## NEW-LOOK KEESEP BEGINS TODAY

The world's biggest yearling auction, the Keeneland September Sale, begins its 12-day run today with a new look that officials hope serve sellers and buyers alike. For the first time in Keeneland's history, Book 1 will be stretched to four sessions, running today through Thursday with action getting underway at noon each day. This Friday, Sept. 13, will be dark, followed by Books 2-5, each consisting of two sessions that begin at 10:00 a.m. daily.



"As everyone knows, we've been tweaking this sale to try to get a format that works, and we hope and anticipate this will," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Having 219 horses selling each day [during Book 1] gives buyers enough time to get around and look at them all, and allows consignors to market their horses. Starting at noon is a great idea that was suggested by one of our consignors; it gives buyers an extra hour in the morning."

It's the third significant change in format in as many years at September. Book 1 was held over two evening sessions in 2011, beginning on a Sunday night. Last year, a slimmed down Book 1 was held over a single session, followed by a three-session Book 2. Russell said the most recent change reflects a trend at sales that has embraced a more-is-better attitude when it comes to catalog size--so long as there is quality throughout, of course.

"It's the way the market is going," said Russell. "Select, boutique sales seem to no longer be in vogue. People seem happier to go out and discover their own horses. It's a factor of the market; it's the kind of format people like, and we like it, because it gets all kinds of buyers out there looking at these horses. Hopefully, we'll have major end-users and pinhookers and foreign buyers out there at the same time."

That certainly appeared to be the case this weekend on the sales grounds, which were packed with shoppers who arrived early and stayed late. "This is going to be a good sale," predicted Gainesway's Michael Heron. "In the past few years, people were sort of hesitant during Book 1, and with Book 2 there would be a lot of energy and atmosphere. Now, the atmosphere is good right from kickoff. I think this was the way to go. It will be interesting to see how the new format plays out, but I'd say we're looking at a strong market." **Cont. p3**

## 'DOLL' TO DEFEND GREEN JACKET

The GII Presque Isle Downs Masters, to be run this evening in Erie, has proven to be a powerful prep race for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint. Last year's heroine **Groupie Doll** (Bowman's Band), 2011 winner Musical Romance (Concorde's Tune), and 2009 victress Informed Decision (Monarchos) all won the Masters before taking home the hardware at both the Breeders' Cup and Eclipse Awards. Dubai Majesty (Essence of Dubai) was beaten a head here by Informed Decision in 2010 before scoring in the Breeders' Cup. Groupie Doll, a facile 4 1/2-length romper at the Breeder's Cup, has made just two starts since then. She was second by a nose to Stay Thirsty (Bernardini) in Aqueduct's GI Cigar Mile H. Nov. 24 before taking a hiatus and coming back with a third-place effort with some trouble in Ellis Park's one-mile GIII Gardenia S. Aug. 10. The Buff and Fred Bradley homebred is heavily favored at 6-5 on the morning line. **Judy the Beauty** (Ghostzapper), however, could give Groupie Doll a run for her money. The Wesley Ward trainee has yet to tally a graded score, but has consistently knocked on the door with three runner-up performances at the highest level, most recently finishing second in the GI Princess Rooney H. July 6. She was a gate scratch from Saratoga's GI Ballerina S. Aug. 23. **Cont. p15**

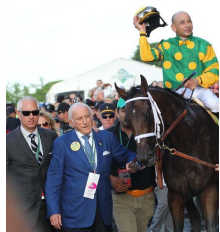

A total of 3,908 yearlings have been catalogued at September. That's an 8.4% jump from last year's catalog, which numbered 3,604, but still well off the 4,319 horses that were catalogued in 2011.

By and large, it's been a successful year of selling horses in America. Most of the juvenile-in-training sales enjoyed across-the-board gains, and that translated well once the yearling sale season began. At Fasig-Tipton July, average was up 10.4% to \$89,785, while the median rose 20%, to \$72,000. At Fasig's Saratoga Sale, average fell a modest 1.3%, to \$295,093, but the median was up 11.1%, to \$250,000. The select portion of the OBS August Sale, meanwhile, saw average jump 25.7% to \$55,058; the median was up 28.6%, to \$45,000. Importantly, the buy-back rate at each sale was down.

