MIDNIGHT ARIA HITS HIGH NOTE IN PLATE

Tucci Stables's **Midnight Aria** (Midnight Lute) tired to third after setting the pace in the June 9 Plate Trial, but the bay refused to fold in the main event, holding off favored **Up With the Birds** (Stormy Atlantic) to earn a gritty victory in the 154th Queen's Plate at Woodbine Sunday.

The 16-1 outsider bobbled a bit at the break, but recovered to set the pace unchallenged through fractions of :24.63, :48.58 and 1:13.65. He shook loose from a host of challengers early on the turn and carried a 3 1/2-length advantage into the stretch. But he began to tire precipitously just as Up With the Birds, mired in traffic on the final bend, was hitting top gear and the bay had just enough left to hold on for the fast-diminishing half-length victory.

"I could see [Up With the Birds] coming and I could feel him," admitted winning rider Jesse Campbell. "I was praying for the wire."

Veteran owners Lou and Carlo Tucci were celebrating their first Queen's Plate success. "My uncle and I have been chasing this dream for over 40 years and it's hard to express what you feel when a dream comes true," said Lou Tucci. "It's like the seventh game final of the Stanley Cup and scoring the winning goal times a thousand." **Cont. p3**

OPTIMISM ABOUNDS AHEAD OF JRHA SALE

As champagne flowed during a presale party on the evening of July 7, the mood among buyers and sellers preparing for the Japan Racing Horse Association select auction of yearlings and foals could not have been bubblier.

With Japan's economy growing stronger, new buyers on the scene--including Qatar's Sheikh Fahad bin Abdullah Al Thani--and an enticing group of horses catalogued, a sense that something extraordinary is about to happen pervaded Hokkaido's Northern Horse Park.

"We are very much proud of this year's catalog--it's the very best ever," said Naohiro Goda, who helps coordinate international participation in the sale and also serves on the horse selection committee, while officially opening the party for the auction's 16th edition. "So, I am very sure you can find a horse to buy on Monday or Tuesday." **Cont. p7**

LUCKY SPEEDS TO GERMAN DERBY WIN

Lucky Speed (Ire) (Silvano {Ger}) swooped late to take the G1 Deutsches Derby by 3/4 lengths at Hamburg Sunday. The sophomore adopted his usual waiting tactics off the pace and settled in a position slightly worse than mid-division through the early tribulations before inching into contention exiting the backstraight. Roused along on the sweeping home turn, he challenged wide approaching the final furlong and was driven out to score in game fashion. "It was a hard decision, but I am glad I picked the right horse," commented rider Andrasch Starke. "I always had a good relationship with Lucky Speed and he really ran a blinder of a race." **Cont. p3**

Unraced as a juvenile, **Lucky Speed** broke through going an extended nine furlongs at Cologne in his first start Apr. 1, but was compromised by a tardy break when second in the G3 Fruhjahrs-Preis des Bankhauses Metzler trying 10 furlongs at Frankfurt Apr. 28. He remained at that distance when annexing the May 26 G3 Bavarian Classic at Munich last time, and emulated former winners of that contest **Athenagoras (Ger)**, **Acatenango (Ger)** and **Samum (Ger)** by securing Germany's premier Classic. In doing so, the bay provided jockey **Andrasch Starke** with a sixth renewal, and trainer **Peter Schiergen** with a fourth. "There was a lot of early pace, so I just left him to find his legs, and I had a really good feeling we'd go close on the final turn," **Starke** said. "This feels like my first Derby success and to win in Hamburg is always great." Trainer **Peter Schiergen**, added, "We had recognized his talent as a juvenile and he was always travelling well and in a good position here. When they were rounding the final turn I already had a good feeling, and it proved correct."

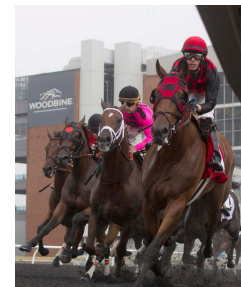

Midnight Aria was claimed from **Lobdell Family Stables** and trainer **Steven Dwoskin** for \$35,000 out of a runner-up effort in a Jan. 24 maiden race over the **Gulfstream** lawn. He returned to graduate in an off-the-turf maiden special weight in **Hallandale** Feb. 16. Since that graduation, the colt had turned in four straight third-place efforts, two in **Gulfstream** turf optional claimers, and then again in the **May 5 Wando S.** and finally in the **Plate Trial**.

