## JUST REWARD

The Sangster legacy is entrenched in The Curragh's recent history, and it was fitting that the family enjoyed Classic glory again yesterday in partnership with the newly founded force of Qatar Racing courtesy of **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}). If victory here was

a welcome return on the heavy investment paid both by the late Robert Sangster and his clan down the years and in the more immediate period by Sheikh Fahad, it was also due compensation for the filly, who had been denied the same pleasure so late at Newmarket three weeks earlier. Stalking the pace early in third under Jamie Spencer,

the 2-1 favorite enjoyed a straight-forward trip throughout and after passing **Just Pretending** (Giant's Causeway) on the front end with a furlong remaining, was mainly hand ridden to score by 1 1/2 lengths from the strong-finishing 40-1 shot **Rehn's Nest (Ire)** (Authorized {Ire}). In doing so, Just the Judge was also added another chapter to the story of another famous racing dynasty, providing Charlie Hills with a first Classic success. "It is a great feeling and I'm so proud of the filly," the son of the legendary Barry Hills said. "She's a diamond and you can do anything with her-- she is so easy to train and very professional, so hopefully there are a few more nice races to go for. I felt sorry for her at Newmarket, as she did it the hard way and got done on the line."

## MAXIOS FIRES BEST SHOT IN ISPAHAN

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Maxios (GB) (Monsun {Ger}), well supported to collect his first badge at the highest level, came from just off the pace to land Sunday's G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp. "I have to thank Maria Niarchos and Alan Cooper, as they always back my judgment, even when the horse was not doing so well," said winning trainer Jonathan Pease. As to where the 5-year-old might go next, Cooper said, "It's about time he traveled, so on Tuesday we'll leave him in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [at Royal Ascot June 19] and we'll also keep him in the G1 Eclipse S. [at Sandown July 6] and I think he's [nominated to] the [G1] Arlington Million, so he has plenty of options." Cont. p5

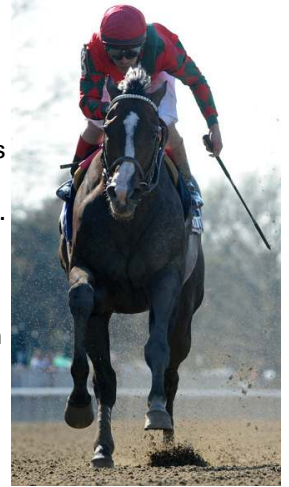
## 'FLAT OUT' EXCELLENT GROUP IN MET MILE

The GI Metropolitan H. never ceases to draw an excellent and diverse cast of competitors, and today's 122nd renewal of the "stallion maker" is no exception.

Preston Stables's **Flat Out** (Flatter) leads the field of nine on the strength of his local form. He's four-for-four at Big Sandy, with victories in the 2011 GI Suburban H., 2011 and 2012 GI Jockey Club Cold Cups and the GIII Westchester S. at this distance last out over **Cross Traffic** (Unbridled's Song) Apr. 27.

He and Cross Traffic, who were separated by just a head after their mile journey, both earned gaudy 115 Beyer Speed Figures in the Westchester and were more than 11 lengths clear of third-place finisher Rattlesnake Bridge (Tapit). The lightly raced Cross Traffic lost nothing in defeat last time, and has a world of upside.

A debut winner sprinting at Gulfstream Jan. 24, the 4-year-old GoldMark Farm representative earned the ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ distinction when he aired by 7 1/2 lengths in a one-mile optional claimer in Hallandale Mar. 10. He set solid splits in the Westchester and was game to cut it close, but may need to conserve his energy a bit more early against this bunch. Cont. p3

The top four finishers from Aqueduct's Apr. 6 GI Carter H.--**Swagger Jack** (Smart Strike), **Sahara Sky** (Pleasant Tap), **Discreet Dancer** (Discreet Cat) and **Fort Loudon** (Awesome of Course)--are all back for more in the Met Mile. Silverton Hill's **Swagger Jack** was second to Fort Loudon in the Mar. 3 GIII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship and to Discreet Dancer (while ahead of Fort Loudon) in the GII Gulstream Park H. a month later, but received a perfectly patient ride from Irad Ortiz, Jr. to upend the Carter at 15-1.

California invader Sahara Sky might have been best in that heat, however. A winner of Santa Anita's GII Palos Verdes. S. Jan. 19 and GII San Carlos S. Feb. 23, the Jerry Hollendorfer trainee wasn't given his cue until it was too late in the Carter, but flew home impressively to cut the winning margin to 3/4 of a length.

