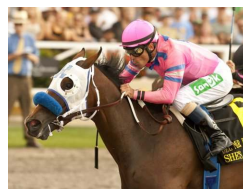

Little had gone right for Alpha since his Travers win. A head-scratching sixth as the 3-5 chalk in the GII Pennsylvania Derby, Alpha concluded his sophomore campaign with a well-beaten 12th in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 3.

Sent to Dubai, Alpha was 12th again in Round 2 of the G2 Al Maktoum Challenge Feb. 7, then was a decent fifth in the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 30. Freshened, he failed to land a blow when fourth in the GII Suburban H. July 6 and sixth in the GI Whitney Invitational H. Aug. 3. Alpha was sporting blinkers for the first time since the Godolphin Mile yesterday. "I think the start was a big, big difference," McLaughlin continued. "Maybe he wasn't as fit as I thought he was the last two races. We had him dead-ready and fit today. Johnny [Velazquez] did a great job breaking well because he's had his gate issues. The stretch run was more nerve-wracking than the Travers, because we were there, trying to hold him off. But it was great. I told Johnny if he breaks well and he can throw mud on the rest of them, please do. He agreed with me. I wish Saratoga was open a little longer for him because he loves it here. He's a nice horse, a really neat horse to be around. I'm just happy for the whole team." Velazquez added, "Once we got to the first turn where I wanted to be, he sat in the four path. We waited until the quarter-pole when the other horse came to me. Once that other horse didn't pass me at the three-sixteenths pole, I knew my horse was going to put up a good fight. Obviously, he did and kicked ahead."

Paynter Fails to Power Up...

It wasn't Paynter's day in the Woodward after lunging at the break. Favored at 3-2, the 2012 GI Haskell hero chased on the outside from second and faded in the stretch to finish last of five. "He broke a little slow, but I found my position right away," jockey Rafael Bejarano offered. "We had a good trip, but I was out of horse by the half-mile. I think he didn't feel comfortable on the surface. He never felt comfortable."

SAY WHAT?

Bill Mott, trainer of runner-up Flat Out and fourth-place finisher Ron the Greek:

"They both ran good. The pace didn't really set up for Ron, but the other horse [Flat Out] made his run at the horse on the lead [Alpha], and he did everything but catch him. I can't complain. The horse gave a big effort, both horses."

Junior Alvarado, jockey aboard Flat Out:

"He ran his race and he put everything he had and we just didn't get lucky at the wire. [Alpha] was strong and ran a great race, too. The only thing, I was expecting Paynter to go with him, but [Alpha] made the lead easy and I had to start going after him a little bit at the three-eighths pole, and that was a long move for him."

Strapping Groom, claimed for \$35,000 off breeder Kinsman Stable and trainer Carl Domino out of a second-place finish at Belmont while returning from a lengthy layoff May 24, stepped up immediately for his new connections with a smart wire-to-wire tally in Belmont's Lion Cavern S. June 26. He faded to finish fifth behind Sage Valley (Discreet Cat) in Saratoga's GIII James Marvin S. July 19, then got back on track in the Kid Russell S. going 6 1/2 furlongs over this course Aug. 12.

Overlooked by the Saratoga faithful here, Strapping Groom broke alertly from his outside post, and held a narrow advantage over Fast Bullet through an opening quarter in :22.92. He began to shake clear on the far turn through a half mile in :45.22 just as Jackson Bend began to wind up from the back of the pack. Wandering a bit to the outside in the stretch, Junior Alvarado straightened out Strapping Groom, and held the 2011 GI Forego S. champ safe in dramatic fashion. "When you claim a horse, you always have high expectations," trainer and co-owner David Jacobson said after saddling his first win at the highest level in a flat race. "I always liked him going back to when he was laid up. Even back then I told my assistant, Frank LaBocchetta, I thought he was fast enough to win a graded stakes. Frank reminded me of that 10 minutes ago. Carl Domino did an outstanding job bringing him back, and he was in great shape when I claimed him." Jacobson continued, "We were fortunate to have an outside post. The horse likes to be on the lead, and Junior [Alvarado's] instructions were to get the lead if he could. After he put away Fast Bullet, I was pretty confident he was going to win." Alvarado added, "Turning for home, I knew I would have something left. When I asked him, he made a great run. I felt [Jackson Bend] coming through along the rail, but I knew I was close enough to the wire. I knew it was my race already."

