After all the dalliances with the weather and the added drama of the late defection of **Declaration of War** (War Front) and the virtual pulling-up mid-race of his stable companion **Kingsbarns (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), it was left to Lord Lloyd-Webber's **The Fugue (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) to impart some class on the proceedings in

Leopardstown's G1 Red Mills Irish Champion S., a "Win and You're In" event for the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, Saturday. Allowed to take part despite the quickly deteriorating ground conditions, the G1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine justified that gamble by upstaging the 9-10 pick **Al Kazeem**

**(GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) with a stylish performance. Sent off the 4-1 joint-second favorite, the homebred traveled strongly behind the leading trio early and was clearly going best in the stretch before being committed on the front end by William Buick with a furlong remaining. Skipping clear from there, the bay was not fully extended to score with ears pricked by 1 1/4 lengths from her British compatriot. "I was worried about the ground, but it worked out well," her rider commented. "She's been so unlucky and should have won so many times last year, so I'm just glad she's getting the rub of the green now. She's always been special and has arguably beaten the best around at the moment." **Cont. p3**

**LORDING IT OVER**

Runner-up in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup 12 months ago, Dr. Cyrus Poonawalla and Morgan Cahalan's **Gordon Lord Byron (Ire)** (Byron {GB}) earned the reward for his consistency by gaining a second top-level success yesterday to add to the Prix de la Foret he garnered last October. Sent off the 7-2 second choice on the easy ground he relishes, the bay stayed on the far side, led approaching the quarter pole and drew away under Johnny Murtagh to best compatriot **Slade Power (Ire)** (Dutch Art {GB}) by three lengths. "When I got to the three [-furlong] marker, I was taking him back and he was just electric and won easy," Murtagh commented. "He's very tough, but today he was different--he looked different and was in a different zone." **Lethal Force (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}), the 5-2 favorite in search of a third Group 1 contest, proved a disappointment on the rain-softened ground and, when unable to boss this affair, faded into ninth. **Cont. p5**

**LOOKING DE PART**

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Departing** (War Front) looked every bit of a deserving 1-5 favorite with a comprehensive four-length success in yesterday's \$500,000 GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs. Seemingly more concerned with a clear run than saving ground, pilot Robby Albarado kept the favorite well out in the track as he loomed an always ominous presence just off pace. Given his cue near the 3/8ths pole, **Departing** swooped up to assert. He faced mild resistance from pacesetter **Ruler of Love** (Peace Rules) at the head of the lane, but that foe was no match as the bay poured it on in the run to the wire to provide conditioner Al Stall, Jr. with a record third Super Derby title. "It's great--I cut my teeth here," said the Louisiana native, who enjoyed previous wins in this race with **Apart** (Flatter) in 2010 and **My Pal Charlie** (Indian Charlie) in 2008. "It's been a long time and we love coming here and I keep a stable here year-round, so the Super Derby's a great race to win and we're proud to win it three times." **Cont. p12**

The Fugue looked every bit a leading contender for the G1 Epsom Oaks when winning York's G3 Musidora S. last May, but encountered the first piece of the misfortune that would dog much of her sophomore campaign in the Classic itself when third after a troubled passage. Heavy rain may have cost her the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot and the G1 Yorkshire Oaks either side of a smooth win in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood, and traffic issues were to blame for her third-place effort behind Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune) in the G1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. If 2013 began with the promise that her luck had turned with a fine comeback third behind Al Kazeem in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 19, the demons returned at Sandown when she exited the July 6 G1 Eclipse S. under a cloud having put in a rare dull effort in seventh to the Roger Charlton trainee. Back with a flourish with a dominant performance in the Aug. 22 Yorkshire Oaks, the bay, who had been committed this week with the forecast for predominantly dry weather, was almost scratched as the rain arrived, but connections opted to take roll the dice. **Cont. p4**

Always traveling with her customary zip as **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) set off in front, she stuck to the heels of Al Kazeem as Joseph O'Brien elected to take Kingsbarns out of the action at halfway. Mastering the long-time leader and favorite approaching the furlong pole, she only needed two slaps with the whip to seal the result and record back-to-back successes for the distaff brigade following the exploits of Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab).

