## HOLLYWOOD STARS

**Obviously (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) and **Centralintelligence** (Smarty Jones) both earned berths to the Breeders' Cup

in their respective divisions courtesy a pair of "Win and You're In" tallies at Betfair Hollywood Park Saturday. Anthony Fanticola and Joseph Scardino's Obviously, third in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Mile, started things off with an authoritative front-running 3 1/4-length tally over **Za Approval** (Ghostzapper) in the GI Shoemaker Mile as the 1-5 chalk. "The main goal is to run back in the Breeders' Cup Mile," trainer Mike Mitchell said. "I

turned him out last year for no problems, just to freshen him. He's razor sharp right now. He's training so well and he looks so good. I think he's better than last year. He's stronger and a little bit more filled out." Centralintelligence, meanwhile, pulled off an 8-1 upset while registering a career high in the GI Triple Bend H. It was 3 1/2 lengths back to **Comma to the Top** (Bwana Charlie) in second. **Cont. p5-6**

## EARLY FIREWORKS

Morton Fink's **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) was sportingly kept in Saturday night's GII Firecracker H. despite a heavy, persistent rain that turned the Churchill sod into a bog, and the reigning Horse of the Year treated fans to a display of class and heart. Hammered down to 1-5 favoritism under John Velazquez, Wise Dan was hemmed in along the hedge just behind the pacesetting **Seruni** (Saint Liam), with longshot **OI Army** (Posse) and second choice **Lea** (First Samurai) to his outside. Crying out for room as they rounded the far turn, Wise Dan slipped through a narrow opening to Seruni's inside in upper stretch, and fought his way past that foe, who bumped him a few times in the process. Finally clear at the eighth pole, he edged away by two lengths under a stiff drive as Lea came along for place honors. **Cont. p9**

## THE KNOCKOUT BLOW

When the chips were down, it was Jim and Jackie Bolger's **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) who was carrying the weightiest punch to prevail in the G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh yesterday. Showing he was suited to the Kildare venue's galloping nature when third in the May 25 G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and successful in the June 9 Listed Silver S., the Coolcullen homebred, who started at 6-1, was kept close to the early pacesetters by Kevin Manning, which helped his cause as he gained first run on **Galileo Rock (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and the fancied runners passing the quarter pole. Drawing on his deep reserves late on, he asserted for a 1 3/4-length verdict over that rival as the G1 Epsom Derby hero **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) failed to fire in fifth. "It's a wonderful day and a great achievement," commented Jim Bolger, who bred the winner, as well as his sire and dam. "I have to give credit to my nephew Ken who looks after the mare and foaled and reared him and to my staff at Coolcullen for the wonderful job that they do with him every day. This is the best--I haven't had anything like this. Last week at Ascot would have come close, for obvious reasons, but this is the best." **Cont. p3-4**