Atlantic Jewel, making her first start in 16 months, finished with her perfect record intact and her reputation enhanced here, showing no signs of rust while striding clear impressively. A A\$320,000 yearling acquisition by Demi O'Byrne at the 2010 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Atlantic Jewel did not appear on the racetrack until her 3-year-old season, but she quickly made up for lost time, taking the 2011 G1 Caulfield 1000 Guineas over the smart Mosheen (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) in her fourth outing. Adding the G2 Wakeful S. two weeks later, Atlantic Jewel took a much-earned spell before returning to lift the G2 Sapphire S. and G1 All Aged S. at Randwick last April en route to champion 3-year-old filly honors. Injury kept the imposing bay from the racetrack for 16 months thereafter, but the champion signaled she may be better than ever yesterday. Taking up a stalking position through the early stages, Atlantic Jewel was hung four-wide on the turn, but shrugged off that inconvenience, charging to the lead under a Michael Rodd handride and crossing the wire eased down. "It's just a relief to get her back from such a long time off," Rodd told *Racenet.com.au*. "We know she's got the engine there. I just had to keep her out of trouble. I was kind to her because she's had a bit of time off and [trainer Mark Kavanagh] would have got up me a bit if I had ridden her out. I had to be a little bit careful, but it's a relief more than anything that her campaign is on track." Atlantic Jewel is expected to target the G1 Cox Plate at Moonee Valley Oct. 26, for which she is one of the early favorites.

Despite experiencing most of his success on the turf, it took a return to the Arlington Poly--where he broke his maiden first out three years ago at the expense of Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz})--for Willcox Inn to snap a 13-month losing streak. He rounded out his juvenile campaign with third-place finishes in Keeneland's GI Futurity S. and the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, and earned his first black-type score in the Arlington Classic the following May. He followed up with a victory in GII American Derby over the Arlington lawn, and added the GIII Hawthorne Derby before the year was out. Shelved after an eighth-place finish in the GI Hollywood Derby, Willcox Inn returned a winner in his seasonal bow last year, but had failed to find the winner's circle since then while keeping some lofty company in races like the GI Arlington Million, GI Shadwell Turf Mile and GI Breeders' Cup Mile. He strung together a pair of half-length defeats in the GII Mervin Muniz Jr. H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 30 and the GII Dixie S. at Pimlico May. 18, and was most recently fifth in the GI United Nations H. at Monmouth July 6. Dropping out to the rear of the field through the early stages here, Willcox Inn kicked into gear entering the turn. Four-wide in third at the quarter pole, the dark bay shifted inwards slightly entering the lane, and was under an all-out drive in the final stages to best the determined frontrunner Gallant Eagle.

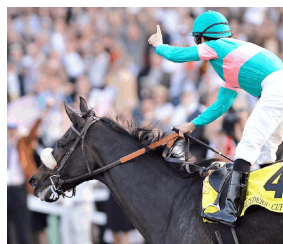

She lacked the experience of Ladys First, who had maintained an admirable level of consistency throughout her busy career so far, and who had flaunted her wares when beating Dank (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the Listed Dick Hern EBF Fillies' S. over this trip at Haydock before finishing runner-up to that talented performer in this race last August. Whereas Integral was denied an ideal early position as she was shuffled back to the rear, Ladys First was able to enjoy the lead and stay out of trouble under Tony Hamilton. As the leader traveled strongly approaching the final quarter mile, Ryan Moore made a wide move on the favorite to grab the advantage, but was unable to shake off his main rival and, after looking likely to succumb in the final 100 yards, drew a rally from Integral to re-join the rail-runner on the line. "She is tough and game and deserves it, as she's run in all the big races," Hamilton said, while Integral's trainer Sir Michael Stoute commented, "The other horse is admirably consistent and I thought she had beaten us, so I'm relieved to share the prize. Ryan [Moore] went too early and said he messed up and got her into top gear too quickly. BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

