### THREE UP FOR BIG AL

Despite having already grabbed the spoils in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and G1 Prince of Wales's S., John Deer's **Al Kazeem (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) turned up at Sandown to bring up a unique hat-trick and justify 15-8

favoritism in his now customary professional manner. Always traveling with zest under cover tracking the leader **Mukhadram (GB)** (Shamardal), the bay was cajoled upsides that rival with a quarter mile remaining and had to survive an inquiry after rolling across him

inside the final 100 yards en route to a two-length verdict over the closer **Declaration of War** (War Front). "He's a fantastic horse and he's proved that today," jockey James Doyle commented before learning that he had been handed a five-day ban as a result of the winner's late infringement. "He just idled and had a look close home, but won pretty well. He was pricking his ears and rolled in to the rail. He's such an uncomplicated horse who has great rhythm and a great presence about him." **Cont. p3**

### A HOLLYWOOD ENDING FOR 'DUDE'

For the third year in a row, a horse named 'Dude' proved victorious in the G1 Hollywood Gold Cup. In 2011, it was the Bob Baffert-trained First Dude

(Stephen Got Even) who got his nose down ahead of **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again), but the latter 'dude' got the job done in 2012, and, in what could be its final running, proved gamest this time, as he held off a determined run from **Kettle Corn** (Candy Ride {Arg})--in receipt of 11 pounds--to score by a length. In becoming the third winner of the Gold Cup in four years for his sire (Awesome Gem, 2010), Game On Dude carried 127 pounds, the most since Perrault shouldered the same load to

victory in the 1982 Gold Cup, and one more pound than Cigar carried in 1995. **Cont. p6**

While there was little in his 3-year-old career to suggest that Al Kazeem would emerge as such a leading force in this category, he had quietly started to build his profile with a trio of seconds in York's G2 Great Voltigeur S. and Newbury's G3 Dubai Duty Free Arc Trial and G3 St Simon S. Showing the benefit of the steady approach when returning with an impressive score in the G2 Jockey Club S. over 12 furlongs at Newmarket last May, he sustained a stress fracture of his pelvis and was subsequently out of action until the G3 Gordon Richards S. over this track and trip Apr. 27. On that occasion, he had leaned across Shadwell's Ektihaam (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the closing stages in a portent of what was to come yesterday, but there was no doubting his obvious superiority, which was also in evidence as he toppled Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) off his pedestal in the Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 26. At Royal Ascot, he had taken until the final yards to master Mukhadram, and had that rival firmly in his sights again here as he drafted in behind the leader with Mars (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) on his outer. **Cont. p4**

As the latter joined up with Mukhadram on the final turn, he had the other Ballydoyle representative Declaration of War for company, but was traveling too strongly to be kept in and quickened while that rival took time to find his stride under Joseph O'Brien. The Shadwell trailblazer kicked away from Mars in early straight, leaving Al Kazeem a gap, and he did not need a second invitation with James Doyle able to employ just hands and heels to move alongside. The whip was used

for a few strides, but when his rider put his hands down as he began to get on top of Mukhadram, the winner took that as an opportunity to muscle out his already beaten rival, who lost out on second to the staying-on Declaration of War. "He's gone from strength to strength and I've never doubted he's a top-class horse," his rider said of Al

Kazeem, who recorded a time third only to the 1987 hero Mtoto (GB) and Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) four years ago. "A lot of people talked about tactics here, but my horse is easy to ride and I could have dropped him out last if I wanted to. I was always happy, but had to sit tight on the bend until the gap came and I was forced to play my cards a bit sooner than I wanted to.

