## SOLIS STARS AT INGLIS BROODMARES SALE

American interests provided the main buying power at the Super Select Session of the Inglis Easter Broodmare Sale at Newmarket Tuesday, the first of three days of broodmare sales. Overall 125 mares were sold for A\$10,882,000 (US\$11,256,460).

California-based bloodstock agent Alex Solis II stepped into the market to buy two lots for A\$1.26 million, including the session-topping lot 127, **One World (Aus)** (Danehill), for A\$720,000 (US\$744,703).

Buying under his Solis Bloodstock banner, he had to withstand strong competition for One World, by Danehill out of the

unraced Artichoke mare Prawn Cocktail, with bidding commencing at A\$300,000. Initially bids went up on \$25,000 lots to A\$500,000 and then it came back to A\$20,000 all the way through to the final bid from Solis.

A Group 3 winner at two, One World has produced 2011 G3 Blue Diamond Prelude S. winner One Last Dance (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) from three named foals to race and was the lone mare Tuesday offered in foal to Lonhro (Aus). She was consigned to the sale by Coolmore Stud.

One World is a full-sister to GSW Langoustine (Aus) and her dam Prawn Cocktail is a half-sister to Royal Academy and to Terlingua, the dam of Storm Cat.

Solis's other purchase was lot 53, Diamond Necklace (Unbridled's Song), for A\$540,000 (US\$559,655). The 9-year-old has left two named foals with both raced. She is in foal to Commands (Aus). The 9-year-old is another with an attractive pedigree. A \$1.15-million Keeneland November weanling purchase in 2004, the half-sister to champion and top sire Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) was stakes-placed in Europe before being sold to the Fleming family's Tyreel Stud for \$1.3 million carrying a full-sister to Shamardal at the 2008 November sale. Diamond Necklace's dam, Helsinki (GB), is a full-sister to another top sire in Street Cry (Ire).

"I have clients back home who are putting together broodmare bands, and these mares will go back to Kentucky," said Solis, explaining his purchases. "Look at the pedigrees--they are huge pages, and we are looking for that kind of pedigree with stallion pedigrees. One World's pedigree goes back to Storm Cat and Royal Academy, which is very hard to get in America. The mare could run herself, and at one time she was the favourite for the Slipper. We are very excited to have a mare like her to take back home. She was precocious so that is what we look for," he added.

UK-based bloodstock agent David Redvers, who signed for nine horses at last week's Easter Yearling sale, including an A\$700,000 daughter of Fastnet Rock (Aus)--Myrrh (NZ) (Nassipour), struck for the opening session's third-dearest lot when going to A\$460,000 (US\$476,741) for lot 155, Group 3 winner Rosa's Spur (Aus) (Flying Spur {Aus}). Consigned by Arrowfield Stud on behalf of the Michael Pitt Dispersal, the 10-year-old is already the dam of SW and MGSP Members Joy (Aus) (Hussonet) and was offered pregnant to More Than Ready. The resultant offspring will be bred on the same cross as 2008 G1 Golden Slipper S. winner and sire Sebring (Aus).



