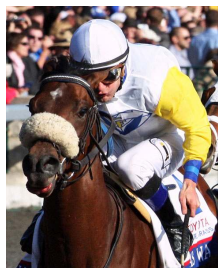

'JAVA' EARNS HIS SHOT AT DERBY

With a powerful last-to-first rally against a full field of 14 in Keeneland's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. yesterday,

Charles Fipke homebred **Java's War** (War Pass) stamped his ticket to the May 4 GI Kentucky Derby while flattering likely Derby favorite Verrazano (More Than Ready) in the process. Second to the subsequent GI Wood Memorial S. winner last time in the Mar. 9 GII Tampa Bay Derby, the Ken McPeek trainee was off a few steps slow, but settled into a rhythm at the back of the pack under Julien Lejaroux as favored **Rydilluc** (Medaglia d'Oro) duelled with longshot **Undrafted**

(Purim) down the backside. Rydilluc tried to blow the race apart at the head of the lane, and Java's War was forced to wheel out seven or eight wide when producing his run. **Palace Malice** (Curlin) wrestled the lead away from Rydilluc in midstretch, but Java's War galloped on with giant strides to find the wire a neck to the good of that Dogwood runner. Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Charming Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) completed the trifecta, while Rydilluc held fourth. "Mr. Fipke deserves all the credit," said McPeek. "The man breeds quality horses. He puts a lot of energy and money into it, and I'm happy for him. He deserves it." **Cont. p3**

PLETCHER/MCPEEK REVERSE EXACTA AT OP

Trainer Todd Pletcher ran second and third behind Ken McPeek representative Java's War in the Blue Grass some 50 minutes before the GI Arkansas Derby, but the conditioner exacted some revenge on his contemporary in Hot Springs thanks to a decisive 4 1/4-length tally from Mike Repole's **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union). McPeek trainee **Frac Daddy** (Scat Daddy) was second at 23-1, with 22-1 **Carve** (First Samurai) third. Favored **War Academy** (Giant's Causeway) was pulled up on the backstretch, while GII Rebel S. runner-up **Oxbow** (Awesome Again) could do no better than fifth. **Cont. p4**

BLACK CAVIAR MAKES IT 25

A published report early Saturday suggested that, for the first time in a long time, **Black Caviar** (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) could be in some trouble in Saturday's G1 T. J. Smith S., an event she was trying to win for the second time in three years. After all, the weather was uncooperative early in the week and the Randwick surface was deeper than Peter Moody wanted, to the point where he considered depriving New South Wales of the chance to see the champ. She is also more accustomed to racing straight or left-handed, so that the 'Sydney' way of going clockwise was seen as a question mark. The 6-year-old was actually friendless in the pre-post markets and touched 1-5, believe it or not, but she proved once again that she has no peer with another flawless run. Making her third start this preparation, having won the G1 Lightning S. Feb. 16 and the G1 William Reid S. Mar. 22, Black Caviar jumped well enough from the one hole and was forwardly placed along the inside through the opening exchanges. As was discussed by Moody and jockey Luke Nolen in the walking ring, the plan was to get the supermare away from the fence to avoid ground that might be shiftier and to avoid getting trapped, and Nolen executed that plan to perfection, holding her up just behind the pacesetter **Rain Affair** (Aus) (Commands {Aus}) and inside of **Hay List** (Aus) (Statue of Liberty), whom she defeated in 2011. Black Caviar traveled sweetly into the stretch and had the front-runner at his mercy 200 meters out, then streaked away to score under hands and heels. **Cont. p10**

