'RULER' FACES EIGHT

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) heads a field of nine for Saturday's G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh, with no surprise defectors at yesterday's declaration stage. Drawn in eight, the unbeaten June 1 G1 Epsom Derby hero will

be aided by stable companion **Festive Cheer (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}) as he bids for the double. Godolphin will also be represented by a pair of runners, supporting their newly acquired Epsom runner-up **Libertarian (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) with the supplemented **Cap O'Rushes (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}). The former is drawn in two, with Michael O'Flynn's Derby third **Galileo Rock (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) breaking against the fence. One who will start as an outsider is Neil Jones' **Little White Cloud (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), who represents the John Oxx stable successful here with

Sinndar (Ire) and Alamshar (Ire) in 2000 and 2003. While this colt lacks the previous strong form of that duo, he was an encouraging third behind Battle of Marengo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in Leopardstown's G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial May 12 and second to Leading Light (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G3 Gallinule S. here a fortnight later and is bred to appreciate this extra two furlongs. Jockey Declan McDonogh said yesterday, "Stepping up to a mile and a half should really suit him, being from the same family as Millenary (GB) (Rainbow Quest) and all those good stayers. He wasn't far behind Battle of Marengo, and we think he's improved a lot since then. He put up a good show against Leading Light, who went and won the [G3] Queen's Vase. He's tough and he handles fast ground, so hopefully they won't get too much rain." On that subject, the track's manager Paul Hensey was on hand to provide an update yesterday. "We had a bit of rain at the weekend and just under 3.5mm this morning and I reckon we'll be starting the meeting, certainly on the straight course, on good ground," he said. "It's a cracking race, you can make a case for five or six." **Field p3**

NTRA RELEASES YEARLY REPORT

The National Thoroughbred Racing Association released its 2012-2013 "Annual Report to the Membership," a 28-page report offering updates on the organization's various initiatives as well as its finances. The NTRA had net revenue of \$66,850 for FY 2013 compared to a net loss of \$598,927 for the previous fiscal year. "After several years of challenging economic circumstances, 2012 will likely be remembered as the year when the Thoroughbred breeding and racing industry began to slowly emerge from the negative effects of a lengthy world-wide economic recession," said NTRA president and CEO Alex Waldrop in an accompanying statement. "Increases in a number of important economic indicators--including pari-mutuel handle, purses and sales market results--have continued to trend in a positive direction in early 2013. CHURCHILL DETAILS NEW SEPTEMBER MEET

Churchill Downs will host its first September meet this year with the inaugural "Homecoming Meet," taking over days it was granted by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission usually reserved for Turfway Park. The 12-day meet, which includes eight stakes with purses equaling \$975,000, kicks off with the GII Pocahontas S. and GIII Iroquois S., both for two-year-olds.

It will also include the first running of the \$175,000 Homecoming Classic, a new stakes race for older horses that will serve as a prep for the GI Clark H. and GI Breeders' Cup Classic, Sept. 28.

The meet will run Friday through Sunday Sept. 6 to Sept. 29, with "Downs after Dark" festivities to be held the first and last Saturdays, Sept. 7 and Sept. 28. The first "Downs after Dark" will feature four stakes, including the Pocahontas and Iroquois, which are Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge events. Both races have been extended from one mile to 1 1/16 miles and the Iroquois purse has been increased by \$50,000.

The Sept. 7 card will also feature the GIII Ack Ack H. and the \$100,000 Locust Grove S. The Locust Grove was changed from a one-mile turf race to a 1 1/16-mile race on the main track.

Churchill will bring back the Open Mind S. during this meet as well Sept. 14. The race was last run in 2007 as a five-furlong race for 3-year-old fillies on the turf and will now be run as a six-furlong test for fillies and mares, ages three and up. The \$100,000 Dogwood S. for three-year-old fillies also returns after a one year hiatus. The GIII Jefferson Cup, last run in 2011, has been changed from 1 1/16 miles to one mile, but remains on the turf and will run Sept. 28.

"Our Churchill Downs team is looking forward to the new Homecoming Meet and the opportunity to offer new racing and entertainment opportunities to fans, families, businesses and horsemen during a time of year in which the weather is usually the best our region offers," said Kevin Flanery, president of Churchill Downs Racetrack. "Racing Secretary Ben Huffman has worked to fashion a schedule of compelling stakes events and an attractive roster of daily racing opportunities that provide owners and trainers with a wide range of competitive options for their horses."

THURSDAY AT THE GALLOPS

Thursday morning brought the by now-familiar G1 Vodacom Durban July gallops, complete with the traditional sticky buns and piping hot coffee, as well as a threat of rain, to Greyville Racecourse. As a precautionary measure, the weekend's racing has been moved from Greyville to Clairwood to prevent any damage to the turf track prior to next Saturday's big race.

The gallops are compulsory for all Vodacom Durban July contenders, and the crowds were out at dawn to watch their favourites work. While the word 'gallop' is slightly deceptive, most of the top contenders were allowed to stretch out over the final 400 meters, with the exception of **Love Struck (SAf)** (Kahal {GB}), who is entered in Sunday's KZN Breeders Million Mile.

Pomodoro (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}), last year's Vodacom July winner, was given a steady workout with former jockey Rhys van Wyk aboard. The champion went smoothly through the gears alongside stable companion **Kolkata (SAf)** (Requiem {SAf}), clocking up the fastest final 400 meters of the morning as he motored home in 20.96 seconds. A very impressive effort and perhaps a Vodacom Durban July double could be on the cards for the 132-pound top weight.