Lady Lloyd-Webber confirmed that her participation had been up in the air.

"It has been touch-and-go, and I nearly didn't get on the plane, because I didn't think we were going to run with all the rain that was forecast," she stated. "But John [Gosden] said, 'It's good ground and we have to run.' I thought we would have to wait 20 years to get another filly like Dar Re Mi, but here we are and it's unbelievable."

Gosden added, "We walked the track twice before racing and I'm glad we decided to run now, so there is a sense of relief. The ground [Friday] would have been perfect, but luckily the heavy rain has only really started now and, if we'd got that three hours before racing, we wouldn't be standing here. After coming over, I wasn't inclined to go back to Newmarket and then across the Channel for the G1 Prix Vermeille next week. She's still relatively fresh and this is a solid form line with Al Kazeem and Trading Leather. We were devastated after the Eclipse, which knocked us for six [weeks], as I thought she'd win that. I knew it was in her to do it and the weather has not defeated us. She's entered on Arc weekend, but that would be dependent on ground as it can be bottomless, and the Breeders' Cup Turf is on the agenda too."

Joseph O'Brien revealed that Kingsbarns had lost his action.

"When he met the road, he took a bit of a bad step," he told *PA Sport*. "He wasn't too bad pulling up and hopefully he's just given himself a little bit of a bang."

One of Ireland's most progressive performers last term, Gordon Lord Byron returned from a strong fourth in the G1 Hong Kong Mile in December and was kept busy in preparation for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen on Meydan's Tapeta. Only seventh in that Mar. 30 contest, he

emerged with much credit when third racing under a penalty and away from the main action in the May 15 G2 Duke of York S. and followed with a respectable fourth in the June 22

G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot. Forced to concede 12 pounds to the potentially high-class 3-year-old Darwin (Big Brown) in the G3 Minstrel S. at The Curragh July 20, that proved too much of an ask for him when second, but he was again at his most admirable when staying on strongly to be third behind Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the Aug. 4 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville. Workmanlike when odds-on for the G3 Desmond S. over a mile at Leopardstown Aug. 15, he was the opposite here as he turned a competitive affair into a procession. **Cont. p6**

Breaking tardily, he was soon traveling strongly behind the far-side pace-setter **Heeraat (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) and it was clear by halfway that he had the measure of the restrained **Lethal Force (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}). Allowed to put his seal on the race with just over a quarter mile to race, he was unchallenged up the rail as Slade Power won the war of attrition down the center. "I knew that he had improved at this time of year every year," conditioner Tom Hogan commented. "I felt today was his day and, hopefully, he will keep on improving this year. I think we'll go for the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 6] and then we might look at the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Oct. 19]--we might try a Group 1 over a mile for a change." Trainer Clive Cox's worst fears that Lethal Force would not act on the ground proved well-founded and he was looking to dismiss the below-par performance. "It was clearly not his true running," he told *PA Sport*. "The track walked a lot better than it rode. I will take all the blame. It was my fault, not the horse's. We shouldn't have run him really, but at the same time we thought it was just on the easy side of good. Fair play to the winner, he was very impressive. Our horse will be fine, we just have to put a line through it. It was my fault.

Without Elusive Kate (Elusive Quality), this renewal had a hollow look to it on paper, and it may be notable that despite her odds of 25-1, La Collina was the sole Group 1 winner in the line-up. That had come when she upstaged subsequent G1 Irish 2000 Guineas hero Power (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) when 33-1 in the G1 Phoenix S. at The Curragh in August 2011, but she failed to progress off that effort and was only fifth and sixth, respectively, in the G1 English and Irish 1000 Guineas. Despite some smart efforts in the interim, including when beaten just over two lengths when fifth in this race last year and when fourth in the G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket soon after, the bay looked to be stuck in a rut and was no match for Chigun (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in The Curragh's G3 Ridgewood Pearl S. over this trip May 25. Sixth in the G1 Pretty Polly S. over 10 furlongs back at that venue June 30, she turned in a rare flop when down the field in the nine-furlong G3 Meld S. here when last seen July 25, but rebounded with a timely revival of fortunes to provide jockey Chris Hayes with a first victory at this level. Covered up in mid-pack racing towards the fence, she was shuffled back before the home turn but kept grinding her way through rivals and eventually past Lily's Angel and Say with 50 yards remaining. Trainer Kevin Prendergast commented, "She's very, very special. She's very genuine and everything went right for her today. She has plenty of guts and the only bad race she's run was the last day here when it was very heavy. She had worked during the week with Gordon Lord Byron, and when he won at Haydock that made us more confident. We will probably go for the G1 Sun Chariot S. [at Newmarket Sept. 28]."