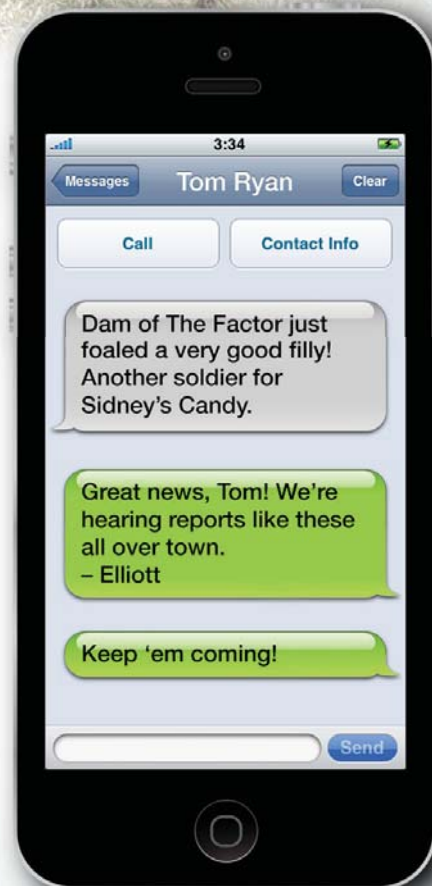

A late-on-the-scene fifth when unveiled going five panels on the Churchill sod last June, Java's War donned cap and gown when stretched out at Ellis in July. He got his first black-type victory going a mile at Louisiana Downs in the Sept. 8 Sunday Silence S., and showed an affinity for this strip when third with some traffic trouble in the Oct. 6 GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity S. Java's War made a premature move before flattening to sixth on the Derby surface in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. to complete his juvenile season Nov. 24.

Let go at 32-1 as **"TDN Rising Star"** Verrazano took all the money at Tampa, the bay flew home from far back to cut the winner's advantage to three lengths on the line. "He didn't really break, but he traveled very nice for me," said Leparoux, who was riding Java's War for the first time Saturday.

"At the three-eighths pole, I tried to catch up a little bit, and he ran big the whole way through the stretch." Todd Pletcher, trainer of the second and third finishers, said, "Both horses ran extremely well. I am proud of both of them, but disappointed at the same time." Java's War sold in utero for \$350,000 at the 2009 Keeneland November sale. His dam is a full-sister to 1998 champion turf mare Fiji (GB). She foaled a son of Fipke's 2008 Queen's Plate winner Not Bourbon (Not Impossible {Ire}) in 2012.

One of Todd Pletcher's numerous 2-year-old graduates at Saratoga last August, Overanalyze was fourth behind stablemate and eventual champion Shanghai Bobby (Harlan's Holiday) in the Spa's GII Hopeful S. Sept. 3. He bounced back to take Belmont's six-furlong GII Futurity S. Sept. 30, and checked in third when stretched to a mile under the Twin Spires in the GIII Iroquois Oct. 28. The bay earned a 99 Beyer Speed Figure when holding off GI Wood Memorial S. runner-up Normandy Invasion (Tapit) in the GII Remsen S. at this distance in Ozone Park Nov. 24, but disappointed as the chalk on seasonal debut in that track's GIII Gotham S. Mar. 2.

Hung four deep on the first turn while traveling in midpack, Overanalyze tracked splits of :23.32 and :47.64 before seeming to spin his wheels on the home bend. He kept plugging away, however, and ranged up outside of Frac Daddy at the head of the lane as pacesetter Falling Sky (Lion Heart) tried to fend off Den's Legacy (Medaglia d'Oro). Overanalyze bore in slightly as he asserted for the lead at the eighth pole, but with a tug of the reins, rider Rafael Bejarano righted the ship and it was all over.

"This is my Derby horse, I'm pretty sure," said Bejarano. "My horse broke really good. I placed him right behind the early speed because I didn't want to rush him. At the half-mile pole, He started to chase the horses on the lead and he kicked clear. I had a beautiful trip. Once we got to the stretch, I felt like I had a lot of horse left and saved something for the next race."

Repole, who also has major GI Kentucky Oaks contender Unlimited Budget (Street Sense) with Pletcher, said via phone, "I wasn't surprised that he won, but I was shocked at how easy he won. I'm really blessed to have a filly for the Oaks and now a colt for the Derby."

McPeek's assistant Phil Bauer, who lodged an objection against the winner, explained the reasoning for his action: "We were in a full drive and he eased over on us. [Frac Daddy's rider Victor Lebron] had to stop riding for a few seconds. It really did affect the margin of victory so I took a shot in the dark, but I was really pleased with the way out horse ran. You can't take anything away from him."

