SO COMPOSED

Lord Lloyd-Webber's **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), undone by York's heavy rain showers when runner-up in the G1 Darley Yorkshire Oaks a year ago, atoned for a rare disappointing unplaced effort last time in the G1 Eclipse S. to turn this year's renewal into a procession Thursday. Always traveling with her customary verve

under a confident William Buick, the homebred bay, who started as the 2-1 favorite, was unextended to overhaul **Venus de Milo (Ire)** (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}) approaching the furlong pole before surging clear under hand riding to score by four lengths in the Breeders' Cup 'Win and You're In' event. "Everybody at home has had so much confidence in her and she showed today how good she is," Buick said. "She loves this ground, saw the trip out really well and was awesome today." **Cont. p3**

IF AT FIRST...

Knocking on the door in two of Britain's major sprints this season, Brian Joffe and Myron Berzack's **Shea Shea (SAf)** (National Emblem {SAf}) tries again in today's G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. at York. More suited to this five-furlong trip than the stamina-stretching six of Newmarket's G1 July Cup, the South African flag-bearer still managed a creditable fourth in that July 13 feature to add to his previous second to **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}) in Royal Ascot's G1 King's Stand S. over this trip June 18. He had beaten that 2010 Nunthorpe hero in both the Mar. 9 Listed Meydan Sprint and G1 Al Quoz Sprint three weeks later and trainer Mike de Kock is hoping the cards fall right here.

"I think this is a better track for him--flatter and faster [than Ascot and Newmarket]," de Kock said. "He'll be much more suited to that than six furlongs up the hill at Newmarket and last time we may have been a little far back. Being his third run back from a rest, Shea Shea should possibly be at his best, but there's always the luck in running--what happens on the day, how they break, how they don't. There's never much between these really top sprinters and everyone's there trying to win." **Cont. p8**

ELEVEN TO DANCE IN BALLERINA

Saratoga's G1 Ballerina S., a Win and You're In for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint, will be headlined by California shipper **Book Review** (Giant's Causeway). Though the Gary and Mary West colorbearer is coming from the West Coast for this test, she is no stranger to Saratoga, having won an allowance affair there last year when under the care of trainer Chad Brown. She eeked out a win in Santa Anita's G1 La Brea S. in her first start after transferring to conditioner Bob Baffert Dec. 26. She was runner-up in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20 and GII Santa Maria Feb. 16 before turning back to score in the GII A Gleam H. over the Betfair Hollywood Park synthetic July 13.

Susan Wantz's **Dance to Bristol** (Speightstown) looks to make it seven in a row and is installed as the 3-1 second choice on the morning line. The consistent chestnut annexed the GIII Bed o' Roses H. at Belmont June 15 and the GII Honorable Miss H. here July 29.

Starship Truffles (Ghostzapper) will make her first start here since topping the Fasig-Tipton July Horses of Racing Age Sale. Castelton Lyons purchased her for \$1,000,000 after she upset Calder's G1 Princess Rooney H. July 6 under the colors of Chasing Tails Stables. She remains in the Marty Wolfson stable. **Cont. p8**

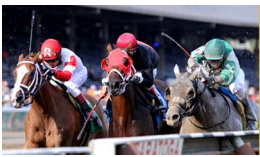

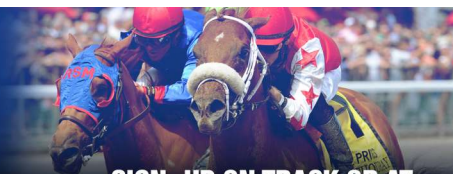

Despite the ground reading officially 'good-to-firm' for this race 12 months ago, the effect of the thunderstorm was sufficient to swing conditions in favor of the French raider **Shareta (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire})** and **The Fugue** was denied the chance to follow up her G1 **Nassau S.** success by a neck. Trouble in running had arguably denied her a Classic win in the G1 **Epsom Oaks** and also the G1 **Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf**, in which she was caged up on the rail at a crucial stage but connections were determined to return at four and put matters straight. Third on her return in the G1 **Prince of Wales's S.** at Royal Ascot June 19, she reportedly returned sick after finishing last of the seven that contested **Sandown's Eclipse** last time July 6, but the signs were strong that she was back on song for this as the market support spoke volumes. Taken back early several lengths off the pace set by the positively ridden **Scintillula (Ire) (Galileo {Ire})**, she traveled with the elan that characterised her winning performance in last year's G3 **Musidora S.** at this venue and by the time she reached mid-stretch clearly had the measure of **Venus de Milo** ahead. Coaxed past the **Ballydoyle** challenger with the final furlong to cover, she was quickly beyond reach to add another edition to her owner-breeder's roster following the exploits of **Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire})** in 2009.