Lazy out of the gates again, Australia soon showed enthusiasm while tracking his front-running stable companion Kingfisher and the Moyglare representative. Cajoled on the home bend as the favorite appeared to be traveling stronger two lengths ahead, the chestnut loomed upsides with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining as that rival failed to show the acceleration that marked his debut performance and quickly asserted in what was a display of total authority. "He is a beautiful mover with lots of speed and the faster the ground, the better it will suit him," commented Aidan O'Brien. "We always thought the world of him. He could run again and be a Dewhurst type, but he doesn't have to, as he's learned plenty. He was lazy and doesn't know he's a racehorse yet, but the gears were there when Joseph asked. He'll be trained for the Classics next year and all the options are open to him."

The United States enjoyed a tall reputation after winning on his sole juvenile start in the same seven-furlong maiden that his stable companion Australia was second in this year at The Curragh last July, but he flopped in the Apr. 14 G3 Leopardstown 2,000 Guineas Trial S. and was not seen until a nine-furlong conditions race at Tipperary Aug. 22. Enterprisingly ridden there, the chestnut responded to the same tactics to register the black-type success that had seemed a formality 12 months ago. Dictating the pace to suit, he was taken into the center of the track in early stretch by Joseph O'Brien and battled gamely when joined by Elleval inside the final furlong. "I was very worried about the ground and that's as soft as he wants it," Aidan O'Brien said.

