## LARNED LOOKING FOR WHITNEY REDUX

In the 85 previous runnings of the prestigious GI Whitney H., just (Discovery, 1934-36) is the only one to post consecutive victories in the event, but Janis Whitham's **Fort Larned** (E Dubai) has a chance to rewrite the history books when he goes in defense of his title this afternoon in a Breeders' Cup Challenge race for the Classic. "Let's hope we can have a little bit more luck this year," said trainer Ian Wilkes. "He's coming into the race great. To stay in good form and be able to have a chance to do that says something about the horse." But it hasn't exactly been smooth sailing this season for the reigning GI Breeders' Cup Classic champion. He famously dumped jockey Brian Hernandez Jr. just after the start of the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 9 and was the prohibitive 1-2 chalk for the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 13, but was no threat in fifth. The 5-year-old was allowed to go off a 3-1 chance for the GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill June 15, and despite setting a very searching pace, waltzed in by better than six lengths in near track-record time, one that could easily have been eclipsed had Hernandez asked for him to finish. **Whitney H. cont. p7**

## RAISE THE LANTERN

Whatever the true merit of her performance in the G1 Falmouth S., Ben Keswick's **Sky Lantern (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}) has a new agenda today as she steps up to 10 furlongs for Goodwood's G1 Nassau S. What is clear from that July 12 Newmarket contest is that the filly that finished ahead of her, Elusive Kate (Elusive Quality), is out of the top drawer, as she has subsequently proved when romping to success in the G1 Prix Rothschild. Sky Lantern appears clearly the best of the 3-year-old fillies at present, having hammered home that fact in Royal Ascot's G1 Coronation S. June 21 to silence any doubts that arose immediately after the May 5 G1 1,000 Guineas at Newmarket. Trainer Richard Hannon said, "The Falmouth is now history, but Elusive Kate gave the form a boost when subsequently winning the Prix Rothschild in France and, provided the rain stays away, we will be going there very hopeful. Obviously, Sky Lantern is stepping into the unknown, but Hughesie has been itching to try her at a mile and a quarter since she won the 1000 Guineas, and this looks the right place to start. **Cont. p8**

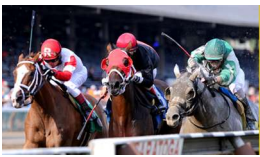

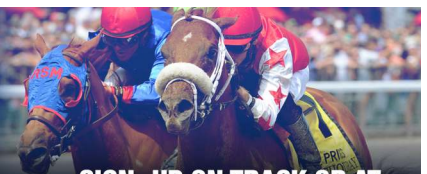

May 17, the bay found only the classy filly Body and Soul (Ire) (Captain Rio {GB}) a neck too strong in the latter track's valuable Sprint Trophy also over six June 15 before running out of steam again over that trip at Newmarket last time July 12. In rear of the

group racing in the center of the track early, he was allowed time to find his feet off the furious gallop and moved into contention approaching the furlong pole. Switched around the trailblazing Justineo (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) and into the lead with 150 yards remaining, he veered left across the path of the chasing Swiss Spirit, but had enough in hand at the line to persuade the stewards that it had not affected the result.

"He's a very good horse, but he wants settling early on, and they went that quick today I was able to do it," jockey Paul Mulrennan commented. "He showed a good attitude to go through the gap and won cosily enough and was idling a little bit in front--the best horse won on the day. He's improving all the time and we don't know how good he could be. We've always held him in high regard and he's proved why today, so it's onwards and upwards now." Trainer Bryan Smart echoed those sentiments. "He's never settled in a race and even at Newmarket last time he still didn't 100%," he said. "The speed he shows for a 3-year-old is amazing, and he is a superstar. I think this could be the top of all the ones we've had. At home he's always wrestled with us, so we've had to come down the gears, but Paul rode him the other morning and said 'boss, this horse is a missile'. Owned by Richie Fiddes, Will Salthouse and the high-profile soccer manager Harry Redknapp, he is bound for the G1 Nunthorpe S. at York now Aug. 23. "We've had to make all the running in his 3-year-old races, as there was not enough pace on, but he had proper older horses to give him a tow today and he destroyed some good ones," Fiddes explained. "The Nunthorpe has always been the plan and he runs well at York, is consistent and a good strong horse, but to think he could win there as well as here is a bit heady. As an owner Glorious Goodwood is as good as anywhere--here and York are the best tracks in the country for me."

