Richard Hannon's Classic brigade have not made the impact most expected so far in 2013, but today's G1 Tattersalls Irish 2000 Guineas offers another opportunity for the stable and their solid campaigner **Van Der Neer (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}). Third in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas three weeks ago, Saeed Manana's likeable performer was building on the promise he had shown at two when runner-up to Kingsbarns (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in Doncaster's G1 Racing Post Trophy and when successful on his sophomore bow in the Listed International Trial S. on Lingfield's Polytrack last time Apr. 6. He is joined by Qatar Racing Limited & CSH's **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}), who was a close-up fifth in a blanket finish in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp 13 days ago. "Van der Neer has done two nice bits of work since he ran so well to finish third at Newmarket and, though he is never spectacular in the mornings, he looked the part when breezing at Herridge on Wednesday morning and the stiff uphill finish should suit him," Richard Hannon Jr said. "Havana Gold takes his racing well, so while this comes quickly after his super run in the French Guineas, we feel it is worth the gamble." **Cont. p3-4**

JUDGEMENT CALL

Qatar Racing Limited and the Sangster Family's **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) will face 15 rivals in tomorrow's G1 Etihad Airways Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh as she bids to regain the winning thread. Beaten a half length by Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}) when runner-up at Newmarket May 5, the Charlie Hills trainee carries stable confidence as she looks to provide her conditioner with a first Classic success. "We'd have to be pretty optimistic, as she's come out of the race well and she ran her heart out there doing it the hard way," commented the son of the famed Barry Hills, who carried off this prize in

1993 and 1999. "She has the advantage of having had that run and this is more of a galloping track, which will suit her. That is what attracted us to this race. She's fit and well, it's a Classic and there is no point in bypassing it. We're drawn two, so we're on the rail. NINE TO LINE UP FOR MET MILE

An extremely well-matched field of nine drew Friday for Monday's G1 Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park. The group includes eight graded stakes winners and combined career earnings of more than \$6.7 million. DEBUTANTE MAY BE NEXT FOR TEARDROP

"TDN Rising Star" Teardrop (Tapit), an eye-catching debut maiden winner at Churchill Downs Thursday ([video](#)), could make her next start in the Debutante S. in Louisville June 22. Owned and bred by Winchell Thoroughbreds, the 3/4-sister to Pyro (Pulpit), GISW, \$1,673,673, overcame a slow start and some greenness to score by 3 3/4 lengths as the even-money favorite. "She had never made a mistake in the morning and didn't do anything right in the afternoon," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "That's how it can go. Obviously, she has a tremendous amount of talent and I was very pleased with her this morning." He continued, "Hopefully we can keep getting in the right spots and having a little success."

While the last five of Aidan O'Brien's record eight winners had tackled the Newmarket equivalent beforehand, this year's prime candidate **Magician (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) is dropping down in trip, having impressed over the 10 furlongs of the G3 Dee S. at Chester when last seen. Many saw him as a Derby prospect immediately after that four-length romp on the Roodeye, so it was a mild surprise that he reverts to the course and distance over which he registered a six-length maiden score at the expense of the subsequent group performer **Bunairgead (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}) in October. "He's a Galileo with a very fast pedigree," his trainer told *PA Sport*. "He showed he got a mile and a quarter well at Chester, whether he'd get a mile and a half I'm not absolutely sure, but Chester's a sharp, fast track and he looked like he wouldn't have a problem dropping back to a mile." Runner-up in the G2 Norfolk S. over five furlongs at Royal Ascot in June and Newmarket's G1 Middle Park S. over six panels in October, **Magician's** stable companion **Gale Force Ten (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) possesses a fair share of speed along with his fellow barnmate **George Vancouver** (Henrythenavigator). The former had more of a straightforward passage through the Poulains than the colt who finished a short head behind him, Havana Gold, but it is hard to quantify how much improvement there is left in him. **George Vancouver** ran a tame race in the Newmarket Classic, but so did the stable's 2011 winner **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and last year's hero **Power (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), so it is far too early to write off his chances. He may need the ground faster than he is due to encounter here, as he came alive on a quick surface in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf in November. There is a possibility that the outsider of the Ballydoyle runners **Flying the Flag (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) could be the surprise package of the race. Out of the 2008 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine **Halfway To Heaven (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), he was finishing with real menace when a close-up ninth in the Poulains and has just 1 1/2 lengths to find with Team Valor's **First Cornerstone (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) on the form of the G2 Futurity S. over seven furlongs here in August.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a + will indicate first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