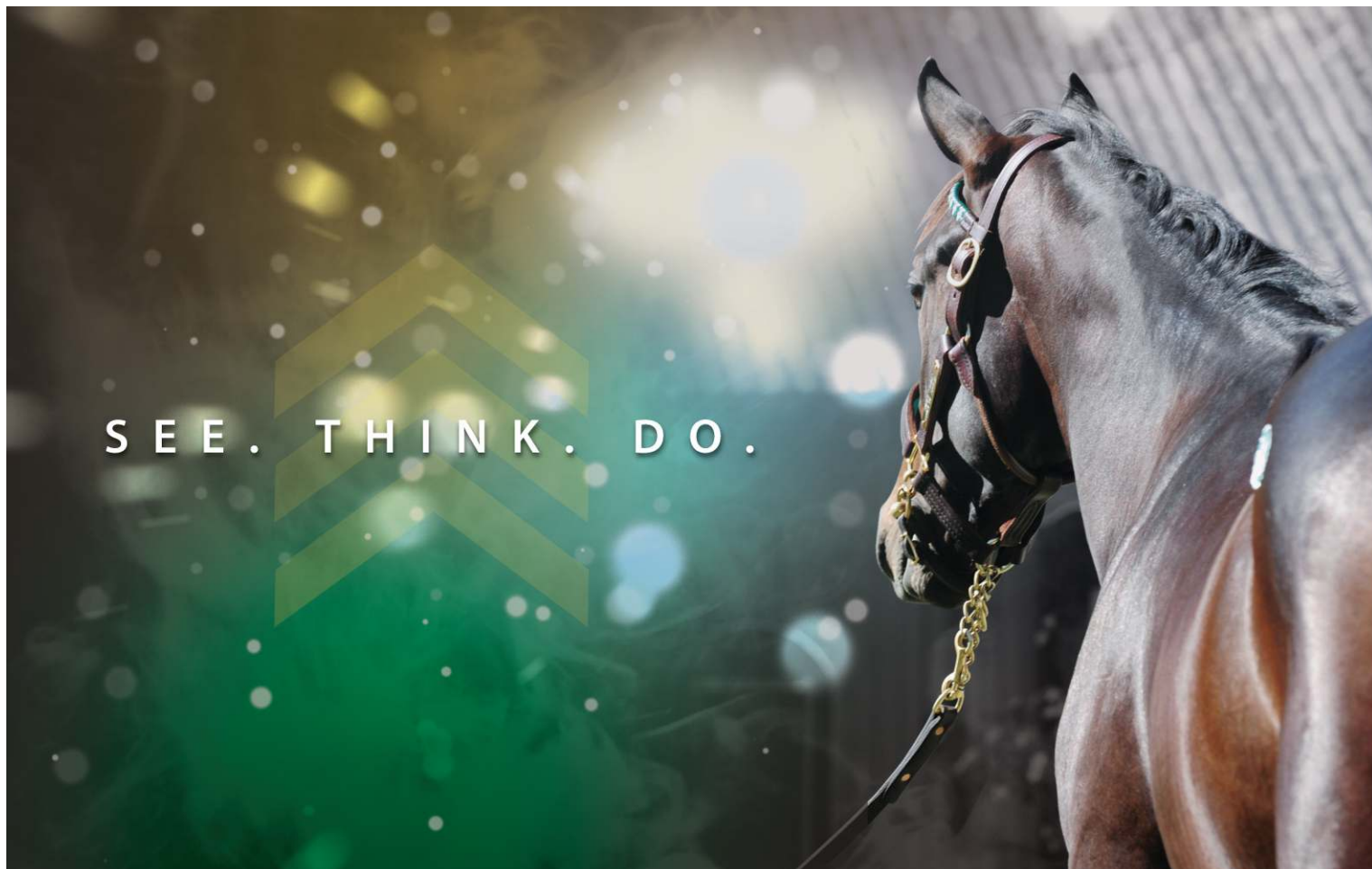

**Baramul, Emirates Expand Their Bands...**

Major Australian studs, including Baramul and Emirates Park, were also responsible for high-priced lots Tuesday afternoon at Inglis. On behalf of his Baramul Stud, Gerry Harvey was the successful bidder on lot 141, **Prima Nova (Aus)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) for A\$400,000 (US\$414,594). Bidding commenced at A\$150,000 and Harvey was leading the bidding right through to the final price. A daughter of Group 1 winner Bonanova (NZ) (Star Way {GB}), the 9-year-old was a two-time stakes winner and runner-up in the G1 Winter S., and was carrying to Manhattan Rain (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}). Emirates Park's Trevor Lobb signed for lot 173, **Snowgums (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) for A\$440,000 (US\$456,357). Consigned by Newgate Farm, the half-sister to G1 Galaxy H. hero **Snowland (Aus)** (Snippets {Aus}) is carrying her first foal by G1 Blue Diamond S. hero Sepoy (Aus) (Elusive Quality).