Solid Appeal, who ended 2012 with a fourth-place effort in the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs, returned with an off-the-turf allowance win at Keeneland Apr. 24 and was coming off a 1 1/2-length victory in the May 25 GII Nassau S. The dark bay filly broke alertly and was taken in hand to shadow pacesetters Coffee Clique (Medaglia d'Oro) and Hard Not to Like (Hard Spun) down the backstretch. She reeled in Coffee Clique and assumed control at midstretch and surged clear in the final furlong as Julie's Love closed for second. Favored Irish Mission (Giant's Causeway) rated in mid-pack and never offered a serious threat, finishing seventh. "Wow is all I have to say, she just ran huge," said winning rider Jesse Campbell. "Just like her race six weeks [ago], she popped out of the gate running. We weren't going that fast and she was very comfortable. She just travelled so well to the quarter pole and when I asked her, she actually moved quicker than I thought she was going to. I didn't want to make the lead that soon, but thank God I had that much horse. She just raced so hard to the wire. This horse is as confident as a horse can get."

Go Blue or Go Home, whose only two career losses came at starts over a mile, ended his sophomore campaign with a four-length win over the Churchill lawn in a five-furlong allowance Nov. 8 and he returned to take his stakes debut in the June 10 Karl Boyes Memorial S. over Presque Isle Downs's Tapeta surface last time out. The bay gelding broke sharply in this off-the-turf event and was soon at the head of affairs. He zipped through fractions of :22.08 and :44.88 and skipped clear through the raindrops in upper stretch before storming home an easy winner to give jockey Luis Contreras his fifth victory on the Queen's Plate card.

Optimism Abounds Ahead of JRHA Sale (cont. from p1)

Noting the sultry sun that baked the bustling sale grounds as buyers scurried to complete inspections, JRHA Chairman Taro Kono said: "I trust the sale also will be very hot. I hope everyone will bring a Japanese racehorse home to race."

Buyers indeed seemed ready to take up the challenge.

"We are very excited," said trainer Mitsumasa Nakauchida, who is working with Sheikh Fahad and his racing manager David Redvers to begin building a Japanese-based stable. Sheikh Fahad plans to seek a Japan Racing Association owner's license and to campaign around 20 horses on the JRA circuit in the coming years. Nakauchida accompanied Sheikh Fahad as he inspected about 10 yearlings on a short list his team prepared.

With so much activity in the barn area, consignor Dr. Harry Sweeney of Paca Paca Farm voiced only sunshine in his upbeat sale forecast.

"There have been plenty of lookers," Sweeney noted. "The Japanese economy has been doing well, and for the first time in years, there is optimism in Japan across the board. It might be a little soon for that to trickle down to the horse business, but I think there will be a lot of good years ahead for Japan. I'm more bullish than I have been in years."

Last year, Sweeney sold a Deep Impact (Jpn) filly foal who is a full sister to 2012 G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby) winner Deep Brillante (Jpn) for ¥145 million (*US\$1,790,124*), a record for any consignor not part of the Shadai Group of farms owned by the Yoshida family that traditionally dominates the sale. This year, Sweeney will offer another full sister to Deep Brillante as one of a seven-member Paca Paca foal consignment set to sell on July 9 following nine youngsters in today's yearling session.

Australian-based owner Paul Fudge bought the Paca Paca filly in 2012 and has returned with his buying team, including Kentucky-based bloodstock agent David Ingordo, for this year's JRHA sale. While attending the party, Ingordo said Fudge's short list included up to 15 horses.

"This sale is as advertised--a very good bunch of horses, and everything vets very well," Ingordo declared, adding that he expects tough competition in bidding for the best yearlings and foals. "They do a top-flight job with the horses, and it shows--they have people from all over the world coming here now to buy their horses."

Another Australian owner, Phil Sly, also has returned to the sale and, like Fudge, now has a JRA owner's license. "This sale just keeps going up and up and up," Sly said, referring to the quality of the horses consigned.

Records could be possible during today's yearling session, as 261 horses have been catalogued and only four were listed as withdrawn by the eve of the sale. Last year, 202 yearlings sold from a then-record 242 offered and established a record gross of ¥5,452,600,000 (about US\$67,316,049). Average price increased 12.5% from 2011 to 2012, hitting ¥26,993,069 (about US\$333,248), and eight yearlings sold for the equivalent of more than \$1 million. The two-day 2012 JRHA sale produced gross of ¥10,296,300,000 (US\$127,114,815), up 12.2% from 2011 and the highest since 2007, when the global economic crisis began to shake the Thoroughbred business worldwide. The JRHA sale record gross was achieved in 2006 when 109 yearlings and 221 foals were sold for a combined total of ¥11,754,500,000.

The sale is set to begin at 10 a.m. local time today.

He's had a couple of hard races in a short space of time so we will certainly just give him 10 days and look and see how he seems."