Doyle continued, "This course suits him, but he did exactly what he did in the Gordon Richards, so maybe there is something here that catches his eye and makes him do that. He could be better with cut in the ground--I've always thought he would be, and there was when he won the Jockey Club S. He stays very well and has tactical speed and a turn of foot." Trainer Roger Charlton remains committed to a tilt at the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 6, with a holiday on the cards now. "I am immensely proud of him and I think it ought to be that he has a break now," he said. "He's had three races on pretty firm ground, so he deserves it and the decision is between the G1 Juddmonte International [at York Aug. 21] or G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 7], with the latter being better timing before the Arc. He's a proper horse and looks like one--he's very special." Aidan O'Brien is looking at dropping the runner-up back in trip now. "He ran a very good race, but he is probably a miler," he told *PA Sport*. "He doesn't stop, but it is his courage that keeps him going. We'd be happy to go back to a mile, maybe for something like the G1 Sussex S. [at Goodwood July 31.]" Angus Gold, racing manager to Mukhadram's owner Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, also told *PA Sport*, "I thought he ran a fabulous race, I think without the interference we'd have been pound for pound with the winner, as it was at Ascot. The winner is a very good horse."

Winner of the GII Hall of Fame S. in 2011, Big Blue Kitten faced the starter but four times last term, finishing the distant runner-up to subsequent Horse of the Year Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland before a 10th behind So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at

Royal Ascot in June. The homebred got the better of Za Approval (Ghostzapper) in a third-level Gulfstream allowance Dec. 2 and was third to Mucho Mas Macho (Macho Uno) in the GII Fort Lauderdale S. Jan. 13, before landing a Mar. 3 allowance in Hallandale. The bay was

along late to defeat the evergreen Rahystrada (Rahy) in a stakes-quality Churchill allowance May 2 and was last seen finishing runner-up to Boisterous (Distorted Humor) in this track's GII Monmouth S. June 9. The bettors zeroed in on Little Mike (Spanish Steps) and made the GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero the 8-5 favorite despite a pair of no-shows in Dubai, including an 11th in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Mar. 30. The Vaccarezza homebred caught a flyer and was in command within a matter of strides, but he had some company in the form of GII Dixie S. hero Skyring (English Channel), as Big Blue Kitten settled in the final threesome.

The pace, while not hot by any stretch, was contested, and Gary Stevens asked Skyring to go after the front-runner in earnest midway up the backstretch the second time. The result was an internal quarter mile from the six-furlong pole to the half-mile pole in :23.48, and the race was likely lost there. Meanwhile, Joe Bravo and Big Blue Kitten were creeping into contention from behind and made their move up the fence turning for home. Teaks North tipped out with a chance at midstretch, but Big Blue Kitten had all the momentum and raced away late. "It's amazing how much you can learn from one race," Bravo commented. "Looking back, we could have won the last one, but I took what I learned there and used it today. This horse was ready to run the whole way around there today. Little Mike came off the rail just a little in the stretch and we were able to get through. This is a good horse." Trainer Dale Romans was not overly disappointed in the effort of Little Mike. "I was really happy to see how willing he was today," he said. "In Dubai, he never really picked up his feet. Today, you could tell he was back to his old self. This should put him in a good spot for the Arlington Million." Little Mike will attempt to defend in that Aug. 17 event, where he could be joined by Big Blue Kitten.

Hollywood Gold Cup cont.

Never a factor when 12th in the 2012 G1 Dubai World Cup, Game On Dude returned with a vengeance, besting Kettle Corn by better than seven lengths in the GII Californian S. last June ahead of Gold Cup success number one. Caught late by Dullahan (Even the Score) in the GI Pacific Classic Aug. 26, he annexed the race newly named for his sire Sept. 29, but the wheels came off after a slow start in the Nov. 3 GI Breeders' Cup Classic and he finished some 15 lengths behind Fort Larned (E Dubai) in seventh. Instead of going away for the winter, Game On Dude returned in this track's Dec. 1 GIII Native Diver S., named in honor of the three-time Gold Cup winner (1965-67), and he wired the field by 1 1/4 lengths. The dark bay overwhelmed his rivals in his first two appearances of 2013, besting Clubhouse Drive (Candy Ride {Arg}) by 6 1/2 lengths in the GII San Antonio S. Feb. 3 and by 7 3/4 front-running lengths in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 2. With \$1.5 million on the line, Baffert elected to ship Game On Dude to West Virginia for the GII Charles Town Classic Apr. 20, and, although he reportedly skated around the bullring that night, his class got him home a half-length to the good of Clubhouse Ride. Asked for his trademark speed by Mike Smith, Game On Dude led them along through an easy opening quarter mile in :25 flat while tracked by stable companion Sky Kingdom and Clubhouse Ride tightly at the fence, but in close attendance. Oilisblackgold (Tapit) was next, and, despite adding blinkers, Kettle Corn found himself at the tail of the field as they raced into the first turn. There was little change in the plot for the length of the backstretch, as Smith allowed Game On Dude to do his thing, and it was Clubhouse Ride and Joe Talamo who came to apply some pressure as they entered the final turn. That one was soon off the bridle and under a heavy ride, but Kettle Corn was winding up from last for Rafael Bejarano and they charged into a clear second at the quarter pole. Smith threw his mount a few crosses in upper stretch and, though he had to work for it, was always holding Kettle Corn in the waning yards. It was a distance back to Sky Kingdom in third.

