**Treasury Bill All Ready for Rebel...**

Gary and Mary West already have two GI Kentucky Derby contenders in **Flashback** (Tapit) and **Code West** (Lemon Drop Kid), currently fifth and 11th in the Derby rankings, and after Saturday's \$600,000 GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn Park they may have two more. Their horses **Treasury Bill** (Lemon Drop Kid), trained by Ron Ellis and **Title Contender** (Pulpit), conditioned by Wayne Catalano will run as an entry at 5-1. The Rebel will be the first start around two turns for Treasury Bill, whose pedigree suggests he'll handle the stretch out in distance. His dam, Wow Me Free (Menifee) was victorious in the GIII Next Move H. and third in the GII Shuvee H. at a route of ground. Treasury Bill most recently came from last to finish second behind Skakin It Up (Midnight Lute) in the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. on Feb. 17. "We've been building him up to this and I've liked him all along," Ellis said. "After his first race he got sick on us and missed about 10 days and that's why we haven't stretched him out yet. He's behind schedule, but actually he's bred to go a mile-and-a-half, and I'm a little surprised at how well he's sprinted up so far. He'll show more speed than he did in his last race."

**QATAR RACING ACQUIRES TRADE STORM**

**Trade Storm** (GB) (Trade Fair {GB}), who registered a personal best in the Mar. 2 G2 Zabeel Mile at Meydan, has been acquired by Qatar Racing in a private deal. The David Simcock trainee, who previously raced in the

colors of Universal Racing, is pointing at the G1 Dubai Duty Free back at Meydan on World Cup night Mar. 30. "Excited to report that Trade Storm has been purchased by Qatar Racing and will remain with David Simcock who has done so well with him," tweeted racing manager

David Redvers. "He remains firmly on course for Dubai Duty Free and will hopefully compete at the top level over eight furlongs this summer around the globe."

"Every trainer and jockey wants three to five, and they are the gates we got with Akeed Mofeed and Mizani," Gibson told South China *Morning Post*. "Gold-Fun wasn't as fortunate with 12, but it's fair to say he's the best-equipped of the three to deal with that. We came out of the draw well overall, and now it's up to the horses and jockeys to perform." **Ashkiyr (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) is flying under the radar, but there are plenty of whispers that he's set for his coming out party this weekend. He has shown steady improvement as the distances have increased, with a fourth to Gold-Fun in the Classic Mile and a third, beaten a length, to **It Has To Be You (NZ)** (Volksraad {GB}) in the Hong Kong Classic Cup at 1800 meters Feb. 17. His task became slightly more difficult when he landed the dreaded outside post in the field of 14. "Unfortunately we've drawn widest in gate 14," said Ashkiyr's jockey Weichong Marwing. "The horse is going well, we haven't been given a chance with the gate, but you never know it might work in his favor anyway. He's improved with every start and he has group form at 2000 meters in France." The last two Derby winners, **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) and **Fay Fay (NZ)** (Falkirk {NZ}) each overcame the widest barrier to score.

**Gomez Picks Up Mount on Flashback...**

Tony Matos, agent for jockey Garrett Gomez, has confirmed that the two-time Eclipse award winning rider has picked up the mount on **Flashback** (Tapit) for the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 6. Gomez will replace Julien Leparoux, who rode the colt to a second-place finish in the GII Santa Felipe S. Mar. 9. Leparoux was widely criticized for his ride in that event after sending the favorite to the front early to duel with second choice Goldencents (Into Mischief). The tempo proved to be too much for Flashback, who faded in the final stages to finish second to Hear the Ghost (Ghostzapper). "We're very excited that Bob Baffert put Garrett on this horse," Matos said. "They've had a lot of success together and we hope it continues."

**McGaughey Looking Forward to Derbies...**

Shug McGaughey looks forward to the GI Kentucky Derby as he prepares **Orb** (Malibu Moon) for the GI Besilu Stables Florida Derby on Mar. 30. The bay colt's win in the GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S. moved him to second in the Derby field ranking, based on the new points system.

