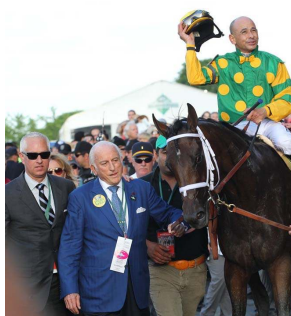

ALL FINE WITH PALACE MALICE

Trainer Todd Pletcher reported **Palace Malice** (Curlin) exited his win in Saturday's GI Belmont S. in fine shape. "He is a remarkable horse," said Pletcher. "He bounces out of his races really well. It was a tough race, a demanding race, and he surprises me how resilient he is. He was feeling very good this morning." Pletcher is already looking ahead to Palace Malice's summer campaign. "Honestly, the way he's feeling this morning, I don't know that I am going to be able to give him much time off," he said. "He's just that kind of horse. He's a high-energy, good-feeling horse. He'll go back to the track four days from now. We'll probably carry forward to the [July 27 GII] Jim Dandy." Pletcher saddled a record five horses in the Belmont and he said Sunday that all exited the race in good shape. **Unlimited Budget** (Street Sense), sixth in the Belmont, will likely return to a race against fillies for her next start.

"Unlimited Budget will most likely go to the [July 20] GI Coaching Club American Oaks, if she comes out of this well, which so far she has." POINT OF ENTRY SUFFERS FRACTURE

Phipps Stable and Frank Stronach's **Point of Entry** (Dynaformer), winner of Saturday's GI Woodford Reserve Manhattan H. at Belmont Park, exited the race with a condylar fracture in his left hind cannon bone, trainer Shug McGaughey revealed yesterday. "He'll be on the shelf for a while," McGaughey said. "How long, I don't know." McGaughey said the 5-year-old five-time Grade I winner will undergo surgery at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital. Surgery will be performed by Dr. Larry Bramlage. "It does need screws," Bramlage said. "This is the kind of fracture we treat all the time. We expect him to come back and run well. It requires surgery, but it's a pretty responsive injury." McGaughey is hopeful Point of Entry can make it back in time for the Breeders' Cup. "I don't know what the down time is until [Bramlage] looks at him," McGaughey said. "He said maybe two weeks [in his] stall, two weeks hand walk and them maybe start riding him under tack. But I'm not going to be too hopeful on that. Best-case scenario, maybe we can get a race into him in September. Best-case scenario, maybe the Breeders' Cup is not out of the question. The intention all along was to retire him at the end of the year."

BOTTI CONTINUES ITALIAN DOMINATION

Not content with filling the first three places in the G2 Derby Italiano, Italy's dominant trainer Stefano Botti repeated the feat in Sunday's G1 Gran Premio di Milano, with **Biz the Nurse (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) making light work of ending a 27-year drought for the sophomores in the 12-furlong event. Unextended in the Apr. 28 Listed Premio Botticelli over 1 5/16 miles at the Capannelle, the bay took the aforementioned 11-furlong Classic by four lengths May 19 and carried his superiority over into this new sphere taking on his elders. Settled with only one behind early by Cristian Demuro, Biz the Nurse took time to find top gear in the straight as his stable companions **Wild Wolf (Ire)** (Rail Link {GB}) and **Romantic Wave (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) battled it out ahead, but he got to that pair with a furlong remaining and drew away for a convincing 2 1/4-length score. **Cont. p4**

Zayat Stables's **Paynter** (Awesome Again), who has battled back from life-threatening illness, will return to the races for the first time since winning last year's GI Haskell Invitational Friday at Betfair Hollywood Park. Rafael Bejarano has the mount on the 4-year-old Bob Baffert trainee in the day's seventh race, a seven-furlong allowance. Paynter, second in last year's GI Belmont S., will be making his synthetic track debut and faces seven rivals.

Orb Earns a Rest...

Trainer Shug McGaughey admitted GI Kentucky Derby winner **Orb** (Malibu Moon) was a tired horse after his third-place effort in Saturday's GI Belmont S. "I went down and looked at him a little later and he was kind of hanging his head," McGaughey said. "He was tired. He'll get a good month of rehab time and see where it takes us." The trainer remained philosophical after a whirlwind Triple Crown season. "I understand the game well enough to know you can't win them all," he said. "He won five in a row, three graded stakes, two Grade 1s--not bad. I was satisfied with the decisions I made. I don't think I took a horse over there that wasn't ready to run. To try to make up that much ground is almost impossible because it's so tiring. Those horses shook loose and we couldn't catch them. Hopefully we can get him back on his feet and get him back going in the right direction. I would love to run him in the [Aug. 24 GI] Travers."

Belmont Handle down 8.1%...

The total handle of \$88,652,023 for Saturday's Belmont Stakes card was down 8.1% from 2012, an acceptable decline considering there was no Triple Crown bid on the line. Last year, I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) came to New York having won the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S., but was scratched the day before the Belmont with a career-ending injury. Still, at that point, many people had already made plans to attend. Attendance for Saturday's race, won by Palace Malice (Curlin), was 47,562, compared to 85,811 last year, a drop of 44.6%.

