COULD POST POSE PROBLEM FOR '99'?

Tanma Corporation's **Super Ninety Nine** (Pulpit) breaks from the far-outside post 11 in today's GII Rebel S. at Oaklawn as he tries to replicate his head-turning romp in the GIII Southwest S. here a moth ago and further stamp himself a major GI Kentucky Derby threat. The speedy chestnut, who was second in the

seven-furlong GIII Hollywood Prevue S. last November, was subsequently fourth in a six-furlong Santa Anita allowance Dec. 28, but he has looked super sharp in a pair of route runs this season. Super Ninety Nine earned a 100 Beyer Speed Figure when he beat stablemate and subsequent GII Risen Star S. runner-up

Code West (Lemon Drop Kid) going a mile in Arcadia Jan. 31. Given an even-money chance to provide conditioner Bob Baffert with his third Southwest trophy in two years (the race was run in split divisions in 2012) Feb. 18, the \$260,000 OBS June buy splashed right to the front through honest fractions and was never seriously threatened, cruising under the wire with an 11 1/4-length edge, good for a 102 Beyer. He'll have to be hard-riden to make the lead again this time, and Baffert wouldn't give much away when asked about tactics. "At this point, we just want to stay healthy," said the Hall of Famer, whose other-wordly record in Hot Springs also includes wins in the last three runnings of this race. "When the gate comes open, [rider Rafael] Bejarano knows the horse well," added the conditioner, who will also saddle the consistent **Den's Legacy** (Medaglia d'Oro), added. Chief among the favorite's challengers--both early and late--will be WinStar Farm and Twin Creeks Racing Stables LLC's **Delhomme** (Dixie Union). Graduating on the stretch-out over a trio of next-out winners second out at Belmont Oct. 13, he earned a 99 Beyer last time when a finishing close third behind stablemate Overanalyze (Dixie Union) and Normandy Invasion (Tapit) in Aqueduct's Nov. 24 GII Remsen S. The form of that race hasn't been particularly flattered, as the top two both came back to finish off the board as chalk. **Cont. p3**

She began her career with seven starts on the sod, culminating in a third-place run in the GIII Robert J. Frankel S. here Dec. 30, but improved markedly when switched to the main track. The bay traveled sweetly throughout the La Canada, and had 1 3/4 lengths on last-out GI La Brea S. winner Book Review (Giant's Causeway) at the wire. More Chocolate earned a 97 Beyer Speed Figure for the win, representing a 10-point improvement from her Frankel effort. The daughter of multiple graded stakes-winning turfer Little Treasure (Fr) (Night Shift) has been given some time off since her last start, but only because her connections are looking forward to a big campaign. "She ran so big in the La Canada, and it's a long year," said John Sadler's assistant trainer Larry Benavidez. "There's no reason to be ahead early."

AURELIA, SOPHIA SQUARE OFF IN AZERI

Stonestreet Stables and George Bolton's **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike) looks to kick off her 4-year-old season with a bounce-back win in today's GIII Azeri S. at Oaklawn, but to do so she'll have to get through the in-form **Don't Tell Sophia** (Congaree), which figures to be no easy task.

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who last took this race in 1989 with Manastash Ridge, has two chances in this year's Rebel. Calumet Farm's **Oxbow** (Awesome Again) turned in a powerful performance to romp by

11 1/2 lengths in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds Jan. 19, and he had some excuses when finishing fourth-beaten just a half-length--in the Risen Star last time. The bay was wide throughout and probably struck the front a bit too soon in the Risen Star, and

will piloted by three-time Rebel-winning jockey Mike Smith this time. "I spoke to Mike briefly last week," said Lukas. "Of course, it doesn't have to be a lot of conversation with a rider like him. I'm just going to put him on the horse and send him out there." Oxbow is out of a full-sister to Tiznow (Cee's Tizzy). Lukas's other runner, Willis Horton's **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song), also sports a big-time pedigree. He's out of MGISW Take Charge Lady (Dehere), making him a half-brother to last year's GI Florida Derby hero Take Charge Indy (A.P. Indy). The chestnut was second to **Texas Bling** (Too Much Bling) in Remington's Springboard Mile Dec. 9, but turned the tables on that foe in the local Smarty Jones S. Jan. 21. He was a distant sixth behind Super Ninety Nine in the Southwest last time.

Gary and Mary West's **Treasury Bill** (Lemon Drop Kid) is an intriguing off-the-pace candidate. Second in Santa Anita's seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. Feb. 17, the chestnut should relish the added ground here.