Sixth in that Newmarket Classic was Ahmad Alkhalafi's G3 Fred Darling S. winner **Maureen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), and the stable companion of Sky Lantern was proving that she stays this trip with a strong finishing effort there. "We weren't sure going into Newmarket whether she would stay the mile, but she finished the race off better than anything," Richard Hannon Jr said. "We can be a little bit handier and, though she has a few lengths to find with Just the Judge, we think that she has a good each-way chance." There were no surprises at yesterday's declaration stage, with David Nagle and Mrs. John Magnier's 1,000 Guineas fifth **Snow Queen (Ire)** (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) set to sport avisor for the first time as she heads a trio from Ballydoyle.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

May 27, 1985...Spend a Buck, winner of the GI Kentucky Derby three weeks earlier, won the GIII Jersey Derby after bypassing the GI Preakness S. The colt earned a \$2-million bonus for sweeping the Cherry Hill Mile H., Garden State S., Kentucky Derby and Jersey Derby.

May 29, 1948...Citation squeezed a victory in the Jersey S. at Garden State Park between his triumphs in the Preakness and Belmont S.

May 30, 1913...Whisk Broom II captured the Metropolitan H. by 1 1/2 lengths in his North American debut. He went on to sweep the New York Handicap Triple Crown, taking the Brooklyn H. and Suburban H. It would be 40 years before his accomplishment was duplicated.

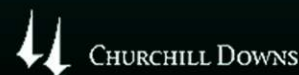

Apr. 25. **Starformer** (Dynaformer), heroine of the GIII Long Island H. Nov. 10 and GIII Very One S. Feb. 16, was last seen finishing a disappointing fifth in the GIII Orchid S. at Gulfstream Mar. 30.

OBVIOUSLY NOT SO OBVIOUS?

He's clearly the most accomplished member of this group, and **Obviously (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) will look to ascend to the top of the West Coast milers--a division he owned in 2012--in today's GII American H. at Betfair Hollywood Park. Winner of the GII Del Mar Mile H. and GII Arroyo Seco Mile last summer and early fall, the bay went the first seven furlongs of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in 1:20.31, but couldn't quite hold off Horse of the Year Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) and Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) and was a gallant third. Despite failing to win his seasonal debut in the GIII San Simeon S. down the hill Apr. 20, he led clear into the final furlong after setting fast splits and only ran out of gas late, missing by a half-length. If this race were about class, Obviously would have it all to himself, but today's pace looks above average and he must spot his rivals three to seven pounds as the 121-pound topweight. He remains the likeliest winner, but could prove vulnerable late. **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) gave a decent account of himself in the San Simeon, rallying from 11 lengths last to be fourth with a final five-sixteenths in just over 27 seconds. While seemingly best at seven furlongs, this two-turn mile should be within his scope and the race flow could enhance his chances. **Lucayan (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) upset last year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at 27-1, but didn't factor in three subsequent French starts for Francois Rohaut. He was scratched from a May 2 allowance with a foot issue and must deal with the one hole for his belated stateside bow. **Barocci (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}), the lone offspring for his sire in the U.S., cuts back to this trip off a one-length score over nine panels here Apr. 28.