**BREEZERS AT THE READY IN NEWMARKET**

Tattersalls could ask for no finer advertisement for its Craven Breeze-up Sale, which starts today at 6 p.m. local time, than the forthcoming appearances this Saturday of two of the 2012 sale's graduates in the Classic trials at Newbury. Moohaajim (Ire), a neat son of Cape Cross (Ire) bought from the Hillwood Stud draft by Marco Botti for 200,000gns last year, lines up for the G3 Greenham S., a race won last year by fellow Craven graduate Caspar Netscher (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}), while the unbeaten G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Rosdhu Queen (Ire) (Invincible Spirit), a 65,000gns purchase by David Redvers for Clipper Logistics, is entered in Newbury's fillies' trial, the G3 Dubai Duty Free S., better known as the Fred Darling S. Rosdhu Queen was consigned last year by Brendan Holland's Grove Stud, which this year offers two more Invincible Spirit juveniles among its draft of nine. Lot 50 is a colt out of the Group 3-winning 2-year-old Quad's Melody (Ire) (Spinning World), a half-sister to GII Del Mar H. winner Bonapartiste (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}).

The first lot into the ring on the second day of the sale is an Invincible Spirit filly (lot [92](#)) out of Albarouche (GB) (Sadler's Wells), a full-sister to Dragon Dancer (GB), who was beaten a short head by Sir Percy in the 2006 Derby at Epsom.

"By the time you get to the breeze, you just want them all to get through it safe and sound and for the nice horses not to disappoint," said Holland, whose team was still showing horses past 5 p.m. at Park Paddocks yesterday. "I thought we'd have put them away by now, but I'm not complaining. It's a relief once they've all come through their breezes okay, and we've been really busy all afternoon. It's been great to have some really positive

feedback about the horses. The fact that we're so busy is a reflection of a good morning's work."

Tally-Ho Stud topped last year's Craven Sale with a Shamardal colt who was knocked down for 500,000gns to John Ferguson on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed. Tony and Roger O'Callaghan have another eight to offer this year at Tattersalls, including a daughter of Elusive Quality who enjoyed a timely update to her pedigree on Saturday.

The half-sister to Saturday's GI Arkansas Derby winner Overanalyze (Dixie Union) sells towards the end of today's session as lot [83](#) and was bought last year at Keeneland's September sale for \$40,000 by Italian agent Federico Barberini, the man also responsible for buying the five-time Group 1-winning sprinter Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) at Keeneland for just \$11,000.

"I was very surprised that she was such good value," said Barberini, speaking at Tattersalls after the Elusive Quality filly had breezed on ground adjacent to Newmarket's Rowley Mile.

"Overanalyze was already a good 2-year-old when she was sold and there was nothing wrong with her. The mare [Unaccloud] has done nothing wrong either. It was fantastic to see Overanalyze win his Grade I at the weekend and I hope that the filly sells well for Roger [O'Callaghan]."

John Ferguson signed for three lots last year for 740,000gns and he was present at Tuesday morning's breeze, as was Sheikh Mohammed, in company with Godolphin trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni.

Nicolas de Watrigant, who buys principally for Qatar's Sheikh Joann Al-Thani, was also at the breeze, along with the A team from Rabbah and a wide range of trainers, including Marcus Tregoning, Sir Mark Prescott, Marco Botti, James Fanshawe, Roger Varian, John Quinn and Jeremy Gask. Later in the afternoon at Tattersalls, Animal Kingdom's trainer Graham Motion was also spotted.

