Elaine and Karl Burke could be on the cusp of something extraordinary as they contemplate a breakthrough Classic success for their Middleham stable courtesy of the season's surprise package **Libertarian (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) in today's

G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh. Highly progressive since his debut win at Pontefract Apr. 9, Godolphin's acquisition upset some big names including **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Dante S. at York May 16 before finishing runner-up to **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the June 1 G1 Epsom Derby despite not being at home on the contours of that venue. "This is a colt that is making rapid progress and like Ruler of the World is only racing for his first season," said jockey William Buick. "I didn't get on him until the Dante S. at York in May and he was a real powerhouse that day. Karl had told me he would probably hit a flat spot, which he did straightening for him but all I needed to do was push him along and he came good soon enough. He cut the leaders down from two out and was well on top close home and beat Trading Leather by just over a length on merit. When it came to Epsom, I think everyone realised that it wasn't going to be a track which would play to the strengths of Libertarian and that was right. He traveled well enough and was just about where I wanted to be at top of Tattenham Hill and was just over a length behind Ryan on Ruler of the World. But the race was won and lost on the turn in over three furlongs out because in a short space of time Ruler of the World quickened and put about six lengths between us and while he was balanced and running, my lad was struggling to get organised and was edging left down the track camber and we must have been eight lengths or more behind with two to run." Buick added, "If you're coming into this race as the Epsom second, there's a nasty stat which says that the last Derby runner-up to turn the form around in Ireland was St Jovite back in 1992. But my view on statistics is that they have to be broken at sometime. I haven't seen Libertarian since Derby day, but all the communication from the Burkes has been extremely encouraging and positive." **Cont. p3**

IS WISE DAN WORTH THE WEIGHT?

While the connections of **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) have expressed a reluctance to contest Churchill's GII Firecracker H. because of a 127-pound weight assignment--11 pounds more than the next-highest runner in the race--the 2012 Horse of the Year will likely be in the gate this evening. The Mort Fink homebred certainly appears formidable regardless of how much he's toting. He aired in his turf debut in this event two years ago, and has suffered only two losses from 12 tries since, one coming when he fell a head short in last year's GI Stephen Foster H. on this main track. The chestnut subsequently reeled off impressive tallies in the GII Fourstardave H., GI Woodbine Mile, GI Shadwell Turf Mile and GI Breeders' Cup Mile to earn year-end accolades. He has picked up right where he left off this season at age six, annexing Keeneland's GI Maker's 46 Mile Apr. 12 and the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic over this course and an additional furlong May 4. "He's doing as well as I could ask," trainer Charlie LoPresti said. **Cont. p7**

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 Epsom Derby winner **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) arrives here attempting to provide Aidan O'Brien with an eighth consecutive success in this Classic he has come to dominate. "We have been very happy with him," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He impressed us at Epsom and we think the Curragh will suit him even better." Also re-opposing the Derby winner is Michael O'Flynn's **Galileo Rock (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has 1 1/2 lengths to find on the Ballydoyle representative and just a short head on Libertarian following his fine third on the first Saturday in June. Previously, he had finished third to **Sugar Boy (Ire)** (Authorized {Ire}) in the Apr. 26 G3 Sandown Classic Trial, where Libertarian was eight lengths back in fourth so his form is solid.

Jockey Wayne Lordan commented, "We went fairly steady at Epsom and a better gallop might suit him here. He seems like he's improved since, so were hoping for a big run. He was a little bit green at Sandown, but he came home really well over a mile and a quarter. A mile and a half plus is what he's bred for and The Curragh should suit. It's open and five or six are tied in closely together on form, so it will come down to who is improving and whoever gets the luck on his side."

Jim Bolger's ambition of winning this race for a second time after the aforementioned St Jovite in 1992 has so far not been realized, but his homebred **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) looked in need of this trip when powering away with the Listed Silver S. over 10 furlongs here June 9. Third in the May 25 G1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, he has speed as well as stamina for this test. "The step up in trip should suit him," his trainer told *PA*



