July Cup would represent as much of a breakthrough for South African racing as that of Agnes World (Danzig) was for Japan in the millennium year. Having mastered **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) in both the Mar. 9 Listed Meydan Sprint and G1 Al Quoz Sprint three weeks later, he failed to re-affirm his superiority over that rival last time in Royal Ascot's G1 King's Stand S. June 18. Only a neck

BOISTEROUS HAS BIG SHOES TO FILL

With stablemate and fellow Phipps representative Point of Entry (Dynaformer) on the sidelines and unable to defend his 2012 title, **Boisterous** (Distorted Humor) will step up in search of his first Grade I victory in today's Man o' War S. at Belmont Park. The 6-year-old sports an 8-5-0-2 record on the Elmont lawn and a 4-3-0-1 mark at this 1 3/8-mile distance. He has finished no worse than second since last October when he took the local Gill Knickerbocker S. going nine panels. The dark bay kicked off 2013 with a runner-up finish to controlling speed Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) in Keeneland's Gill Ben Ali S. on the Polytrack Apr. 21, and exits a victory over Big Blue Kitten (Kitten's Joy) in the Gill Monmouth S. June 9. Big Blue Kitten annexed the GI United Nations S. a week ago back in Oceanport. **Cont. p7**

'CAPPING CONUNDRUM AT COLONIAL

A case can be made for--or against--as many of eight of the sophomore colts and geldings signed on for tonight's GII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs. **Rydilluc** (Medaglia d'Oro) is a deserving morning-line favorite with a perfect record in four starts on the turf. The striking bay colt dominated **Charming Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) by 3 1/2 lengths in the Gill Palm Beach S. at Gulfstream Mar. 3, then made the majority of the pace in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 13 at Keeneland before finishing fourth, derailing any shot at a Kentucky Derby run. He enters this off a 3/4-length defeat of Charming Kitten in the inaugural Penn Mile June 1, but he, like several others in this heat, must answer the 10-furlong question. **Cont. p9**

'KATE' PROVES 'ELUSIVE'

Last year's G1 Prix Rothschild winner Elusive Kate had shown a tendency to wander left on several

occasions, including when successful in the 2011 G1 Prix Marcel Bousac at Longchamp, and that trait was in evidence again here as she carried her sole serious rival Sky Lantern across the track inside the final quarter mile to prompt an inevitable inquiry. After several

minutes of protestation from the arguably unlucky runner-up's rider Richard Hughes and deliberation from the stewards, the result was left to stand and Teruya Yoshida's flagbearer had a third top-level success in the books. Elusive Kate has demonstrated her effectiveness from the front, as she had done at her favored Deauville and also when runner-up on unfavorably slow ground behind **Giofra (Fr)** (Dansili {GB}) in this race 12 months ago. Subsequently third adopting those tactics in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois in August, she was forced to play catch-up when second in the G1 Sun Chariot S. after missing the kick on the Rowley Mile here the following month before filling third spot once again under positive tactics in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot on Champions' Day. **Cont. p3**


Fitter for her return fourth in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 18, she was allowed to set steady splits under William Buick here as Hughes sent Sky Lantern to within a length and a half. Injecting winning pace from the three to the two-furlong pole, Elusive Kate drifted steadily left as she bossed her larger rival, who even received a blow across the nose with Buick's stick in the process. While there was little doubt that she was holding the runner-up all the way to the line, the inconvenience suffered by the vanquished would have seen the result reversed in the majority of racing nations other than this one. "She hung to her left and I ended up taking Richard with me, but she beat her fair and square," Buick protested immediately afterwards. "She's done it all her life and costs herself a lot of ground by doing it, but she keeps winning and has never run a bad race. She's an absolute joy for a jockey to ride." Gosden added, "She always drifts left and did it when she won the Prix Marcel Boussac. It's a habit of hers and that's probably why she likes Deauville so much, as she can pop onto the left rail there.

