

A CLASSIC TOUCH OF FRENCH CHIC

She has a problem with going straight, but Paul Makin's **Chicquita (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) has an abundance of class and talent, and employed both to break her maiden in yesterday's G1 Darley Irish Oaks despite forfeiting valuable ground veering left in the closing stages. Runner-up in the June 16 G1 Prix de Diane when taking the same diagonal path last time, the bay looked a straightforward proposition for much of this contest, traveling easily in third under Johnny Murtagh off the sedate pace set by **Just Pretending** (Giant's Causeway). Angled out for her run

inside the final quarter mile, the 9-2 shot went left, but still managed to overhaul the long-time leader with 100 yards remaining and score by a half length from the closing **Venus de Milo (Ire)** (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}). "She hadn't won before this race, but I knew she was a top-class filly," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said. "We came here because The Curragh is the typical racetrack for a filly like her with a long acceleration who stays. Johnny rode her well, as she's not easy and you have to relax on her early and not ask for too much too quickly." **Cont. p3**

THAT'S HOW YOU DEFEND A CROWN

Besilu Stables' two-time champion **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) added to her legacy with another brilliant performance in Saturday's G1 Delaware H., running away with a 10 3/4-length decision over **She's All In** (Include). A life-and-death winner over Tiz Miz Sue (Tiznow) in last year's renewal--then a Grade II--Royal Delta was unchallenged through a half mile in :47.50 this time around, and dropped the hammer in the stretch to win without breaking a sweat. "She did it the right way and she is an awesome mare when she finds her right stride and gets her rhythm," Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott commented. "She was training great coming into the race. Actually, a little to good if there is such a thing. She was wanting to work a little fast, but doing it the right way. We are looking at the [G1] Personal Ensign at Saratoga [Aug. 25] for her next race." **Cont. p3**

King of Prussia Stable's **Princess of Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior), sent off the 2-1 second-choice in the G1 Coaching Club American Oaks off the heels of a 38-1 upset in the G1 Kentucky Oaks, rocked the Spa with a six-length tour-de-force victory over **My Happy Face** (Tiz Wonderful). Chicquita exhibited the normal amount of greenness expected of a debutante when third over nine furlongs at Longchamp in October, but there was a more dramatic display of recklessness when taking a dive

into the hedge when in the clear in a Saint-Cloud conditions event on her 3-year-old return May 24. It was a measure of the regard in which her astute conditioner holds her that she was still sent to the Prix de Diane, and she justified that faith with a four-length second to Treve (Fr) (Motivator {GB}) at

Chantilly, which may have been lessened had she not drifted across the track late on. This contest represented a different examination of her constitution, with Joseph O'Brien setting a surprisingly steady tempo on Just Pretending, but she settled into a gentle rhythm in behind. With Tom Queally moving the 9-4 favorite **Riposte (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) up to second soon after, she was provided ideal cover, and Johnny Murtagh allowed the front duo to scrap in the straight before angling the French raider out for her effort halfway down. With Just Pretending winning the fist-fight with the Juddmonte representative, the real threats were emerging from behind, and Chicquita had first run on Venus de Milo, who she crossed as she went left, which resulted in a stewards' inquiry. "She has plenty of talent and could have a great career if she manages not to do anything stupid and get disqualified in her races," de Royer-Dupre said. "She never gives a problem in training, and so what happened at Saint-Cloud was a big surprise. I don't want to put blinkers on her, as she has plenty of energy, and so I hope she can learn with each race. I think the main race for her is the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 15] as a prep for the [Oct. 6] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. She could be better at four than she is now." Joseph O'Brien said of Just Pretending, "I thought I could nick it if I got an easy lead, but this trip stretches her. She's run a solid race and dropping back to a mile or a mile and a quarter, there is a Group 1 in her somewhere."

Freshened after winning her second straight GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 2, the dark bay kicked off her 5-year-old campaign with a runaway tally in Gulfstream's GIII Sabin S. Feb. 17. She never lifted a hoof in the G1 Dubai World Cup, and followed that disappointing 10th-place finish with a well-beaten second in the GII Fleur de Lis H. at Churchill June 15. Regular pilot Mike Smith was full of praise after yesterday's romp. "It is about as easy as it gets," Smith said. "Even though it was hotter today then her last start, she was actually cooler. She brought her "A" game. She jumped out there, got into stride right away and made every step a winning one. I just cruised around there with her. Everyone expected it and we did what we were supposed to do, so it is just a sigh of relief. I just wanted to make sure I stayed on and crossed the wire. This race should really step her forward."

responded and revved up with a three-wide sweep, and showed her foes no mercy in the stretch. "I thought she was always traveling really well," Pletcher continued. "There wasn't a lot of pace in there and they were tightly bunched. We made a mistake in the Gazelle when we felt like Close Hatches was the only speed. We kind of took her out of her running style [that day]."

