## EUROPEAN RECORD FALLS

The European record price for a breeze-up horse was smashed at Tattersalls Thursday when an Elusive Quality (Gone West) colt ([lot 148](#)) from the Lynn Lodge Stud draft was claimed by a determined Jamie McCalmont for 760,000gns (US \$1,219,725) during the second session of the Craven Breeze Up Sale.

The strong bay colt was one of the fastest breezers on the turf on Tuesday ([video](#)) and had been expected to sell well, but McCalmont had to dig deep to ensure he had the last word with Ross Doyle intent on making it a protracted bidding duel from his hiding place on the back stairs opposite the auctioneer. Doyle wasn't the only other interested party, but had outlasted Stephen Hillen, Richard Brown and Dick O'Gorman, all early participants in the chase.

"I hadn't really thought about what price he'd make, but to me he was the best horse in the sale," said McCalmont who declined to disclose the name of his client. "He's a solid, lovely horse and the sire is very good--he's had a Kentucky Derby winner [Smarty Jones], Quality Road, and Raven's Pass.

"I've been at the breeze-ups at Barretts, Keeneland and Palm Meadows, but this sale here is very, very strong," McCalmont added.

While last year's Craven Sale topper had fetched 500,000gns, the European record was previously held by the Green Desert colt out of Alexander Three D, who sold for 625,000gns to Katsumi Yoshida at the same sale in 2006.

Despite such a stellar return, Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud ended the sale in second position on the list of leading vendors behind Mocklershill, but they were the only two consignors to breach the million-guinea mark, with Mocklershill selling eight for a total of 1,093,000gns and Lynn Lodge trading six for 1,016,000gns. Unsurprisingly, O'Leary was delighted with his record-breaking sales-topper.

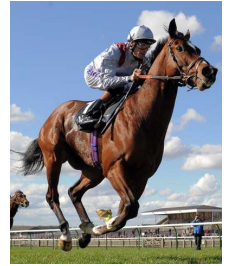

## TORONADO FORCE

Sheikh Joaan bin Hamad Al Thani's new acquisition **Toronado (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) looked an inspired purchase yesterday after the colt maintained his unbeaten record with ease in Newmarket's G3 Novae Bloodstock Insurance Craven S. Last seen beating **Dundonnell** (First Defence) by a half-length in Doncaster's G2 Champagne S. over seven furlongs in September, the 8-11 favorite demonstrated how much improvement he had made throughout the winter by putting that rival to the sword in ruthless fashion despite carrying a three-pound penalty. In front from the outset under a confident Richard Hughes, the imposing bay stayed on the bridle until the reins were moved with a quarter mile to race, where Dundonnell was already struggling to keep tabs. With the winner crossing the line still in hand, it was left to his stable companion **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) to get closest, four lengths down and thoroughly outclassed. Trainer Richard Hannon has now won this 2000 Guineas trial six times and Toronado will head to the main event as the chief threat to Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}). Jockey Richard Hughes is confident that will be the case on May 4. "He's a very good horse, I don't mind what the ground is and I can ride him whichever way I want, so he's going to be very hard to beat," Hughes commented. "Dawn Approach is a very good horse, the best man in Ireland trains him and he looks a very straightforward horse so I'd like to go by him quick." **cont. p6**

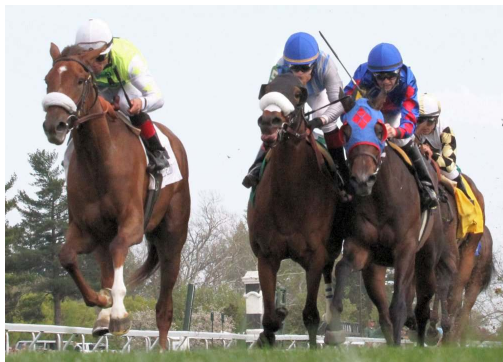

"He was a special horse, and you hope when you have a horse like him that special things will happen," O'Leary said. "I really hope for the buyer that he stays lucky, but mentally he's absolutely rock solid--he's the complete package."

That package provided a significant boost to the 2013 Craven sale's average of 89,660gns--the second-highest ever and the best in five years. It improved by 22% on the 2012 average of 73,316gns. The median fell fractionally to 55,000gns from 57,000gns, but the overall turnover was another area to have posted gains, up by 8% to 9,235,000gns (from 8,578,000gns). Illustrating the selective nature of the market, which has been a feature of breeze-up sales globally so far this year, the clearance rate was a more disappointing marker, falling to 66% from 78% 12 months ago.