Unbeaten before running into Trading Leather (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in the G3 Autumn S. on Newmarket's Future Champions' Day in October, Montiridge stepped up off a third in the Listed Royal Windsor S. over an extended mile May 13 to annex the Listed Heron S. at Sandown May 30. Runner-up in Royal Ascot's G3 Jersey S. over seven furlongs June 19, the dark bay went back up to this trip to take Newmarket's Listed Stubbs S. July 11, and justified market confidence to add a Pattern-race score to his tally here. Held on too early towards the rear by Richard Hughes, he was given a typically confident ride and, after allowing Tawhid first run, swallowed him up in the final 100 yards for a comfortable score. "He is very good and he should have won the Jersey S. at Royal Ascot," Hughes said. "I got to the front too soon that day and he pulled up with me, so I was not going to make that same mistake this time. He has so much pace that we could easily bring him back to six furlongs." Richard Hannon Jr was welcoming back his father's 250th winner at the track and added, "Montiridge is much more settled than he was last year. He has matured through the winter and has grown up enormously and that easy win will have been a great confidence-booster for him. We now have a Group 3 to go with his two Listed victories, so it is time to look further up the ladder, and we feel that he has the potential to reach the top floor. We will look for races like the G1 Prix du Moulin [at Longchamp Sept. 15] and the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Oct. 19] and, of course, there are the G2 Challenge S. [at Newmarket Oct. 12] and the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 6] over the seven, and the good news is that he is likely to stay in training as a 4-year-old."

Annedote stepped up off a seven-furlong handicap score at Newbury May 18 to win the Listed Sandringham H. at Royal Ascot June 19, but dropped to fourth in the Listed Valiant S. also over that track and trip last Friday. Angled over to the rail from her wide draw, the bay was kept against the fence until switched out to take over from Winning Express with 100 yards remaining and assert for a clear-cut success. "She's not very robust, but is so tough it's unbelievable," trainer Johnny Portman said. "She came out of Royal Ascot incredibly well and only ran a week ago, but although I don't like running them too soon there is a limited program for her and she was well. I gave her time between her races as a 2-year-old deliberately, but you have to strike while the iron's hot. She did that well today--I didn't want her to be on rail, but she missed the break slightly and Richard [Kingscote] took that decision and got his gap and came good. She means the world to me and I'd love the owners to be brave enough to race her in America for ourselves. There has been a lot of interest in her from buyers there and she would be very good there."

Successful in the Royal Hunt Cup at Royal Ascot and fourth in the G1 Sussex S. at this meeting in 2009, Forgotten Voice was sent hurdling after his career was stalled by injury. Back on the level in Royal Ascot's Listed Wolferton H. June 21, the bay finally gained the black-type success he looked booked for earlier in his career. Held up early with one behind, he traveled with exuberance off the strong tempo and, when asked to lengthen, reeled in Lost In the Moment in the final 50 yards for a stylish win. "He settled well and has a bit of speed," jockey Johnny Murtagh said. "He won well and has improved a lot from Ascot."

Richard Hannon Jr later added, “[Sky Lantern is] going to need luck, as there are a lot of runners. We think she’ll get the trip and [has] plenty of ability, but the traffic and number of runners is what worries me. Tomorrow’s not her Derby or the Breeders’ Cup.” Sky Lantern was beaten convincingly by **Hot Snap (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. over seven furlongs at Newmarket Apr. 17, and that Juddmonte representative re-opposes off a break having flopped in the Guineas. Qatar Racing Limited and the Sangster Family’s **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}), who was second and third behind Sky Lantern in the Guineas and Coronation respectively, did win the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas on fast ground at The Curragh in the interim May 26, but connections are hoping the ground eases. “We’ll have a good look at the ground,” trainer Charlie Hills commented. “There are showers forecast, but after having three runs on quick ground in quick succession, I wouldn’t be keen to ask her to run on it again. She’s got a Group 2 option at Deauville [the Prix de la Nonette], but if there’s a shower or two she’ll take her chance. Her breeding suggests she should be better over further.” Also representing Qatar Racing is the May 31 G1 Epsom Oaks runner-up **Secret Gesture (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who will miss the race and head to Sunday’s G1 Preis der Diana if Just the Judge is given the green light. **Cont. p9**

"[Secret Gesture] doesn't appear as ground-dependent as the other filly," Racing Manager David Redvers told *PA Sport*. "[Trainer] Ralph [Beckett] is pretty confident she'd gallop on the road if we asked her to. Ground conditions in Germany are also quite quick. The plan is to run her on Saturday if Just the Judge doesn't run, but if Just the Judge does run at Goodwood, Secret Gesture will probably go to Germany." In a red-hot renewal, Cheveley Park Stud's unexposed and unbeaten Listed Sandown Distaff winner **Integral (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) adds spice along with Godolphin's star of the Dubai World Cup Carnival, **Sajjhaa (GB)** (King's Best). Successful in two Group 2s and two Group 1s there, including in the Mar. 30 G1 Dubai Duty Free, the 6-year-old was fourth when last seen in the G1 QEII Cup over this trip at Sha Tin Apr. 28. "She raced in a hood in Dubai and I think that has turned her around," Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "She is now very effective in her races. A mile and a quarter is stretching her, as her best trip is at a mile or nine furlongs. Sajjhaa was running against a small pool of horses in Dubai and, now she is back in Europe, there is a much bigger tank of fish to be running against. But she is quality and she is peaking at the right moment."

