PLETCHER EXACTA IN DERBY TRIAL

If the GIII Derby Trial S. is any indication for things to come next weekend in Louisville, look out. **Forty Tales** (Tale of the Cat), a disappointing fifth as the even-money chalk in the GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Mar. 2, held off a fierce late rally from stablemate **Capo Bastone** (Street Boss), keying a Todd Pletcher exacta. "We felt like there was a bit of speed in the race and both of these horses' styles are to settle and make one run," Pletcher said. "It seemed like the track was playing favorably to those kinds of horses on the night, so we just let them do their thing and it worked out well." Any chance Forty Tales wheels back for the Derby after picking up 20 crucial points for the win? "I doubt it, but we'll see how he comes out of it," Pletcher responded. "I'm sure that the owner will want to talk about it, but I would say he's probably a one-turn horse." **Cont. p4**

TODD SQUAD OUT IN FULL FORCE

With rain in the forecast, Todd Pletcher called an audible Saturday morning and breezed five of his potential GI Kentucky Derby starters beneath the Twin Spires. Working in company with 6-year-old mare Authenticity (Quiet American), the unbeaten GI Wood Memorial S. hero **Verrazano** (More Than Ready) drilled five furlongs in :59.40 (6/52). With exercise rider Humberto Zamora in the irons, Verrazano began the breeze on the outside, about a length behind the 6-year-old mare, and rolled by to outfinish his stablemate by a length. The  **"TDN Rising Star"**  was clocked in splits of :11.80, :23.20, :35 and :47, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:13. "We had a really good morning," Pletcher said. "I thought Verrazano's work was very good. He was well in hand and handled the track well." Pletcher continued, "We had to beat that rain. I was afraid of what might happen to the track. And they're racing here [Saturday night], and you just don't know what it is going to be like in the morning. We just needed to get it done today. I remember, too, that [2010 Derby winner] Super Saver worked on Saturday."

& :48.40), with the former skimming the rail and finishing a length to the good. Calvin Borel, slated to enter the Hall of Fame this summer, met the press after getting acquainted with the GII Louisiana Derby hero. "It is a great honor," Borel said of Friday's announcement. "It hasn't all sunk in, but I'm very excited about it." Regarding Saturday's breeze, Borel continued, "I was very pleased with it. He did everything right. He's my kind of horse; he does everything the way you're supposed to. He

does what I ask, not what he wants. He's smart. And you need a horse like that in the Derby. You just know you're going to get in trouble and you need a smart horse to get you out."

Overanalyze (Dixie Union), with Gary Stevens aboard, and **Palace Malice (Curlin),** with Mike Smith in the irons, also worked in company. Palace Malice, a close second in the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 13, had the edge by about a length in the early stages, but the pair wound up on even terms at the finish. Clockers caught the GI Arkansas Derby hero in fractions of :12, :23.40, :35.40, and a final time of :47, the fastest of 70 breezes at the distance. Overanalyze galloped out five furlongs in :59.60 and six furlongs in 1:13.40. Palace Malice carved out splits of :12, :23.60, and :35.40, with a final time of :47.20 (2/70). He galloped out five furlongs in :59.80. The Dogwood colorbearer wore blinkers for the first time in the work, and will also sport the shades for the first time in the Derby. "I also liked Revolutionary's drill," Pletcher added. "He went very well and galloped out strong. Overanalyze's work this morning was very good. It was his best work ever."

Forty Tales was a sharp winner of his first two starts, including a six-furlong Parx allowance Jan. 5. He came from out of the clouds to finish second, beaten a half-length, in the GII Hutcheson S. Feb. 2, but failed to duplicate that performance in the Swale. Subsequently freshened, he lined up in the Derby Trial as a slight 3-1 favorite. Placed in sixth as Zee Bros (Brother Derek) zipped through fractions of :22.48 and :45.07, Joel Rosario began to go to work on the far turn, took over from the pacesetter in mid-stretch, and found the wire in time as Capo Bastone came flying from last of nine. "It was a perfect trip," Rosario said. "He broke well. I figured there was going to be some speed in the race and we'd be five, six, seven lengths off the speed. That's exactly where we were. When we turned for home, I asked him to go and he went and put me in a good spot." As for the runner-up, Pletcher added, "We were thinking that if he ran really well we could consider the Preakness or something like that. We'll see how he comes out of it." Triple Threats

McPeek Duo Work in Company...