**Gold Goes Dutch...**

Until the Elusive Quality colt exited the ring, a son of Dutch Art (GB) (Medicean {GB}) ([lot 129](#)) had held sway when knocked down for 320,000gns to equal the previous evening's best price. On that occasion, McCalmont had given way to successful bidder Angus Gold. Offered by Willie Browne and his Mocklershill team, the colt, out of an unraced daughter of GI Del Mar Oaks winner Dublino (Lear Fan), will race for Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum, with his

trainer yet to be decided.

"I've missed out on quite a few so far, and I was very keen to get him," said Gold. "He looked a very athletic horse to me--and to quite a few other people apparently."

Gold's parting shot--"It's a very strong market"--echoed McCalmont's sentiments, and was perhaps an understatement when describing the ferocious early-evening skirmishes.

The handbell signaling the start of the sale had barely stopped ringing when yet another six-figure juvenile waltzed out of the ring with the Craven Sale picking up where it had left off the night before, as a rash of pricey offerings went under the hammer early in the session.

**Invincible Demand...**

Vendors with the offspring of Invincible Spirit (Ire) in their drafts were sporting broad grins Thursday evening. The Irish National Stud stallion was all the rage at the Craven Sale, with nine of his juveniles selling for an average price of 143,111gns, including [lot 112](#), a colt closely related to GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Vale Of York (Ire) who made 300,000gns. The buyer may not have been disclosed, but the buying team of Peter and Ross Doyle with trainer Richard Hannon is a familiar one.

After signing the docket, Ross Doyle said: "He's come from a good home and he's a smasher. He looks very sharp and breezed well, plus there's a Breeders' Cup winner by the same sire in the family." **cont. p4**

**Tattersalls coverage cont.**

The colt, out of the winning Nayef (GB) mare Carrig Girl (GB), a half-sister to the dam of Vale Of York, was a 38,000gns purchase at Book 2 of Tattersalls' October Sale and was consigned this time around by Adrian Costello's Clenagh Castle Stud. The same outfit also enjoyed a good result in the opening session of the sale when selling an Exceed and Excel (Aus) (Danehill) colt ([lot 13](#)) for 145,000gns.

Invincible Spirit provided another of the auction's speedier gallopers in [lot 99](#), a colt whose price tag improved from 10,000gns as a yearling to 230,000gns six months later after graduating from the exceptional Mocklershill breeze-up academy. David Redvers, standing with Sheikh Fahad Al-Thani, made the final bid. "How they managed to buy him last year for 10,000gns is a complete mystery," Redvers said. "He's a lovely horse and he breezed exceptionally well. Congratulations to the best operators in the business."

Hailing from a family nurtured by former trainer, owner and breeder Peter Harris, the colt is a great grandson of Harris's Connaught Bridge, and his relatives range from top-class juvenile Primo Valentino (GB), progressive stayer Julienas (Ire) and one of the best jumpers currently in training in Britain, Overturn (GB).

Redvers later saw off Blandford Bloodstock for a colt by Claiborne resident Arch (Kris S.) ([lot 109](#)), but had to go to 210,000gns to ensure the son of the Peintre Celebre mare Bourbon Ball joined his team. The Qatar Racing/Pearl Bloodstock team ended up with seven 2-year-olds from the sale for an outlay of 868,000gns.

**Dubawi Also to the Fore...**

With one of Darley's American flag-bearers, Elusive Quality, being responsible for the sale's headline horse plus Oak Tree Farm's colt out of Empress Of India ([lot 137](#)) which made 170,000gns, Sheikh Mohammed's British wing was also to the fore courtesy of one of the country's leading young stallions, Dubawi (Ire). Lots [108](#) and [111](#), a colt and a filly, respectively, by the son of Dubai Millennium (GB), each brought 200,000gns when sold to Dick O'Gorman and Shadwell respectively, while another Dubawi colt ([lot 161](#)) out of the winning Galileo mare Ivory Gala (Fr), fetched 180,000gns.



**Evita's Colt Goes For a Song...**

Malcolm Bastard sold an Invincible Spirit colt during the opening session for 150,000gns, and fared even better Thursday when presenting an Oasis Dream (GB) grandson of Lord and Lady Lloyd-Webber's outstanding broodmare Darara (Top Ville) ([lot 139](#)), which was one of 11 purchases for leading buyer Blandford Bloodstock during the sale for 230,000gns. The third foal of Darara's Selkirk daughter Evita (GB), the colt, who doesn't officially turn two until May 6 and counts Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}), Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) and Diaghilev (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) among his close relatives, had been withdrawn from the October Yearling Sale.

