ON TOP OF HIS 'GAME'

Only four rivals will take on **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) as he attempts to defend his title in today's G1 Hollywood Gold Cup. A puzzling seventh as the favorite in last year's G1 Breeders' Cup Classic, the 6-year-old has been unbeatable since, including a runaway victory in the G1 Santa Anita H. Mar. 2 and a hard-fought tally over **Clubhouse Ride** (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GII Charles Town Classic most recently Apr. 20. Co-owner and former New York Yankees manager Joe Torre is expected to be on hand to watch his charge perform at Hollywood

today. "My heart was pumping," Torre said after attending the \$1.5-million showcase in West Virginia earlier this spring. "It's a helpless feeling because you can't do anything about it but watch. It's sort of the same thing when [New York Yankees closer] Mariano Rivera goes out to the mound. You put your hands in your pocket and hope for the best." Clubhouse Ride, runner-up behind Game on Dude in three straight, finally escaped that one's mighty shadow to impressively annex the GII Californian S. June 1. **Kettle Corn** (Candy Ride {Arg}), a well-beaten third in last year's Gold Cup, adds blinkers after finishing a well-beaten fourth in the Californian. **Field p4**

A field of eight will vie for a berth to the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf in today's G1 United Nations S. at Monmouth Park. **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) pulled off an impressive treble last term-- capturing the G1 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. at Churchill Downs May 5, the G1 Arlington Million Aug. 18, and the Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 3. Trained by Dale Romans, Little Mike returns to the U.S. following a pair of disappointing efforts in Dubai, including an 11th-place finish in the G1 Dubai Duty Free last time Mar. 30. He is two-for-two lifetime over the Monmouth Park grass. **Cont. p5**

'JUDY' SEEKS BREAKTHROUGH IN ROONEY

Wesley Ward owned and trained **Judy the Beauty** (Ghostzapper) looks to capture an elusive Grade I in today's Princess Rooney H. at Calder. Second in the 2011 G1 Spinaway S., the chestnut came a nose away from annexing the G1 Prioress S. the following August. Never worse than second in nine lifetime starts, she was last seen checking in runner-up at 4-5 in Churchill's GIII Winning Colors S. May 27. **Cont. p5**

ONCE MORE INTO THE BREACH

John Deer's **Al Kazeem** (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) has already garnered the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and G1 Prince of Wales's S., and bids to extend his monopoly on the major European middle-distance contests in today's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown. This race is usually tagged as the first "clash of the generations", but with a sole 3-year-old in opposition in **Mars (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), it has a lopsided feel to it this year. For trainer Roger Charlton, the biggest concern is the fact that Al Kazeem is back racing so soon after his exploits at Royal Ascot June 19. "He came out of it amazingly well, but you can never tell and it was a tough race," he said. "Seventeen days is probably a few days short of what would be ideal, but he eats incredibly well and is heavier than he was before Ascot and is fresh and bright and looks well. From all the external signs, it looks good." This will be Al Kazeem's fifth Pattern-race in succession, and he has mastered all-comers in the previous four, which also include the G3 Gordon Richards S. over this track and trip Apr. 27. "I think he was underrated up until Ascot, and is right up with there with a lot of the good horses I've trained and on official ratings, he's the best," Charlton added. "Smaller fields are slightly messy and it may become tactical, but James [Doyle] is very alert to the situation and you've just got to play the cards you've got and hope you have the right horse." **Cont. p3**

