Exiting the stalls like a shot, Fort Larned, a grandson of Whitham's champion racemare Bayakoa (Arg), rushed up to take the early lead and kept 9-5 choice Take Charge Indy safe through opening splits of :23.69 and :46 4/5. Loping along down the backstretch as Take Charge Indy appeared to be working just to keep up, the handsome bay fired all boosters turning for home, kicked clear in the lane and was 6 1/4-lengths clear of **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) at the wire. **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate) closed late for third, while the favorite finished sixth and last. The final time of 1:47.45 was 17/100ths of a second off the track record set by Victory Gallop in 1999. "We were going down the backside and were cooking right along and the poles were going by pretty fast, but he was always doing it well within himself so I wasn't really worried about it," said winning rider Brian Hernandez.

He added, "When we turned for home, I pulled the stick through and he switched leads like the Fort Larned of old." Eighth in this test last season, Fort Larned regrouped to win last June's GIII Cornhusker H. at Prairie Meadows before annexing the GI Whitney Invitational H. Aug. 4. "I took the blame [running eighth in 2012], because I didn't do a good job with this horse for the Stephen Foster last time. I had too pretty of a horse. I had a show horse, not a racehorse last year. I knew I was coming in ready this year. The

Stephen Foster was one we wanted to win." Third when favored in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Sept. 29, the Ian Wilkes trainee returned to land the Breeders' Cup Classic at healthy 9-1 odds at Santa Anita Nov. 3. Well supported in his much hyped return in the Mar. 9 GII Gulfstream Park H., he fell to his face exiting the stalls and led the field through a merry chase--albeit riderless--before finally being corralled. Given another chance by bettors at the windows for his latest in the Apr. 13 GII Oaklawn H., the 5-year-old failed to mount any significant challenge

and had to settle for fifth, beaten 10 lengths by Cybersecret (Broken Vow). "He ran unbelievable," said winning trainer Ian Wilkes. "It was gratifying to get the horse back and to prove that he's as good as I thought he was and show he wasn't a one-year wonder." As for what's next for Fort Larned, Wilkes added, "We'll run him in the Whitney and try to have him defend his crown." As for the Classic, he said, "It's always been the end of the year goal to get back to the Breeders' Cup. We'll go the Whitney and then take it one race at a time." Haras du Quesnay's Treve followed a smooth winning debut at Longchamp in September with an assured and authoritative follow-up here May 15, and there should be more to come, as those runs came at a mile trip that should be a minimum on pedigree. Whether she can upset the likes of Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Thani's **Flotilla (Fr)** (Mizzen Mast)--who is attempting to become the 26th filly to complete the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches-Prix de Diane double--or Baron Edouard de Rothschild's **Esoterique (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) remains to be seen, but it is significant that her knowledgeable connections are taking the plunge. While the G1 Prix Saint-Alary had become an almost insignificant trial for this Classic after the double was achieved by Zainta (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) in 1998, there were two consecutive winners of that Longchamp contest to emulate her in Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) and Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) in 2009 and 2010. This year, it is up to **Silasol (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) to fly that particular flag following her last-gasp success May 26, which was her second at that level at Longchamp, having won the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on Arc day. In a change of tactics there, the Wertheimers' homebred swooped from rear to deny Martin Schwartz's **Alterite (Fr)** (Literato {Fr}) in a bunched finish.

It is likely that similar tactics could be employed in what could turn out to be a tactical affair. Successful six times in this race, Alain de Royer-Dupre saddles a dark horse this time in Peter Makin's expensive purchase **Chicquita (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). She has plenty to find following a fall on her sole sophomore start in a conditions event over this trip at Saint-Cloud May 24.