War Academy, who was hard to load and forwardly placed along the rail before rider Mike Smith pulled him up, walked off the track under his own power. "He was just very uncertain over the surface and I tried to get him to settle," said the Hall of Famer. "He was ok the first turn, but then he took four or five really awkward steps. I didn't see anything major causing it, but I just felt really awkward on him and figured 'better safe than sorry,' so I pulled him up. I didn't want to take any chances."

Daisy Devine turned in a gallant effort from the front end in defense of her Jenny Wiley title, but in the end, the class of Centre Court won out en route to a breakthrough success at the highest level. The homebred went on a three-race winning streak last spring and early summer, winning her maiden at Churchill Downs in May, that track's Gll Regret S. June 16 and Saratoga's Gll Lake George S. July 25. Runner-up in the Gll Lake Placid S. at the Spa Aug. 19 and in the Gll Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at this venue in October, the dark bay got back to winning ways in the Gll Mrs. Revere S. Nov. 17 and easily accounted for Samitar in Gulfstream's Gll Honey Fox S. in her seasonal debut Mar. 16. As expected, Daisy Devine led them a few strides out of the gate, and while she had a reasonably easy time of it (opening half in :48 flat), she did have to go harder than she did last year, when she covered the opening half-mile in a pedestrian :50 3/5. Centre Court bided her time from third, but still had plenty of work to do to reel in the front-runner, who was about five in front as they cornered.

However, the public's choice began to bear down in upper stretch, collared Daisy Devine at the eighth pole and drove clear. Samitar rallied nicely to be third.

"I got a little worried around the three-eighths pole," said jockey Julien Leparoux when asked if he ever thought Daisy Devine had stolen away.

"But coming to the quarter pole, I knew I was running faster and I

knew I was going to catch her. She's a good filly. She's gotten a lot better from last year. She was already good, but she got a lot better this year. We're looking forward to a great year from her." Trainer Rusty Arnold indicated that the long-term goals for Centre Court are either the GI Diana S. at Saratoga July 27 or the GI Beverly D. S. at Arlington Aug. 17.

Last Full Measure had never gone shorter than a mile in 10 previous efforts, but the St George Farm homebred continued her exported sire's success in Grade Is for females over the Keeneland Polytrack with an upset victory here. She took an 8 1/2-furlong allowance by a nose here last October before finishing third to Daisy Devine (Kafwain) in the GIII Cardinal H. over the Churchill sod in November to finish off 2012. She filled out the tri again in Tampa's GIII Endeavour S. Feb. 3, but was a dull ninth in that venue's nine-furlong GIII Hillsborough S. Mar. 9. Allowed to caboose the field early as Jamaican Smoke carved out splits of :22.33 and :45.23, Last Full Measure shifted to the outside of Byrama for clear sailing nearing the stretch. The pacesetter had opened daylight past the eighth pole, but was clearly growing leg weary as Last Full Measure began to inch closer ominously. The bay took over in the waning strides, and found the line just in time with Byrama breathing down her neck. An objection was lodged claiming that Last Full Measure cut off Byrama in midstretch, but it was quickly disallowed. "I guess it just took me a while to figure out she wanted to sprint," trainer Philip Oliver said glibly. "The race didn't seem like it was coming up that tough so we just decided we'd take a shot and it turned out pretty good."

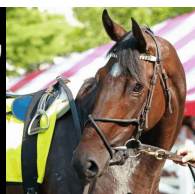

"I guess it just took me a while to figure out she wanted to sprint," trainer Philip Oliver said glibly. "The race didn't seem like it was coming up that tough so we just decided we'd take a shot and it turned out pretty good."

Mizdirection came into this test supported by an impressive record, boasting a perfect five-for-five over the Santa Anita turf course. A stakes winner and graded stakes placed at three, the grey kicked off her 4-year-old season with a three-race winning skein, including a score in the 6 1/2-furlong GIII Monrovia S. and last year's renewal of this race, which was downgraded when pulled off the turf. Beaten by Mega Dream (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Great Lady M S. last May, she was sent to the sidelines and didn't resurface until a victory over Unbridled's Note (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Santa Anita. Up late to defend her title in the Jan. 6 Monrovia, she was an impressive 2 1/4-length winner in her latest to the post in the GII Buena Vista S. Feb. 18. Off the blocks in good order this time, she quickly moved to the front, but allowed stablemate Schiaparelli to take over and carve out an opening quarter mile in :22.41. Applying some pressure on that rival through a half in :44.64, she appeared beaten as the leader opened up a four-length cushion in early stretch, but she came on again late to best that rival by a half length at the wire. "I felt at a point in the stretch that [Mizdirection] wasn't going to get there," admitted trainer Mike Puype. "The other filly was running and she made it hard on her and she barely got there as it was. She always shows up. She's a very live horse. We'll wait for the [GI] Just a Game [S. at Belmont Park on June 8], a flat mile."

