## EYES TO THE SKIES

With the dark clouds threatening to burst over Dublin, all-important ground conditions remain an unknown ahead of today's G1 Red Mills Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. With significant rain an almost inevitability, John Deer's **Al Kazeem (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) is firmly in the mix for a race he looked set to swerve as late as mid-week, while connections of **Declaration of War** (War Front) and **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB})

are praying it arrives in moderation. Al Kazeem has a 2 3/4-length deficit to make up on Declaration of War from the G1 Juddmonte International at a sun-baked York 17 days ago, but trainer Roger Charlton has always maintained that easier ground will mean a better performer. "Al Kazeem left Beckhampton at 8 a.m. this morning to start his long journey to Ireland in the hope that there will be some rain at Leopardstown before racing tomorrow evening," Charlton

said yesterday. "The weather forecast seems to change by the hour, and there is a wide range of opinions as to how much they will get. The gun is loaded, so fingers crossed yet again." While the surface was fast when the 5-year-old took the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 26, the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and G1 Eclipse at Sandown July 6, his York effort may have been one too many on unsuitably quick ground, and he shortened stride late to allow the G1 Irish Derby hero and G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. runner-up **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) back past and into second. Aidan O'Brien has won a record seven renewals of this race, and Declaration of War holds strong credentials if the weather is not as dramatic as forecast, but on no worse than yielding Joseph Allen's homebred will still be a force to be reckoned with. He has form on soft ground at a lower level, but his best efforts have come on a sound surface. Also from Ballydoyle is the intriguing **Kingsbarns (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who brings an unbeaten record into play despite not being seen since winning the G1 Racing Post Trophy on the soft going at Doncaster in late October. Long held in high regard, he will be helped by wet conditions and remains totally unexposed and an unknown quantity. Lord Lloyd-Webber's **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) had her ideal fast ground when registering an authoritative success in the 12-furlong G1 Yorkshire Oaks at the Ebor meeting 16 days ago and trainer John Gosden is facing a nervous time in the build-up. **Cont. p3**

Trainer Al Stall Jr. cut his teeth down on the Bayou and has done exceptionally well over the past five year's in the GII Super Derby, the marquee race of the meet at Louisiana Downs.

Victorious in 2008 with My Pal Charlie (Indian Charlie), he repeated the dose with Apart (Flatter) in 2010. However, it was the runner between those who failed to win, but ultimately gave Stall his finest hour. That would be Blame (Arch), who had the hopeless task of chasing Regal Ransom (Distorted Humor) around the Bossier City oval in 2009 and settled for a running-on second. Blame would go on to snap the unbeaten streak of Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the 2010 GI Breeders' Cup Classic for owners Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider, whose silks will be carried aboard heavily favored **Departing** (War Front) this afternoon. **Cont. p9**

### Irish Champion S.

**WIN AND YOU'RE IN®**

"She's very well, but obviously we are watching very carefully what happens with the weather," Gosden told *PA Sport* about The Fugue. "Obviously, we would be very concerned if it rains but things are changing all the time." Leopardstown's Racing and Operations Manager Nessa Joyce gave the latest update yesterday

afternoon. "We had an isolated shower overnight, which was a bit of a surprise and gave us four millimeters of rain," she explained. "We're calling the ground good-to-firm all round at the moment and we'll just have to see what happens later in the day. It's the great unknown. I think the

heaviest of the rain is going to be in the middle of the night and the latest forecast suggests we could get anything between 10 and 20 millimeters. The good thing is it sounds like by the morning we'll hopefully have had the worst of the rain, so we should have a good idea where we stand. The worst-case scenario is that it rains throughout the day, but it is very hard to predict. Hopefully, it is going to be more showery than persistent rain. There is a crazy outside chance we won't get any rain at all, so we're just going to have to monitor things very closely."