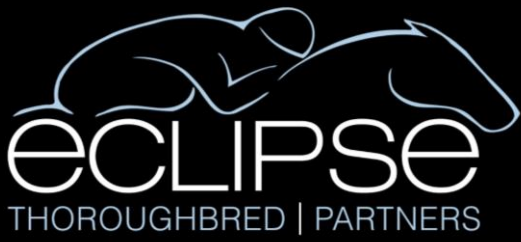

Byrama, runner-up on Del Mar's Polytrack in the restricted CERF S. last term, went one better in the Unzip Me S. on the Santa Anita lawn in September. Kicking off 2013 with a fourth behind Mizdirection (Mizzen Mast) in the Jan. 6 GII Monrovia S., she rounded out the show spot in the restricted Wishing Well S. Feb. 10. Third again when going a mile in the Feb. 18 GII Buena Vista S., the bay just missed by a neck in Keeneland's GI Madison S. going seven-eighths of a mile Apr. 13. Sixth last time in the GI Humana Distaff over the Churchill main track May 4, she was losing the blinkers on debut on the Cushion Track. Content to stalk the early pace through an opening quarter in :23.53, the 4-year-old closed on the front after a half in :47.14, was joined at the head of the lane by More Chocolate, but repelled that one's bid and kicked away late to score by a 3 1/2-length margin. "We didn't have any cover going around the first turn and I was a little worried about that, but then she settled in well into a real nice rhythm," said winning jockey Gary Stevens. "Actually, I made her kick a little earlier than I would have liked. Her run is only about an eighth of a mile and I had to use her between the quarter pole and the eighth pole and she was able to float home the last sixteenth of a mile." Added winning trainer Simon Callaghan, "She loves the synthetic, so we'll definitely keep her on that."

With most of the pre-race hype swirling around two-time champion older mare Royal Delta, yesterday's GII Fleur de Lis H. appeared to be a mere formality. Bet down to 1-5 favoritism, Royal Delta was fanned out four wide around the first turn as Funny Proposition bounded out to take a comfortable lead. Moving easily through a half in :46.83, Funny Proposition must have felt the breath of her rivals on her back as the field--headed by Royal Delta--loomed approaching the quarter pole. While Royal Delta appeared to be struggling to keep up in the stretch, Funny Proposition was floating along up front under a strong hand ride by Joel Rosario. At the wire, Funny Propostion was five lengths clear of Royal Delta, with She's All In 3/4 of a length back in third. A winner over this track 13 months ago, Funny Proposition failed to hit the board in three subsequent starts, including a sixth-place finish going a mile at Gulfstream Feb. 18. Third against \$63,500 optional claiming foes over the Keeneland Polytrack Apr. 14, the 4-year-old came back to win her latest while trying eight panels over this track May 17. "The saying is, 'It's nice when a plan comes together,'" said Norm Casse, assistant to Mark Casse. "We had a plan and it came together the way we thought it would. We thought we would take it to (Royal Delta) right away and she was coming off a layoff. I've said this before that we've never gotten to run her every three or four weeks where she's actually getting race fit. She was finally race fit and was working very well. For a long time she had shown she was our best horse and we got to see it today." As for the beaten favorite, trainer Bill Mott said, "She seemed a little bit more pensive in the paddock than normal. Maybe it's just a matter of getting back into action. We'll see."