The Ken McPeek-trained duo of **Frac Daddy** (Scat Daddy) and GI Blue Grass S. hero **Java's War** (War Pass) worked five furlongs in company in 1:02 following the renovation break. Frac Daddy, second in the GI Arkansas Derby, finished a half-length in front, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:15.80. Java's War was out in 1:16.60. "It was a nice solid breeze--it was a maintenance work," McPeek said. "They've worked together quite a few times. Frac's got more speed than the other horse. Java's War keeps coming." Frac Daddy, a

9 3/4-length maiden winner beneath the Twin Spires last November, was a close second in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 24. "He likes this racetrack," McPeek continued. "The timing is right. We're encouraged."

Normandy Invasion Works Quick...

Normandy Invasion (Tapit) covered five furlongs in :59.00, the second quickest work at that distance out of 52 horses. The GI Wood Memorial S. second-place finisher went splits of :11.80, :23.20, :34.80 and :46.60. He galloped out six furlongs in 1:11.80. Exercise rider Javier Herrera was aboard. "It was more of a maintenance move," explained trainer Chad Brown. "He worked quick, but I thought he did it well within himself. He didn't work with any company and galloped out well. He came back good. All the serious work is done."

Solid Work for Black Onyx...

GIII Horseshoe Casino Cincinnati Spiral S. winner **Black Onyx** (Rock Hard Ten) worked a half mile in :48.60 with jockey Joe Bravo in the irons. The Sterling Racing colorbearer set splits of :12.20, :24.20 and :36.20, and galloped out five panels in 1:02.40. "It was a good workout," conditioner Kelly Breen said. "We weren't looking to go too fast. We know what the horse is able to do and we want to just keep him doing what he did before his previous wins. It was a nice workout."

Mylute Back on Usual Work Pattern...

GII Louisiana Derby runner-up **Mylute** (Midnight Lute) went four panels in :50.60 Saturday morning under jockey Rosie Napravnik. The time was the 59th fastest work at that distance of 70 workouts. "Look, I've said for three weeks, that Mylute's big work is going to be similar to what he did before the Louisiana Derby in company, and he did what we wanted him to do," trainer Tom Amoss said. "Last week's work, which was a half-mile [in 47.80] by himself, caught me off guard. It was a better work than I anticipated, not the kind of work he typically does. But he had a target. There were a couple horses working in front of him, and it kept his attention. Today was certainly a mediocre work by most people's standards, but that is my horse, how he works. His work pattern before the Louisiana Derby is almost identical to what he did today. I'm very comfortable with what he did. I have a horse that's coming into the Derby the right way."

Oaks Works, Gallops and Arrivals...

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out his four GI Kentucky Oaks contenders to breeze at Churchill Downs Saturday morning. GII Gulfstream Oaks winner **Dreaming of Julia** (A.P. Indy) worked a half mile in :51.00 with an early

split of :25.80 and an out time of 1:03.60. GIII Bourbonette Oaks heroine **Silsita** (Macho Uno) worked under Gary Stevens in company with GII Fair Grounds Oaks winner **Unlimited Budget** (Street Sense). The latter, who breezed on the outside, went

five panels in :59.60 and the former covered the distance in 1:00. "She's a good work horse; that's her," exercise rider Patti Krotenko said of Unlimited Budget. "But she felt very strong this morning. She's definitely on the muscle and ready to roll." Stevens was also happy with his mount's work, commenting "She was very keen going to the pole and I didn't want her kicking all the way in. But she got over the track well and it was a good effort for her." **Princess of Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior), the GII Gazelle S. runner-up, was the last of Pletcher's Oaks quartet to work. She put in four furlongs in :49.20 and galloped out in 1:01.60 in company with stablemate Fusaichiswonderful (Fusaichi Pegasus). "I thought they all did well," Pletcher said of the works. "Unlimited Budget was our strongest and fastest today. She's doing well. Dreaming of Julia--we tried to do with her what we did coming up to the Gulfstream Oaks [a :50.80 breeze]. We didn't want her going too fast. We wanted to save something with her. All in all, it was good. I was happy with the whole bunch."