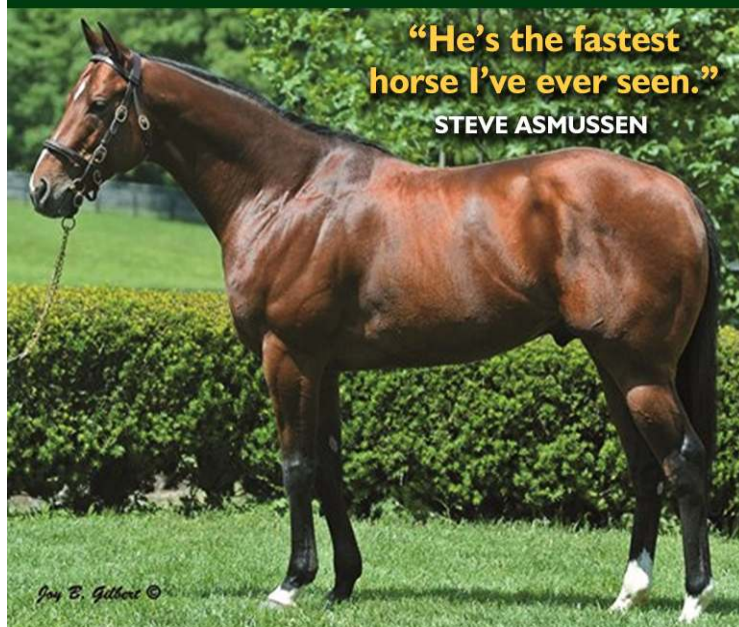

**FORCE TO BE RECKONED WITH**

Whatever the weather, sprinters at the peak of their division either have deadly speed or not, and **Lethal Force (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) bids to flaunt his raw prowess in that department in today's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. Only Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) has been able to rain on his parade this summer, but his latest second to that stellar performer in the Aug. 4 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at her beloved Deauville stands up to the closest inspection. Previously, the Cheveley Park Stud signing had inflicted two comfortable defeats on last year's Haydock hero Society Rock (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) in the June 22 G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot and G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 13, and the only concern for trainer Clive Cox is the threat of more rain turning the ground extremely testing. "Lethal Force is in excellent form and I really hope conditions are suitable for him," he told *PA Sport*. "I couldn't be happier with him. He's in great nick and obviously he has already proved this year that he's at the top of his game. He came back very well indeed from a very good race in France, and [Moonlight Cloud] is a very special filly. With her being on home territory, it was a tough nut to crack and it was a course record. Adam [Kirby] knows our horse really well, and his impression on the day was that he probably wasn't quite as sharp as he was for the July Cup run." One who will benefit from the significant easing in conditions yesterday is the Irish raider **Gordon Lord Byron (Ire)** (Byron {GB}), who returns to the scene of his second placing 12 months ago. He was only 3/4 of a length behind Lethal Force when third in the Maurice de Gheest, and if it gets heavy, he will be in his element, as he was last year on Arc day when capturing the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp. His latest success came in a weak renewal of the G3 Desmond S. over a mile at Leopardstown Aug. 15. Conditioner Tom Hogan told *PA Sport*, "He arrived over there Thursday night and was out on the track on Friday morning. He's in very good order. The rain is fine, but a drop was needed as it would have been very quick if they didn't get a drop. Last year, we thought we were drawn on the side with pace and it didn't work out like that. Hopefully, this year we will be. We were catching Lethal Force in Deauville the last day we met, so hopefully there will be a good pace and we might get by him one of these days." If Lethal Force underperforms, Cheveley Park Stud could still collect with the 3-year-old they own in partnership with David Armstrong, **Garswood (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}). He beat his elders over seven furlongs in the G2 Lennox S. at Glorious Goodwood last time July 30, and will also benefit from a softening surface. "The more rain, the better to slow the others down a bit because we're dropping him back in trip," trainer Richard Fahey told *PA Sport*. "He's in great form and we're delighted with him. He goes there in top shape. We switched him off this year to try to get a mile and he has won over seven."

