CROSS TRAFFIC LEAVES HIS 'MARK'

It's been a whirlwind and sometimes aggravating sort of year for Paul Buhlmann's GoldMark Farm. The operation's Mylute (Midnight Lute)--owned in partnership with Whisper Hill Farm--was a strong fifth in the GI Kentucky Derby and third in the GI Preakness, while **Cross Traffic** (Unbridled's Song) had registered a pair of monster Beyer Speed Figures while finishing second in the GIII Westchester S. in April before missing by a nose in the GI Met Mile. Trainer Todd Pletcher took the decision soon after to attempt to stretch out the 4-year-old colt in spite of those big efforts around one turn, and it paid dividends Saturday when the grey set a strong pace from defending champion Fort Larned (E Dubai) and held off a late bid from **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal) to register a breakthrough victory in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga. "It's an unbelievable feeling," Buhlmann enthused when interviewed after the race by HRTV's Scott Hazelton. "Cross Traffic is an awesome horse. He has developed into a top-notch and magnificent specimen and I am pleased to be associated with him." The victory earns Cross Traffic an all-fees paid trip to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, but Buhlmann will let the horse do the talking. "If he says that he's willing to go, then that's what we'll do," he stated. "He's been telling us that he's ready to go. He's filled out and he's been running very well." Cont. p3

SILI SEASON

Not an obvious contender for yesterday's G1 Nassau S., Khalid Abdullah's **Winsili** (GB) (Dansili {GB}) silenced the Goodwood crowds by leading home fellow outsider **Thistle Bird** (GB) (Selkirk) for a shock exacta. With just a single black-type win to her name in the May 17 Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial at Newbury, the homebred was unhurried early by William Buick and, after waiting in rear, made her move out wide, which led to the hampering of the 7-4 favorite **Sky Lantern** (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. In front soon after, the 20-1 shot battled to withstand the challenge of Thistle Bird and score by a neck. "She's not easy and the whole team have done a great job," her rider said. "I decided to take my time, as she has a nice turn of foot and I got a nice run through. The hood helps her a lot and makes her focus, and she was very game." Cont. pxx

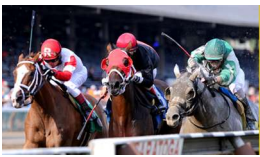

A son of Stop Traffic (Cure the Blues), a seven-furlong specialist who invaded the Spa and defeated Runup the Colors (A.P. Indy) to win the 1998 GI Ballerina H., Cross Traffic was consigned to the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale by Taylor Made and fetched a final bid of \$300,000 from the GoldMark braintrust, but first faced the starter earlier this winter in South Florida. The gun-metal gray validated 7-10 favoritism in easily graduating by 1 3/4 lengths over Gulfstream's one-turn mile Jan. 24 and followed that with a 7 1/2-length thrashing of Fast Falcon (Awesome Again) in a first-level allowance Mar. 10, earning a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆. He was made the even-money chalk in a group including Belmont horse-for-the-course Flat Out (Flatter) in the GIII Westchester S. Apr. 27 and led every step of the way, bar the final one, dropping a head decision to that more-seasoned foe. Cross Traffic pressed on to the GI Met Mile May 27 and was hounded along through six furlongs in a testing 1:09.20, but clung to a late lead only to be foiled by Sahara Sky (Pleasant Tap). To sprint or to route--that was the question--and Cross Traffic answered that in no uncertain terms Saturday to pay homage to his sire, who died last week. **Cont. p4**

Most felt that Cross Traffic would be put to the sword early by Fort Larned, but that one left there a bit flat-footed, and Cross Traffic was allowed a fairly soft opening quarter mile in :24.17, pressed along initially by Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) to the inside and eventually Fort Larned, who was hustled up to press from the outside rounding the first turn. The GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner crept closer to ratchet up the pressure on the pacesetter, and indeed, Cross Traffic was forced to go an internal half-mile from the seven-eighths to the three-furlong pole in :46.07, while the back markers had yet to be heard from. Fort Larned was popped the question outside Cross Traffic at the quarter pole and Mucho Macho Man loomed a threat three deep into the lane, but the front-runner turned back those bids and set sail for the wire. Successful Dan was beginning to find his best stride approaching the lane and was the only danger, as Cross Traffic lugged in at the eighth pole, opening the door just a bit. The eventual winner ducked out a bit at the sixteenth pole, causing both Mucho Macho Man and Successful Dan to shift their ground, but he got to the wire by a diminishing margin. "The first quarter was the most important one; we didn't have to chase him to be there," winning rider John Velazquez commented. "After that, we started picking it up every eighth of a mile, but it was a comfortable pace. I felt comfortable the way he was going."

