VICTORY WITH A CAUSE

Coolmore Stud sponsored the day's racing at Keeneland, so it seems only appropriate that **Winning Cause**, a son of the farm's Giant's Causeway--for whom the day's co-featured event was named--would emerge victorious in the GIII Lexington S. Not that the colt didn't fit the race on his merits. The chestnut came into the Lexington perfect in two tries over the local Polytrack, having won his maiden during last year's fall meet before bridging a 12-length gap to take a first-level allowance by 3/4 of a length over an about seven-furlong distance Apr. 6.

DUDE, THAT WAS CLOSE

In the end, **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) wasn't nearly as impressive or as dominant as he was in registering towering Beyer Speed Figures of 116 and 117 in winning the GII San Antonio S. and GI Santa Anita H. in his two previous trips to the post in 2013.

The true test of a champion is to succeed when perhaps below their best and to find a way to win, and the 6-year-old had to call upon all his class

to hold off the talented duo of Big 'Cap runner-up **Clubhouse Ride** (Candy Ride {Arg}) and **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate) to take the GII Charles Town Classic Saturday night in West Virginia. "He's just a workhorse. He does everything. He runs over everything," said Hall of Fame rider Mike Smith. "He had a bit of trouble handling the surface today; he was slipping on it especially around the turns. He's not used to those tighter turns." So important was the race that co-owner Joe Torre flew in to witness it in person. "My heart was pumping," said Torre. "It's a helpless feeling because you can't do anything about it, just watch. Sort of the same thing when Mariano Rivera goes out to the mound. You put your hands in your pocket and hope for the best." CT Classic cont. p3

Waking Up is Hard To Do...

Winning Cause didn't show a whole bunch in a pair of turf routes to begin his career, finishing sixth as the favorite in his Saratoga debut Aug. 4 and fifth at the Spa Aug. 29. Cut back to one turn for his Oct. 18 appearance over seven furlongs of this track, he raced within touch, swept in front and finished willingly to score by 1 3/4 lengths. Winning Cause made a pair of starts in stakes company over the Aqueduct inner during the winter, finishing a distant second to Clawback (Put It Back) in the Jimmy Winkfield S. Jan. 21, but was a disappointing last of five when odds-on in the Feb. 21 Java Gold S. It was back to Lexington on a recovery mission Apr. 6, and, with Julien Leparoux taking over at the controls, Winning Cause got a generous pace to run at and finished fast to take that seven-furlong test.

Stretching back out on short rest, Winning Cause raced in fifth and on his own down the backstretch as

an above-average pace developed in front of him. He came under a ride on the turn and was steered out into the four path as he zeroed in on the front cornering for home. Longshot General Election (Harlan's Holiday) followed Winning Cause's move

into the stretch, but the Pletcher runner did slightly the better in the final 100 yards and held sway late.

"From the one hole, I couldn't ask for a better trip," Leparoux explained. "In the first turn, he put me in a good spot and I got room to get him out there [toward the middle of the track] and he just cruised around there and finished strong."

So, with five Derby hopefuls already in the shedrow, how about sixth, trainer Todd Pletcher?

Game On Dude was backed out of the stalls, then quickly reloaded, but was beaten for early speed by Percussion (Bluegrass Cat), who led the Dude through an opening quarter that was posted in a questionable :25.96. The Pletcher runner, who may have been something of a rabbit for defending champion Caixa Eletronica (Arromanches), was hounded along by the heavy favorite and ultimately relinquish the advantage as they reached the quarter pole. Smith pointed Game On Dude towards the wire, but he had his onrushing market rivals to deal with. Clubhouse Ride came at him from the outside and Ron the Green tried to rally up the fence, but class told on the day, and Game On Dude found the wire first. All-sources handle on the card reached \$4,398,984, smashing the previous record on a single Charles Town card by nearly \$1 million. The \$332,876 wagered on track also represented a near 25% increase over last year's on-track business.

Possessed of as much raw talent as any 3-year-old in training, Departing continued his upward progression with this breakthrough graded-stakes success.