**OPEN HOUSE**

With no stand-out performer in the line-up for today's G1 Coolmore Fusaichi Pegasus Matron S. at Leopardstown, the way is clear for an improver to step forward, and one who fits that bill is Kieran Leavy, Lorcan Cribbin and Amanda McCreery's supplemented triple pattern-race scorer **Fiesolana (Ire)** (Aussie Rules). Having already annexed this track's G3 Ballyogan S. over six furlongs June 13, the 4-year-old showed that extra distance held no fears when adding the G3 Brownstown S. and G3 Fairy Bridge S. to her tally at Fairyhouse July 3 and Tipperary Aug. 22. On the latter occasion, she gave the high-class Sea Siren (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) five pounds and a decisive 1 1/4-length beating over just 120 yards shy of this trip despite being reportedly short of peak fitness. "She's in great form--she came out of her race at Tipperary very well," trainer Willie McCreery said. "We're clutching at straws a little bit, but she deserves to be there having won three Group 3s this year. Her wins this year have all been on watered ground, but I don't know if she needs a bit of cut in the ground. She has a very high cruising speed and she's able to quicken off it and saves a little bit for herself when she hits the front as well. All she has done is progress and she's answered everything we've asked. She has a good draw, is very straightforward in her races and the mile shouldn't be a problem." If Ibrahim Araci's **Chigun (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) can revisit the form of her impressive win in The Curragh's G3 Ridgewood Pearl S. over this trip May 25, she could play a leading role, but she has to rebound from two unplaced efforts on contrasting ground conditions in the G2 Duke of Cambridge S. at Royal Ascot June 19 and G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville July 28. "The ground is probably irrelevant for her, as long as it's not extreme either way," the owner's Racing Manager Rob Speers told *PA Sport*. "She wouldn't want it very quick or too heavy. I think with Elusive Kate not running, it's a very open race. There are probably half a dozen fillies in there with a genuine chance and hopefully we're one of them." Visiting from France is Guy Pariente's **Kenhope (Fr)** (Kendargent {Fr}), who proved that her second in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 21 was no fluke when third in the Rothschild. Her trainer Henri-Alex Pantall took this in 1997 with Clerio (GB) (Soviet Star) when it was a Group 3 staged at The Curragh. His assistant Ludovec Gadben told *PA Sport*, "She has recovered very well from her last race at Deauville and she traveled well to Ireland and arrived Thursday morning. Everything is going in a good way for the filly. It was good news for us that Elusive Kate does not run. She is a tough filly and has been running well all year at a high level, so we think she should run very well. Any rain would be good news for her. She goes on all ground, but she is better if it is somewhere between good and heavy. She has run well on all types of racecourses, so the track won't be a problem for her." **Field p6**