Re-opposing is Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Mukhadram (GB)** (Shamardal), who also boasts winning course-and-distance form having annexed the G3 Brigadier Gerard S. on his seasonal bow May 30. He went down by a neck under positive tactics employed by Paul Hanagan at Royal Ascot, and it looks likely that a similar ploy is on the cards. "Paul rode a beautiful race at Ascot and had them all in trouble for a bit," the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Angus Gold commented. "It took what I feel is the best older horse in Europe all the Ascot straight to

catch him, and was well above our horse's previous best. We've always said this horse doesn't need to make the running, but he's got a lovely long stride and is not a horse you would want to settle out the back and use for his speed. He's got that great action, a good stride on him and a high cruising speed so I'm sure he'll be there or thereabouts. He is stronger, has matured and is turning into a high-class horse." Also in that Royal Ascot feature was Lord Lloyd-Webber's smart filly **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), and she is certain to progress off that seasonal bow. Trainer John Gosden is expecting better from last year's G1 Nassau S. winner over her ideal surface, and she bids to break a 21-year barren spell for fillies in this race. "She was drawn on the outside and the outside over a mile and a quarter at Ascot is difficult, because you are straight to Swinley Bottom within half a furlong," her conditioner said. "You've got to drop across and accept that, or go for the lead, which is not ideal. Consequently, we got where we thought we'd be, which was well back. They went a solid pace and she finished better than anything, so we couldn't be happier with her." **Cont. p4**

Aidan O'Brien is one shy of a record six wins in this prestigious affair and, despite ruling out Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), still holds a strong hand in the June 18 G1 Queen Anne S. winner **Declaration of War** (War Front) and ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Mars. Joseph Allen's homebred Declaration of War looked as if this return to 10 furlongs would not pose a significant problem when finishing off that mile contest strongly at Royal Ascot, while Mars has been quietly progressing in some serious sophomore tests. Sixth in the G1 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4 on what was his first run on grass, Michael Tabor's colorbearer was also in that spot despite having too much to do in the June 1 G1 Epsom Derby and met trouble in running when third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at the Royal meeting 17 days later. Their trainer is hopeful they can answer some questions here. "Declaration of War is in good form, he came out of Ascot well," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He's run over a mile and two before, but obviously not at the top level. We were delighted with him at Ascot, he showed a lot of speed and traveled well through the race, and when Joseph asked him to quicken, he quickened well. Obviously, going a mile and a quarter at the top level is different. We should learn a lot about him for the rest of the year... It's a chance to run over the distance at the top level and we will see where to go for the rest of the season then."

O'Brien added, "We're happy with Mars. Ryan thought he would have preferred a clearer run. It looks like a mile and two should suit him judged on all his races. He's wearing a hood, because he sweated up and it just keeps him calm and keeps out the sound. The race comes along nicely for both of them." Stall Antanando's Apr. 28 G1 Prix Ganay winner **Pastorius (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}) is no back-number, and trainer Mario Hofer is confident he will rebound from a disappointing effort when beating only one home in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 19. "He has recovered well from his trip to Singapore and is now back in top form," Hofer told *Racing Post*. "We are not worried about the ground, as he goes on anything, but of course we have the greatest respect for the opposition, which looks very strong."

Five Chances for Wolfson's Fourth...

"It certainly would be nice to finally get a Grade I and to get it right here in Florida," Ward, who himself is still seeking a win at the highest level, told *Daily Racing Form*. "We've been pointing her to this race ever since putting her back in training earlier this year. Normally, I might be concerned running a horse over the Calder surface for the first time, but Judy the Beauty worked :34 4/5 here as a 2-year-old and just skipped over the track." South Florida fixture Marty Wolfson has won a record three Princess Rooneys, and could run as many as five in this year's renewal. "I like to have a speed filly, I like to have a stalker, I like to have a closer, and I have all those," Wolfson said of his propensity to run multiple horses in races. Among his entrants is Miller Racing's **Spectacular Sky** (Sky Mesa) whose only loss from four tries at Calder came here a year ago when she was last of 11. But she bounced back with three consecutive local wins and started off 2013 with a victory in Tampa Bay's Manatee S. and runner-up finish to subsequent GI Humana Distaff S. winner Aubby K (Street Sense) in Gulfstream's GII Inside Information S. Mar. 17. "The only concern I have is she's better going [seven furlongs]," Wolfson said. The 5-year-old broke through the gate before Belmont's GII Vagrancy H. May 18, ultimately weakening to fifth. "The last race I ran her was in New York and she broke through the gate and ran off about 20 yards and they caught her, but she's never done that before," he noted. Perhaps the speediest of Wolfson's representatives is **Starship Truffles** (Ghostzapper), who blitzed a local starter optional claimer by 10 lengths here a week ago, earning a 96 Beyer Speed Figure. **Cont. p6**