Forwardly placed here while three off the inside, Starship Truffles tugged Zayas to the lead at the three-eighths marker, and the team had a couple of lengths on her rivals as they cornered. She switched her leads on cue in upper stretch and was ridden mostly hands and heels for the remainder for her 11th victory from 16 local appearances. Judy the Beauty was one of the last to leave the stalls and appeared to struggle a bit down the backside. But she kept to her task and stayed on well to be second.

A neck second to Close It Out (Closing Argument) in the Jack Dudley Sprint H. over this track and distance Nov. 10, Bahamian Squall defeated that rival into third, with Fort Loudon (Awesome of Course) second, in Gulfstream's Sunshine State S. Dec. 2. The Dizney homebred managed a career-best 102 Beyer in the Sunshine Millions Sprint in Hallandale Jan. 19, but was forced to settle for second behind Off the Jak (With Distinction) and followed that with a close third to Fort Loudon in the GIII Gulfstream Park Sprint Championship Feb. 9. Spelled for four months thereafter, Bahamian Squall resumed in the June 8 Ponche H. on Summit

Bahamian Squall rolled up outside of Justin Phillip (First Samurai) nearing the stretch, leaving Trinniberg in a pocket, and engaged Artefacto at the three-sixteenths. Trinniberg plugged away gamely past a tiring Cajun Breeze to make it a three-way go entering the final furlong, but Bahamian Squall kept finding to win comfortably in the end. Jackson Bend rallied to just miss second. The win secures Bahamian Squall a spot in the field for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint this November. "[Jockey] Luis [Saez] did a great job," said Fawkes, who won the 2010 Smile and Breeders' Cup Sprint with Big Drama (Montbrook). A good battle was waged on the Belmont tote between Flat Out--winner of the last two runnings of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and four of five overall at Big Sandy--and the progressive Last Gunfighter, perfect in six starts since being transferred to the barn of Chad Brown. As it turned out, the only war that was waged was in the market, as Flat Out turned in another masterful performance, despite being taken out of his element. Third to Fort Larned (E Dubai) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last November, the handsome 7-year-old took some time to get his feet under him this term, finishing fourth behind Graydar (Unbridled's Song) when favored in the GI Donn H. Feb. 9 and fifth to that rival in the GII New Orleans H. Mar. 30. The come-from-behinder was ridden much closer to the pace in the GIII Westchester S. going this track's one-turn mile Apr. 27 and was up in the final jump to nail the luckless Cross Traffic (Unbridled's Song), but it was back to one-run tactics in the GI Met Mile May 27, and his last-out third to Sahara Sky (Pleasant Tap) was full of merit. Despite a slight bobble at the break, Percussion (Bluegrass Cat) pushed through to lead them out of the chute, and it was Flat Out who was closest to that one. Alpha (Bernardini), fractious in the gate, raced just in advance of Last Gunfighter, while Fast Falcon brought up the rear early on. The second favorite was the first to be asked a serious question, and they advanced to be within a length of the joint leaders, but Junior Alvarado took a peek behind him and sent Flat Out to the lead three furlongs from the wire. Shaken up in upper stretch, the Preston runner pinched a winning break and went his final furlong in a smart :11.96 to win handily to become just the second multiple winner of the Suburban (Devil His Due, 1993-94). "This obviously was an easier race than the last two," said Hall of Famer Bill Mott. "He ran hard today, but he ran real hard to win [the Westchester] and then he got jostled around a little bit in the Met Mile, which may have cost him something. It's nice to see him bounce back. I figured when he went by that horse on the lead, he was going to be tough to beat from there." The winner is likely to make his next appearance in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 3, a race in which he was third last year to Fort Larned, also a candidate for the race.