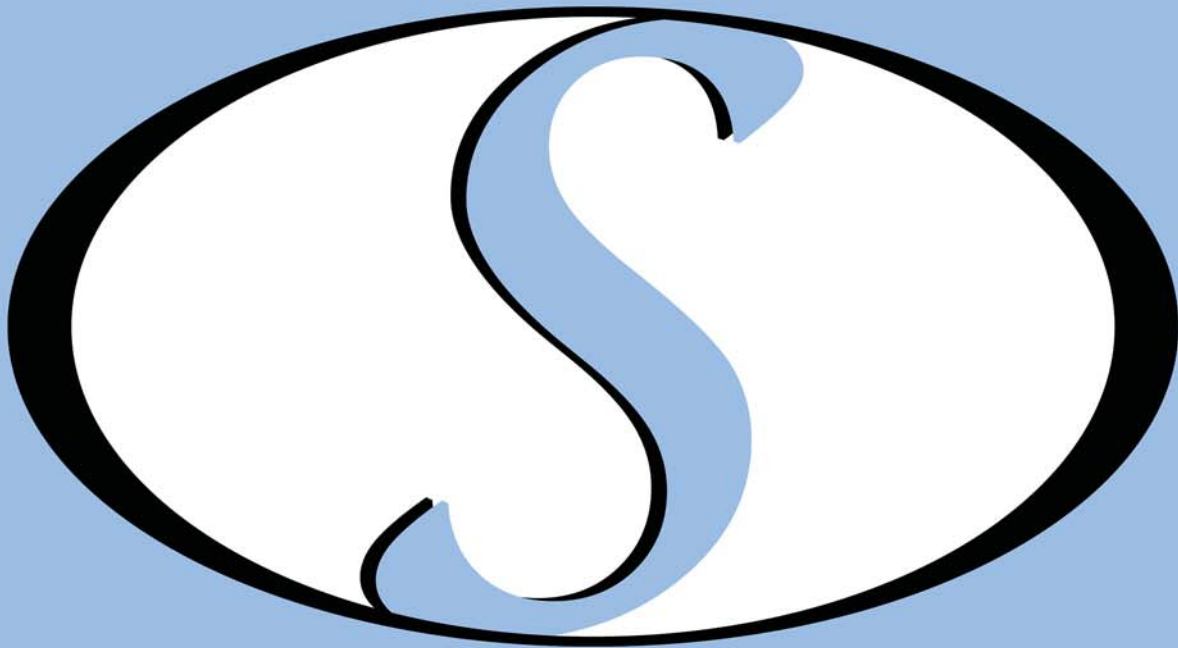



Already a millionaire in just seven career starts, Departing went two-for-three over the winter, the lone blemish being a third behind the more-seasoned Revolutionary (War Pass) in the GII Louisiana Derby. He tried the GI Preakness S. off a blowout score in the GIII Illinois Derby, but was never a real threat when sixth to Oxbow (Awesome Again). He exits a facile 8 3/4-length defeat of **Ruler of Love** (Peace Rules) in the GII West Virginia Derby Aug. 3, and it's difficult to envision anything but a winning effort at prohibitively short odds. **Cameo Appearance** (Majestic Warrior) tries two turns and the main track for the first time in what has shaped as a promising start to his career. Impressive in winning his first two Arlington tries for trainer Wayne Catalano, the homebred was void of excuses when third in the one-mile Straight Line S. on the Arlington Million undercard Aug. 17. Pat Valenzuela is in from California to ride. **Cameo Appearance** is part of an uncoupled entry with the under-achieving **Treasury Bill** (Lemon Drop Kid), who remains eligible for an entry-level allowance. The progressive **Holiday Mischief** (Into Mischief), runner-up to Departing in the Texas Heritage S. Mar. 2, belied odds of 16-1 when wearing down Stall trainee Sunbean (Brahms) in the Aug. 3 Prelude S. Further improvement can see him factor in the finish.

**BOISTEROUS OUT TO MAKE AMENDS**

Exiting one of the more disappointing efforts of his career, Phipps Stable' **Boisterous** (Distorted Humor) will look to re-start what has been an otherwise successful season in today' GII Bowling Green H. on opening day of the fall championship meet at Belmont Park. A winner of six of nine tries over this turf course, the 6-year-old was runner-up to loose-on-the-lead Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) in the GII Ben Ali S. over the Keeneland Poly Apr. 21, but returned to the infield to land the GII Monmouth S. June 9 before a first top-level success in the Man O'War S. here July 13. Instead of cutting back to 10 furlongs for the GI Arlington Million, a race in which he flopped in 2012, Boisterous instead stretched out to a mile and four panels for the GI Sword Dancer Invitational Aug. 17, but was brutally wide on the final turn and did not see out the trip, finishing eighth to Big Blue Kitten (Kitten's Joy). **IROQUOIS A REAL MELTING POT**

An interesting collection of 12 juveniles is set to face the starter in tonight's GIII Iroquois S., with the winner to receive an all-dues-paid trip to California for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. They've come from all over to run, as five of the contestants made their most recent appearance at cross-commonwealth Ellis Park, while others are shipping in from Parx, Monmouth and Saratoga. **Ride On Curlin** (Curlin) has been made the 5-2 morning-line favorite, and deservedly so off a visually impressive 7 3/4-length success in a 5 1/2-furlong maiden at the Peapatch July 13. Prior to that, he tried this surface and overcame a sluggish start to round out the exacta underneath the well-regarded and subsequently stakes-placed Conquest Two Step (Two Step Salsa) June 21. Though he led throughout last time, he didn't go all that hard up front and could find himself outrun in the early going here. **Tapiture** (Tapit) remains a maiden after just a single racetrack appearance, but that runner-up effort at Saratoga Aug. 17 looks pretty imposing. The winner that day, Strong Mandate (Tiznow) came back to romp in the GI Hopeful S. last weekend, and the Winchell homebred could be this good.

There was nothing particularly sexy about the debut win from Cash Is King LLC's **Honorable Judge** (Afleet Alex), but he ships in here with longshot claims from the Keystone State. The bay debuted over a mile Aug. 11, settling worse than midfield before romping home by nearly seven lengths. He should get more pace to run at this time and if pedigree angles are your thing, his full-brother Afleet Again won the GI Breeders' Cup Marathon at this track in 2011.

Trainer James Divito sends out the favorites in both 2-year-old stakes at Arlington Park today starting with **High Roll** (Roman Ruler) in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity. High Roll was last seen going gate-to-wire to graduate at first asking by a solid 3 3/4 lengths here Aug. 3. The Curtis Green homebred is a half to stakes winner Muppet Man (Corinthian), who was runner-up in this event last year. Filippo Santoro, William Mathews, and Marvin Fleming colorbearer **Lotsa Mischief** (Into Mischief) was fourth on debut over the Canterbury sod July 11, but rebounded to romp home by nine lengths when switched to the dirt at Prairie Meadows Aug. 2. **KATIERICH FARMS ON THE RISE**

Larry Doyle's KatieRich Farms, in operation for only five years, will send seven yearlings through the Keeneland sales ring during Book 1 of the September sale and a further nine will follow during the sale's second week. This will mark KatieRich's third September consignment and the farm enjoyed some strong results in 2012.