She has a great turn of foot and caught them all at it coming out of the 'dip' and when they've drifted across the track together, William has had the stick in his left hand the whole way and there's been no contact. She's a great filly and made all like that against really good fillies in France in the Prix Rothschild and loves to bowl along. There is a ton of talent there, but [she] has run against the colts a lot and it's nice to be back among the fillies. She's tough and very powerful--she's as wide as she is tall and you'd have to be thrilled with her attitude. We never had a spring this year and there are no good races for these fillies until Royal Ascot, where she could have run in the Duke of Cambridge and won but went for the Queen Anne. The races for her are from now on, and the [July 28] Prix Rothschild is an obvious one to go for and after that there are races like the G1 Matron S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 7]. We might even want to go for a Breeders' Cup Mile later on." Sky Lantern's connections were taking events on the chin afterwards. "I'm waving the white flag, because the other horse is under my nose and there's nothing I can do," Hughes told *PA Sport*. "She got whipped in the face as well. It's a shame, as she's the one who has the bad habit and I'm the sufferer." Richard Hannon Jr added, "She has run a good race and that's racing. The stewards' decision is not going to change--that's life and we'll have to come back and worry about winning the next time. She'll have a short break now, and then will come back for the Matron and then the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf."

Unbeaten over six furlongs after contesting a maiden on the Rowley Mile here May 16 and conditions event at Yarmouth 12 days later, Lucky Kristale ran sixth in a deep renewal of Royal Ascot's G3 Albany S. June 21 and underlined the quality of that race by winning this competitive affair with real authority. Held up initially by Tom Queally off the fast early fractions, the bay eased into contention as the pace started

to collapse before the quarter pole and scythed between rivals to lead at the furlong marker before drawing away from the laboring favorite Rizeena.

"There was a good even tempo, so I was content to sit just a little bit off the pace as they went very fast in the Albany and she was to the fore that day," Queally explained. "[Trainer] George [Margaron] just said we should take our time today and use her turn of foot. She's got the scope to improve some more, so she's an exciting prospect and we're going to have plenty more fun with her." Her conditioner added, "People didn't realize how upset I was at Royal Ascot, as this filly is just a machine. She bounced the gates at Ascot and didn't get home. There's no doubt a Group 1 is just around the corner for her. She is so laid-back and a pleasure to train." Rizeena's trainer Clive Brittain told *PA Sport*, "She tried hard, but she was sort of lugging to the left and not quite going through. Take no credit away from the winner, though. There'll be other days, and we might look at the G1 Moyglare Stud S. [at The Curragh Sept. 1] now."

main pack towards the far rail early, she took time to pick up but ground her way to the front with 100 yards remaining and was too strong for last year's winner Gracia Directa in the run to the line.

Mike de Kock had warned before the Royal meeting that Shea Shea might improve for the experience, and he believes that is the case, with his only concern being the trip. "He's been great for us and South African breeding, but this is a tough race," he said. "At Ascot, we produced our horse at the right time, but it wasn't to be. I'm pretty confident that five furlongs suits best and it's not an easy six furlongs either, plus he's a hold-up horse who gets lazy in front so Christophe [Soumillon] is going to need nerve. We've come a long way not to try and he's definitely got the ability." Two who will relish this six furlongs are the June 22 G1 Diamond Jubilee S. first and second **Lethal Force (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) and **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), with the former looking to confirm a two-length beating in that race. Previously, Alan Craddock's grey was a head second in receipt of five pounds from Simon Gibson's dual Group 1 winner in the G2 Duke of York S. May 15, and it is hard to predict how the cards will fall this time. "I expressed before that he has really blossomed from three to four and that is clearly visible in the standard of performance we have been able to see so far," trainer Clive Cox explained. "He improved markedly from that great run in the Duke of York and we were on level weights at Ascot, so we clearly upped our game a bit and he's in similar form to that. In his work at home, he switches off beautifully so we are not bound by any decisions in that respect. Reading the horse's body language and the way he has trained since he came back from Ascot, I'm very confident." Aidan O'Brien brought Mozart (Ire) here in 2001 and Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Gale Force Ten (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) has an eerily similar profile to that high-class performer. Second in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 25, he went on to take the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 19, and his trainer is hoping for a repeat of history. "He's run over six furlongs, it was seven at Ascot and he's run over a mile," he commented. "It's a big drop back, but it will be interesting. He's a bit in the Mozart mold, really. Mozart was second in an Irish Guineas, just won the Jersey S. at Ascot and then came back here." Also dropping back in trip is Lawrie Inman's **Sovereign Debt (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}), having finished runner-up in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. May 18 and ninth in the June 18 G1 Queen Anne S. over a mile.