"The 2-year-old sales were very strong, and that's continued on to the yearling sales so far," said Russell. "We hope the momentum carries. We talked about supply and demand, and I think that's key. Supply is down, and there's a lot of interest out there. I'm very happy with the quality of the catalog we have here, and talking to the people out there, they seem to like what they're seeing."

### September Standouts...

September isn't necessarily the type of sale that relies on timely updates to boost its status--its reputation goes well beyond that--but that doesn't mean sales officials can't point out several big wins in recent weeks. Last year's renewal has already produced 22 black-type winners, including a quartet of Grade I winners. Lane's End sold **Strong Mandate** (Tiznow), winner of the GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga Sept. 2, to Robert Baker and William Mack for \$200,000.

Jeff Treadway paid a little less than that--\$185,000--for subsequent GI Spinaway S. heroine **Sweat Reason** (Street Sense), who was sold by Betterworth Westwind Farms. Mersad Metanovic Bloodstock acquired the Warrendale-consigned **She's a Tiger** (Tale of the Cat) for \$150,000 roughly 50 weeks before she won the GI Del Mar Debutante S. Aug. 31. And Cromwell Bloodstock paid \$95,000 for **No Nay Never** (Scat Daddy), a Paramount Sales grad who shipped in to win the G1 Darley Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 18.

The 2011 September Sale, meanwhile, can boast of having turned out a pair of eventual Classic winners in the form of GI Preakness S. winner **Oxbow** (Awesome Again), a \$250,000 colt from Burleson Farm's consignment who sold to Bluegrass Hall rep Eddie Kane; and the GI Belmont S. winner **Palace Malice** (Curlin), a \$25,000 Lane's End grad who sold to Colin Brennan, agent.

"Our grads have really outshone themselves," said Russell. "We won two Classics this year, and have now won nine of the last 12 Triple Crown races. Then the summer opened up, and we had 15 Grade or Group 1 winners, including the winners of the Travers [Will Take Charge], the King's Bishop [Capo Bastone], and the Test S. [Sweet Lulu]. It's a tremendous achievement."

Russell said it's been rewarding, too, to see longtime Keeneland clients, such as Baker, Mack and Will Take Charge's owner Willis Horton, and younger clients like Cromwell's Gatewood Bell and Mersad Metanovic, realize success at September.

"The great thing about September is you get a chance to sell to such a broad range of people," said Russell. "Mr. Mack, Mr. Baker and Mr. Horton are regulars who have bought successful horses here before, and it's great. But it's also great to see this younger generation coming up and having success, too."

**3, c, Arch--Fanny Cerrito, by Gulch**  
*Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency*

This grandson of the top-class Sabin (Lyphard) is a half-sibling to two stakes horses, including the stakes winner and Group 1 performer Poseidon Adventure (Sadler's Wells). "He is a beautiful Arch colt from a good family," said Taylor Made's Mark Taylor. "He's a really nice colt; gorgeous with a great walk. He should appeal to buyers from every part of the world."

**6, c, Smart Strike--Fashion Star, by Chief's Crown**  
*Consigned by Lane's End, agent*

A handsome, well-made chestnut, this colt was produced by MGSP Fashion Star and is thus a half to the Grade I winner Eddington (Unbridled). Another sibling, Star Crowned (Kingmambo), placed third in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen and earned a tick over \$600,000. Group 1 winner Miserden (Private Account) falls under the second dam.

**8, c, Distorted Humor--Film Maker, by Dynaformer**  
*Consigned by Lane's End, agent*

The \$2.2 million earner Film Maker did some of her best work at Keeneland--she won the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. here as a sophomore in 2003. This colt, her fourth, is a full-sibling to the good turf runner Film Shot, a multiple graded performer for trainer Bill Mott.