Veteran Havelock boasted a victory in the 2011 GIII Woodford S. over this course and distance, but was let go at double his 4-1 morning line making his first start as a 6-year-old here. The bay also took the GII Play the King S. at Woodbine two years ago and last May's GIII Hanshin S. going a mile over the Arlington Polytrack. Fourth behind the red-hot Delaunay (Smoke Glacken) in the Nov. 3 Bet On Sunshine S. on the Churchill main track, he had last been seen checking in seventh in Woodbine's GIII Kennedy Road S. Nov. 25. Last from the gate, Havelock bided his time at the back early and still had tons to do by the time they hit the straight. Maneuvered to the inside by pilot Garret Gomez, he began to slowly pick off horses, but seemed at midstretch to be one-paced. Favorite Something Extra cut through a seam on Havelock's outside, and the sight of that horse seemed to conjure up another gear from the winner. One of five across the track nearing the line, he scraped paint and got his nose down at the right time. "He loves it here," said winning trainer Darrin Miller, who sent out Silverton Hill's Dominican (El Corredor) to a victory on this card in the 2007 GI Blue Grass S. "Garrett was humble, and I want to say that was all him. He made every decision the right decision. [Havelock is] a great horse. He's a lot of fun. He always shows up. Garrett did a fantastic job."

With the early-week withdrawal of top rival Fiveandahalfstar (Aus) (Hotel Grand {Aus}) due to injury, It's A Dundee figured to dominate Saturday's G1 Australian Derby and ran out a highly impressive winner in his first go at 2400 meters. A disappointing seventh to Fiveandahalfstar in the G1 Victoria Derby Nov. 3, It's A Dundee was a useful fourth to Pierro (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}) in the G2 Hobartville S. over heavy Rosehill turf Mar. 2, but atoned for that effort with sound victories in the 1600-meter G1 Randwick Guineas at Warwick Farm Mar. 16 and in the G1 Rosehill Guineas going a mile and a quarter Mar. 30. He was looking to become Sydney's first Triple Crown winner since Octagonal (NZ) in 1996 and did so with utter authority. Wrangled back to race one from the rear for James McDonald, It's A Dundee was quietly ridden through the opening 10 furlongs before being allowed to loop rivals approaching the stretch. He left his rivals for dead within a matter of strides and raced away to an imperious success, hinting at even better to come in the future. Philippi, exiting a win in last weekend's G2 Tulloch S., claimed second, while Kingdoms completed a 1-3 finish for his sire. "He's the best [I've trained], I think he is a very good horse," trainer Murray Baker told reporters afterwards. While he could run back in the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. in two weeks time against his elders, McDonald was asked about the colt's Melbourne Cup prospects. "On that performance he was hitting the line as strong as ever and he'll run the two-miles no worries!" he confirmed.

"I found a nice spot--that was going to be the most difficult thing with drawing one," Nolen recollected of his strategy. "We were running third and I just wanted to give myself more opportunity and clear running." And to those who questioned whether she was vulnerable? "She wasn't a protected species today and she had to earn it. If there are any knockers after that, come and see me and I'll sort you out," he said wryly. It was her eighth straight win at the highest level and 15th overall, surpassing the previous Australian mark held by Kingston Town (Aus). No firm plans are in place for a possible next start, but that could reportedly come in Brisbane, Adelaide or back at Royal Ascot.