Newmarket's undulations provide quite a test for the 2-year-olds, who are required to gallop slightly downhill as the pace quickens before finishing off uphill. Added to the vagaries of the heath's ancient turf was a strong cross-wind on Tuesday morning. There are no official times recorded for breeze-up sales in Europe as in North America, but plenty of the major buyers have invested in their own timing systems and several of the fastest breeders of the day included Friarstown Bloodstock's More Than Ready colt (lot 6) out of Mary Ellise (In Excess {Ire}) and an Intikhab colt (lot 11) from the family of July Cup winner Owington (GB) consigned by Con Marnane's Bansha House Stables. The Bansha draft also includes a Royal Applause (GB) half-brother to Overdose (GB), the sprinter dubbed the 'Budapest Bullet', and three 2-year-olds by last season's champion first-season sire New Approach (Ire).

At the time of writing, there were 19 withdrawals from the 182-lot catalogue, with action in the sales ring set to take place over two evenings after racing on the Rowley Mile.

Fifth on debut over a mile at this track in October, Ferevia broke her maiden over 11 furlongs at Amiens Mar. 27 and took a major leap forward with an impressive score in this G1 Prix de Diane trial. Keen early, the bay was steadied in rear by Olivier Peslier as the favorite Baltic Baroness shared front-running duties with Orion Love (GB) (Zamindar). Cajoled into action on the home turn, the homebred was switched into the clear as Maxime Guyon sent the favorite into a daylight lead and had almost three lengths still to find approaching the furlong pole. Picking up in style, she inhaled that rival with 50 meters to race and drew away for a convincing success, with Orion Love losing third spot in the stewards' room after causing interference against the rail late on.

# BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

## LOOK TO THE SKY

Today's G3 Lanwades Stud Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket should go some way to shedding light in the G1 1000 Guineas picture, with five black-type winners pitched against two exciting maiden winners. In the former category is last year's G1 Moyglare Stud S. heroine **Sky Lantern (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}), who signed off with a luckless run when a hampered eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita in November. The form of her Moyglare success looked strong at the time, and it may be worth taking Monday's maiden flop of the runner-up Scintillula (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) with a pinch of salt. Trainer Richard Hannon said, "We did not want to risk waiting for Newbury, so we took a chance on the ground and opted for the Nell Gwyn over the Fred Darling for Sky Lantern and it seems that we might get lucky, as conditions seem to be drying up at Newmarket. Sky Lantern has thrived through the winter and she did her best piece of work yet on Monday morning, so we could not be happier with her." Among the unproven and untested category are Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Lady Nouf (GB)** (Teofilo {Ire}) and Khalid Abdullah's **Hot Snap (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}). Both won their only starts in talking fashion, and the former accounted for the subsequent impressive winner Secret Gesture (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and listed-placed Desert Image (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}) over this trip at Leicester in October, while Hot Snap's score came over a mile on the Polytrack at Kempton in September. A half-sister to Middy (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), she may find this trip on the sharp side, but Sir Henry Cecil still holds the record of seven winners in this, even if he has not sent one to post since 1987.

# NEWS TODAY

## RODRIGUEZ GIVEN CONDITIONAL LICENSE

Following a two-hour hearing, the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission License Review Committee ruled to grant a license to Rudy Rodriguez, who conditions Kentucky Derby hopeful Vyjack (Into Mischief) on the condition that this year's GIII Gotham S.m winner be monitored by 24-hour video surveillance while stabled at Churchill Downs. The surveillance must be approved by the KHRC and open to KHRC officials at any time. Vyjack, third behind Verrazano (More Than Ready) last time out in the Apr. 6 GI Wood Memorial, is currently being treated for a mild lung infection at Fair Hill Training Center in Maryland. Among the chief topics discussed at yesterday's hearing was a 2007 violation handed down by New Jersey regulators regarding his association with Wild Desert (Wild Rush), who was allegedly being trained under a false name at Aqueduct by trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. who serving a suspension during that time. Rodriguez, who was working as an exercise rider for Dutrow during that time, was given a 7-day suspension and \$2,500 fine in association with that horse. In more recent times, Rodriguez has been under scrutiny for drug positive results in New York.