Moreno failed to get the money in nine attempts over various surfaces and distances while racing in Southern California, including a second-place finish in a two-turn affair at Santa Anita Apr. 13 and a fourth-place finish over the Betfair Hollywood Park grass May 5. 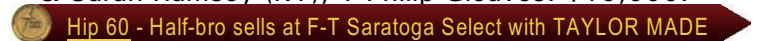

There was a surprise in store here as For the Lads took advantage of the flops of under-performing favorites to lead home a big-priced trifecta. Successful in Turffontein's Listed Ruffian S. Mar. 9, the chestnut was runner-up in the G3 Pretty Polly S. back at that venue three weeks later before finishing off the board in the G2 SA Fillies Nursery Apr. 27. Also unplaced in the G2 Devon Air S. over an extended seven-furlong trip at Clairwood June 8, she bounced back with a staying effort to provide trainer Sean Tarry with a first renewal. Settled in mid-division early, she came alive when the whip was applied in mid-stretch as the market leader Happy Valentine (SAf) (Silvano {Ger}) tried to see off all rivals under positive tactics. As that rival ran out of gas in the final furlong, For the Lads was just getting going and she worked her way to the lead with 75 yards remaining.

***Deja Vu for Van Niekerk...***

For the victorious owner, a second straight July success was a truly emotional moment.

"I had been watching Pomodoro, but I realized at about the 500 [-meter] marker that it wasn't his day, so I began to look for Heavy Metal," said Van Niekerk, who was sporting a red-and-blue repp tie that echoed his silks. "It reminded me of last year, because Pomodoro had the red cap that day, and [winning jockey] S'Manga [Khumalo] had the red cap today. It's remarkable to win it again; I started crying. It's so special on the day that we honor Madiba [Xhosa clan name of Nelson Mandela]. It's remarkable and emotional."

As the horses made their way to the post for the July, the crowd hushed as images of Nelson Mandela flashed across the big screens, and tenor Bongani Thembe sang the national anthem accompanied by a string quartet. Heavy Metal was confidently handled by Khumalo and, as the field spread out at the top of the straight, began to make his run. The 4-year-old poked his head in front with 100 meters remaining and hit the wire a long neck to the good of Run for It (SAf) (Dynasty {SAf}), with the filly Do You Remember (SAf) (Silvano {Ger}) a neck further behind.

"It was a great feeling," said Khumalo. "I'm very happy. He was always going so well. I followed Run for It and I knew no horse could quicken up like [Heavy Metal]."

After the trophies were presented, the silver-haired Niekerk joked that Khumalo's new platinum hair was a tribute to himself.

Sean Tarry trains both Pomodoro and Heavy Metal, but opted to leave Heavy Metal at his Johannesburg base while taking last year's July hero to prep at Durban's Clairwood Racecourse.

"I kept him there because he's comfortable training on the Polytrack and he can also use the treadmill there," Tarry explained. "And training at altitude couldn't hurt. I have a wonderful team back in Johannesburg and they deserve all of the credit."

Though Tarry wasn't present for Heavy Metal's last major work ahead of the July, he managed to keep tabs on his charge.

"S'Manga said he worked very well, but I could only see it on YouTube," Tarry laughed.