**17, c, Tapit--Flock of Doves, by Kingmambo**

*Consigned by Denali Stud (Craig & Holly Bandoroff), agent*

This is the second foal from an unraced half-sister to G1 Vincent O'Brien National S. winner and Irish highweight Pathfork (Distorted Humor). His stakes-winning second dam, meanwhile, the Sadler's Wells mare Visions of Clarity (Ire), is a half to GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner and multiple champion Spinning World (Nureyev). "He's a striking individual," said Denali's Director of Sales Aly Strainer.

**18, c, Candy Ride (Arg)--Flying Dixie, by Dixieland Band**  
*Consigned by Gainesway*

This colt was produced by a winning half to MGSW Hungry Island (More Than Ready) and GSW Soaring Empire (Empire Maker). His third dam is the blue hen Grade I winner Chic Shirine (Mr. Prospector). "He's out of a top King Ranch family--there's real depth and quality to the pedigree," said Gainesway's Michael Heron. "He's a big, rangy horse who moves well, and he's finding his way onto the major buyers' lists. We anticipate a good result."

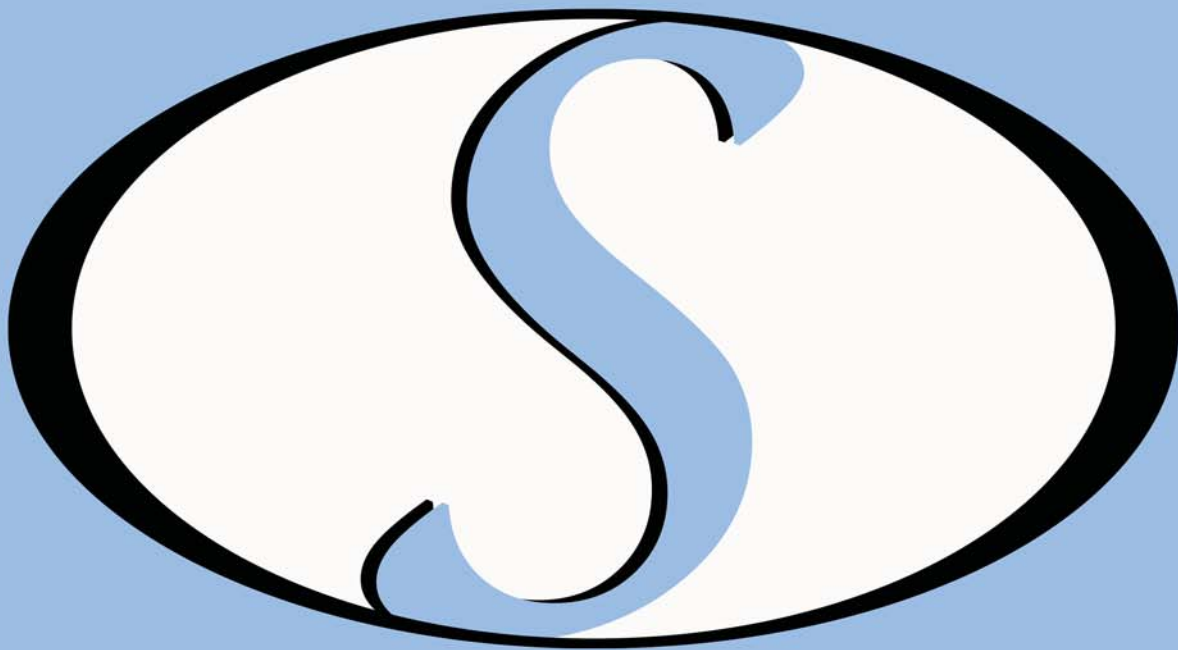

**80, f, Malibu Moon--Hollywood Story, by Wild Rush**  
*Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent*  
 Named Miss Hollywood, this filly was produced by the \$1.1 million earner Hollywood Story, whose wins included the GI Hollywood Starlet and GI Vanity International H. This filly is a half to MSP Hoorayforhollywood (Storm Cat).