Owner Edward Stanco also campaigned Princess of Sylmar's stakes-placed, winning dam, a \$67,000 FTMMAY graduate. The 9-year-old has also produced an unraced 2-year-old colt by Honour and Glory; an E Dubai yearling filly; and a Petionville weanling filly.

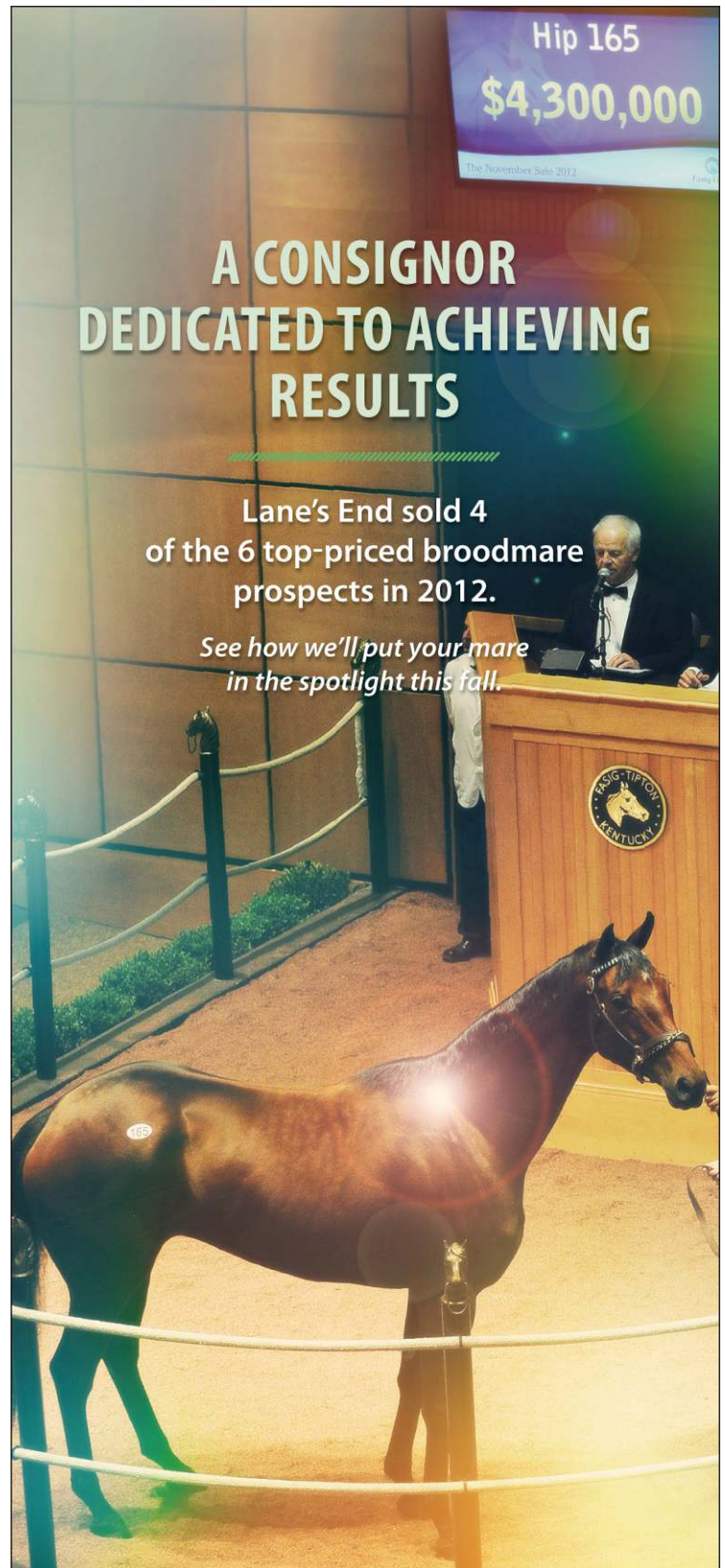

title June 29. Slightly favored to get back on track here, he caboosed the field of nine through a half mile in :46.23. Jeranimo still had plenty to do as they rounded the far turn, found a seam in deep stretch, and came charging on the outside to win in style. "It seems almost surreal to say the horse redeemed himself when he had nothing to prove," trainer Mike Pender said. "They're going to say this was a weak rendition of the Eddie Read, but all he has done is run second to Acclamation [in 2011] and take down the winning honors today. I think when Jeranimo is in a real horse race, where there's speed, tactical speed and deep closers like himself, that's when he's able to shine. And today, he had perfect conditions."

