HAVANA GOLD GETS UP IN JEAN PRAT

Havana Gold (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}), coming off a fourth-place effort in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas, lived up to his early promise with a late-running victory in Sunday's G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly. Ridden by Mickael Barzalona to gain a pitch in mid-division as the early stages were marked by scrimmaging for position, the sophomore tracked **San Marino Grey (Fr)** (Clodovil {Ire}) in early stretch as Thierry Thulliez on G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner **Style Vendome (Fr)** (Anabaa) attempted to keep him in a pocket. Traveling too strongly to be boxed in, Havana Gold swooped in the final 100 meters and steadily asserted from the former as the Wertheimers' pacemaker **Mondialiste (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) held on to third spot. "He deserved that, as he's a very consistent horse, and a good one, too," Richard Hannon, Jr. said. "The Irish Guineas was a strange race and maybe not his true form, but he won well here, and we're convinced he will stay farther, so we are tempted to try him over a mile and a quarter." **Cont. p7**

AMBIVALENT COMMITTED IN PRETTY POLLY

Ambivalent (Ire) (Authorized {Ire}) showed a new dimension to score a front-running victory in Sunday's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. Under an inspired Johnny Murtagh, the dark bay filly was quickly in front and, chased only by **Harasiya (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), was

game against the fence when pressed by that rival inside the final quarter mile. She had secured the victory by the time last year's G1 Epsom Oaks first and second **Was (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Shirocco Star (GB)** (Shirocco {Ger}) found their best stride.

"[Trainer] Roger [Varian] said to let her stride along, as she is hardy and tough and a little bit hot," Murtagh said. "We used the one draw and it was pretty straightforward. She was game in the end, as they all lined up to have a go at her and she dug deep. She would have no problem going back to a mile and a half, and she should improve." Varian added, "She has run well on her two starts this year, but both races were tactical; they went steady and we held her up and she had been a bit gassy. Today, we had nothing to lose at the highest level, so I said to Johnny to change tactics and ride her forward, and it came off." **Cont. p3**

'NOT A SCRATCH' ON WISE DAN

Reigning Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) endured an eventful trip during a rainy renewal of Saturday's GII Firecracker H., but exited the victory with nary a scratch, according to trainer Charlie LoPresti. "He looks really good today and he doesn't have a scratch on him, believe it or not," LoPresti said. Wise Dan, trapped along the hedge, was forced to bully his way to the lead over a soggy turf. "I watched the race a bunch last night and this morning," LoPresti said. "It was nerve-racking with the weight spread and the way the weather played out, but we got through it. And he handled the weight spread and showed he's truly a great horse. I just hope they don't put too much weight on him down the road. I'm glad he got to run up there and the fans really cheered him on when he came back. Hopefully, it was good for Churchill to have a horse like that run up there." Wise Dan is expected to remain at Keeneland before shipping to Saratoga in mid-July. "We're thinking about the [Aug. 10 GII] Fourstardave and the [Aug. 3 GI] Whitney," LoPresti said. "We'll see how he comes out of it and how he handles going up there. We'll also look at the [Aug. 31 GII] Bernard Baruch and the [Aug. 31 GI] Woodward. There are four races up there that we're looking at with this horse. I'd really like to keep him undefeated and I'd like to win a Grade I on dirt with him this year. If we get a Grade I on dirt with him, keep him going and get a few wins on the grass and then get to the Breeders' Cup, maybe he'll get Horse of the Year again."

Ambivalent Committed in Pretty Polly (cont. from p1)

Ambivalent had lived up to her name prior to this career-best, managing just a pair of successes despite having flaunted above-average ability on the Newmarket gallops. Breaking through when taking the Listed Chalice S. over 12 furlongs at Newbury in August, the bay ran fifth in the G2 Park Hill S. when tried over an extended 14-furlong trip at Doncaster in September. Tiring to 12th in the G1 Prix de l'Opera over this trip when the hood was removed at Longchamp on Arc day, she was back in that headgear on her seasonal bow when second to Dalkala (Giant's Causeway) in York's G2 Middleton S. over an extended 10 furlongs May 16. Only third when held up in customary style in Haydock's G3 Pinnacle S. over 12 furlongs when last seen June 8, connections opted for a radical change in tactics here.