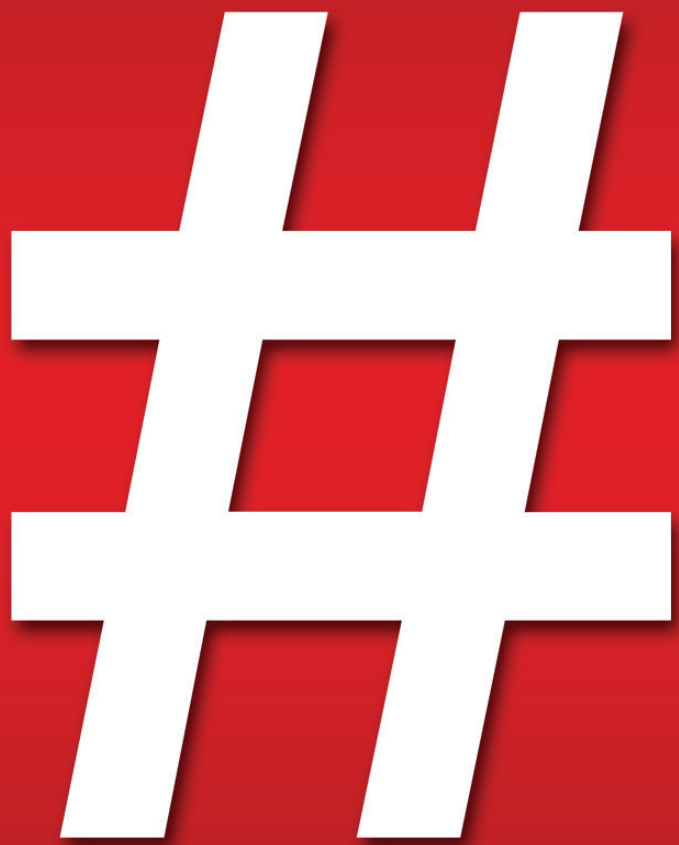

Trading Leather made a promising start to his career  
 when chasing home Battle of Marengo (Ire) (Galileo  
 {Ire}) in Leopardstown's Listed Breeders' Cup Juvenile  
 Turf Trial in early September and built on that with a  
 seven-length maiden score over a mile at Gowran Park  
 later that month. Taken to Newmarket to contest the  
 G3 Autumn S. over that trip on Future Champions' Day,  
 the bay mastered the highly regarded Hannon trainee  
 Montiridge (Ire) (Ramonti {Fr}) before coming unstuck  
 on Doncaster's testing ground when fifth of seven in  
 the G1 Racing Post Trophy a fortnight later.

At the time of his 1 1/4-length defeat by **Libertarian**  
 (GB) (New Approach {Ire}) in the G2 Dante S. over an  
 extended 10-furlong trip at York May 16, Jim Bolger  
 was exuding confidence about the Derby bid of Dawn  
 Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) and so Trading  
 Leather was denied the chance to build on his fine prep  
 effort at Epsom. Instead, he ran an admirable race to be  
 third in the Irish Guineas and then an ideal trial for this  
 Classic when subduing **Lines of Battle** (War Front) in  
 the Silver S., where he displayed a relentless galloping  
 style on his favored fast surface, one that matters  
 when annexing the G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby.

Keen initially before Libertarian's pacemaker **Cap O'Rushes (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}) and the outsider **Ralston Road (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) set a tempo that he could settle behind, he was three lengths down on the former as he was committed on the home turn and took until the quarter pole to work his way past the race's surprise package. While Joseph O'Brien was busy on the 4-5 favorite **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and getting no instant response, it was Ballydoyle's second-string **Festive Cheer (Fr)** who looked set to present a real threat, but he was stopped in his daring rail-running bid by the hanging Cap O'Rushes approaching the furlong pole. Galileo Rock was left to throw down the only meaningful challenge, but Trading Leather was always holding him and was drawing away again in the final yards. "He was a bit rusty in the Dante and had been held up a little bit beforehand as well," Jim Bolger said. "We'd expected he would improve a nice bit for that and unfortunately we had to run him in the Guineas, so he didn't get to show it until the Silver S. I was very happy from flagfall and he just had to bide his time. We'd have no worries about going back to 10 furlongs with him and the only requirement is good ground. He was a little bit slow coming to hand last year and we managed to hold on to him--I did put him on offer a couple of times, but nobody rushed in. They could do now, but we need a stallion, so we'll see what happens." Kevin Manning added, "It was a true-run race and he picked up and lengthened all the way to the line. He has a will to win and loves that quick ground. He has everything that you want in a top mile-and-a-half horse and this is one of the most special ones of my career. It's a great privilege to win."

Galileo Rock's rider Wayne Lordan said of the runner-up, "I was a little bit flat in the middle of the race and when I got to Kevin [Manning]'s girth, although he tried and ran a blinder, the winner picked up." His trainer David Wachman added, "We made a bit of a race of it, so we're happy with that and he's definitely stepping forward. He needs to again to be competitive at the back-end and he'll be in the G1 St. Leger [at Doncaster Sept. 14] and we'll see how he is, but good ground is essential and as a 4-year-old, he'll really come into his own." Aidan O'Brien said of the disappointing Ruler of the World, "He was a little bit edgy before the race and Joseph's first reaction was that maybe he didn't get the mile and a half around here--it is stiff and they went a real pace the whole way. He won the Derby by quickening and this was a proper test, so maybe we'll give him a break and go back to a mile and a quarter. He probably needs that, so we'll start him back in the autumn. He is a horse with plenty of pace and he could go for the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 7], but we'll see how he goes."