The striking bay debuted with a handsome 2 1/4-length defeat of Ground Transport (Big Brown) going six furlongs at the Fair Grounds Dec. 22, then overcame a wide passage to best a field, including yesterday's GIII Lexington S. runner-up General Election (Harlan's Holiday) by a solid 4 1/2 lengths in his two-turn debut in New Orleans Feb. 1. Departing was slated for a start in the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 23, but drew in the parking lot, and connections opted for a start in the Texas Heritage S. at Sam Houston the following weekend. He duly obliged with a visually impressive 2 3/4-length success and was exiting a strong third behind Revolutionary (War Pass) and Mylute (Midnight Lute) in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 30.

Saddled with post 13--the same stall which housed 2012 winner Done Talking (Broken Vow)--and adding Lasix for this, Departing jumped well and was midfield upon settling, but was carried out a bit by Abraham (Distorted Humor) as the field raced into the first turn. Already caked with mud as they made the backstretch, the gelding was guided out to be widest passing the midway point of the race. Still five or six off the inside approaching the final turn, Departing advanced in hand for Brian Hernandez Jr. and came calling for the lead in upper stretch. Having covered a lot of extra territory, he lugged in a bit entering the final furlong, but was never in any sort of danger and was taken in hand in the final 50 yards.

"We are very happy with the horse and very proud of today's effort," said trainer Al Stall Jr., having just landed in Louisville. "He obviously moved forward off the Louisiana Derby, and he's been a totally different horse since then."

After being excluded from the new Kentucky Derby points structure, officials at Hawthorne bumped up the purse of the Illinois Derby and positioned it as a potential prep for the GI Preakness S. in three weeks' time. Stall indicated that it is one of many races under consideration for Departing.

"We just have to watch the Derby and see what happens there," Stall explained. "His schedule won't change and we'll know more after May 4."

Lady of Shamrock caboused the field behind a slow pace and was in the midst of what appeared to be a winning rally in deep stretch when she was impeded badly by Viva Carina. The heavy favorite crossed the line second, but was quite justifiably awarded the GII Santa Barbara S. courtesy of the stewards.

Lady of Shamrock emerged as the leader of her generation on the West Coast turf circuit last season with wins in the GIII Providencia S. in April, the GI American Oaks in July and the GI Del Mar Oaks the following month.

The dark bay gave a very good account of herself in her first try against older horses in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf Nov. 2, coming from last in the field to finish fifth, just 2 1/2 lengths behind the victorious Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune). She got a well-deserved respite thereafter and resumed with a running-on second following a slow start in the nine-furlong GII Santa Ana S. over this course Mar. 24.

Lady of Shamrock and Rafael Bejarano were content to trail through the stretch and onto the backside, but was going to have work to do, as Viva Carina and The Only Key (GB) (Key of Luck) slowed things down up front. The cadence quickened a bit after six furlongs in a pedestrian 1:14.41, and Bejarano was getting busy on Lady of Shamrock, guiding

her into contention with a solid run up the fence. Viva Carina was still traveling well and carried a clear advantage into the stretch, but Lady of Shamrock was closing with menacing strides at the wood. The pacesetter drifted in under a right-handed stick from Victor Espinoza in the final furlong, causing Lady of Shamrock to lose all momentum, and the stewards were left with no choice but to act.

"I don't think he [Espinoza] knew I was there," said Bejarano, who could have angled out, but gambled inside. "I tried to come running but I also wasn't screaming and [I] didn't let him know. He was surprised, it wasn't his fault. His filly just kept coming in. I tried to sneak through there...When I saw the opportunity on the rail in the stretch and I saw a lot of room, I just kept running but unfortunately when Victor used the right-hand stick, his horse kept coming in and completely crossed my lane."