The in-and-out type had previously finished sixth behind **Capitalism At Risk** (Bull Market) and stablemate **Oh Carole** (Unbridled's Song) in the June 8 U Can Do It H. "Starship Truffles, she just kind of freaked [last time]," Wolfson said. "She's won like nine of 11. I didn't like her race in the U Can Do It. She didn't run well, and I knew it wasn't a fair value, so I ran her back last week and if she won I was going to run [here]. She did more than that--she opened up by 12 and won under wraps in 1:04, which is fast here, so that's why I ran her back this week. I wouldn't usually run back in a week."

An overflow field lines up for an automatic berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint today in Calder's GII Smile Sprint H. Sherry Parbhoo's **Trinniberg** (Teufflesburg), the defending BC Sprint winner and champion sprinter, looks to bounce back from a pair of disappointments as he appears at his home base in the afternoon for the first time since being narrowly bested by **Fort Loudon**

(Awesome of Course) in the GIII Carry Back S. on this card 12 months ago. This year hasn't begun as well as 2012 ended for the 4-year-old, who was 11th in Meydan's G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 30 and seventh in Churchill's sloppy GII Churchill Downs S. on the Kentucky Derby undercard May 4. There is a relative dearth of early speed signed on for this caliber of sprint, and Trinniberg will likely be able to send and tuck in from his outside draw. If the pace does heat up, Silverton Hill's **Swagger Jack** (Smart Strike) will be dangerous. Second to Fort Loudon in the GIII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship S. Feb. 9, the Marty Wolfson pupil filled the same slot behind Discreet Dancer (Discreet Cat)--and in front of Fort Loudon--in the one-mile GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 9. The dark bay cut back to seven panels to upend Aqueduct's GI Carter H. at 15-1 over Sahara Sky (Pleasant Tap) Apr. 6, but could only manage a seventh-place finish after enduring some traffic trouble behind that runner in the GI Metropolitan H. at Big Sandy May 27. "He got knocked into the rail--he was turned sideways," conditioner Marty Wolfson said of his charge's trip in the Met Mile. "That's why [Jose] Lezcano called and wanted to ride him because he rode the race on Fort Loudon and he was right behind it, he saw what happened. The horse would have been right there. He might have won the Met."

Admitting that six panels may be a bit sharp for Swagger Jack, Wolfson explained, "I plan on running him in the [seven-furlong GI] Forego [S. at Saratoga Aug. 31] and I needed a race in between without having to ship him anywhere." **Fort Loudon** (Awesome of Course), sixth last time in the Met Mile, is one of three for trainer Stan Gold. He's joined in the entries by **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil) and also-eligible **Grande Shores** (Black Mambo). The former was a dominant 2-year-old here in 2009 before annexing Grade I sprints in New York for conditioner Nick Zito in 2011 and 2012. Brought back this year after issues at stud, the 6-year-old was fifth behind **Black Diamond Cat** (Wildcat Heir), **Close It Out** (Closing Argument), **Grande Shores** (Black Mambo) and **Bahamian Squall** (Gone West) and in front of **Trickmeister** (Proud Citizen) and **On Appeal** (Closing Argument) in the track-and-trip Ponche H. June 8.