The likely favorite could face his sternest test from Calumet Farm's **Optimizer** (English Channel). The D. Wayne Lukas trainee was second behind Horse of the Year

Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in Churchill's G1 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. May 4, and a close-up third in Pimlico's GII Dixie S. May 18.

He stretched Point of Entry to 1 1/2 lengths when second in the G1 Woodford Reserve Manhattan H. over yielding going here last time June 8.

Moyglare Stud homebred **Speaking of Which (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) rates an upset glance as he gets more ground to work with. A Group 3 winner by nine lengths at The Curragh for Dermot Weld last May, Speaking of Which ran on late to be second in Santa Anita's GII Twilight Derby on Breeders' Cup Friday Nov. 2, but was a distant last in the G1 Hollywood Derby Nov. 25.

Subsequently transferred to Christophe Clement, the dark bay was last of six in the 8 1/2-furlong GIII Fort Marcy H. May 4 before a confidence-building optional claiming score over the same trip at Monmouth June 21. "I ran him in the Fort Marcy, and I made a big mistake," admitted Clement. "He should have gone farther. They went very quickly and he was always one-paced." Of his charge's most recent outing, the conditioner offered, "It was an easy race, but I thought it went well. He was very impressive. It was a perfect race, mentally, for him, and he came back in very good order."

THE FABRE FACTOR

While the G1 Grand Prix de Paris has assumed many guises throughout its long history, one recent constant has been the domination of trainer Andre Fabre, and he seeks a 12th renewal in today's Juddmonte-sponsored renewal with a talented trio. They include the highly progressive **Flintshire (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who carries the famed pink-and-green of the race's supporters as Rail Link (GB) did with success in 2006. Like that former stable star, the homebred captured the G3 Prix du Lys at Chantilly June 16, and the authority that he stamped on that contest on relatively fast ground conditions suggested he could be destined for similar heights to his predecessor. "He's stepping up in class, but we hope he can keep progressing, as he was very impressive in the Prix du Lys last time," the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. Joining him is Prince Faisal's May 4 G2 Prix Greffulhe scorer **Ocovango (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}), who was suffering defeat for the first time when fifth in the June 1 G1 Epsom Derby, and the unexposed June 14 Listed Derby du Languedoc winner **Au Revoir (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}), who races for Australia's OTI Management. That operation's Terry Henderson said, "We're hopeful more than confident with him, because the horse is jumping up a long way in class from listed level to a Group 1. Andre Fabre is a very astute trainer and he wanted to run him, so he's not just going around for the practice." Aidan O'Brien has won this twice and relies on **Battle of Marengo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who tries again at the top level after finishing fourth at Epsom and runner-up in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot June 21. The cheekpieces that were on for those outings are now replaced with blinkers, suggesting that the G2 Beresford S. and G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial winner is beginning to frustrate his illustrious connections. "He's in good form, everything is good," the Ballydoyle conditioner said. "He hasn't done a lot [since Ascot], but we're happy with him."