Winner of the Gold Rush Futurity at Colorado's Arapahoe Park in 2011, Chips All In won the Pasadena S. Mar. 23, but had dropped his last five starts--by about two lengths combined. Fourth in the Tsunami Slew S. at Hollywood in May, he was a neck second in a division of the Oceanside S. at Del Mar July 18 and third, beaten a head, in the GII LaJolla H. Aug. 11. He got some time off and returned to action with a career-best 104 Beyer, but only good for a runner-up effort to Unbridled's Note (Unbridled's Song) in the Joe Hernandez H. over course and distance Feb. 23. He had GI Breeders' Cup Mile third Obviously to target here and proved best with a fitness advantage.

A stalking third as Obviously tugged Joe Talamo through enervating fractions of :21.52 for the quarter and :43.16 to the half-mile, Chips All In went after the chalk in earnest entering the final furlong and was able to peg him back late for the victory.

"Obviously had to run hard to get up to the lead after not getting away, so we were worried about him," said Ral Ayers, assistant to trainer Jeff Mullins. "He's tough on the lead, but maybe he needed one. Who knows? We'll take what we can get."

Talamo was not unduly disappointed in the effort of the runner-up.

"That's what we thought he would do, go straight out to the front," said Talamo. "He's coming off a long layoff so it was a perfect race for him and it should set him up for the summer."

The Hannon stable has rarely had such a strong hand among their 3-year-olds and if Toronado (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) has the feel of a Hawk Wing, Olympic Glory fills the Rock of Gibraltar mold with his similar profile. Fans of the pair will be relieved to hear that a repeat of that Ballydoyle duo's 2000 Guineas face-off of 2002 will be avoided as they are to be kept apart for the mile Classics at least, with this colt heading for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp May 12. One of the season's leading juveniles, Olympic Glory surrendered only to Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot in June when lacking the vital experience of that rival before going through the rest of the campaign with an air of relaxed authority. Overcoming a late setback to win the G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket's July meeting and a penalty to follow up in Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. the next month, the bay sauntered through the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp in October before holing up for the winter. Connections had warned that he was under-cooked for this trial and for a while that seemed likely to cost him the win as he labored to pick up the positively-ridden Sir Patrick Moore. Getting to that rival with a furlong remaining, he had a bullseye on his back as the smooth-traveling Moohaajim loomed ominously, but when the whip was applied the possibility of a fight was quickly canceled out and he crossed the line with plenty to spare. "He's a lovely horse and a little bit lazy at home, so we thought he might be a bit big and he's still blowing, whereas Toronado cleared his nose very quickly after the Craven," jockey Richard Hughes said en route to the winner's enclosure. **Cont. p8**

“He likes cut in the ground and so France might be the better option--I gave him a couple of digs to let him know he'd had a race and he needs another furlong now.” Trainer Richard Hannon, who was winning this for the sixth time and therefore equaling the record of Sir Henry Cecil, could not hide his enthusiasm for his G3 Craven S. winner Toronado as he discussed plans for his stable stars. “We've had a great week and it's nice that the owner has bought Toronado, as we can now separate them,” he said. “Toronado is a machine, so Olympic Glory will go to the French Guineas and Toronado to the English.”

This race appeared a likely spot for Pierro's fourth-straight win and third in Group 1 company, but last year's champion 2-year-old was beaten on the square by Sacred Falls, who provided his trainer Chris Waller with a third victory in this event and a Group 1 double after Royal Descent (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) took the G1 Australian Oaks one race earlier. Sacred Falls kicked off his career in New Zealand with six-straight wins, capped by the G1 New Zealand 2000 Guineas at Riccarton Park in November. He didn't quite pan out immediately after joining Waller in Sydney this term, finishing fifth in both the G2 Royal Sovereign S. at Rosehill Feb. 16 and G1 Royal Randwick Guineas at Warwick Farm Mar. 16. But he was second to It's a Dundeel (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}), albeit by seven lengths, in the G1 Rosehill Guineas two weeks later, and returned to top form here. Content to caboose the field early as Pierro took up a perfect spot in midpack along the inside, Sacred Falls was still in last at the top of the straight. He followed the favorite's move in between horses, dashed to the inside of that foe and out-kicked him in the run to the line. Pierro looked as if he'd also be passed by the filly Norzita, but dug in to earn the consolation prize. "We thought about not running," Waller admitted to *Racing and Sports*, citing concerns over the heavy ground. "If it was left up to me we would have hardly had any runners today at all." The conditioner earned his first Group 1 victory in this race in 2008 with Triple Honour (NZ) (Honours List {Ire}) and annexed the Doncaster again two years later with Rangirangdoo (NZ) (Pentire {GB}). "I can't describe the feeling," he said. "I don't think you ever get used to it." Pierro's jockey Nash Rawiller said that the colt's impost ultimately proved his undoing. "Four kilos is like 12 kilos in this weather," he said, referring to the nine pounds Pierro was giving the winner over the easy going.