Dan Uninjured Following Paddock Incident...

Things got interesting about 11 minutes until post time for the Whitney, when Successful Dan reared and fell on the path leading to the track. "When he took the halter off he sucked back, and he crossed his back legs and fell over sideways," trainer Charlie LoPresti explained. "He didn't flip over. He crossed his footing and fell sideways. I did not see it." After warming up quietly, jockey Julien Leparoux brought his mount over to the track vet for one final stamp of approval. "Not at any point did I want to scratch him," said Leparoux. "I just wanted a second opinion to say he's OK. Rather be safe than sorry." Successful Dan is a candidate for the GI Woodward S. Aug. 31. Fort Larned's trainer Ian Wilkes said it was a bad day at the office. "He just walked out of the gates. It wasn't the start we were looking for. He got away bad," Wilkes offered.

Good Things Come to Those Who Wait...

From the time GoldMark representatives signed the ticket until Cross Traffic made the starting gate earlier this winter at Gulfstream Park, some 904 days had passed. In the span of 107 seconds and some change Saturday afternoon, connections' patience was rewarded. "He was just a big, strapping colt, but I just thought he was a bit immature at two," GoldMark's Todd Quast explained when reached by phone Saturday evening. "We got him to the track at three and he was close to running--he worked a bullet at Belmont in May [5f in :59.41]--but came up with a shin problem. We just gave him the time and that was it. Knowing that sire and the family, we just decided to take our time." Quast continued, "It's really kind of phenomenal the progress he's made. It's a testament to taking time with him, because we always thought he was a quality colt." Quast was especially pleased for Cross Traffic to win the Whitney on the sesquicentennial of the track. "It's so great--winning a race like this at Saratoga where we bought him," he said. "[Owner] Paul [Buhlmann] is very much into history and the history of racing. He got to have lunch with Mrs. Whitney. To win this race up here against these horses is really something. There are no other words for it. This is very exciting. We always try to do right by the horse, so it's great to be vindicated for taking the time."

Following an impressive winning debut over seven furlongs at Newmarket in August, Winsili was second to the subsequent Listed UAE 1000 Guineas winner Lovely Pass (Ire) (Raven's Pass) in a mile conditions event at Ascot the following month before being supplemented for the G1 Fillies' Mile. Injured straight after that decision was made and on the sidelines until her convincing return success in a first-time hood in the Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial, the bay failed to see out the 1 1/2 mile trip in the June 20 G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot. Held up early with only the ultimately disappointing Just the Judge (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}) and Thistle Bird behind throughout the early stages, she was kept in the slipstream of Sky Lantern and looked to be traveling the worse of the pair as they entered contention in early stretch. While Richard Hughes remained languid on the grey in front, William Buick's industry in the saddle proved decisive, and he was upsides the favorite passing the quarter pole, and subsequently kept her trapped in behind Sajjhaa (GB) (King's Best) as she rolled by. With Sky Lantern's cause lost by that baulking, Winsili had only the strong closer Thistle Bird to concern her, and she began to emerge best in that war in the final 50 yards. Trainer John Gosden commented, "We were drawn outside, which is a disadvantage, but at least it meant we weren't boxed in. She can't stand still, she has to be moving and is strong-minded. When she goes to the canters in the morning she has to go one other and trot past and if she has to wait, she nearly throws herself on the ground in frustration. Prince Khalid has won four of the last five, which is some achievement." For Sky Lantern's rider Richard Hughes, there was no doubt that the outcome was affected by the incident before the furlong pole. "I had a good run through and edged out to go round Godolphin's mare when Buick's horse rolled down on top of me and put me back on heels," he explained. "I was coming out to win and was very unlucky. I'd had an argy-bargy match earlier with Hot Snap at the top of the hill too."