'GUNFIGHTER' SEEKS SEVENTH STRAIGHT

John Gunther's **Last Gunfighter** (First Samurai) looks to keep an impressive win streak rolling as he seeks his seventh win in as many starts in Belmont's GII Suburban H. this afternoon. Transferred from Helen Pitts to Chad Brown last fall, the homebred has moved steadily up the class ladder and Beyer Speed Figure scale ever since. He earned his first graded stakes win in the GIII Excelsior S. on the Aqueduct inner Mar. 23, and paired up 100 Beyers with an easy 4 1/2-length tally in the May 17 GIII Pimlico Special S. The 4-year-old will make his first start at Big Sandy since breaking his maiden here last October. "The horse has done nothing wrong since we got him," offered Brown. "There are a lot of nice horses in the race, and we hope that he keeps inching forward. If he does, he should be competitive." Last Gunfighter may need to do more than inch forward in order to contend with Preston Stables's **Flat Out** (Flatter). A break-out winner of this event two years ago, the multiple local Grade I-winning 7-year-old earned a gaudy 116 Beyer Speed Figure when narrowly besting ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Cross Traffic (Unbridled's Song) in the one-mile GIII Westchester S. here Apr. 27. While Flat Out could only manage third in the May 27 GI Metropolitan H. after checking on the turn, he was flattered by Cross Traffic's super-game runner-up performance and figures to appreciate an additional furlong to work with. "We didn't get it done in the Met Mile, which we wanted to, and maybe we'd give him another opportunity here," trainer Bill Mott said of the decision to run in this spot rather than wait for Saratoga. "I would think the Suburban might not be as tough as the Met Mile was. If we were to wait for [Saratoga's Aug. 3 GI] Whitney we'd have to wait another month and I'm not sure the horse needs another month." Godolphin's **Alpha** (Bernardini), a winner of last year's GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S. (in a dead heat), hasn't been seen Stateside since a 12th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in November. He turned in two disappointing efforts in Group 2 company at Meydan over the winter. **Field p8**

Second in Laurel's Private Terms S. in March for trainer Pablo Andrade and Brahman Red LLC, the bay shipped to New York to upset Aqueduct's Fit to Fight S. at 12-1 Apr. 7. Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners subsequently purchased a controlling interest in the colt and transferred him to Todd Pletcher. The bay scratched from the GII Peter Pan S. May 11, and rerouted to the seven-panel Gygistar S. here May 22 where he checked in third. "The Gygistar was probably a little shorter than we had hoped to run, but I think he ran well," said Pletcher. "We learned a few things about how he needs to be ridden, and I hope those things can be applied to this race." Fellow Pletcher trainee **Abraham** (Distorted Humor) comes off a fourth-place finish in the Peter Pan, while the Chad Brown-conditioned **Saint Vigeur** (Smart Strike) was a distant second in that even last time. 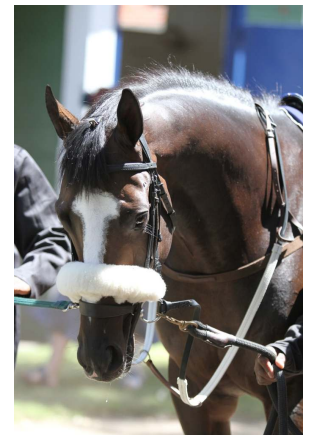

JULY, JULY! 20 SET FOR DURBAN STARDOM

Durban typically has a mild winter, perfect for staging South Africa's most prestigious event, the G1 Vodacom Durban July over 2200 meters at the Greyville Racecourse.

However, there has been steady rain during the past week, causing the ground to have plenty of give, and the first two races on Saturday's card have been cancelled. The sun is expected to chase away the clouds by post time tomorrow, but the condition of the course will certainly make it a test of stamina for the 20 runners in the R3.5-million (US\$344,806) feature.