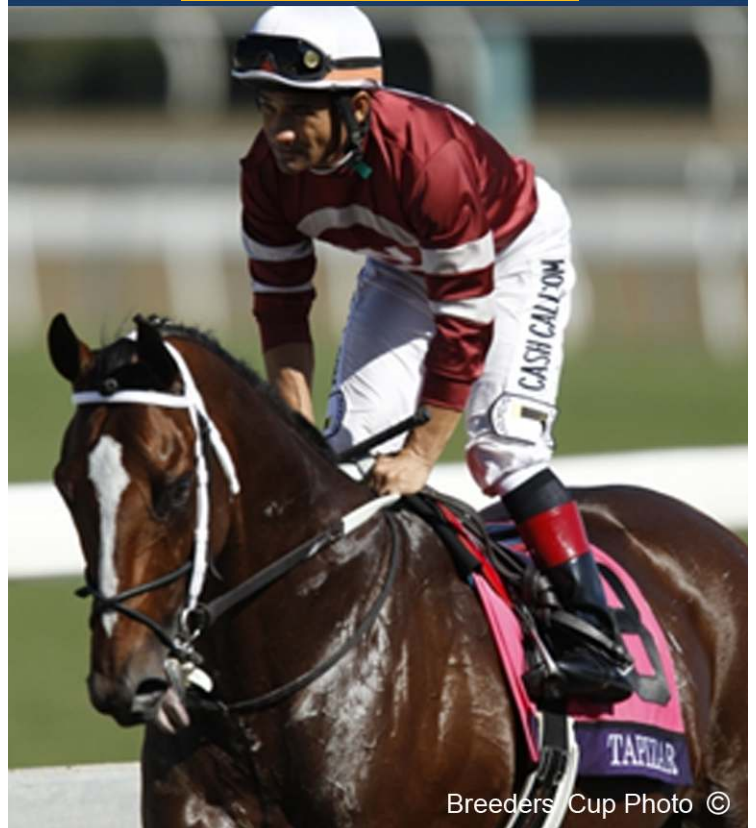

with a 3/4-length victory over Normandy Invasion (Tapit) in Aqueduct's GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 6, but faded to 14th after chasing the pace in the May 4 GI Kentucky Derby and came out of the race with a gash on his hock. While the Todd Pletcher trainee

bypassed the GI Preakness S. and GI Belmont S., he was flattered when two other runners who were part of the Derby pace--Oxbow (Awesome Again) and Palace Malice (Curlin)--scored in those two spots, respectively.

## GIII Pegasus cont.

"We're excited to get Verrazano going again, especially at our home track, Monmouth Park," said Bryan Sullivan of locally based co-owner Lets Go Stable. "Things didn't work out for us in the Kentucky Derby, but we're really looking forward to the second half of the year and, hopefully, we will have a say in some of the big races. We would love to win Sunday, but were hoping to use this as a prep race for the Haskell. It's very special to bring this horse to our home town, as we've had a tremendous amount of support from friends and family throughout the past five months, and they're excited to see him run in person." But Verrazano will face a stern challenge from Trilogy Stable and Laurie Plesa's **Itsmyluckyday** (Lawyer Ron). The dark bay came into the Derby with a victory in the Jan. 26 GIII Holy Bull S. and second-place finish to Orb (Malibu Moon) in the Mar. 30 GI Besilu Stables Florida Derby, but didn't handle the slop at Churchill and checked in 15th.

Training too well before the Derby for conditioner Eddie Plesa Jr. to believe his performance on the first Saturday in May, Itsmyluckyday came back at Pimlico and proved second-best behind Oxbow. He'll be piloted by big-race rider Mike Smith for the first time today. "This race has been our target since before the Preakness," Plesa, who has been having a very productive Monmouth meet, said. "He's coming into it excellent. The 3-year-old picture is wide open for about a half-dozen horses so far. The Haskell is the goal. I haven't looked past that yet."