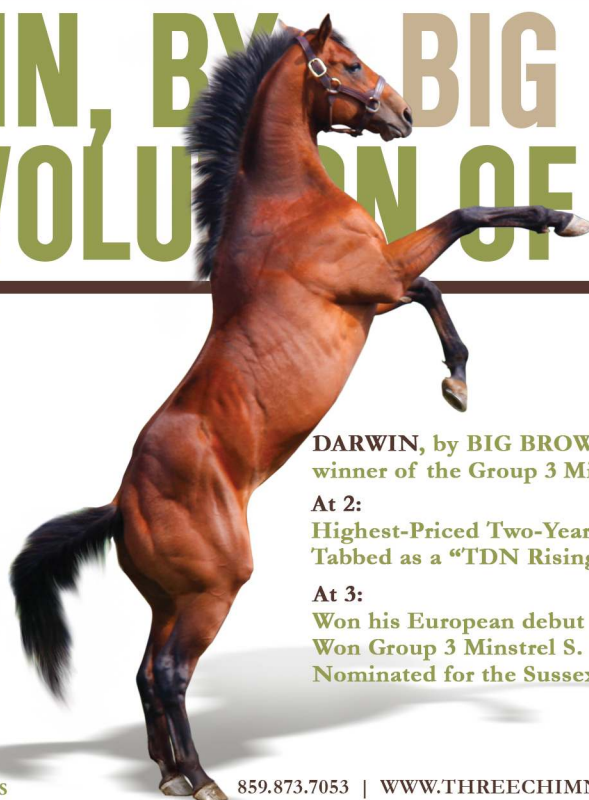



HEADING UPWARDS

Won in the past by Arcangues, Carnegie (Ire), Dubai Millennium (GB) and Valixir (Ire) (Tremolino), Maisons-Laffitte's G2 Prix Eugene Adam is an often-important staging post en route to the major leagues and today's renewal is as competitive as any of its recent predecessors. His Highness The Aga Khan's **Shikarpour (Ire)** (Dr Fong), whose sire is also on this race's honor roll, has looked a highly progressive colt so far, and followed a fine fifth in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly June 2 with a strong-finishing second in the G3 Tercentenary S. over this trip at Royal Ascot last time June 20. The form of that race was flattered when runner-up Irish Sweepstakes (Any Given Saturday) aired by better than seven lengths in a state-bred maiden on Friday's opening-day card. **All in Blue** (More Than Ready) wheels back on 17 days' rest off a 6 1/4-length debut success down at Belmont Park on Independence Day, good for **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** status. While the 80 Beyer Speed Figure he earned that day is easily the best of this bunch, he was last of that quintet to begin and raced in the clear thereafter. Anything but an alert dispatch from the one hole today could land him in a world of trouble.

He's a very good work horse in company, but today's work he was by himself. That was our last work, and we'll gallop into the race." Mylute is expected to face off versus GI Belmont S. hero **Palace Malice** (Curlin), GII Dwyer S. winner **Moreno** (Ghostzapper), GIII Matt Winn S. hero **Code West** (Lemon Drop Kid), and GII Peter Pan S. winner **Freedom Child** (Malibu Moon) in the Jim Dandy. The GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner and defending Whitney champion **Fort Larned** (E Dubai), coming off a dominant win in the June 15 GI Stephen Foster H., worked five furlongs in 1:03.81 over the main track.

"It was a little slower than what I wanted, but the track was a little dead this morning, and it was a work to set up a work," said trainer Ian Wilkes. "We'll come back [next week] and get a major work with him off this."

Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) worked five furlongs in 1:01.61 under exercise rider Nick Petro.

"He had a great work this morning, and we're looking forward to the Whitney," trainer Kathy Ritvo said. "He'll have one more work; the day will be dependant on the weather."

Mucho Macho Man failed to finish the Jan. 19 Sunshine Millions Classic in his 2013 debut and is coming off a third-place finish in the June 14 Criminal Type S. at Belmont Park.

"His last race was a good comeback race for him," Ritvo added. "It reminded us of the Alysheba last year, when he finished third and then came up and won the [GI] Suburban H."

Alpha (Bernardini), dead-heat winner of last year's GI Travers S., worked a half-mile in :51.77 over the main track and is considered possible for the Whitney.

"It was just a little half-mile," reported trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He's fit and ready. He'll have to work back next week, and we'll make a decision."

After wintering in Dubai, Alpha returned stateside to run fourth in the July 6 GII Suburban H. last time out.

HORSES, HUMANS SAFE AFTER DOGWOOD

FIRE A fire broke out in a barn at Dogwood Stables in Aiken, South Carolina, Saturday afternoon, but all 21 horses that were stabled there were moved to the

safety of adjacent paddocks or other nearby farms. "They think at this point, that the fire started in the office and spread to the barn," said Mary Jane Howell, director of public relations for Dogwood. "There may still be some stalls standing, but I can't imagine, with

water damage as well, that it won't be a total loss." Howell said that the fire broke out about 1:45 p.m., but was under control some 20 minutes later when she was finally able to gain access to the property. She reported that as of 4 p.m. Saturday, fire crews and other emergency personnel were still on site dousing the structure with water. Howell indicated that a handful of Dogwood employees, who had earlier attended a wedding not far from the property, were involved in helping get the horses to safety. One employee, identified by Howell as Victor Zambrano, was taken to the hospital for possible smoke inhalation, but there were no other serious injuries reported.