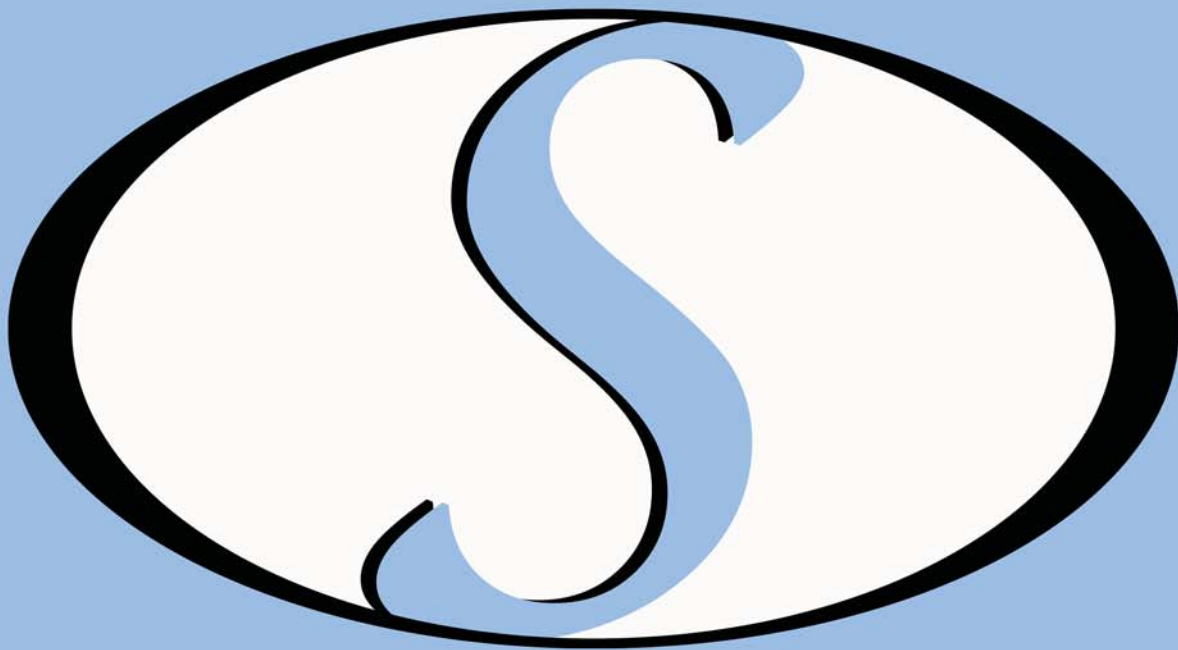

The rare homebred for Ken and Sarah Ramsey not by one of their own stallions, Hyper finished a close-up second to the re-opposing London Lane (Langfuhr) in the GII Colonial Turf Cup June 22 and entered this off a victory in the restricted, 1 5/8-mile John's Call S. at Saratoga July 31. Hyper patiently bided his time off a sensible half in :48 4/5 as Boisterous saved ground in the slipstream of the pacesetter Quick Casablanca (Chi) (Until Sundown). Hyper made a menacing four-wide move on the far turn and was in front by the time they turned for home, and kicked on well under a Javier Castellano drive to gamely hold the relentless charge of Finnegans Wake. Boisterous, crying out for room at the quarter pole, bounced off the hedge in upper stretch, and once finally extricated, could only put in a mild rally to get up for third. "My horse didn't break too sharp today, for whatever reason," said Castellano. "My goal in my mind was to keep him relaxed the first part of the race and then find the kick. When Boisterous and my horse made their moves at the same time, at the quarter-pole, Johnny [Velazquez] didn't have a choice, he had to go inside. I had a choice, to go around horses. My horse took off and did it the right way. He hung a little bit, but when he saw the other horse come on the outside, he came on again."

One race after a half-sister to their accomplished former colorbearer Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}) annexed the GII Pocahontas S., Donegal Racing enjoyed a one-two finish with rank outsiders Cleburne and Smart Cover, with the former earning a ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 2. Cleburne showed better speed than his stablemate early, taking a rail-skimming path from midpack with Smart Cover dropping well out of it. Cleburne started picking off rivals along the inside on the turn, and sliced into the clear in the lane as his stablemate started to gather momentum while still well out of it. Favored maiden Tapiture--looking to complete a double for his connections with the Pocahontas--bowed his way through on the inside in midpack, but two sets of green and yellow Donegal silks kept inching closer as the line loomed and got there in time to complete a \$500 exacta. Cleburne won his lone other start, a two-turn maiden special on the grass at Ellis Aug. 16, while Smart Cover got up by a nose--also on the Ellis lawn--July 28 after an off-the-board effort sprinting here in June.

"They both ran super races," said trainer Dale Romans of the one-two finishers. "They're both nice horses, they want to run long and I couldn't be happier with them." Though Romans earned the Eclipse Award for

outstanding trainer last year, he has not enjoyed the same level of success in 2013. "It always feels good to win a big race, especially with young horses," he said. "You can start thinking about next year. It's been a tough year. But we've had a lot of reasons for that, we've worked them all out and we're going good again."

