SKY LANTERN HEADING TO FALMOUTH

Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}), impressive winner of the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 21, is set to try her elders for the first time in the G1 Etihad Airways Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 12, providing the turf rides quick enough, *Racing Post* reports. "Sky Lantern will probably go for the Falmouth, but she would need fast ground," trainer Richard Hannon told the publication. A troubled eighth when favored in the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf last November at Santa Anita, Sky Lantern was runner-up in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket on her seasonal debut

Apr. 17 before besting Just the Judge (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}) in the G1 English 1000 Guineas at headquarters May 5. The Coronation was billed as a rematch between those two adversaries, but Sky Lantern turned the prestigious event into a one-horse affair, streaking away with a blinding turn of speed to score by four lengths with Just the Judge back in third. The gray filly will receive a nine-pound age allowance from her older rivals in the Falmouth, a race which could also attract G2 Duke of Cambridge S. winner **Duntle (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), as well as **Giofra (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality), first and second, respectively, in last year's Falmouth.

'POWER' BACK FOR CUP

Last Tuesday's G1 King's Stand S. winner **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) will return to Britain to contest the G1 Darley July Cup, trainer Eddie Lynam confirmed yesterday. Following the 6-year-old's second top-level

success in Royal Ascot's five-furlong highlight, he will tackle another furlong in the July 13 Newmarket feature. "Sole Power has taken Royal Ascot in his stride and it's all systems go for the July Cup," Lynam told *PA Sport*. "We are very hopeful that he will last out the extra

distance. Johnny Murtagh is very confident that he will stay the six furlongs and he settles so much better in his races nowadays, so we have decided to give it a go."

RULER GETS VOTE OF CONFIDENCE

Jockey Joseph O'Brien yesterday issued an upbeat bulletin regarding Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) ahead of Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh. Favored to stay unbeaten and provide Aidan O'Brien with an 11th renewal and an eighth in succession, the G1 Epsom Derby hero has given all the right signals as he bids to become the 17th colt to complete the double. "He's an exciting horse and we're looking forward to it," O'Brien said at Naas yesterday evening. "He won very nicely the last time at Epsom, and you'd be hoping he's improved since. The Curragh is probably the fairest track of all that the Classics are run on and he's won there already. This is a race every jockey wants to win."

'DAN' READY FOR ANOTHER EXPLOSION

After days of back-and-forth, reigning Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) was entered for Saturday evening's GII Firecracker H. at Churchill Downs, but he is not a certain starter in the race. "Mr. Fink and I are going to talk, and he will make the ultimate decision," trainer Charlie LoPresti told the Lexington *Herald-Leader*. "Whatever he wants to do, I am 100% behind him, because the horse is good, the horse is in really good shape. I'm not worried about running him." LoPresti says it isn't the 128-pound impost, but the spread in the weights that is bothersome. "He's going to have to give them 11-15 pounds, that's what I'm concerned about. It's not about putting the weight on him." On paper, **Lea** (First Samurai) is the only foe within shouting distance of Wise Dan, owner of nine consecutive triple-digit Beyers.

The homebred has gone favored in each of his six career starts, including this track's GIII Commonwealth Turf S. last November. He exits an off-turf allowance score in Louisville June 1.

Top Horses on the Sidelines

C R K Stable's **Demonic** lived up to the hype in his unveiling with a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ worthy performance at Santa Anita Jan. 13 ([video](#)), and has left everybody waiting for more since.

Favored at even-money, the \$400,000 Keeneland September yearling graduate chased on the outside in fifth through a half mile in :45.66. With Garrett Gomez in the saddle, the handsome bay revved up with a four-wide move as they

straightened for home, and lengthened that mighty stride of his for a well-timed narrow victory over impressive next-out winner Tiz the Truth (Tiznow). Demonic stopped the clock for seven furlongs in 1:22.89, good for an 88 Beyer Speed Figure.