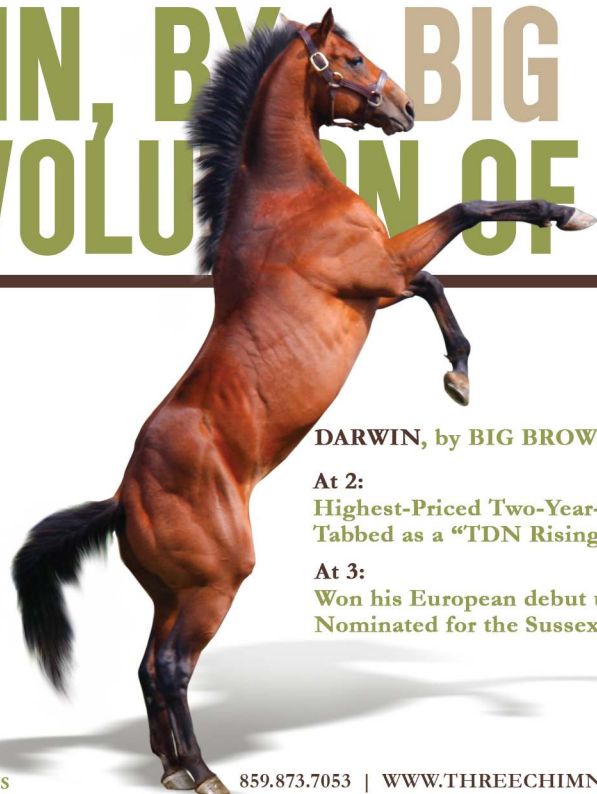

AN 'OBVIOUS' CHOICE IN SHOEMAKER

Fanticola and Scardino's **Obviously (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) leads a field of five competing for an automatic GI Breeders' Cup Mile berth in today's GI Shoemaker Mile S. at Betfair Hollywood Park. The bay was third behind Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the 2012 year-end championship off back-to-back Grade II wins, and began his 5-year-old season with a runner-up finish in the GIII San Simeon S. down the hill at Santa Anita Apr. 20. He relished the return to this trip in the local May 25 GII American H., and will look to lift the spirits of trainer Mike Mitchell, who is recovering from an apparent seizure suffered at the Inglewood oval June 16.

Should Obviously face more pace pressure than he did last time, **Lucayan (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) could be the one stamping his ticket to the Breeders' Cup. Last year's G1 French 2000 Guineas hero was transferred from Francois Rohaut to Neil Drysdale for a 2013 North American campaign, and got rolling late after a slow start to complete the American H. exacta. **Jeranimo** (Congaree) exploded in the straight to take this race a year ago, but will have to bounce back off a last-place finish behind Wise Dan in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. on yielding Churchill grass May 4. The Michael Pender pupil kicked off 2013 with a patented last-to-first win in Santa Anita's GII San Gabriel S. Jan. 13. East Coast invader **Za Approval** (Ghostzapper) is a half-brother to 2006 BC Mile winner Miesque's Approval (Miesque's Son) and rides a two-race hot streak. The Live Oak homebred first tasted black-type success in Gulfstream's GIII Appleton S. Mar. 30, and he justified odds-on favoritism in Monmouth's GIII Red Bank S. last time May 18.

ALL EYES ON JIMMY CREED

A berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint will be on the line in today's "Win and You're In" GI Triple Bend H. at Betfair Hollywood Park. The well-bred **Jimmy Creed** (Distorted Humor), ninth in last year's Sprint, has been perfect since. The 4-year-old got the money in the prestigious GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26, then delivered a narrow victory in the GII Potrero Grande S. last time Apr. 6. He has been working up a storm in the a.m., including a three-furlong blowout in :35.20 at Santa Anita June 27. **Comma to the Top** (Bwana Charlie), a game winner in Aqueduct's GIII Tom Fool H. Mar. 2, faded to fourth in the Potrero Grande, but has been unstoppable in two subsequent tries. He annexed the Cool Frenchy S. over this course May 4, then earned a gaudy 109 Beyer Speed Figure in the GIII Los Angeles H. last time May 27. Triple Bend defending champ **Camp Victory** (Forest Camp) has gone winless in five subsequent starts, most recently completing the trifecta in the Los Angeles.