**TALAMO LOOKING TO KICK START MEET**

Jockey Joe Talamo was third in the jockeys' standings at Santa Anita over the winter and fell just one victory shy of sharing in the premiership at the recently completed meet at Betfair Hollywood Park. The Louisiana native is off to a slow start at the Del Mar stand, but will try to turn it around when he partners favored **Include Me Out** (Include) in today's G1 Clement L. Hirsch S., a "Win and You're In" event for the G1 Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. The defending race champion, the Jay Em Ess runner finished third in her two subsequent appearances at four, behind loose-on-the-lead Love and Pride (A.P. Indy) in the G1 Zenyatta S. and to Royal Delta (Empire Maker) in the Ladies' Classic. "The second half of the year I had trouble keeping weight on her and I knew she was getting a little tired, but she kept going and ran a great race in the Breeders' Cup," trainer Ron Ellis said. "So we gave her a well-deserved rest and we're hoping to go into the Breeders' Cup this year with a fresher horse." The bettors clearly viewed her comeback test in the six-furlong Desert Stormer H. June 16 as a prep for bigger and better, but she exceeded expectations with a 3/4-length victory. She gets her preferred two turns here and has only finished outside the exacta once in seven synthetic tries.

"It's a lot to ask the second time out off a layoff and first time around two turns of the year," Ellis said. "And I'm not sure that the outside post is the place to be the way the track has been playing. But she ran very well in the comeback from the layoff and she worked well over the track (a bullet four furlongs in :46 4/5 Monday) and Joe knows her well so he'll do what he has to do." **More Chocolate** (Malibu Moon) looms an interesting alternative. A two-time winner and Grade III-placed on the grass, the bay trained well on the dirt at Santa Anita and surprised some with a 5-1 upset of G1 La Brea S. heroine Book Review (Giant's Causeway) in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20. Set a hopeless task chasing Joyful Victory (Tapit) in the G1 Santa Margarita S. Mar. 16, she finished runner-up, then was slightly disappointing when a well-backed fifth to Authenticity (Quiet American) in the GII La Troienne S. at Churchill May 3. She tried the Cushion Track for the first time in the G1 Vanity H. at Hollypark June 15 and may have moved prematurely before settling for second to **Byrama (GB)** (Byron {GB}). She gets a key rider change to Rafael Bejarano today, who broke her maiden on the grass last July.

### TAKE ME HOME, COUNTRY ROAD

It lacks the glitz and glam of last weekend's GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Haskell Invitational S., but today's GII West Virginia Derby has lured an interesting trio of invaders, two from the Midwest and one who ships in from Saratoga. That is Repole Stable's **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union), who makes his first start since an even seventh behind stable companion Palace Malice (Curlin) in the GI Belmont S. June 8. Last year's GII Remsen S. hero was fifth from a wide draw as the favorite in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 2, but earned his way into the GI Kentucky Derby with a 4 1/4-length victory in the GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 13. He never landed a blow in the Run for the Roses, finishing 11th, and adds blinkers to kick off the second half of the season. **Departing** (War Front) looks to atone for a sixth-place effort behind Oxbow (Awesome Again) when he last faced the starter in the GI Preakness S. May 18. Winner of his first three trips to the post, the homebred was a solid third behind Revolutionary (War Pass) in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 30, but overcame a wide passage to romp by 3 1/4 lengths in the GIII Illinois Derby. With regular rider Brian Hernandez Jr. in Saratoga to ride Fort Larned, trainer Al Stall Jr. has reached out for Robby Albarado. **Betweenhereandcool** (Unbridled's Song) brings progressive form into this rich event. The easy winner of a first-level Churchill allowance June 2, the bay missed by a neck to Looking Cool (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GIII Iowa Derby June 29. The latter did little to flatter the form of that race with a distant sixth to Palace Malice in the Jim Dandy.

## TAYLOR MADE STALLIONS PURCHASES GRAYDAR INTEREST

Taylor Made Stallions announced Friday that it has purchased an interest in GI Donn H. winner **Graydar** (Unbridled's Song--Sweetest Smile, by Dehere) from Twin Creeks Racing LLC. Taylor Made stood Graydar's recently deceased leading sire until his passing last Friday. "Graydar is the closest thing I've seen to Unbridled's Song, and obviously we've had the privilege to be around a lot of good ones through the years," said Taylor Made President and CEO Duncan Taylor. "Graydar's combination of looks, class, and sheer brilliance remind me of his sire, both on