MAKE PLETCHER'S A DOUBLE

Leading trainer Todd Pletcher boasts the top two choices on the morning line in Saratoga's G1 Spinaway S. today as he looks for his fifth victory in the end-of-the-meet championship for juvenile fillies. Alto Racing's **Sweet Whiskey** (Old Fashioned) breaks from the far-outside nine post as she looks to justify the ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ distinction. The \$300,000 OBSMAR buy entered a 5 1/2-furlong heat Aug. 11 with quite the reputation, and left a 5 1/4-length graduate in front-running style. "It's a little bit of a short rest, and that's always a concern," Pletcher offered. "And going to seven furlongs is always a concern, but she really impressed us with her breeze the other day (four furlongs in a bullet :47.69 on the main track) and certainly showed us that she is behaving as if she's ready to come back with another big effort. We hope she runs to her training." Joining Sweet Whiskey from the Pletcher brigade is Repole Stable's **Stopchargingmaria** (Tale of the Cat), another hot firster who lived up to the hype. Backed down to 1-2 here on opening day, the \$220,000 OBSMAR buy aired by 5 1/2 lengths. **Art of the Game** (Elusive Quality) was fourth with trouble in that race, and returned to win by daylight stepping up to 6 1/2 panels Aug. 18. Pletcher's first-call rider John Velazquez lands on Sweet Whiskey, freeing up Stopchargingmaria for Javier Castellano, who picked up the mount on Thursday's GII With Anticipation winner Bashart (War Front) when Velazquez chose another Pletcher trainee. The Spinaway also features the dead-heat winners of the July 19 GIII Schuylerville S.--**Brazen Persuasion** (Indian Charlie) and **Bahnah** (Elusive Quality)--as well as Valene Farms's **Designer Legs** (Graeme Hall), who was promoted to first via DQ in the Aug. 11 GII Adirondack S. Let go at 16-1 off a win in the July 20 Prairie Gold Lassie and trainer change from Gary Scherer to Dallas Stewart, the chestnut came just short of Who's in Town (Speightstown) at the wire, but was placed first when the unofficial winner was demoted to fourth for interference with heavy favorite Fiftyshadesofgold (My Golden Song) as well as some bumping with Designer Legs herself. "She ran hard," Stewart said of his charge's Adirondack performance. "She got bumped, but she ran hard. She's doing very well, and she looks like she's growing, and we're happy with the way she's coming up to the race. We hope for a repeat of the performance from last time."

This is not our main plan, we want him to be 100% in five weeks' time. The ground at Baden-Baden is on the slow side, but it is drying up. He wouldn't want the ground too fast, but there should be a little bit of cut in the ground and he should be fine." If ring-rustiness takes away Novellist's brilliance, there is a door open for his progressive stable companion **Seismos (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) after he beat the 3-year-old **Empoli (Ger)** (Halling) by four lengths in the G1 Grosser Preis von Bayern over this trip at Munich Aug. 11.

The Curragh's G1 Moyglare Stud S. is another home highlight which has come to be dominated by Aidan O'Brien, and the supplemented ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Tapestry (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) has strong credentials to add a seventh edition to the Ballydoyle conditioner's current record today in this automatic qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. Like her dam Rumpelstiltskin (Ire) (Danehill), Susan Magnier's unbeaten filly enters this contest on the back of a smooth course-and-distance win in the G2 Debutante S. Aug. 11, and bids to emulate her success eight years ago. "This was always the plan, and she's won her two starts very nicely," O'Brien said. "She's in good form and everything seems very well with her. It looks a good race and it will be a good experience for her." If any filly is able to break the Ballydoyle dominion, it is Qatar Racing's impressive G3 Albany S. winner **Kiyoshi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who has been rested since winning a deep renewal of that six-furlong Royal Ascot contest June 21. No less than five who finished in her wake there have gone on to win black-type contests subsequently, including another re-opposing Ballydoyle representative in the July 18 G3 Silver Flash S. winner **Wonderfully (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), and connections are confident Kiyoshi can make her presence felt here. "We've been really happy with her and she is where we want her at this stage," trainer Charlie Hills said yesterday. "She traveled over nice and cool and ate and drank. It's going to be a tough race, but she certainly deserves to be there and seven furlongs should really suit her. She's bred to want further than six furlongs, and The Curragh is one of the best tracks in the world, so I would imagine there will be beautiful ground and there will be no excuses at all there." Trying this trip for the first time is Sheikh Rashid Dalmook Al Maktoum's already-accomplished **Rizeena (Ire)** (Iffraaj {GB}), who followed a win in the June 19 G2 Queen Mary S. over five furlongs at Royal Ascot with a second in the G3 Duchess of Cambridge S. at Newmarket July 12, and third in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 18 over six. "She's in great form--her weight is good and Clive [Brittain] is very happy with her training and has never been more pleased with her," the owner's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told *PA Sport*. "Obviously, it's going to be tough with Charlie Hills' horse, who looks a worthy favourite, but our filly is very good."