"She's done well to come back after being so ill after the Eclipse," trainer John Gosden commented. "I thought she would really get to the colts that day and give them a race and it is a testament to her that she has come back, as she scoped with a horrible mucus in her and it flattened her considerably for two weeks. She has proven that she is tough and mentally strong and shown resilience. Last year, William kicked and looked to have won the race, but got nailed by **Shareta** so I told him to wait today. She likes this flat, galloping track and top-of-the-ground and outsprinted them. She has been unlucky in previous races, but that happens and she is obviously the best of the elders. I would consider the G1 **Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe** [at Longchamp Oct. 6] if the ground is good or good-to-soft, but not if it's bottomless and then there is the **Breeders' Cup** at the end of the year."

Following successes in a maiden on Newmarket's Rowley Mile May 16 and a conditions event at Yarmouth 12 days later, Lucky Kristale was one of a clutch of smart fillies treated as mere flotsam in the wake of Kiyoshi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in Royal Ascot's G3 Albany S. June 21. The bay rebounding from that spanking to take the G2 Duchess of Cambridge S. at Newmarket last time July 12 and made light of a subsequent penalty in this 'Win and You're In' event for the G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. Settled in rear early by Tom Queally while racing among the stand's-side group, she found a turn of acceleration which her rivals lacked and, after swooping on the lead just before the furlong pole, stretched away to score comfortably. "She was supposed to go for the Prix Morny, but despite working really well she choked and her scope was dirty but we caught it early," reported trainer George Margaron. *cont. p5*

“She hadn’t galloped for 10 days, so we were pushing it a bit. She would miss the bus if you didn’t ask her, but you wouldn’t get past here in a queue when she’s woken up and she’ll get the mile in the Guineas. There is a lot of improvement in her and I don’t think I’ve got to the bottom of her. She’ll go straight to the G1 Cheveley Park S. [at Newmarket Sept. 28]. Tom says the further she goes the better she’ll get and that seven furlongs or a mile will be no problem, but she has so much toe, we might as well use that over six. I am as excited with her as I was with my best horse, Barathea Guest (GB), and he still has the edge in my heart and I’ve ridden horses like Gunner B and Katies when I was with Mick Ryan, so I know a good one when I’ve got one.”

A former Jean-Claude Rouget project before her switch to Ireland, Fiesolana had the pace to win the G3 Ballyogan S. over six furlongs at Leopardstown June 13 and followed up under a penalty in the G3 Brownstown S. over another panel at Fairyhouse July 3. Only sixth tried over nine furlongs in The Curragh's G2 Kilboy Estate S., the form of that contest was boosted by the subsequent Stateside exploits of the winner Dank (GB) (Dansili {GB}) and she was the subject of support back in her comfort zone here. Stalking early on the inside, the bay muscled her way out of a pocket to overhaul Sea Siren passing the furlong pole and stayed on the stronger of that pair to the line. "I thought she might be undercooked for this, but she doesn't take a lot of work," trainer Willie McCreery said. "We might go to Longchamp for the [Oct. 6] G1 Prix de la Foret."

Cup Classic.

Trainer Bob Baffert was pleased with the draw. "It's a good draw because he's on the outside looking in," Baffert said. The 6-year-old gelding was sixth in the 10-furlong race in 2011 and runner-up behind **Dullahan** (Even the Score) a year ago. Game on Dude is unbeaten in four starts this term, including a last-out victory in the July 6 GI Hollywood Gold Cup, but his presence didn't scare away the competition.



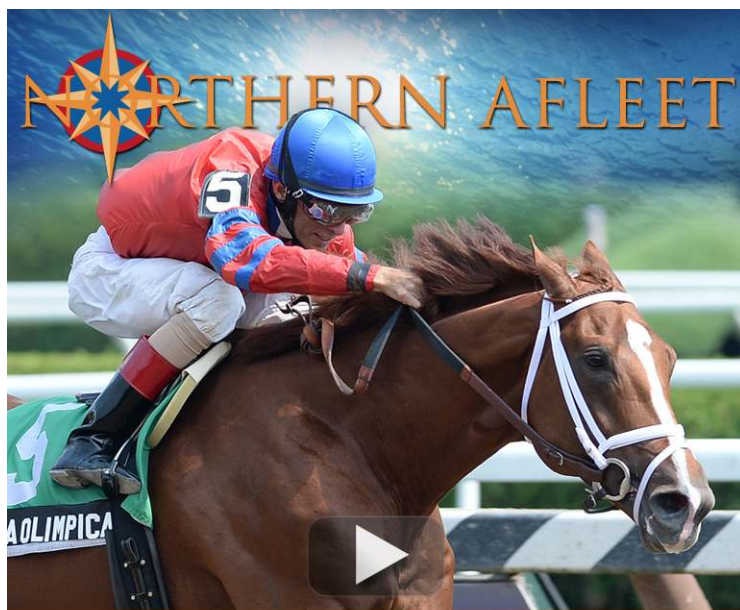

"It's the synthetic track, that's why, it can be a crapshoot," Baffert said of the 12-horse field. "I'm not offended. It's a \$1-million race. Everybody thinks they can win. I can't keep them out."