Heavy Metal captured the G1 President's Champions Challenge at Turffontein Apr. 27 and won the Pinnacle S. three weeks later at the same course. In his most recent appearance, he was second in the G3 Jubilee H. at Turffontein June 9. Tarry described the 4-year-old as a horse "tailor made for the special day in Hong Kong," but there are no immediate plans to send Heavy Metal overseas.

"We will go back to the drawing board and possibly consider an international campaign, but it's very difficult with all of the regulations," Tarry explained. -MK

All of the pre-race talk had centered on the sensational Happy Valentine (SAf) (Silvano {Ger}), and she attempted to string the field out by taking up the running. However, the chestnut began to shorten stride midway up the straight, and For the Lads outfinished Along Came Polly (SAf) (Judpot) for glory in the 1400-meter test. Both July hero Heavy Metal and For the Lads were bred by the Bosworth Farm Stud operation of Dr. Neil and Lyth Orford, and share an antecedent in the form of Tight Drums (SAf) (Hard Up {Arg}). That Group 1-placed runner is the second dam of Heavy Metal via her daughter Percussion (SAf) (Baroon {GB}), while her other daughter Skin Tight (SAf) (Winter Romance {GB}), a listed winner and twice placed at group level, foaled For the Lads.

"We had always thought highly of her," said Van Niekerk, who is the executive chairman of PG Bison with interests in wood and glass. "She's out of a mare that I raced and she was bred by Bosworth. She won one race, was mad as a March hare, and was retired.

"They're from the same family, the two Group 1 winners," Van Niekerk added. "Both are from the Star Drums family, and Bosworth has done so well with that line. They're a small farm and don't stand stallions, and I think that makes it even more special."

Both For the Lads and Heavy Metal are yearling sales graduates. Heavy Metal was a R250,000 purchase at the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale in 2010, while For the Lads sold for R300,000 at the Cape Premier Yearling Sale 18 months ago. The chestnut filly hails from the third South African crop of Trippi (End Sweep), who left Florida to hold court at Drakenstein Stud in the Western Cape. -MK

### *Hitting the Jackpot...*

July Day was a huge success for freshman sire Judpot, an American-bred son of A.P. Indy and Miesque. The chestnut stallion stands at Varsfontein Stud in the Western Cape, and his son Forest Indigo (SAf) defeated a competitive group in the G1 Durban Golden Horseshoe S. for owner Chris Gerber. Based in Johannesburg, Gerber operates Moutonshoek Stud in Western Cape. Bred by Varsonftein from the Fort Wood mare Albizia, the bay RNA'd for R125,000 at the Cape Premier Yearling Sale, but a few months later sold for R160,000 at the Emperors Palace National Yearling Sale. Judpot was also represented by Along Came Polly (SAf), who was runner-up to For the Lads in the Golden Slipper. Along Came Polly was a R60,000 yearling at the Emperors Palace Sale. -MK

### *A Thing of Beauty...*

The G1 Garden Province S. was regarded as the deepest field on the July card, and the race lived up to its billing. Shanks Syndicate's Beach Beauty (SAf) (Dynasty {SAf}) figured to have a tough time of it from her 16 post, but the popular bay mare came knifing through to claim the prize. Having acquitted herself admirably against males in both the G1 J&B Met and the G1 Rising Sun Gold Challenge S., Beach Beauty recorded her 12th win from 23 outings, and yesterday's prize money took her earnings over the R3-million mark.

"She's just so brilliant," said winning rider Sean Carmack. "Her acceleration is top drawer. The boss [trainer Dennis Drier] just keeps her ticking over race to race."

Drier added, "I was always concerned about the 16, but Sean said 'leave it to me,' and they've come through."

