



REVENGE FOR RAMSEY IN LAKE GEORGE

On the first Wednesday of the 2012 Saratoga meeting, Ken and Sarah Ramsey's Stephanie's Kitten (Kitten's Joy) was desperately unlucky not to win the GII Lake George S., ultimately setting for fourth behind Centre Court (Smart Strike) in a blanket finish. While those two adversaries face a rematch in Saturday's GI Diana S. at the Spa, **Kitten's Dumplings** (Kitten's Joy) exacted revenge for her owners, coming from well back off a generous pace to record a diminishing half-length victory from **Watsdachances (Ire)** (Diamond Green {Fr}). 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star"** 🌟 **Tapicat** (Tapit) chased the pace throughout and held for third.

A bit fractious in the paddock and in the stalls, the 3-2 chalk was headstrong through the opening half-furlong, but was snagged back to the tail by Joel Rosario as **Midnight Watch** (Stormy Atlantic) bowled

along on the engine through an opening quarter in :23.55 and four furlongs in a testing :46.45 over a rain-affected turf course listed as good. Tapicat and Mike Smith were the first to make some noise and loomed a threat as they cornered into the stretch, but by that time, Rosario had

his mount in full stride and they swept five wide into the lane, just to the outside of Watsdachances. Tapicat battled on courageously at the fence, but Kitten's Dumplings had her measure, surged by and held firm late as Watsdachances gave game chase into second.

"I was a little far behind, but that's how she likes to run," Rosario summarized. "She has a really nice kick, but she can hang a little bit, so I'm always careful to time it. I was hoping they'd go quick in front, and my horse has a little bit of speed, but if you use her early, she won't give it to you turning for home."

Winner of half of her four starts at two, including the La Seniorita S. at Retama Park, Kitten's Dumplings was runner-up to Tapicat in the GIII Florida Oaks Feb. 2 prior to a decent fifth to Emollient (Empire Maker) in the GI Ashland S. on Polytrack Apr. 6. She returned to the infield for her two most recent appearances, defeating Praia (Distorted Humor) in the Edgewood S. May 3 and in the GIII Regret S. June 15, both at Churchill Downs.

SECOND SEASON BEGINS IN DANDY STYLE

A field of 10, headed by GI Belmont S. upsetter **Palace Malice** (Curlin), will face the starter in Saturday's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga, the unofficial start to the second half of the year for the sophomore set. The bay, who ran himself into the ground when the very unexpected pacesetter in the GI Kentucky Derby May 4, got blinkers off for the "Test of the Champion" and was much more manageable en route to his 3 1/4-length defeat of GI Preakness S. hero **Oxbow** (Awesome Again). He has breezed no fewer than five times since and has received rave reviews

as he seeks to become the first Belmont winner to follow up in the Jim Dandy since Conquistador Cielo in 1982. Trainer Dallas Stewart believes he has a live longshot in the form of Charles Fipke's **Perfect Title** (Perfect Soul {Ire}). The homebred exits a visually impressive allowance score going the Jim Dandy distance at Churchill Downs June 7 ([video](#)). "Did y'all see his last race?" asked Stewart, who then called up the replay on his cell phone outside his Saratoga barn. "I know we're trying the big time here, but he's bred for it. He won as easy as a horse can win going a mile and an eighth. I was like, 'You know what? Why not.' I'm telling you, this son of a [gun] can run." **Field p4**

BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

OUT OF THE ORDINARY?

Leopardstown's G3 Korean Racing Authority Tyros S. has served as a stepping stone for the likes of Teofilo (Ire), New Approach (Ire), Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Cape Blanco (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in recent times. While he is unfortunately gelded and therefore unable to feature in next year's Classics, there is much to like about the way Sean Jones' **Exogenesis (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) has gone through his brief career so far and he occupies pole position in today's renewal. Beating a smart collection of rivals, including the subsequent G3 Anglesey S. third Mansion House (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in a hot conditions race over this track and trip last time July 4, he is held in the highest regard by Ger Lyons.

"It's a huge step up in class from a winners' race to a Group 3, especially as we are bypassing listed level, but he's a course-and-distance winner and he's a nice horse," Lyons told *PA Sport*. "Whether he's up to this remains to be seen, as it all depends on what Ballydoyle throw at you."

Trainer Aidan O'Brien's duo are **Sir John Hawkins** (Henrythenavigator), who steps up from six furlongs and sports blinkers for the first time after finishing third in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and Newmarket's G2 July S. a fortnight ago, and the May 5 Limerick maiden winner **Expedition (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}). **Field p4**

BACK TO MARS

Having competed in four of the toughest Group 1 races on the calendar, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Mars (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) takes a step back today to bid to register a first win on grass and first black-type success in Leopardstown's G3 Jockey Club of Turkey Meld S. Sixth in the May 4 G1 2000 Guineas and June 1 G1 Epsom Derby, the Ballydoyle trainee was third in Royal Ascot's G1 St James's Palace S. 17 days later and ran with credit when fourth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 6. Wearing the hood that he sported for the first time in that 10-furlong contest, he should be able to add to his sole win on Dundalk's Polytrack last July. Kirsten Rausing and Jackie Bolger's **Scintillula (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was only beaten a length in Saturday's G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh, but Coolcullen representatives are often able to back up smart performances and she may rate the greatest threat.

