## 'RULER' HEADS DERBY ELEVEN

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) yesterday headed a list of 11 remaining in Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The

Curragh. While Aidan O'Brien has left **Battle of Marengo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Count Limonade (Ire)** (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}) in the race, it is expected that the unbeaten blue riband hero could be joined by stablemate **Festive Cheer (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}).

Godolphin yesterday supplemented both the Epsom runner-up **Libertarian (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) and pacemaker **Cap O'Rushes (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) Fourth under top weight in Thursday's King George V S. at Royal Ascot, the former is set to be ridden by William Buick. Others of note include Jim Bolger's G1 2000 Guineas third and Listed Silver S. scorer **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}), Michael O'Flynn's Derby third **Galileo Rock (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Sugar Boy (Ire)** (Authorized {Ire}), who beat the latter rival in the G3 Sandown Classic Trial when last seen Apr. 26. Trainer Patrick Prendergast, who worked Richard Barnes's homebred yesterday, said, "He moved beautifully, traveled well and looks in great nick. The ground was a little quick for him, but that's as good as he goes at home as he only does what he has to."

## BAFFERT PLEASED WITH PAYNTER'S WORK

Zayat Stables' **Paynter** (Awesome Again) drilled four panels yesterday at Santa Anita in :48.40. It was his first work since a 4 1/2-length allowance tally at Betfair Hollywood Park June 24. That seven-furlong affair was the 4-year-old's first start back since a nearly fatal bout with colitis and laminitis. "He breezed an easy half and looked fantastic doing it," trainer Bob Baffert said. The Hall of Famer added that he has not yet determined where the G1 Haskell Invitational hero will appear next.

***Eclipse for Al Kazeem...***

**Al Kazeem (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) will forego a tilt at the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. and instead run in the G1 Coral-Eclipse, trainer Roger Charlton announced yesterday. John Deer's 5-year-old, who added the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot on Wednesday to his previous top-level success in the Tattersalls Gold Cup, will take in the July 6 Sandown contest as he is geared towards the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6. "The Eclipse is the plan and after that, the [Sept. 7] G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. It gives him two months off, then a month before the Arc. He'll stay at a mile and a quarter and is not going to run in the King George."

***Cirrus Will Improve, Trainer Promises...***


**Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) remains on course for Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. despite his disappointing return when only fifth in Sunday's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, trainer Corine Barande-Barbe announced yesterday. Now officially the highest-rated flat horse in training, Jean-Claude-Alain Dupouy's 7-year-old will bid to rebound in the July 27 highlight. "He is great this morning," his conditioner told *PA Sport*. "He rolled in his box, went for a walk and was standing up on his back legs and fighting. Races seem to give him a lot of energy." Of Sunday's effort, the conditioner added, "There was no pace at the beginning of the race. The German pacemaker had to be ridden to go to the front and Cirrus was too concerned with what he was doing and could never get into the right rhythm. It was also his first run over the distance in over a year--since he won the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. I didn't have much choice, as if I had run him over a much shorter distance, it would not have been the right preparation for the King George. The King George is still the plan. I think he will improve a lot for the run and he will make a few steps between now and then. He will be in much better condition at Ascot."

***Nassau Aim for Judge...***

Qatar Racing and the Sangster family's **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) is being targeted at the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood, connections announced yesterday. Runner-up in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5 before going one better in the Irish equivalent three weeks later, the Charlie Hills trainee was third in Friday's G1 Coronation S. and will now be stepped up to 10 furlongs for the Aug. 3 contest. "Just the Judge has come out of the Coronation S. in very good form and I am pleased with her," said Hills. "Obviously, the [outside] draw didn't help at Ascot, but she still ran a very good race. She got caught a bit wide and I would say that cost her second. We have been looking forward to stepping her up in trip and I don't think a mile and a quarter will be a problem for her. I can even see her getting a bit further than that next year."