**Spring in Their Footsteps...**

In his closing statement, Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony had referred to "remarkable pinhooking triumphs," and this was certainly the case for [lot 171](#), a filly by Foostepsinthesand (GB) (Giant's Causeway). Emma O'Gorman and Armando Duarte, who consign as Seven Springs, turned a nice profit on the filly, bought for €17,000 at Tattersalls Ireland's September Yearling Sale, who was produced to the minute to garner a return of 190,000gns for the Newmarket-based duo. Another Blandford Bloodstock purchase, she is out of the dual winner and producer of four winners La Caprice (Housebuster).

"The Tattersalls Craven Breeze Up is well established as Europe's premier sale of 2-year-olds in training, and the 2013 renewal has very much lived up to this billing," said Mahony. "Buyers from throughout the world have all contributed to a sale which has produced rises in turnover and average.

"The record top price of 760,000gns, comfortably eclipsing the previous record for a European breeze-up of 625,000gns, was the obvious highlight, and a wonderful result for Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud, which has been at the forefront of the European breeze-up scene for many years. Competition at the top of the market has, without doubt, been the feature of the sale and the number of six-figure lots has only been bettered once, while turnover in excess of 9 million guineas is the third highest in the sale's history." He added: "While there have been so many positives to take from the sale, including the first purchases at Tattersalls by mainland Chinese buyers, it should also be recognised that the market has been selective at times. We would have liked to have seen a higher clearance rate, and economic realities understandably continue to play a part in this business, but overall the 2013 Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale has served as another reminder of the enduring global demand for quality bloodstock."

"Last year, I felt he was a big baby and I was trying to nurse him home but this year he is strong--I said to Richard [Hannon] the other day he would gallop down the side of a mountain, that's how balanced he feels," Hughes added. "He went down beautifully to the start and stood like a lamb, so when he pinged the gates I let him go. We took him to Kempton two weeks ago and he followed four or five horses around and he never picked up the bit, so I didn't mind having to make it today. You are always worried coming off the brow of the hill here if they don't act and change their legs, but he actually quickened down the hill really well and when he met the rising ground he quickened again. It's a bit blowy today and if you are ever going to run free, it will be today." Toronado had been talked about as a Derby prospect last term and his rider was refusing to rule out a tilt at a middle-distance Classic despite his obvious speed. "We asked a few very good judges in the winter whether he would stay [a mile and a half] and they said there was no reason why he wouldn't," he continued. "From day one, I thought he was more of a Derby than a Guineas horse, and about a month ago I still thought that, as he wasn't showing us much pace at home but he lit up in his last two pieces of work which were more serious. He showed us then he has everything."

But instead, the conditioner has shipped the colt to the Bluegrass for tomorrow's GII Coolmore Lexington S. to see exactly where he stands. "He has been training well on the all-weather surface at Fair Hill and we figured this work be a good time to take a shot," said Trombetta, the "M" in the ownership group R.D.M. Stable along with with his father, Rudy, and brother Dino. Winner of two of his first three career starts, Where's Dominic was runner-up in the Miracle Wood S. going a one-turn mile Feb. 9 and is exiting a decent fourth to Mr. Palmer (Pulpit) in the Private Terms S. over nine furlongs Mar. 9. Trombetta will tinker with the colt's equipment for tomorrow's race. "We are going to change equipment and put blinkers on him for the Lexington," Trombetta said. "He was in position to win his last two races but did not get it done," Trombetta explained. "He has been working well in them." Where's Dominic breezed a half-mile in :48 (4/25) at Fair Hill Apr. 13. Edgar Prado has the call in the Lexington.

Canadian champion **Inglorious** (Hennessy) aims to find the winner's circle for the first time since taking the Queen's Plate in June 2011. Out of the money just twice in her next seven efforts, the Donver Stable colorbearer has finished third in her last three starts: the GII Dance Smartly at Woodbine July 8, the GII Bayakoa H. at Betfair Hollywood Park Dec. 8, and the GIII Suwannee River S. going 1 1/8 miles over the Gulfstream turf Feb. 9. She took a 1 3/16-mile allowance there in August 2011 and, more recently, was fourth under those conditions Aug. 15. The dark bay won an allowance at Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 21 and finished second by a neck in the Prix Isola Bella S. at Chantilly Nov. 5 for trainer Bary Pascal. The Michael Matz trainee will break from the outside gate and is given a 10-1 morning-line chance. GII New York S. winner **Mystical Star** (Ghostzapper) looks for another graded score over a track where she boasts a 3-2-1-0 record. The Christophe Clement trainee was second to In Lingerie (Empire Maker) in the 1 1/8-mile GI Spinster here Oct. 7 and has since finished second by a neck in the 1 1/2-mile GIII Long Island H. over the Aqueduct sod Nov. 10 and completed the GIII Hillsborough S. trifecta at Tampa Mar. 9. Making her second start off a layoff and getting a distance cut makes her the one to beat.