CONNECTIONS WAIT ON ST NIC

Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was undergoing surgery at Fethard Veterinary Hospital yesterday as a result of the fractured pastern suffered in training ahead of Saturday's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. While there was no official update on the 6-year-old's condition in late evening, trainer Aidan O'Brien paid his own personal tribute to the six-time Group 1 winner as he waited for more news. "It has been a long day for St Nicholas Abbey," O'Brien told the *Racing Post* yesterday afternoon. "He is still in surgery and we're waiting on news. As a racehorse, he was always very special. He could travel very well in his races and he always had that ability to quicken really well. His record speaks for itself."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Optimizer Likely for Sword Dancer...

Calumet Farm's **Optimizer** (English Channel), a two-time Grade III winner on grass earlier this season, will bypass the GI Whitney H. Aug. 3 in favor of the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga Aug. 17, trainer D. Wayne Lukas confirmed Wednesday. "I put him in there to take a look at it," Lukas said of nominating Optimizer to the Whitney. "He ran a pretty decent race on the dirt the last time he ran on it," he added, referring to his fourth in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 13. The homebred was also a close second in the GII Rebel S. during his sophomore campaign. Victorious in the GIII Col. E. R. Bradley H. and GIII Fair Grounds H. earlier this season, Optimizer was runner-up to Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 4 and third to stablemate Skyring (English Channel) in the GII Dixie S. two weeks later. The 4-year-old was runner-up behind Point of Entry (Dynaformer) in the GI Manhattan H. June 8 and was more recently a well-beaten fifth in the GI Man o'War S. July 13. "He didn't care for the surface," Lukas said.

Normandy Invasion Set to Return to Track...

Fox Hill Farm owner Rick Porter reported on his website www.foxhillfarmstable.com that stable star **Normandy Invasion** (Tapit), who has been nursing a foot issue which will preclude a start during the Saratoga meeting, is scheduled to return to the track to resume training this morning. "Ian Mckinlay came to Saratoga [Wednesday] morning and found Normandy ready for the work to his hoof. He put a wall around the hoof which is wired into the hoof for stability. He put glue on shoes on him. In the meantime, the hoof will continue to grow inside the wall Ian built around it. He is very pleased with the way his foot looked before and after he did the work." Runner-up to Verrazano (More Than Ready) in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 6, Normandy Invasion led the GI Kentucky Derby field into the stretch before tiring to finish fourth to Orb (Malibu Moon). He was briefly under consideration for the GI Preakness S., but it was subsequently decided to focus on a summer campaign. He was to use tomorrow's Curlin S. as a prep for the GI Travers S. before his foot ailment derailed those plans. Normandy Invasion is tentatively scheduled to return to action in the \$1-million GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 21.

MONZANTE TRAGEDY SPARKS DEBATE

The circumstances surrounding the injury and subsequent euthanization of grade I winner Monzante at Evangeline Downs on July 20 have set off debate throughout the horse racing community and beyond. The NTRA has participated by reminding the industry of the NTRA Safety & Integrity Alliance's work.

The NTRA formed the Safety & Integrity Alliance in 2008 to establish and implement national standards for racetrack safety and integrity. Twenty-five racetracks across the United States and Canada, representing nearly 70% of total North American handle, are currently accredited.

There is no guarantee that accreditation by the Alliance would have saved Monzante but tracks that comply with the Alliance Code of Standards are implementing the most current safety advances to the benefit of our equine and human athletes. This includes helping owners and trainers find aftercare and second career opportunities for their aged and infirmed horses.

The NTRA commends the Louisiana State Racing Commission for its aggressive investigation of the tragic events on July 20; and we urge all tracks and participants, including Evangeline Downs and its horsemen, to seek accreditation and take full advantage of the Alliance's growing body of knowledge and best practices related to the safety of our human and equine athletes.

Gaines Suspension Upheld:

The California Horse Racing Board has affirmed the decision of Hollywood Park stewards to suspend trainer Carla Gaines for 30 days, beginning Aug. 1, and fined her \$2,500 after the Maddy Laboratory at the University of California at Davis determined that urine samples from A Little Luckier (Lucky J. H.) and Winding Way (More Than Ready) contained levels of testosterone in excess of authorized levels for fillies and mares. A split sample sent to the University of Florida confirmed the overages. A Little Luckier was disqualified from a runner-up effort at Hollywood July 14, 2012, while Winding Way finished first at Del Mar July 21, 2012. Purse money for both races was ordered redistributed. "I have no choice but to appeal," Gaines told *Daily Racing Form*. "I am shocked and disappointed in the decision. I was at the entire hearing, and I don't understand the verdict. I'm going to take every step I can to clear my name."