and off the racetrack, and he has that special presence about him like Unbridled's Song had." Trained by Todd Pletcher, the \$260,000 Fasig-Tipton Florida grad aired by 8 1/2 lengths and earned a 100 Beyer Speed on debut at Gulfstream last April. He romped with similar ease at the Hallandale Beach oval in December, and earned a 109 Beyer for a three-length success in the Feb. 9 Donn. The 4-year-old most recently annexed the GII New Orleans H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 30. "We felt like we had to be a part of Graydar after his awesome performance in the Donn, and we were fortunate enough to partner on the horse back in February with Steve Davison, Randy Gullatt and the Twin Creeks group, who we've had a long and good relationship with," revealed Taylor. "The entire Thoroughbred community suffered a big loss with the passing of Unbridled's Song, and we felt it was time to announce some good news. We're extremely excited and carry big hopes for Graydar. We've always felt that he would be a great heir to carry on his terrific sire line." Graydar, a half-brother to MGSP runners Union Course (Dixie Union) and Star of David (Bernstein), is currently in training with Pletcher at Saratoga with the GI Breeders' Cup Classic his long-term goal. He has earned \$601,560 to date.

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### Camelot Nears Return...

Aidan O'Brien has provided an upbeat bulletin regarding **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) as the 4-year-old is readied for his comeback in late summer. With talk of retirement after his latest disappointing fourth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 20, last year's G1 2000 Guineas and English and Irish Derby winner appears to be back on track. "He's in good order. He's back after a break and he's starting to progress," the Ballydoyle conditioner said. "York and Leopardstown would be the two main races that could be possible. The [Aug. 21 G1] Juddmonte [International] and [Sept. 7 G1] Irish Champion are great races, but it will depend on how he comes along." O'Brien also had news of last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy hero **Kingsbarns (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). "He's moving great and is in full work--he could be exciting if he comes back," O'Brien added. He could turn up at the Curragh for the [Aug. 11] G2 Royal Whip, or he could have a racecourse gallop or go straight to Leopardstown [for the Irish Champion]."

### McPeek Looks to Wage 'War' on the Travers...

Trainer Ken McPeek will work GII Virginia Derby hero **War Dancer** (War Front) and GI Blue Grass S. victor **Java's War** (War Pass) together Saturday as a prep for possible starts in the GI Travers S. McPeek is the co-defending champion of the Travers having trained one of last year's dead-heat winners in Golden Ticket (Speightstown). "We're likely to have one and possibly two horses in the race," McPeek said. "They'll both be nominated." McPeek had mentioned a possible surface switch for War Dancer earlier this season. He had originally been pointing Java's War at the GI Secretariat on the Arlington Park sod Aug. 17. "Mr. Fipke and I have discussed it, and he was inclined to try him on the dirt again," McPeek said. "At this point, they're both doing well. We've still got to do the math. We've got to look at the past performances, we've got to see how the horses are training, make sure everybody's hitting on all cylinders, that they're drilling the feed tubs; all the details."

### Dancing House Heads to Spinaway...

Saratoga debut winner **Dancing House** (Tapit) is being pointed at the GI Spinaway Sept. 1, according to trainer Kieran McLaughlin. The Darley homebred is the daughter of Grade I turf winner Tout Charmant (Slewvescent) and despite that strong turf pedigree, McLaughlin ran her filly six furlongs on the dirt in her unveiling. "She trained so well on the dirt that we decided to run her on the dirt, and being that she won, we hope she never sees the turf," McLaughlin said. Dancing House raced mid-pack for most of that start, then tipped out and ran down the leader to score narrowly. "She ran very well and is going to improve," said McLaughlin. "She was in tight and was very professional."

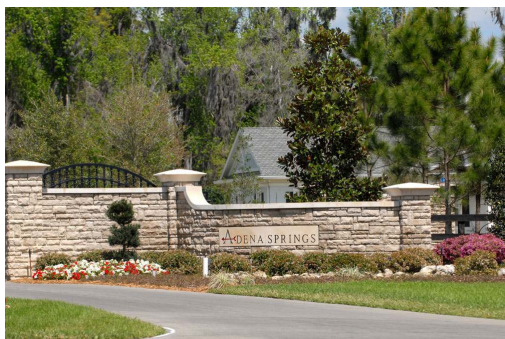

### ADENA'S MILLION DOLLAR BABIES

Frank Stronach's Adena Springs, selling under its own banner during next week's Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Select sale in Saratoga Springs, offers up a quartet of colts that are sure to draw plenty of attention during the



course of the two-day sale. Leading this year's small but select consignment is [Hip 34](#), a son of Distorted Humor out of Delta Princess (A.P. Indy), who is renowned for

having produced champion 3-year-old filly and older mare Royal Delta (Empire Maker). Also up for grabs on Monday is [Hip 42](#), a chestnut by Street Cry (Ire) out of Dreamtheimpossible (Giant's Causeway), who is a daughter of GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Spain (Thunder Gulch); and [Hip 62](#), a full-brother to SW and GISP Judy the Beauty. The farm's sole offering on Day 2 is [Hip 95](#), a dark bay by Street Boss out of MGSW and GISP Miss Isella (Silver Charm).