Winless in five starts since taking the 2012 Pacific Classic, Dullahan returns as the 7-2 second choice and breaks from post nine. "It is what it is," Tammy Fox, assistant to trainer Dale Romans, said of the draw. "I don't know how well the outside posts have been doing here, but the best horse is going to win and, if he's the best, he can win from there."

Dullahan disappointed in a pair of races in Dubai, including an 11th-place effort in the G1 Dubai World Cup, but returned with a solid third-place effort in the July 13 GIII Arlington H. "His race in Chicago was a good prep for him and hopefully he'll rebound like he did last year and get the money," Fox added.

Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid), a two-time winner of the Pacific Classic, ended a winless drought with a victory in the July 26 GIII Cougar H. The Doug O'Neill trainee won this race in 2009 and 2010 and was third last year. He is 8-1 on the morning line. "I'm super pleased," O'Neill said of Richard's Kid post six. "We'll be loading near the end, so he won't have to stand in there very long, and we should be able to get a good spot."

It only takes two weeks to have that put right, so he'll come back in the autumn and go back to a mile at Ascot or in America."

"He's a beautiful horse. Wow. I had seen his form and seen him run on TV and all that, but I had never seen him physically. Boy, he's a beautiful horse. He should be a factor in the [GI] Forego S. [Aug. 31]. That's why he's here."

GI Ballerina S. - #5 Book Review (5-2)

I hate to take a short price in a field of 11, but to me, there's a huge standout in this race. Book Review looks extremely tough to beat, and even if she goes favored, the presence of win machine Dance to Bristol and a full field means my pick's price can only go so low. First a bit on Dance to Bristol: it's hard to knock a horse who's won her last six and only been out of the exacta once, but I'm not sold on the quality of fields she has beaten. Plus the seas parted for her last time after she got a solid pace set-up, and now she has to contend with the rail. Book Review, meanwhile, has proven that she's best around one turn--and specifically this seven-panel trip at which she's five-for-six. Her track-and-trip allowance win last year probably takes this or comes close, and though she subsequently disappointed in the Test, her only bad race since then was at 1 1/8 miles. The West homebred's victory off the bench in the Gil A Gleam H. last out July 13 came against a short, but accomplished field, and she didn't seem to be loving the synthetic in her first try on it. With a start under her belt and enough pace in front of her thanks to six-furlong types like Classic Point and Starship Truffles, Book Review should only need a bit of racing luck to handle this field.

Hung out five-wide in a five-horse field in the GIII Winning Colors S. at Churchill Downs May 27, Judy the Beauty came surging late to place within 3/4 of a length of the winner that day.

Favored in the GI Princess Rooney H. at Calder July 6, she ran a big one in defeat once again, launching a wide rally after blowing the break to complete the exacta behind Starship Truffles. Judy the Beauty's been training up a storm since, including a best-of-44 five-furlong bullet in :58 1/5 at Saratoga Aug. 11. Drawn favorably on the outside here, the tactical runner should see out a perfect stalking trip and have every chance to get the money if she's good enough. Getting re-united with Rosario for the first time since her tally in Lexington earlier this spring can't be a bad thing, either. Hard not to respect a filly that's finished no worse than second in 10 career starts and who boasts wins in three different countries. **Wager: \$44 Win on #8 Judy the Beauty.**

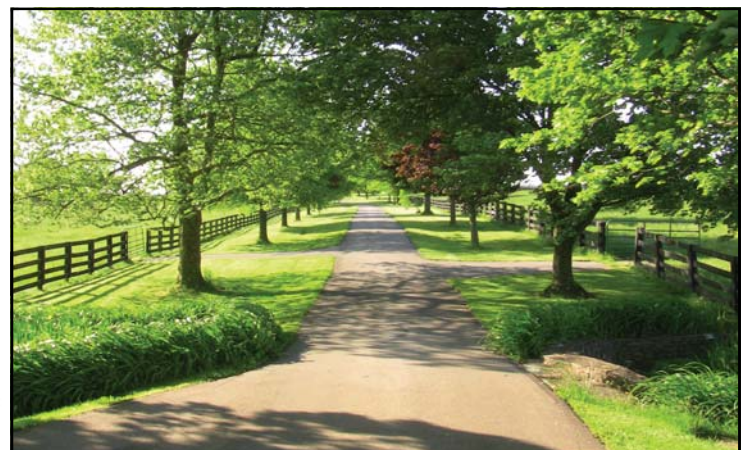