Doyle is chairman and CEO of the real estate investment management company Katierich Asset Management LLC and previously served as chairman of Kinetics Asset Management, which he co-founded. He traces his interest in horse racing to his high school days growing up not far from Belmont Park.

"I've been interested in horseracing since high school--so that's a long time ago," Doyle laughed. "I lived not far from Belmont Park and we used to hitchhike to the racetrack and blow any money we had earned that summer."

Doyle dabbled in racehorse ownership for a few years, but began getting more involved in 2000 as his business interests expanded.

"Initially, my trainer, Mark Hubley, called me up and said, 'What do you think of this?' and we went in and we had a little success and it was very exciting," Doyle explained. "Back then I wasn't as established as I later became in my other business, so when I came into a little more money, I called him up and said, 'Let's go do it for real.'"

Doyle's initial focus was on buying yearling fillies with an eye towards building a broodmare band. Among his early purchases was Miss Mary Apples (Clever Trick), who was a \$37,000 Keeneland September purchase in 2001. The filly went on to run second in the 2002 GII Schuylerville S. before producing stakes winners Miss Red Delicious (Empire Maker) and Dr. Diamond Prize (Pure Prize). He also campaigned multiple graded stakes placed Your Round (Distorted Humor).

In 2008, Doyle purchased a 330-acre farm in Midway to house his burgeoning broodmare band. Named KatieRich after his two children, the farm is managed by Hubley.

"At that stage of the game, I had a bunch of broodmares at various different locations, so at that time I started looking for a farm," he said. "I probably wasn't looking for anything quite as big as what I got, but back in 2008, that was the only one available."

The KatieRich broodmare band currently numbers about 30 head and Doyle said he is always looking to increase quality, if not quantity. KatieRich is primarily a commercial breeding operation.

"I breed primarily to sell, but I race what I can't sell," Doyle said. "That's why I think I have the best trainer in central Kentucky because Mark Hubley has a 24% win ratio with horses that no one else will take."

In addition to Hubley, Doyle credits Tammy Ingebritson with the operation's success.

"I rely on Mark Hubley and Tammy Ingebritson, who basically runs the broodmare band and everything at the farm," he explained. "I'm very fortunate that I can trust them and they can handle everything. There is never a question of that. So I love that aspect of it. They really know what they are doing and they are very professional and they are very smart. And it's been very enjoyable. They take a lot of that decision making. We don't always make good decisions, but they are always made with the right intent."

KatieRich Farm's 2012 Keeneland September consignment was highlighted by an Elusive Quality colt who sold for \$370,000 to Winchell Thoroughbreds. Ben Glass purchased a son of Pulpit from the consignment for \$330,000.

The farm's 2013 consignment includes [hip 2](#), a son of Tiznow out of False Impression (A.P. Indy) and from the family of GI Kentucky Oaks winner Believe You Can; as well as a daughter of Dynaformer ([hip 221](#)) out of stakes winner Miss City Halo (Carson City). [Hip 259](#) is a Hard Spun colt out of My McIntosh (Pulpit), a daughter of Miss Mary Apples.

During the second week of the sale, Doyle looks forward to selling [hip 1304](#), a colt by Congrats out of Far and Away (Strong Hope), half-sister to the dam of GI Kentucky Derby winner Orb (Malibu Moon); and [hip 1572](#), a colt by Indian Charlie out of Unkatzable (A.P. Indy). The yearling is a half-brother to graded stakes placed Izshelegal (Maria's Mon). Far and Away was a \$13,000 purchase out of the 2010 Keeneland November sale, while Unkatzable was purchased for \$340,000 out of that same auction.

Doyle said he was excited about his farm's 2013 consignment, but he admitted he expected even bigger things in 2014.