SHEEPSHEAD BAY 1-2-3 BACK IN NEW YORK

Richard Santulli's **Tannery (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}), Godolphin's **Anjaz** (Street Cry {Ire}) and Northern Bloodstock's **Minkashi (Fr)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) ran 1-2-3 over soft going last time in the GII Sheepshead Bay S. May 25 and return to Elmont this afternoon for the GII New York S. A Group 3 winner in Ireland last year for trainer David Wachman, Tannery failed to build on a Stateside debut third in last September's GI Garden City S. in three subsequent efforts, but put it all together in the Sheepshead Bay at 10-1 odds. "I hope she runs as well as she did last time," trainer Al Goldberg said. "I wish she was carrying more weight, but she's training well, eating well, and doing well. I expect her to run a good race. I think she likes a little give in the ground, but she should run well as long as it's not too hard." With intermittent storms in the forecast for Friday and Saturday, Tannery should find the ground to her liking. Anjaz, a well-pedigreed daughter of British highweight and \$10.5-million 2007 KEENOV broodmare buy Playful Act (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), also began her career in Europe, competing mostly in British handicaps for Saeed bin Suroor. She was a late-on-the-scene fourth behind **Regalo Mia** (Sligo Bay {Ire}) in Gulfstream's GIII Orchid S. Mar. 30 before the Sheepshead Bay. "She settled well into the country in the first race, and she has adapted well here," conditioner Tom Albertrani offered. "She made a good first appearance at Gulfstream, and she did well over the soft turf last time. I've seen some improvement since her last race, so I'm pretty hopeful coming into the weekend. I don't think [the turf course condition] will make a difference." Minkashi set the pace last time in the Sheepshead Bay off a runner-up finish in the local Owsley S. May 3. **Mystical Star** (Ghostzapper) and **Starformer** (Dynaformer), fifth and eighth last time respectively behind Tannery, also reoppose here; while MGISW **Lady of Shamrock** (Scat Daddy) invades from Southern California off a third-place run in Betfair Hollywood Park's GI Gamely S. May 27.

Racing's Battle of the Sexes – On Four Legs

We didn't know much about Most Improved and he was a very good horse for Brian [Meehan], so we just wanted to go very gently and go forward. He traveled very well and just got tired in the straight. All the class is still there--he moved up very easily and Joseph said four [furlongs] out he took a big heave. He has plenty of speed and will have no bother coming back in trip."

CALDER ENACTS RESTRICTED ACCESS POLICY

Calder Race Course revealed yesterday that it will enact a "Restricted Access Policy" beginning Monday, prohibiting horses stabled at Calder Race Course from returning to the track grounds after competing at other Florida racetracks (with possible exceptions as determined by Racing Secretary Mike Anifantis). "This change in policy comes as a direct result of Gulfstream Park's decision to disregard an agreement between the two tracks designed to prevent future race-date disputes and a head-to-head clash," said a track release. "In that agreement, Calder traded the more lucrative December dates to Gulfstream for less desirable April dates." John Marshall, Vice President and General Manager of Racing at Calder, said, "There is now a greater expectation for horses stabling and training on Calder's property, at Calder's expense, to race at Calder." Gulfstream's inaugural fall/summer meet begins Monday. There will be racing at the Hallandale Beach oval July 4 before switching to a Saturday/Sunday schedule through November, at which point the winter meet will commence. Gulfstream had previously announced that it would not place restrictions on horses traveling back and forth between Calder and Gulfstream. "On Jan. 2, after Calder had already applied for dates similar to 2012, Gulfstream made what can only be described as a rogue and reckless decision to apply for a year-round schedule, including running on top of Calder on Saturdays and Sundays beginning July 1," continued Marshall. "After unsuccessful attempts to get Gulfstream to re-consider and honor their previous commitment, Calder had no choice but to amend its application and file for a year-round schedule beginning in July with live racing Fridays through Sundays." Marshall added, "Gulfstream's head-to-head dates filing and simulcast revenue pursuits are direct attacks on Calder, its horsemen and Florida racing. This could be a catastrophic move for the industry that will negatively affect owners, trainers, breeders, and all other Thoroughbred racing participants in the state. Calder will not stand idle and allow others to divert our horsemen's purse money and water-down South Florida's racing product."

CHRB Creates Off-Site Wagering Task Force:

The California Horse Racing Board instituted a Task Force on Mini-Satellite Expansion, in an effort to take pari-mutuel racing to bars, restaurants, etc. Commissioner George Krikorian will chair the Task Force and Commissioner Steve Beneto will be a member as well. "Clearly this program needs an assist from the Board," said Commissioner Krikorian. "The law and regulation authorizing mini-satellites have been on the books for more than four years now and yet only five mini-satellites have been opened in the state. Perhaps another four or five could open this year, but that still would be far short of the 45 mini-satellites permitted under the law. Our goal is to expand the mini-satellite side of the business using all of the resources at our command. And part of that effort will be exploring issues and conditions relating to revenue sharing with the satellites and their radius of protection from competing interests."