Impressing from the word go, Just the Judge showed dash to win over seven furlongs at Newbury in late June and followed up at the expense of the colts in the Listed Washington Singer S. back over the same track and trip the following month. After her subsequent win in Newmarket's G2 Rockfel S. over that distance in October, she left jockey Michael Hills under no illusion as to her quality, and he had only positive messages to pass on to Qatar Racing's retained rider Jamie Spencer as she was prepared for the

G1 1000 Guineas. Despite not coming right in her coat ahead of that May 5 Classic and being forced to race away from the main pace for the early part, she emerged with great credit losing out only in the final yards to Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}) and was the obvious choice here. Breaking well from her ideal post in two, she was allowed room to take a prominent pitch as her stall neighbors **Maureen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) and **Uleavemebreatless (GB)**


(Tiger Hill {Ire}) were taken back and moved forward into the lead, respectively. Taking the shortest

route around in the cat-bird seat tracking Ballydoyle's Just Pretending, she had dead aim on that rival as she was committed on the front end by Seamus Heffernan with a quarter mile remaining.

Shaken up as a threat emerged on her outside from **Big Break (GB)** (Dansili {GB})--who had suffered a vastly contrasting trip throughout from her wide post--Just the Judge had more to offer inside the final furlong and there was no Sky Lantern lurking this time. "She's a smart filly and had the form coming into the race, but when you are the one to beat and there are 16 runners,

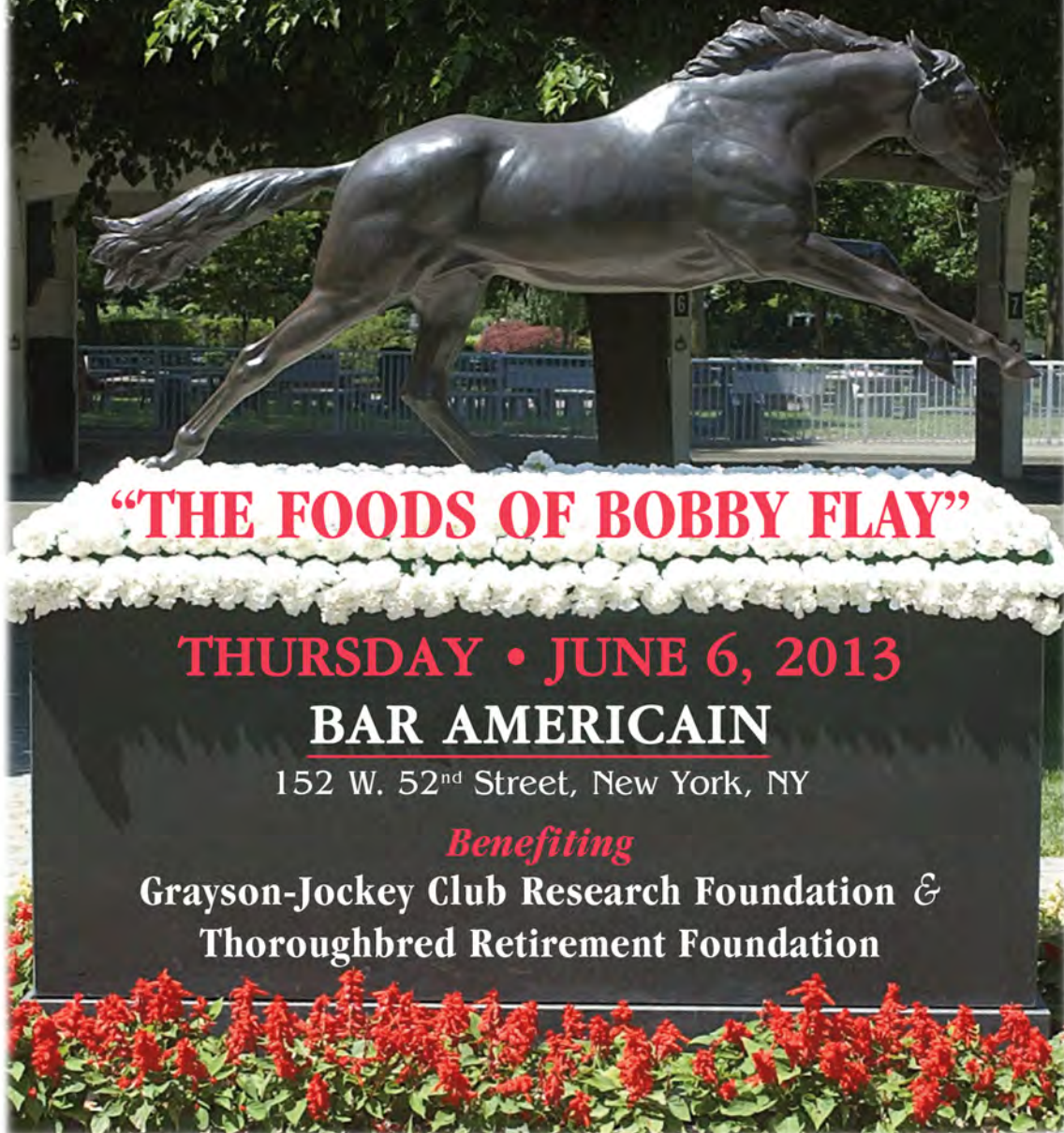
it's never going to be as straightforward as ABC," her rider said. "I got a good position and I was always happy--it was just a case of following Seamus [Heffernan] through. She is a filly that has always felt as if she will get further and gives all the signals that ten furlongs will be well within her grasp. When she comes off the bridle, she takes time to pick up and so will be even better when she gets to go further. What happened at Newmarket was hard lines and although you think 'should I have waited longer, I think Hughesie's filly was the best on the day, but my filly has come forward since