"There are a handful that we're pretty excited about this year, but next year I think I will have a really bumper crop," Doyle said. "Next year I might have 15-20 of them that will be a wow factor." -*Jessica Martini*

**STREET SENSE TO RETURN TO U.S.** *Street Sense* (Street Cry {Ire}--Bedazzle, by Dixieland Band), the 2007 GI Kentucky Derby winner and sire of Grade I winners Aubby K and Sweet Reason this season, will return to the United States to stand in 2014 at Darley at Jonabell in Kentucky. The only horse to date to win both the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and the Run for the Roses, *Street Sense* stood in 2013 at Darley in Japan. "Street Sense received tremendous support from top breeders during his first five seasons here in America and also last year in Japan," Charlie Boden, Darley's Head of Sales in America commented. "His progeny on the track, as we had hoped, have had a wonderful year and his nine 2013 stakes winners will ensure he will cover a quality book of mares next season." *Street Sense* has also been represented this term by Japanese Group 3 winner *Fleet Street* (Jpn), MGSW Unlimited Budget, Silverette and Sensible Lady, who book-ended the trifecta in the Turf Amazon H. at Parx Sept. 2, and

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ *Carnival Court*, the half-sister to dual champion *Royal Delta*, who was third in the GI Alabama S. Aug. 17. *Street Sense* is currently the leading third-crop sire by progeny earnings with over \$4.3 million and is second to fellow Darley stallion *Discreet Cat* by number of 2013 stakes winners. Added Boden, "As *Street Cry* fast approaches hitting the 'century mark' in number of stakes winners, his best son will be welcomed back with open arms by the breeding public and all of us here at Jonabell." A 2014 stud fee will be announced at a later date.

## MOREIRA MAKES HISTORY AT KRANJI

Three-time Singapore champion jockey Joao Moreira completed a historic feat at Kranji yesterday when he rode eight winners from as many mounts. In doing so, the Brazilian-born rider bested the previous Singapore record of seven winners on a card, set by jockey Saimee Jumaat in 2009.

Moreira won the first four races on the card aboard *Silent Power* (Aus), *Hanks* (NZ), *Zac Spirit* (Aus) and *Mr Magnus* (Aus) before being forced to sit out the fifth, an event restricted to apprentice riders.

He picked up right where he left off with a trio of wins aboard *Alan* (NZ), *Cash Luck* (Aus) and *Weowna Flyer* (Ire) in the sixth, seventh and eighth races, tying Saimee's record before making history in the ninth aboard U.S.-bred gelding *Faretti* (Tale of the Cat).

"What's better than a dream come true? I think this is it," an emotional Moreira remarked after his eighth win. "To be honest, I never dreamed of winning on all my eight rides tonight, but when I started to close in on the fifth win, I thought maybe I had a chance, as I still had good chances. I would like to first of all thank the Singapore Turf Club for having given me the chance to ride here. There is no better place than Kranji to ride at and I'm so happy I've done it here."

Moreira was also full of praise for his mounts, especially *Weowna Flyer* and *Faretti*, who helped him tie and break the record.

"Winners come and go, but these two horses will be special to me now," said Moreira. "I spoke with [trainer] Mike [Clements] after the race, and I told him [*Weowna Flyer*] is so tricky to ride. He doesn't like to be inside runners and when I was able to take him to the outside tonight, he showed me so much heart in the home straight. As for *Faretti*, he took a while to wind up, and for a moment I thought the eighth win was out of my reach. But then he got going again, and I was in seventh heaven when he hit the line in a nick of time."

### I WANT REVENGE TO PAULS MILL

Grade I Wood Memorial winner **I Want Revenge** (Stephen Got Even--Meguial {Arg}, by Roy) will enter stud for the 2014 season at Ben and Elaine Walden's Pauls Mill in Versailles, Kentucky.

The heavy ante-post Kentucky Derby favorite until raceday when he was forced to scratch due to an ankle filling, I Want Revenge launches Walden's return to the stallion business, on hiatus since the sale of the stud's four stallions to WinStar Farm in 2011.

"I love falling in love with a stallion," said Walden. "I count it a privilege to support a stallion with a lot of our own mares, and to infuse ideas and passion into his marketing. I Want Revenge is a game-changer. He was a freak of nature as a racehorse and is the best-made horse conformation-wise that I have ever retired to stud. His Gotham win was truly unforgettable."

I Want Revenge was winner of the GIII Gotham S.--by 8 1/2 lengths ([video](#))--and the GI Wood Memorial, where he reared at the start and came with a remarkable late run to score by a widening 1 1/2 lengths ([video](#)). Both of those efforts came while he was under the care of trainer Jeff Mullins.

By a son of A.P. Indy out of a daughter of Roy (Fappiano), I Want Revenge is bred along the same lines as Tapit and Bernardini. His dam, Meguial, was one of Roy's top winners in Argentina, where she was second in the Argentine equivalents to the 1000 Guineas and Oaks. Roy himself was a 17-length winner of his maiden race at two, and won twice at Aqueduct at three before going on to be a successful sire in Chile and Argentina.