While Paddy O'Prado did much of his best work on the infield, he was third in the 2010 GI Kentucky Derby here. Another Donegal runner, MGISW Dullahan (Even the Score), was third in last year's Derby. 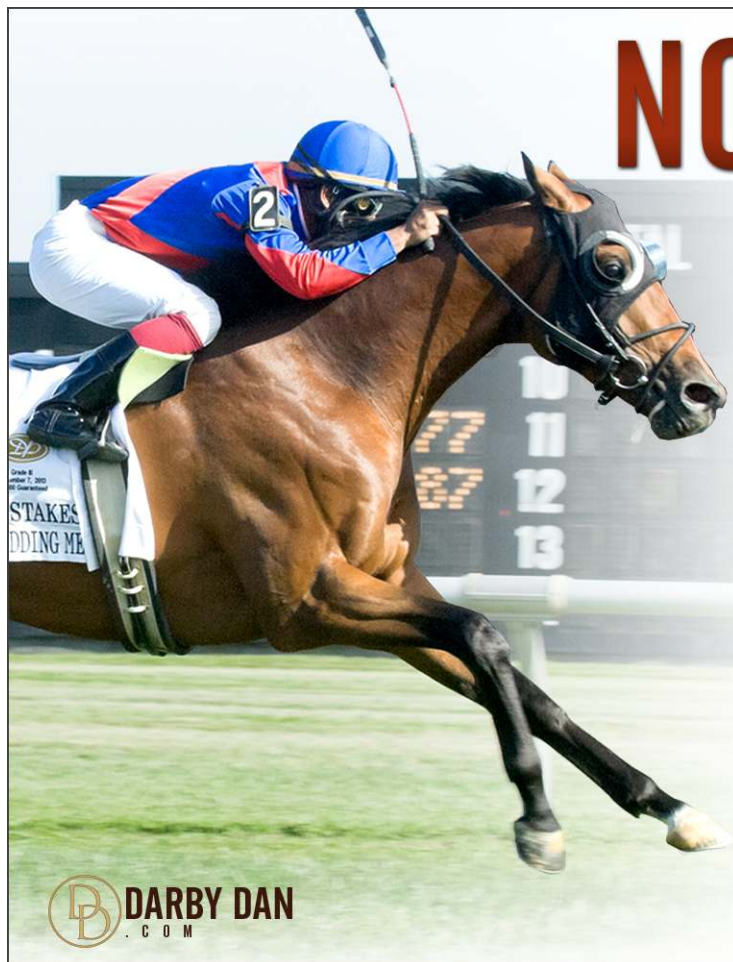

While Solitary Ranger hadn't been out since a pair of runner-up finishes to hot Wesley Ward firsters going 4 1/2 furlongs at Keeneland's spring meet, there was plenty on paper to suggest he had a big shot to provide his freshman sire (by Danzig) with his first black-type winner. No Nay Never (Scat Daddy), victor of the second of Solitary Ranger's previous appearances Apr. 26, had gone to Europe and dominated in both Royal Ascot's G2 Norfolk S. and Deauville's G1 Prix Morny. Adding to that positive form update was the Wayne Catalano trainee's work pattern--he entered this off back-to-back bullet works over the track Aug. 23 and Aug. 30. Keyed up early to press through quick splits of :22.89 and :46.43, Solitary Ranger started to inch clear in upper stretch, but appeared as if he'd face a formidable challenge from Whyruawesome creeping up along the inside. That foe struggled again to maintain a straight path in the lane, but there was no way he was getting to Solitary Ranger regardless as the leader kicked on to win as he pleased. "The horse has a lot of talent," said now three-time A-W Futurity-winning trainer Wayne Catalano. "Wesley Ward has a nice horse that beat him and he went on across the pond and won the best two races in Europe. That flattered our horse. I just pointed him toward this race the whole time. He ran a nice race. We talked about that he might be fresh. I told [rider Florent Geroux] to use his own judgment, but whatever you do, don't move too early."

A three-time winner and victorious in listed company for his breeder and trainer David Smaga in France in 2010, Foreteller was snapped up by current connections and registered a 30-1 upset over G1 Victoria Derby hero Fiveandahalfstar (Aus) (Hotel Grand {Aus}) in the G1 Ranvet S. Mar. 23 before finishing fifth to that rival in the G1 The BMW S. two weeks hence. Narrowly runner-up in the G2 Hollindale S. May 4 and in the G1 Doomben Cup May 18, Foreteller was spelled and returned with an eighth, beaten 3 1/2 lengths, in the G2 Warwick S. over 1400 meters at Warwick Farm Aug. 24. Like many others in this field, including ante-post G1 Melbourne Cup favorite Puissance de Lune, Foreteller was trying a distance short of his best in a means-to-an-end sort of race, but got the job done nonetheless. Foreteller settled towards the tail of the field and bided his time back there in company with Puissance de Lune. But Foreteller kept on well under a Craig Newitt drive and dove late for the victory. Moudre ran on for third. Sea Moon (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}) went to his knees a stride or two away from the gate and never picked up in the straight, finishing 12th, but only five lengths away in his Australian debut. "I thought he would run really well, but I was a little bit unsure whether we could beat the grey horse," Newitt told *AAP*. "If I was following any other horse in the race, I probably don't beat him, but I always had the drop on him and it was good to get the bob."