Lady of Fifty, one of three in the race for Hall of Fame trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, was able to remain in the clear every step of the way in this Breeders' Cup Challenge event for the Ladies' Classic and drove clear late for the upset. The gray, only once off the board in nine previous synthetic tries, bested her elders in the GII Bayakoa H. last Dec. 8 at Hollywood Park, but could do no better than fourth as the favorite behind More Chocolate in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20. Third to Great Hot (Brz) (Orientate) when that one went coast-to-coast in the GII Santa Maria S. Feb. 16, she faltered to be second as the odds-on selection in the GII Marjorie L Everett H. in Inglewood May 18 and was exiting a third as the chalk in the GI Vanity H. June 15. Cont. p7

Rafael Bejarano opted to ride More Chocolate this time around, and Corey Nakatani took over on the double-digit chance. Lady of Fifty raced one from the tail early as stablemate Sister Kate (Benchmark) was pushed along on the engine by Great Hot. Things began to bunch up as the field reached the stretch, but Lady of Fifty, shifted out to the grandstand side, was able to avoid the abundant traffic that was occurring to her inside and found the wire first. More Chocolate came with a good run from midpack and was right there behind the wall of horses turning for home. She tried to go outside of a weakening Sisterhood (Kitten's Joy), but, when stymied there was forced to go inside, and the lost momentum likely cost her the race.

Delivering a near carbon copy of his victory earlier this year in the GIII Illinois Derby, Departing flexed his muscles in this valuable event. Impressive in winning his maiden and first allowance condition at the Fair Grounds over the winter, the homebred drew extremely wide for the GII Risen Star S. in late February and instead shipped to Houston for a decisive victory in the Texas Heritage S. Mar. 2. A good, if green, third to Revolutionary (War Pass) in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 30, he homebred covered a ton of ground, but ran off with the Illinois Derby Apr. 20, scoring by just over three lengths. The gelding made the trip to Pimlico for the GI Preakness S. May 18, but raced on the inside, the worst part of the track that day, and made a mild bid nearing the stretch before settling for sixth, beaten 10 lengths by Oxbow (Awesome Again). The bettors' choice over GI Arkansas Derby winner Overanalyze, Departing was settled in midpack by Robby Albarado, deputizing for Brian Hernandez Jr., and was angled out to the six path and into the clear for the run up the backstretch. About the same time Fort Larned was throwing in the towel in the Whitney, Departing was just warming up, as he cornered to the lead outside Ruler of Love turning for home and walked in. "I just kept him out of trouble and he did everything he needed to do," Albarado commented. Winning trainer Al Stall Jr. said it was unlikely that his charge would press on to the heavies in the GI Travers S. Aug. 24, but could be pointed for races like the Super Derby, Pennsylvania Derby or Indiana Derby, all Grade II events.

Runner-up in a Sept. 21 allowance, Alpha Bettor was fourth to subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile third Delegation (Speightstown) in the GIII Durham Cup Oct. 14. Fourth to James Street (El Prado {Ire}) in the GII Autumn S. Nov. 10, the chestnut got some down time, returning to reverse form with Delegation in the GII Eclipse S. May 12. That Gary Barber runner exacted his revenge last time out in the GIII Dominion Day S. over 10 furlongs July 1, defeating Alpha Bettor into third with James Street a neck better in second. Ultimate Destiny bounced out of the stalls early and led in advance of Awesome Overture as Alpha Bettor boxed them from third and James Street in fourth. Ultimate Destiny still held the call, but only narrowly from Awesome Overture, but Justin Stein took advantage of an opening at the fence and drove through inside of the game pacesetter to score comfortably in the finish. HIGH NOON IN NORMANDY