### ‘ROCK’ COLT TOPS INGLIS WEANLING SALE

A colt by Fastnet Rock (Aus) (Danehill) topped Monday’s opening session of the Inglis Australian Weanling Sale in Sydney. A member of the Erinvale Thoroughbreds’ consignment, [Lot 71](#) proved very popular during inspections despite the wet weather. Opening with a healthy A\$200,000 volley, bidding on the colt quickly followed up with a raise of A\$10,000 before Edinburgh Park’s Ian Smith struck the winning blow at A\$240,000 (us\$222,029). The Sept. 13 foal is out of

Promptness (Eddington), an unraced, half-sister to graded winners War Thief (Lord at War {Arg}), Watch (Lord at War) and Prime Meridian (The Prime Minister).

The day’s second-highest price was A\$150,000 for [Lot 404](#), which headed the Lee Fleming Thoroughbreds Unreserved Dispersal. By Wanted (Aus) and out of Aquatint (Supremo), the half-brother to A\$804,094 earner Blue Sky (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) sold to Eliza Park International.

Leading New Zealand pinhooker Ascot Farm secured the top priced filly on the day, going to A\$120,000 for the first foal out of listed juvenile winner She’s Got Gears (Aus) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) for A\$120,000. The Exceed and Excel (Aus) filly was offered by Coolmore Stud as [Lot 92](#).

As in 2012, weanlings by Fastnet Rock’s Group 1-winning son Wanted were hot commodities in the Newmarket sale ring yesterday. Seven lots by the Eliza Park resident stallion were sold at an average of A\$82,000.

At the conclusion of Monday’s initial session, a total of 88% of Select Session offerings sold at an average of A\$23,380. *Cont. p5*

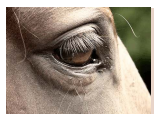

For nearly 30 years Royal Ascot's top events have played their part in kindling Europe's love of Danzig and his descendants. His son Always Fair won the G2 Coventry S. back in 1987 and Danzig went on to enjoy further Royal Ascot success with the likes of Danehill (G3 Cork and Orrery S., now the Golden Jubilee), Dayjur (G2 King's Stand S.), Ad Valorem (G1 Queen Anne S.), Shaadi (G1 St James's Palace S.) and Soapy Danger (G3 Queen's Vase).

It was hardly surprising, then, that last week's Royal Meeting proved very rewarding for stallions from the Danzig male line. The most successful was Danehill's son Dansili, who enjoyed group success with Riposte, Thomas Chippendale and Remote. Danehill Dancer--another son of Danehill--also enjoyed a stakes treble, featuring group wins by Duntle and Hillstar, while Exceed and Excel supplied the Royal Hunt Cup winner Belgian Bill. The male line's influence even stretched to victories by two great-great-grandsons, thanks to Dandy Man's son Extortionist in the Windsor Castle S. and to Mount Nelson's son Berkshire in the Chesham S.

The Green Desert branch also got into the act via Oasis Dream, sire of the game Group 3 winner Gale Force Ten and Opinion, and Cape Cross, sire of Elidor.

All the stallions mentioned above are based in Britain or Ireland, but it was great to see Claiborne Farm score a magnificent double via War Front. This Joseph Allen-bred son of Danzig is rapidly filling the void left at the Paris stallion station when Danzig was pensioned in 2004, at the age of 27. As War Front was conceived when his sire was 24, and is still only 11 years old, there is a good chance that Danzig will be appearing as the grandsire of major winners some 50 years after his birth--especially as his final crops also contained such good colts as Hard Spun, Mawathee, Astronomer Royal and U S Ranger. **Cont. p7**

Now resident at WinStar Farm, U S Ranger was also bred by Joseph Allen, from his Red Ransom mare My Annette. Withdrawn from the September Yearling Sale, the son of Danzig showed sufficient promise in winning his three starts for Allen as a juvenile in France that he came to the attention of Michael Tabor and it wasn't long before the colt was racing for a collective consisting of the Coolmore partners and Allen. Switched to Aidan O'Brien, the son of Danzig went very close to landing the G1 July Cup in 2008.

The venture with U S Ranger has encouraged further collaboration between Allen and the Coolmore partners. Lines of Battle, winner of the G2 UAE Derby earlier this year, is another example and so too are the G1 Queen Anne S. winner Declaration of War and the impressive G2 Coventry S. hero War Command.

As reported in the [TDN of June 19](#), Allen retains a 40% interest in War Front, whose racing career was

largely one of so near and yet so far. Although he won the GII Alfred G Vanderbilt H. over six furlongs, War Front also found one too good for him in five other graded stakes as a 4-year-old, beaten by the likes of Silver Train, Pomeroy and Henny Hughes. He was a good, solid

performer without being a star, as witnessed by his seventh-place finish at 16-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint.