The Bill Mott-trained **Flashy Gray** (Flashy Bull) worked in company and was clocked going five panels in 1:01.00. "I thought it was very good," Mott said. "They went off nicely. They were off easy in 13 and picked it up. It's all we needed. I think the most important part was that the rider felt like [Flashy Gray] was there when she needed her."

In other Oaks news, **Close Hatches** (First Defence) galloped over the track and both **Pure Fun** (Pure Prize) and **Midnight Lucky** (Midnight Lute) galloped 1 1/2 miles. **Beholder** (Henny Hughes) arrived at Churchill Saturday afternoon from California.

Derby Talk...

Hall of Fame trainer Shug McGaughey was at Churchill Downs on Derby Day last year, but bolted early following Data Link (War Front)'s troubled fifth-place finish in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic.

"We got in the car and watched the Kentucky Derby in a Mexican restaurant in Versailles after I got picked up for speeding," he said. "When I told the guy where I was going, he let me go. He was in front of me. I said, 'How did you know I was speeding?' He said, 'You were catching me fast.'"

Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas saddled 1995 first- and third-place finishers Thunder Gulch and Timber Country.

"I'm standing there with [Overbrook owner] Bill Young, and I said to him that I thought we ran a hell of a race [with Timber Country] and think that we'll probably move forward... And Bill says to me, 'Wayne, don't worry. I know you worked hard. It was just fine. We were glad to be a part of it. Who won the race?' I said, 'I did, with the other horse.' He said, 'What the hell are you doing standing here?' I responded, 'I'm cooling you out.'"

not unusual to see people who have had remarkable achievements in business, or who run multinational corporations or even countries demonstrate an exuberance not normally seen in their outside-the-racetrack persona. We are most often party to these displays when they're rooting home one of their runners at the Breeders' Cup, the Dubai World Cup or

under the Twin Spires. Friday at Keeneland, however, I saw something which indicated the greatest level of passion I may have ever seen in the game. I was in attendance at Keeneland for Ken and Sarah Ramsey's eighth lifetime graded stakes win, which earned them the track's coveted gold engraved Tiffany plate. The race was also their 24th win of the meet. I've come to know Ken over the years and wanted to offer him my personal congratulations on such a momentous achievement. I walked toward the Keeneland Director's Room after the winner's circle ceremony for the Elkhorn. But as I headed into the clubhouse tunnel, I was almost run over by Ken, his son Jeff, their farm manager Mark Partridge, family and friends, who, en masse, had rushed out of a toast celebrating one of the great achievements of racing in Kentucky and were running at a pace which suggested a fire. They had done so because the field for the last race of the spring meet, a \$20,000 maiden claimer, had just crossed the finish line and their 6-1 shot, also trained by Mike Maker, had won the race. I'm not sure any of the 17 prior winners of the Tiffany gold plate would have run so hard, so fast and so joyfully to the winner's circle to get their picture taken with a maiden claimer, but that's what makes Ken Ramsey so special. He loves the sport, loves winning races, loves standing his own racehorses at stud and giving them an opportunity to succeed, and, as everybody knows, loves to bet. But I daresay the thing he loves most is getting his picture taken in the winner's circle. And over the past 16 racing days at Keeneland, he's done that more than anyone. Ever. Congratulations, Ken.