**82, c, Speightstown--Holy Nova, by Pure Prize**  
*Consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent for Glen Todd*  
 Holy Nova was a seven-time winner whose victories included the GIII Ballerina S. at Hastings. This is her first foal, and the striking chestnut has been well received at the Three Chimneys consignment.

**95, c, Tiznow--I'm a Flake, by Mineshaft**  
*Consigned by Lane's End, agent*  
 This is the first foal from a daughter of MGISW November Snow (Storm Cat) and represents a proven cross, as her dam is a half to the GI Carter H. winner Morning Line, another by Tiznow. Two other of the mare's siblings are also stakes producers. Tiznow is having another fine year at stud as the sire of horses like recent GI Hopeful S. winner Strong Mandate, and his sire sons, most notably Colonel John, are performing, as well.

**98, c, Giant's Causeway--Imagine (Ire), by Sadler's Wells**  
*Consigned by Eaton Sales, agent*  
 This colt is a son of the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Imagine, a champion racemare who's has been just as effective the breeding shed. "This is arguably one of the best pedigrees in the entire book," said consignor Reiley McDonald. "He's a half-brother to Group 1 winner Horatio Nelson (Danehill) and a full-brother to Group 2 winner Viscount Nelson. This colt is as well-balanced a Giant's Causeway as you'll see; he looks as his pedigree suggests."

**120, c, Awesome Again--Joyful, by Distorted Humor**  
*Consigned by Denali Stud (Craig & Holly Bandoroff), agent*  
 This colt got two updates since the catalog was printed. First, his 2-year-old brother Cleburne (Dixie Union) won on debut going two turns on the turf at Ellis Aug. 16. Then Cleburne, a \$310,000 KESEP juvenile, returned at Churchill Saturday night to shock the GIII Iroquois S. at 34-1, putting himself on the early trail to next year's GI Kentucky Derby. "He's a really lovely horse," said Denali's Director of Sales Aly Strainer. "And obviously Saturday's update is just huge."



**156, f, Blame--Le Relais, by Coronado's Quest**  
*Consigned by Elm Tree Farm LLC (Mr. and Mrs. Jody Huckabay), agent for Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings LLC*

This filly is from the first crop of GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner and champion older male Blame (Arch), who led all sires in his crop last year by weanling average, with all 16 on offer selling for an average of \$132,727. That was off a stud fee of \$35,000. This filly is a half to GI Fountain of Youth S. winner Soldat (War Front).

**159, f, More Than Ready--Life Happened, by Stravinsky**  
*Consigned by Select Sales, agent*

This Mar. 31-foaled filly is a half-sister to this year's GI Jerome S. and GIII Gotham S. winner Vyjack (Into Mischief), as well as to the MGSP Prime Cut (Bernstein). "She has a lot more scope than your typical More Than Ready," said Select Sales principal Carrie Brogden. "She's actually very typical of what the mare throws--very correct, very nice physical horses. This filly's been very uncomplicated. She eats, she sleeps, she takes care of herself. She's going over very well."

**183, c, Malibu Moon--Madcap Escapade, by Hennessy**  
*Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent*

This is another offering from the top racemare and sales producer Madcap Escapade, whose victories included the GI Ashland S. here at Keeneland. This filly is bred along the same lines as Madcap Escapade's first foal, the Grade I winner Mi Sueno (Pulpit), both being sired by sons of A.P. Indy.

One of Godolphin's stalwarts who has his day now and then, Lost In the Moment enjoyed a peak here with Mickael Barzalona timing his run to perfection in this valuable prize. Runner-up in the 2011 G2 Goodwood Cup and a close-up sixth in that year's G1 Melbourne Cup, the bay managed a third placing in the G2 Lonsdale Cup last term and came back in similar form this season when taking the Listed Fred Archer S. over 12 furlongs at Newmarket June 29. Kept at that trip for Goodwood's G3 Glorious S., he was runner-up in that Aug. 2 contest before running third over an extended 13 furlongs in the G3 Geoffrey Freer S. at Newbury Aug. 17.