TURF TRY FOR EMOLLIENT IN AMERICAN OAKS

Juddmonte homebred **Emollient** (Empire Maker) ships cross-country and tries the turf in this evening's G1 American Oaks. The Bill Mott trainee has alternated between losses and victories in her first seven starts, and is due for a win if that pattern continues. She kicked off 2012 with a sloppy Gulfstream allowance score in February, but finished fifth beaten 30 lengths when Dreaming of Julia (A.P. Indy) freaked in the Mar. 30 GII Gulfstream Park Oaks. Brought back just a week later, Emollient looked like a different horse when she aired by nine lengths on the Polytrack in Keeneland's G1 Ashland S. Apr. 6. But the bay again disappointed last time, finishing a distant sixth at 3-5 in Pimlico's GII Black-eyed Susan S. May 17. With two turf works since her most recent try and plenty of solid European stakes performers in her family, the good Emollient appears likely to show up despite the change in scenery and surface. "She ran so well on the synthetic, we're hoping there's a correlation between synthetic and turf," trainer Bill Mott said. "Her two turf works at Belmont Park were very good." Also heading west is **Emotional Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), who will look to further expand the empire of scalding-hot owners Ken and Sarah Ramsey. The Wesley Ward pupil got her nose down on the line to take a grassy Keeneland allowance Apr. 7 and annexed Pimlico's Hilltop S. by the same margin when last seen May 17. The local contingent includes the top four and seventh-place finishers from the nine-furlong GII Honeymoon H. June 8. Wertheimer homebred **Sarach** (Arch) controlled the pace from the outset to post an 8-1 upset, while favored **Scarlet Strike** (Smart Strike) flew home from dead last to complete the exacta.

The pace projects honest, if not breakneck, given the presence of James W. Murphy S. hero **Redwood Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) as well as **War Dancer** (War Front), who figures as well. Charming Kitten should have every chance to turn the tables. A rallying third in the Blue Grass and ninth in the Kentucky Derby, the Ramsey homebred was perhaps closer to the pace in the Penn Mile than he would have preferred, but closed off his race well, with a final quarter mile in :22.78, slightly better than Rydilluc and .01 slower than **Jack Milton** (War Front). The added real estate can work in his favor tonight. **Draw Two** (Macho Uno) has maybe the most upside of any runner in the field. A facile maiden winner over yielding Belmont turf last Oct. 17, the grey went missing, but showed few signs of rust in his May 10

return, overcoming a slow start before running out a convincing winner over recent Belmont allowance winner Stormy Len (Harlan's Holiday). He should be motoring late and is the value play of the bunch.

FILLY LOOKS TO 'TELL A GREAT STORY'

Sagamore Farm homebred **Tell a Great Story** (Bluegrass Cat) hopes to do just that in today's 1 1/16-mile GII Delaware Oaks for trainer Ignacio Correas. The morning-line chalk has never been off the board in her five lifetime starts, and most recently took the Go For the Wand S., the local prep, by a nose over **Ile St. Molly** (Ile St. Louis {Chi}), **Alli Leigh** (Student Council), and **Broomsage** (Include). **Maracuya** (Big Brown) was a debut winner at Gulfstream Mar. 6 and scored again in an optional claimer there Mar. 31, earning a 90 Beyer Speed Figure. The Ralph Nicks trainee was last seen finishing a well-beaten fourth after setting the pace in the GII Black Eyed Susan at Pimlico May 17. **Makayla's Angel** (Sky Mesa) comes into this off of back-to-back wins here. The Debby Oxley homebred took an allowance last out June 12. Tim Ritchey sends out **Dancing Afleet** (Afleet Alex) as both trainer and owner along with Beverly Frazier. The bay also boasts impressive back-to-back wins here, with a 7 3/4-length graduation June 13 and a 3 3/4-length score in an optional claimer June 24.