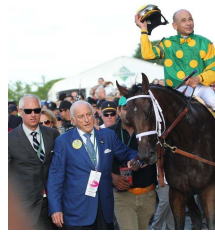

Having put his stop-start 3-year-old campaign back on track when winning the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York Aug. 22, Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's colt has chipped a bone in his near-fore. A tweet from the owners read, "Telescope will not run again this season as he has sustained a small bone chip to his near-fore fetlock joint. The chip will be removed asap. It is such a shame that he won't be running in the Champion S., but he will be back for an exciting campaign in 2014."

**CLARIFICATION:** The story about the retirement to stud of GSW **Winslow Homer** (Unbridled's Song) suggested Fox Hill Farm retains an interest in his stud career. They do not, and the stallion will stand as the property of a syndicate at Brent and Crystal Fernung's Journeyman Stud. We regret any confusion.

### 'NEVER' IN DOUBT AT PARAMOUNT

It's fitting that the outstanding juvenile colt **No Nay Never** (Scat Daddy) takes his name from the Irish folk song "[The Wild Rover](#)," considering the men who sold him, Paramount Sales principals Pat Costello and Gabriel Duignan, hail from the Emerald Isle. The unbeaten colt, who backed up his G2 Norfolk S. win with a victory in the G1 Prix Morny S. at Deauville Aug. 18, highlighted a big summer for Paramount, which sold No Nay Never at Keeneland September a year ago for \$95,000.

Another September graduate, the \$185,000 buyback **Bashart** (War Front), stamped himself as a turf star in the marking with a convincing win in the G2 With Anticipation S. at Saratoga Aug. 29, while **Forty Tales** (Tale of the Cat), an \$80,000 FTKJUL grad, completed a graded stakes hat trick in the GII Amsterdam S. at the Spa July 24. Other 2013 standouts to pass through a Paramount consignment include **A Shin Top** (Tale of the Cat), a \$400,000 September grad from 2011 who has won a trio of group stakes in Japan and earned over \$1.7 million.

Costello and Duignan are quick to deflect credit. "We're lucky to be in the position to sell for people that raise very good horses," said Duignan. "It makes us look good, but our success comes from our clients."

Paramount was launched in 2001 as a partnership between Taylor Made, Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds and Costello and Duignan. At the time, Costello was running his own farm, Drumkenny Farm, while Duignan was running the Ryan family's Castleton-Lyons Farm near Lexington. The men had begun working together through a successful pinhooking partnership they dubbed "The Lads," which realized a profit in 10 consecutive years, and the launch of Paramount seemed a logical next step.

Paramount got off to a quick start, selling the sale-topping GSW Spanish Empire (Pleasant Colony) for \$400,000 at the short-lived Keeneland October Sale in 2001. The next few years saw Paramount sell or offer a champion in **Forever Together** (Belong to Me) (\$27,000 KEESEP yrl '05) and a pair of Grade I winners in **Flower Alley** (Distorted Humor) (\$40,000 KEENOV wnlg '02) and **Sweet Talker** (Stormin Fever) (\$47,000 RNA yrl KEESEP '03).

In 2006, Paramount sold **Isla Canela** (Gone West--Islington {Ire}) as a KEENOV weanling for a world-record \$2.4 million. The same year, they sold eventual GI Belmont S. upsetter **Da' Tara** (Tiznow) for \$175,000 and GI King's Bishop winner **Visionaire** (Grand Slam) for \$300,000, both at FTSAUG.

By 2007, Costello and Duignan had bought out the other partners. The change in ownership makeup didn't disrupt the string of successes, however. Over the next few years, Paramount would go on to offer as yearlings the Grade I winners **General Quarters** (Sky Mesa), **Archarch** (Arch), **Bullsbay** (Tiznow), **Lilacs and Lace** (Flower Alley), **Majesticperfection** (Harlan's Holiday) and **Sassy Image** (Broken Vow).

"We've had some great clients that have been with us from the start and stayed with us," reiterated Costello. "Operations like the Randal family, Green Lantern, Sierra Farm, Castleton Lyons...they breed great horses, and it makes our job easy."