Trainer Gai Waterhouse showed typical confidence in backing up G1 Golden Slipper S. winner Overreach on just one weeks' rest in Saturday's G1 Sires' Produce S., but despite having things her own way up front, was victimized by a stinging late rally from Slipper fourth Guelph. A maiden winner at Warwick Farm Jan. 26, Sheikh Mohammed's homebred bested stablemate Montsegur (Aus) (New Approach {Ire}) in the fillies' division of the G3 Blue Diamond Prelude S. at Caulfield Feb. 9, but was only ninth to Miracles of Life (Aus) (Not a Single Doubt {Aus}) when well-supported in the G1 Blue Diamond S. a fortnight later. Guelph was then trained up to the Slipper and was running on well at the end of the 1200-meter test to finish within 3 1/2 lengths of Overreach. The chief market rival here, the Darley runner had no choice but to cover ground from the 13 hole and looked to have a tough task ahead of her, as the favorite enjoyed a reasonably soft time while tracked by Villa Verde (Aus) (Not a Single Doubt {Aus}). The Slipper winner led comfortably into the lane, but Scandiva, a half-sister to the dam of Black Caviar emerged a threat, putting a head in front in deep stretch. Those two dueled for a couple of strides, but Kerrin McEvoy was just winding up Guelph from behind and she stormed past for the victory. "Whatever you ask her she tries to do it," McEvoy said. "She's got a great attitude and the ability to match." Ironically, Guelph's dam won the Blue Diamond Prelude and Sires' Produce S. in her 2-year-old season in 2007. The winner is likely to run back in the G1 Champagne S. Apr. 27. It was another big day for Exceed and Excel, who, in addition to the 1-3 finish here, was the sire of Safeguard (Aus), winner of the G3 Kindergarten S. earlier on the card, and the Peter Moody-trained Kulgrinda (Aus) in the G3 R N Irwin S. at Morphettville.



BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

WIDE OPEN GROUP IN BEAUMONT

An evenly matched field of 11 sophomore filly sprinters line up for today's GII Beaumont S. presented by Keeneland Select. Columbine Stable's **Magical Moon** (Malibu Moon), scratched from last week's GI Ashland S., could appreciate the return to Keeneland's Polytrack. The AI Stall trainee was up on a hot pace before settling for third in last October's GI Darley Alcibiades S. She was most recently a rank fourth in the grassy Allen Lacombe Memorial S. Mar. 2. Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' **Judy In Disguise (GB)** (Elusive Quality) gets the narrow morning-line nod at 7-2 as she seeks her third win from as many Stateside tries. The former British-based Bill Turner trainee romped by seven lengths in a Golden Gate optional claimer in her first try for Simon Callaghan Feb. 12, and took the Sweet Life S. down the hill at Santa Anita two weeks later. **Lady Banks** (Successful Appeal) rates a longshot look turning back off a distant fourth-place finish behind Live Lively (Medaglia d'Oro) and Dreaming of Julia (A.P. Indy) in the Feb. 23 GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream. She took Aqueduct's six-furlong Ruthless S. previously in the slop Jan. 12. **Renee's Titan** (Bernstein), who upended champion Beholder (Henny Hughes) two back in the GII Santa Ynez S. Jan. 21, goes out for the same connections as yesterday's GIII Commonwealth S. winner Handsome Mike (Scat Daddy). She was eighth last time in the one-mile GI Las Virgenes S. Mar. 2.