Flat Out, a two-time winner of Belmont's prestigious GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, stayed perfect in four attempts over Big Sandy in determined fashion here. A distant third behind Fort Larned (E Dubai) in last term's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, he began his 7-year-old campaign with a fourth-place finish behind Graydar (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Donn H. Feb. 9. Subsequently freshened, the Preston colorbearer was fifth behind that same rival in the GII New Orleans H. last time Mar. 30. Cutting back to a mile, Flat Out chased early in fourth through an opening quarter in :22.77. With Junior Alvarado aboard, he began to launch his bid while three-wide on the far turn as Cross Traffic sizzled through a half mile in :45.33 and six furlongs in 1:08.87. Those two threw it down for the length of the stretch with a game Cross Traffic clinging to a narrow advantage while racing on his wrong lead along the inside. Flat Out kept on coming on the outside and was along in time in the shadow of the wire. "He does have an affinity for this racetrack, and he showed it today," said Leana Willaford, assistant trainer to Bill Mott. "He had won going a mile before. Sometimes when you shorten them up, they finish a little stronger. [Junior Alvarado] did a great job. He was aware [Cross Traffic] was the lone speed and didn't let him get too far away."

Runner-up in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York and the G3 Dubai Duty Free Arc Trial and G3 St Simon S. at Newbury in 2011, Al Kazeem managed only one outing last term and that came in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket in May. Trainer Roger Charlton revealed that a tilt at the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 26 is next on the agenda. "He's a stunning-looking horse and a nice one too and that was a good effort after twelve months off," he added. "We know he gets a mile and a half, but the more commercial races are over a mile and a quarter, so he will go to The Curragh and then Royal Ascot." Despite a 63-day layoff on account of a virus, the connections of All Too Hard expressed confidence in their colt prior to this return, and the bay justified favoritism with a stirring victory here that stamped his ticket to the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot in England June 18. "We always thought he was the real deal and he certainly proved it today," said Vinery Stud's Peter Orton. "He is just the most magnificent looking animal and a really classy racehorse. "We didn't need to be here today. He's got nothing to prove, but you don't duck and dive from these things. It was just great to see him get his return and yes, we will definitely be on our way to England." The A\$1.025-million sales-topper at the Inglis Easter yearling sale in 2011, All Too Hard has long since emerged from the shadow of his immortal elder sister Black Caviar to establish himself as one of the best horses in training in Australia. He became the first horse to defeat champion 2-year-old **Pierro (Aus)** (Lonhro {Aus}) when collecting his first Group 1 victory in last season's G1 Caulfield Guineas, and followed up with a gallant second-place effort against elders in the G1 Cox Plate in October.



Put on the shelf following that effort, All Too Hard has returned this year to annex three straight Group 1 events, including the G1 C.F. Orr and G1 Futurity S., both at Caulfield in February. He made his final preparation for this return by winning a trial over this strip last Friday. Making his first start in Sydney in seven months here, All Too Hard took up a prominent position outside second favorite **More Joyous (NZ)** (More Than Ready) through the early stages. Swinging four-wide at the top of the lane, All Too Hard kicked into gear passing the 200-meter mark, sweeping past his rivals to post an impressive victory. **More Joyous** faded to a lackluster seventh.

Reliable Man was sent off a long 11-1 second choice behind the heavily-favored 3-year-old It's a Dundee in his second Australian start here. While the grey left no doubt as to his dominance in the end, his victory was marred when he sustained an injury shortly after pulling up, which trainer Chris Waller later declared to be likely career-ending. With yesterday's victory, Reliable Man became a Group 1 winner on both hemispheres. He went unbeaten through his first three starts in France for trainer Alain de Royer Dupre, including the G1 Prix du Jockey Club. He collected the G2 Prix Niel two starts later and, although he went winless in his next six starts in Europe, he was far from disgraced, finishing three lengths behind So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in fourth in last year's Royal Ascot's G1 Prince of Wales's S., and 1 3/4 lengths off Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in the G1 King George S. a month later. He wrapped up his campaign with an eighth place finish in the GI Canadian International. Joining the Chris Waller stable thereafter, Reliable Man resurfaced with a trial victory at Warwick Farm over Group 1 winner Manawanui (Aus) (Oratorio {Ire}) Mar. 26, and was a first-up sixth behind Pierro (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}) going 1500 meters in the G1 George Ryder S. at Rosehill Apr. 6. Racing prominently through this stretch out to 2000m, Reliable Man dropped back to travel midpack off the rail for the run down the backstretch. Swinging three-wide at the top of the lane, he sprinted clear in midstretch and was no match for his rivals.