Today's G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest features a fascinating clash between the treble-seeking **Moonlight Cloud (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and the new sprinting star in the firmament, **Lethal Force (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}), as the duo square up in Deauville. While the

former looked every bit as potent as ever when winning the G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot on her return over seven furlongs at Longchamp July 6, her British peer dominated the June 22 G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 13. George Strawbridge's

star mare has won the last two renewals of this race by a cumulative margin of nine lengths, so she will be a tough rival to master as Lethal Force attempts to stamp his authority on proceedings. Their running style is contrasting, with Alan Craddock's highly-progressive 4-year-old possessing pillar-to-post speed and Moonlight Cloud best coming off the pace with a killer turn of acceleration. Trainer Clive Cox is happy to take on Freddy Head's luminary in her own backyard. "She's a very smart mare; I don't doubt that and we will give her the utmost respect but, at the same time, we're very happy with our horse," he told *PA Sport*. "Obviously, this is six and a half furlongs this time, but we are pleased to move in that direction with him as he has won over seven in the Hungerford. I hope the ground continues to dry at Deauville. At the moment, there's a forecast for the possibility of thunder but then a dry forecast through to Sunday. If the forecast is correct, the ground should suit him, and I hope it will, as that's why we're going there." Last year's G1 Prix de la Foret scorer **Gordon Lord Byron (Ire)** (Byron {GB}) ran into a smart rival in Darwin (Big Brown) when carrying a penalty in the seven-furlong G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh July 20, but will have ground to suit if the thunderstorms arrive in time.

SPRINT SHOWDOWN IN VANDERBILT

Delaunay (Smoke Glacken) and **Gentlemen's Bet** (Half Ours) meet for round two in a compact renewal of the GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. at the Spa. Forced to show a new dimension after getting bumped at the start in the Iowa Sprint H. June 28, 1-5 chalk Delaunay took a narrow lead over Gentlemen's Bet in the stretch that

day before being outkicked home by 1 3/4 lengths. Gentlemen's Bet, a close third behind **Justin Phillip** (First Samurai) in the GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn Apr. 13, was also an impressive winner in an optional claimer at Churchill Downs May 17. He has paired up 107 Beyers in

his last two. "Delaunay is a great horse, and like any athlete they can have better days," train Ron Moquett said of his charge's main rival. "Delaunay is going to run a great race. We're looking at it like they are all going to run their 'A' game. We'll see how we stack up against them. We respect them, but at the same time we look forward to the opportunity. These are the fastest horses in the United States, and we want to state our case." Delaunay, meanwhile, capped a six-race winning streak with a tour-de-force decision in the GII Churchill Downs S. May 4. He has posted two workouts at Saratoga since having his streak snapped in Iowa, including a four-furlong move in :48 July 27. "He didn't break all that well and he gave the field a few lengths," trainer Tom Amoss said. "In fairness, Gentlemen's Bet ran a great race and we're going to have to improve in order for us to win." Amoss continued, "Transitioning him to the Saratoga track has been a bit of a process. He didn't work all that great in his first work over the track, but his second work was better. We're hopeful he's going to handle the track."

Racegoers at Dusseldorf are in for a treat today as Qatar Racing and Newsells Park Stud's **Secret Gesture (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) pays a visit for the G1 Preis der Diana. Having left trainer Ralph Beckett stunned with her defeat by stable companion Talent (GB) (New Approach {Ire}) in the May 31 G1 Epsom Oaks, she should be able to boss these opponents as she did in the May 11 Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial, where the re-opposing **Miss You Too (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) was 10 lengths back in second. "I'm very happy with her physically and mentally going into the race," her trainer told *PA Sport*. "I would imagine she'll start favorite, and we're looking forward to running her. The ground is going to be quick, but I've always been surprised by how well she handled softer ground. There is nothing about her action which suggests she could go on soft." Of the home team, Gestut Haus Ittlingen's **Daytona Bay (GB)** (Motivator {GB}) is one of the most interesting after beating the re-opposing **Quilita (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) and **Ars Nova (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB})--who had previously been successful in the G2 Diana-Trial at Hoppegarten June 9--in the July 6 G3 Hamburger Stuten-Preis. Henri-Alex Pantall has done well in this country in 2013, and brings across Horst Rapp's **Orion Love (GB)** (Zamindar), who boasts smart form in her native France. Runner-up in the G3 Prix de Royaumont over 12 furlongs at Chantilly June 2, she was third in the G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud three weeks later, and that form may be of a high enough quality for her to upstage the domestically-trained fillies.