## GRADE II WINNER EL PADRINO RETIRED

Let's Go Stable's **El Padrino** (Pulpit--Enchanted Rock, by Giant's Causeway) has been retired from racing, it was announced Tuesday. Stud plans for the half-brother to GI Wood Memorial S. winner Verrazano

(More Than Ready) have yet to be finalized. "It's unfortunate that El Padrino won't have a Grade I win next to his name, because he certainly demonstrated to us the ability to win at that level," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "There's no doubt that he has the talent, looks, and pedigree to be a top-class stallion." A

runaway winner at Belmont in his second career start, El Padrino was third in his juvenile finale in the GII Remsen S. The \$210,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase kicked off his sophomore campaign with a pair of victories, including the GII Risen Star S. Fourth in the GI Florida Derby, he came home 13th in the Kentucky Derby. The colt had been targeted toward the Feb. 9 GI Donn H. following a second-place effort in an \$80,000 optional claiming test at Gulfstream Dec. 19. "El Padrino exited the Kentucky Derby with a minor injury to his left fore and though he was poised for a big 4-year-old campaign," Let's Go Racing principal's Bryan Sullivan and Kevin Scatuorchio said in a release. "A recurrence of that same injury knocked us off course for the GI Donn H. this winter."

## Midday Confirmed in Foal to Frankel...

Juddmonte Farms' MG1SW **Midday (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}--Midsummer {GB}, by Kingmambo) has been scanned in foal to **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), it was confirmed yesterday. The 7-year-old prevailed six times at the highest level, including three straight scores in Goodwood's G1 Nassau S., and was the first mare to be covered by the operation's unbeaten dual World Champion. She successfully delivered her first offspring, a bay colt by Galileo, in January. "It is now six weeks since Midday was last covered and we are happy that everything is progressing as it should," commented Juddmonte's Philip Mitchell. "With 16 Group 1 wins between the sire and the dam, it is a mating that has attracted a great deal of interest, and we look forward to next year's foal with great anticipation." Ollie Pynn, of veterinarians Rosssdales and Partners, undertook the scanning procedure and Juddmonte has posted a youtube video online, which can be viewed [here](#).

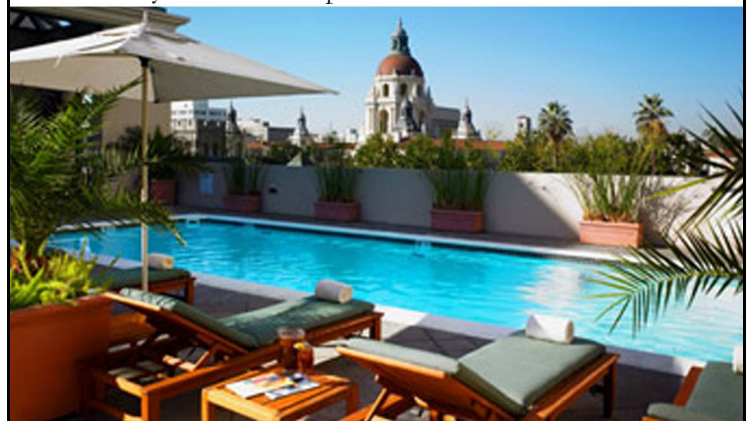

**NEW CHART TOPPER: WAR PASS**

Just two weeks after his Revolutionary won the \$1-million GII Louisiana Derby, Lane's End's late 2007 champion 2-year-old **War Pass** (Cherokee Run) moved to the top of the 2013 Second-Crop Sire List ([click here](#)), by virtue of Java's War's win in last Saturday's

\$750,000 GI Blue Grass S (Beyer a low 89). On Monday, War Pass, who has just seven winners this year, of which four are black-type horses, was around \$16,000 in front of Hill 'n' Dale's two-time

