader Douglas Whyte a real battle for the jockeys' premiership--in the irons for the first time, Military Attack was ridden more positively and was second early before easing back to save ground from about fourth. Purton guided Military Attack off the inside to challenge one off the fence in the stretch, tackled pacesetter **Same World** (GB) (Hawk Wing) crossing into the final furlong and skipped clear. **Pure Champion** (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) rallied late to deny connections a 1-2 finish, with **Xtension** (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) in third.

Triple Threats

GOTHAM FIELD TAKING SHAPE

Pick Six Racing's **Vyjack** (Into Mischief) is expected to put his unbeaten streak on the line in Saturday's 1 1/16 miles GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct. The gelding is coming off a narrow victory in the Jan. 5 GII Jerome S. "The competition is going to get tougher, so he'll have to keep stepping up," admitted trainer Rudy Rodriguez. Vyjack worked six furlongs at Aqueduct Thursday in 1:15.13. "He did it very good and did everything we asked him to do," said Rodriguez. "It looks like he's coming into the race in good shape. He's going a little longer this time, so we had him breeze six furlongs and gallop out seven eighths."

Also aiming for the Gotham is Shadwell's **Elnaawi** (Street Sense). The half-brother to To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) is coming off a one-mile maiden win at Aqueduct Jan. 12. "We'll see how we fit in," commented Art Magnuson, assistant to trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He's training well and ran well, so here we are." Elnaawi could be joined by stablemate **Transparent** (Bernardini). The Darley runner graduated in his sixth start last time out at Aqueduct Jan. 26. "We'll talk to everyone involved," Magnuson said of Transparent's status for the Gotham. "He needs to take another step forward. They're lightly raced, and it's just a timing and experience thing."

Also considered likely for the Gotham: GII Remsen and GII Futurity winner **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union); GII Hutcheson S. winner Honorable Dillon (Tapit); **Escapefromreality** (Read the Footnotes); **Siete de Oros** (A.P. Warrior); **Ore Pass** (War Pass); **Sky Captain** (Sky Mesa); **West Hills Giant** (Frost Giant); **Alcolite** (Hook and Ladder); and **Champion Boy** (Big Brown).

LA DERBY NEXT FOR IVE STRUCK A NERVE

Ive Struck a Nerve (Yankee Gentleman), upset winner of Saturday's GII Risen Star S., came out of the race in fine shape and will now be pointed towards the Mar. 30 GI Louisiana Derby. "We'd be crazy not to run in the Louisiana Derby," said trainer Keith Desormeaux. "Plus, we have to represent the home team." The Risen Star is Desormeaux's biggest victory to date. "I suppose, like a lot of modern horsemen, I could buy into the theory that fresh is better, and try to train my horse up to the Kentucky Derby off of his race yesterday, but that's not my style," said Desormeaux. "My horse is fit, and it's a lot easier to train an athlete that is fit. Fit horses don't get hurt so easily. My horse came back from his race just fine and ate up everything last night and this morning. He keeps good weight on him, and he's heavy-boned." Desormeaux added he and Ive Struck a Nerve's owner Matt Bryan are enjoying the experience. "We're having fun with this horse," the Lafayette, Louisiana native said. "We went out to dinner last night, talked about the future and had a lot of laughs."

"I thought I'd at least get the same weight as Bill Mott's horse [Ron the Greek]. That's a good horse. Every time I run against those good horses, they beat me. My horse is a tough little horse, but Ron the Greek's tough, too." **Game on Dude** captured the 2011 Santa Anita H. and is coming off an easy 6 1/2-length victory in the Feb. 3 GI San Antonio S.

ON FIRE BABY BACK TO WORK

Anita Cauley's multiple graded stakes winner **On Fire Baby** (Smoke Glacken), off since running fourth in last year's GI Acorn S., returned to the work tab at Oaklawn Park Sunday, going four furlongs in :49.00. "She was a little anxious and a little bit faster the first part than we wanted her to, but overall she did real good," reported trainer Gary Hartlage. "She galloped out good." On Fire Baby won the 2011 Gill Pocahontas S. and Gill Golden Rod S. She returned at three to finish third against the boys in the Smarty Jones S. before winning the Gill Honeybee S. She was fifth in the GI Kentucky Oaks. "She'll be on a weekly program now in her training to see four, five, six weeks down the road where we are at for a race," Hartlage added. "I'm not going to say. You never know. It just depends on her and we'll leave it all up to her."

Before returning to Hartlage's barn, On Fire Baby had been training at Eisaman Equine. The trainer said the filly has matured since he last saw her.

"She's picked up 100 to 200 pounds," Hartlage said. "She's filled out some more and probably grown an inch or two. She's probably as powerful as she's ever looked. I know she is. She's more powerful and she's matured."

All Too Hard Aims for Australian Guineas

Trainer John Hawkes has announced that Saturday's G1 Cathay Pacific Futurity winner **All Too hard (Aus)** (Casino Prince {Aus}) will start in next Saturday's G1 Australian Guineas at Flemington. The half-brother to Black Caviar (Bel Esprit {Aus}) started the year with a victory in the G1 C.F. Orr S. at Caulfield Feb. 9. "At this stage he'll be running in the Guineas for sure," his conditioner told *Racing and Sports* of running back in a week's time. "We'll monitor him over the next couple of days to be certain everything is all right, but I don't see any problems."