"It's pretty close to what we usually have," said Adena Springs General Manager Eric Hamelback. "The most we've had here was six. We don't always sell them ourselves, Hidden Brook [acting as agent] has sold many of our horses in the past. Mr. Stronach made the decision this year to go ahead and sell them ourselves."

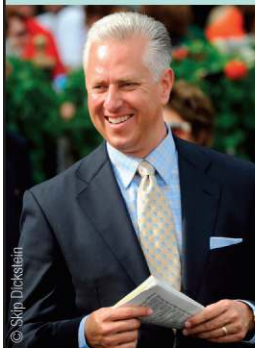
And what last season's Eclipse Award winning breeder lacks in size, it certainly makes up for in quality. Underscoring that point is the star power Adena is offering, with three of the four mares responsible for the Adena consignment having realized over \$1 million in the sale's ring over the past three years. Delta Princess, carrying Hip 34, brought \$2.6 million at Keeneland November in 2011; Dreamtheimpossibledream, in foal to Galileo (Ire), secured a \$2.55-million final bid at the same venue in 2010, while Miss Isella was purchased for \$1.085 million at Keeneland January in 2010.

"In our case, we feel the pedigree has to be the first criteria," confirmed Hamelback. "The selective nature that Fasig-Tipton goes through to fit this sale dictates they are looking for very good athletes. But in this true select sale, you want to have a strong pedigree as well. With the four that we're bringing this year, we certainly feel we have that."

According to Hamelback, this year's team of youngsters, which were pegged early for the Saratoga sale, met the standard the operation always hopes to present at the boutique venue.

"Obviously, the selections are made very early and you still have a lot of time for sale's prep," explained Hamelback. "Some of them don't always progress as you would wish and it might turn out that September is a better option. But in our case, with the four that were selected for this session, we're very happy with the way they've progressed and the pedigrees are there, so that helps."

**Sales and Beyond...**

If its assembly of hardware is any indication, Stronach's Adena Springs has ascended to the top of several areas of the racing industry. The operation has earned the Eclipse Award as outstanding breeder eight times; and has amassed nine Sovereign Awards--Canada's equivalent--as both outstanding owner and breeder. Adena also brought home a record-tying four Eclipse Awards as the leading owner. In the sale's ring, Adena has also developed the reputation for offering top rung runners. Among them are multiple Grade I winners Ginger Punch (Awesome Again) and Game on Dude (Awesome Again), victorious in his latest start in the July 6 GI Hollywood Gold Cup. The former, who found no takers at \$27,000 at the Adena Springs March sale in 2005, annexed a sextet of Grade I's, including the 2007 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at Monmouth Park. After retiring with over \$3 million in the coffers, she later sold for \$1.6 million to Katsumi Yoshida at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton November sale. Offered by Hidden Brook, acting as agent, at Keeneland September in 2008, the latter RNA'd for \$210,000 and bagged six Grade I's to date and has already earned over \$5 million.

"At fair market value, we have offered up a lot of very good horses and some have sold and some have gone on to do really well for us," said Hamelback. "Our goal with the horses that we sell is to get them to the racetrack. Our goal is not sell a \$1-million yearling. Our goal is to get somebody a very good racehorse that'll win a graded stakes or a Grade I, not to have a big sale horse."

In fact, two-thirds of the graded stakes winners by Adena Springs' stallions were offered as yearlings.

"We are certainly known for breeding to race, but we have sold very good yearlings, of the caliber of Game on Dude," Hamelback continued. "We raise a very good horse on the farm and we want to be recognized as offering really good yearlings. The horses we sell don't get treated any differently than the ones we keep. So, we want people to know that our quality horsemanship and the breeding and matings that Mr. Stronach plans is to produce a racehorse. Hopefully, the market will sustain enough to have this quality of yearling at a fair value."

**Millionaire Moms...**

Delta Princess, the dam of Hip 34, collected a trio of Grade III's during her racing career before retiring with over \$740,000 in earnings. As a broodmare, the full-sister to Grade I winner Indy Five Hundred hit paydirt early with her 2008 foal Royal Delta, who won three graded stakes at three, including the GI Alabama S. and GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. Only months away from earning a 3-year-old filly championship, Royal Delta brought \$8.5 million from Besilu Stables at the Keeneland November sale as part of a dispersal of Palides Investments, while her dam realized a healthy \$2.6-million final bid from Stronach at the same venue. Royal Delta returned at four to annex five more graded stakes, including the GI Beldame Invitational followed by another Ladies' Classic before rounding out the season with yet another championship, this time for older female. This season, the bay mare won the Feb. 17 Gill Sabin S. at Gulfstream and most recently, galloped home an easy 10 3/4-length winner in the July 20 GI Delaware H. Looking to ride the wave of success generated by his illustrious sister, the yearling by Distorted Humor appears to have all the right elements to make for a profitable sale.