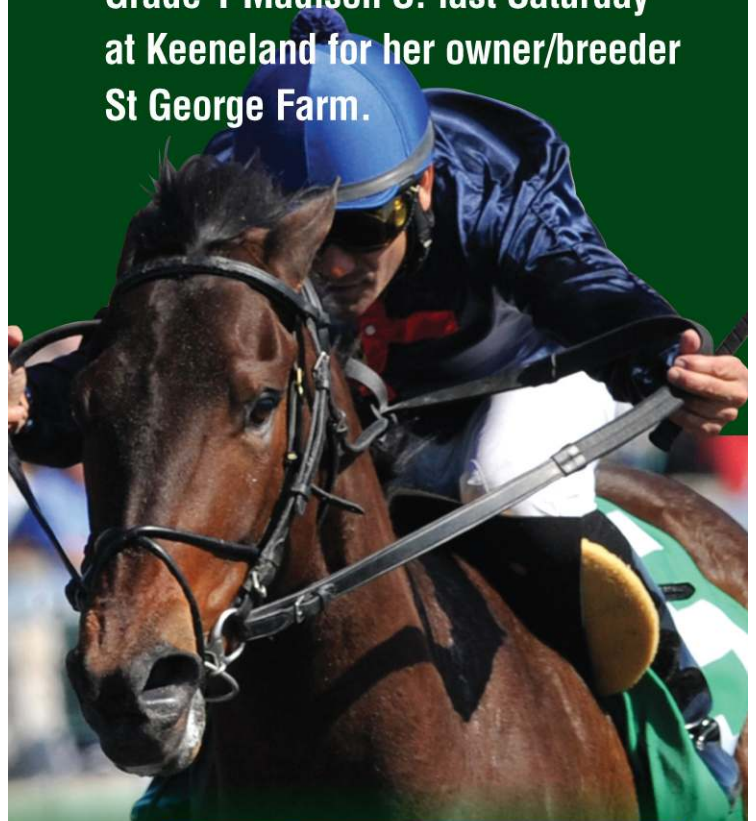
GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner, **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet), who leapt to the head of the class last month ([click here](#) to read Andrew Caulfield's column yesterday about War Pass and Java's War).

Spendthrift's **Into Mischief** (Harlan's Holiday) is in third, with Ashford's **Majestic Warrior** (A.P. Indy) rounding out a quartet of North American second-crop sires with over \$1-million in progeny earnings so far this year. Darley's 2008 GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Raven's Pass** (Elusive Quality), who had a good winter in Dubai, is in fifth place, with two-time Horse of the Year and \$10-million earner **Curlin** (Smart Strike), now over \$700,000 for the year after his Palace Malice ran a game second in the GI Blue Grass, in sixth.

The three top second-crop sires are each due to have two runners in the May 4 GI Kentucky Derby. War Pass will have the two trial winners, as mentioned, Revolutionary and Java's War; they would both figure to go off around the 15-1 mark. Midnight Lute is due to be represented by GIII Sunland Derby winner Governor Charlie and GII Louisiana Derby second Mylute, who will be around the same price and longer, respectively. Into Mischief will have GI Santa Anita Derby winner (Beyer 105, highest of the Grade I nine-furlong preps) Goldencents--he figures to go off third choice, at around 7-1--and GI Wood Memorial third Vyjack. Palace Malice will line up for Curlin, which means roughly a third of the field will be from their sires' first crops.

The two favorites, though, will be the unbeaten GI Wood Memorial (Beyer 95) winner Verrazano (More Than Ready), who, as predicted, John Velasquez will stick with, and the GI Florida Derby (Beyer 97) winner, Orb (Malibu Moon), who is unbeaten this year, and will get Joel Rosario. I went back and watched the Wood again, and the second time I thought Verrazano had won it with a bit more in hand than I originally thought. We're still guessing whether he will get 10 furlongs after a dawdling pace and sprint finish in the Wood, but I like his chances better after watching the replay a second time. Verrazano is likely to go off around 7-2, with Orb around 5-1, and Goldencents likely to be the only other Derby starter under 10-1. It looks a pretty open race, though; you wouldn't mind being live with 'All' in a Pick-3 of Pick-4 as the band strikes up 'My Old Kentucky Home.'