SPENDTHRIFT EXPANDS 'BREED SECURE' PROGRAM

B. Wayne Hughes' Spendthrift Farm has expanded its 'Breed Secure' program to include 10 Kentucky stallions.

"Breed Secure is a program we also started last year with Into Mischief, and after seeing the positive effects we have decided to offer it almost across the board on our stallions," Hughes said. "I believe it's a far superior alternative to foal sharing, and maybe it will eventually replace foal sharing in the industry. Breed Secure allows commercial breeders to breed a mare to a stallion of their choice without having any risk as it relates to the stud fee. When that breeder goes to sale, if he or she doesn't make a reasonable profit then not a dime of the stud fee will be owed to Spendthrift. Hopefully there is a tremendous profit made at sale, and when that happens, he or she would only be responsible for paying back the stud fee and not a dime more."

Archarcharch, Dominus, Line of David, Notional, Paddy O'Prado, Temple City, Tiz Wonderful, Tizway, Warrior's Reward and Wilburn are all offered in the Breed Secure program.

Breeders involved in the program can decide at what age to sell the resulting foal. The breeder gets the first proceeds up to \$10,000 for an in-foal mare, \$6,000 for a weanling, or \$12,000 for a yearling. Any dollars after those amounts would go towards paying back the stud fee, and once the stud fee is paid back the breeder gets to keep the balance.

If the sale doesn't meet the minimum, any shortcomings are completely forgiven and Spendthrift is only entitled to receiving a maximum of the full amount of the stud fee and nothing more.

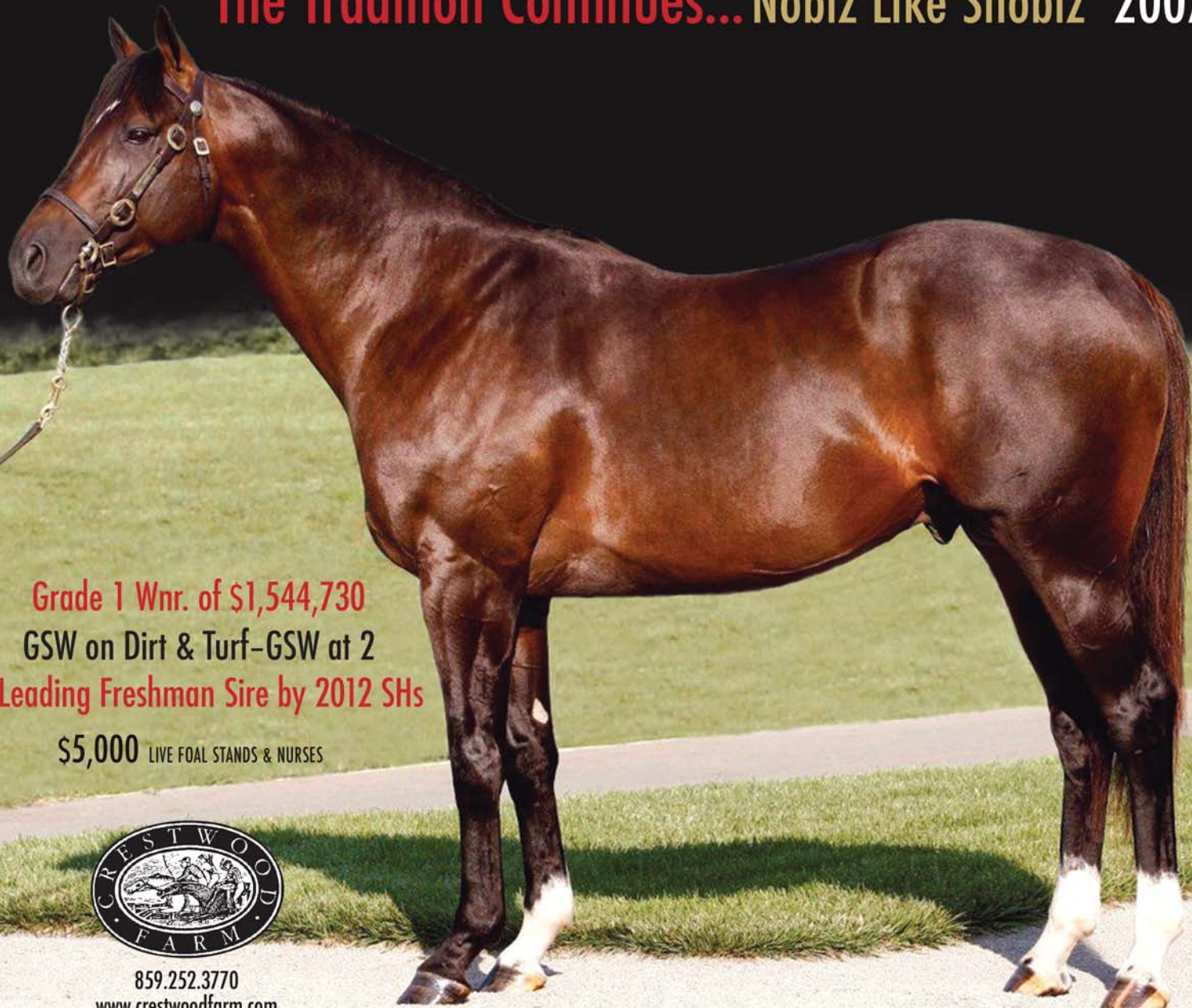