Southern Equine Stable's **Moreno** (Ghostzapper) came out of his seven-length victory in Saturday's GII Dwyer S. in fine shape and is expected to ship to Saratoga Monday. The colt has a few options for his next start. "We'll go to some sort of Derby with him, whether it's the [Aug. 24 GI] Travers S., the [Aug. 3 GII] West Virginia Derby, the [Sept. 7 GII] Super Derby," said trainer Eric Guillot. "There are a bunch of options this time of year. We'll see who is going where before we make a decision."

JACOBSON BREAKS BELMONT RECORD

Trainer David Jacobson broke the Belmont Park spring/summer meet record for wins when Abra (Elusive Quality) won Sunday's sixth race. Abra was Jacobson's 41st winner at the meet, breaking the record of 40 set by Todd Pletcher in 2003. "It's very rewarding," said Jacobson. "I'm very fortunate to be here and have my horses run as well as they are. It's an honor to be mentioned in the same breath as Todd Pletcher. This isn't supposed to happen--we're a claiming outfit, mostly, so we're supposed to do well at Aqueduct, not at Belmont during the spring and summer. But this gives our whole outfit momentum going into Saratoga." Jacobson, son of trainer Howard "Buddy" Jacobson, has won six NYRA meet titles and finished 2012 tied atop the leader board with 110 wins at Aqueduct Racetrack, Belmont Park, and Saratoga Race Course. "It's been all about putting the whole package together; it's not any one thing," Jacobson added. "I have my brother [Doug] working with me, and he has been claiming good horses every day. I have the best owners anybody can have who allow me to run my horses where I believe they should run and win. I'm fortunate enough to have riders like David Cohen, Joel Rosario, and the other really good jockeys ride for me, and they ride hard. And my staff is the key, Paul Wilson, Frank LaBocchetta, the list goes on."



HONG KONG NEWS

MILITARY ATTACK HK HORSE OF THE YEAR

Military Attack (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}), winner of the G1 Audemars Piguet QEI Cup and G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, was crowned Hong Kong's Horse of the Year for 2012/13 at the Hong Kong Jockey Club's Champion Awards ceremony at Sha Tin Racecourse yesterday. The 5-year-old, conditioned by John Moore, also took Champion Middle Distance honors, and was voted Hong Kong's Most Popular Horse of the Year by the public. Military Attack notched a total of five victories over the season, and his Singapore Cup victory marked the first for a Hong Kong-trained horse in that country's flagship contest, and also the first international Group 1 win for his trainer.

Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}), Horse of the Year the past two seasons, was named Champion Miler. The 6-year-old won three of six starts this season, including the G1 Longines Hong Kong Mile.

California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}), who made history by becoming the first back-to-back winner of the G1 Longines Hong Kong Cup, was crowned Champion Stayer, while G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint winner **Lucky Nine (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) was named Champion Sprinter. **All You Wish (NZ)** (Thorn Park {Aus}) was named Champion Griffin.

While the trainer's championship will come down to the final meet of the season at Happy Valley Wednesday, Douglas Whyte has already secured a record 13th consecutive jockey's title on the merit of 100 victories. Dicky Lui was named Champion Apprentice Jockey. **Bullish Friend (Aus)** (Court Command {Aus}), earned the 2011/12 HK\$1-million Hong Kong Sale Bonus.

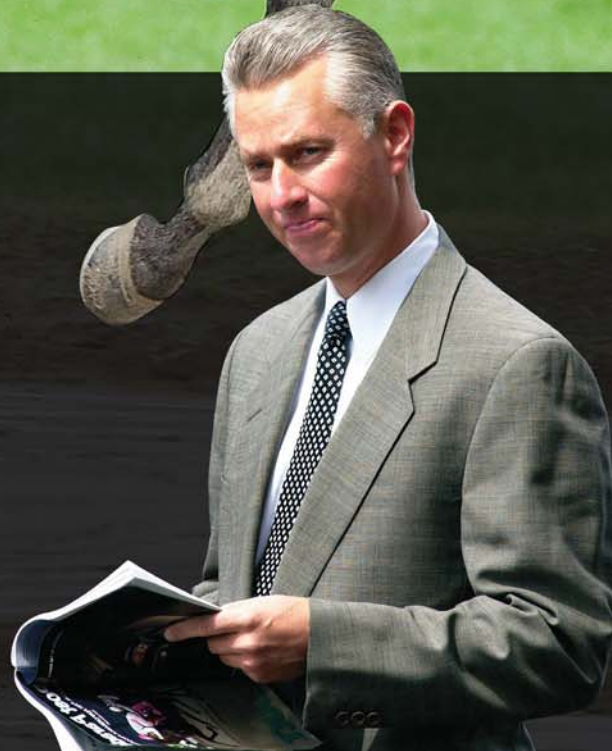