Held up towards the rear early in customary fashion as his compatriot Ambivalent was allowed a soft lead, he looked out of contention when driven inside the final quarter, but gradually ate up the deficit when switched outside and swamped the dueling fillies in the last 50 yards. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "He has run a huge race to win like that. He was behind, but finished well and has the class to succeed over a mile and a half, though he might be better at two miles. Lost In the Moment seems to be improving still at the age of six. There are no plans at the moment for him, but we will bring him home and see how he comes out of this victory."

Title Contender showed promise last year when he graduated at Santa Anita, besting subsequent graded winners in Code West (Lemon Drop Kid) and Ive Struck a Nerve (Yankee Gentleman) under Bob Baffert and owners Gary and Mary West. He struggled initially when he stepped up to graded company and was transferred to Wayne Catalano's stable. Title Contender didn't find his way back to the winner's circle until July 27 when he took the GIII Ohio Derby at Thistledown. He was privately purchased off that victory and was put in the care of Anita Bolton. The dark bay was a wide 11th in Northland Park's GIII Canada Derby Aug. 17.

Title Contender was away well here and held to a stalking position for the first time down the backstretch. Title Contender continued to lengthen his winning margin down the lane and finished under wraps. Prominent local owner Peter Redekop also took this race last year with the Craig MacPherson-trained Second City (Distorted Humor).

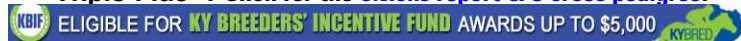

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### *Emollient Breezes Towards Garden City...*

Juddmonte Farms' **Emollient** (Empire Maker), already a Grade I winner on two surfaces, breezed six furlongs Sunday morning in 1:14.12 over the Belmont turf course in advance of her appearance in Saturday's GI Garden City S. at the Long Island oval. Winner of half of her eight career starts, the homebred overcame a wide draw to crush her rivals in the GI Central Bank Ashland S. at Keeneland in April and added a victory in the GI American Oaks over the summer at Hollywood Park. Those efforts sandwiched a dull sixth in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. on the dirt May 17. "She'd run so well on the synthetic at Keeneland," said Mott of the decision to try turf in the American Oaks. "We'd worked her on the turf and that went extremely well. So we decided to try her away from dirt, since obviously that wasn't working out. Empire Makers seem to run very well on the synthetic, but they can be dirt or turf as well," he added. "They can do anything, you just have to test them out. You see a lot of them win at Keeneland when you put them on synthetic, which she did. She's been good enough to win on all three, but at this point in time I'd say she's best on turf, or synthetic."

Among those set to oppose Emollient in the Garden City are GI Del Mar Oaks winner **Discreet Marq** (Discreet Cat); **Caroline Thomas** (Giant's Causeway), last-out upsetter of the GII Lake Placid S.; Lake Placid and GII Lake George S. runner-up **Watsdachances (Ire)** (Diamond Green {Fr}); and **Alterite (Fr)** (Literato {Fr}), runner-up in this year's G1 Prix Saint-Alary and making her U.S. debut for owner Martin Schwartz and trainer Chad Brown.

### *Breeders' Cup Options for Futurity Winner...*

**Solitary Ranger** (U S Ranger), who broke his maiden in style by taking Saturday's GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity by 5 1/2 lengths, has the Breeders' Cup as a long-term goal, but trainer Wayne Catalano has yet to determine what surface the colt will appear on. "He looks pretty good [Sunday]," said the conditioner, who was winning the Futurity for the third time since 2009. "We'll probably look at the [GI Dixiana] Breeders' Futurity [at Keeneland Oct. 5] after this. We liked him all along. He's been breezing very well." Solitary Ranger was a debut second over the Keeneland Poly Apr. 7, then had the misfortune of hooking subsequent G1 Prix Morny hero No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) in an Apr. 26 heat and rounded out the exacta. Saturday's race was his first in over 19 weeks.