Demonic posted eight subsequent workouts and was under consideration for several GI Kentucky Derby preps earlier this spring, but was instead freshened with an eye on the second half of the season, according to owner Lee Searing.

"Demonic had a slight foot issue, and we gave him all the time he needed," Searing explained. "He will resume training perfectly healthy in mid-July. Plans are for him to make the races again as soon as he's ready. He is with [trainer] John Sadler at Hollywood Park."

Produced by GIII Delaware Oaks heroine Sincerely (Meadowlake), Demonic is a half-brother to Silver Edition (Silver Deputy), SW & MGSP, \$377,685. His third dam Furl Sail (Revoked) was champion 3-year-old filly in 1967.

"Demonic is a beautiful colt with loads of talent," Searing continued. "He was not primed for his initial race, and we sure saw all that ability surface way before we thought it would. We have always thought that he would go a route of ground, but needed to get him started [in a sprint]."

Searing concluded, "He will come back a bigger, stronger colt, and hopefully we'll have a fresh, talented late 3-year-old." **Cont. p4**

The \$725,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase, produced by a half-sister to GI Triple Bend H. winner Pohave (Holy Bull), is currently on the comeback trail at Saratoga, most recently breezing five furlongs over the Oklahoma turf course around the dogs in 1:02.58 June 24.

"She is doing well and [trainer] Bill [Mott] is happy with her so far," Buffolo continued. "We are pointing her to Saratoga, very likely the [GII] Lake George [S. July 24] against straight 3-year-old fillies. We will take it one race at a time and go from there."

Tapicat, off since validating her **TDN Rising Star** badge by running her grass record to a perfect three-for-three in her stakes debut in the GIII Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Feb. 2 ([video](#)), is nearing a return to the races this summer.

The speedy chestnut recovered from an awkward break that day to easily defeat subsequent GIII Regret S. and Edgewood S. heroine Kitten's Dumplings (Kitten's Joy) in wire-to-wire fashion by 2 3/4 lengths.

"She was going to the [GI] Ashland [S.] at Keeneland [Apr. 6], but we felt that she was not 100%, so we decided to give her a short break," Besilu Stables' Fabricio Buffolo revealed. "She came to the farm and stayed a few weeks where she rested and then resumed training."

The promising sophomore **Crop Report** failed to make it into the oversubscribed GIII Spiral S. at Turfway Park Mar. 23, but served notice on the undercard with a powerful last-to-first victory in the \$75,000 Team Valor Rushaway S. ([video](#)). Subsequently sidelined with a ligament issue, the strapping dark bay is likely to return to Rick Mettee's Fair Hill base to resume serious training in about a month, according to Team Valor International CEO Barry Irwin.

"Crop Report jammed his left suspensory ligament in the Rushaway," Irwin reported. "No tears or fiber damage, but a lot of jarring. His ligament increased in size. Since then, he has been rehabbing at WinStar Farm--doing hyperbaric, water treadmill, walking and just began jogging under tack."

An impressive maiden winner over the Newmarket grass last October for owner M. J. Tuckey and conditioner William Haggas, Crop Report overcame a world of trouble to finish an eye-catching third behind subsequent GIII Spiral S. upsetter Black Onyx (Rock Hard Ten) in his first attempt for Team Valor in his U.S. debut in a \$75,000 optional-claimer over the Gulfstream lawn Feb. 23 ([video](#)).

Favored at 3-5 while trying the synthetic for the first time in the Rushaway, Crop Report trailed the field of six after getting bumped shortly after the break. Joel Rosario remained cool as Crop Report cabooseed the field through a half mile in :47.97. The son of GIII Delaware H. heroine Amarillo (Crafty Prospector) began to roll on the far turn, and came charging down the lane on his left lead to get the money by 1 3/4 lengths.

"We have no plans for him other than to get him back in action," Irwin added. "He has an enormous amount of raw ability, but being as big as he is and such a late foal [May 31], it is not surprising that he had trouble getting started as early as he did."