Beach Beauty was bred by Trevor Armitage, and races in the name of Shanks Syndicate. The group was formed to honor the early passing of Armitage's son Mark. -MK

Victorious in the Black Gold S. in his seasonal unveiling over soft turf at the Fair Grounds Mar. 2, he missed by a neck to the talented Jack Milton (War Front) in the grassy GIII Transylvania S. Apr. 5 before besting GIII Coolmore Lexington S. hero Winning Cause (Giant's Causeway) in the Marine last time out. Anything close to that effort should take this. Jockey Eurico Rosa da Silva won back-to-back Queen's Plates, with Sam-Son's Eye of the Leopard (A.P. Indy) in 2009 and Big Red Mike (Tenpins) the following year. Inglorious (Hennessy) parlayed victory in the 2011 Woodbine Oaks into Queen's Plate glory, and Chiefswood Stable's **Nipissing**, by its 2004 Plate winner Niigon, will look to follow suit. The bay filly is five out of six at Woodbine, her only defeat coming at the hands of Coffee Clique (Medaglia d'Oro) when runner-up in the GIII Selene S. May 19. But she was able to bounce back in the Oaks, handing **Spring in the Air** (Spring At Last) a 3/4-length defeat. **Dynamic Sky** (Sky Mesa), part of an uncoupled John Oxley entry, retains the services of Kentucky Derby-winning jockey Joel Rosario. The dark bay colt, third two back in the seven-furlong Queenston S. May 11, exits a hard-fought victory from **His Race to Win** (Stormy Atlantic) and **Midnight Aria** (Midnight Lute) in the June

## FEAR IVAN

Gestut Schlenderhan has been responsible for two of the last six winners of the G1 Sparda Deutsches Derby at Hamburg and the famed black, blue and red will be sported by the favorite in today's edition in **Ivanhowe (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}). Having taken the main trial --the 11-furlong G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen-- by 2 1/2 lengths from Gestut Ebbesloh's re-opposing **Empoli (Ger)** (Halling) and Thomas Schaffer's **Schulz (Ger)** (Rail Link {GB}) back in fourth at Cologne June 16, the Wilhelm Giedt-trained homebred probably deserves his market prominence. Heading the opposition is Stall Nizza's **Nicolosio (Ire)** (Peintre Celebre), who warmed up for this with a seven-length triumph in the May 20 Listed Grosser Preis der Hannoverschen Volksbank also over 11 furlongs, and who is a close relative to the 2005 Derby hero Nicaron (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}) and Stall Hornoldendorf's G3 Bavarian Classic winner **Lucky Speed (Ire)** (Silvano {Ger}). He represents the Peter Schiergen stable along with Empoli, and was staying on strongly at the end of that 10-furlong Munich trial May 26. Gestut Auenquelle's **Global Bang (Ger)** (Manduro {Ger}) would have arguably won the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) had he not chartered a wayward path in that Cologne Classic last time May 20. If he stays this trip, he is a major player.

The New York-bred was fifth in a blanket finish in Keeneland's GIII Shakertown S. Apr. 13 and third to Night Officer (Officer) after setting the pace in the May 16 Around the Cape S. at Belmont.

His last may be forgiven, a last-of-five effort in the Jaipur S. rained off the grass in Elmont June 7. **Rothko** (Arch) brings plenty of back class into this turf debut. Winner of last year's GIII Aristides S. on the main track, the Padua homebred set the pace in defense of his title in that event June 1 before settling for third. He's bred well-enough for the surface switch and will offer some value against more-proven turf sprinters.

Hughes was originally slated to partner G1 King's Stand S. ninth **Shamexpress (NZ)** (O'Reilly {NZ}), but will get the leg-up on the King's Stand fifth after intended rider Gerald Mosse was sidelined with a fractured collarbone in a recent Hong Kong spill. "We are delighted to have Richard's services, he is a great jockey and we are very pleased to have him," trainer Clive Cox told *Racing Post*.

## SALES NEWS

### EXPECTATIONS HIGH FOR JRHA SALE

Two days before Japan's most prestigious sale was set to begin at the Northern Horse Park in Hokkaido, the smile on Teruya Yoshida's face perhaps was the best barometer for the auction.

Typically conservative in his estimations and never one to get carried away with enthusiasm, Yoshida's

playful grin blossomed into a beam as he greeted guests in his office on the sunny afternoon of July 6.