and I didn't have to give her a smack today. Ascot's mile is pretty stiff, so the [June 21] G1 Coronation S. will suit her and it is a case of rationing out her stamina."

Charlie Hills confirmed that a rematch with Sky Lantern is on the agenda. "Full credit to Jamie, he gave her a peach of a ride," her trainer said. "We can ride a bit more of a race on her at Ascot and taking on Sky

Lantern will make a great spectacle. She is not the easiest, as when she gets fresh she can throw a few shapes and you have to keep the top on her, so it's a big team effort." For Sheikh Fahad, the result marked a watershed as the first Classic winner in the silks of Qatar Racing and he commented, "This is Qatar Racing's first proper

season and this is the first Classic. We said after Newmarket that she was mugged, as she didn't see the other filly and we were confident coming here. She is much better in her coat now and showed today that she is a different filly. She is only going to improve." Aidan O'Brien was delighted with the effort of Just Pretending and said, "It wasn't a fast pace and Seamus was delighted with the filly. She's done well to have gone from not winning her maiden to progressing the way she has."

After his four-length winning debut over a mile here in September 2010, Maxios earned a "TDN Rising Star" tag in part due to the manner of his success, but also with the immense promise that his illustrious pedigree bestowed upon him. With so much expectation on his shoulders, the half-brother to Bago (Fr) (Nashwan) was almost disappointing when managing to scrape home in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon by only a short head at Saint-Cloud the following month and was left alone thereafter. His Classic campaign started off badly with a tame performance when last of five in the G3 Prix la Force over 1 5/16 miles back at this venue in April and never recovered, but following that write-off year, the green shoots were emerging with a second

placing in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly last June. Two unplaced efforts in the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville in August and G2 Prix Dollar over this course and distance in October meant that the path to redemption was not running smoothly, but they sandwiched a more respectable win in the G3 La Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte in September. With many of the better horses of 2012 now at stud, the homebred returned at five to a European pattern open to the lesser lights, and he quickly capitalised by scoring in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt over 10 furlongs here before finishing second behind Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}) in the G1 Prix Ganay over the same track and trip last time Apr. 28.

Settled in behind the leading duo by Stephane Pasquier enjoying a perfect tow against the rail, the dark bay needed room in early stretch and that came just before the initially free-running Planteur was committed with a furlong remaining. Picking up as that rival began to pay for his earlier exertions in the final 50 meters, he asserted for the career high with the still-unexposed Mandour producing an eye-catching finish. The Niarchos family's racing manager Alan Cooper added, "This horse deserves a Group 1 and we've known for a long time that he is a nice horse. He was good at two and four and he had reasons for his bad year at three. And now is even better at five."

Surrendering late to the subsequent G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up Esoterique (Ire) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) in that extended nine-furlong trial for the G1 Prix de Diane, the bay returned to winning ways with this late show under the contrasting tactics employed by Olivier Peslier. Keen early initially without cover, she eventually accepted restraint as she was anchored in rear along with stable companion Ferevia off the steady pace set by **TDN Rising Star** and favorite Siyenica (Fr) (Azamour {Ire}). Asked to close in early stretch, the homebred had three lengths to make up as Alterite hit the front with a furlong remaining, but found an extra gear to rob that rival in the shade of the post and come out on top of a five-filly blanket finish.