CENTRE COURT, SAMITAR MAKE '13 DEBUTS

Top 3-year-old turf fillies from last year **Centre Court** (Smart Strike) and **Samitar (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) make their 4-year-old debuts today in a solid renewal of the GII Honey Fox S. After one off-the-board effort on dirt as a juvenile, Centre Court raced exclusively on the sod last year, posting an ultra-consistent record of four wins and four runner-up efforts from eight tries. She earned her first graded victory in last June's GIII Regret S., and bested eventual GI Matriarch S. winner Better Lucky

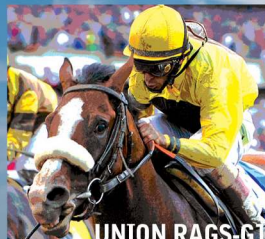

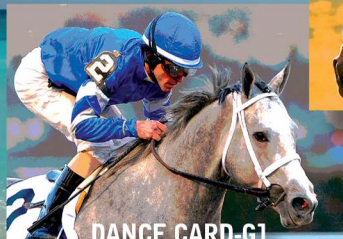

Centre Court returned to winning ways in Churchill's Nov. 17 GII Miss Revere S., and shows a quick worktab over the Palm Meadows sod. "She's right on schedule," trainer Rusty Arnold said of the Humphrey homebred. "She's doing great and this is a perfect spot at a mile to bring her back and set her up for the [Apr. 13 GI] Jenny Wiley at Keeneland, which is out first major target for her this year." Martin Schwartz's Samitar took The Curragh's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas for conditioner Mick Channon in May, and annexed the GI Garden City S. in September in between her runs at Saratoga and Keeneland. The bay is joined here by stablemate **Pianist** (More Than Ready), a well-regarded runner who comes of a course-and-distance optional claiming win Feb. 7. She's four-for-four at the distance, and took last September's Given S. at Belmont before finishing fourth at odds-in on Keeneland's GIII Valley View S. and again behind **Channel Lady** (English Channel) in the Big A's Stardusk S. Nov. 21. Channel Lady took the GIII Suwanee River S. in front-running fashion here Feb. 9.

The 2011 champion juvenile filly made the best of an abbreviated sophomore season, taking the GI Cotillion S. over Questing (GB) (Hard Spun) in September and finishing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic Nov. 2. A close-up third in the seven-furlong GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26, the bay came up just four votes shy of Questing for the 3-year-old filly Eclipse. She'll break from the outermost post seven and figures to go favored on reputation alone. Don't Tell Sophia, meanwhile, rides a three-race win streak into the Azeri and has proven too tough to handle for the local fillies and mares so far this season. The 5-year-old completed her 2012 season with an optional claiming win going 6 1/2 panels at Churchill Nov. 22, and took the track-and-trip Jan. 19 Pippin S. and Feb. 16 Bayakoa S. by a combined 13 3/4 lengths. **Cont. p6**

"I would like to have more in there," trainer and co-owner Phil Sims said of the group of seven. "I hate short fields. Mainly on principle because of the pace. It seems sometimes some horses find even more trouble in the small fields because they all bunch up. But she's ready." **She's All In** (Include) and **Tiz Miz Sue** (Tiznow) were a distant second and third, respectively, in the Bayakoa. The latter took this race a year ago, and stretched eventual champion older mare Royal Delta (Empire Maker) to a neck in the Gil Delaware H. in July. Pin Oak Stable's **Songs and Sonnets** (Unbridled's Song) rounds out the major contenders having taken a local Jan. 31 allowance by eight lengths in her first start on conventional dirt.

She might be as good as any filly I've had."

BC ADDS TRAVEL ALLOWANCE, LOWERS ENTRY FEES The Breeders' Cup Board of Directors has passed a new budget which, for the first time, will include a travel allowance for all horses shipping to California for this year's Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships at Santa Anita Park Nov. 1 and 2. International horses will be given a \$40,000 travel allowance and domestic horses will be given \$10,000. The Breeders' Cup has also decided to reduce entry fees from 3% to 2%. "As the leading international Thoroughbred racing event offering \$25 million in purses, today's actions further our goals of increasing our global reach by creating even more attractive opportunities for our participants," said Tom Ludt, Breeders' Cup Chairman. "We're very excited to extend significant travel allowances to all owners shipping horses to California and to make the Championships more affordable by reducing entry fees by 33% for all races."

Last Week - As expected, the very talented **Verrazano** was just too good for them at Tampa. We'll see if he remains as dominant as the distances continue to increase on the road to the Derby. Very nice job by DiDonato selecting the impressive longshot runner-up in that one and also getting a very generous show price despite the winner's overwhelming low odds... Thought I was live with **Tiz a Minister** when he began to wind up from a mile out of it in the San Felipe, but he had to settle for a good third at 12-1. Was quite pleased that he showed up, but just wish he could've at least gotten second for a nice score in my Twin Spires account.