LET BATTLE COMMENCE

Leopardstown's G3 P W McGrath Memorial Ballysax S. has proved fertile ground for burgeoning Derby prospects in recent times, with Ireland's power stables of Aidan O'Brien and Jim Bolger firing the opening salvos from their considerable armories. The score stands at seven-six in favor of Coolcullen at this point, including the last three renewals but Ballydoyle appear to hold a strong hand this time with **Battle of Marengo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) heading the list. Successful in this track's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Trial S. in early September, he followed up in the G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh later that month for which he picks up a five-pound penalty here. He is joined by his exciting stable companion **Foundry (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who made an instant impression on debut when scoring by 5 1/2 lengths over seven furlongs here in November. Joseph O'Brien is on Battle of Marengo and he told *PA Sport*, "If he runs a nice race, we'll be happy. I would be a little but worried if the ground went very soft. There's no denying he gets through it all right, but I've always thought he was a better horse on better ground. He's a lovely-moving horse and the day he won in Leopardstown last year on good ground, my saddle slipped, I couldn't push him at all in the straight and he still broke the track record. For his first run back and his first run over a mile and a quarter, you wouldn't want the ground to be too bad. [Foundry] only had the one run towards the back-end of last year, but he couldn't have done it any easier than he did. Seamus [Heffernan] was very impressed with him and we were all delighted, so hopefully he'll run a nice race on Sunday as well, but Battle of Marengo is obviously the form horse." Of the Bolger pair, Kevin Manning has opted to ride **Alpinist (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}) over the G3 Killavullan S. runner-up **Beyond Thankful (Ire)** (Whipper) and the former secured this opportunity with a mile maiden win at The Curragh Mar. 24. "He's very well and we're hoping he can make the step up, but it won't be easy," Bolger told *PA Sport*. "He has plenty of speed and we could have stayed at a mile if we'd wanted to, but we made a decision to come for this race and go down the middle-distance route. I think better ground will suit him well." Interestingly, Beyond Thankful was beaten nearly 12 lengths by Richard Barnes' **Sugar Boy (Ire)** (Authorized {Ire}) when fourth in the nine-furlong Listed Eyrefield S. here in November and that rival will be a tough nut to crack if he repeats that achievement.

QUEEN BEE

Aidan O'Brien's record of eight renewals of today's G3 Leopardstown 1,000 Guineas Trial since 1997 bodes well for the prospects of **Snow Queen (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who appeared a typical improver from the Rosegreen establishment last term. Runner-up in the Listed Blenheim S. over six furlongs at The Curragh in September, Diane Nagle and Susan Magnier's bay ended up with a win in the prestigious Birdcatcher Nursery over that trip at Naas the next month. Rider Joseph O'Brien told *PA Sport*, "She's in good form and she's a filly with plenty of ability, but she has her quirks. She won a good race over six furlongs on her last run last year and I don't see any reason why she wouldn't stay a mile. She has form on softer ground, so hopefully, she'll run a nice race." Another trainer with a fine record in this is John Oxx, with five editions to his name, and his representative this time is **What Style (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}). She beat Snow Queen on her sole start over this track and trip in August and her conditioner is keen to see her back in action. "What Style is going all right and has just had the one run which she won, so she's an unknown quantity," he told *PA Sport*. "It's a good race with a good-level standard of fillies with good ratings and a bit of experience behind them, so she's up against it. We've no idea what her level will be eventually. She doesn't require a lot of homework, so we'll have to run her a couple of times to see where she fits in."

If Morandi is able to translate his superiority over this shorter trip, his rivals will find it hard to live with him but if he is vulnerable it may be that Jean-Louis Bouchard's **Us Law (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) can profit. A solid campaigner at two, the Pascal Bary trainee annexed Saint-Cloud's G3 Prix Thomas Bryon over a mile in October before finishing third behind Loch Garman (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in the G1 Criterium International back at that track the following month.

EXTRA SECURITY MEASURES FOR DERBY

A 24-hour surveillance will be placed on this year's GI Kentucky Derby entrants, the *New York Times* reports. Former Kentucky Derby-winning trainer John Ward, the executive director of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, also told the publication that trainers, veterinarians and staff would be required to log in and out at the barn and that an expanded drug testing policy will also be in place for the Derby runners. "We're trying to have everything bulletproof," Ward commented. "We want people to understand that we are doing everything we can to be transparent and present a clean and safely run race to a casual fan who tunes in for the spectacle, as well as our betting customers."

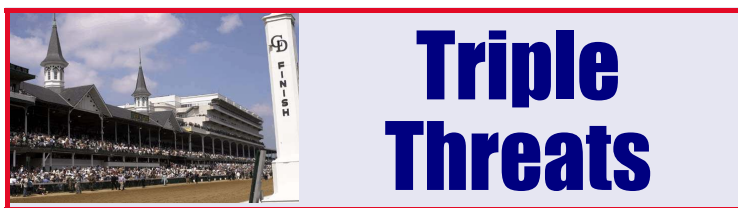

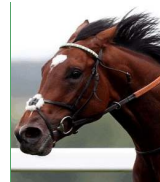

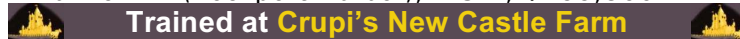