Retired to Claiborne, where he was foaled and raised, War Front wasn't an obvious contender to develop into a worthy heir to Danzig's throne. After all, Claiborne had already tried several times to find a successor to the multiple champion sire, without hitting the jackpot.


The triple Grade I winner Polish Navy was the first son to stand alongside Danzig at Claiborne, but he was sent to Japan in 1992 after a slow start. However, his sale was quickly followed by victories by Ghazi in the GI Secretariat S. and by Sea Hero in the GI Champagne S. Sea Hero went on to take the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Travers S. the following year.

Claiborne then made a bold move to secure the Danzig succession with the arrival of Lure and Boundary in 1995. Sadly Lure proved sub-fertile and Boundary had to be pensioned at the age of 15 in 2005 because of declining fertility. Like Polish Navy, Boundary also sired a Kentucky Derby winner when Big Brown developed into the dominant 3-year-old of 2008.

It is tempting to speculate about how War Front would have fared had he followed the transatlantic path taken by so many sons of Danzig, such as the multiple Group 1 winners Green Desert, Danehill, Dayjur, Polish Precedent, Anabaa and Agnes World. Most of these shone over the sprint distances which formed the basis of War Front's career and they were, of course, on turf. Rather surprisingly, War Front was never tried on turf, even though his dam Starry Dreamer had spent much of her 31-race career contesting turf stakes. This daughter of Rubiano had been good enough to finish second in four Grade II events on turf and her smart Pulpit colt Ecclesiastic also did most of his racing on grass, notably winning two editions of the Gill Jaipur S.

War Front's stallion career has lent further support to the theory that he needn't have been just a conventional dirt horse. The Factor gained his Grade I successes on dirt and all-weather, whereas Data Link, Summer Soiree, Declaration of War and the Hong Kong Group 1 winner Sweet Orange have all gained their best wins on turf.

War Front is now covering some spectacular books of mares, but this hasn't always been so and his current 3-year-olds, from his third crop, number only 43. That hasn't stopped him coming up with Lines of Battle (G2 UAE Derby on Tapeta), Jack Milton (a Grade III winner on turf) and Departing (GIII Illinois Derby on dirt), as well as War Dancer and Sustained, both graded-placed on turf.

This crop also includes The Brothers War, a Joseph Allen homebred who was a listed winner over six furlongs in France before being sold to Team Valor. Bearing in mind that this 3-year-old has never been tried over more than seven furlongs, even though he is out of a Group 2 winner over 1 9/16 miles, I briefly wondered whether War Front's speed is proving dominant.

Although speed was also the main asset of The Factor, several of War Front's best winners have shone beyond a mile. Summer Soiree, Soldat and Data Link all have good victories over a mile and an eighth, while Declaration of War has two wins, including one at listed level, at around a mile and a quarter. Lines of Battle is another who may get a mile and a quarter.

There must also be a good chance that War Command will stay a mile or more, which makes this eye-catching Coventry S. winner all the more exciting. It is easy to guess why Allen decided to send War Command's dam Wandering Star to War Front. Like the dam of U S Ranger, Wandering Star is a daughter of Red Ransom. Indeed she was a very good daughter of Red Ransom, as she showed in winning the GI E.P. Taylor S. over a mile and a quarter. Of course, this is the popular Danzig-Roberto cross, which has been responsible for such as War Chant, Furiously and Yashmak. More recent examples are the European Group 1 winners Style Vendome and Temida, as well as Lines of Battle, a War Front colt with a dam by Arch (which, incidentally, also produces 2x4 to Danzig).

War Command follows Naval Officer, a very useful son of Tale of the Cat, as the second above-average winner out of Wandering Star. His second dam, Beautiful Bedouin, had the distinction of being a half-sister to Silver Hawk, a Classic performer who became a highly effective stallion. Add in the fact that his third dam Gris Vitesse won the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and War Command has a pedigree which will have plenty of appeal to breeders. Also, add in the fact that he is a late-April foal, and here we have a colt who could make this year's 2-year-old scene extremely interesting.