**More Second-Crop Sires**

Darley's **Street Boss** (Street Cry) now has 19 winners this year, placing him one ahead of Millennium Farm's **Student Council** (Kingmambo), who won the GI Pacific Classic on the all-weather and the GI Pimlico Classic on the dirt, and one adrift of leader Majestic Warrior. A two-turn horse himself, Student Council had a good meet at Oaklawn Park, siring the six-furlong Martha Washington S. winner Sister Ginger in February. Last weekend another filly, Alli Leigh, won her second of the meet in a two-turn 'non-winners of two' allowance. Now in 12th spot on the 2013 second-crop sire list, Student Council could well be one to keep an eye on through the summer as a 'racehorse' sire.

WinStar's 2008 GI Norfolk S. winner **Street Hero**, another by Street Cry, got his second black-type winner over the weekend, the 3-year-old filly Street Girl, who won the Calder Oaks. Darby Dan's Magna Graduate is about as unheralded as they come. He earned over \$2.5 million, but that was from winning one Grade II, six Grade III's, and running third in the G1 Dubai World Cup. Also, he's by a pretty minor son of Danzig, Honor Grades (black-type placed half-brother to A.P. Indy and Summer Squall), but he's got a very decent filly in Blueyesintherein, who took her career record to 3-for-3 in her first 2013 start, the Instant Racing S. at Oaklawn Park. And do not forget top 2012 North American Freshman Sire, Coolmore's (formerly Ashford's) **Henrythenavigator** (Kingmambo). Aidan O'Brien is tuning up his two 2012 Grade I/Group 1 winners, George Vancouver and Pedro the Great, as well as another colt, Cristoforo Colombo, who was third to Dawn Approach in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot and might yet prove the best of them. Now a European second-crop sire, 'Henry' nevertheless got tuned up for the European season with a black-type winner at Santa Anita, the 3-year-old filly Jubilant Girl.