But despite the success on the synthetic track, Catalano has a surface switch in the back of his mind, potentially even on Breeders' Cup day. "I think we'll be eventually trying the turf with him. But, right now, our main goal is to get him to the Breeders' Cup," the 'Catman' confirmed. The Louisiana native also reported the Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' **Battlefield Angel** (Proud Citizen), a troubled sixth in the Arlington-Washington Lassie S. Saturday, is also likely to be Keeneland-bound for a start in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 4. She could face a rematch in that two-turn test with Lassie victress **She's Offlee Good** (Offlee Wild).

### *Kazeem Fine After Champion Eclipse...*

Trainer Roger Charlton yesterday reported **Al Kazeem (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) to be none the worse for his defeat in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown. Runner-up to The Fugue (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the 10-furlong feature, John Deer's homebred 5-year-old was suffering his second consecutive reversal after finishing third in the G1 Juddmonte International. "I was pleased with the run and that he reversed the form at York with Trading Leather," he told *PA Sport*. "He was just beaten by a very good filly on the day. I expect we will see what happens next weekend in all the trials and make the right decision [about his target]."

### *Approach Continues to Thrive...*

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) was the subject of an upbeat bulletin from trainer Jim Bolger yesterday as he builds towards the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Godolphin's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 St James's Palace S. winner returned a dirty scope after his latest fifth in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville Aug. 11 but is firmly back on track for his mile target on QIPCO Champions' Day Oct. 19. "All's been well since about 10 days ago, and he's at the top of his game at the moment, so we'll start getting him ready for Ascot shortly," his conditioner said. "He was scoped two days before the Deauville race and he was clean and the day after the race he wasn't. It's reasonable to assume that he had mucus when he was running and that would account for his run."

### *Universal Injured...*

Abdullah Al Mansoori's G2 Jockey Club S. and G2 Princess of Wales's S. victor **Universal (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) has suffered a career-threatening injury at trainer Mark Johnston's Yorkshire base. The 4-year-old chestnut, who was a last-out fifth in the July 27 G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot, fractured a pastern during morning exercise yesterday. **Cont. p17**

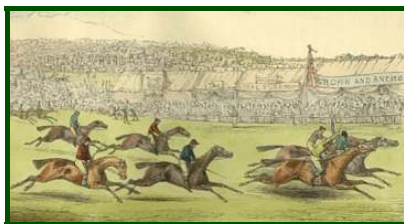

“Universal, the highest-rated horse in our yard, fractured his pastern on the gallops this morning,” commented trainer Mark Johnston. “He is travelling to Newmarket Equine Hospital where surgeon Ian Wright will operate. I am in Lexington for the forthcoming Keeneland yearling sales and so is owner Abdullah Al Mansoori. I have just spoken to him on the ‘phone and, as he so aptly put it, we are both numbed. Our dreams of Group 1 glory for this admirably progressive horse are shattered. It was our intention that Universal would run in the Irish St Leger next weekend, followed by the Canadian International and the Japan Cup. With such a tough horse, it never entered our heads that injury could stop him. It brings back memories of Fruits of Love, who fractured his pelvis on the eve of the first Keeneland sale I ever attended. I can only dream that Universal’s accident will have such a happy outcome and that he might race successfully again.”

Not raced since finishing last in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 20, James Rowsell and Mark Dixon’s homebred G1 Epsom Oaks heroine pleased in a racecourse gallop at Kempton on Friday. “She worked at Kempton because the grass gallop at home is very dry and therefore very quick, so we haven’t been able to get on the grass,” Beckett explained. “She’s in good nick and I’m hoping we’ll be able to run. I’ll see how we are early in the week and we’ll plan away from there. I’d like to run her.”

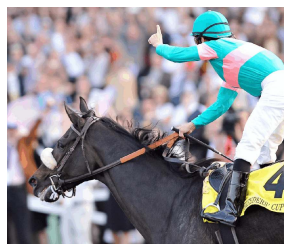