Centralintelligence broke through in a big way to earn his way into the starting gate for the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. An allowance winner at Santa Anita last March, he followed with a strong second in the GIII Los Angeles H. in late May, but failed to build on that performance with a well-beaten sixth in this race last year. Sidelined thereafter, the chestnut returned with a useful fourth behind Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie) in the five-furlong Cool Frenchy S. May 4. He took another step forward with a good second behind that rival in the GIII Los Angeles H. May 27, and was overlooked a bit while adding another furlong here. Drawn well on the outside, he tracked the pacesetter Comma to the Top from fourth through a half mile in :45.19. With Victor Espinoza aboard, he hit the gas with a sweeping move on the far turn, and leveled off nicely in the stretch to win for fun. "It was nice that he put it all together for us on the right day," trainer Ron Ellis said. "He ran so poorly in this race last year because he came out of it with a chip in his knee, so he certainly had a good excuse."

Ellis continued, "He had surgery and they actually pulled two chips out of his right front. We're going to skip [Del Mar]. This year we're going to point for the Breeders' Cup Sprint. This was our test today to show if he was good enough to keep pace with some good sprinters. You won't see him run again until the fall meet at Santa Anita. He deserves another chance at a mile, but I just don't see when he's going to get a chance to do it."

Obviously announced his presence with a three-race winning streak last term, including the GII Del Mar Mile H. Aug. 26 and the GII Arroyo Seco Mile S. at Santa Anita Oct. 6. The speedy bay gave a valiant showing on the big stage with a respectable third behind heavyweights Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) and Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Nov. 3. Freshened, Obviously resurfaced with a runner-up effort in the GIII San Simeon S. going down the hill Apr. 20, then returned to the winner's circle over the course-and-distance GII American H. May 25. Taking his customary spot on the lead here, he led by five lengths through a half mile in :46.38, and was never seriously threatened by the runner-up while punching his ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile.

"We'll definitely run in the [GII] Del Mar Mile H. [Aug. 25]," trainer Mike Mitchell said. "I'll sit down with [owners Anthony Fanticola and Joseph Scardino] and discuss what's next for him after that." Jockey Joe Talamo added, "He is just an unbelievable horse. # BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

## STYLE TRIAL

Recently purchased by Sheikh Joaan Al Thani, the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner **Style Vendome (Fr)** (Anabaa) takes centre stage today in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly. Backing up his previous success in the G3 Prix Djebel over seven furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 4, the grey had the subsequent G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero Intello (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) and G3 Jersey S. winner Gale Force Ten (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) behind in the May 12 Longchamp Classic and holds pole position in this final Group 1 race of the year open to just the 3-year-olds. Nicolas Clement, who has trained three winners of this prize already, told *PA Sport*, "I have been very pleased with his preparation and we have put a pacemaker in the race to ensure there is a strong pace. I am very happy with the horse. It is hard to judge whether he has improved since the French Guineas, but condition-wise, he looks a picture. It is a nice field. We hope for a clear run and we will see what happens. After this, hopefully he will take on older horses in the obvious races."

Also behind Style Vendome in the mile Classic was Qatar Racing Limited & CSH's **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}), who looked the likely winner at one point before fading to fifth, just under a length in arrears. He has subsequently finished fourth in The Curragh's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas May 25 and has one of these races in him. "Havana Gold certainly deserves to win a big one," Richard Hannon, Jr. said. "He ran a super race in the French 2000 Guineas and again in Ireland, but we felt that he would have more chance of hitting the jackpot here than he might have had at Royal Ascot."