"Like I said after the Fountain of Youth, I wake up every morning thinking of winning the Kentucky Derby," McGaughey said. "I wish I'd won it a long time ago so I wouldn't have to worry about it anymore."

Orb breezed a half-mile at Payson Park in 48 2/5 seconds on Monday, the second fastest time recorded at that distance on the day. He will be seeking his fourth straight victory in the Florida Derby and his third at Gulfstream.

Orb broke his maiden at Aqueduct on Nov. 24 in his fourth start. He then won a 1 1/8-mile allowance before upsetting the heavily favored **Violence** (Medaglia d'Oro) by a half-length in the Fountain of Youth.

"Not that I didn't think that he had a chance to be a decent horse, but it's just how quick he's become a decent horse," McGaughey commented. "After he broke his maiden, he just put it all together."

McGaughey saddled six horses for the Kentucky Derby between 1984 and 2002. In 1989, Easy Goer took 2nd behind Sunday Silence in both the Derby and Preakness before capturing the Belmont.

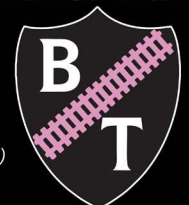

"I can't speak for Eddie, but I know he had targeted this race and I think he was coming whether Larry (Jones, trainer of Joyful Victory) came or not."

Smith noted that **Brushed by a Star**, a Grade II winner at Churchill and Monmouth last year, is doing "super" ahead of her first Grade I foray.

**SHA TIN HOSTS HKIS, PART TWO** A total of 16 horses--six newly turned Northern Hemisphere 3-year-olds and 10 2-year-olds from the Southern Hemisphere are set to go under the hammer at the 'Derby' edition of the Hong Kong International Sale, to be held Saturday morning (HK time) in the Sha Tin parade ring. The youngsters were acquired by representatives of the Hong Kong Jockey Club at auction houses in the U.S., England, Ireland, France, Australia and New Zealand. Bernardini is the sire of one of

the best 2-year-old fillies in Australasia in the form of G1 Diamond S. winner Ruud Awakening (Aus), and the Darley dual-hemisphere sire is responsible for the most expensive of the HKJC's purchases. Lot 9, a son of Rock on Madonna (Aus) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), cost A\$360,000 when he was offered at the 2012 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, and is bred similarly to Ruud Awakening, who is out of a Danehill mare.

His dam is a half to the outstanding Divine Madonna (Aus) (Hurricane Sky {Aus}), a four-time Group 1 winner in Australia. Dubawi (Ire) is the sire of two of the top runners in Hong Kong in former G1 Hong Kong Sprint hero Lucky Nine (Ire) and likely Hong Kong Derby favorite Akeed Mofeed (GB), and the stallion is represented tomorrow by lot 3. "He wasn't used to that style," Vaccarezza commented, referring to the ride given Little Mike by Kieren Fallon. "He was bouncing around in the saddle, he held him up, then rushed through a hole. "He is such a class act, and we are blessed to have him. He's come back, he's hungry and you can't have a better rider, and I think he'll fit perfect with Little Mike. He's got a clock in his head and I think you'll see a big race." Vaccarezza and family depart next week for a return trip to Dubai.

The Storm Cat Career Development Award, inaugurated in 2006, is a \$15,000 grant designed as an early boost to an individual considering a career in equine research. It has been underwritten annually by Mrs. Lucy Young Hamilton, a Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation board member whose family stood the retired champion stallion Storm Cat at Overbrook Farm.

The three Storm Cat winners for 2013 are Brandy Burgess of Colorado State University, Daniel Warren Youngstrom of the Marion duPont Scott Equine Medical Center at Virginia Tech, and Erin McConachie of the University of Georgia.

“The committee who selects the Storm Cat recipients described how difficult it was this year to select one over two other exceptional candidates,” said Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation President Edward L. Bowen. “Since Storm Cat is now 30 years old, our chairman, Dell Hancock, suggested that we fund all three--one for each decade of the stallion’s life--on this one occasion. Therefore, Lucy Young Hamilton will fund one of them and our foundation will fund the other two and we will be helping three young researchers this year.”