Paramount's most recent standout, Bashart, came by way of a new client, however. Rosedown Racing's Jeffrey Weiss was purchasing his first-ever mare when Duignan bought the 12-year-old Busy Windsong (Clever Trick) for \$90,000 on his behalf at the 2011 Keeneland January Sale with Bashart in utero.

Weiss returned Bashart to the Keeneland ring not once but three times, but failed to get him sold each time. Paramount consigned when Bashart RNA'd for \$65,000 at the 2011 Keeneland November sale and for \$185,000 at last year's September sale. Scanlon Training consigned when Bashart was led out unsold at \$195,000 at this year's April juvenile sale.

Asked about Bashart as a September yearling a year ago, Duignan remembered, "He went from being near the top of many lists, to dropping just off. It was just one of those things. He was a lovely horse, he really was, but for whatever reason people got off him. All credit to Jeff--he had the guts to race him."

Bashart has won two of three starts and earned \$178,000 for the Todd Pletcher barn.

No Nay Never was another who perhaps failed to live up to expectations in the ring, though he did sell at September, bringing \$95,000 to the bid of Cromwell Bloodstock.

"He was a lovely horse--I remember him well," said Costello. "I thought he'd bring a bit more money, actually. He was a very athletic horse."

Paramount comes into this year's September Sale with a stacked draft, according to Costello and Duignan, who have 150 horses cataloged over the

next 12 days.

"From top to bottom, the whole way through, it's the best consignment we've ever had," said Duignan. "A lot of times you may have 10 really good ones, and a bunch that you're worried a little about. That's not how it is this year. And again, that's a tribute to our clients."

Standouts include [Hip 27](#), a Tale of the Cat--Forty Love (Forty Niner) full-brother to this summer's star sophomore sprinter Forty Tales; and [Hip 36](#), a Street Cry (Ire)--General Consensus (Giant's Causeway) colt from a half-sister to recent Grade I winner Centralintelligence (Smarty Jones) who is offered on behalf of Sierra Farm.

"He's a big, solid horse," said Costello of hip 36. "He's the first foal out of a multiple Grade II performer, and he's a very, very good first foal. The Tale of the Cat was bred by the Randal family, and they breed lovely horses."

Others to watch include [Hip 204](#), a Tiznow--Meerkat Miss (Giant's Causeway) filly from a 3/4-sister to champion Hold That Tiger (Storm Cat) and a half to Classic winner Editor's Note (Forty Niner).

"It's a very good family, and her half-brother [the \$300,000 KEEAPR grad Chomsky, by Distorted Humor] ran a strong third on debut to [TDN Rising Star] Havana [Dunkirk] at Saratoga," said Duignan.

There are no fewer than seven yearlings by the world-class Galileo (Ire) at September, including the Paramount-consigned [Hip 174](#), a filly out of the GI Garden City BC S. winner Luas Line (Ire) (Danehill).

"She's like all the Galileos--they all have a big walk to them," said Costello. "There's a need and desire in America for pedigrees like this."

Costello and Duignan say the action's been strong thus far at their Barn 49, which could bode well for Paramount in the coming days.

"I'm usually a pessimist, but it's hard not to feel optimistic heading into this sale," said Duignan.

Reddam has also raced the likes of Breeders' Cup winners Red Rocks (Ire) and Wilko over the last 10 years. The regional Owners of the Year were Godolphin (Eastern Region); John and Debby Oxley (Midwestern Region); Brereton C. Jones (Southern Region); and Reddam Racing LLC (Western Region). The O'Farrell family's Ocala Stud has been a Central Florida mainstay for better than 50 years, and has been responsible for a slew of talented Florida-bred runners, including champion Musical Romance (Concorde's Tune) and Grade I winners Turbulent Descent (Congrats) and Bellamy Road (Concerto). Octogenarian Morton Fink is the owner and breeder of the reigning Horse of the Year Wise Dan and also acquired and raced his sire Wiseman's Ferry. He bred the chestnut from Lisa Danielle (Wolf Power {SAf}), who was also crowned the Broodmare of the Year at the awards ceremony. In addition to Wise Dan, Lisa Danielle has produced his year-old half-brother Successful Dan (Successful Appeal), recent runner-up in the GI Whitney H.