I Want Revenge was weighted at 118 on the Experimental Free Handicap at 2 after finishing second by a nose to Pioneerof the Nile in the GI Hollywood Futurity.

"I have an exceptional partner in I Want Revenge in Pat Madden, and we currently have a second horse in mind," said Walden. "We have been buying mares of late and Pat enjoys the symmetry of being involved in both sides of the business."

A stud fee will be announced in the near future.



*Ben Walden, Jr. has been at the forefront of the stallion business for the last 25 years. He began Vinery in 1986 standing stallions such as Red Ransom and Cryptoclearance. Walden sold Vinery in 1998, and began Pauls Mill in 2011, standing U S Ranger, Artie Schiller, Bellamy Road and Summer Bird. After selling those stallions to WinStar Farm, Walden has focused on broodmares and young horses at Pauls Mill, but will re-enter the stallion business in 2014 with I Want Revenge (Stephen Got Even--Meguial {Arg}, by Roy).*

### Why did you decide to get back into the stallion business?

**BW:** I don't feel like we have been out of the stallion business because we continue to be vested in the four horses that went to WinStar in Bellamy Road, Artie Schiller, Summer Bird and U S Ranger. We still have some ownership in those horses and it's a pleasure to be involved with WinStar on the outside and with my brother Elliott, who is doing a magnificent job over there. We have taken shares in Gemologist and Bodemeister--two of the five horses they have syndicated in the last couple of years. We've been building and improving Pauls Mill slowly, but surely. Since we sold the stallions we've been raising foals and breeding for the market. We also have a small racing stable. We have taken a position in Maclean's Music over at John Sikura's Hill 'n Dale as well.

### What have you done in the interim?

**BW:** We've been buying mares because we felt it was a good time to buy mares. We're up to 60 mares at Pauls Mill and we've been raising young horses and selling yearlings and weanlings.

**Why did you pick I Want Revenge?**

**BW:** He was an easy horse to land on. The horses that have blessed my life with stallion success have shared a common thread in that they have shown some sort of brilliance during their racing career. More specifically, Red Ransom was a brilliant maiden winner when he broke the track record at Saratoga. Bellamy Road was a brilliant race horse and has turned out to be potentially a great sire. The best is yet to come for him. Elliott and his team have done a better job getting mares to him than I did. Both Red Ransom and Bellamy Road are of the mold that I Want Revenge is from. His Wood Memorial was spectacular. He was left at the gate, he missed the break badly and somehow he connected with the field turning for home behind a wall of horses and it wasn't until the last 50-100 yards that he had a chance to win the race and he did--it was just an amazing effort. Off that race he was going to be a short price in a full Derby field and I watched him over the last several years when IEAH tried to keep bringing him back and he wasn't the same horse. He was the perfect horse to re-enter the stallion business with and I love the fact that he's bred like Tapit and Bernardini.

**How many more stallions do you plan on acquiring?**

**BW:** Our barn has four stalls and we have no interest in adding more. We're looking at another horse right now that we, hopefully, will be able to acquire for the 2014 breeding season. He's a similar horse to Bellamy Road and I Want Revenge in that he's a top two-turn dirt horse with tremendous two-turn speed.

**What are your goals for Pauls Mill?**

**BW:** My goals for Pauls Mill is to survive--number one--and to continue getting up in the mornings and walking out onto a farm that may be as beautiful as any in central Kentucky, and enjoy doing what I do for a living. It has been a tremendous blessing. I'm 55 and I think most breeders in our business would agree that it's a privilege to do what we do. It's not always easy to makes ends meet, but it's a privilege. You're dealing with so many things beyond your control, but that's where my faith comes in. Our goal is to stay small, do a good job, put a lot of creativity and energy into our three or four stallions, try to fill them up, and let the chips fall where they fall.