British import **Rising Legend (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) went last-to-second in Betfair Hollywood Park's GIII Generous S. in November, but wasn't seen again until belying 7-1 odds with another late rally in the Oceanside. A neck back of that Hronis Racing colorbearer was **Gabriel Charles** (Street Hero), who made the last move and may have gotten the money had he not been forced to switch paths and make his bid in between horses late.

Saturday Recap: Well, miraculously, I finally found a winner, and it came at a time that I was getting killed so badly that I had him for the max bet. **Strapping Groom** (+\$1976) pulled off the shocker, heading a Showdown at the Spa exacta that paid \$215 (Seemed a little light--hopefully because of the TDN faithful). The Woodward didn't go quite so well, however, as **Flat Out** (-\$130) couldn't get by Alpha despite looking like the winner for most of the way. That head hurt pretty bad on the personal wagering front.

GI Spinaway S. - #4 Sweet Reason (8-1)

I'm sure she's the biggest wise guy horse of all time, but I can't help but take a shot with **Sweet Reason** here. The run she put in in the stretch of her debut to win going away by 6 1/4 lengths was just jaw-dropping. Devoid of early speed in the sloppy 5 1/2-furlong test, the Leah Gyarmati trainee tipped out and inhaled a seemingly home free pacesetter to win with a turn of foot rarely seen on dirt. Granted, the slop could have had something to do with it, but wet tracks usually aid frontrunners--not closers--and it's not as if the daughter of Street Sense is bred to relish a short sprint. Plus there's a good chance she sees another wet track today (hopefully that doesn't kill her price). She should improve with more ground, just like her half-sister Don't Forget Gil (Kafwain), a graded stakes winner around two turns who was a close second in a weak renewal of the GI Coaching Club American Oaks when it was run at 1 1/4 miles at Belmont. There should be enough pace to set up for a closer and enough money on Pletcher, et al. to hopefully keep the price on Sweet Reason inflated. **Wager: \$146 Win on #4 Sweet Reason.**

Was forced to watch the Woodward with no action after the late scratch of **Mucho Macho Man**...

GI Spinaway S. - #5 Dancing House (12-1)

As much as I love factoring speed figures into my handicapping, it's never too good an idea to read into them too much--good or bad--when analyzing 2-year-olds, who can improve dramatically race-to-race. The well-bred **Dancing House** showed enough tenacity in her six-furlong debut at the Spa July 31 that makes me want to take a shot with her despite earning a lowly 58 Beyer Speed Figure that day. Sent off at 4-1 for the red-hot Kiaran McLaughlin, the gray sat within striking distance in fifth after getting roughed up a bit at the break. Racing in tight quarters for most of the way beneath Irad Ortiz Jr., Dancing House came with a sustained stretch rally to get the money in game fashion by a head. Produced by the classy millionaire Tout Charmant, the daughter of Tapit should certainly appreciate the added real estate and figures to get a pretty nice set-up as well. How can you go wrong getting 12-1 on the hottest barn in town right now? **Wager: \$100 Win on #5 Dancing House.**

SAEZ ACCUSED OF USING ELECTRONIC DEVICE IN TRAVERS Luis Saez, who piloted Willis Horton's **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song) to victory in last weekend's GI Travers S., has been accused by the connections of 30-1 runner up **Moreno** (Ghostzapper) of using an electric device during the race, according to published reports.

Moreno's connections have filed a complaint with the New York State Gaming Commission. Moreno's trainer Eric Guillot alleges that NBC video footage shows Saez tucking an electric buzzer under his saddle while galloping out.

"We have received a complaint, which we are thoroughly investigating," Lee Park, spokesman for the NYSGC, told *Daily Racing Form*. We have sought the assistance of the New York State Police, which has expertise in video analysis."

The three NYRA track stewards are also involved in the investigation. Saez, speaking through his agent Richard DePass, denied the allegations.

"It's absurd for someone to make an accusation like that," DePass told *DRF*. "We deny it one million percent. We're going to get an attorney and pursue this vigorously."

D. Wayne Lukas, trainer of Will Take Charge, spoke out in support of Saez.

"It's just unfortunate," Lukas told *DRF*. "That's a good kid. He didn't do anything wrong. It'll run its course. The people that look at that stuff will come to the right conclusion."