Guelph appeared hopelessly beaten at the top of the stretch, but nonetheless came thundering down the straight to score her second straight Group 1 victory, and sweep the last two legs of the Australian 2-year-old Triple Crown, following her win in the G1 Sires Produce S. two weeks ago. Taking into account the victory of Overreach (Aus) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in the G1 Golden Slipper Apr. 6, fillies by that sire completed a sweep of the Triple Crown.

A homebred for Sheikh Mohammed, Guelph kicked off her career with a second place finish in the Listed Gimcrack S. at Randwick last October before taking her next two races, including the G3 Blue Diamond Prelude at Caulfield. She failed to fire next out in the G1 Blue Diamond S., finishing ninth, but rebounded to finish fourth in the Golden Slipper at odds of 16-1. Sent off at 9-1 for the Sires' Produce a week later, Guelph traveled in the rear before making a big move inside the final 200 meters, and she made a similar run yesterday. Traveling near the back of the pack through the early stages, she began to weave her way between rivals at the top of the stretch and, after appearing to linger slightly approaching the 100-meter mark, burst through for a thrilling victory. "She was a mile too far back, I thought," trainer Peter Snowden told *Racenet.com.au*. "We had a plan to be in the first half dozen from the better draw. I thought there was too much to do but she was good enough to do it. She's been to Melbourne then back to Sydney for the Slipper and then the Sires' and now the Champagne. It shows her ability and toughness. She's right up there with the best we've seen this season." Guelph's dam, Camarilla--who also won the Sires' Produce--died last year, but she has a yearling colt by Shamardal, and a weanling colt by Street Cry (Ire).

Yesterday's G1 Sydney Cup looked to be a battle of the imports, headed by favored Kelinni (Ire) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}), but it was the seasoned Mourayan who led home a trio of longshots to post his first Group 1 victory. A Listed-winning juvenile at Leopardstown in Ireland, the former Aga Khan homebred was sold to his current connections at the conclusion of a sophomore campaign that included a placing the G1 Irish Derby. While it took Mourayan more than two years to record his first victory down under, he was far from disgraced, placing in Group 1 company three times during that period, and he got off the mark at long last in the G3 Craven Plate over this strip last October. Seventh in the G1 Melbourne Cup thereafter, he wrapped up that campaign with a fourth place finish in the G2 Zipping Classic at Sandown. He resumed this year with a pair of eighth-place finishes, behind All Too Hard (Aus) (Casino Prince {Aus}) in the GII Futurity S. Feb. 23, and in the G1 Australian Cup Mar. 9. He was most recently fourth upon his return to Randwick in the G2 Chairman's Quality S. Apr. 13. Saving ground on the fence through the early stages while shouldering co-top weight of 128 pounds here, Mourayan moved off the rail as the field turned into the backstretch. About five-wide at the top of the lane, he stormed down the middle of the track under a determined drive to post a landmark victory. "It just panned out well," winning rider Hugh Bowman told *Racenet.com.au*. "I had to give him a bit of a squeeze out of the barriers and I landed in a nice position but the key to him today was he had the blinkers off. That was the difference. He just travelled much smoother than he did a fortnight ago in the Chairman's [Quality] and in the Melbourne Cup."