"There have been many, many inspections of the horses--maybe double the number of last year," said the master of Shadai Farm and the vice chairman of

the Japan Racing Horse Association, which conducts the two-session select sale of yearlings and foals.

"I don't know if that's a good thing, but it's certainly not a bad thing," he said with a chuckle, adding that he would be happy if last year's sale results--the most robust since 2007--were equaled this year.

All the signs, however, point to the possibility of even greater returns in 2013. A number of new buyers are expected to gather at the Northern Horse Park sale pavilion, led by one of the most aggressive young participants in global racing, Qatar's Sheikh Fahad bin Abdullah Al Thani, who is making his first foray to Japan's premier bloodstock market. Accompanied by his racing manager, David Redvers, Sheikh Fahad was busy on July 6 looking at foals at Shadai and Northern Farms, as well as the sires at the Shadai Stallion Station.

"Each time I have seen them at the races in Europe, I have asked them to come to Japan," Yoshida said of Sheikh Fahad and his contingent. "So, now they come."

Australian-based Paul Fudge of Waratah Thoroughbreds, joined by his American bloodstock advisor David Ingordo, also was inspecting horses at the Yoshidas' farms. Last year, Fudge paid ¥145 million (*US\$1,790,124*) to acquire a full sister to 2012 G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) winner Deep Brillante (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), and another full sister is consigned by Dr. Harry Sweeney's Paca Paca Farm to this year's foal session.

New domestic buyers also are expected to be on hand this year in the wake of the Japan Racing Association's recent decision to relax some rules regarding minimum assets and income levels for owner licensing eligibility. With more people now able to seek owners' licenses for the rich JRA circuit, there should be a higher demand for Japan's top yearlings and foals, Yoshida noted.

A total of 489 horses have been consigned to the sale, with 261 yearlings entered for the July 8 session to begin at 10 a.m. local time and 228 foals to follow on July 9 in another session starting at 10 a.m. The Yoshida family has dominated this sale since its inception in 1998, and this year is no exception. With 140 horses (70 yearlings and 70 foals) from Katsumi Yoshida's Northern Farm--the perennial sale leader--another 135 (86 yearlings and 49 foals) from Shadai Farm and three yearlings and four foals from Haruya Yoshida's Oiwake Farm, the Yoshida brothers claim 57.7% of all the horses consigned. Apart from the consistency of the Yoshidas' dominion, this year's catalog appears to stand out as the most diverse and high quality in sale history for several reasons.

The Japanese sire ranks have become deeper in recent years as breeders and owners have continued to seek out new recruits from abroad while developing more homebred international-caliber runners who have recently been retired to stud. At the same time, the Yoshida brothers and others have waged a worldwide campaign to acquire the best broodmares with a variety of bloodlines to breed to their many Sunday Silence line stallions, and some of those mares' offspring are highlights in this year's sale catalog.

For example, Teruya Yoshida's Lily of the Valley (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}), winner of the G1 Prix de l'Opera in 2010, will be represented by her first foal, a brown colt by Deep Impact, in the foal session. Catalogued as [Hip 410](#), the flashy youngster with four white legs and a white stripe will enter the ring with a reserve price of ¥100 million (about *US\$1 million*), although he is less than four months old and still with his dam.

"Most people say this is a super looking colt," Yoshida said. "I am a lucky man to have him."

Deep Impact is the world's leading sire by progeny earnings and has become the successor to his sire, Sunday Silence, who topped the Japanese general sire list a record 13 times. As Deep Impact has ascended, breeders are opting in large measure to hang on to his offspring, as only 13 yearlings and 17 foals by the hot sire--who typically covers more than 200 mares annually--have been entered in the sale, which will dictate very high prices for many, Yoshida predicted.

The stallion's other sale offspring include yearling colts out of American Grade I winners Persistently (Smoke Glacken), Laragh (Tapit) and Ave (GB) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}), and colt foals out of 2002 Horse of the Year Azeri (Jade Hunter) and 2007 GI Apple Blossom winner Ermine (Exchange Rate).