The Wertheimers' **Anodin (Ire)** (Anabaa) was another who failed to hit the board at Longchamp, but the brother to Goldikova (Ire) has since won the G3 Prix Paul de Moussac over this track and trip June 8, where he made all to account for Baron Van Gysel's **San Marino Grey (Fr)** (Clodovil {Ire}) by a length. He is aided by two pacemakers this time, so a strong pace looks assured, which will also help Joseph Allen, Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Lines of Battle** (War Front). He stays further than this mile, as he proved when successful in the G2 UAE Derby over 1 3/16 miles on Meydan's Tapeta Mar. 30. Not disgraced when seventh in the May 4 GI Kentucky Derby, the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ has subsequently finished second to Trading Leather (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in the Listed Silver S. over 10 furlongs at The Curragh June 9.

## REMEMBERING HOW IT WAS

It seems a long time since **Was (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) captured the G1 Epsom Oaks, but Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's formerly expensive and now priceless commodity has been kept in training, which tells its own story and she bids to get back on track in today's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. Despite managing third placings in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood and G1 Yorkshire Oaks in August, there was a feeling of anti-climax to her 2012 campaign and her return fourth over a mile in

the May 25 G3 Ridgewood Pearl S. would have put her right for this test. Jockey Joseph O'Brien is hoping for better. "She ran a nice race at the Curragh earlier on in the year over a mile and that trip is probably a bit short of her best," he said. "She's stepping back up to a mile and a quarter here, so we'll be hoping for a good run."

Due to the generous weight-for-age terms that show no sign of being revised, she has to give an enormous 12-pound concession to Sue-Ann Foley's highly progressive sophomore **Alive Alive Oh (GB)** (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}) and that may prove beyond her. That filly launched herself into prominence when registering a six-length success from Was's stable companion **Magical Dream (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the May 7 Listed Salsabil S. over this trip at Navan. She has since been to Royal Ascot for the G2 Ribblesdale S. only to be scratched late when the rain stayed away and the ground firmed up. "That was the first time she'd ever had a journey of any real length, but she took it all in her stride, thankfully," trainer Tommy Stack's son and assistant Fozzy told *PA Sport*. "It was just a shame she couldn't run. It will be a long time before we scratch a favourite at Ascot again, I can say that. But the owners are very understanding and they want her for a long time, not just a good time. The ground was very hard at Ascot, so it was the correct decision, we feel, anyway. She seems well, she's taking on the older fillies, but she seems well and I don't think I'd swap her for anything in the race. She should have a very good chance."

Moyglare Stud Farm's **Princess Highway** (Street Cry {Ire}) is another who failed to build on an impressive early 3-year-old campaign at the end of last term, with her emphatic six-length dismissal of **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and the re-opposing Oaks runner-up **Shirocco Star (GB)** (Shirocco {Ger}) in Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale S. placing her among the very best of her generation. Subsequently third in the G1 Irish Oaks here in July, she was unplaced in both the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September and the GI E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine the following month and was upset at 8-13 in the G3 Blue Wind S. over this trip on her 4-year-old bow at Naas last time May 15. She is tried in blinkers for the first time here and if they spark a revival on ground she relishes, she could yet re-emerge as a leading force in this division.

## CALIDOSCOPIO RETIRED

**Calidoscopio (Arg)** (Luhuk--Calderona {Arg}, by Lefty), winner of last year's GII Breeders' Cup Marathon, has suffered a tendon injury and has been retired from racing. The 10-year-old was coming off a dramatic last-to-first victory in the June 7 GII Brooklyn H. A Group 1 winner in Argentina, Calidoscopio was making his first U.S. start when he rallied from last to score a 4 1/4-length victory in the Marathon. On the board in 24 of 42 starts, the veteran won 11 times and earned \$975,154. He is expected to return to Argentina to take up stud duties.