The Travers was the first Grade I victory for Saez, a 21-year-old native of Panama City.

STRAUSS RETIRES AS DMTC CHAIR

Robert Strauss, presidential cabinet member, statesman, and lawyer, has stepped down from his 12-year post as the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club's board of directors Chairman.

David Batchelder, businessman, board member for the past five years, and racehorse owner, was unanimously voted to fill the role.

"I am honored to be associated with the exemplary management and board of the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club," Batchelder said. "Del Mar sets the standard for all of horse racing with its incredible location and facility, combined with the passion of its fans and the integrity of its leadership. I also would like to add my personal thanks to Mr. Strauss for his leadership as our chairman."

The 94-year-old Strauss will stay involved as a director and chairman emeritus.

"Del Mar is just a wonderful place to be each summer and it has been my great joy to be involved with it over these many years," Strauss said. "The fine sport, the special people and the marvelous setting have all blended together to make it a magical summer playground for any and all."

Financial Mogul was sent off as the 2-1 chalk, but could do no better than fourth in the July 22 maiden eventually won in dominating fashion by Monday's GI Hopeful S. contestant Big Sugar Soda (Ready's Image). The winner, who was also a \$170,000 KEESEP RNA, is a half to Bear in the Woods (Formal Gold), GISP, \$210,200. Hailing from the final crop of legendary Lane's End sire A.P. Indy--who was pensioned in April 2011--Honor Code was raised at the Justice family's Dell Ridge Farm, but was always on the radar of Lane's End's Will Farish.

"We sell some horses for them, and they saw him as a foal and followed through and bought into him privately as a young yearling in early 2012, and we stayed in for a small piece," commented Dell Ridge's Des Ryan. "He's always been a nice big horse, one of those that was born pretty and he's stayed pretty. He never went through one of those awkward phases. Has a lot of presence and a lot of class, very kind horse to be around."

Farish, who has seen and raised his fair share of his now-retired stallion's offspring over the years, had high praise for the Dell Ridge-bred son of Serena's Cat (Storm Cat).

"Honestly he's one of the most remarkable looking A.P. Indys I've ever seen," Farish explained.

"We were so thrilled to get him being that it's his last crop and how good he's been to us." He continued, "He was the entire package, a remarkable-looking individual. He's beautifully balanced, very correct and everything that you'd hope for conformationally."

Farish said Honor Code has never set a bad hoof forward since they acquired a majority interest.

"We broke him in Ocala and he was a colt that had a great attitude," the Lane's End patriarch stated. "When [trainer] Shug [McGaughey] got him, he was impressed, but you never know what they're going to turn out to be. He's worked well and impressed us and Shug at every level. Shug let the horse take us to the races, and that's always been the game plan with the A.P. Indys. Physically they're able, but mentally you can sometimes really stop before you get started."

And just what was Farish thinking when Honor Code was 20 lengths last early on?

"I was thinking he was a little overboard with our game plan," he said with a laugh. "We wanted him to have a good first start. [Jockey] Johnny [Velazquez] just sat on him, then he hit him one time then it was just a matter of having a clear path and fortunately it was open. We were very excited by that incredible performance."

Dell Ridge Farm went to \$1.4 million to acquire Serena's Cat, a granddaughter of champion Serena's Song (Rahy), at the Keeneland November Sale back in 2003, and campaigned the filly to four wins from 12 starts, including a victory in the 2007 Klassy Briefcase S. Bred to A.P. Indy in her first year at stud, she did not produce a foal in 2009, but gave birth to a colt by Unbridled's Song in 2010. That offspring, a colt named Noble Tune, graduated for Dell Ridge at first asking at Saratoga last September following which they sold a majority interest to Martin Schwartz. The dark bay has gone on to add this year's GII American Turf S. to his score in last year's GIII Pilgrim S. and runner-up effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. Serena's Cat is the dam of a yearling filly by Bernardini and foaled a colt by Tapit Mar. 18 of this year. She is back in foal to the Gainesway stallion. --Alan Carasso

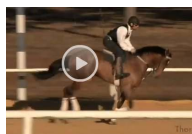

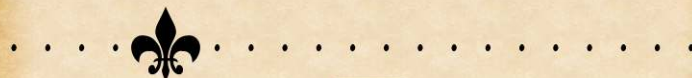