PREAKNESS WRAP

If the Derby's been rough on me from a betting standpoint, the Preakness has been much kinder in recent years, and last weekend helped me regain some dignity after a dismal showing at Churchill. Thanks to big efforts by Oxbow, Itsmyluckyday and Mylute, I hit the trifecta several times, and if I had actually been in Baltimore to celebrate afterward with TDN-ers Steve Sherack and Jessica Martini, there's a pretty good chance I would have woken up on Sunday with D. Wayne Lukas tattoo on my back. Or more likely a Kegasus tattoo on my chest. But we avoided any grand statements of excess and can now proceed to the Belmont, shame free.

1) **ORB** (c, 3, [Malibu Moon](#)--Lady Liberty, by Unbridled) disappointed as the heavy favorite in the Preakness, running fourth at 3-5, but is still the undisputed divisional leader with the Derby, Florida Derby and Fountain of Youth on his resume. It's hard to say exactly what went wrong at Pimlico. Obviously he didn't get the sort of pace to run into that he did in the FOY and in the Derby, but that said, he was soundly beaten by Mylute (3rd), who was dead last after the opening half and maybe three lengths back of Orb at that point. I'm not sure Orb ever looked completely comfortable out there, and maybe just simply had an off day after four consecutive wins. It's low-hanging fruit to commend trainer Shug McGaughey and the class he's displayed in the last few weeks, but how can you not? He didn't try to dress up the defeat in excuses--didn't blame the two-week return, etc.--and just said it was probably due to a combination of factors, which it probably was. And when the NBC crew interviewed him directly after the race, he came off as exactly what he is: a terrific ambassador for the sport. **Last week ranked #1** [▶ Get Andrew Caulfield's Take.](#)

2) **VERRAZANO** (c, 3, [More Than Ready](#)--Enchanted Rock, by Giant's Causeway) doesn't have a Classic win on his resume like Oxbow, but boasts an important Grade I in the Wood Memorial and still has plenty of time to make his mark on this division. Connections have opted for a sensible return in the 1 1/16-mile GIII Pegasus S. at Monmouth June 16, which will serve as a prep for the GI Haskell Invitational on the shore July 28. I like that Pletcher & Co. have decided to keep him routing--again, after seeing him at the Derby, I don't think he's built like a sprinter--and even if he winds up topping out at nine furlongs, there are plenty of nice races with big purses to be won at that distance. **Last week ranked #2** [▶ Get Andrew Caulfield's Take.](#)

3) **OSBOW** (c, 3, [Awesome Again](#)--Tizamazing, by Cee's Tizzy) was beginning to look like a horse that didn't want to win before his breakout Preakness tally, but that he was the eighth choice at 15-1 (and six points higher than, for example, Governor Charlie) just didn't reflect what were some very solid efforts earlier in the year. I would also say that too much emphasis is being put on what people are calling a dawdling pace. They obviously weren't flying up front, but his splits of :23 4/5 and :48 3/5 (and to a lesser degree a 6f mark in 1:13 1/5) weren't glacial, as listless as the track was playing (in the GIII Allaire duPoint, Daydreamin Gracie led through :25 3/5 and :51 2/5 splits and didn't hit the board; the horses that were 1-2 in the GIII MD Sprint after a half in :45 3/5 didn't either). And his BRIS pace lines of 95/105/114 reflect this. In short, this was a much more comprehensive win than Oxbow's being given credit for. By the way, from a pedigree perspective, it's pretty wild to think that a 1986 model Seattle Song mare named Cee's Song, whose lone win in 18 starts came in a \$40,000 maiden claimer, would become one of the most important broodmares of the past 15 years. She's the dam, of course, of two-time BC Classic winner Tiznow and of \$2.8 million earner Budroyale, and is now the second dam of both Oxbow and last year's Haskell winner Paynter. **Last week ranked #5** [▶ Get Andrew Caulfield's Take.](#)

4) **REVOLUTIONARY** (c, 3, [War Pass](#)--Runup the Colors, by A.P. Indy) remains on course for the Belmont, where he'll be ridden by Javier Castellano. **Last week ranked #3** [▶](#)