The other entrants from the barn of Sean Tarry, **Whiteline Fever (SAf)** (Right Approach {GB}) and **E-Jet (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}) worked well, quickening up smartly, and both appeared to be very fit. Now trained by Charles Laird, **Astro News (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}) gave jockey Kevin Shea a hard time, as he pulled all the way to the line, clocking 22.47 seconds for the final quarter mile.

Run For It (SAf) (Dynasty {SAf}) and **Capetown Noir (SAf)** (Western Winter) both proved very eager through the early fractions, before settling down to their work. Regular pilot Karl Neisius returned with a big grin after Capetown Noir left his companion, **Taipan (SAf)** (Dynasty {SAf}), in the dust as he finished smartly, clocking 21.22 seconds for the final 400 meters. **Gothic (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}), who has not been seen since finishing second to Wylie Hall (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) in the G1 SA Derby, proved far too strong for his working companion. Pulling away smartly over the final furlong, he worked hard into the bit to finish in 22.25 seconds. Dark horse **Punta Arenas (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}) produced a classy performance, travelling smoothly to the line after picking up his companion at the 1000-meter mark to finish in 22.87 seconds.

The only filly to take on the boys come next Saturday, the diminutive **Do You Remember (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}), was given an easy workout, stretching comfortably to the line in 22.59 seconds. In contrast, both **Hill Fifty Four (SAf)** (Captain Al {SAf}) and **Jet Explorer (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}) both put their riders to the test. Hill Fifty Four shifted out sharply in the straight, forcing M J Byleveld to switch his stick before working nicely to the line, while Anthony Delpech had his hands full restraining an overly keen Jet Explorer. Delpech wisely did not allow Jet Explorer to come off the bit, but despite being restraint, the gelding quickened up smartly, finishing in an impressive 22.59 seconds.

DELAHOUSSAYE WINS PINCAY AWARD

Hall of Fame jockey Eddie Delahoussaye has been named the recipient of the 10th-annual Laffit Pincay, Jr. Award, which honors a member of the horse racing community who has “served the sport with integrity, extraordinary dedication, determination and distinction.” Pincay, also a Hall of Fame rider, will present the award to Delahoussaye on Hollywood Gold Cup Day at Betfair Hollywood Park July 6. “Eddie is one of the very best jockeys I ever rode against and he was definitely the best I faced on horses that came from behind,” Pincay said. “If you heard him coming during a race, you knew you were in big trouble.” Pincay continued, “He’s a very low-key guy who has always handled things the right way and that’s something I continue to admire about him.” Delahoussaye, a native of New Iberia, Louisiana, won 6,384 in a career that spanned five decades. Among his wins are two Kentucky Derbies, two Belmonts and one Preakness. He retired from riding in 2003 at the age of 51, but remains active in the sport as an owner, breeder and bloodstock advisor in addition to his role as board member of the Edwin J. Gregson Foundation, a California-based non-profit organization which aims to improve the lives of backstretch workers and their families.

Prominent Trainer & Football Great Passes Away:

James Hudson, professional football player and Texas trainer, died Tuesday at age 70 after a longtime illness. Hudson was a member of the University of Texas championship team in 1963 and the Jets Super Bowl winning team in 1969. Hudson first got into horse racing when a man who owed him money gave him five Quarter Horses to repay his debt. He soon switched to Thoroughbreds and spent most of his time racing at Oaklawn, Fair Grounds and Louisiana Downs. Once Lone Star Park got up and running, however, Hudson was able to move his string back home to Texas. Hudson had many multiple stakes winners and graded stakes placers over his 20-year training career--which ended just two years ago--including Icy Morn (Crowned Jewel) and Snug (Swamp). Funeral services will be held at 1:00 p.m. July 1 at Riverbend Church in Austin, Texas.

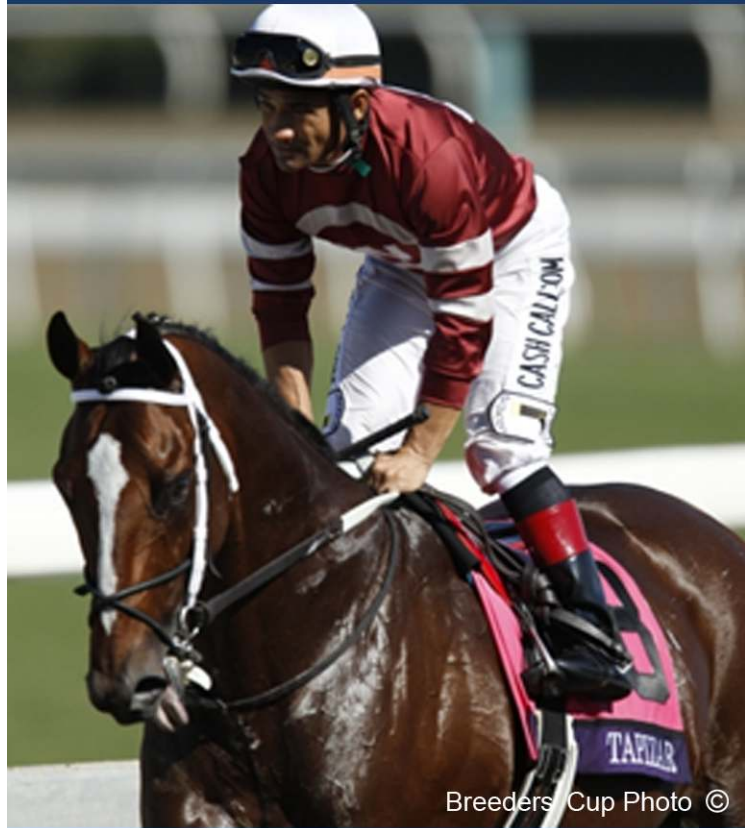