An intriguing octet lines up for today's GII A Gleam H., a "Win and You're In" event for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint at Santa Anita in early November. Today's test brings together the last two winners of the GI La Brea S., **Teddy's Promise** (Salt Lake), the 2011 victress, and **Book Review** (Giant's Causeway), who landed a moderately rated affair last December in Arcadia. All things equal, if every rival fires their best shot, **Teddy's Promise** is your likeliest winner. Victorious in half of her 10 local appearances, the Calbred was just touched off by **Rumor** (Indian Charlie) in the Mar. 10 GIII Las Flores S. at Santa Anita when giving the Richard Mandella trainee five pounds, but bounced back with a career-best 99 Beyer in the five-furlong Time to Love S. at this venue May 5. The homebred found two spots of trouble in the Desert Stormer H. June 16 and couldn't quite get it done, missing by less than a length in third. She returns to her winning La Brea trip today. **Book Review** was up to best **Reneesgotzip** (City Zip) by a neck in the '12 La Brea, with champion My Miss Aurelia (Smart Strike) third, but was less successful at a route of ground, finishing second in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20 and in the GII Santa Maria S. Feb. 16. She has fired fresh before and is batting .800 at this specialist distance. **Reneesgotzip** is perfect in three appearances over this Cushion Track and was to make her seasonal debut in the GI Princess Rooney H. last weekend, but connections could not arrange suitable transport, and she lands here instead. **Byrama (GB)** (Byron {GB}) fell just a neck short in the seven-furlong GI Madison S. at Keeneland Apr. 13, but got a heady ride from Gary Stevens and earned a first win at the highest level in the GI Vanity H. June 15.

Placed in Group 1 company on his last two starts, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Aljamaaheer (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) is afforded an opportunity to register a first pattern-race success in today's G2 Summer Mile at Ascot. Third behind Farhh (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. May 18, the chestnut followed that with a second to Declaration of War (War Front) a month later in the G1 Queen Anne S. at the Royal meeting. While those efforts suggest he will be hard to beat here, he also has some reversals on his record in lesser company, and trainer Roger Varian will be hoping he can take advantage of a class-drop here. "Aljamaaheer has improved with every run this season and put up a career best to be second in the Queen Anne last time out," he said. "He has done everything right at home since, and the trip and ground should suit him." Interestingly, Luca Cumani has opted to bring Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum's **Afsare (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) back in distance following his latest runner-up finish to Mandour (Smart Strike) in the 10-furlong Gala S. at Sandown July 5. Last year's GI Arlington Million second has not looked an obvious candidate for this trip, and his biggest issue may be how he deals with the start, as he has developed problems with the stalls. One of the darker types is Giuliano Manfredini's **Guest of Honour (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who had the subsequent dual listed scorer Montiridge (Ire) (Ramonti {Fr}) back in third when impressing on his black-type debut in the May 13 Listed Royal Windsor S.

I am hoping for another good run."

Reddam Racing's **Recanted** (Empire Maker) is another who overcame a tardy beginning to win on debut over 6 1/2 furlongs at Newbury June 13, and his form links in with Outstrip. "He impressed when winning on debut at Newbury, has continued to please in his home work and has a great chance," trainer Brian Meehan commented.

Domestic Buyers Step In...

Tom Malone jumped straight in with an opening bid of 50,000gns for **Franciscan (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) ([lot 684](#)) and had to see off trainer David Elsworth to land the 5-year-old for 60,000gns. Formerly trained by Luca Cumani and bred by Fittocks Stud, which Cumani owns with his wife Sara, the gelding has won five of his 22 starts. His half-brother Forte Dei Marmi (GB) (Selkirk), trained by Roger Attfield, recently highlighted the family's durability with his victory in the GIII Singpiel S. at Woodbine at the age of seven. Franciscan will now head to the stable of leading northern jumps trainer Donald McCain, along with the good-looking 4-year-old **Cool Sky (GB)** (Millkom {GB}), bought earlier in the day for 42,000gns.

The partnership of trainer Jane Chapple-Hyam and Ned and Max Sangster's Invictus Racing has already enjoyed a great run of success with Excelebration (Ire)'s half-brother Mull Of Killough (Ire), a treble stakes winner at his local track Newmarket. The trio teamed up again to buy **Captain Bertie (Ire)** (Captain Rio {GB}) ([lot 548](#)) for 50,000gns from the draft of Charlie Hills' Faringdon Place Stables. Chapple-Hyam will now prime the 95-rated miler for an autumn campaign.