5) **ITSMYLUCKYDAY** (c, 3, [Lawyer Ron](#)--Viva La Slew, by Doneraile Court) got a fine trip in the Preakness and had every chance in the lane. Despite loss, shows early season efforts were no fluke. Targets Haskell. **Last week ranked #7** [▶ Get Andrew Caulfield's Take.](#)

6) **NORMANDY INVASION** (c, 3, [Tapit](#)--Boston Lady, by Boston Harbor) **Last week ranked #4** [▶](#)

7) **GOLDENCENTS** (c, 3, [Into Mischief](#)--Golden Works, by Banker's Gold) got one of the best trips of the race in the Preakness and could manage only fifth. Sprinter/miler? **Last week ranked #6** [▶ Get Andrew Caulfield's Take.](#)

8) **MYLUTE** (c, 3, [Midnight Lute](#)--Stage Stop, by Valid Expectations) put in a good late run to be third in the Preakness, earning a giant 121 late-pace fig. Will skip Belmont. **Last week ranked #9** [▶](#)

9) **VYJACK** (g, 3, [Into Mischief](#)--Life Happened, by Stravinsky) **Last week ranked #8** [▶](#).

10) **DEPARTING** (g, 3, [War Front](#)--Leave, by Pulpit), from a trip standpoint, ran a similar race to Orb early in the Preakness, racing just outside that foe, and made nice progress on the far turn to put himself into striking position. I guess the distance found him out in the lane, but still a horse with talent. Could see him winning races like WV, OH, IL Derbys, etc, or being a threat on grass. **Last week ranked #10** [▶](#)

RECKLESS PURSUIT

An unbeaten revelation at two, **Reckless Abandon (GB)** (Exchange Rate) faces his elders in an intriguing renewal of the G2 Temple S. at Haydock today.

Rattling up a rare sequence in the G2 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot in June, G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte in July, G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August and G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in October, the Clive Cox trainee gets only four pounds from the hardened veteran sprinters here.

Only the star fillies **Fleeting Spirit (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and **Airwave (GB)** (Air Express {Ire}) have managed to upstage the mature brigade in this in recent times, but Reckless Abandon's conditioner is hoping that class will win out. "He's in very good form and I'm very happy with him," he told *PA Sport*. "He has wintered well and hopefully this is a stepping stone to Royal Ascot. It's a shame we don't have a 3-year-olds only race at this time of year, but that's the way it is and this is the logical step to take. We certainly hope he can be as effective at both five and six furlongs like last year and we are running him in the right races." **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), who beat **Kingsgate Native (Ire)** (Mujadil) in this two years ago, again has that rival back in second in Newmarket's G3 Palace House S. over this trip three weeks ago. Trainer Edward Lynam told *PA Sport*, "He seems in good form with himself and won his last start. By all accounts the ground is good at Haydock. It's his fourth run in a couple of months and he's been around a bit. That would be the slight niggle. We're happy with the horse. There are 12 runners; it's not a massive field, so it should be straightforward."

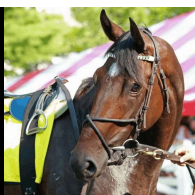

BC BERTH UP FOR GRABS IN ARGENTINA

A field of 19 will line up for today's G1 Gran Premio 25 de Mayo at San Isidro in Argentina, the first Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" race of the year for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The winner of the 2400-meter turf race will receive automatic entry into that \$3 million event, to be contested Nov. 2 at Santa Anita. Headlining the Gran Premio are the top three finishers of last month's G3 Clasico Porteno over this trip: **Storm Rancher (Arg)** (Bernstein), **Going Somewhere (Brz)** (Sulamani {Ire}), and **Soy Carambolo (Arg)** (Val Royal {Fr}). Storm Rancher is well-proven over these marathon distances, having also won last year's G2 Clasico General Pueyrredon going 1 7/8 miles. Going Somewhere, who finished 1 1/2 lengths behind Storm Rancher in the Porteno, made headlines last year when winning the G1 Carlos Pellegrini over this strip in December. Soy Carambolo, a two-time Group 3 winner last fall, did well to finish third in the Porteno off a six month layoff. He finished fourth in this event last year. The Gran Premio 25 is part of the international Breeders' Cup Challenge, a global series of 67 stakes races whose winners receive automatic berths into a corresponding race of the Breeders' Cup World Championships.