"She's always worked incredibly well at home, but prior to today she'd been placed in group races and had only won a listed race," said trainer Roger Varian. "She's not a straightforward filly, and half the key is to keep a lid on her excitement prior to the off. The team here did a great job with her and I was pretty pleased with her condition as she went out on to the track. We'll just get her home and enjoy today--there are plenty of options for her."

Trainer Aidan O'Brien was pleased with the effort of Pretty Polly runner-up Was. "We were delighted with that and she loves fast ground and stays more than a mile and a quarter," O'Brien said. "Hopefully, she's back on the right road now and will keep coming forward."

Lightly campaigned last year, Berlin Berlin came to the fore when runner-up in Hanover's G3 Grosser Preis Jungheinrich Gabelstapler over 11 furlongs in September, but was on the back foot next time when down the field in the G3 Hubertus-Liebrecht-Gedachtnispreis at this trip at Baden-Baden in October. Seen only once subsequently, the bay was off the board in the Listed Sachsen Preis over 10 furlongs at Dresden June 8, but delivered on earlier promise to cause an upset in a race that was designed as a lap of honor for last year's G1 Preis von Europa winner Girolamo. Held up in mid-division early under cover, she hooked up with Runaway passing the eighth pole and had her nose in front where it mattered after a sustained duel.

Runner-up to Heart Focus on debut over this trip at Naas May 15, Bye Bye Birdie was upset at 1-2 over this course and distance 10 days later before getting off the mark at the first time of asking at the expense of the smart Abbakova (Ire) (Dandy Man {Ire}) over five at Cork June 16. Sent to Royal Ascot to contest last Wednesday's G2 Queen Mary S., the bay finished in mid-division there, but showed she was unfazed by her busy campaign by quickly establishing a decisive lead in a first-time visor here. Stretching away inside the final quarter as Heart Focus chased, she was firmly in command at the line to gain a vital black-type win.

Those who witnessed the 10-length debut success of Ernest Hemingway in a maiden on Dundalk's Polytrack last April may have benefitted from a speculative punt on the impressive-looking colt at inflated odds in this first marathon attempt. That first outing came over an extended 10 furlongs and he tackled that trip again when representing Ballydoyle in the G2 Dante S. the following month. Trying to make all there before fading into last of the seven runners, the dark bay was wrapped up until the autumn and re-appeared as a pacemaker for Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) and St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe before running second in a conditions event back over the track and trip on which he had so beguiled on his racecourse bow 12 days later. Restricted to just one start so far this term, he was fourth in the Apr. 7 Listed Alleged S. over a mile-and-a-quarter trip that was obviously inadequate at this stage of his career. Settled a little worse than mid-division early by Seamie Heffernan, who is enjoying another spell in the limelight at present, he was temporarily short of room on the inner turning for home as the leader Mijhaar (GB) (Shirocco {Ger}) started to backpedal. Switched wide for his effort, he unleashed a turn of acceleration that his rivals lacked to cut down Royal Diamond and Voleuse de Coeurs passing the furlong marker and was firmly in command in the run to the line. "He had always shown plenty and won his maiden very impressively, but he is massive and probably took a bit longer to come to hand," Heffernan explained. "He skated in today and I'd say I'd have won at any distance from a mile and a quarter."

West Hills Giant was last victorious in the New York Breeders' Futurity at Finger Lakes Sept. 29 and hasn't managed to find the winner's circle since stepping up in class against open company--he was seventh in the GIII Pilgrim S. over yielding Belmont turf Oct. 8 and third in the Java Gold S. at Aqueduct Feb. 10. Adding blinkers, he finished second behind Vyjack (Into Mischief) in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 2, 12th in the Apr. 13 GI Blue Grass S. over the Keeneland synthetic, and broke poorly and finished fifth in the Mike Lee S. against Empire-breds June 1.

Shedding blinkers and returning to the turf for this one, the favorite was unhurried early, but gradually moved up between horses to sit in a stalking position on the backstretch. Forced out about five wide entering the lane, the chestnut grabbed the lead in upperstretch and kept on for the win. "He hasn't been as quick from the gate the last couple of starts, but he had run a route of ground the times before that," said winning conditioner John Terranova. "They helped today with a quick half-mile, so I'm kind of glad he was sitting back there taking his time, so he could get a clear shot and an outside run. It was a nice, smooth race for him.