"Today was the day to try another tactic with her and, although she did not understand early on, she did settle and was able to produce her turn of foot," trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias commented. "Olivier gave her a great ride and the other filly ran well also, so we will take two to the Diane [at Chantilly June 16]. It's better to have a pair of runners in it than watch it on TV."

Domeside, who carved his reputation in his native Spain, went from winning the Prima Bannaby over 11 furlongs at Madrid's La Zarzuela Mar. 17 to success in a 12-furlong claimer for lady amateur riders at Saint-Cloud a fortnight later. What that sequence did for the veteran's confidence is hard to quantify, but he went from that low level to finish a neck behind Last Train when third in the G3 Prix de Barbeville over this track and trip last time Apr. 28 and stepped up again to register a first pattern-race success here. Third early as Les Beaufs set about his customary business bowling along in isolation, Christophe Soumillon was content to allow that rival substantial rope as the leader established a clear lead as early as halfway. That daring paid off only for the eventual winner, who proved the only rival able to get to last year's G1 Prix Royal-Oak hero after finding the perfect split between him and the one-paced Last Train en route to taking command in the final 200 yards. "Today, this horse had everything going for him and the softer the better," trainer Mauricio Delcher-Sanchez commented. "We might consider the G1 Gold Cup [at Royal Ascot June 20], but he'd have to be supplemented and is not easy at the gate, which in England might be a problem."

"He was so impressive last year and I was so excited about him, so it was hard to take when I found out he had incurred an injury during the race at Newmarket," jockey James Doyle commented. "Roger [Charlton] always said we would get him back and the class was still there when we were galloping him, so it's great to see it all come together. Roger left a lot to work with at Sandown and didn't want him at 100% as he was using it as a stepping stone, but I was still able to win without giving him too hard a race and he's come on leaps and bounds for that. You have to respect Camelot, whose record speaks for itself, but passing the two pole, I couldn't believe how well we were going and I was having to take him back. There's a lot of fun to be had with him now." Aidan O'Brien is still intent on taking in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and was not too perturbed with the reversal. "He ran well, he probably got a little bit tired and met a very fit horse on the day," he told the *Racing Post*. Favored Kizuna emulated the feat of his Japan Derby-winning sire Deep Impact and gave the stallion his second straight winner of the Classic after Deep Brillante (Jpn) a year ago, while earning his first Group 1 victory and third consecutive group win. After taking the G3 Mainichi Hai in March, Kizuna skipped the first leg of the Triple Crown, the G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas), and instead stretched out to 2200 meters to win the G2 Kyoto Shimbun Hai last time out. Kizuna settled near the back of the field as Apollo Sonic rushed out to set the early fractions. Meikei Pega Star (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) pulled his way to the lead down the backstretch before Apollo Sonic reengaged that foe turning for home and briefly opened a clear lead in upper stretch. Epiphaneia was first to overtake the leader, taking over with 100 meters to run, but Kizuna, who had angled to the outside for racing room, unleashed a powerful late rally to surge to the lead late. Kizuna's win gave jockey Yutaka Take a record fifth Japan Derby victory. Take also rode Deep Impact to Derby glory. This was the first Derby victory for trainer Shozo Sasaki.

The last time Tony Cruz had tasted victory in the Champions and Chater Cup was back in 1995 when he rode Makapura Star (NZ) for trainer John Moore, and it all came full circle Sunday when evergreen California Memory successfully negotiated this 2400-meter journey in his first attempt. Successful in defending his title in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 9, the popular gray was always up against it in the Stewards' Cup Jan. 20, but gave a good account of himself when a running-on third to top miler Glorious Days (Aus) (Hussonet). He was at something less than peak fitness for the G1 Audemars Piguet QE II Cup Apr. 28, but finished well for second behind Military Attack (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}), who would frank the form in no uncertain terms in Singapore last weekend. Sent off the second choice here, California Memory switched off nicely in midfield as Liberator (Aus) (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) set a sensible pace. That one was still going strong and pinched a break on the field rounding the turn, and, for a few strides, it looked as if California Memory would fail to fire. But Matthew Chadwick got his mount back on the bit, guided him down to the inside in the stretch and kicked away, as stablemate Willie Cazals rallied from the tail for second. Favored Dominant was outfinished for third. "My game plan was just to get him settled and get him behind to make sure he could see out the 2400 meters," said Chadwick. "He relaxed beautifully; when they took off around about the 800-meter [mark] and then when they picked up around the 600-meter [point], he was caught a bit flat-footed." earned a victory at the highest level with a powerful four-length success over More Chocolate (Malibu Moon) last time in Santa Anita's GI Santa Margarita S. Mar. 16. She received a career-best 108 Beyer Speed Figure for the effort. The well-traveled