On-track handle was \$10,700,326, down 22.3%, while the off-track handle was \$77,951,697, down 5.8%. The 2013 numbers compared favorably to 2011, when Derby winner Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) and Preakness hero Shackelford (Forestry) were upset by Ruler on Ice (Roman Ruler). Total handle was up 9% from two years ago (+6% on track, +9.5% off track), though attendance was down 14.7%.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

MIZDIRECTION OK AFTER JUST A GAME LOSS

Mizdirection (Mizzen Mast) came out of her disappointing fifth-place effort in Saturday's GI Just a Game S., according to trainer Mike Puype. "I'm not making any excuses," Puype said Sunday morning. "It's just the circumstances. After all the rain they got, the turf course was really deep. When they come out here, it's different, and when we fly there, it's different. I don't think her quality is in question. We had to take a chance with the race being a Grade 1 and for all that money." Mizdirection was expected to be back at her Betfair Hollywood Park base Sunday night and immediate plans for the 5-year-old mare are up in the air.

DECLASSIFY EYES KING'S BISHOP

Kaleem Shah's **Declassify** (Orientate), who followed up a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ debut at Santa Anita Apr. 6, with a 7 1/2-length romp at Hollywood Sunday (video), will be pointed towards the Apr. 25 GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga. The colt was a \$450,000 OBS April juvenile purchase last year. "We bought him strictly for his athletic ability," trainer Bob Baffert said. "He had worked really fast and did things the right way. We took our time with him because he had a few minor setbacks like shins and quarter cracks."

Boisterous, winner of last year's GIII Knickerbocker S. and GII Red Smith H., was returning to the turf after a runner-up effort behind Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) in the Apr. 21 GIII Ben Ali S. over Keeneland's Polytrack. The even-money favorite settled into a ground-saving fourth as longshot Two Notch Road took the field through fractions of :24.62, :49.20 and 1:13.17 over a turf course labeled good. Boisterous angled to the outside for running room in upper stretch, quickly inhaled the pacesetter and strode clear as Big Blue Kitten closed from last to second. "I had the absolute perfect trip all the way around there," reported winning rider John Velaquez. "The horse on the lead I know is a good horse because I rode him last year.

I knew he would carry me a pretty far way. We got squeezed around the quarter pole, but once we got to the outside it was over. It's fun to ride ones like this." Buzz Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey, added, "That sure worked out how we hoped. This horse likes to put himself in the race early, not necessarily on the lead, but right up with the leaders. I really liked our chances when I saw him sitting in fourth behind the leaders. He hasn't won a Grade I yet, but he's a solid Grade II, Grade III horse."

A debut winner over this strip last August, Nipissing went on to collect her next three starts, including the Princess Elizabeth S. and South Ocean S. to round out her campaign. The homebred was sixth when ambitiously placed in the GI Ashland S. Apr. 13 and returned to her home base to finish a credible second to the smart Coffee Clique (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GIII Selene S. May 19. She was sent off the second choice here behind Grade I winner Spring in the Air.

Nipissing was content to travel midpack outside of runners early. Moving into contention around the turn, she passed a tiring Smartyfly (Smart Strike) at the top of the lane and took dead aim on her front-running stablemate Original Script. Nipissing collared that rival inside the final sixteenth with Spring in the Air at her flank and held that rival at bay for her third lifetime stakes victory. Nipissing became the first daughter of a Queen's Plate winner to take the Woodbine Oaks since Avowal in 1982. Nipissing's sire Niigon, who also campaigned as a homebred for Chiefswood Stable, won the 2004 Queen's Plate. He died last year after a paddock accident. It was the second Oaks win for jockey Steven Bahen and the first for trainer Rachel Halden. "Last time we were a little further back, so I was hoping she'd break a little sharper, which she did today," said Bahen. "I wanted to be three, four lengths off the pace, sit on the outside and give her a clean trip. It worked out perfectly. She ran her eyeballs out and she galloped out strongly like she always does." Halden, a former assistant to trainer Roger Attfield, added, "It feels great. It just seems such a long time ago that she won the Princess Elizabeth and we started talking about this race. You just hope she stays healthy and everything goes to plan and fortunately it did."

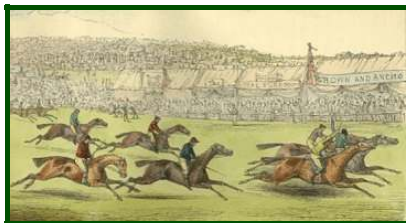

Purchased for C\$90,000 by Ciaran Dunne on behalf of Donna and Vern Dubinsky's Donver Stable at the 2009 Ontario September Yearling sale, Inglorious opened her career with wins in the 2010 Fanfreluche S. and Ontario Lassie S. Second in the GIII Rachel Alexandra S. at Fair Grounds in 2011, she returned to Woodbine to win the La Lorgnette S. before becoming the fifth filly to complete the Woodbine Oaks/Queen's Plate double and earning the Sovereign Award as Canada's champion 3-year-old filly. Winless in nine starts since the Queen's Plate, the 5-year-old mare was third in last year's GII Dance Smartly S., GII Bayakoa S. and GIII Suwannee River S. On the board in 11 of 16 starts for trainer Josie Carroll, Inglorious retires with five wins and earnings of \$1,421,222. "She's had an extraordinary career and is telling us that it's time," Carroll told *Daily Racing Form*. "[The owners] wanted to listen to her and retire her while she's in good health. Naturally, it's disappointing, but she's done everything we've asked her to do."

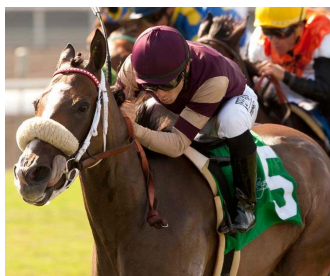