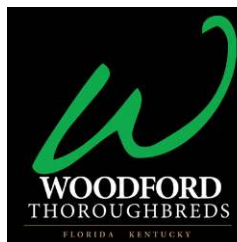

REDDAM REPEAT IN BEST PAL?

Owner J. Paul Reddam audaciously sent Know More (Lion Heart) into last year's GII Best Pal S. as a maiden--an unraced one at that--and emerged looking very smart, as the colt graduated in style. **Ontology** (Tapit) brings race experience into today's renewal and is the 5-2 choice on the morning line to give his owner back-to-back runnings of this prep for the GI Del Mar Futurity in early September. The chestnut, a \$210,000 purchase out of this year's OBS March sale, gave a solid account of himself in a five-furlong test at Hollywood Park, giving game chase when second to **Alpine Luck** (Lucky J. H.). Those foes rematched in the Hollywood Juvenile Championship July 13, and Ontology got to within a half-length of the wire-to-wire winner. He gets a bit more ground to work with here and may get some help to set up a late run as blinkers go on for the first time. Call Alpine Luck's trainer Mike Harrington nonplused about the morning line. "That tickles me, I've beaten him twice and still they make him the favorite," said Harrington, himself a two-time Best Pal winner (Swiss Yodeler, 1996, Creative Cause, 2011). "But it's a pretty evenly matched bunch and there are several in there that could win it. We'll just take a shot and see what happens." **Alberts Hope** (Run Away and Hide) was sent off at a near-hopeless 33-1 for his July 14 bow in Inglewood, but nevertheless turned in one of the most impressive efforts of any juvenile at the meeting, coming from off the speed to score by a widening 3/4 of a length. He's back on just three weeks' rest, but has a smooth five-furlong drill (1:00, 8/82) over this strip and is capable of another surprise, albeit at a fraction of his debut price. Rum Point (Malibu Moon), third on that occasion, wired yesterday's first race at the Seaside oval. Much was expected of **Guns Loaded** (D'wildcat) in his July 20 unveiling over this surface and did not disappoint, leading throughout to score by 1 1/2 lengths. He too has a snappy work under his belt since and can be a pace presence at a minimum.

Wise Dan Goes Easy in Fourstardave Prep...

Reigning Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) got his final tune-up for next Saturday's GII Fourstardave H., covering a half-mile in a sensible :49.59 over the Saratoga main track. It comes one week after scorching the turf training track at Oklahoma to the tune of :57.38 for five furlongs July 27. "I just wanted to do something easy with him," said trainer Charles LoPresti, who trains the 6-year-old for owner Morton Fink. "I wasn't sure what I was going to do. I didn't want to take him to the turf again. I just wanted a nice, easy work for him, just something to keep him ticking over to next week." The emphasis yesterday was clearly not on time, but rather on style. "He could have gone so much faster, but we didn't want him to do that," LoPresti added. "He did that last week. That was the work that prepared him for this race. This was just something to tick him over." Wise Dan carries a seven-race winning streak into next weekend's race, a skein which began in last year's Fourstardave. He was last seen taking the GII Firecracker H. by an eventful two lengths at Churchill Downs June 29.

McPeek Sends Out War Duo for Travers Works...

Breezing in company and both prepping for the GI Travers S. Aug. 24, GII Virginia Derby hero **War Dancer** (War Front) and **Java's Pass** (War Pass), victorious earlier this year in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S., went a half-mile over the Oklahoma training track Saturday morning. War Dancer was awarded with the time of :49.03, while Java's War, last seen finishing fourth in the GII Swaps S. at Hollywood July 4, was timed in :49.41. They were the fourth- and fifth-fastest works on the morning from 53 at the distance. "They worked good," McPeek said. "War Dancer worked super. Java got a little late in the work, but, for the most part, it was a good, solid breeze. They're going to work back next weekend. Just want to stay steady and make sure they eat up."