"We will be trying some new fertility techniques that weren't available when 'Star' last stood at stud," he explained. "He is a little older and more mature and we take some real heart from the job that was done on Foreplay. Our bloodstock manager Dean Harvey oversaw the transformation of Foreplay from a sub-fertile stallion to a real commercial option, now batting at close to 80% fertility. Stem cell treatment really helped and from what we understand, Starspangledbanner and Foreplay's areas of concern are very similar." No fee has been set at this time.

AL TAYER BACKS STEROID CRACKDOWN

Emirates Racing Authority's Saeed Al Tayer yesterday offered his full support to Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's decree that the import, trade and use of anabolic steroids for equine sport will be made a criminal offence. As a result of the high-profile scandal surrounding Godolphin's ex-trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni, the vice chairman of the body threw his weight behind the halt to the use of the substances.

"The UAE now has the strictest regulations possible against anabolic steroids anywhere in the world," a statement on Godolphin's website read. "It is important to understand that this decree will cover every horse, in every stable, of every yard. There will be no hiding place and these changes will be for the betterment of all horse sports in the region."

INVINCIBLE SPIRIT BREEZER SETS NEW RECORD AT GORESBRIDGE

There was a new record price set at Goresbridge's Breeze-Up Sale yesterday, as a son of Invincible Spirit (Ire) fetched €145,000 (*US \$187,452*). Consigned by Kilminfoyle House Stud, [hip 98](#) boasts as his second dam the GII Nassau S. winner Siringas (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}) and was snapped up by Rabbah Bloodstock. "He's a lovely, well-balanced horse who did a very nice breeze and he's by a proper stallion in Invincible Spirit," the operation's Jono Mills told the *Racing Post*. "We were delighted to get him and he will be going into training with James Tate." On a memorable day for the Gowran Park establishment, a Shamardal colt also broke into six figures when selling to owner Nigel Tinkler for €125,000. Rangefield Bloodstock's [hip 78](#) is a grandson of the G2 Premio Ribot winner Oriental Melody (Ire) (Sakhee) whose family includes Nashwan, Unfuwain and Nayef. "He did a very nice breeze and Fergal Lynch, who rode him yesterday, liked him a lot," Tinkler told the trade daily. "I've bought this horse on behalf of Mr Jim Gordon who has been a very loyal owner of mine." Four lots earlier, David Redvers had paid €82,000 for a colt from the first crop of Art Connoisseur (Ire) from Powerstown Stud. From a top-class Canadian family featuring last year's GI Cotillion S. third Dixie Strike (Dixie Union), the April-foaled chestnut will race in the colors of Qatar Racing. "It's very rare at a breeze-up sale that the best horse is so clearly the best horse," Redvers told the *Post*. "His time was half a second quicker than anything else and that seems to have taken nothing out of him. I bought three here last year and all have won and shown a good level of form." Another first-crop sire Bushranger (Ire) also figured prominently, with a colt selling to Desmond Koh for €62,000. Also from the draft of Tom Whitehead's Powerstown Stud, [hip 34](#) hails from the extended family of the great Miesque and all her esteemed progeny. Moments earlier, Gill Richardson Bloodstock secured a colt by Intense Focus, whose runners are also on the track this term. [Hip 28](#) from Mayfield Stables is related to the Tally Ho Stud resident Sir Prancealot (Ire) (Tamayuz {GB}) and cost €58,000.

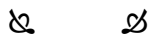