New sires with international credentials also are stepping in to fill the catalog. G1 Dubai World Cup winner and Japanese champion Victoire Pisa (Jpn) (Neo Universe {Jpn}); European

champion Workforce (GB) (King's Best), winner of the G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and American Grade II winner Casino Drive (Mineshaft), a half brother to GI Belmont S. winners Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy) and Jazil (Seeking the Gold), all are represented by individuals from their first crops. Victoire Pisa and Workforce each have 13 offspring in the catalog, while Casino Drive has three. Danon Chantilly (Jpn) (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}), a record-setting Group 1 winner in Japan, has seven foals from his first crop in the sale.

Other sires and dams will be highly recognizable anywhere in the world. Empire Maker (Unbridled)--who has been widely supported since beginning duty in Japan in 2011--has 13 yearlings and 16 foals in the catalog. American-based sires Bernardini, Big Brown, Elusive Quality, Giant's Causeway, Tapit and Unbridled's Song also have offspring entered for the sale, as does European-based Sea The Stars (Ire) and Australian-Irish shuttler Fastnet Rock (Aus).

Harbinger (GB), who was rated the world's best racehorse in 2010, leads all sires with 38 offspring in the sale, including 18 yearlings from his first crop and 20 foals, and he is followed by two-time leading Japanese sire King Kamehameha (Jpn), who has 15 yearlings and 17 foals for a total of 32 sale entries.

Some of the headline offerings by King Kamehameha, who ranks second only to Deep Impact among leading Japanese sires this year as he did in 2012, include a yearling colt who is the first foal out of GI Alcibiades S. winner Wickedly Perfect (Congrats) and a filly foal out of GI Mother Goose S. and GI Coaching Club American Oaks winner Spoken Fur (Notebook).

***New Kids on the Block...***

The first offspring of exceptional racehorses always are eagerly awaited in the sale ring, and buyers at this year's Japan Racing Horse Association select sale will have the chance to bid on the initial foals by international Group 1 winners Victoire Pisa (Jpn) (Neo Universe {Jpn}) and Workforce (GB) (King's Best).

Both stallions are earning rave reviews when it comes to the conformation and size of members of their first crops, and both will be represented by 13 foals in the July 9 JRHA select sale session.

"Victoire Pisa is going to be a nice stallion," said Teruya Yoshida, the owner of Shadai Farm who has strongly supported the 2011 winner of G1 Dubai World Cup and Japanese champion at three and four. "They are very correct and they look strong. They are good-moving horses, well made and with good legs, and that means everything."

Some of the most intriguing offerings by Victoire Pisa, a handsome and robust 17-hand grandson of Sunday

Silence, include [Hip 398](#), a dark bay or brown colt out of G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) winner Erimo Excel (Rodrigo de Triano); [Hip 406](#), a brown filly out of Canadian champion Magic Code (Lost Code); [Hip 437](#), a bay colt out of May Kiersey (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a three-quarter sister to G1 Epsom Derby winner Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and a full sister to Group 3 winner and G1 Prix de Diane runner-up Gagnoa (Ire); [Hip 478](#), a bay colt out of American Grade II-placed Honestly Darling (Kingmambo), a half sister to the dam of

Japanese champion and sire Gold Allure (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), and [Hip 493](#), a dark bay or brown colt out of Dream of Genie (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}), a half sister to the dam of GI Ashland S. winner Emollient (Empire Maker) from the immediate family of French champions Coup de Genie (Mr. Prospector) and Bago (Fr) (Nashwan) and Group 1 winners Denebola (Storm Cat) and Maxios (GB) (Monsun {Ger}).

The foals of Workforce also are impressive, tending to be correct and strong.

"They are big and look to be stayer types," Yoshida said. "I think he is going to be a good stallion too."

Winner of the G1 Epsom Derby in record time in only his third career start and also winner of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe as a 3-year-old, Workforce has been popular in Japan as a high-quality representative of the Kingmambo sire line, which has worked so well via top stallion King Kamehameha (Jpn) with daughters of Sunday Silence.