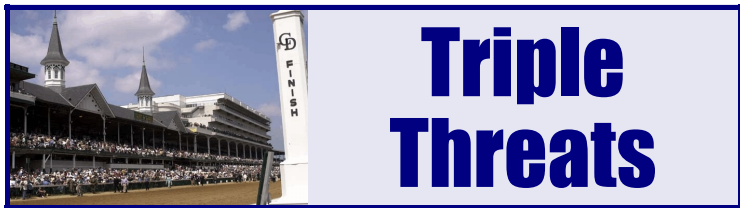

in :48.80, recording splits of :12.40, :24 and :36.60 before galloping out five-eighths in 1:01, six furlongs in 1:13 seven panels in 1:26.60. She was out the mile in 1:44.

"I thought she had another very good work today," Pletcher said. "We were looking for a solid work with a good gallop out and I thought she did that very well. After a monstrous effort, we were anxious to see how she bounced out of it. Her appetite, energy level and enthusiasm have all been terrific since that race. If [the Gulfstream Oaks] did take something out of her, she hasn't shown it."

Repole Stables' **Unlimited Budget** (Street Sense), undefeated in four career starts including the GII Fair

Grounds Oaks Mar. 30, worked in company with GIII Bourbonette Oaks victress **Silsita** (Macho Uno), and the duo covered five furlongs in 1:00.60. Sectional times were :12, :23.80, and :48.40. Unlimited Budget galloped out three-quarters of a mile in

1:14, while Silsita was timed in 1:13.80.

"We switched positions with them and put Unlimited Budget on the inside this time," Pletcher said. "It seemed like it was maybe a touch deeper on the inside. I thought [Unlimited Budget] worked well. I thought both fillies worked well, but Silsita was a little bit stronger on the gallop out today. Last week, Unlimited Budget was on the outside and she was a little bit stronger, so I don't know if there's anything to that or not."

Gary Stevens put Silsita through her paces and is likely to have the mount in the Oaks, Pletcher said.

Princess of Sylmar (Majestic Warrior), runner-up most recently to ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Close Hatches (First Defence) in the GII Gazelle S. Apr. 6, breezed alongside GIII Eight Belles S. candidate Fusaichiswonderful (Fusaichi Pegasus), and the pair went four furlongs in :48.60, in fractions of :12.40, :24.40 and :36.80.

"I thought Princess of Sylmar's work was OK this morning," Pletcher said. "It looked like she was struggling with the racetrack a little bit down the lane. I would say I need to see her work next week before making a decision on whether she'll run in the Oaks or not."

Rose to Gold Goes a Half..

Just 10 days removed from her front-running victory in the GIII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Park, **Rose to Gold** (Friends Lake) returned to the worktab with a strong half-mile breeze at Churchill Downs timed in :48.20. The bargain-basement purchase went in splits of :12.20, :24.20 and :36 flat before galloping out five-eighths of a mile in 1:01.40.

"I'm told she worked really well," trainer Sal Santoro said from his barn at Calder. "The plan right now is to breeze her one more time before the race. We're trying to keep on the same schedule we've used since day one. In the end, though, it's all up to her. She'll tell me what she wants and what she needs."

Santoro is very much looking forward to the Oaks experience.