Ontario-bred has been to Belmont twice before, finishing third in the 2010 GI Frizette S. and second in the 2011 GI Mother Goose S. **Authenticity** (Quiet American) could prove a major factor here from gate to wire. The Padua Stables representative posted a mild upset over GI Apple Blossom H. winner On Fire Baby (Smoke Glacken) and 2012 GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Believe You Can** (Proud Citizen) in the May 3 GII La Troienne S. on the Kentucky Oaks undercard, and was the only runner that day to find the winner's circle after racing on the rail. She will look to provide trainer Todd Pletcher with his fourth win in this race in the past four years (Awesome Maria 2011, Life at Ten 2010) and is joined by uncoupled stablemate **Disposablepleasure** (Giacomo). That Glencrest Farms colorbearer was a 1 3/4-length allowance winner over **Centring** (A.P. Indy) going this trip at Gulfstream Mar. 17, and justified 6-5 favoritism when taking Hawthorne's GIII Sixty Sails H. Apr. 20. She's another with solid local form, having broken her maiden by 11 lengths in October of 2011 and finishing second in the GI Mother Goose S. last June. Both performances came at this distance. Cresran homebred **Tiz Miz Sue** (Tiznow) upended Joyful Victory in last year's GIII Azeri S. at Oaklawn, and pulled off another upset in this year's renewal of that event when besting Don't Tell Sophia (Congaree) and My Miss Aurelia (Smart Strike) two back Mar. 16. She's coming off a runner-up effort in the Apple Blossom Apr. 12 in which she endured some traffic trouble.

## RISING STARS ALIGN IN ACORN

A quartet of ☆ **"TDN Rising Stars"** ☆ square off today in Belmont's prestigious GI Acorn S., contested on Met Mile day as opposed to its usual place on the GI Belmont S. undercard for the second straight year.

Stonestreet Stables **Kauai Katie** (Malibu Moon) leads the way as she looks to make it four-for-four in 2013. The bay suffered her first career defeat when she chased

Beholder (Henny Hughes) before fading to fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Santa Anita Nov. 2, but has bounced back with aplomb as a sophomore. She annexed Gulfstream's GIII Old Hat S. by eight lengths on New Year's Day and the GII Forward Gal S. by 5 1/2 lengths over fellow 'Rising Star' My Happy Face (Tiz Wonderful) 25 days later. Kauai Katie prepped for this in the Big A's Road Princess S. Apr. 21, defeating three overmatched foes by the easiest of 3 1/4-length margins at 1-20. She must travel an extra furlong this time, however, against stiffer competition. Pegram, Watson and Weitman's **Midnight Lucky** (Midnight Lute) was as impressive as could be donning cap and gown by 7 1/4 lengths in her 6 1/2-furlong Santa Anita unveiling Feb. 16, and validated that performance while handing a route of ground in the 1 1/16-mile Sunland Park Oaks. She cruised by eight lengths that day, lowering the track record in the process. Receiving glowing workout reports leading up to the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks, the grey found herself caught up in a hot pace and faded to fifth. She'll now hope for success from the same Oaks-to-Acorn angle that put fellow Bob Baffert trainee Gabby's Golden Gal (Medaglia d'Oro) in the winner's circle here in 2009. Baffert also took this race last year by five lengths with yet another 'Rising Star' in Contested (Ghostzapper). Bill Mott also brings back Juddmonte Farms's **Close Hatches** (First Defence) from an Oaks disappointment--the GII Gazelle S. winner simply never fired when seventh under the Twin Spires.

Look for the (K) throughout the TDN graded stakes entries, denoting Keeneland sales graduates.