ROCKPORT HARBOR EUTHANIZED

Rockport Harbor (Unbridled's Song--Regal Miss Copelan, by Copelan), a multiple graded stakes winner for Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farms, was euthanized Friday at age 11 at New Bolton Center in Pennsylvania due to complications from laminitis.

"It's with great sadness that I report that Rockport Harbor has been euthanized due to laminitis," Porter confirmed on his website, www.foxhillfarmstable.com. "Rocky holds a very special place in my heart. He was the first really good colt I had in my stable...Rocky is responsible for a lot of the joy that I've gotten from horse racing, and I'll never forget him."

A \$470,000 Keeneland September purchase by Porter, Rockport Harbor won his first four races by more than 20 lengths combined for trainer John Servis, including scores in the GIII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct. The big gray suffered a hoof injury in the Remsen and never recaptured his top form as a 3-year-old, although he did take the GIII Essex H. at Oaklawn, and finished second in the GIII Rebel S. He retired with five wins from eight starts and earnings of \$324,800, and entered stud at Darley's Jonabell Farm in Kentucky, where he sired 12 black-type winners, including Grade III winners May Day Rose, Pataky Kid and Bryan's Jewel. Rockport Harbor relocated to Pin Oak Lane Farm in Pennsylvania last fall, and currently leads that state's sire rankings, with earnings of \$3,092,293 for the year.

Ouch. Was thinking I may scratch again when Successful Dan fell over on his way to the track, but I guess he exited the incident unscathed considering the way he ran to be a close second. Wish he had been called on a little sooner, and can't believe they didn't take a look at Cross Traffic's antics in the stretch, as the winner veered out sharply, forcing Mucho Macho Man to alter course and interfere with Successful Dan.

GI Alfred G Vanderbilt H. - #5 Caixa Eletronica (10-1)

This might not have come up as great a betting race as the Whitney, but it does seem a bit trickier than the short field might suggest. The key is probably how one analyzes the Iowa Sprint H. in which top two choices Delaunay and Gentlemen's Bet ran one-two. Gentlemen's Bet got the money and a 107 Beyer Speed Figure, but it's hard to deny that Delaunay ran the better race considering his poor start and subsequent wide move. The latter hails from a barn that has sent out two runners who disappointed in stakes this meet, however, and I'm hesitant to trust Delaunay--especially at a short price--to return to his best form (which would make him very tough to beat). I can't take Gentlemen's Bet on principle if I'm against the horse who ran better than him last time--not to mention that that pair may hook up early if Delaunay breaks better. Of the remaining three runners, on their best day, **Caixa Eletronica** is the fastest. He has two 107 Beyers at six panels (career tops) and makes an interesting cut back off a nine-furlong starter optional claiming win just eight days earlier. Trainer Todd Pletcher has had success with Caixa Eletronica turning back in the past, most notably when the veteran came out of a fourth-place finish in the Met Mile to run down Justin Phillip from out of the clouds in last year's GII True North. My biggest concern is that Caixa Eletronica will leave himself with too much work to do in the lane, but if he keeps close early and gets the right set-up, he could prove dangerous late as the longest shot on the board. **Wager: \$50 Win on #5 Caixa Eletronica.**

I've been on the Delaunay bandwagon since he began rolling at the Fair Grounds meet earlier this winter, but after listening to owner Maggi Moss express her concerns about how her charge will handle the Saratoga surface on the NTRA teleconference earlier this week, and also seeing Tom Amoss echo those sentiments in the NYRA notes, it's hard to get too excited about backing the former claimer as the chalk here. That being said, I have enough history with **Justin Phillip** that makes me want to chase after him again, especially if he goes off as the fourth choice. A painful second at 6-1 in this race last year (can you tell that I backed him that day?), the dark bay got back on track with a pair of wins at Oaklawn earlier this term, and also placed a solid second over a speed-favoring surface in the GII True North H. on the GI Belmont S. undercard. Willing to give him a pass for a mediocre fourth over the tricky Calder surface in the GII Smile Sprint H. July 6, and he's more than capable of stepping up with a big one over this course despite being winless in four prior attempts. Getting re-united with Johnny V can't be a bad thing, either. **Wager: \$50 Win on #4 Justin Phillip.**