**Royal Delta**

"He's a neat little packaged horse," said Hamelback. "Physically, he is very much like Distorted Humor. I had the privilege of working for Prestonwood Farm when we bought Distorted Humor. I also nursed him back when he had his ankle surgery back when Elliot [Walden] was still training. So, I was around Distorted Humor a long time and this colt has a lot of the same traits."

A Mar. 13 foal, the dark bay is also a half-brother to GSP Empire Way (Empire Maker), who brought \$250,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Florida sale in 2011 and Carnival Court (Street Sense), who secured a \$650,000 final bid from Darley at Keeneland September that same year. The latter has won two of three starts, including her latest, a mile test at Belmont July 7.

"Looking at the program that we have, we obviously still have the mare and a soon to be weanling [by Street Cry] out of the mare," offered Hamelback. "We still have plenty of connections to the family if the market serves right and this colt is purchased well." **Cont. p15**

### Adena cont.

Offering a page that is sure to appeal to buyers on both sides of the Atlantic is Hip 42, a colt by Street Cry (Ire). Out of Dreamtheimpossible, who is Group 1-placed in England, the May 5 foal is the second foal out of the mare that cost Stronach \$2.55 million at the Keeneland November sale. Purchased at the time carrying a foal by Galileo, Dreamtheimpossible was subsequently sent to Street Cry. Now two, the colt by Galileo was initially prepped at Adena South and is currently in pre-training at Adena North in Canada. In 2013, Dreamtheimpossible produced a colt by Bernardini.

“Mr. Stronach has always supported Darley stallions, Medaglia d'Oro and Street Cry in particular,” said Hamelback. “Mr. Stronach looks for quality, and as a son of El Prado (Ire), Medaglia d'Oro fit the bill. As with Street Cry, he has had so much success at stud, so we will send many of our quality mares to those two stallions.”

Also costing a pretty penny at public auction is the dam of Hip 95, Miss Isella. A multiple graded stakes winner and Grade I placed on the track, Miss Isella was secured for \$1.085 million at Keeneland January in 2010. Sent to Street Boss in 2011, the half-sister to multiple graded stakes winner Sir Cherokee (Cherokee Run) produced a colt by Awesome Again this year.

“From his dam's side, he's quite an outcross and, if anybody knows anything about Adena breeding, Mr. Stronach has built his reputation on outcrosses,” said Hamelback, explaining the match. “Looking at how Street Boss's pedigree matched with Miss Isella, it was at the time, certainly not a commercial mating, but that doesn't dictate how Mr. Stronach thinks. He wants to produce a racehorse.”

Regarding the colt's inclusion in the Saratoga catalog, Hamelback added, “He is very athletic, he has a good hind leg, a good walk and extremely good depth. He was selected by Fasig-Tipton to go to either sale, either July or Saratoga. Street Boss's successes on the track haven't been too mainstream, but he's done reasonably well. Since the decision was left to me, I decided to bring him here, because I thought he'd fit well.”

With three of Adena's four offerings produced out of mares that have drawn over \$1-million at auction, the question remains whether the market can support such highly-invested stock.

“I really think it can,” opined Hamelback. “In fact, I would even go back to the November sale, when you look at the quality of weanlings and mares sold there, you will see that the upper end of the market was very strong. Three or four years ago, these types of horses wouldn't have brought as much as I think they will, or I expect they will, bring next week. I think the market will be close to, if not over, what Mr. Stronach's assessment is going to be.”

While not sporting the million-dollar credentials of the other matriarchs which are responsible for this year's Adena consignment, Holy Blitz (Holy Bull)--the dam of Hip 62--is sure to benefit from the recent success of Adena stallion Ghostzapper.

“As far as selling the colt, if you look at the Ghostzappers that we have, for the commercial market, we just felt he would be a great representation of Ghostzapper,” said Hamelback.

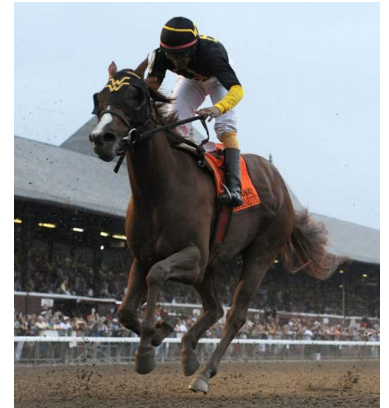
Over the past course of the past two months, the 2004 Horse of the Year was represented by Grade I winners Starship Truffles and Better Lucky, in addition to Grade II scorer Moreno.