You've got to roll with the punches, but we're hoping it shakes down our way."

GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Goldencents** (Into Mischief) worked four panels at Santa Anita in :48.40 Wednesday, and came out of the work well, according to trainer Doug O'Neill. "He worked great," the trainer commented. "He walked today. He had a day off. He'll work a week from today and if he comes out of it well, he'll fly out a week from Saturday [to Kentucky]."

If he pleased him there and reproduced what he was showing at home, he could maybe go to the Dante and take it from there."

**GUINEAS GREEN LIGHT FOR GARSWOOD**

Wednesday's Listed European Free H. winner **Garswood (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}) has been confirmed on course for a tilt at the May 4 G1 QIPCO 2000 Guineas. Trainer Richard Fahey chose his *sportinglife.com* forum to announce that Cheveley Park Stud and David Armstrong's impressive winner of the seven-furlong prep will try a mile for the first time in the Newmarket Classic. "Garswood will run in the Guineas," he said. "It's the obvious route to take and he came out of the Wednesday's race very well. He hardly blew afterwards. I've had some good horses through my hands in recent years, but we've always thought the world of Garswood. He has the X Factor."

**CERTIFY ON TRACK**

Godolphin's unbeaten **Certify** (Elusive Quality) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin yesterday as she is geared up for her return in the G1 1000 Guineas. Having collected the G3 Sweet Solera S. on Newmarket's July Course in August and G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster and G1 Fillies' Mile on the Rowley Mile the next month, the Mahmood Al Zarooni-trained filly went into winter quarters the leading protagonist for the May 5 Classic, and Racing Manager Simon Crisford is hoping she has carried that over to the new term. "She hasn't grown much, but she's all muscle and all power and is very straightforward and pretty fit," he said. "She doesn't need a prep race and she's done very well over the winter, so she'll give a good account of herself. The Nell Gwyn winner yesterday [Hot Snap] was very impressive and looks like the one to beat."

## Why they call it gambling...

Phew, it's been a humbling few weeks for my Derby 10. First, Super Ninety Nine, ranked #2 for several weeks, stopped badly in the Santa Anita Derby, the same race from which the highly regarded (by me) Flashback emerged injured. Former #1 Vyjack ran well in the Wood, but not so well that he was a danger to winner Verrazano. Last week's #9 Rydilluc, meanwhile, wasn't the monster I was hoping he might be in the Blue Grass, while Oxbow, last week's #2, couldn't even make it into the super in the Arkansas Derby. So maybe it goes without saying that I'm as opinion-free on the Derby as I've been in years. I dunno--maybe that's a good thing. Last year, I loved Union Rags all spring, the year before Dialed In, and neither ran particularly well on Derby day. Maybe being lukewarm on everybody

will get me to a winning ticket. A suspect strategy, I know.

Anyway, barring something unforeseen in the Coolmore Lexington tomorrow, late defections, etc., I don't imagine this list will change much from now through the Derby, though I am excited to see all these horses in the flesh at Churchill. This week, we'll keep things simple, next week we'll do a "yes-no-maybe" on pedigree angles, and in the final week, we'll talk about pre-Derby workouts and how the horses are looking at Churchill.

One last thing. A 100% unsolicited and pander-free shout-out to the new sponsors of this, darkhorsebet.com. I've been betting through them for about a year now, drawn by the fact that this North Dakota-based operation offers about a 6% rebate on my preferred bets, tris and supers (depending on the track), money that's deposited into your account every Friday. I'm not a big bettor, but not a \$2 bettor either, and play often and am happy to break even. I just looked up my account history. Over the past 12 months, I've bet \$29,121.70 and got back \$28,159.06--a loss of \$962.64. But I also got back roughly \$1,300 in rebates, edging me into the black. That makes a big difference for a guy like me. It's also pretty rare that you're on a first-name basis with the folks who own your betting service, but Trish and Bruce Soulsby are exceptionally hands-on (Trish answers most emails herself) and, from what I can tell, are just great people. Worth checking out.