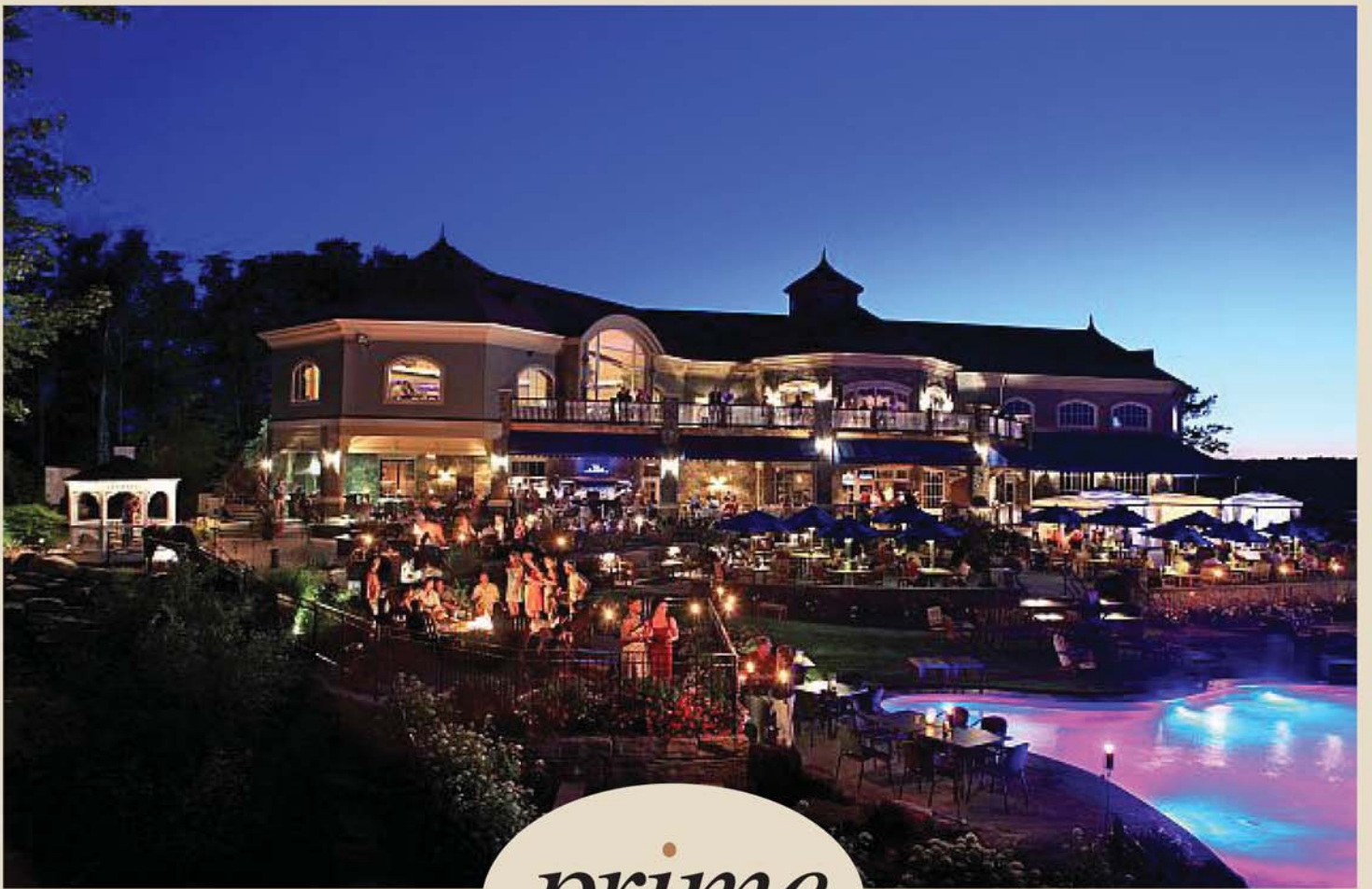