ELITE QUINTET IN GANAY CLASH

Five top-level winners are set to go postward for a mouthwatering renewal of the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp today, Europe's first Group 1 contest of the year. Pascal Treyve and Jean-Pierre Gauvin's **Saonais (Fr)** (Chichicastenango {Fr}) sprung from relative obscurity to swoop for last term's G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly in June, but the effects of a 10-month campaign took their toll with off-the-board efforts in the Oct. 7 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at this track and the Dec. 9 G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin, his only overseas foray. He seeks redemption here and returns off a career-long refresher since that latest outing. German raider **Pastorius (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) is another to boast a domestic Derby victory, having annexed the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg in July. He also bagged the same month's G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at Munich, and closed his sophomore year with a commendable fourth to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) and Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Oct. 20 G1 Champion S. at Ascot. ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Ridasiyna (Fr)** (Motivator {GB}) was compromised by nerves when surrendering her unbeaten record in August's G2 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville, but bounced back with an impressive success in the Oct. 7 G1 Prix de l'Opera here before running a close fourth in the Nov. 2 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Santa Anita last time. Fellow distaffer **Giofra (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who was runner-up in this last year before bagging the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket, hit the board in the Opera and renews rivalry with Ridasiyna coming off a second in the Dec. 9 Hong Kong Cup--ahead of Saonais--and a third in last month's G1 Dubai Duty Free at Meydan. Pearl Bloodstock's **Dunaden (Fr)** (Nicobar {GB}) added to his 2011 G1 Melbourne Cup and G1 Hong Kong Vase scores with a victory in last term's G1 Caulfield Cup, and lines up off a fourth in the Mar. 30 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan. However, this will be his first race going shorter than 12 panels in almost three years.

DERBY WINNERS COLLIDE IN QE II CUP

Two of the last three winners of the Hong Kong Derby, 2011 hero **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) and reigning champion **Akeed Mofeed (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) cross swords for the first time in today's G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Racecourse. The 'Dragon' used his Derby as a springboard to victory in this event in two years ago, but has thrived this season at distances from 1400 to 1600 meters. At his brilliant best to defeat top local miler Glorious Days (Aus) (Hussonet) in the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 9, the bay was a subpar fourth to that rival in the Stewards Cup Jan. 20. After missing the Hong Kong Gold Cup over this course and 2000-meter distance in February owing to injury, he hooked Glorious Days and Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup Mar. 17, but dusted those top-class foes by 2 1/2 lengths. Ambitious Dragon is best on the top of the ground, but trainer Tony Millard is not put off by recent inclement weather. "The rain we've had was good, it meant the grass was beautiful," the South African explained. "I'm pleased with him going into the race and hopefully everything goes according to plan. We just need a bit of luck now." Akeed Mofeed will look to join Ambitious Dragon and Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) as the only horses to complete the Derby/QE II double. Brought along methodically by trainer Richard Gibson, the 4-year-old was victorious in a Class 2 handicap over nine furlongs just 15 days ahead of his Derby win, and looks to prove himself on this stage. **Eishin Flash (Jpn)** (King's Best) has been the talking horse all week long, as he turned in one powerful gallop after the other. Cherry On The Top's Triple Tiara run began Mar. 2 at Turffontein, when she took the G2 Gauteng Fillies Guineas going a mile. She

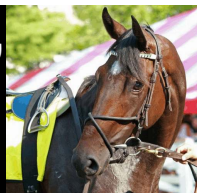

Singleton Splits With Waterhouse...

After pin-up mare More Joyous (NZ) (More Than Ready) could beat only one rival home in Saturday's G1 All Aged S. at Randwick, owner John Singleton made the decision to remove all his horses from the care of trainer Gai Waterhouse. Singleton told Australian television that the conditioner's son Tom, a bookmaker, had been telling people that the eight-time Group 1 winner was not right. "Tom has been saying she's got problems and I don't know about them," the owner told the Seven Network. "It's too much. It's a conflict of interest. My horses will be moved to another trainer. When I hear the horse has got problems and I don't know about it, it's wrong." Singleton's comments led stewards to conduct their own inquiry, during which Waterhouse stated the mare had received antibiotics for heat in her neck this past Thursday, but Singleton's personal vet passed More Joyous fit to run Saturday. In the end, no official action was taken. "We cannot put much weight on racecourse tattle," chief steward Ray Murrhy told AAP. Following the hearing, stewards accompanied the stable foreman back to the stables and collected treatment records. They will also review all betting transactions and intend to call Tom Waterhouse in for questioning when the hearing is resumed this coming Friday.

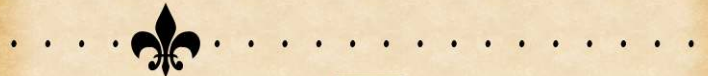