"It's a very open July," summed up trainer Dean Kannemeyer, who will saddle star sophomore **Capetown Noir (SAf)** (Western Winter). The powerfully built colt secured wins in the G1 Cape Premier Guineas and G1 Investec Cape Derby during the summer, and comes into this affair off a blanket-finish third in the G1 Daily News at Greyville June 1. Capetown Noir showed he could handle 10 furlongs in both the Cape Derby and the Daily News, but the muddy footing has his conditioner cautious about the additional distance Saturday evening. **Cont. p10**

"If it wasn't the July, we wouldn't be racing tomorrow," Kannemeyer acknowledged. "My horse is a daisy cutter, really has a wonderful action. Of course, we would want good ground, but that's not the case."

The conditioner also voiced concern about Capetown Noir's post, as the 3-year-old is out in the 15 hole. "Obviously, I'd love to be closer to the paint," Kannemeyer admitted. "But if they have a good, genuine pace, then it will be alright and the jockey [Karl Neisius] will be able to drop in. If they go slow, then he'll be forced to stay wide."

Among Capetown Noir's 19 rivals is defending titleist **Pomodoro (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf}). Pomodoro posted a 20-1 upset 12 months ago while shouldering a 121-pound impost. Since then, he has notched a third in the G1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate and a fourth in the G1 J&B Met, and most recently was third to Variety Club (SAf) (Var) in the G1 Rising Sun Gold Challenge S. at Clairwood June 8.

"Pomodoro did win last year from 20, but like always, you need the luck," Kannemeyer added. "Pomodoro won last year with 55 [kilograms, 121 pounds]. He's good enough to win the July again, but I'm not sure if he can with 60 [132 pounds]. But I do have to respect him."

Alongside Capetown Noir, another 3-year-old facing his elders here is **Wylie Hall (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), who made his way to South Africa after being purchased as a yearling for A\$205,000 at the 2011 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. The bay captured a listed event over very soft ground at Turffontein Apr. 6, and followed that with a win in the G1 South African Derby over 2450 meters on the same course Apr. 27. He was fourth, beaten a neck, in the Daily News, and will surely benefit over further ground here.

The racecourse will stage a 67-second moment of silence in tribute to Nelson Mandela before the running of the July.

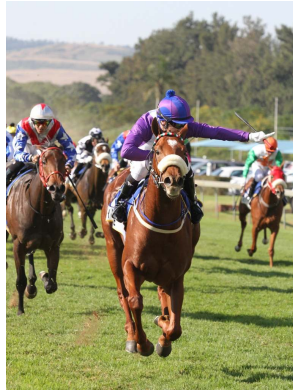

KZN SALE CLOSURES WITH GAINS

The two-day KZN Yearling Sale in Durban ended yesterday with across the board gains. The aggregate was up 54% to R20,270,000 (US\$1,990,670), while the average price of R90,089 (US\$8,847) was up 31% from last year. The median was up 20% to R60,000 (US\$5,892).

A colt by Mogok fetched the highest price of yesterday's session, bringing R400,000 (US\$39,283) from Tyrone Zackney from the draft of Scott Bros-Highdown Stud. Second billing went to a son of Var, who was purchased by trainer Dennis Drier for R350,000 (US\$34,373) from consignor Daytona Stud. The sale topper came Thursday, when a son of Silvano (Ger) closely related to champion Bold Silvano (SAf) (Silvano) brought R650,000 (US\$63,835) from B D Burnard.

Bloodstock South Africa Chief Executive Officer Tom Callaghan said, "We had a much stronger catalogue this year, with many of the country's top sires well represented, and the sale also benefitted from the support of many of the Cape breeders. It was also encouraging to see a great crowd turnover, as well as a number of new buyers. This sale continues to grow in stature, and its positioning in relation to the [G1 Vodacom Durban] July is a stroke of genius. It has also benefitted from great teamwork from both [Bloodstock South Africa] and the KZN Breeders. The positive uptick in the South African bloodstock market defies logic when taking into account the overall financial situation and is a tremendous tribute to the resilience of the South African racing community."

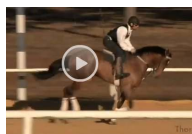