"It's very exciting to even be on the same racetrack with the likes of Bill Mott and Todd Pletcher and Dale Romans and all of these guys," he commented. UNCAPTURED CROWNED CANADA'S HOY

John Oxley's **Uncaptured** (Lion Heart) capped a big evening for his connections when he collected the Sovereign Award as Canada's 2012 Horse of the Year in a ceremony held at Woodbine Racetrack Friday night.

The Ontario-bred, who also collected champion 2-year-old male honors, became the first juvenile to take Canadian racing's highest honor since the filly Ruling Angel in 1986.

The winner of his first four starts--including the Clarendon S., Vandal S. and Swynford S., Uncaptured tasted defeat just

once in seven starts last year when fifth in the GIII Grey S. his first time going two turns. The dark bay rebounded next out, however, scooping Churchill's GIII Iroquois S. by 5 1/2 lengths and adding the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. to round out his campaign. He finished second, beaten 1 1/2 lengths, in his 3-year-old bow in the GIII Spiral S. Mar. 23, and was most recently a well-beaten 10th in the GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland Apr. 13.

Uncaptured is trained by Mark Casse--who also conditions champion older female and female sprinter **Roxy Gap** (Indian Charlie)--and bred by Bill Graham, who also received the Sovereign Awards in their respective categories. Oxley was also honored as outstanding owner, and he enjoyed a fourth success when his **Spring in the Air** (Spring at Last)--also trained by Casse--was crowned champion 2-year-old filly.

Canyon Farms' **Strait of Dover** (English Channel) made history last year by becoming the first British Columbia-bred to win the Queen's Plate, and last night he added the Sovereign Award as champion 3-year-old male to his mantle. The Danny Vella trainee, unplaced in his first two starts on the dirt at Hastings as a juvenile, has found a home on the Woodbine Polytrack, where he has gone undefeated in five starts, including wins in last year's Marine S. and Queen's Plate. The dark bay was shelved after his classic victory with a soft tissue injury, but is expected to return to the races this year.

It was also a fruitful evening for the connections of dual classic winner **Irish Mission** (Giant's Causeway), who took home the trophies as champion 3-year-old filly and champion female turf horse on the merit of victories in last year's Woodbine Oaks and Breeders' S. Irish Mission's dam, **Misty Mission** (Miswaki) was honored as outstanding broodmare.

PIERRO RETIRED

Australian 2-year-old champion **Pierro (Aus)** (Lonhro {Aus}--Miss Right Note {Ire}, by Daylami {Ire}), winner of last year's G1 Golden Slipper S. and the Australian 2-year-old Triple Crown, has been retired from racing, according to Racing Victoria.

The news came less than 24 hours after the 3-year-old finished second to Sacred Falls (NZ) (O'Reilly {NZ}) in the G1 BMW Doncaster at Randwick in Sydney. Pierro bows out with 11 wins from 14 starts, including five Group 1s, and earnings of A\$4,536,650.

Bred by Darley, Pierro was purchased by David Kobritz from the 2010 Magic Millions National Weanling Sale for A\$115,000. Reappearing in the following January's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, the dark bay was picked up for \$230,000 by trainer Gai Waterhouse for Kolivos. Waterhouse declared Pierro "the Golden Slipper" winner following a first-out victory at Randwick in October 2011, and the colt proved that prophecy correct, enjoying a perfect 6-for-6 juvenile campaign in Sydney, highlighted by victories in the Golden Slipper, G1 Sires Produce, and G1 Champagne S.

After collecting the G3 Run to the Rose and G2 Bill Stutt S. to kick off his sophomore campaign, Pierro tasted defeat in the G1 Caulfield Guineas and G1 Cox Plate. He came roaring back, however, in the G2 Hobartville S. at Rosehill Mar. 2, and later added the G1 Canterbury S. (Mar. 23) and G1 George Ryder S. (Apr. 6) over that course. The 5-2 favorite for the Doncaster, Pierro finished a valiant second while giving Sacred Falls nine pounds.

No stud plans have been decided for Pierro.