The final day ended with session gains in the aggregate, up by 27% at 1,874,400gns, and the average, which rose by 12% to 13,988gns. The median increased fractionally to 7,750gns from 7,500gns. Overall, the sale's turnover of 6,970,300gns improved by 47% on the 2012 total, and was the highest aggregate at the July Sale since 2008. The median of 8,000gns was up by 23% and the average of 15,987gns by 35%. Only the clearance rate dropped slightly at 87%, compared to 89% last year.

"This has been a very strong sale from start to finish," said Edmond Mahony. "The key indicators of average, median and turnover are all significantly higher than last year, and a clearance rate hovering around 90% demonstrates the strength and depth at all levels of the market."

"An equally important feature of this year's July Sale has been a discernible feeling of cautious optimism returning to the market. It would be wrong to attach too much significance to the vibrant trade this week, but as we start to look forward to the October Yearling Sale, one can draw some encouragement from the sustained global demand we have experienced at Tattersalls this week."

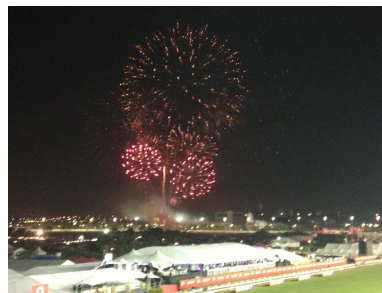

Into Africa...

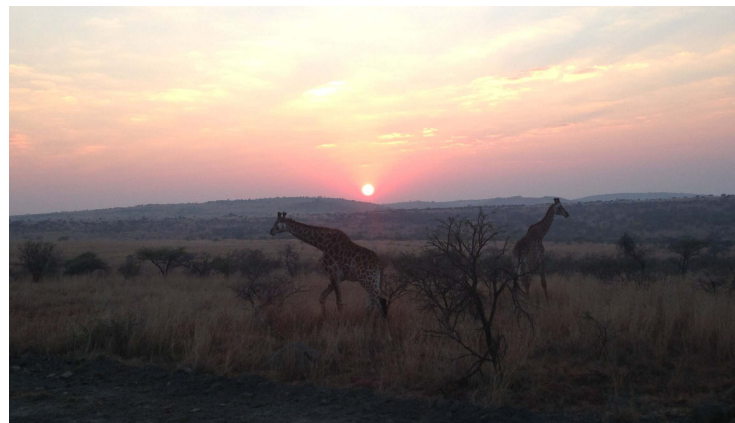
Going on safari has always featured prominently on my bucket list, but not even I could predict that it would surpass my wildest expectations. The international media

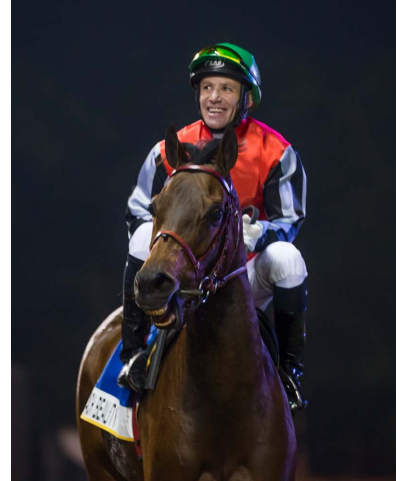

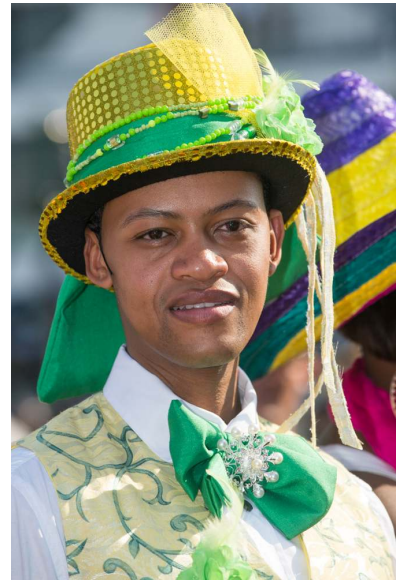