“Keep in mind, when the initial selections were made, we didn't know that [Ghostzapper] would explode like he has in the last month or so,” admitted Hamelback. “One might say, we got a little bit lucky with him.”

The Feb. 8 foal is a full-brother to Judy the Beauty, who was victorious in the Shady Well S. and runner-up in the GI Spinaway S. at two and came back at three to finish second in the GI Prioress S.

“Judy the Beauty won a turf sprint in France [allowance, May 2011], but they are really very different physical types,” explained Hamelback.

“Judy the Beauty is a spitting image, albeit a chestnut, of Ghostzapper, right down to the enormous gaskin and hip. Whereas this colt is, phenotypically, like the mare. By my definition, he is a touch European in that he's a little bit longer. I would be the first to say that he looks very much like a turf-type route horse and of course, Ghostzapper has had success with turf horses. We're certainly tagging him as a horse for all surfaces.”



**Judy the Beauty**

A stakes winning half-sister to graded winner Fan the Flame, Holy Blitz--in foal to Awesome Again--was sold for \$75,000 at last fall's Fasig-Tipton November sale. Explaining the decision to part with the up-and-coming mare, Hamelback said, “As part of the program, Mr. Stronach's philosophy is that we are going to sell good mares at times. You saw that when we sold Ginger Punch [by Awesome Again, for \$1.6-million at FTKNOV in 2009] and Tap to Music [by Pleasant Tap, sold for \$390,000 at FTKNOV in 2010]. We sold those mares because in essence, he will always continue to keep a young broodmare band going.”

And according to Hamelback, Adena's philosophy to offer up some of its prized mares to the sale's market, also extends to its younger assets.

“The misconception might be that we are selling culls, but that is not the case,” stated Hamelback. “The group we are offering at Saratoga would certainly dictate these are deeper quality horses for any organization, and we're offering them up at sale. We'll just have to wait and see what the market says.”

#### GI Whitney H. - #1 Successful Dan (12-1)

It's been a pretty inauspicious start to this contest so far for both myself and Steve, but we've finally got a very interesting race here to look at--hopefully one of us (preferably me!) can land on the winner and turn this thing around. All discussions have to start with defending winner Fort Larned, who will be quite formidable if he runs to his BC Classic or last-out Stephen Foster effort. But the speedster will likely be hounded early by the extremely talented Cross Traffic, who ran much too well to lose last time in the Met Mile. That pair seems to be on a collision course, with Mucho Macho Man (who I was tempted to pick but ultimately couldn't trust) not far behind. So with that expected hot early pace (something that never seems to materialize these days), I'll go with **Successful Dan**, who may sit the perfect pocket trip just behind the speed here. He has races that win this--he beat Fort Larned and Mucho Macho Man in last year's GII Alysheba S. with a 110 Beyer Speed Figure--and I'm willing to excuse his fourth in the Stephen Foster. He was never going to win when squeezed while attempting to mount a bid in upper stretch, but he was definitely going to cut it closer than the 15 lengths he was beaten. Plus, Successful Dan never seemed comfortable having to try to keep up with free-wheeling Fort Larned, and I think he's better when allowed to relax a bit more early. He'll definitely get that chance here, and if the workout reports are correct, Wise Dan should be ready to fire a big one. **Wager: \$100 Win on #1 Successful Dan.**

#### GI Whitney H. - #5 Ron the Greek (6-1)

Man, things are getting really ugly in a hurry for both of us here, but there's still plenty of time to turn it around, hopefully. While I will be rooting for my boy Fort Larned to collect his second straight renewal of this prestigious contest, my money will be on **Ron the Greek** at a generous price. The hard-knocking 6-year-old ran one of the best races of his career in defeat over this course when second behind the GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero in this race last year. Favored at 5-2 that day, Ron the Greek came from a mile out of it after making a seven-wide rally on the far turn to finish within 1 1/4 lengths of the winner. A runaway victor of the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream in January (earned a gaudy 115 Beyer), Ron the Greek ran a huge third behind Game on Dude after getting roughed up at the start in the GII Charles Town Classic, but failed to land a blow when a distant third in Fort Larned's impressive GI Stephen Foster H. when that one was left alone on the lead. It doesn't look like Fort Larned will get away with anything like that this time with the presence of the speedy Cross Traffic, as well as the tactical Mucho Macho Man. The deep-closing Ron the Greek figures to get a perfect set-up this time around, and will show that he's still more than capable of competing with the big boys when he brings his best. **Wager: \$100 Win on #5 Ron the Greek.**

### Louisiana Training Center Fire Kills 19 Horses:

A barn fire at River Point training center, adjacent to Louisiana Downs, killed 19 horses, according to published reports. Retired jockey Gino Dezinat was able to save one horse. The neighboring barn caught fire, but the blaze was able to be extinguished quickly. Trainer Dwight Viator lost four horses in the fire including multiple stakes winner Look at the Time (Brahms). "The barn burned down to the ground," Viator told *Daily Racing Form*. "A fire started in one of the living rooms, the only room that somebody was living in, and I don't know, it just went in flames. I got a call at 6 p.m., was here in five, 10 minutes, and it was gone." Viator was told one of the horse managed to break through the front of his stall and escape the flames. "What really hurts me, it's the way the horses die," he said. "The way those that don't get out suffer. These horses are like my kids, and the way they died, that's just not fair."