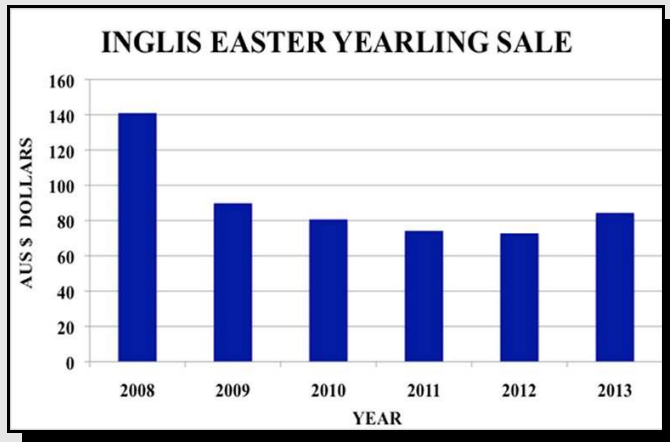

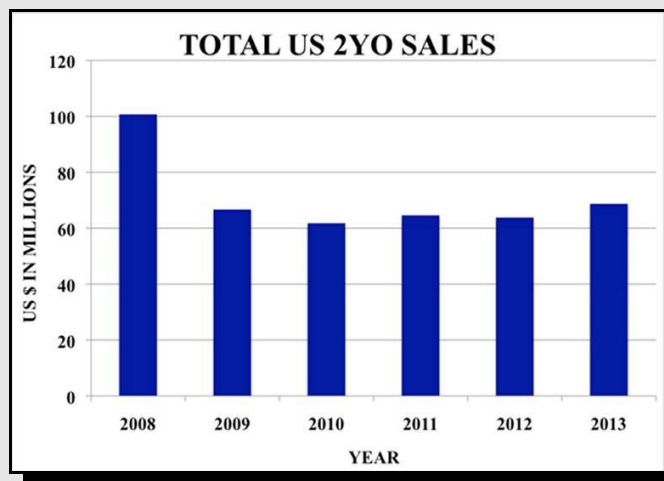

The 2013 third-crop sire list continues to be dominated by Darley sires. **Street Sense** (Street Cry), **Discreet Cat** (Forestry), **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor), and **Hard Spun** (Danzig) are 1-2-3-5 on the current list ([click here](#)), with former Stonewall stallion **Lawyer Ron** (Langfuhr, died after siring two crops) splitting them in fourth. The two big movers this week were Ashford's **Scat Daddy** (Johannesburg), into sixth, by virtue of 4-year-old Handsome Mike's win in Keeneland's GIII Commonwealth S., and 3-year-old Frac Daddy's second to Overanalyze in the GI Arkansas Derby, and Darley's Irish-based **Teofilo** (Galileo), who moves into seventh, miles clear of Coolmore's Dylan Thomas (Danehill) and Ireland's Morrishown Lattin Stud's Dark Angel (Acclamation), who had two 4-year-old black-type winners in England over the weekend, among European third-crop sires.

Teofilo is actually the leading third-crop sire of black-type winners so far this year, with four, including dual U.S. Grade II winner (on the grass) Amira's Prince. Two more of his 2013 black-type winners are on England's all-weather tracks, plus the 2011 G1 Dewhurst S. winner Parish Hill, making his first start in almost 18 months, won a 10-furlong listed race at the Curragh.

Also in Europe, the formerly obscure French sire **Kendargent** (Kendor) had the upset G3 Prix de la Grotte winner Kenhope in his second small crop. His first small crop included a filly who ran third to Black Caviar last year in the G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot. Kendargent's APEX rating at the end of 2012 was 6.25--they'd like him to keep that pace up, because it puts him among the world's leading sires. He looks awfully good for a former nobody.

Much of the focus was on batch eight, a 1600-meter trial which featured five of the runners. **Akeed Mofeed (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) will look to join Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) and Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}) as recent winners of the Hong Kong Derby to follow up successfully in the QE II, and the progressive 4-year-old showed that he retains the form which carried him to an impressive victory in the domestic centerpiece

Mar. 17. Better than midfield for Douglas Whyte, Akeed Mofeed raced in about sixth position on the turn, was steered out in upper stretch and ran on nicely in the final 50 meters to take the heat by 1 1/4 lengths from **Ashkiyr (Fr)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who was ninth in the Hong Kong Derby ([video](#)). The final time for the metric mile, around the cones, was 1:39.51. The latter is trained by John Moore, who also sent out **Military Attack (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) to a strong sixth in the same trial, ahead of stablemate **Irian (Ger)** (Tertullian) who closed off well to be eighth. "[Jockey] Derek [Leung] reported that he was very happy with the trial without over-stressing him at any time in the trial," said Moore of Military Attack. "He trialed really well even though he lost his off-hind shoe, and I'm going into the QEII hoping for a good gate and if he can bring his best that day he's a live chance." Batch nine at just over five furlongs on the all-weather featured two-time defending G1 Hong Kong Cup hero **California Memory** (Highest Honor {Fr}), who was asked the entire time by Matthew Chadwick and went around there at one pace, finishing last of 10 ([video](#)). "He was sore after his last run and had a few days off so this was a good blowout," said jockey Matthew Chadwick. "He's probably a bit behind but he's been slowly coming back to form and that trial should bring him on." California Memory was last seen finishing 10th to Military Attack in the Hong Kong Gold Cup over the QE II distance of 2000 meters Feb. 24. The Tony Cruz stable was also represented in the day's first heat by **Zaidan** (Street Cry {Ire}). Most recently sixth to Military Attack in the Premier Plate H. over 1800 meters Mar. 24, Zaidan was prominent for Chadwick on the far side, was overtaken by Group 2-placed sprinter Time After Time (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) inside the final furlong, but fought back to finish a half-head back in second ([video](#)).