## GROUPIE DOLL BACK ON TRACK

Champion female sprinter **Groupie Doll** (Bowman's Band), off since finishing a narrowly beaten second to Stay Thirsty (Bernardini) in last year's GI Cigar Mile H., turned in her first work of the year Saturday at Churchill Downs. The 5-year-old mare worked three furlongs in :35.80 with jockey John Mckee in the irons. "It was a good morning to see her back and to tell the partners that everything went well," said trainer Buff Bradley, who co-bred and co-owns Groupie Doll. "She came back good and cooled out good. She'll tell you when she wants to do something and she was ready." During her 2012 championship season, Groupie Doll won the GI Madison S., GI Humana Distaff S. and GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint. She was given a short break after the Cigar Mile, but Bradley was not pleased with the way she was training at Gulfstream over the winter and the champion was sent for a more extended vacation. "The big thing today was that she was willing to do it," Bradley said. "She was very willing to do it and she wasn't at Gulfstream. Sometimes you don't know with these fillies. They're a little temperamental and they might not come back as good as you had hoped, but she seemed like her old self today." Bradley said possible targets for Groupie Doll include the Aug. 23 GI Ballerina S. or Sept. 9 GII Presque Isle Downs Masters. "We'll keep breezing her and we'll probably breeze her every Saturday," Bradley added. "I know it'll take about four more works to get her where we need to be and then we'll start making a plan."

Cozze Up Lady is co-owned by the Martin Racing Stables of Texans Bill and Stevie Martin, Dan Morgan's Morgan Thoroughbreds, Westwind Property and her breeder Kip and Suzanne Knelman's Farfellow Farms. The Martins and Morgan also campaigned champion female sprinter Dubai Majesty (Essence of Dubai). Favored Aubby K never looked comfortable and offered a mild late rally to finish third. "I don't think she handled [the Polytrack] really well," said Eddie Castro, who rode the beaten favorite. "She gave me a bunch, but not enough."

Nov. 3. Debt Ceiling had to wait out a rain delay as thunder storms poured down on Churchill, but didn't take long assuming command here and drawing off to a much-the-best win. The Maryland-based colt won at first asking at Laurel Mar. 30, then made it two straight at 5-1 odds in the Rollicking S. on the GI Preakness S. undercard at Pimlico May 18. Off at those odds once again, Debt Ceiling was away in good order and sat third as My Corinthian raced up to set an unrealistic first quarter of :20 4/5 in advance of Hollywood Talent. My Corinthian was soon spent, and Debt Ceiling made an aggressive move to the front three furlongs out. He opened up by four or five leaving the quarter pole and, despite being geared down by Eric Camacho in the final furlong, maintained that advantage to the wire. Trainer Jerry Robb thinks the colt will continue to improve. "The first race, I didn't expect him to win," he said. "He did it on raw talent. The last two races, we went in feeling very confident." Asked about making the trip to Churchill, Robb said, "There were really no other races on the East Coast for him. This was the closest around, and I'm glad we came." It was Robb's first win under the Twin Spires. He said Debt Ceiling will likely be pointed toward a race at Saratoga.

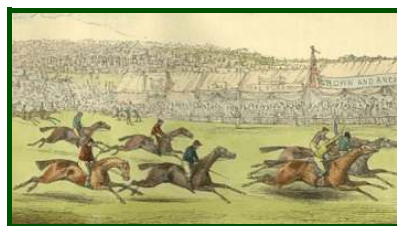

While the Ballydoyle conditioner is not ruling out a tilt at Saturday's G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown, last year's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 English and G1 Irish Derby hero could bow out after his latest fourth in last Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. "He's a very important horse to us and he's not one we want to take any risks with," O'Brien told *PA Sport* yesterday. "The last day at Royal Ascot, he obviously hadn't come back to his best and, while the Eclipse is still an option, retirement is something we might have to consider as well. The spark was never there after his run in the Irish Derby last year. He had a tough race there on testing ground and then had that problem over the winter."

**The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) is targeting Saturday's G1 Eclipse S. with the Lloyd-Webbers', John Gosden announced yesterday. "That's the plan and she's in good form," Gosden said. "We hear there's rain Tuesday and then it's meant to be warm, so as long as we don't get a lot of thunderstorms, she should run. From the Eclipse, we'll know which way to go--whether to stay with the colts or go back for the [G1] Nassau [S. at Goodwood Aug. 3]."