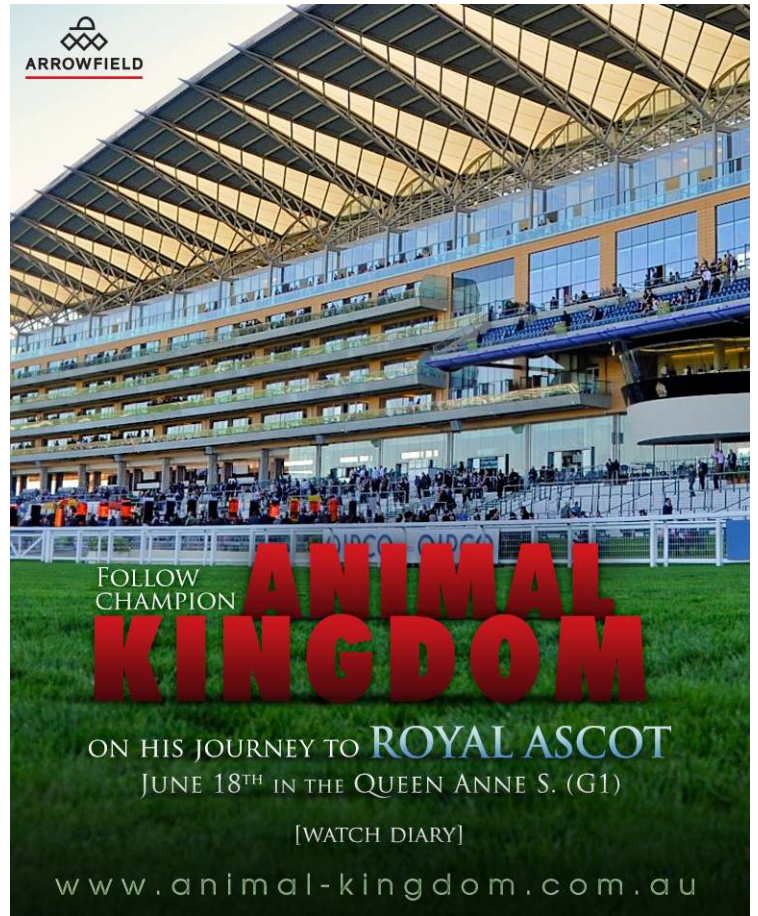

### *Paynter Perfect Out of Return....*

Zayat Stables' **Paynter** (Awesome Again), who returned from what can only be deemed multiple near-death experiences to romp in a seven-furlong Hollywood allowance Friday afternoon, has emerged from the effort in excellent shape, according to Mike Marlow, assistant to trainer Bob Baffert.

"He's real good this morning," said Marlow of the 4-year-old, who earned a monster 114 Beyer Speed Figure for the effort. "He came

back pumped up, like he didn't even run. He wasn't tired at all. He ate well last night and he's happy this morning. He's an amazing horse. His owners couldn't have been happier if it was a Grade I. It was like a Grade I to them. The whole thing was good for racing." After first surviving colitis and then laminitis, Paynter earned a nationwide following. Following his victory Friday, the hashtag #PowerUpPaynter was trending fifth on Twitter, meaning that Paynter was the fifth most-popular subject in the country.

### *Wise Dan Works, Lopresti Outlines Plans...*

Mort Fink's homebred Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) worked a bullet five furlongs in :58.40 over the Keeneland Polytrack yesterday, a move that pleased trainer Charlie LoPresti. "He worked very well and galloped out really strong," LoPresti said of the 6-year-old gelding. "We were very happy with it." While LoPresti noted that Wise Dan could make his next start in the GII Firecracker H. at Churchill Downs June 29, he said the horse's schedule could change depending on his elder brother, 7-year-old gelding **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal), also a Fink homebred. Successful Dan was fourth in yesterday's GI Stephen Foster H. "We are going to see what happens with Successful Dan," LoPresti explained. "Right now we are looking at the Firecracker for Wise Dan, but if we are lucky enough to win the Stephen Foster with Successful Dan then I might point Wise Dan to the [GI] Whitney [H. at Saratoga Aug. 3]. Whether I would use the Firecracker as a prep for that race or not is something we'd have to consider." LoPresti noted that the pair will not meet on the racetrack any time soon. "They'll be kept apart leading up to the Breeders' Cup," he noted. "The only chance they'd run against each other is if they both wound up in the [GI] Breeders' Cup Classic." Wise Dan and Successful Dan received a further update to their pedigree pages when their 3-year-old half sister **Enchanting Lisa** (War Chant) won on debut at Presque Isle Downs Wednesday. LoPresti said no plans have been made for Enchanting Lisa, but that she will likely be part of his Saratoga string.