**WINSLOW HOMER RETIRED** Winslow Homer (Unbridled's Song--Summer Raven, by Summer Squall) has been retired to stud at Brent and Crystal Fernung's Journeyman Stud in Ocala, Florida, for the 2014 breeding season, where he will stand as the property of a syndicate. Bred by Overbrook Farm, who acquired the colt's Grade III-winning dam for \$750,000 at Keeneland November in 2005, Winslow Homer fetched a final bid of \$310,000 from Tom McGreevy, agent for Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farm at Keeneland September in 2008. The gray colt defeated subsequent

GISW Stately Victor (Ghostzapper) at second asking at Saratoga, then earned **"TDN Rising Star"** status with a 12 1/2-length allowance score going two at Philly Park. Victorious in the GIII Holy Bull S. to kick off his sophomore season, Winslow Homer added a nine-length success in Saratoga's Curlin S. later that summer. "I followed Winslow Homer's racing career closely from the time he broke his maiden at Saratoga as a 2-year-old," said Brent Fernung. "He had as much talent as any horse in his crop. He's a beautiful horse with a pedigree to match. The breeders in Florida are going to love him." Winslow Homer retires with four wins from 11 starts and earnings of \$273,365. A stud fee will be announced at a later date.

Trainer Clive Cox revealed that the 3-year-old, who has had just two outings this term and has been off the track since finishing fifth in the G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 18, has suffered a late muscular injury. "He's not 100% sound and he's sore in his hamstring," he told *PA Sport*. "Although we've worked on it as hard as we can this morning, we've had to admit defeat. He pulled out stiff this morning and he's just not 100% to perform tomorrow."

**Hannon Pair Set for Moulin...**

Trainer Richard Hannon will send both **Olympic Glory (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) and **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) to Longchamp for next Sunday's G1 Prix du Moulin. Sheikh Joaan Al Thani's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner Olympic Glory was last seen finishing second in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 11, while Qatar Racing Limited and CSH's G1 Prix Jean Prat hero Havana Gold will be reverting to a mile, having finished fifth in the 10-furlong G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville Aug. 15. The conditioner's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr said, "We look like being two-handed in the Prix du Moulin at Longchamp on Sunday week, with both Olympic Glory and Havana Gold pencilled in for that race. They have both done well on their forays to France, and, hopefully, one of them might get lucky again." Hannon Jr also had news of the G1 Sussex S. hero **Toronado (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), who disappointed in the G1 Juddmonte International at York 16 days ago. "Toronado is back cantering after his hiccup at York and, hopefully, he might yet make the [Oct. 19] G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, though both him and Olympic Glory will also come into the equation for the Breeders' Cup."

**Fordubai Heads to Indiana Derby...**

Straight Line S. hero **Fordubai** (E Dubai) may be headed to the GII Indiana Derby next Oct. 5. "He's doing wonderfully. He's just perfect right now," reported trainer Greg Geier. "I thought he would run really good that day. I didn't realize he'd pick it up that much, but he sure did. In the allowance he ran in 1:39 and change and then won going 1:37 and change (in the Straight Line). He definitely picked it up. We're probably looking at the [GII] Indiana Derby [Oct. 5], right now."

The Indiana Derby would be Fordubai's first time back at two turns since finishing second to Departing (War Front) in the GIII Illinois Derby Apr. 20.

"We'll definitely look and see how the Super Derby horses do. I beat (Super Derby entrant) Cameo Appearance (who finished third in the Straight Line) and we finished right behind Departing. If they run one-two, I'm looking really good," Geier said.

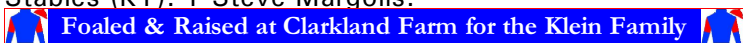

**Equine Industry Contributes \$3 Billion in KY:**

According to the 2012 Kentucky Equine Survey, the equine industry created 40,665 jobs and had a total economic impact of \$3 billion in the state last year. It also contributed \$134 million in tax money.

The value-added effect, which is a measure of profitability and new income paid to workers, totaled \$1.4 billion.

"We are pleased to announce the long-awaited results from the economic impact study," said Jill Stowe, University of Kentucky Ag Equine Programs director. "The estimates underscore the continued significance of the equine industry to the commonwealth, and they show that each segment of the industry contributes in important ways to the economy as well as to the rich cultural fabric of Kentucky."

Breeding had the highest employment figure of 16,198, while racing had the highest output of \$1.28 billion.

The study also found that there were 35,000 equine operations and 1.1 million acres devoted to horses. The majority of the state's equines are used for trail and pleasure riding and broodmares are the second largest group.

"The data from this study will benefit the state in many ways," said Anna Zinkhon, Kentucky Horse Council Board president. "We have already made use of the results at two regional horsemen's caucuses held in areas with identified concentrations of equine populations. We are looking forward to at least three additional regional horsemen's caucuses based on this data in 2014."