**RACE READINESS KEY FOR 'MIX'**

Glen Hill Farm's **Marketing Mix** (Medaglia d'Oro) makes a belated seasonal debut in today's GI Gamely S. at Betfair Hollywood Park and looks far superior on paper to any of her six rivals. But will that lack of recency come back to bite her? To say the Ontario-bred had a productive 4-year-old campaign would be a monumental understatement, with four wins from seven tries and over \$1-million in earnings in 2012 alone. Following a pair of Grade II scores at Woodbine, she missed by a head when second in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 18 before earning that elusive first top-level win in the Rodeo Drive S. at Santa Anita Sept. 29. She led into the final furlong of the GI Breeders' Cup Filly/Mare Turf, but could not resist Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune) and settled for the place. Marketing Mix was ticketed for a prep in the GII Distaff Turf Mile May 5 at Churchill, but connections chose not to tackle the rain-affected turf. Preakness-winning jockey Gary Stevens takes over in the irons. If not Marketing Mix, then it would appear **Lady of Shamrock** (Scat Daddy) is the next most-likely winner. She, too, was four-from-seven in 2012, with signature victories in the GI American Oaks at this venue and in the GI Del Mar Oaks before a fifth in the Filly/Mare Turf. She makes her third start of the season here, having justifiably been promoted to the win in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 20.

**Tiz Flirtatious** (Tizbud) defeated Lady of Shamrock in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 24 and ran the best race of her career when finishing runner-up in this track's GI Matriarch S. last November.

**'CHANCES' LOOKS TO MAKE HER 'POINT'**

**Watsdachances (Ire)** (Diamond Green {Fr}) looks to regain the winning thread and snap a two-race losing streak in today's GII Sands Point S. at Belmont Park. The bay filly rallied to take her U.S. debut in the P.G. Johnson S. at Saratoga Aug. 29 and overcame yielding Belmont turf to add the GIII Miss Grillo S. ahead of an outstanding runner-up effort to Flotilla (Fr) (Mizzen Mast) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' Turf Nov. 2. The form of that race was flattered when the winner returned to take this year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}), the troubled eighth at Santa Anita, landed this year's G1 English 1000 Guineas. However, things didn't go all that smoothly for Watsdachances in her sophomore debut in Keeneland's GIII Appalachian S. Apr. 18, where she finished an excuse-free fourth to **Unbelievable Dream** (Kitalpha), but she should improve for the effort and looms large here. Barclay Tagg's other entrant, Caroline Thomas (Giant's Causeway), could get a bit forgotten here. 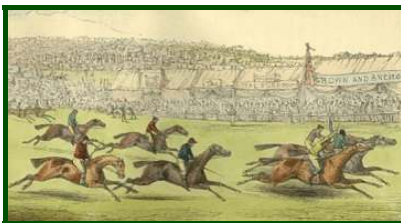

MAGICIAN ENTERS DERBY PICTURE

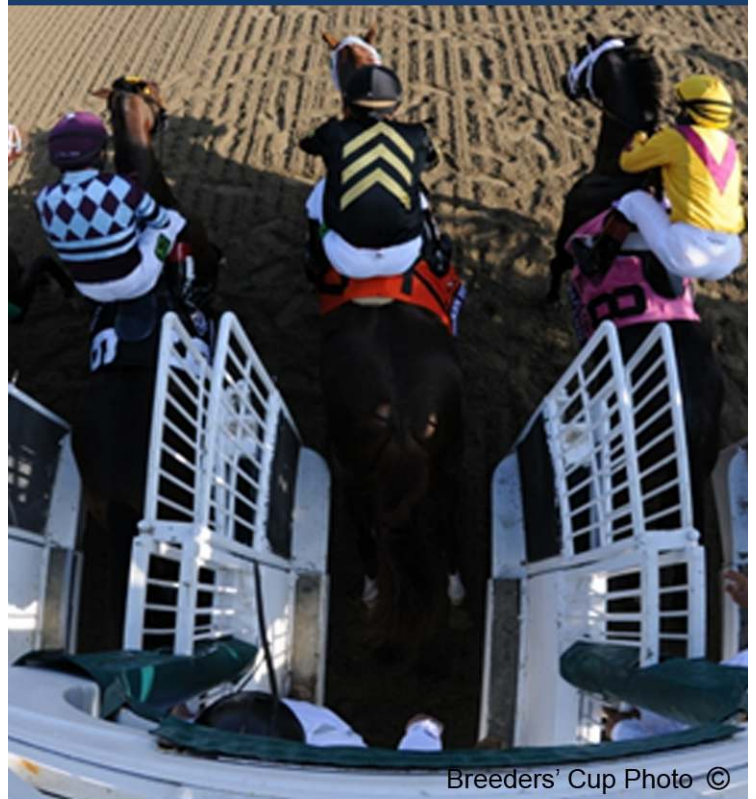