GII Rebel S. - Baffert simply refuses to lose at Oaklawn, and he'll be represented by a formidable pair here, including 3-2 morning-line favorite and runaway Southwest winner **Super Ninety Nine**. That being said, between the chalk's outside draw and the presence of plenty of other speed types, I'm going to look elsewhere. **Treasury Bill**, a promising son of Lemon Drop Kid, should thrive in his first attempt beyond seven furlongs. He's bred to run all day (graded winning dam was a stakes winner at the Classic distance), and he's been on my watch list since his visually impressive come-from-behind maiden win over a saturated Santa Anita main track (somehow labeled wet fast) with first-time Lasix in his second career start Jan. 27. The Gary & Mary West colorbearer ran another big one in the San Vicente, rallying into slow fractions with a wide trip while the winner saved all the ground and also had the benefit of sitting a bit closer to the lead. Treasury Bill worked a sharp bullet in :48 flat at Betfair Hollywood Mar. 11, and looks like he means business here. **Selection: #1 Treasury Bill (5-1)**

STAYING ALIVE

59 Players remain eligible for the top prize in the Road to the Derby Showdown

BRIAN DIDONATO:

Last Week - **Verrazano** was too good--as he figured to be--in the Tampa Bay Derby, but **Java's War** put in a nice run from out of the clouds to be second at 32-1. I was pleasantly surprised by the \$8 show pay-off.... I didn't feel great about how **Hear the Ghost** was traveling in the San Felipe until midstretch, when he seemed to be spurred on by Steve's pick **Tiz a Minister** coming up alongside him. The big chestnut was powerful late, and though the table was set for him by an early duel, he still seems like one to keep watching out for as the distances get longer.

GII Rebel S. - I'm a bit conflicted here, as **Super Ninety Nine** is my official "Derby horse" right now and I'm sitting on a 47-1 future on him from Pool 1. I think he'll be very tough to beat, but there is some chance that a hot pace and/or his outside post could do him in. I still have a hard time imagining him finishing out of the top three, but acknowledge that he won't offer much value, so I'll look elsewhere for this contest.

Treasury Bill really interests me in this first two-turn try. Third after a slow beginning when unveiled over 6 1/2 furlongs of Betfair Hollywood Park Cushion Track Nov. 9, the Ron Ellis trainee graduated going the same distance at Santa Anita Jan. 27 thanks to a very impressive last-to-first rally. He didn't get much pace in the seven-furlong GII San Vicente S. Feb. 17, but unleashed another powerful stretch run down the center of the track to finish second. One could almost argue that he hung a bit, but he did cover 22 feet (about 2.5 lengths) more than winner **Shakin It Up** according to Trakus data, and was only beaten a length. Treasury Bill runs like a horse who still has some maturing to do, and clearly he wants more ground. He's by Belmont winner Lemon Drop Kid and his dam **Wow Me Free** (Menifee) was a pure router who took the GIII Next Move H. at nine furlongs and a listed event at 1 1/4 miles. There's similar stoutness throughout his female family. This is a fairly conservative and patient barn, so it has to be a good sign to see Treasury Bill ship in. Note: It looks like **Title Contender**, who's coupled with Treasury Bill, has been entered as a rabbit. If he somehow hits the board but Treasury Bill doesn't, it'll still count.

KY COURT OVERTURNS VET SUSPENSION

The Kentucky Court of Appeals yesterday overturned the four-year suspension of veterinarian Dr. Rod Stewart handed to him in September of 2009 by the Kentucky Horse Racing Authority (now the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission) for the possession of cobra venom. The court's ruling was based on the lack of any explicit mention of cobra venom in the state's medication rules for Thoroughbreds at the time the suspension was handed out, coupled with the then-legal use of the substance as a painkiller for Standardbreds. Stewart, whose possession of the venom was discovered during a search of trainer Patrick Biancone's barn at Keeneland in June of 2007, said during the investigation that he treated both breeds. He also received an additional one-year suspension for possession of carbidopa and levodopa, used to treat Parkinson's disease in humans. That suspension had already been overturned by a lower court. Biancone served a six-month suspension for his involvement. The court's opinion read: "We are ultimately in agreement with Dr. Stewart that the commission's permissive use of snake venom under Standardbred horse regulations, coupled with the lack of express forbiddance of snake venom in Thoroughbred racing regulations creates an ambiguity, which does not give a veterinarian of ordinary intelligence a reasonable opportunity to know that the commission intended to prohibit snake venom in Thoroughbred racing."