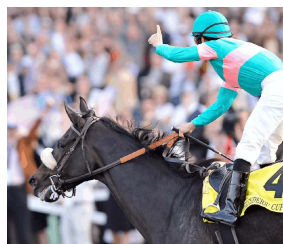

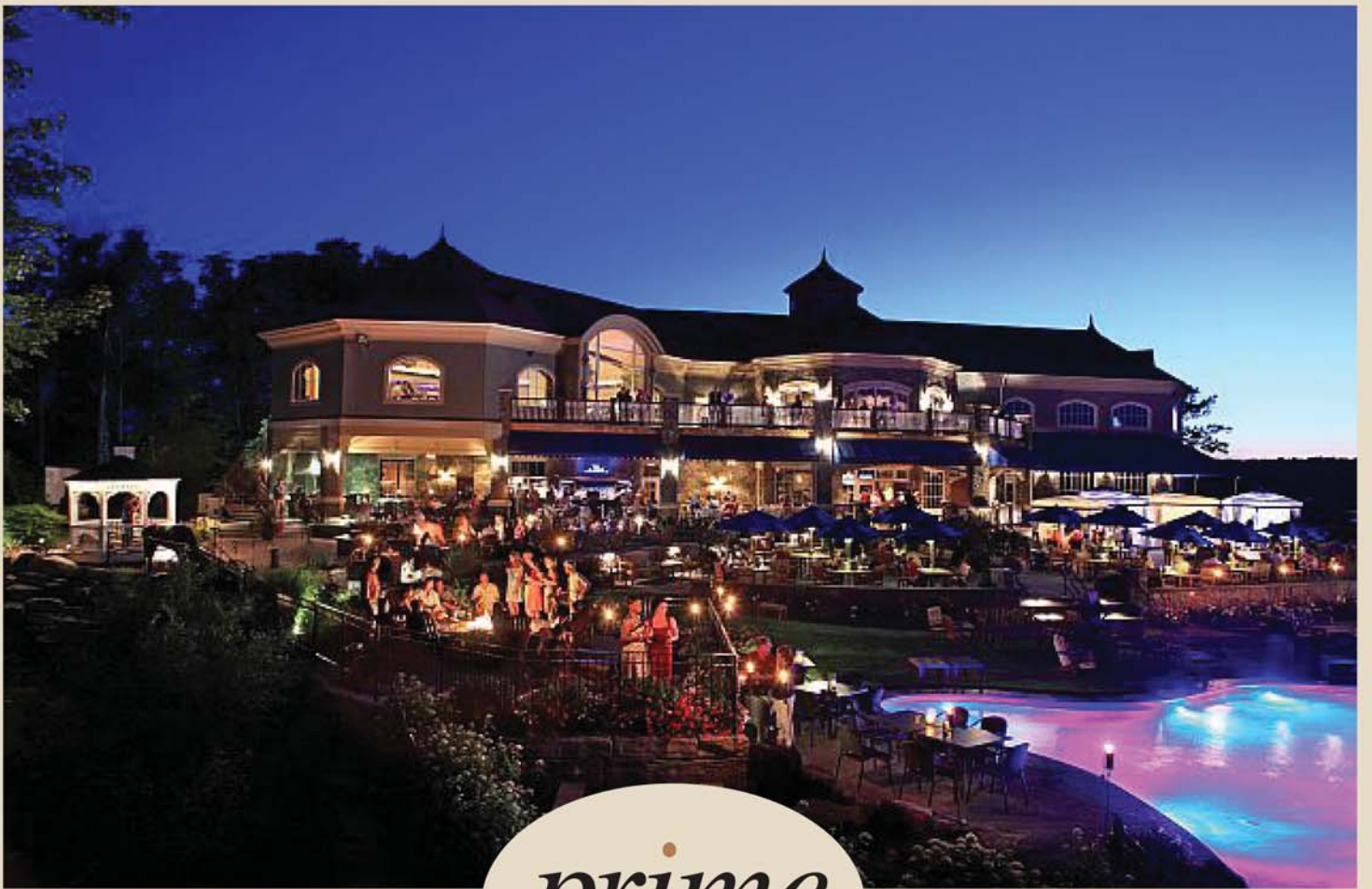
